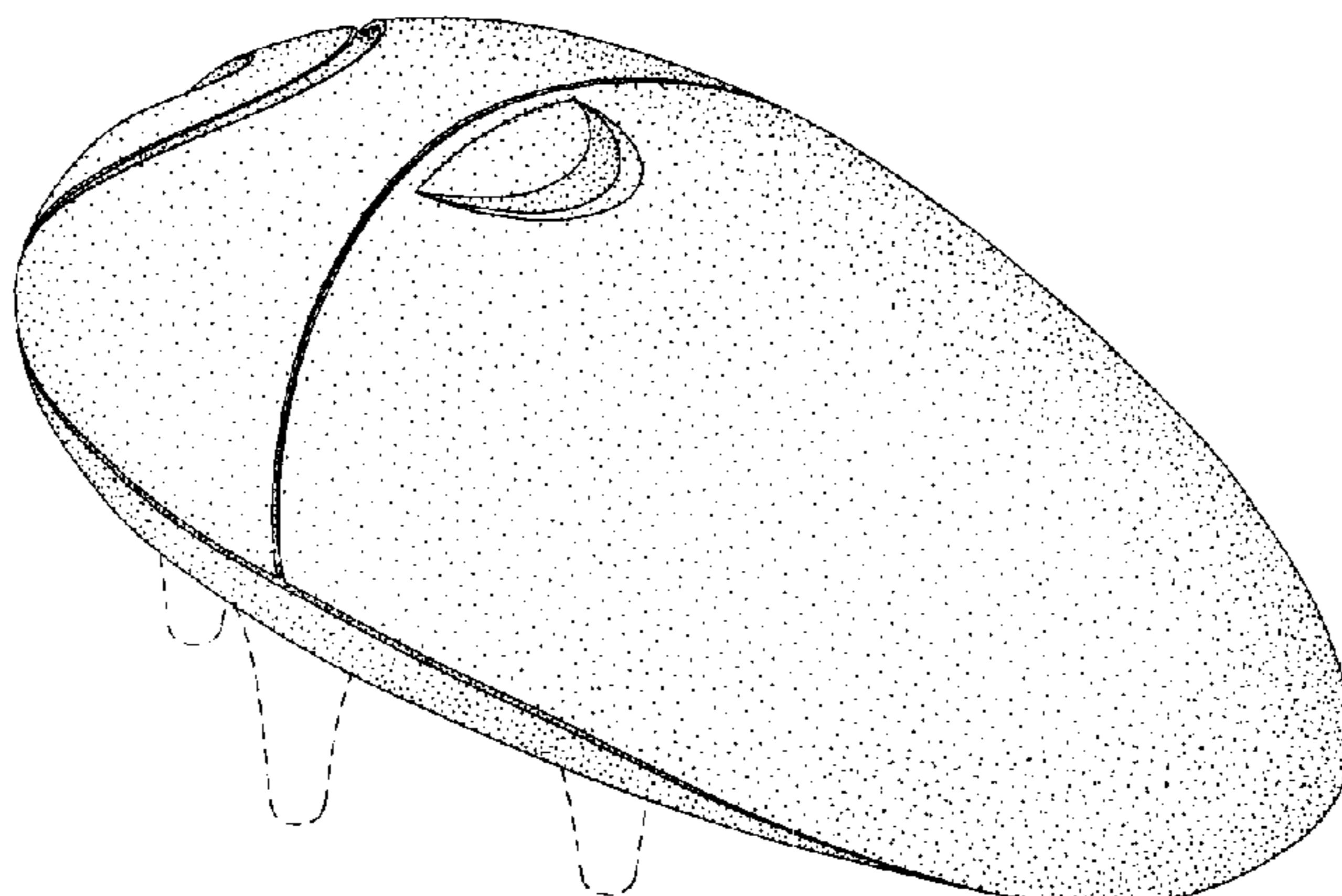
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an scalp applicator, embodying our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side being a mirror image;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.

