The ornamental design for an explorer tumbler, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of an explorer tumbler showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the design.

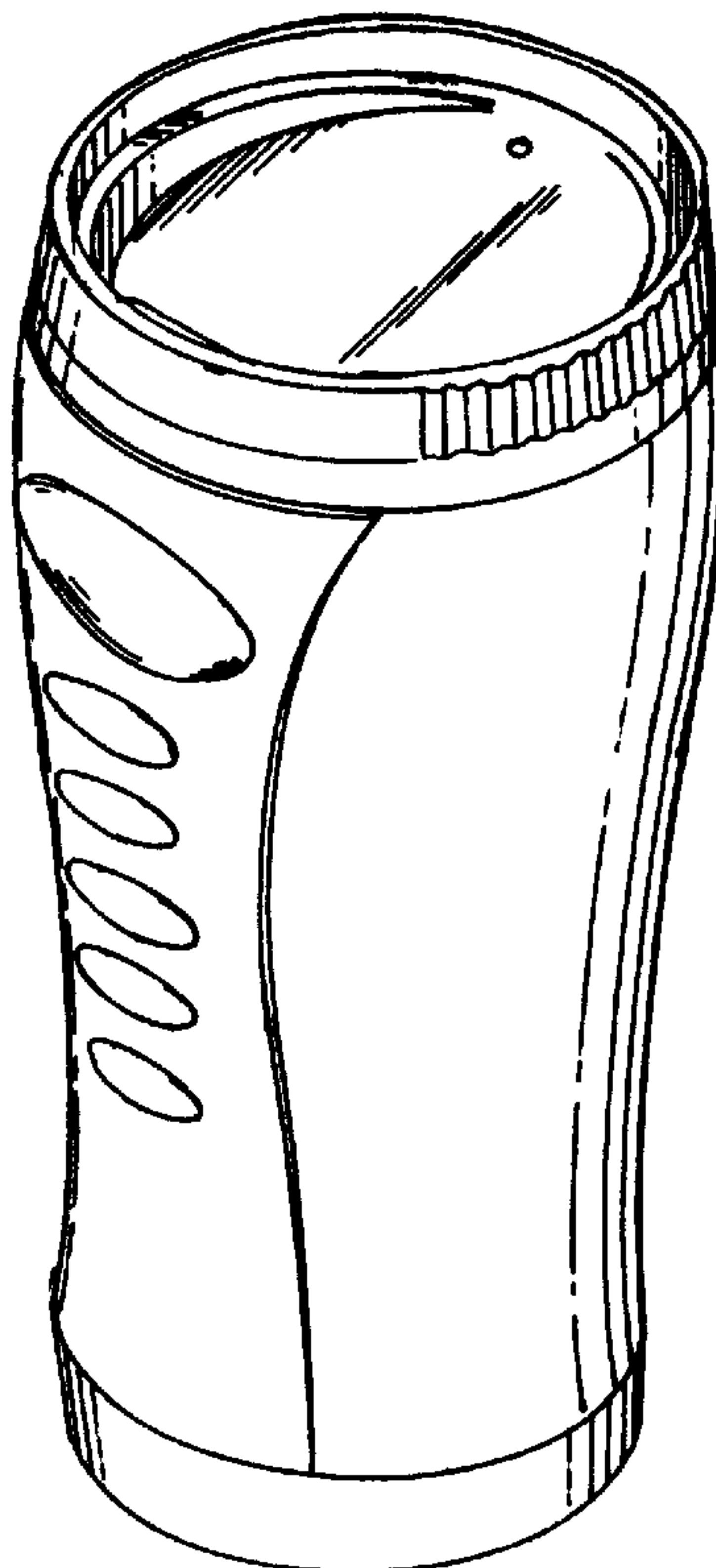
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the design, the left side being a mirror image thereof.

