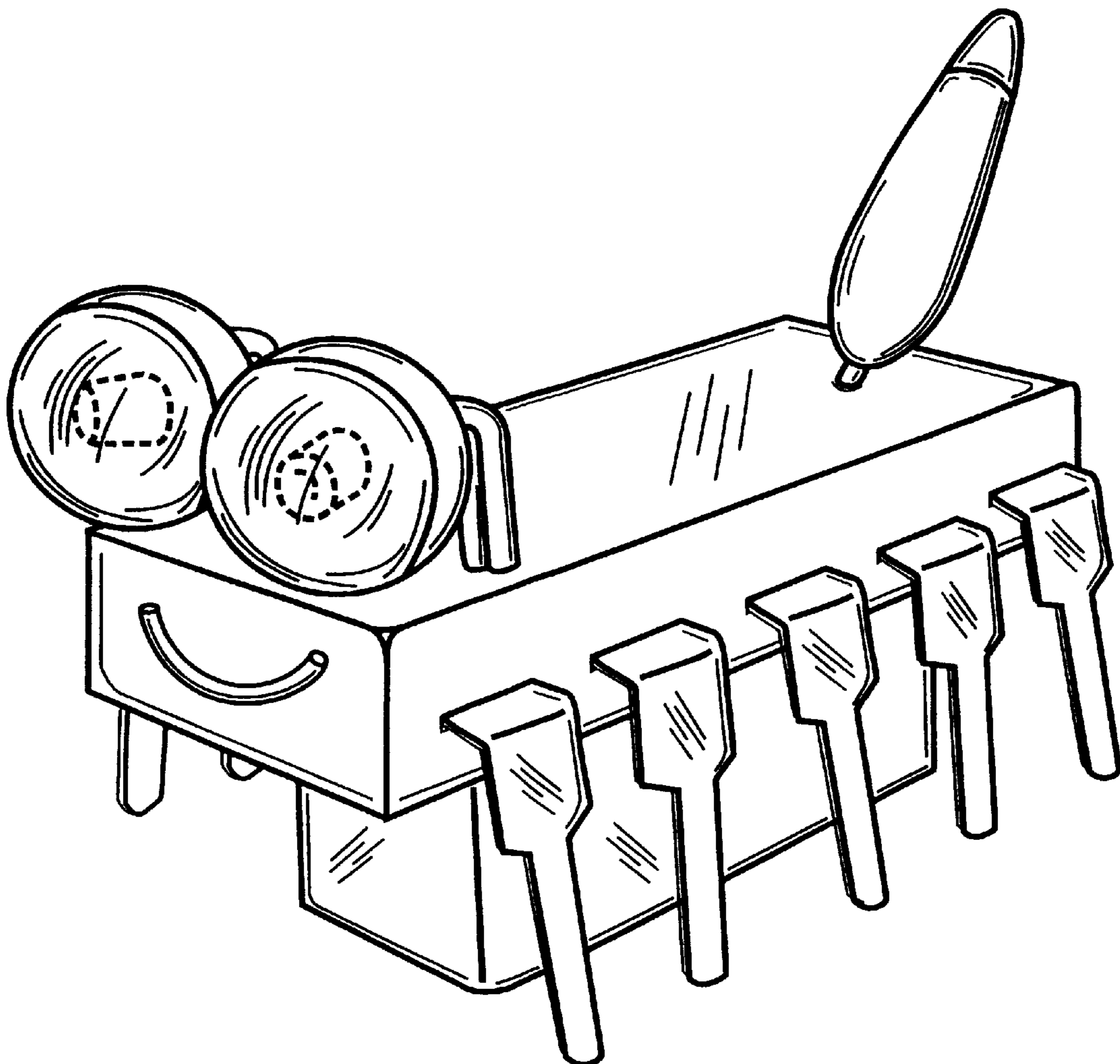
FIG. 1 is a perspective view.

