DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair of the first embodiment construction embodying the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a front view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a right side view of FIG. 1, the left side being a mirror image of the right side;

FIG. 4 is a rear view of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 5 is a top view of FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a chair of the second embodiment construction embodying the present invention;

FIG. 7 is a front view of FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a right side view of FIG. 6, the left side being a mirror image of the right side;

FIG. 9 is a rear view of FIG. 6; and

FIG. 10 is a top view of FIG. 16.

FIG. 11 is a perspective view of a chair of the third embodiment construction embodying the present invention;

FIG. 12 is a front view of FIG. 11;

FIG. 13 is a right side view of FIG. 11, the left side being a mirror image of the right side;

FIG. 14 is a rear view of FIG. 11; and

FIG. 15 is a top view of FIG. 11.

FIG. 16 is a perspective view of a chair of the fourth embodiment construction embodying the present invention;

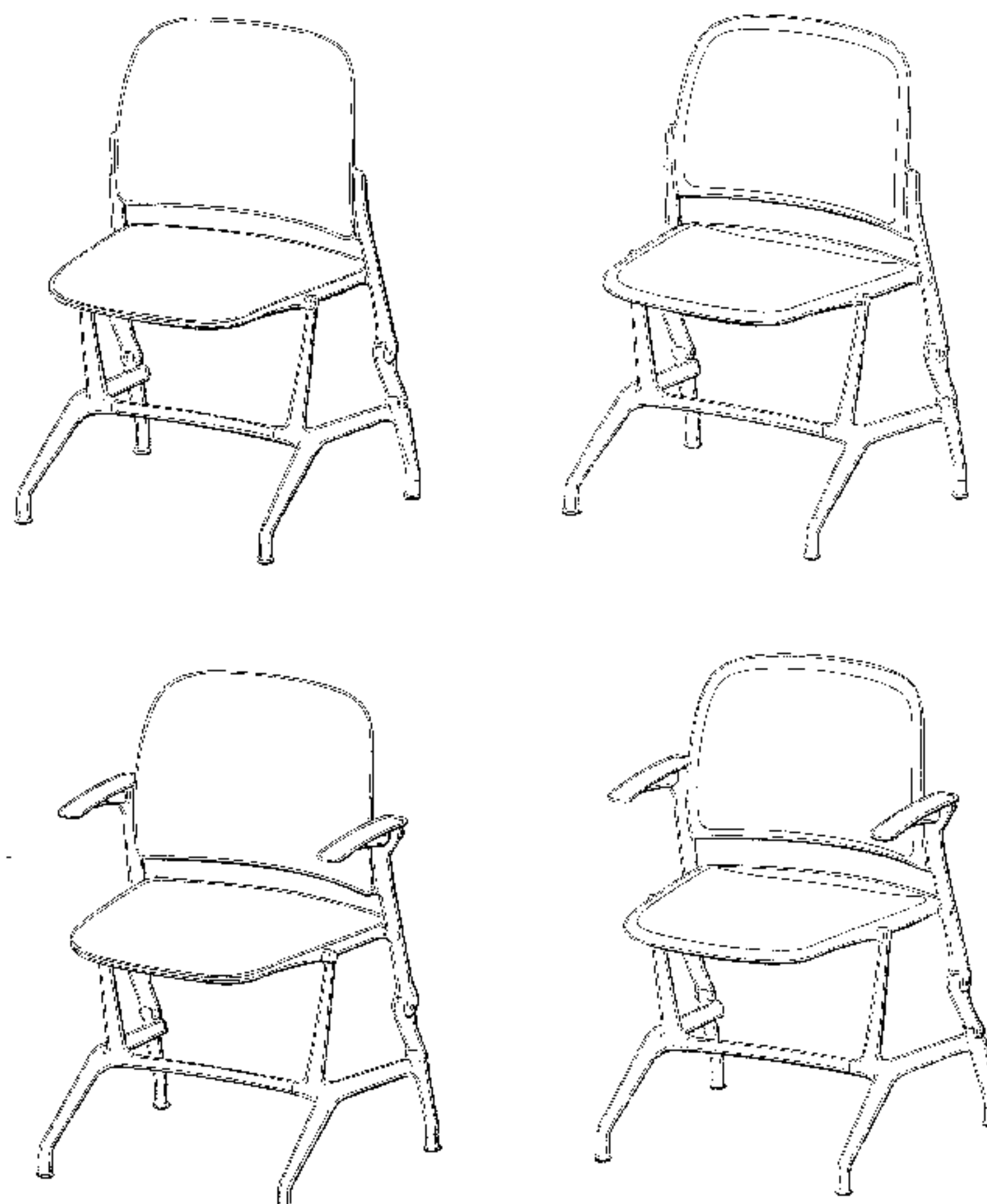
FIG. 17 is a front view of FIG. 16;

