FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

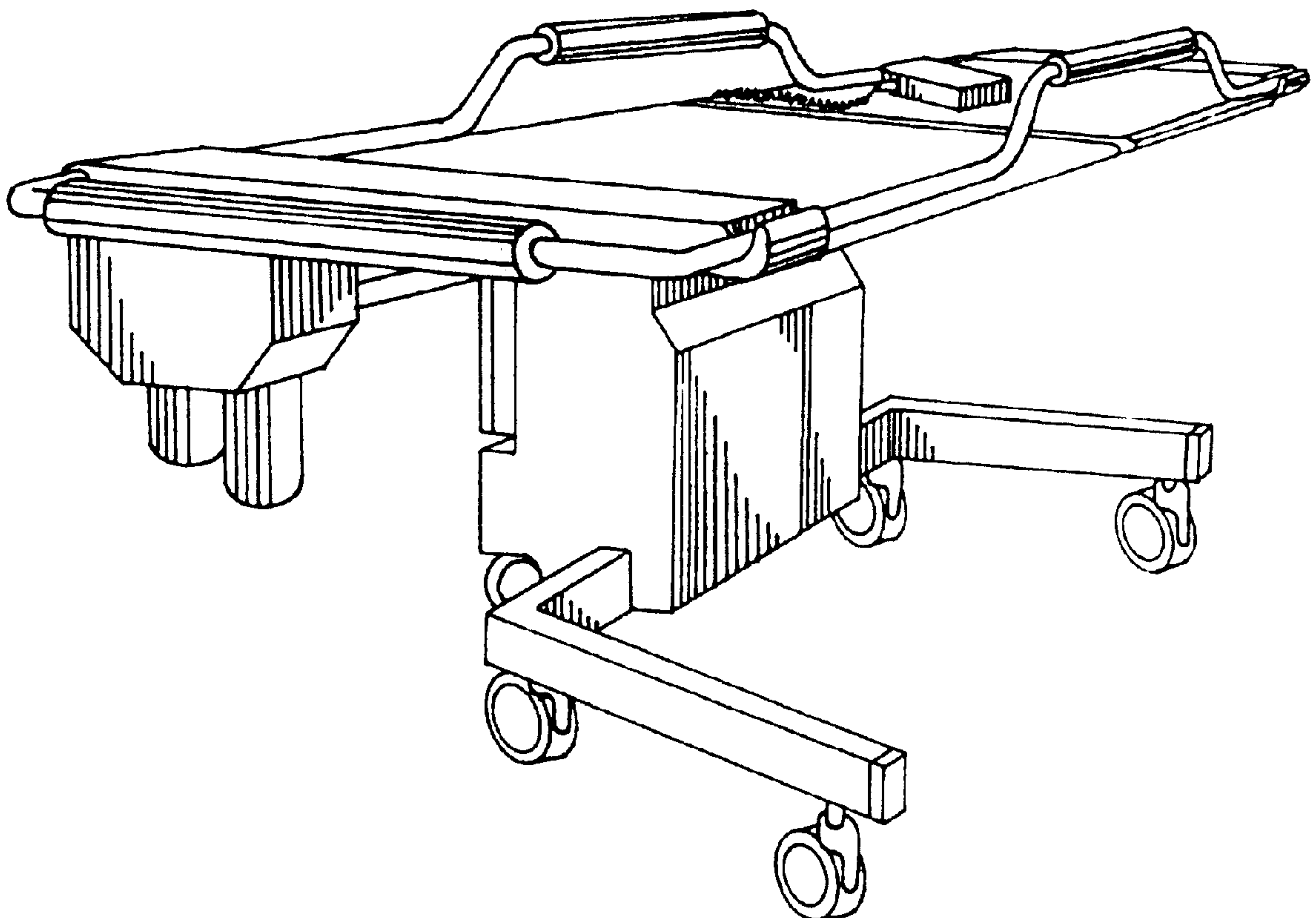
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