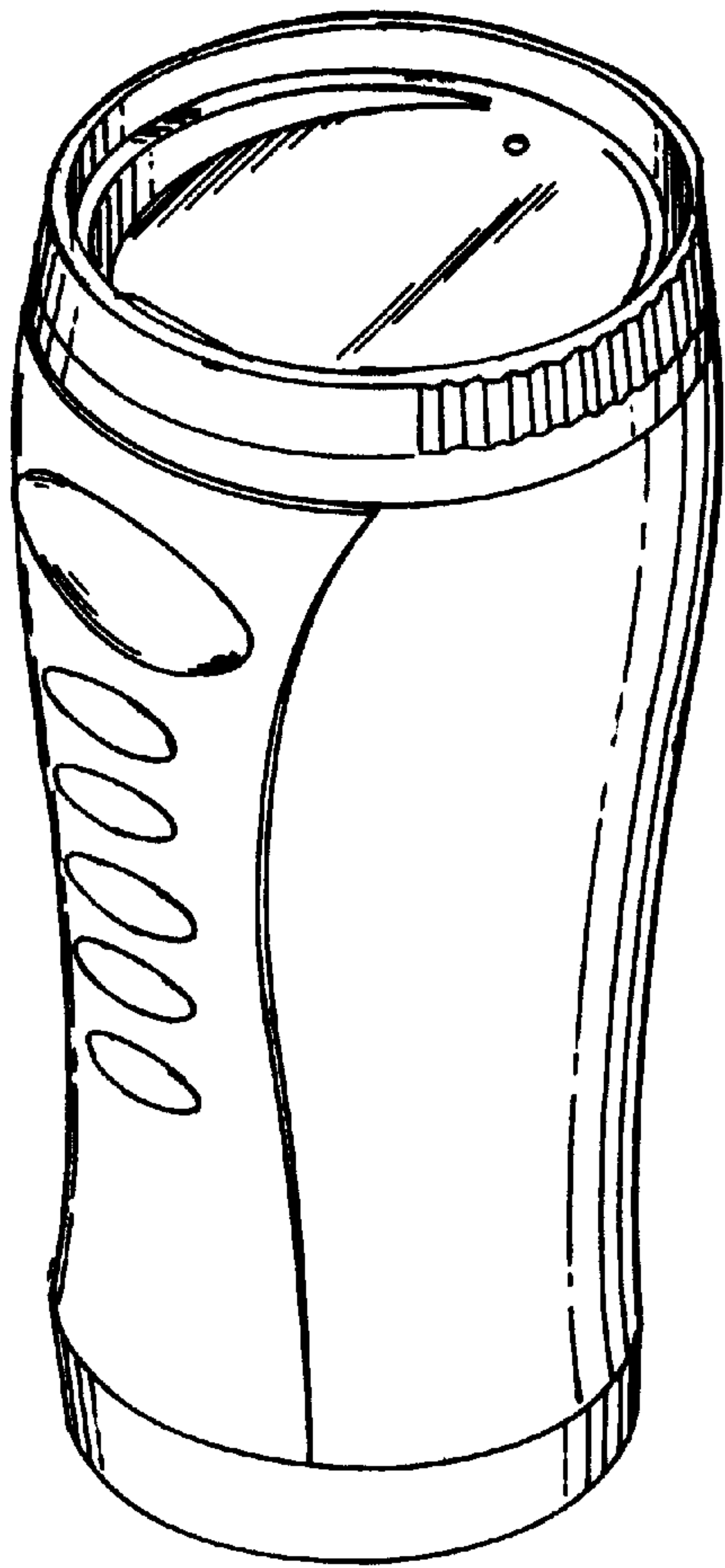