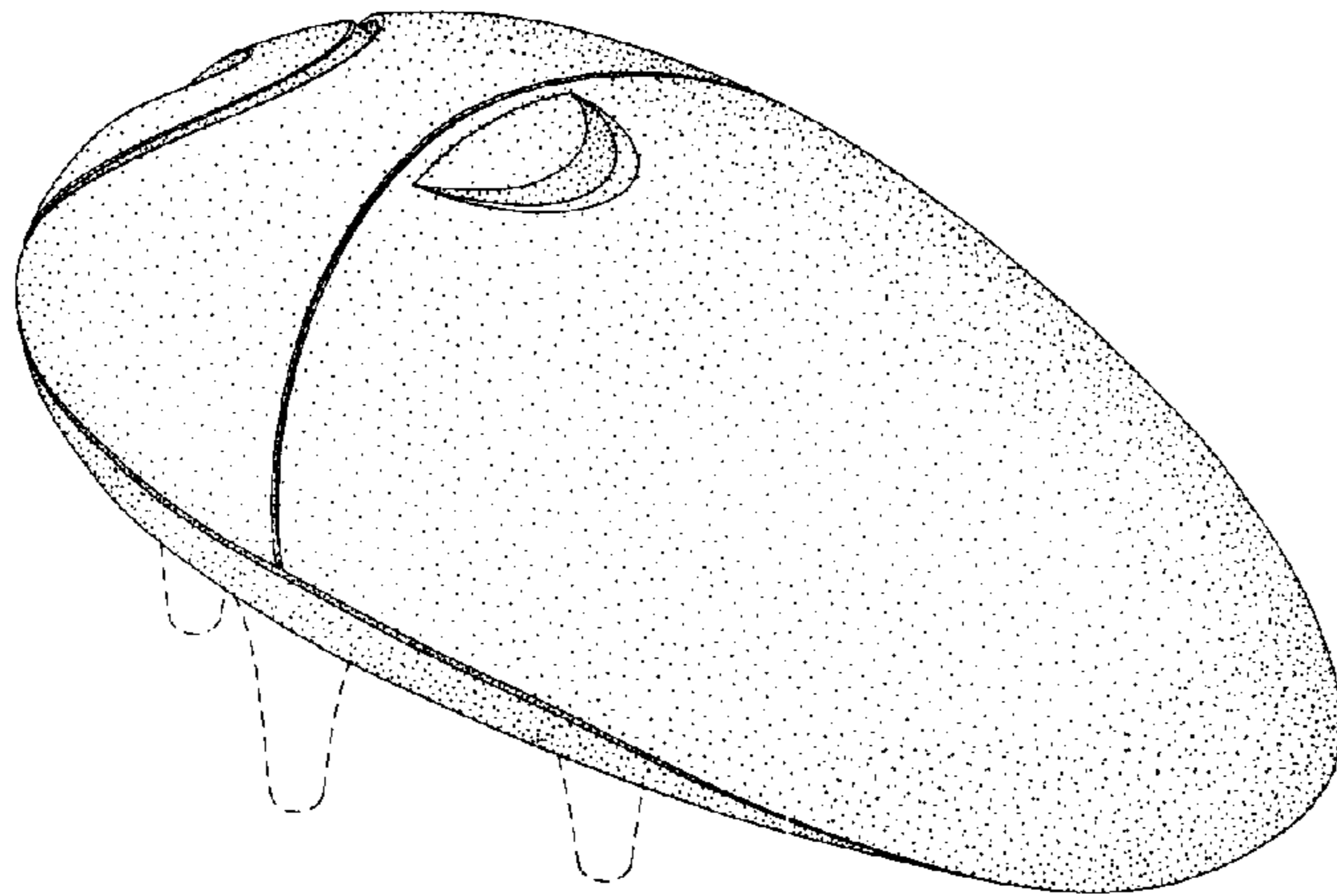