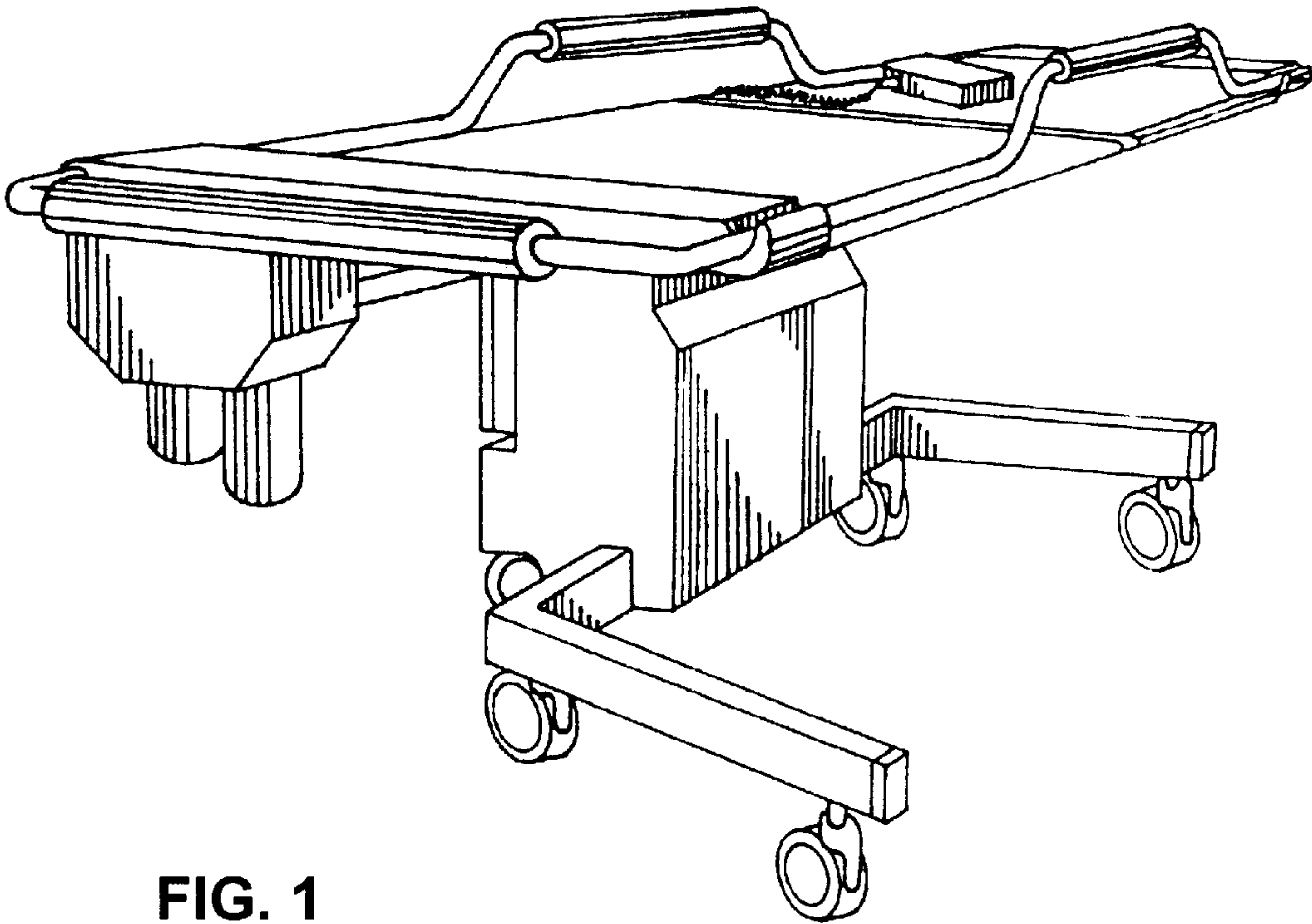