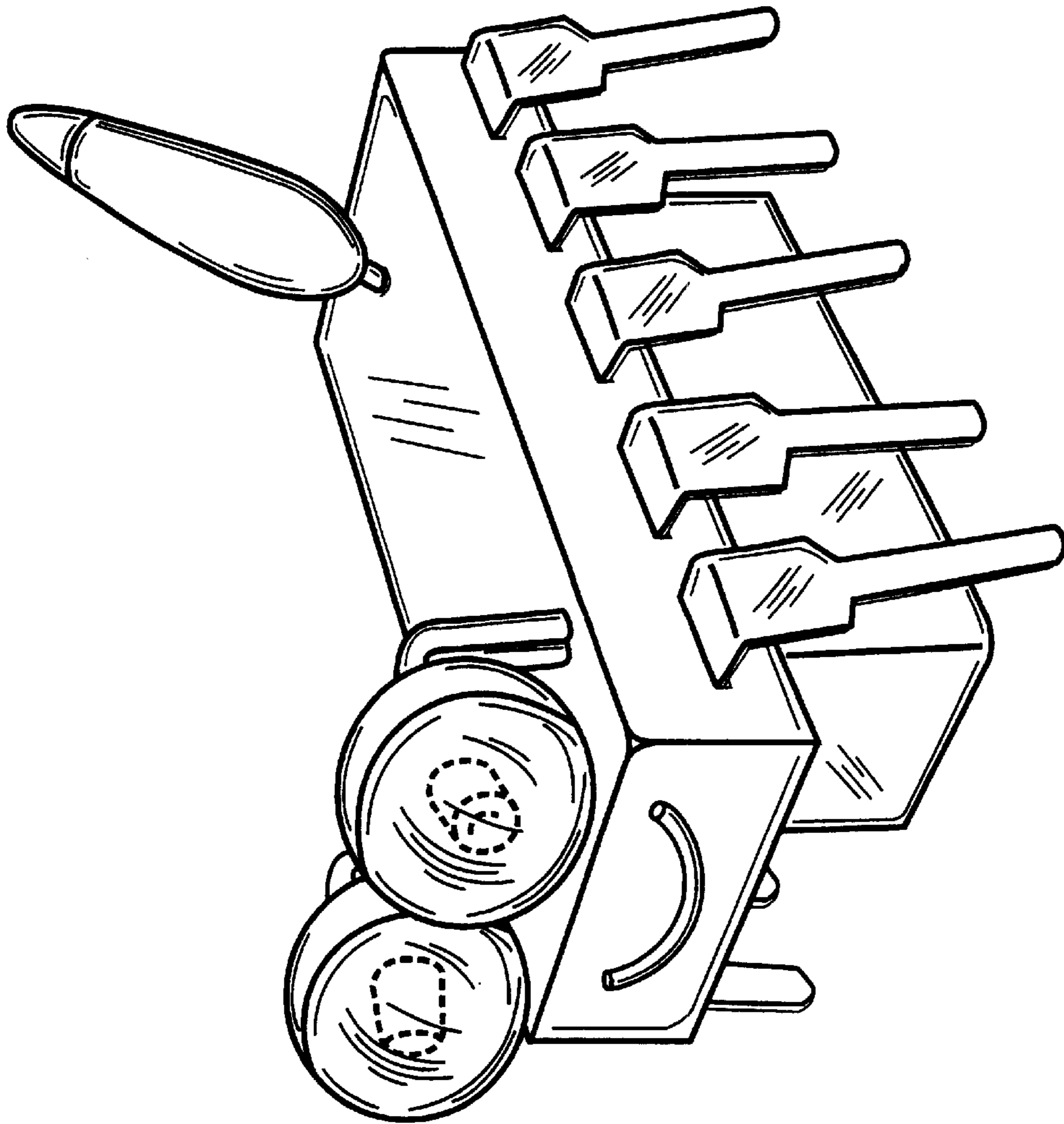