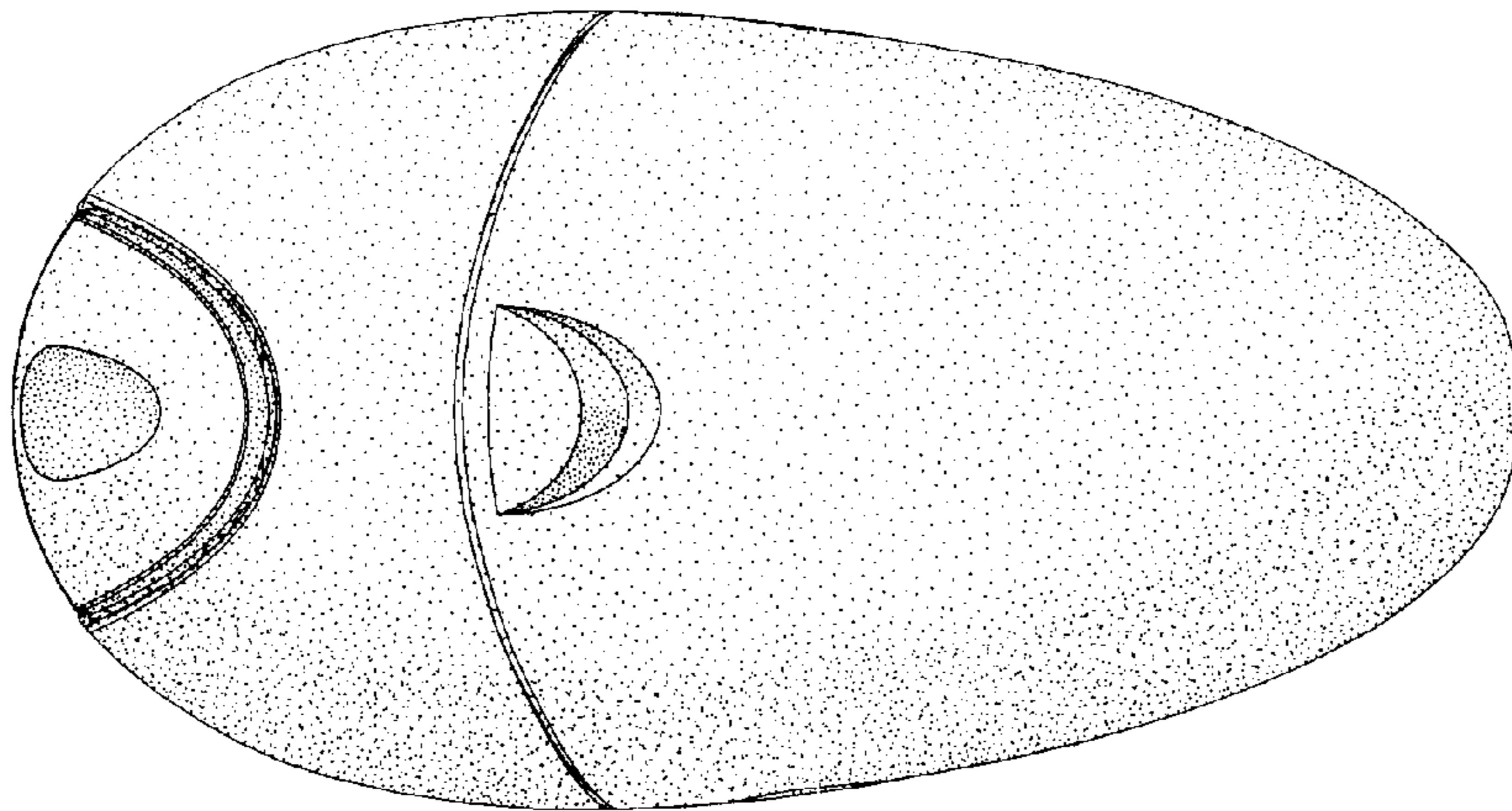