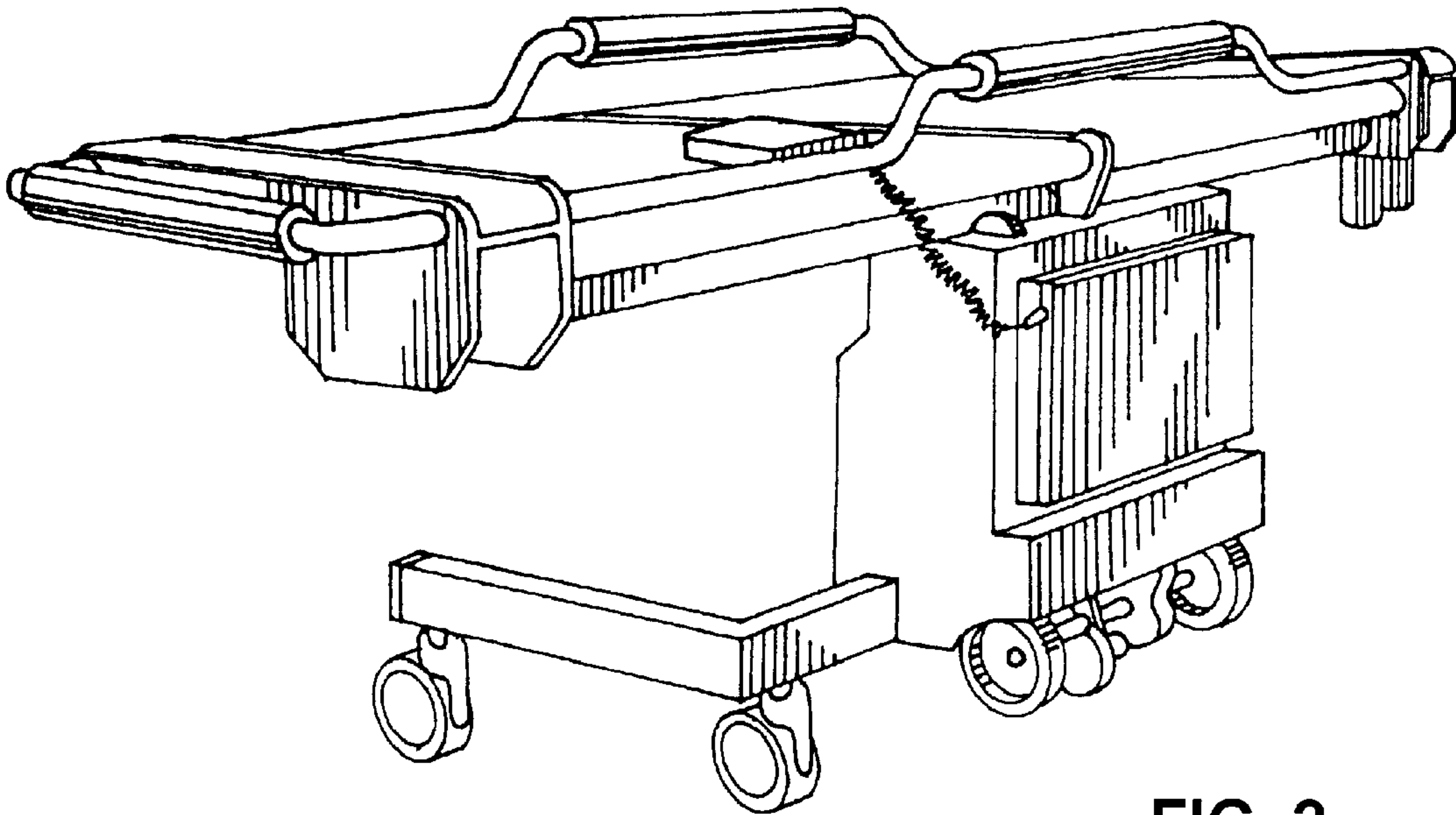