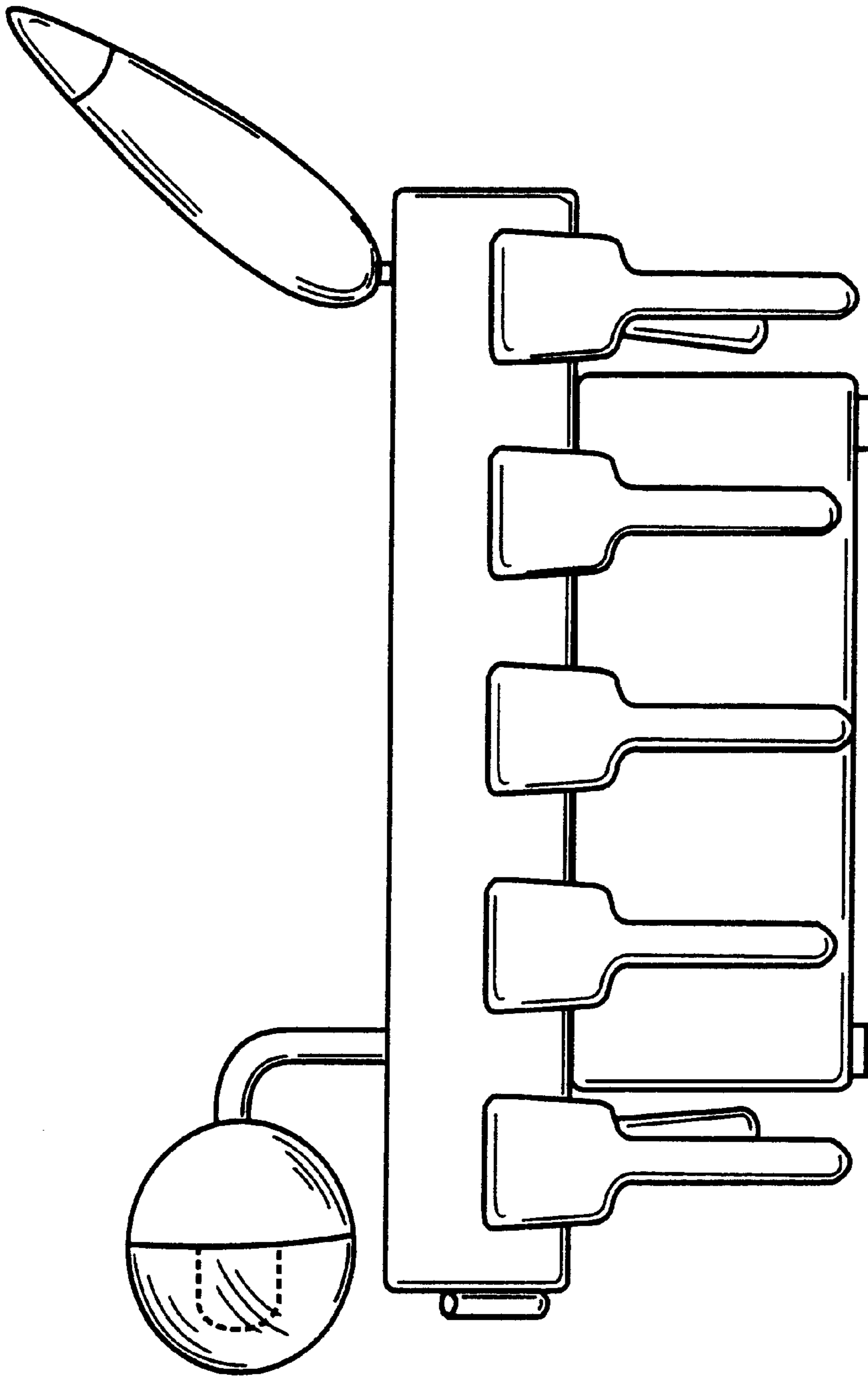