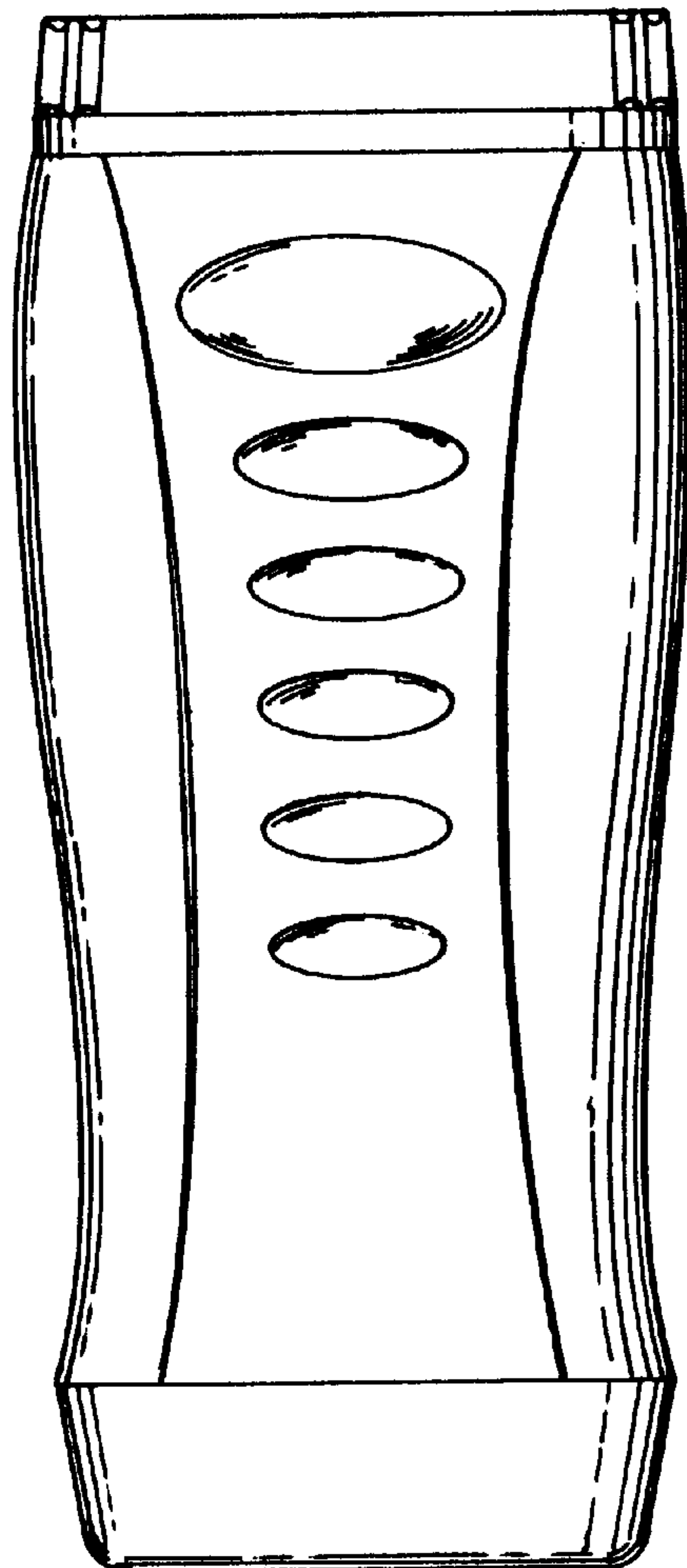