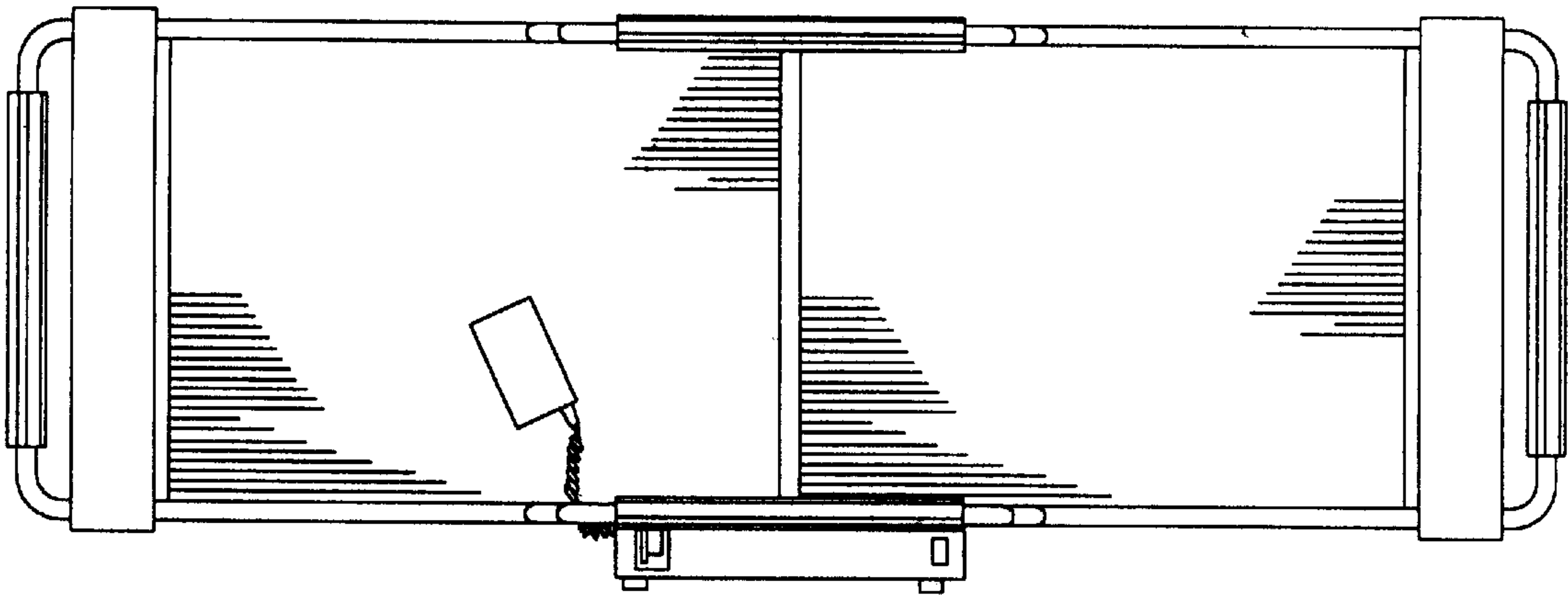

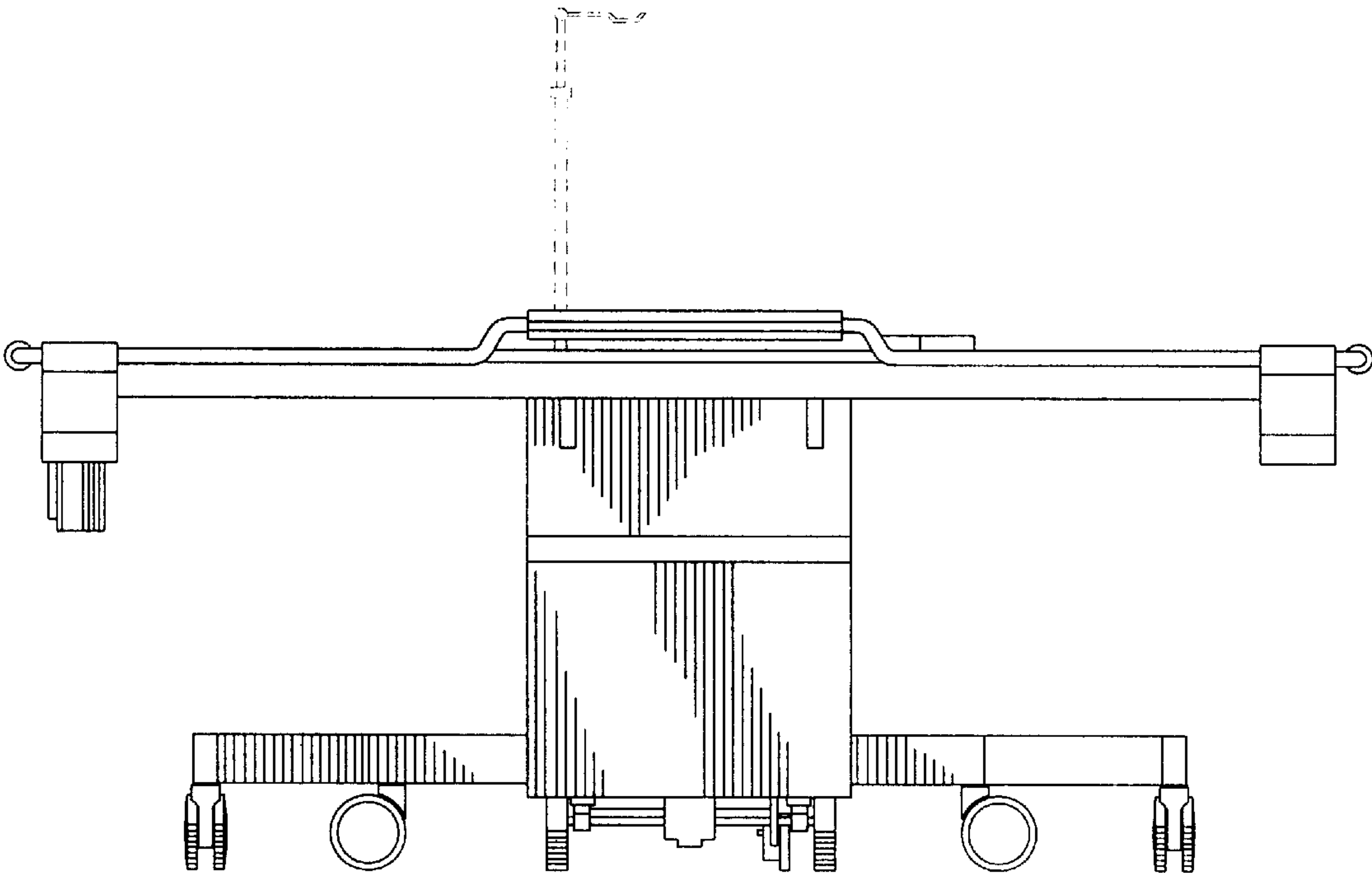