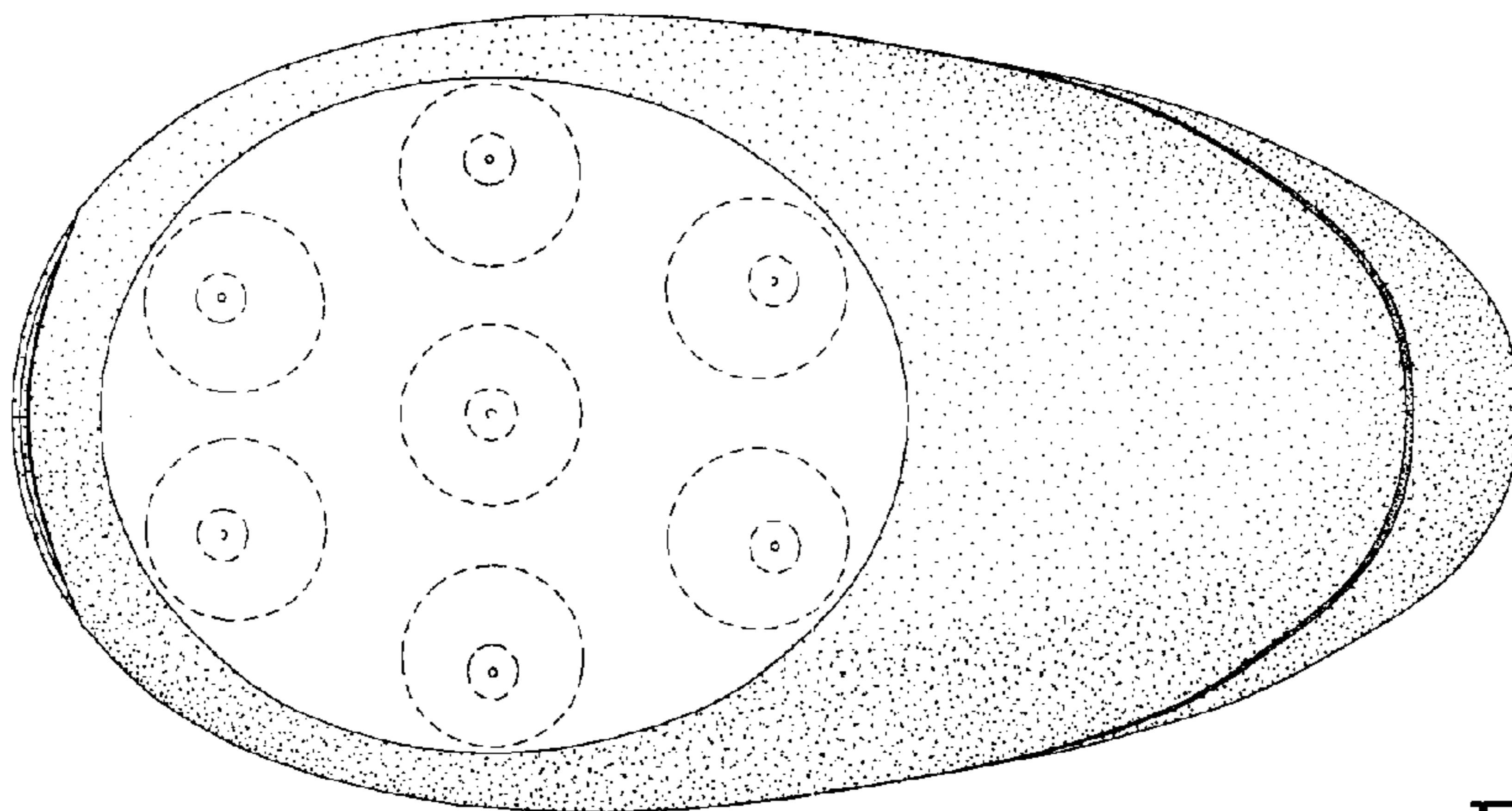

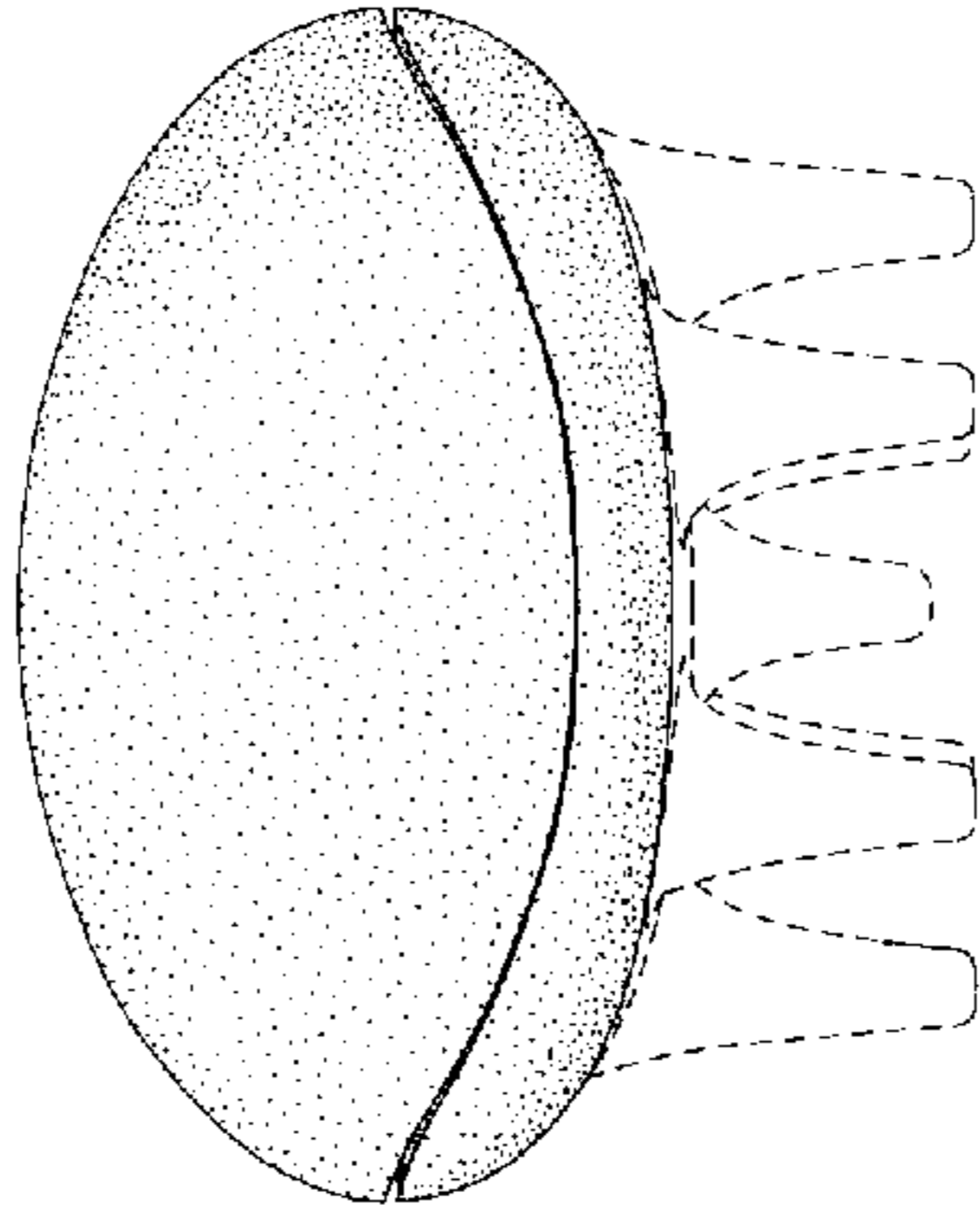