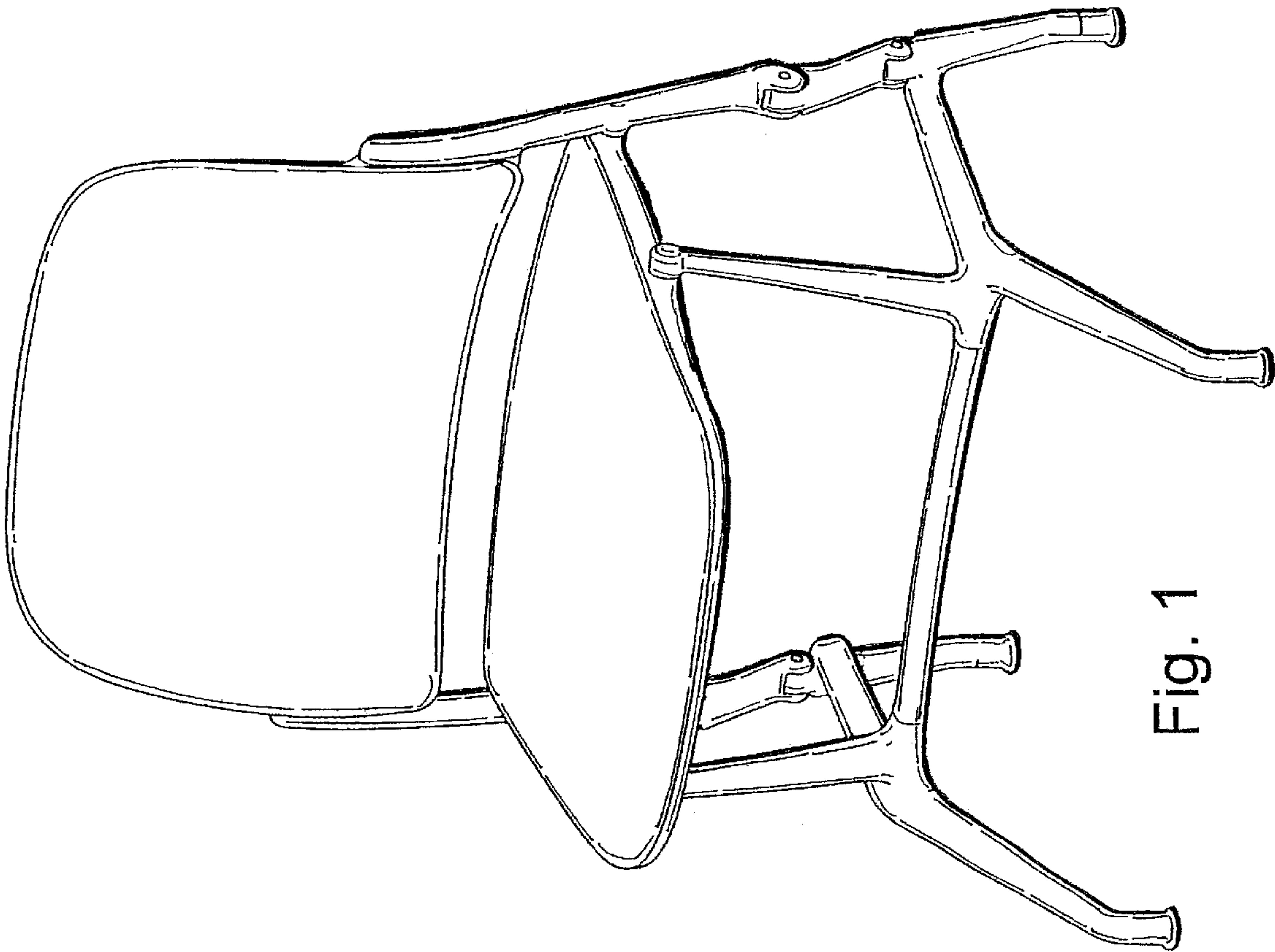

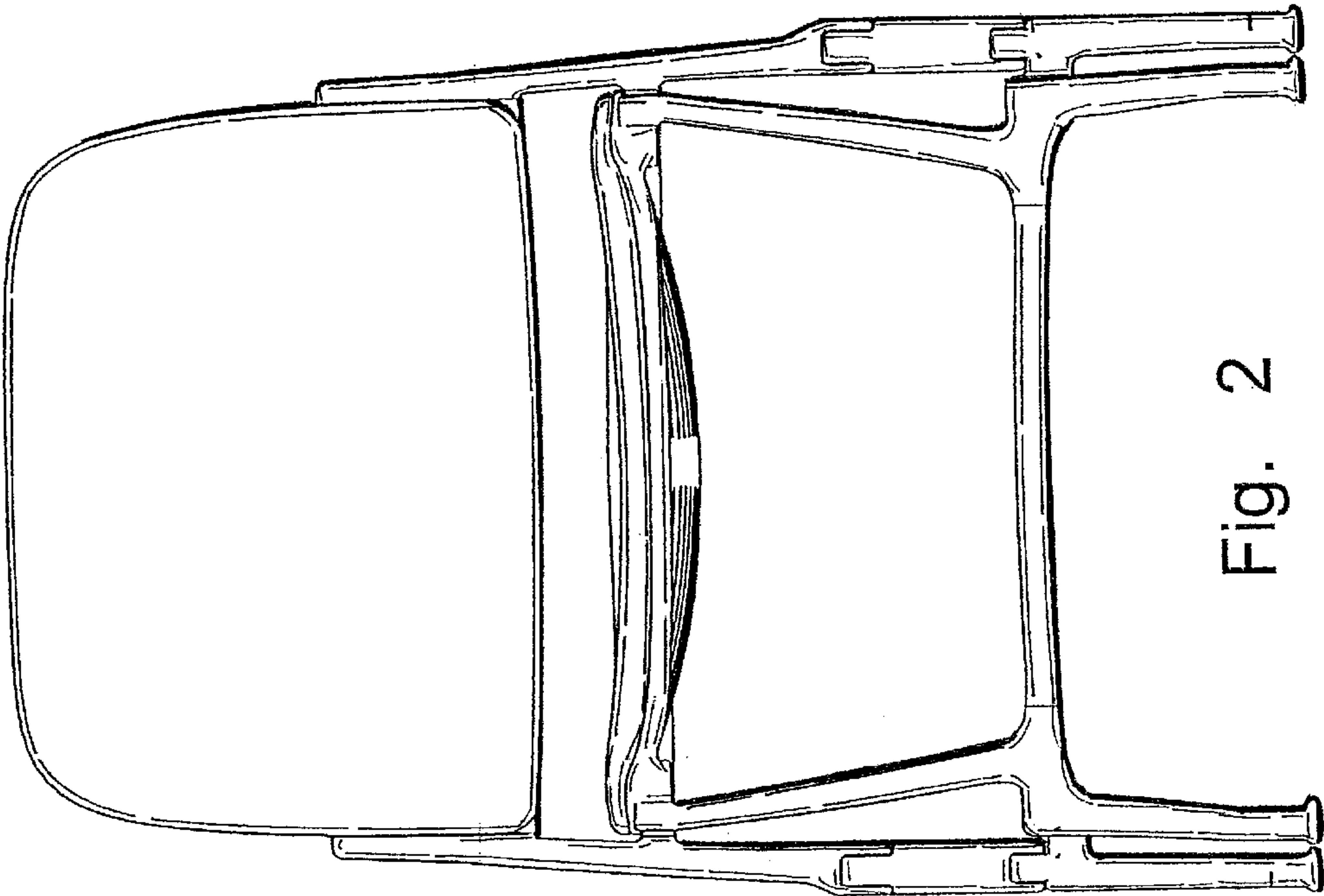

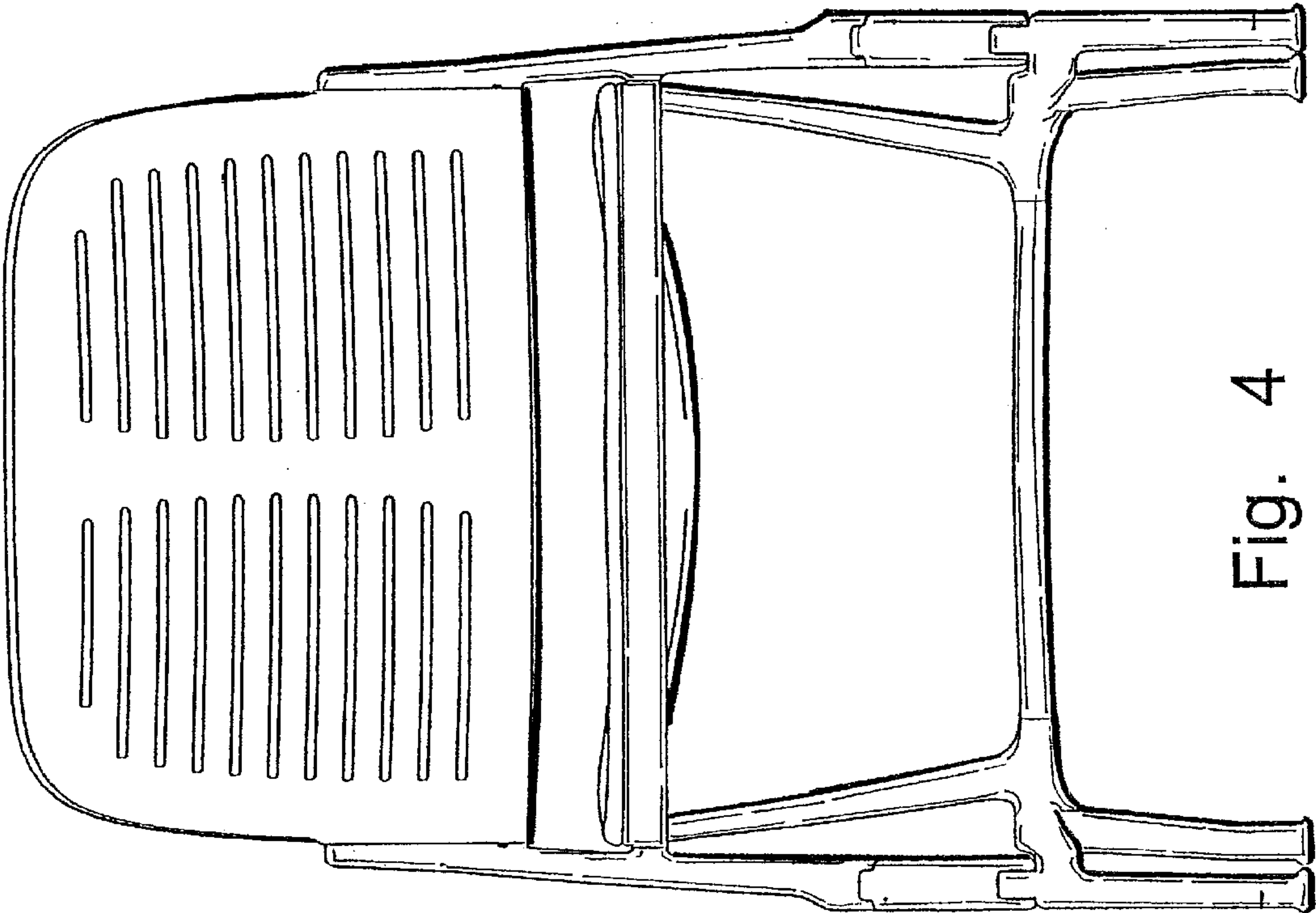