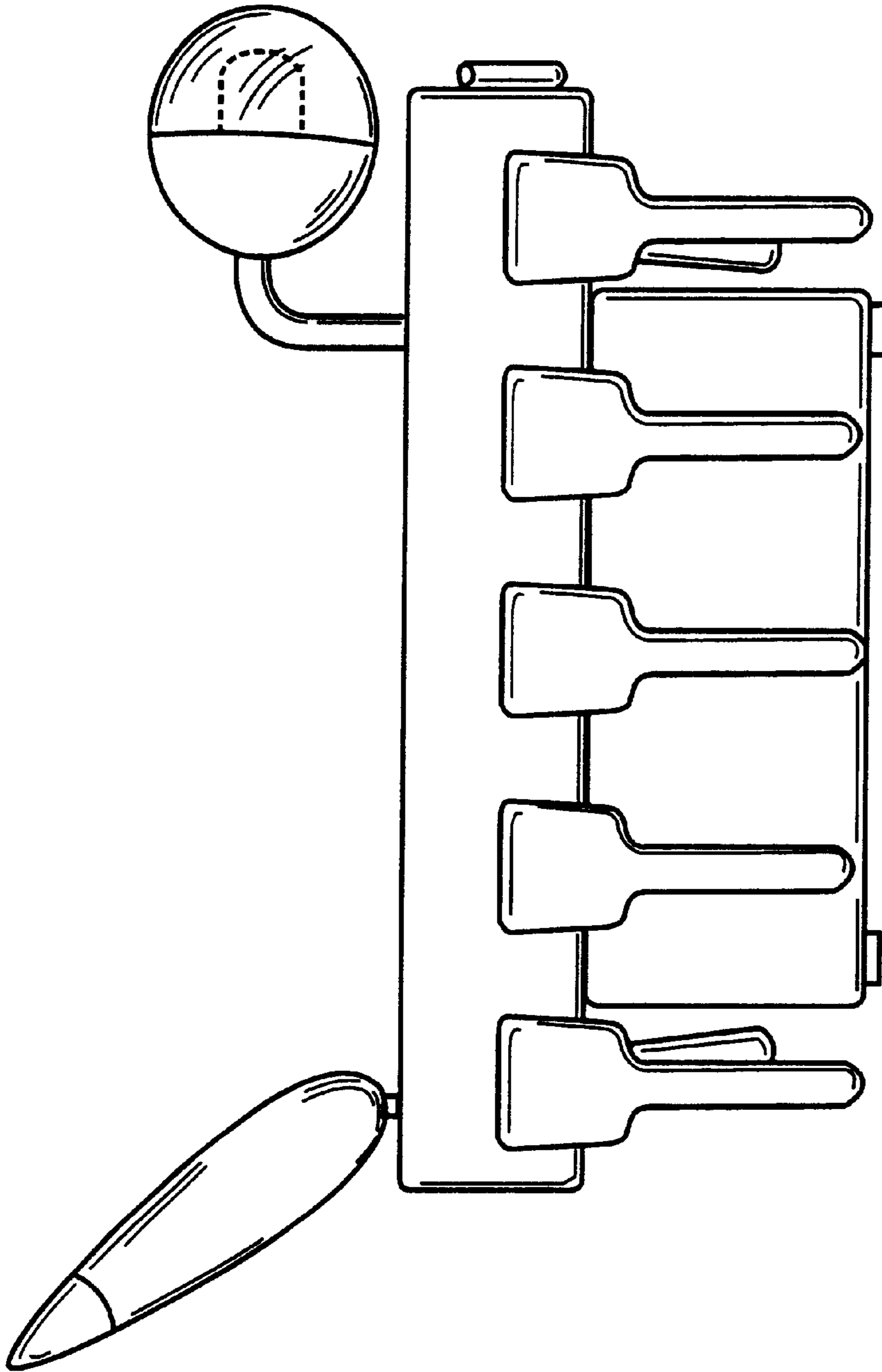

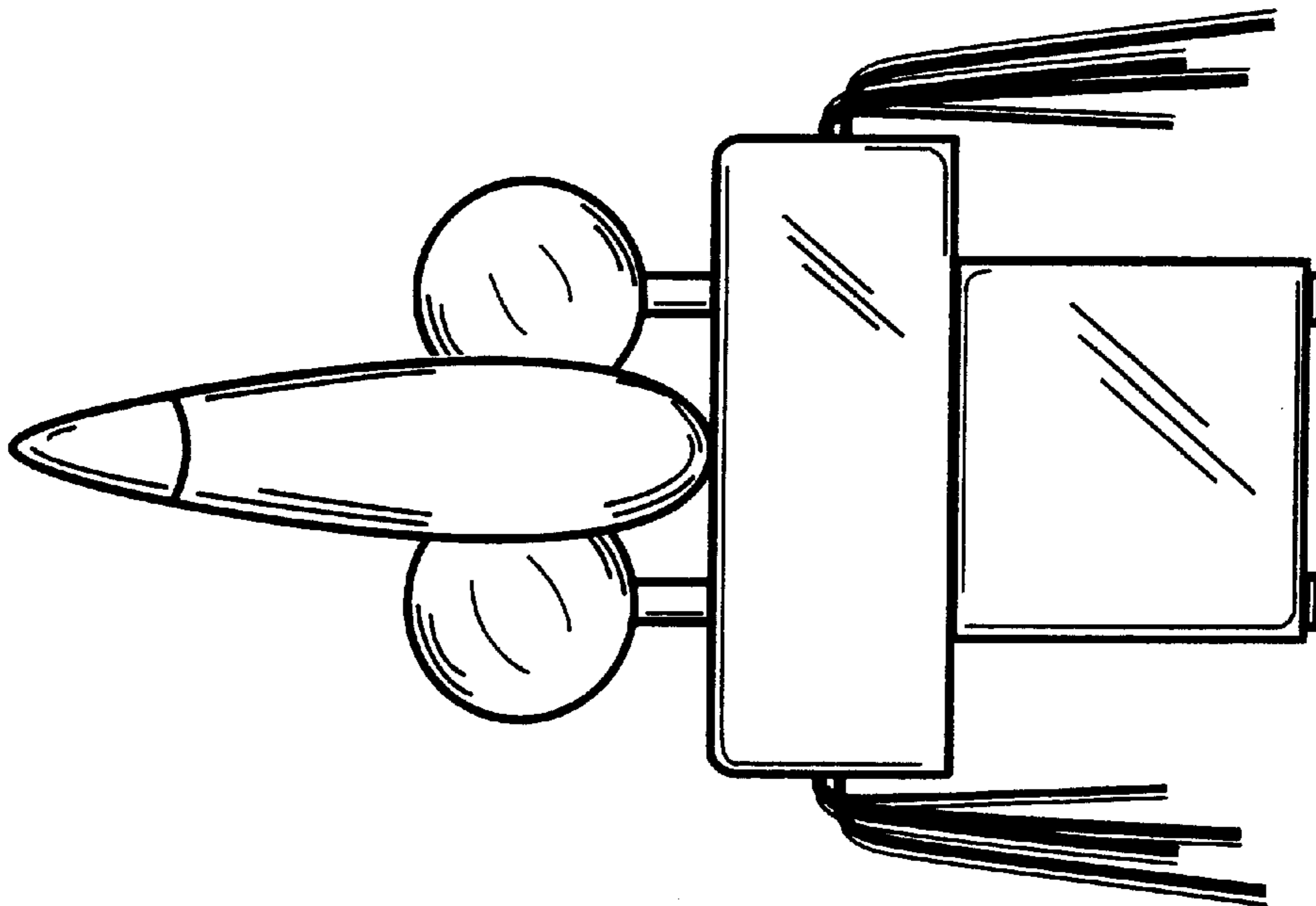