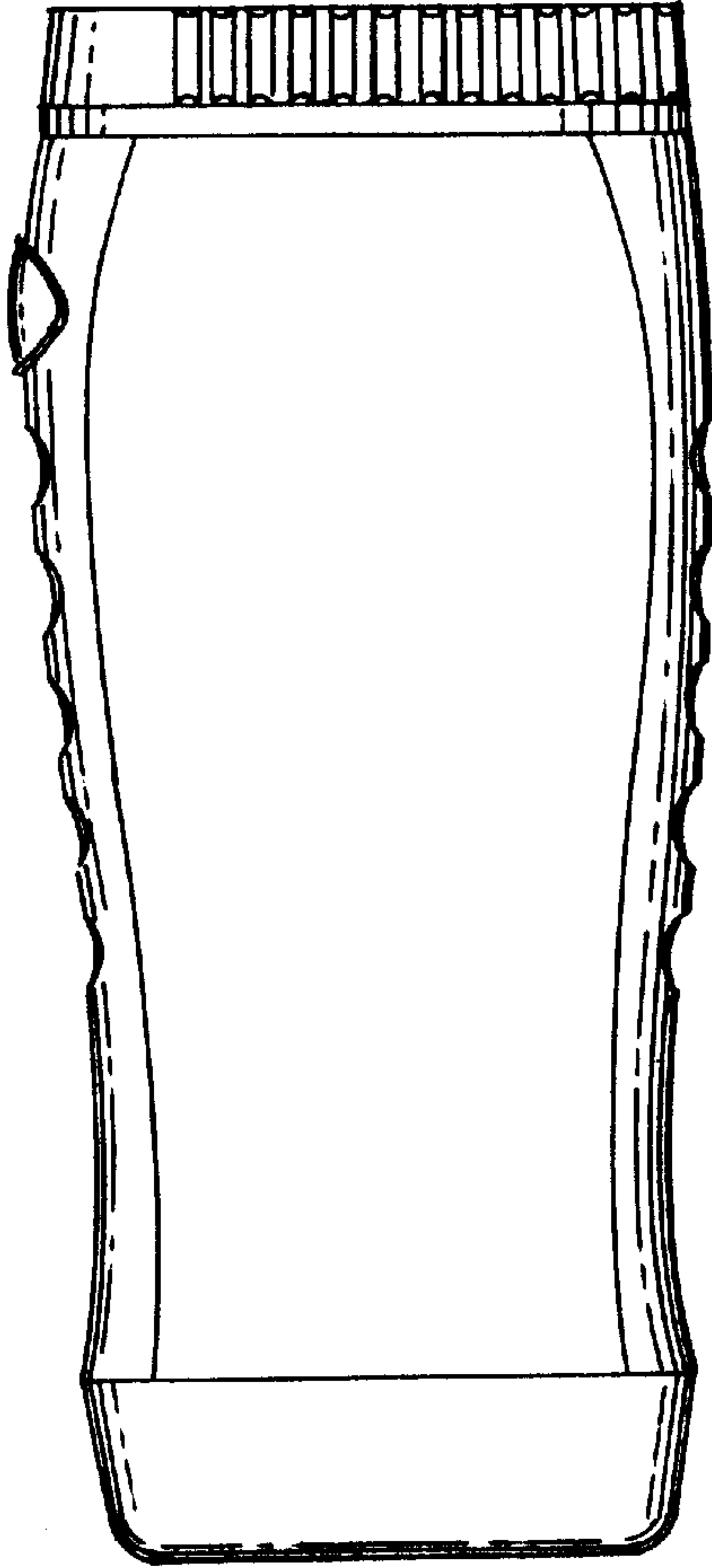

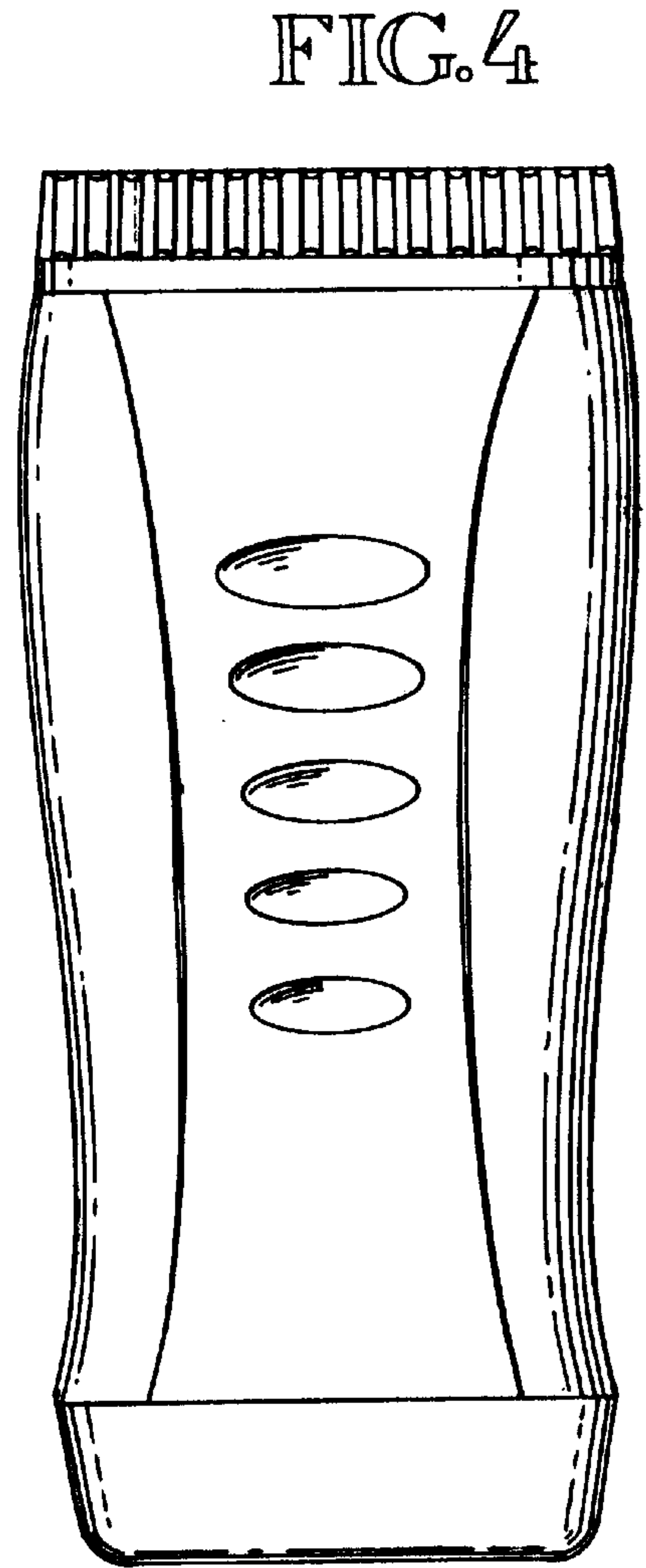