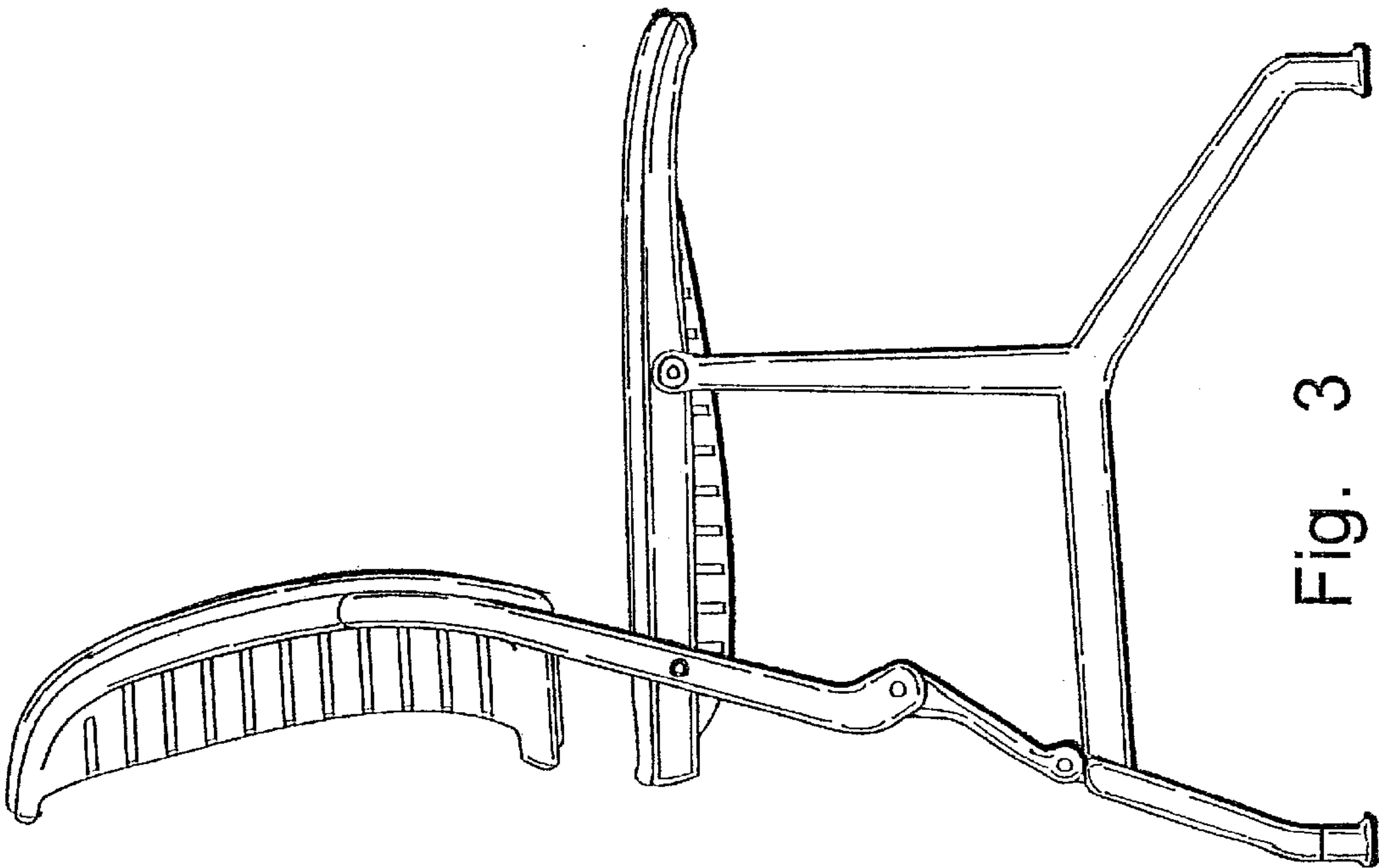

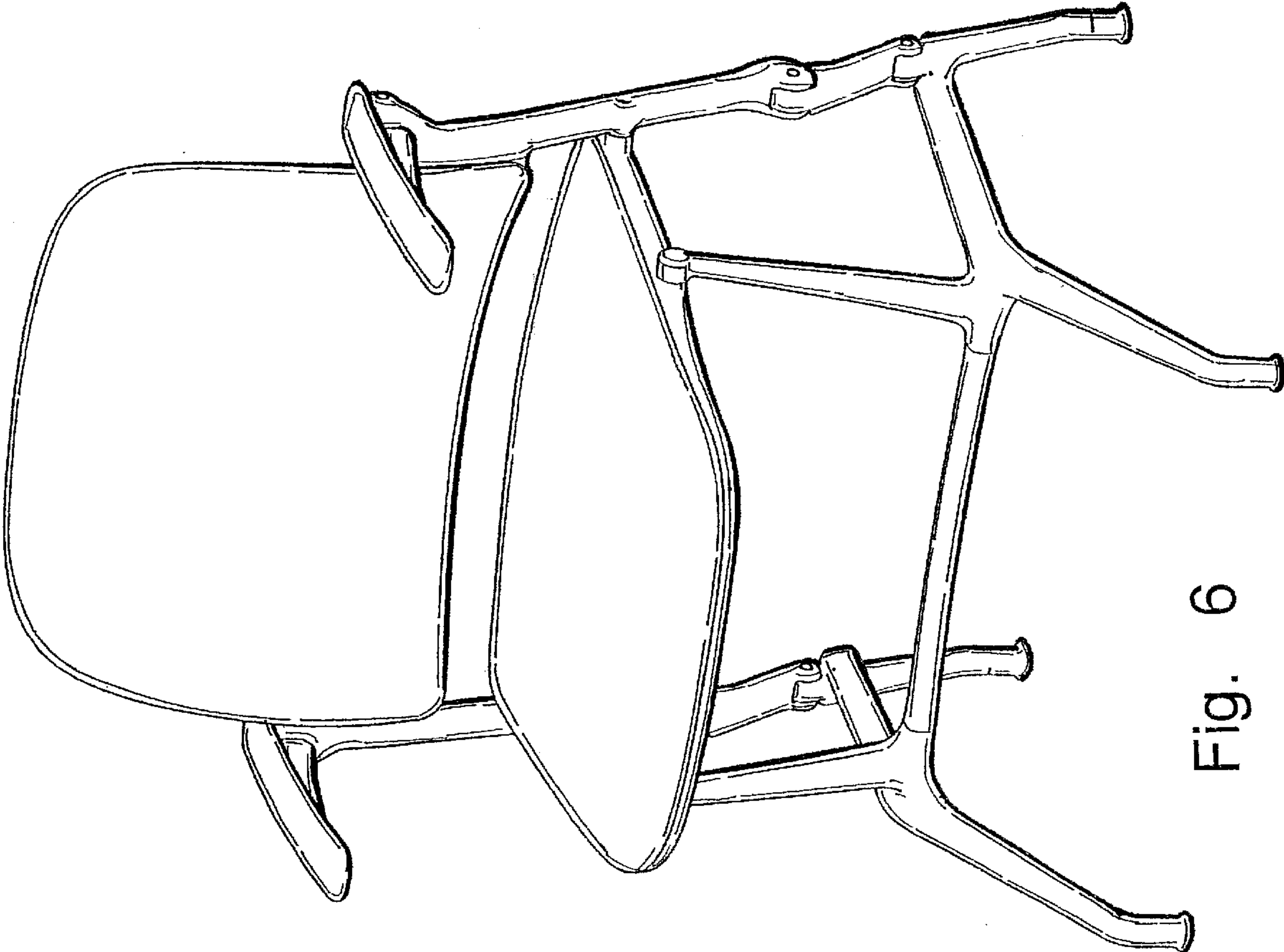

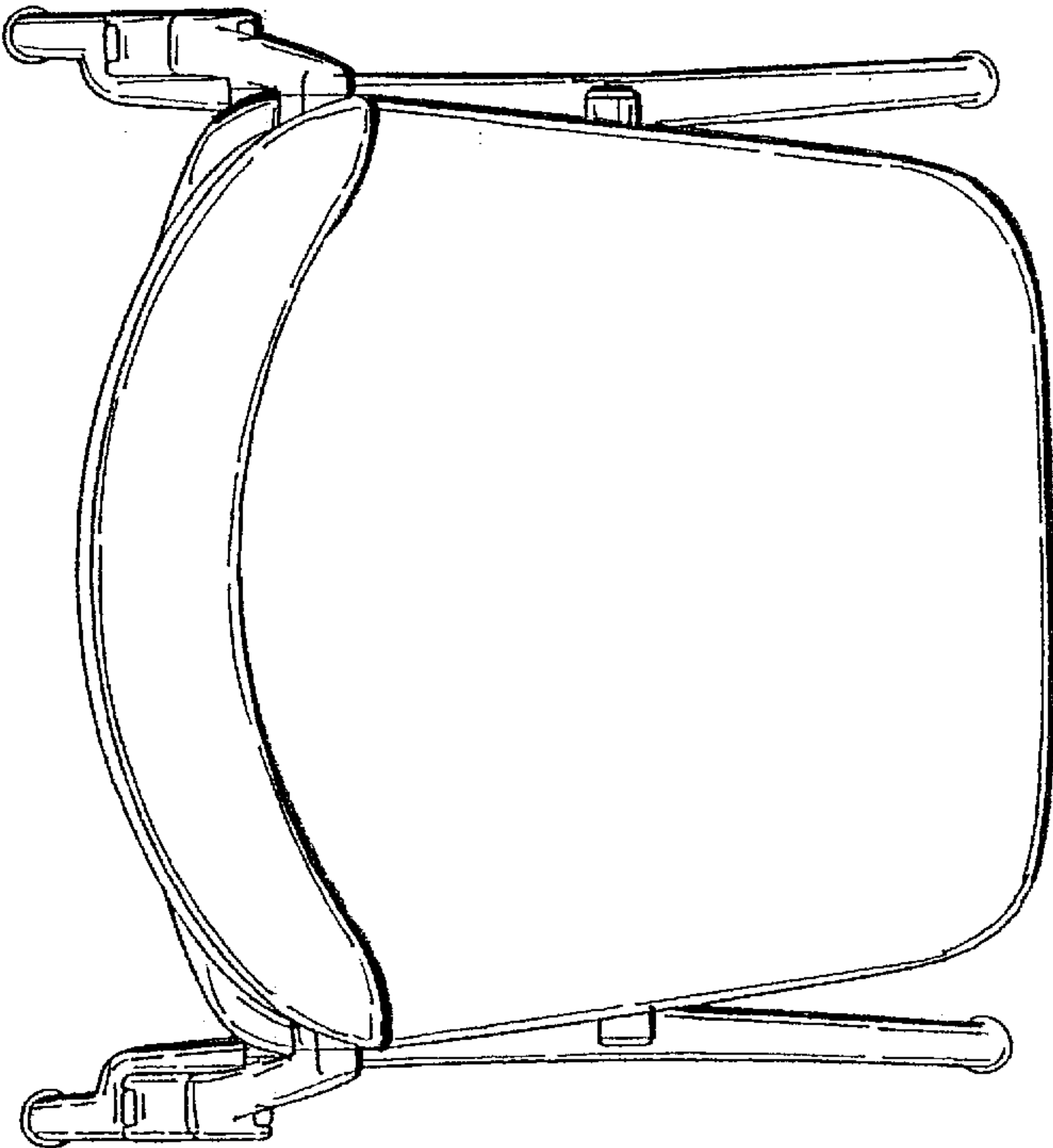