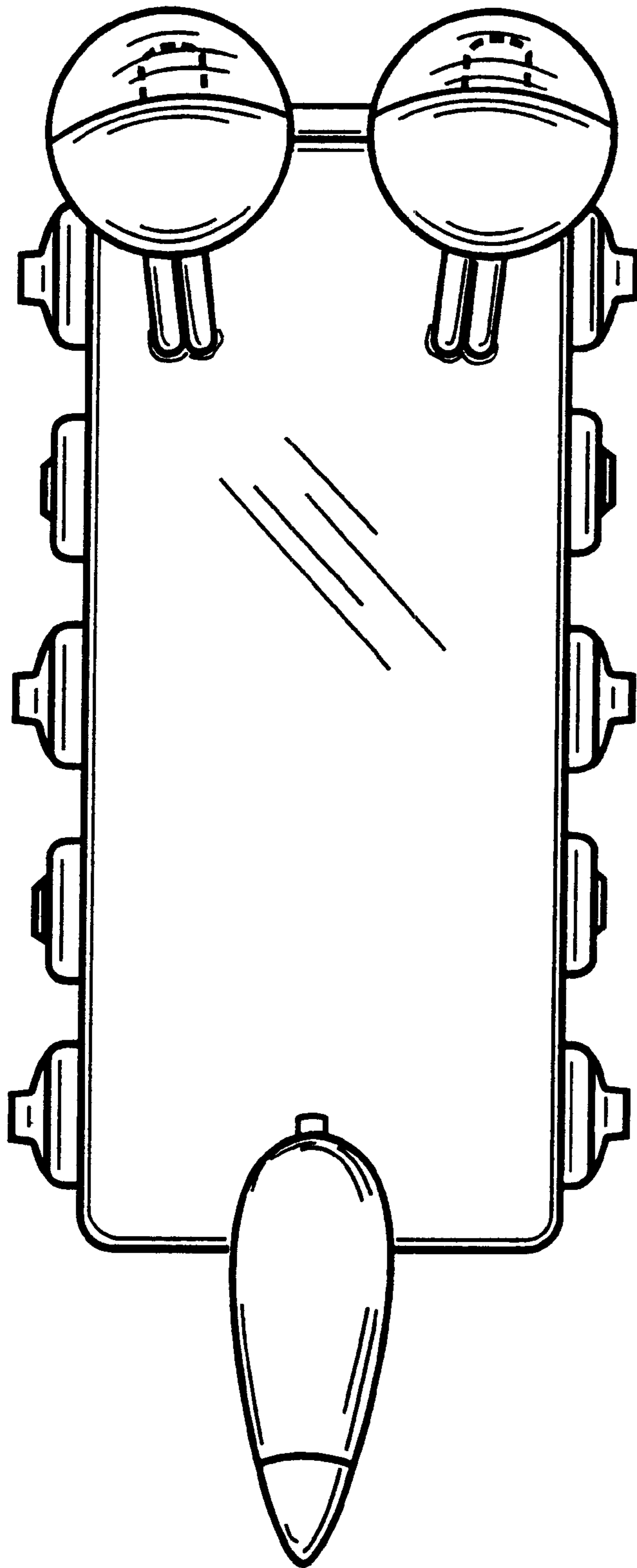

