
The ornamental design for the gun barrel rest, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION


FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a first embodiment of a gun barrel rest showing the new ornamental design thereof;

- FIG. 21 is a top elevational plan view thereof, the bottom elevational plan view being identical thereto.





