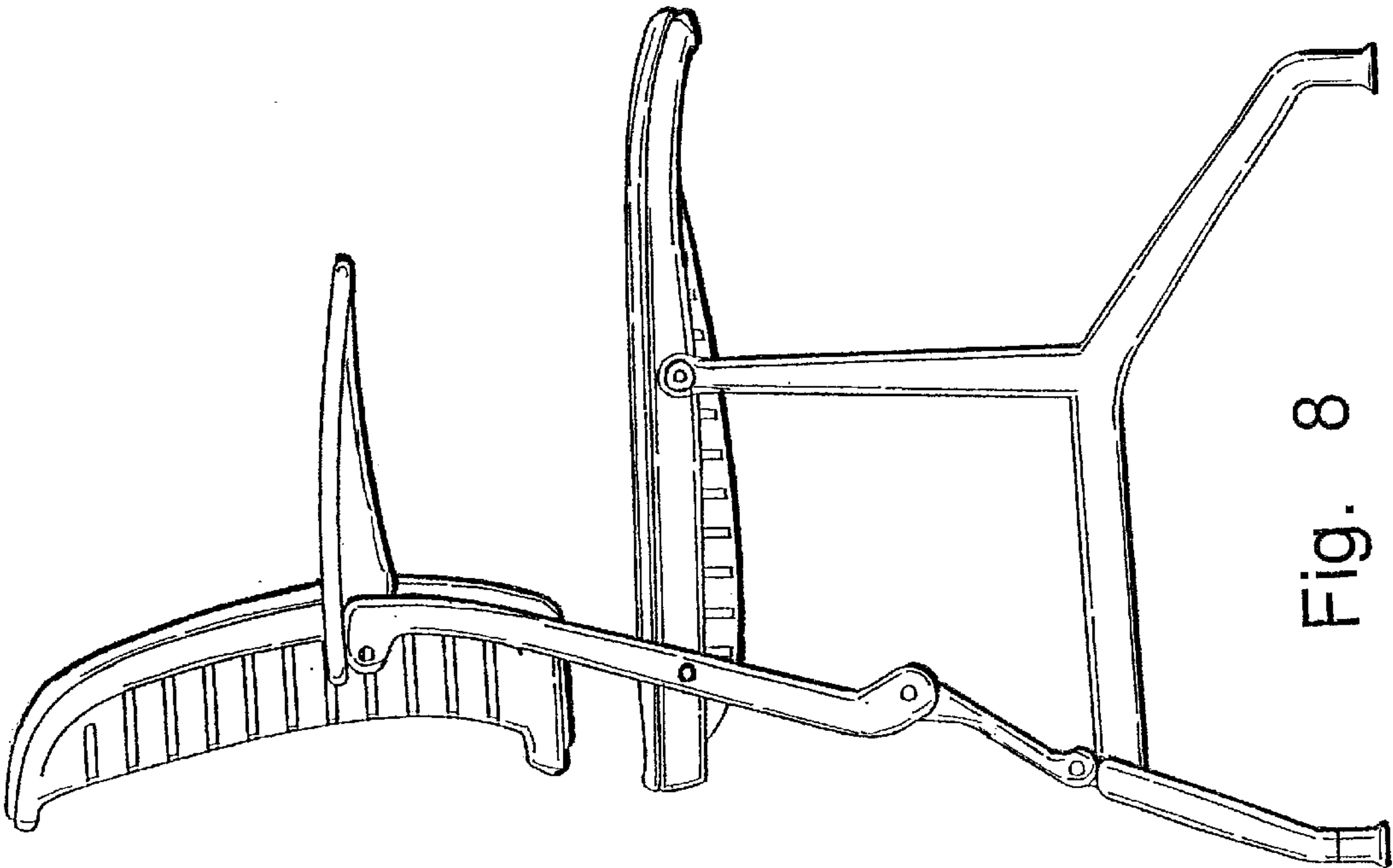

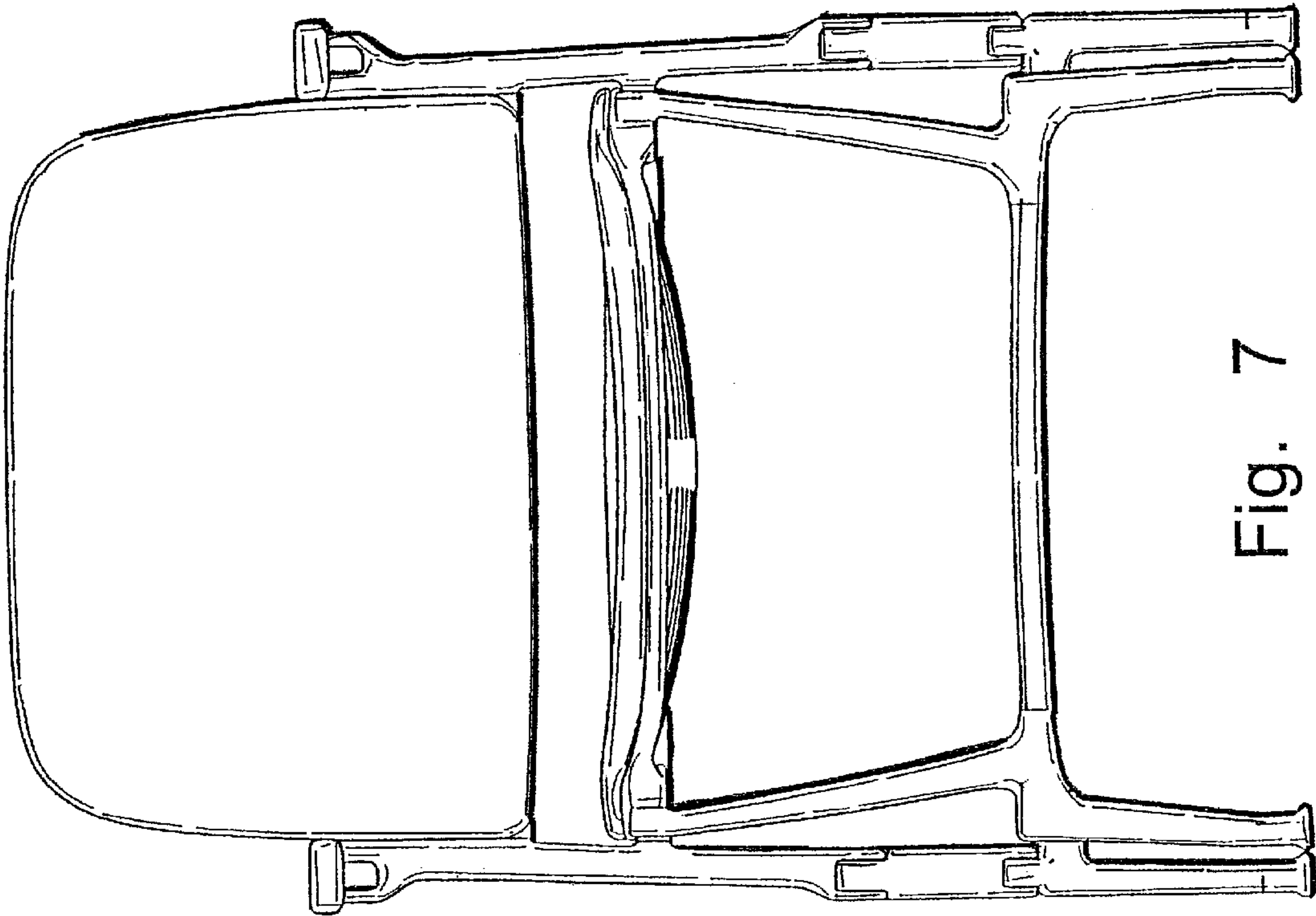

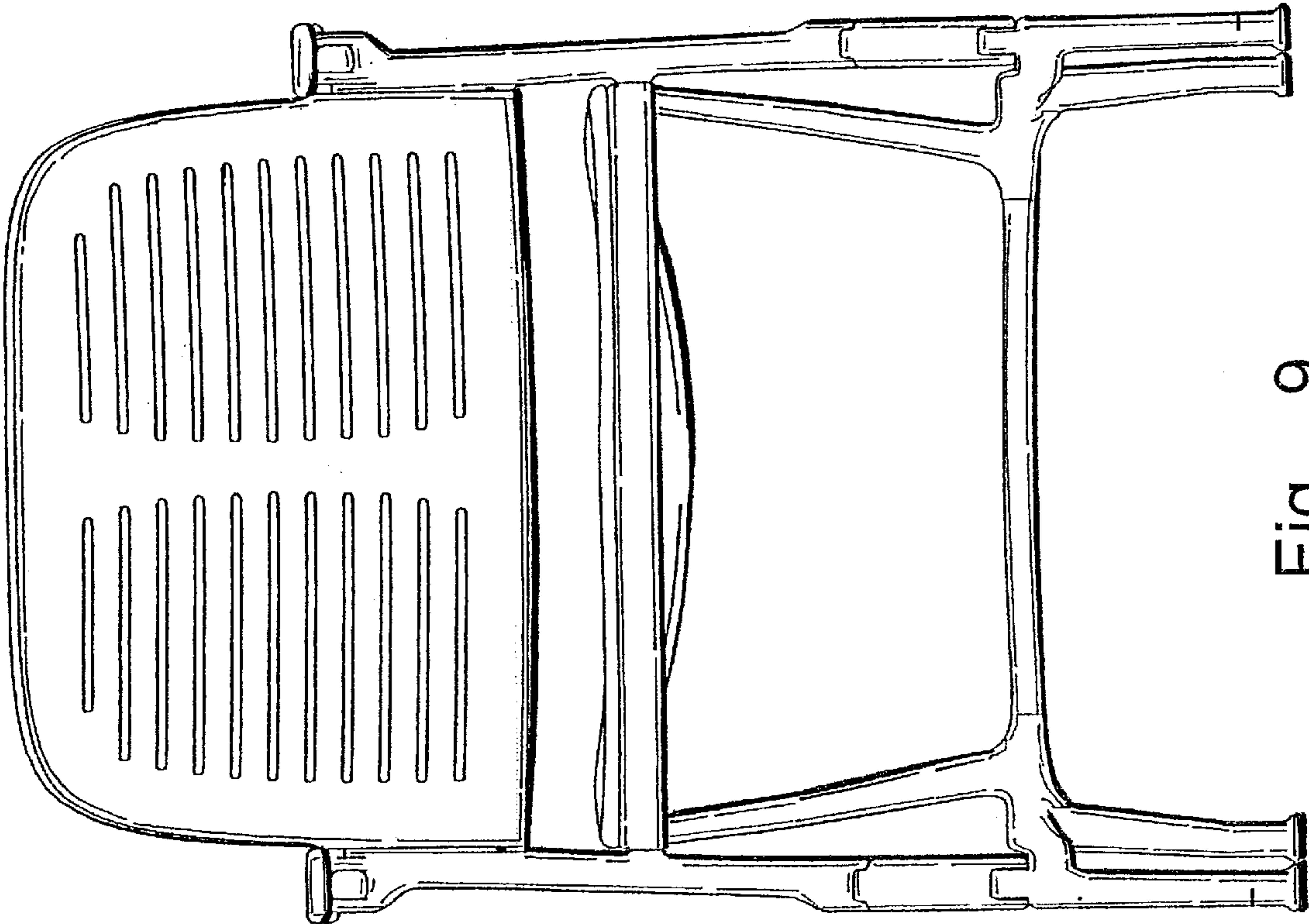