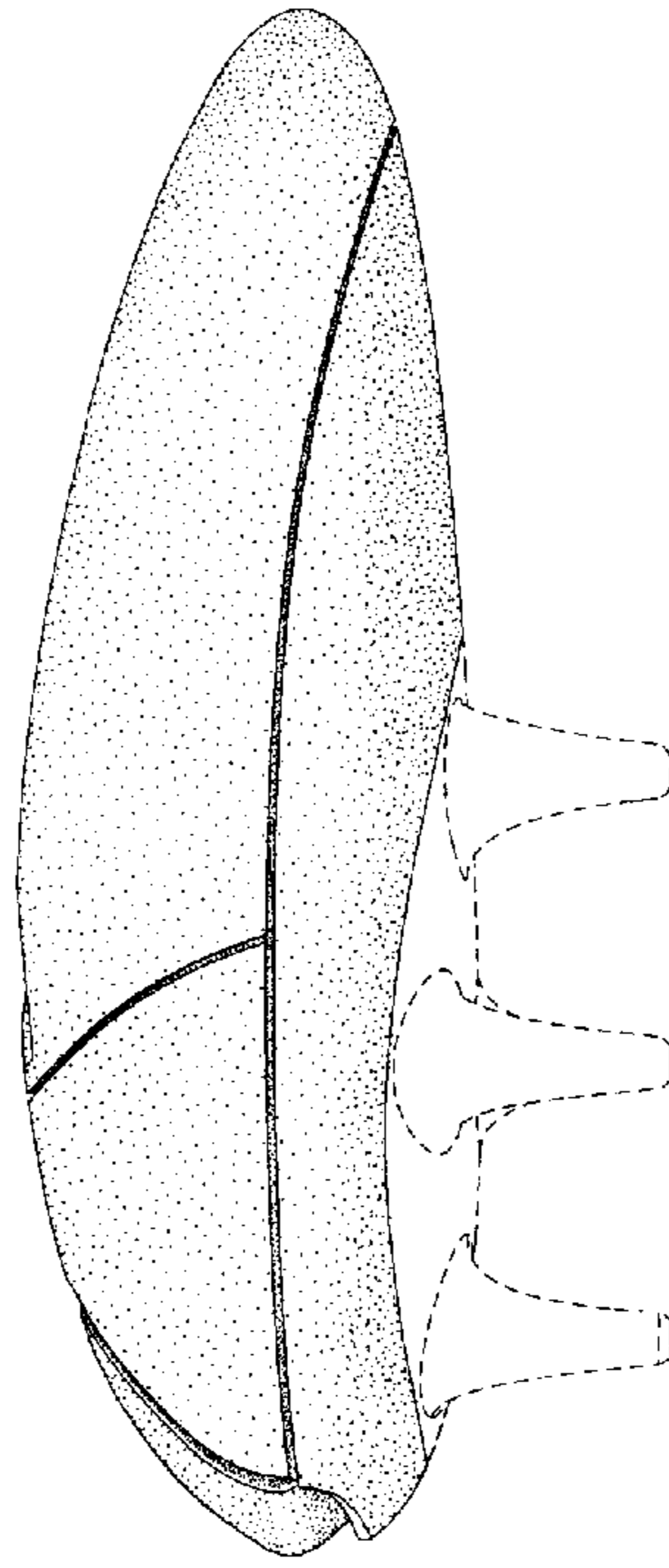