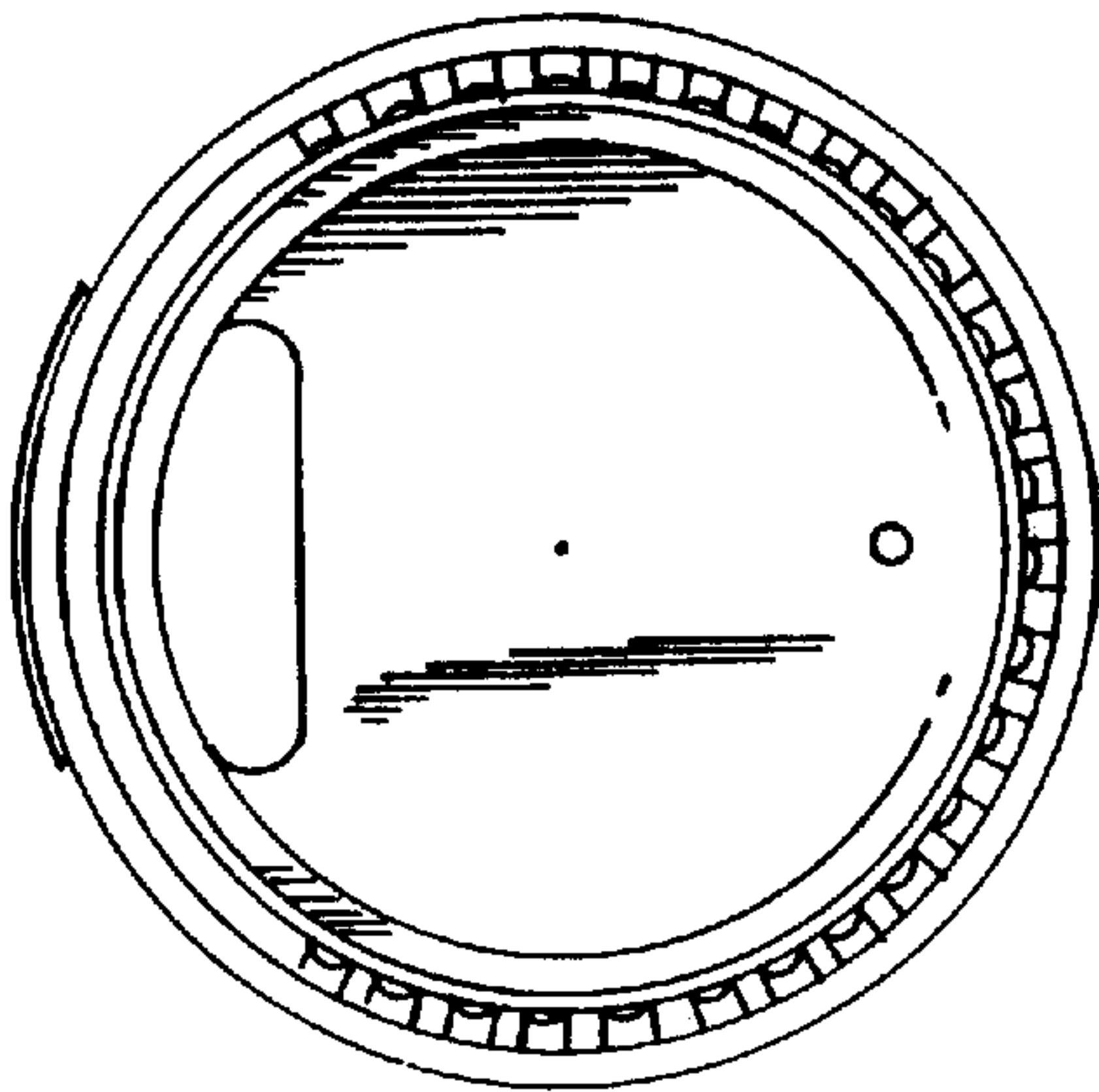