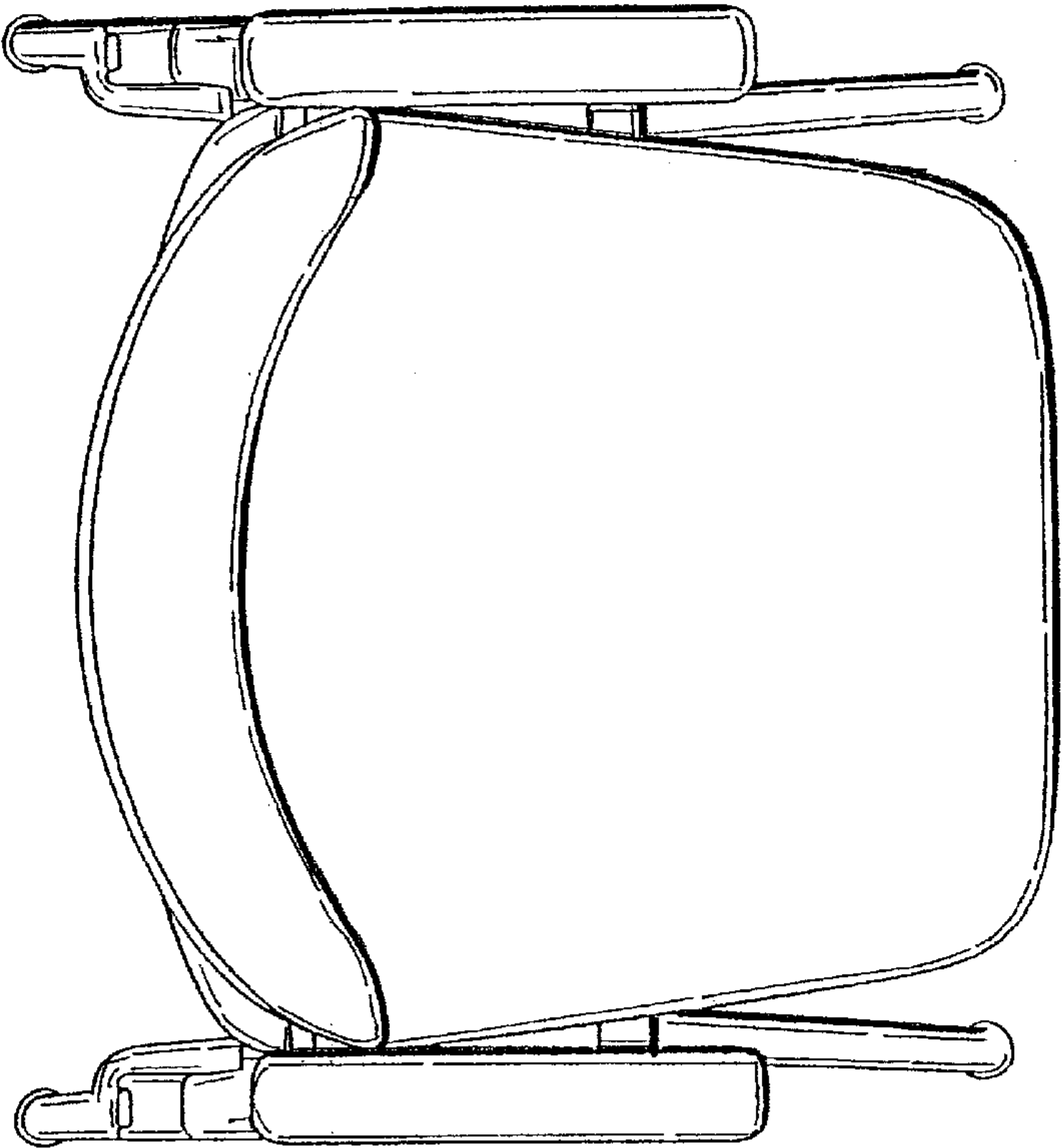

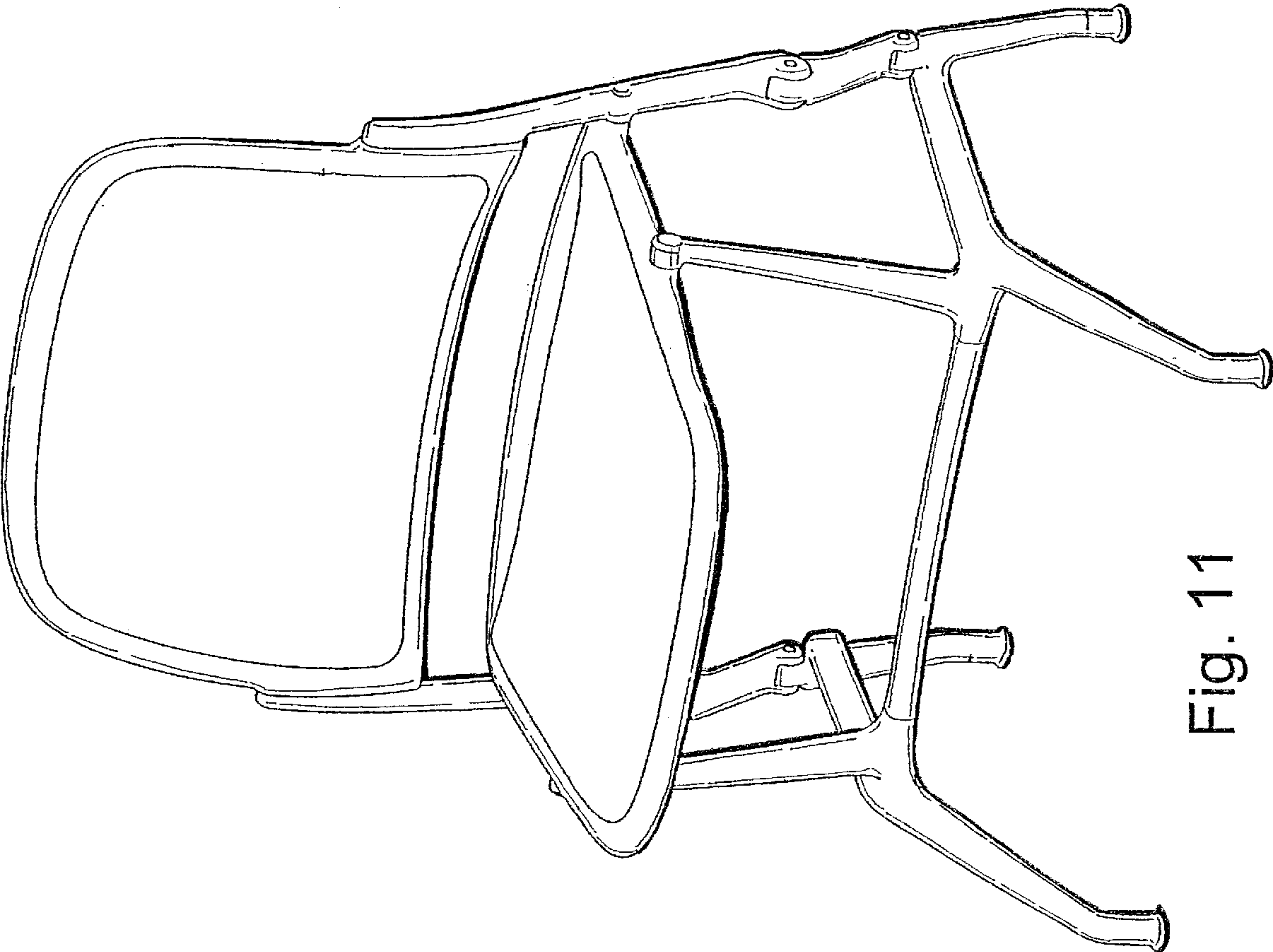