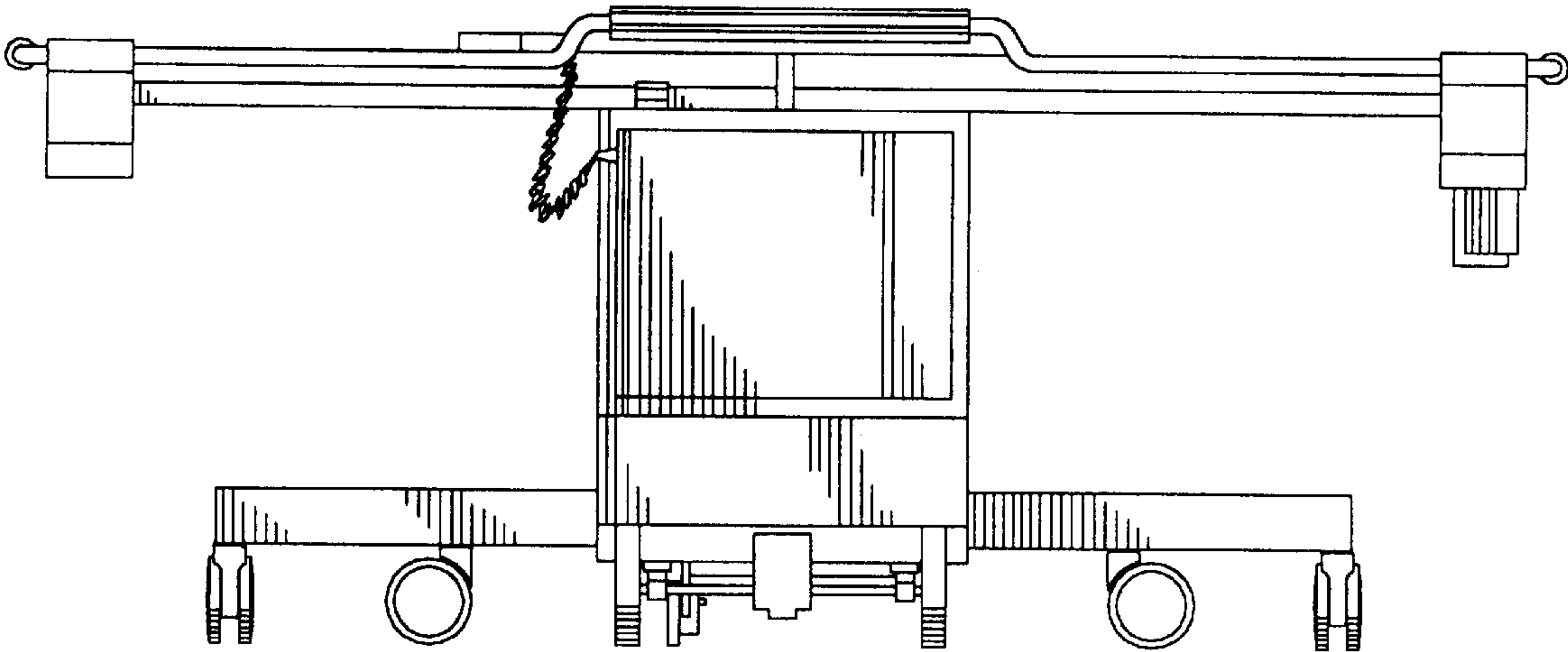