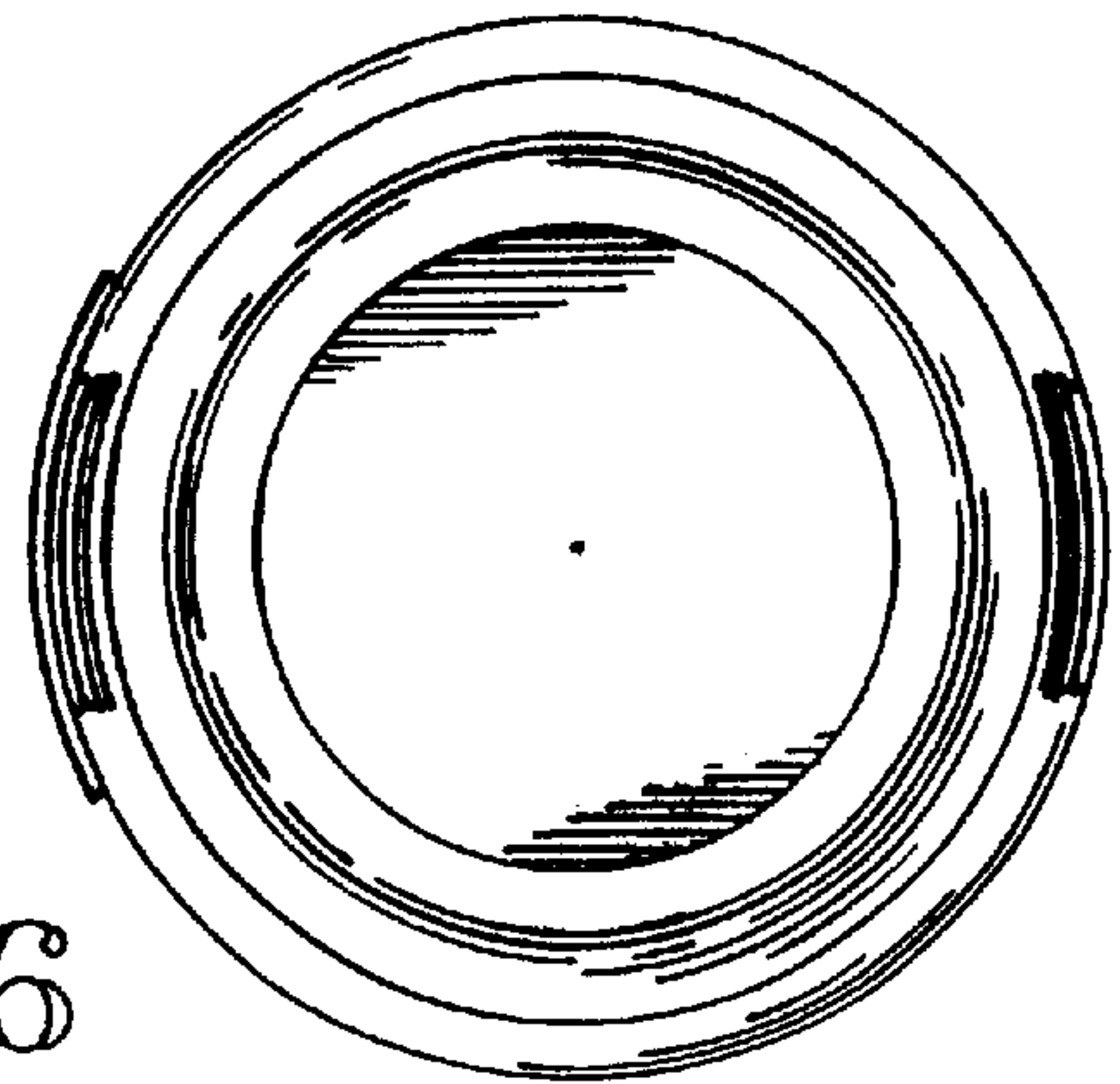