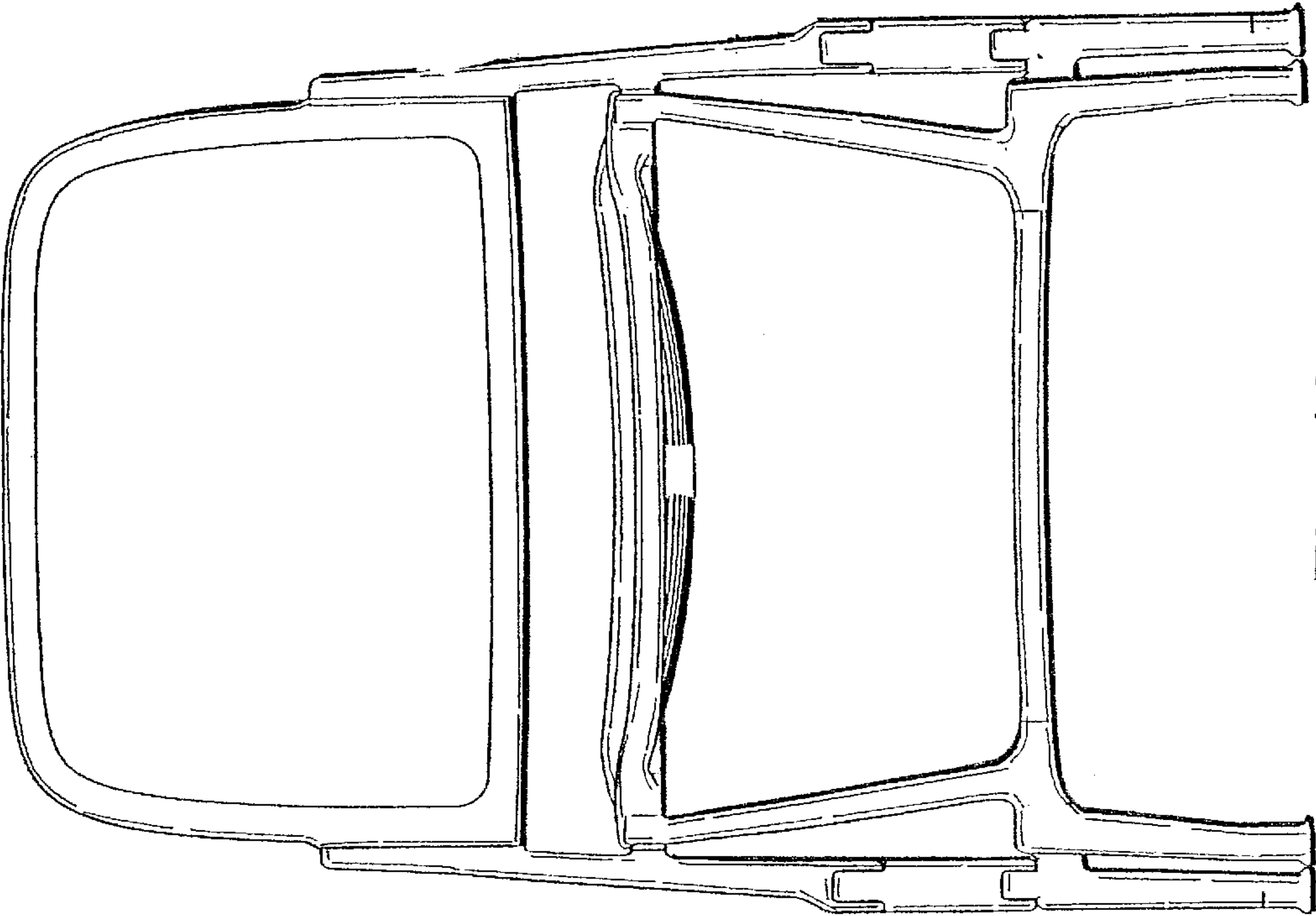

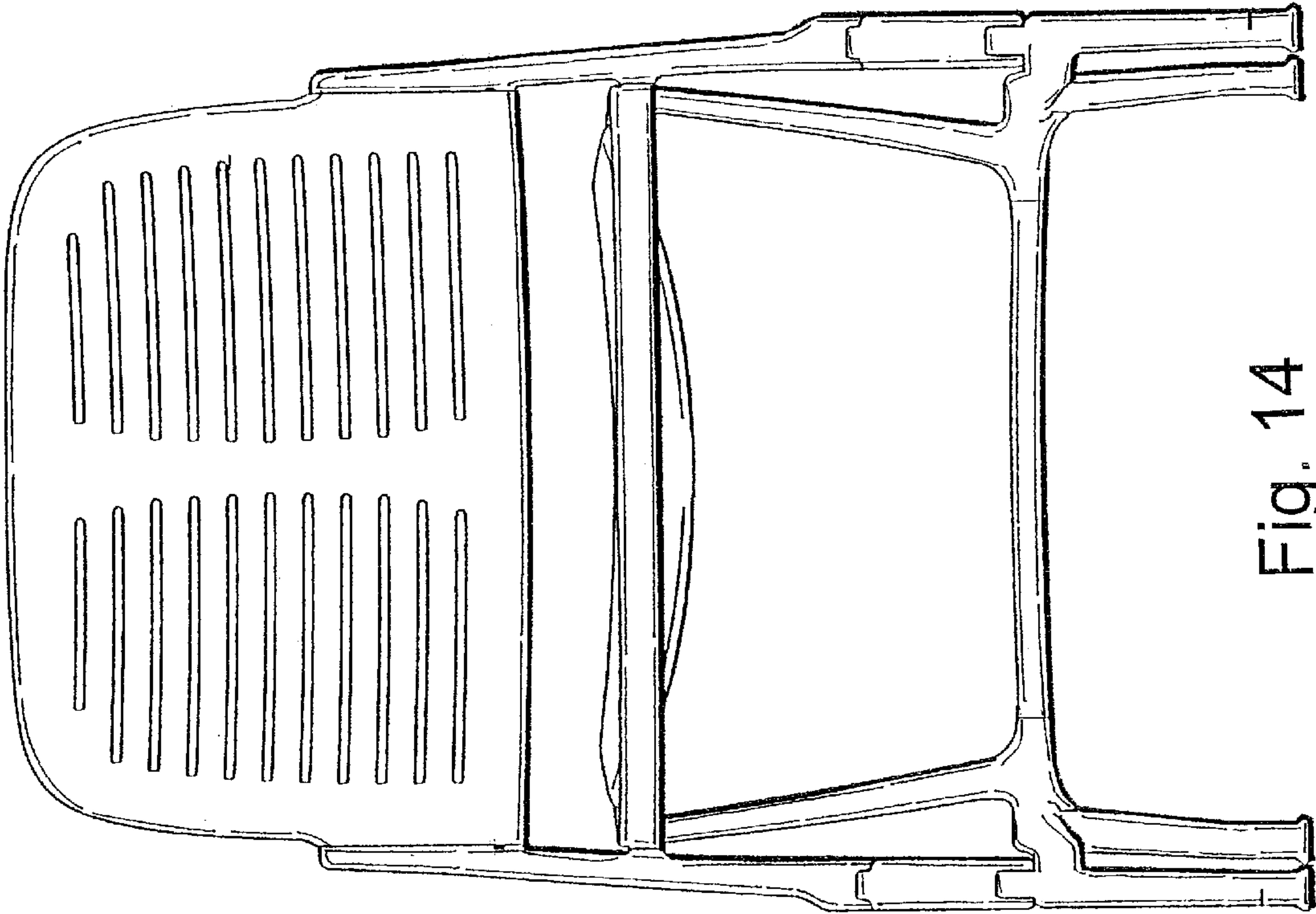

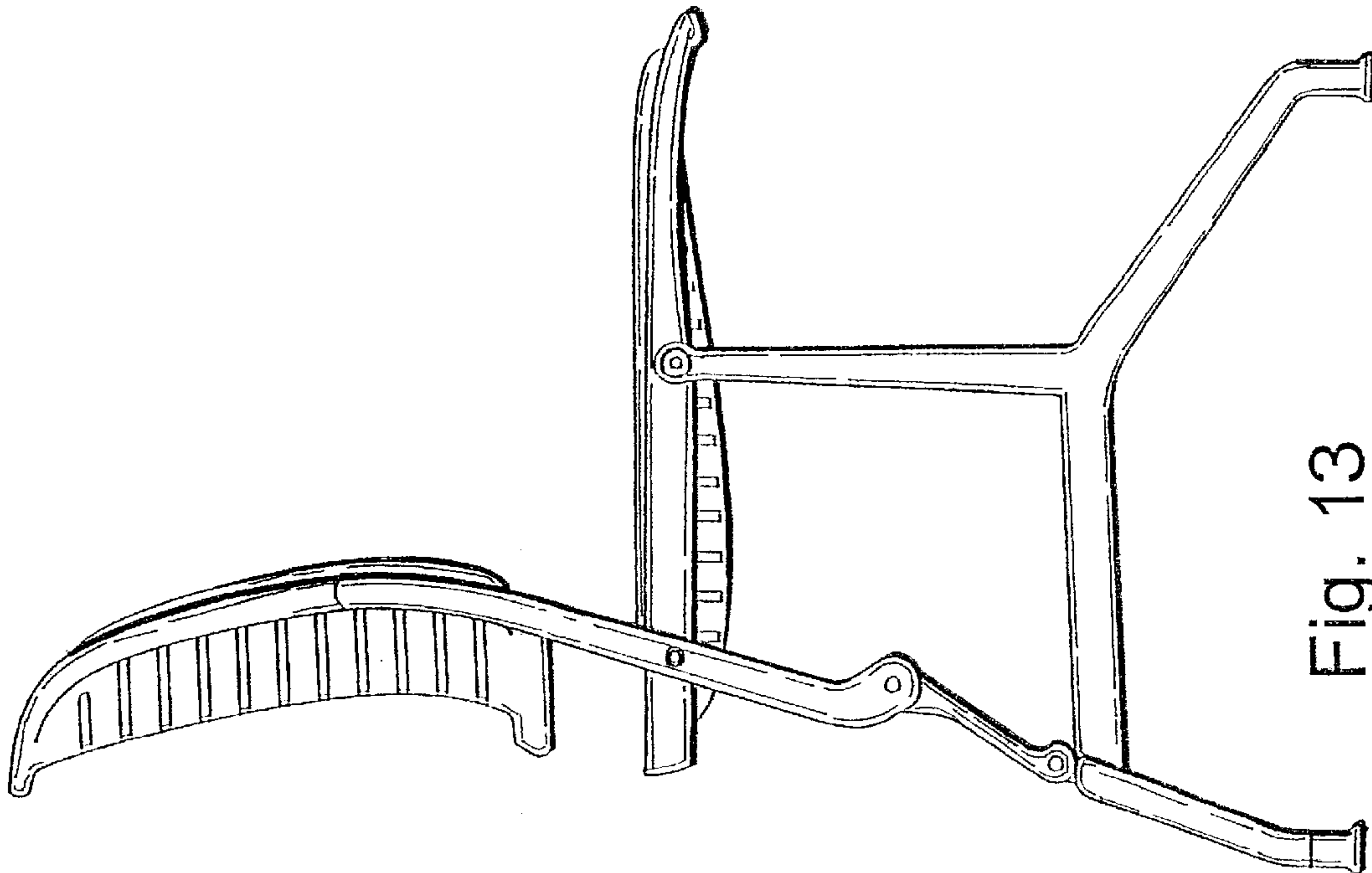