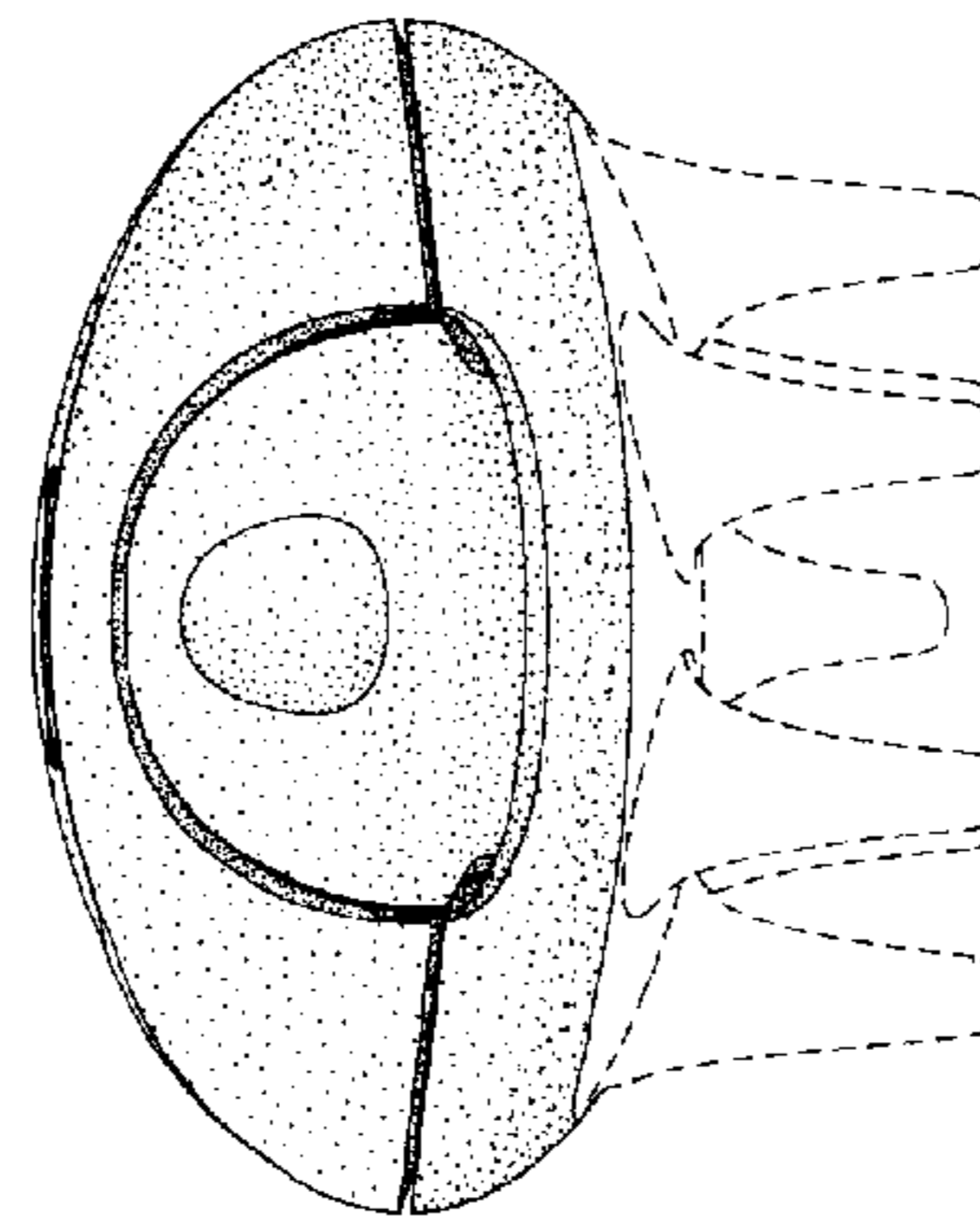