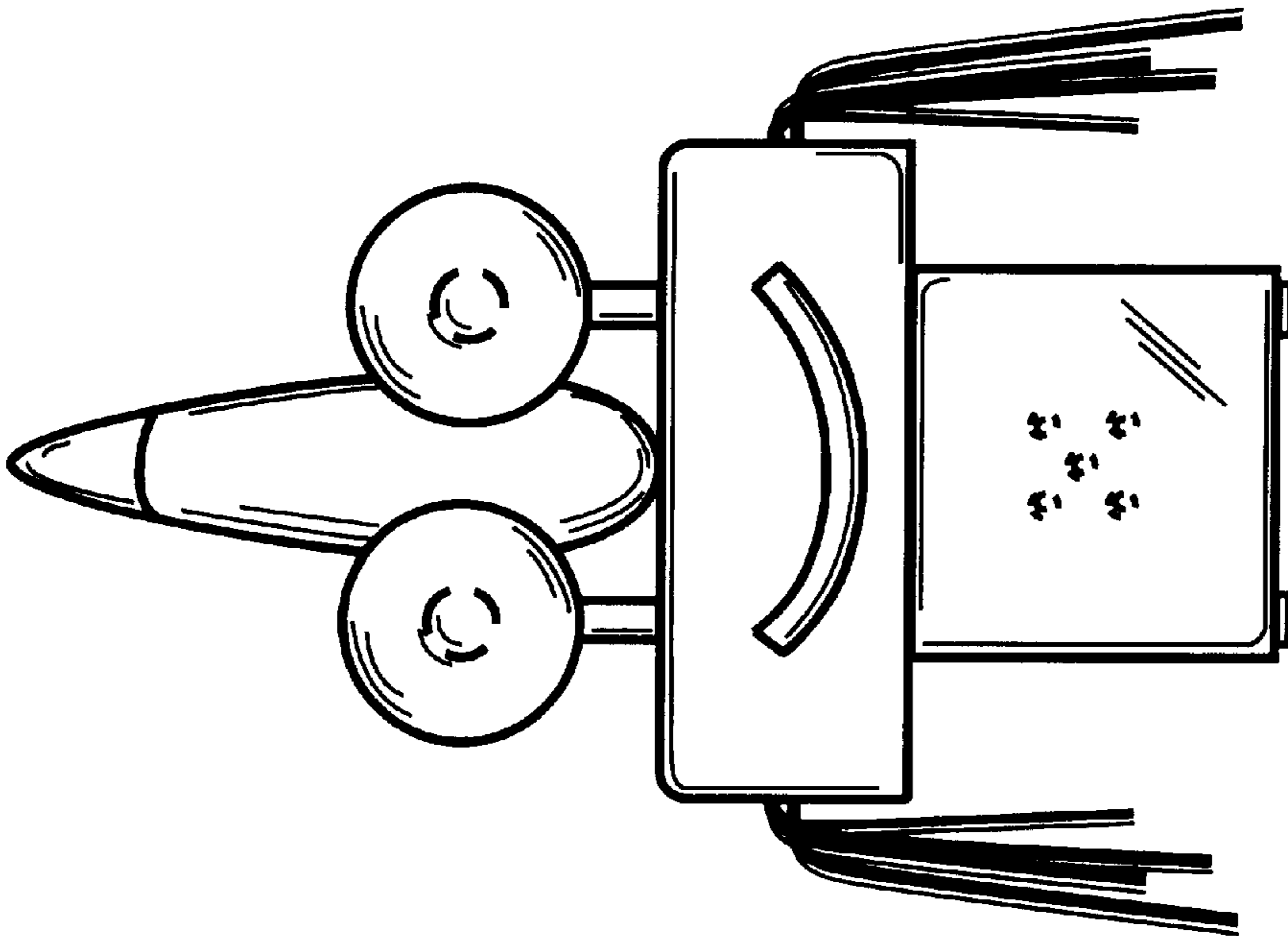