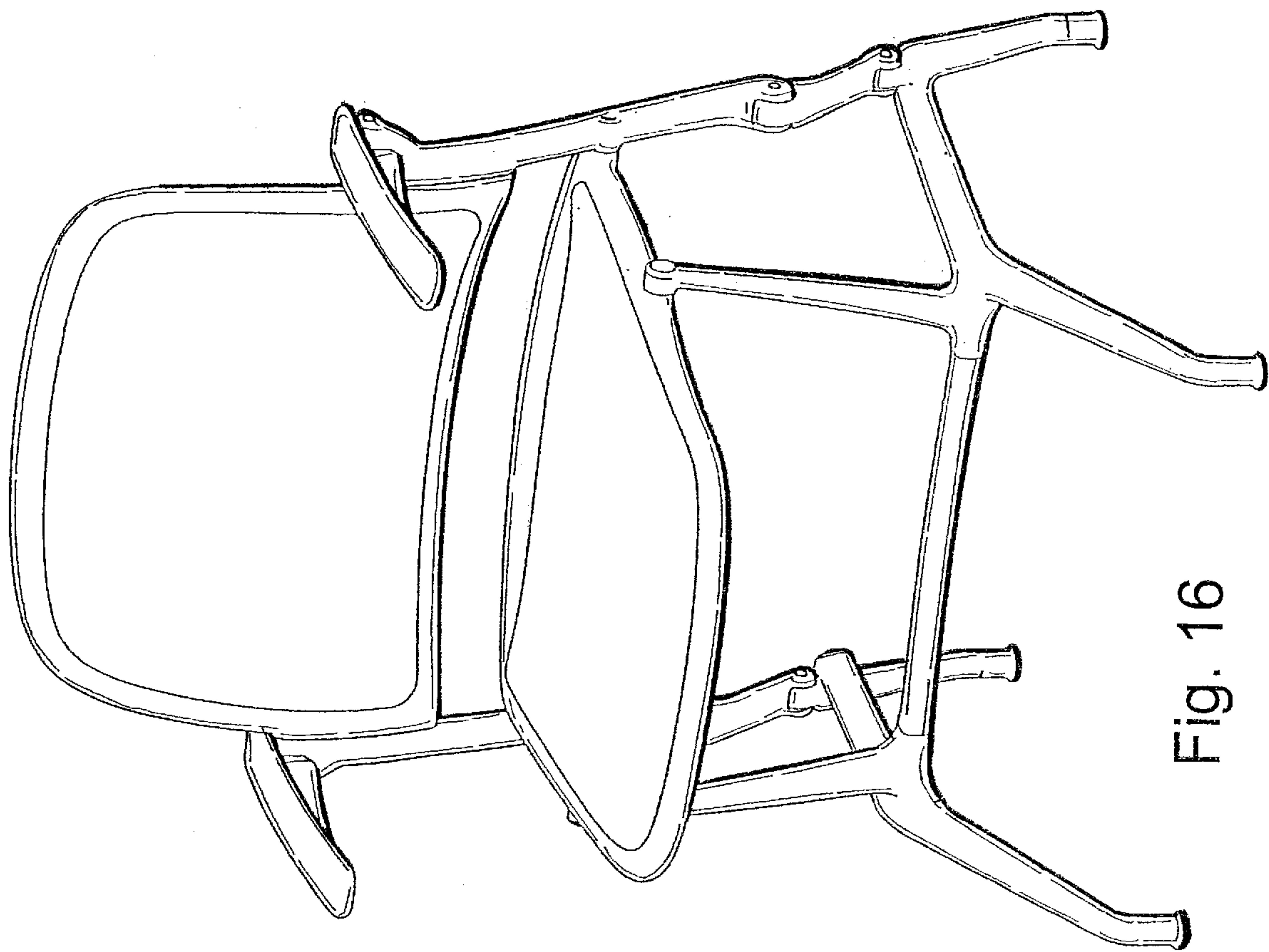

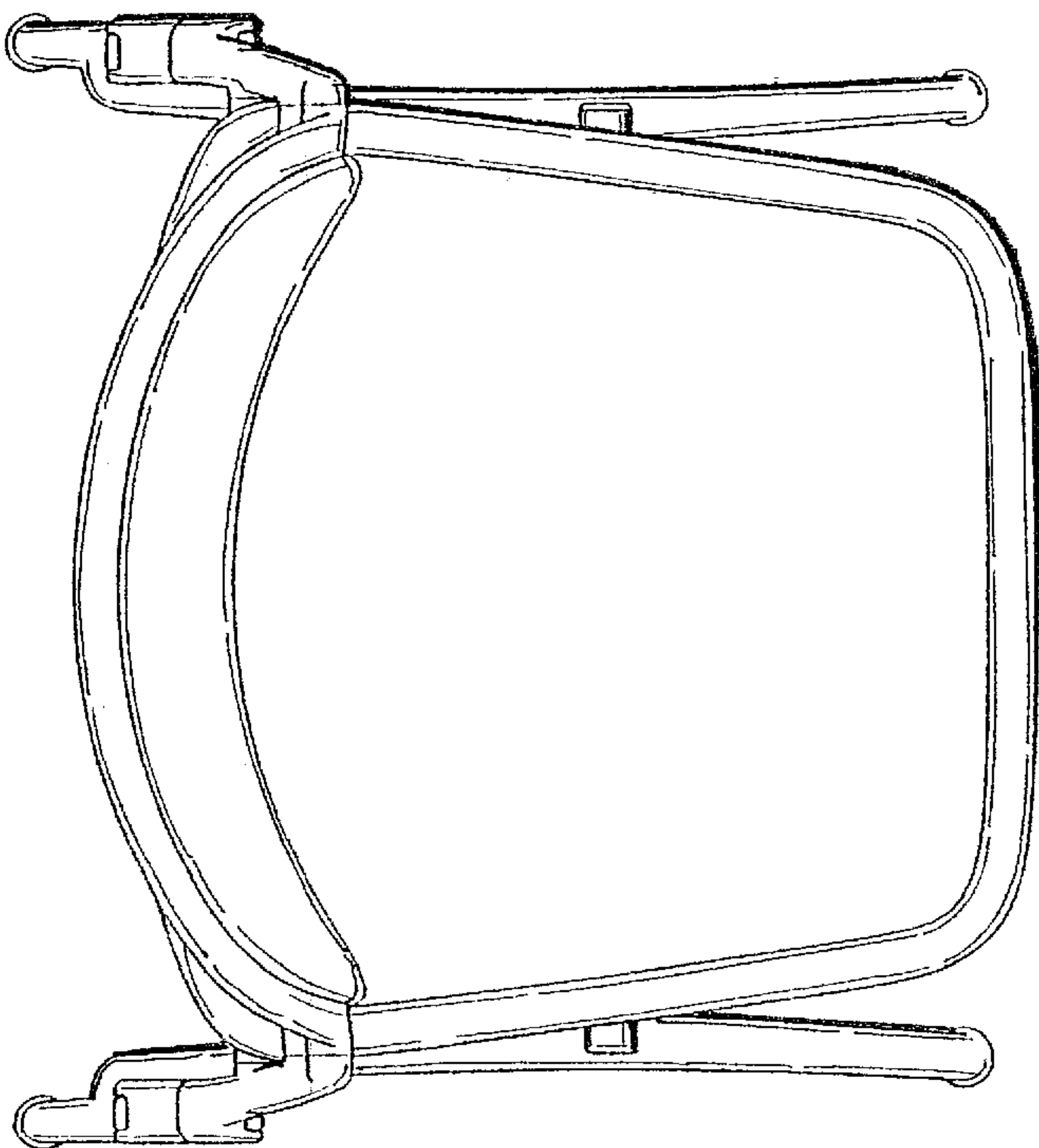

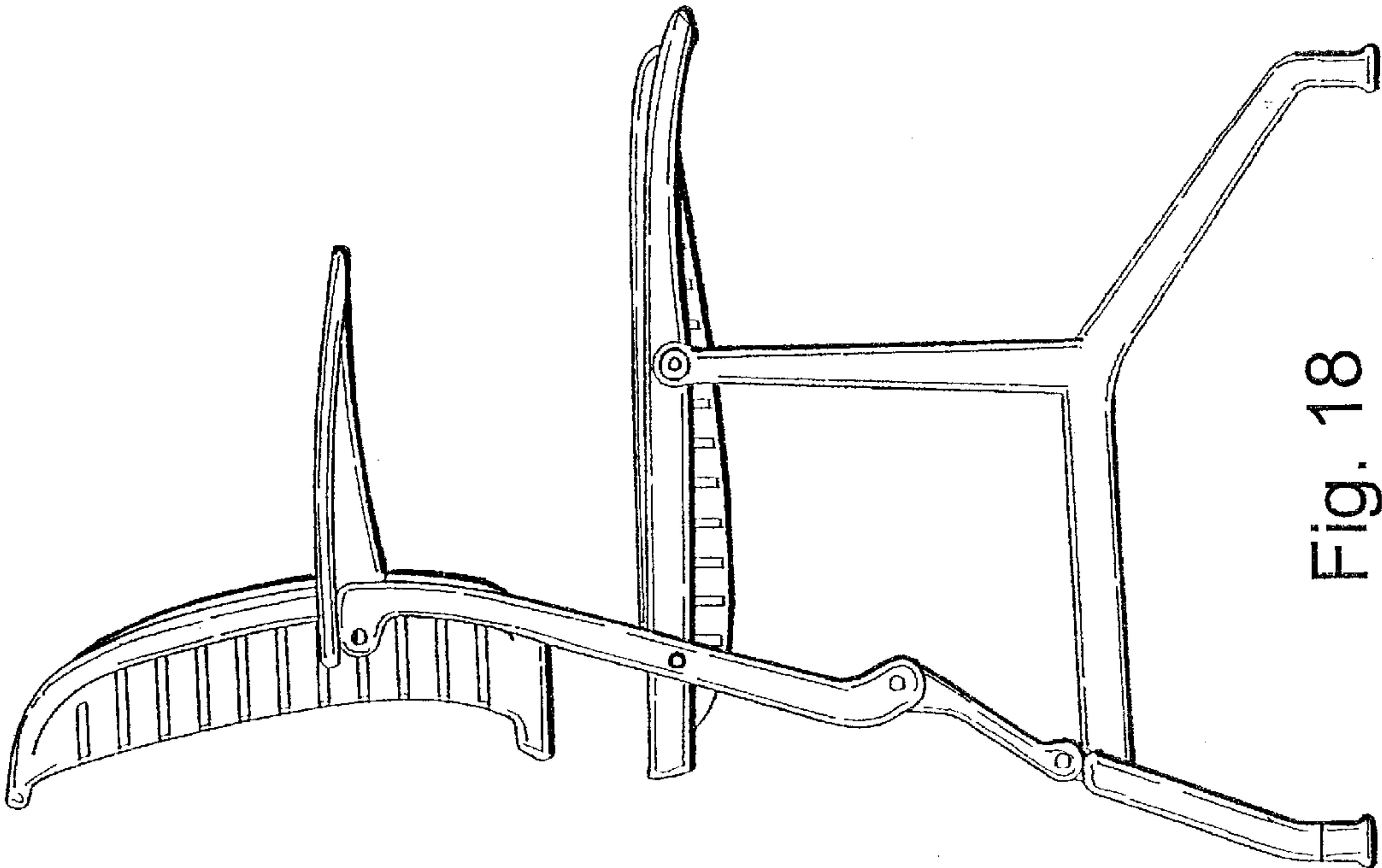