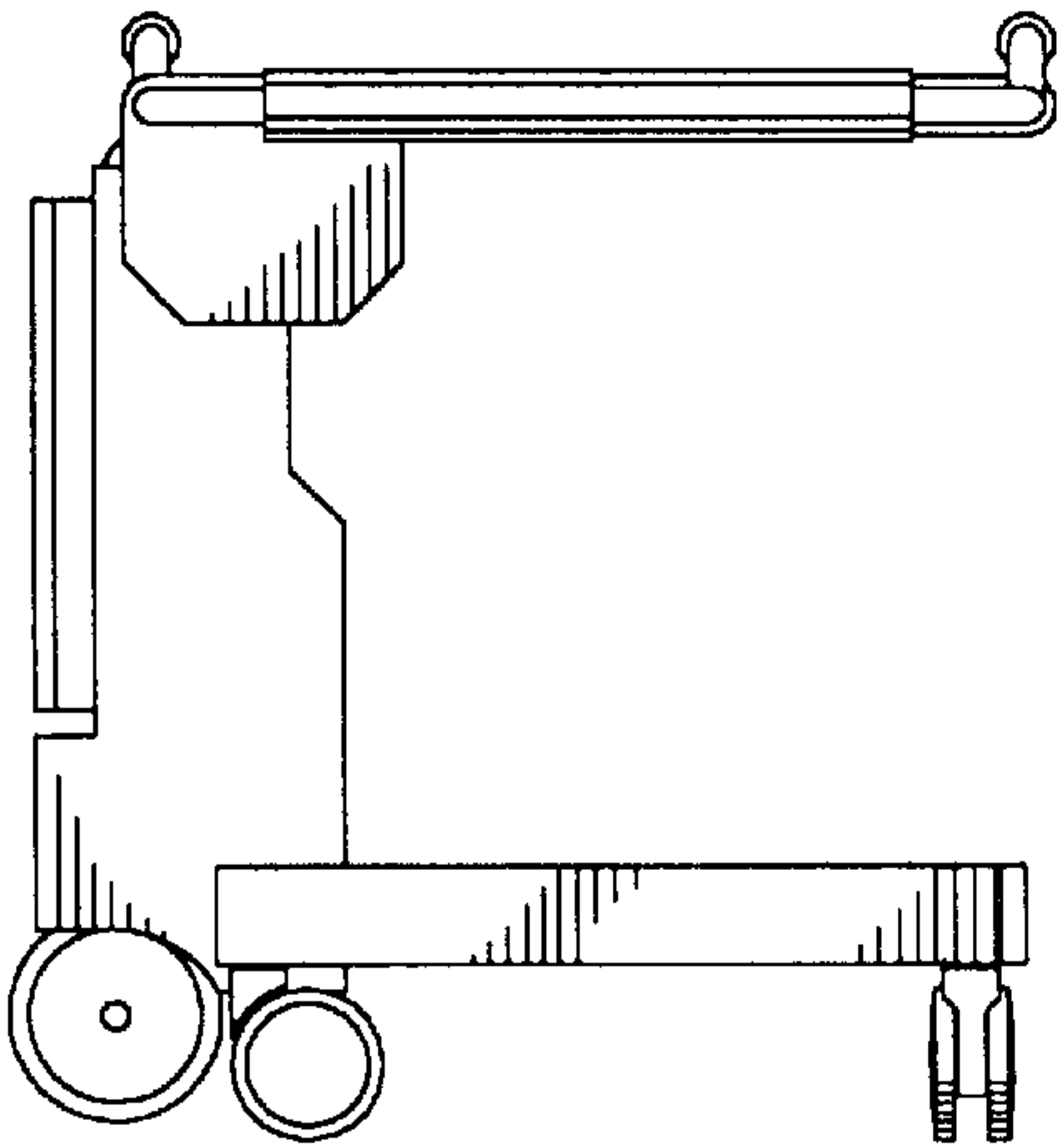

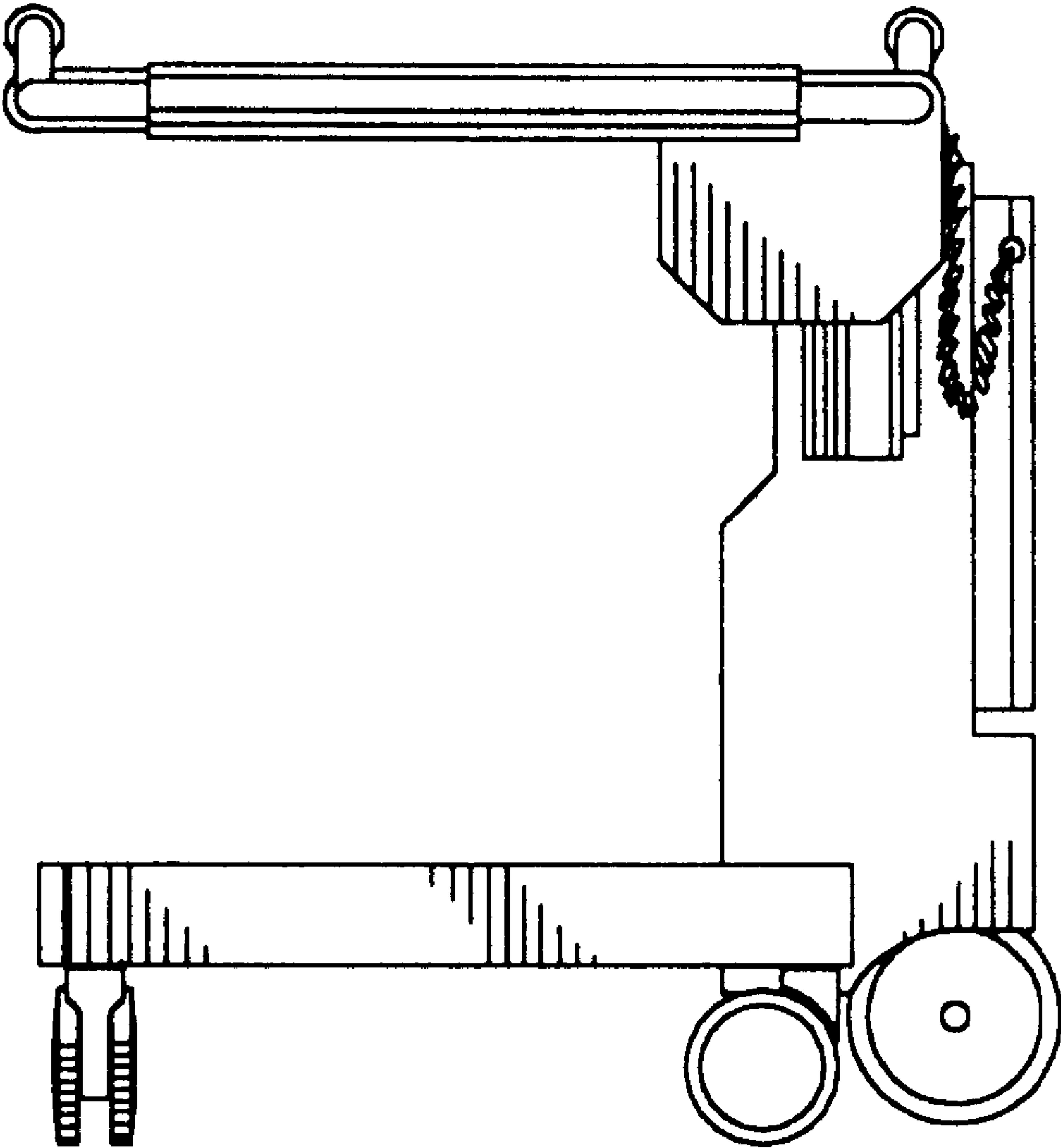