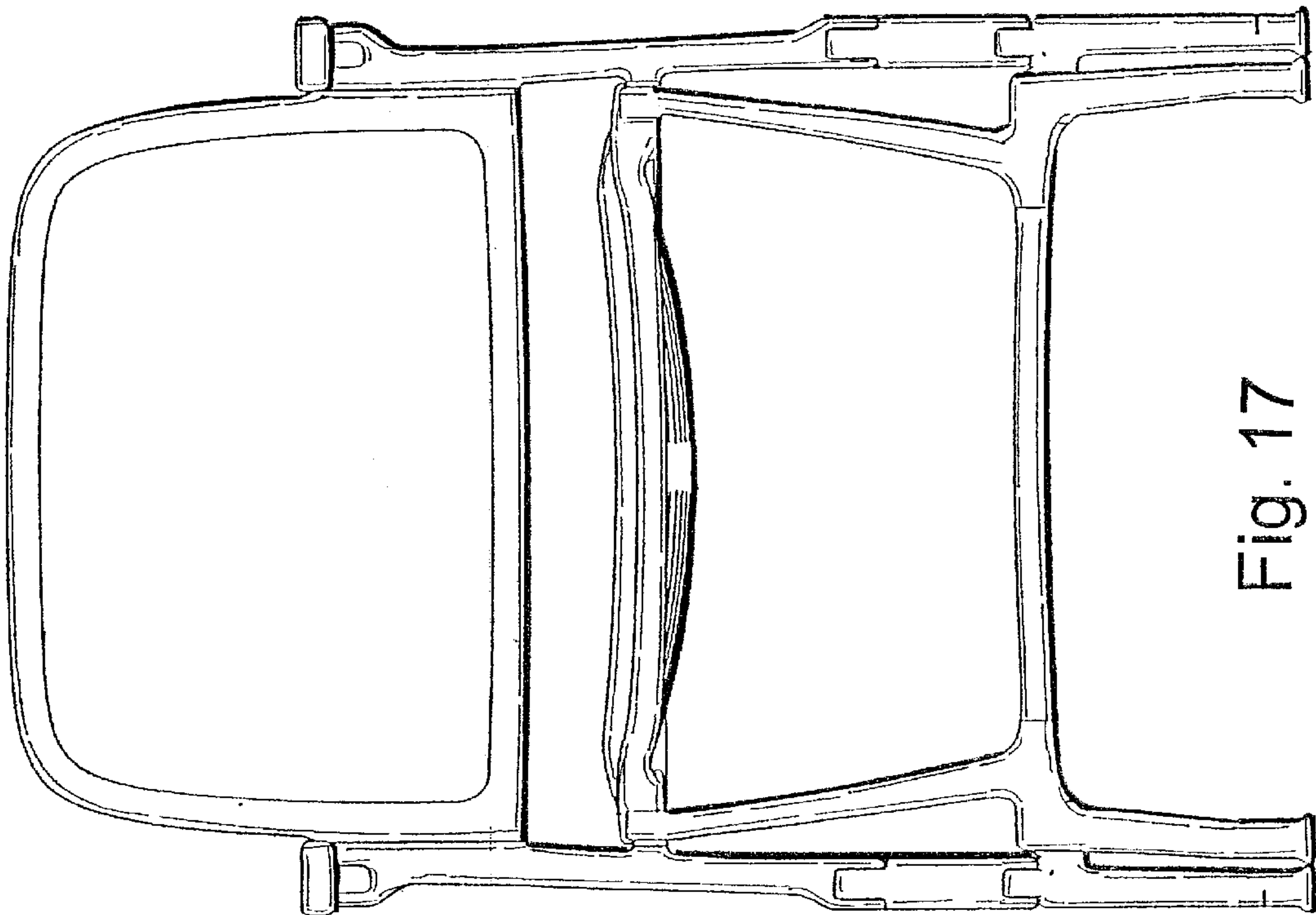

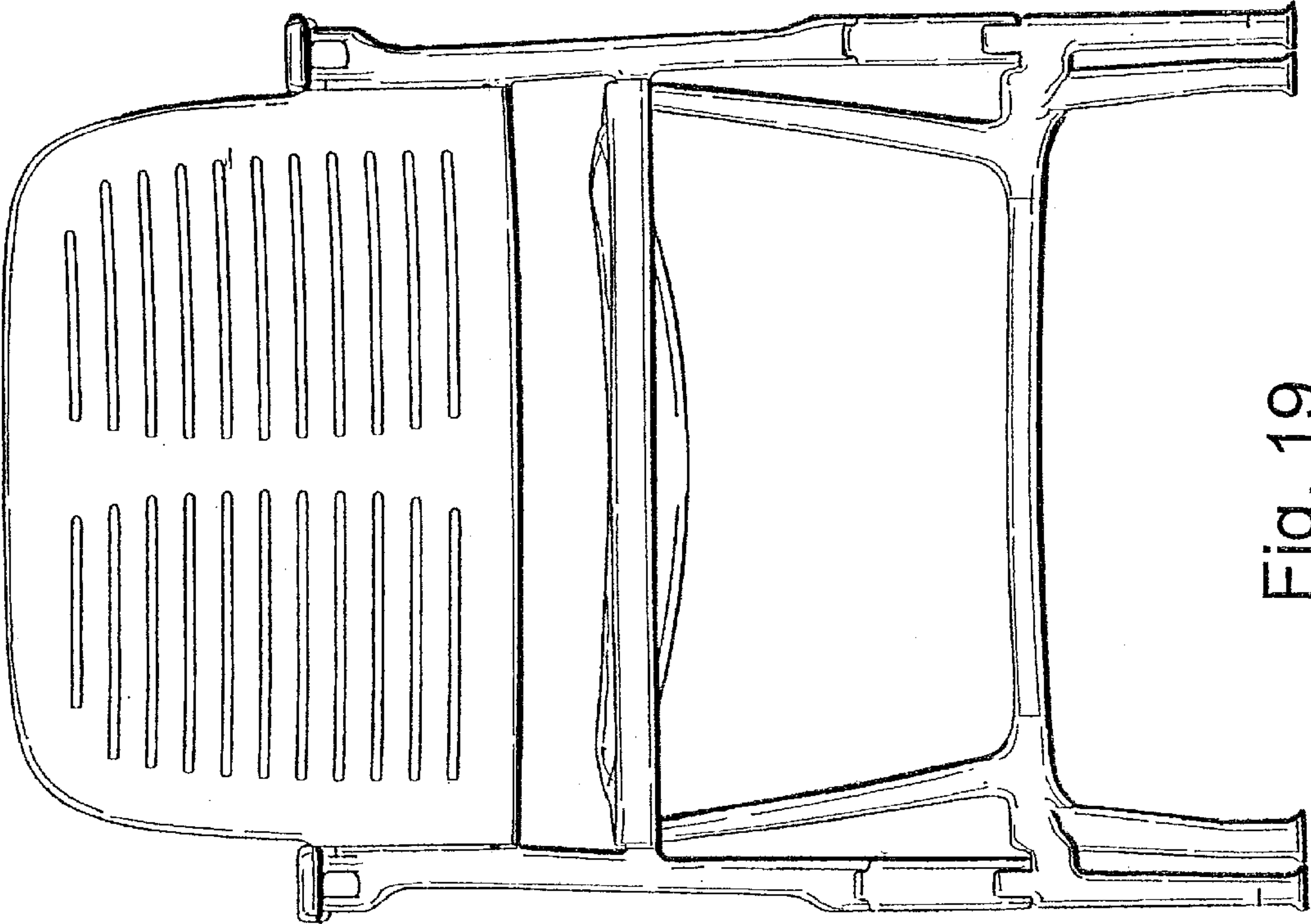

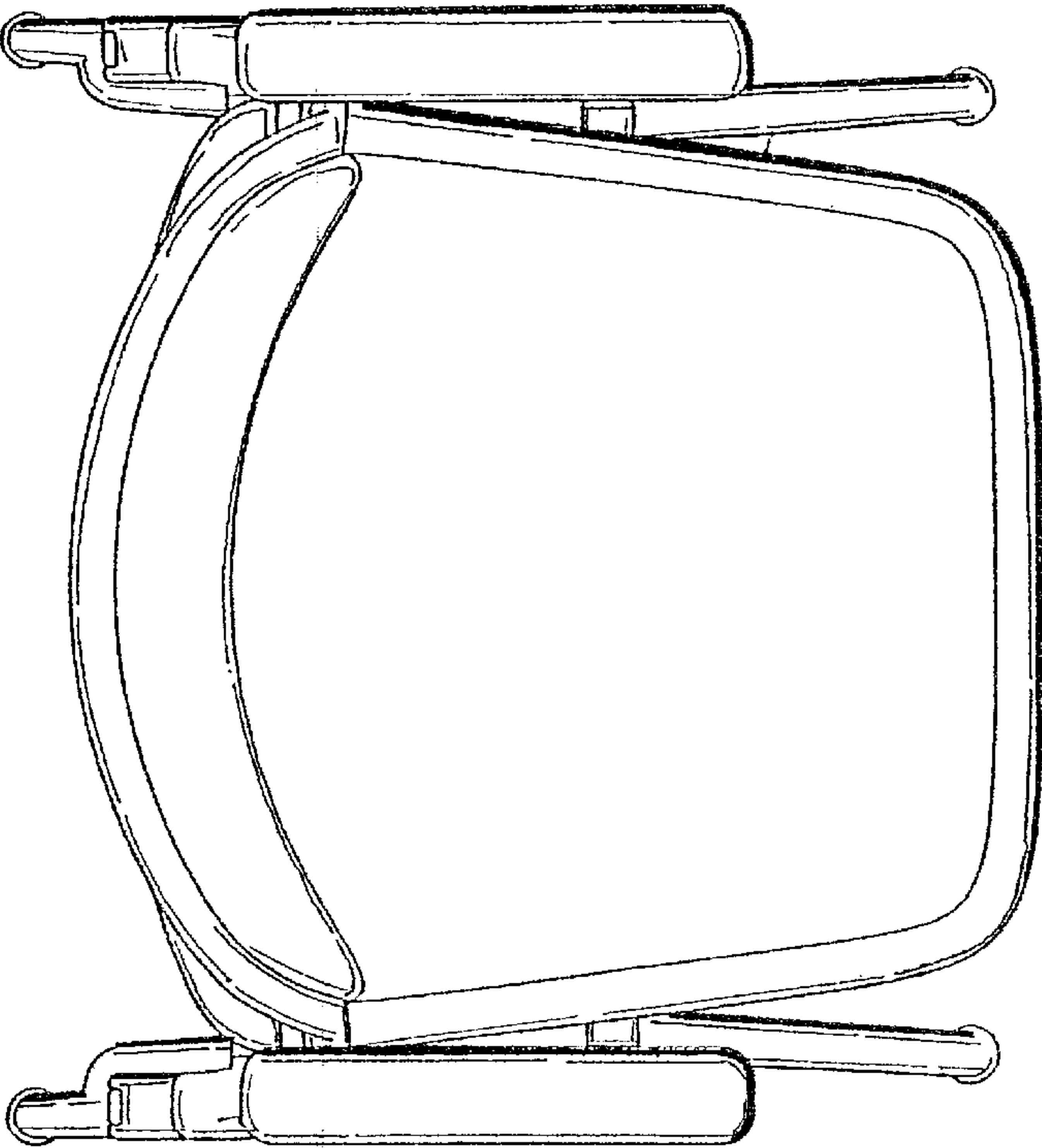
