The oblique line shading on the drawings is understood to represent a translucent or transparent surface.

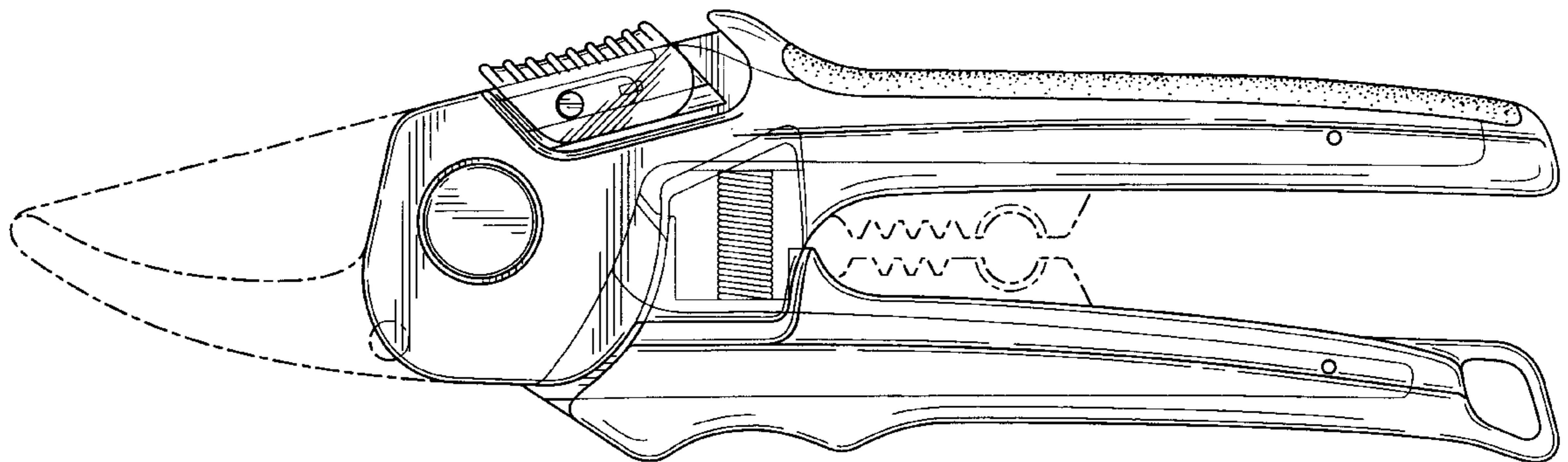

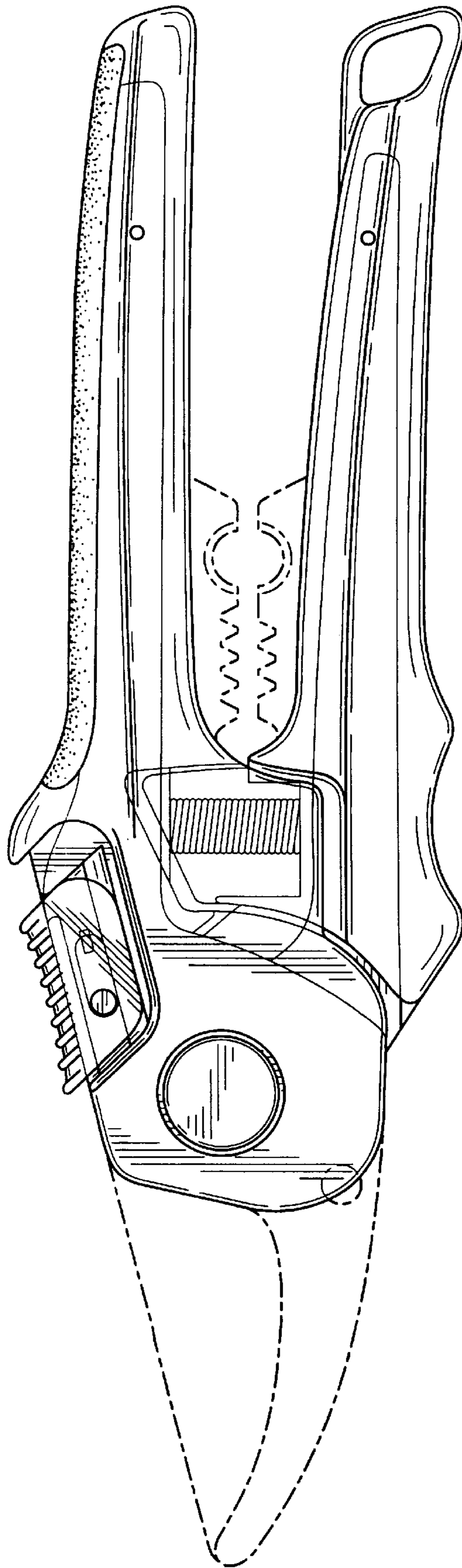

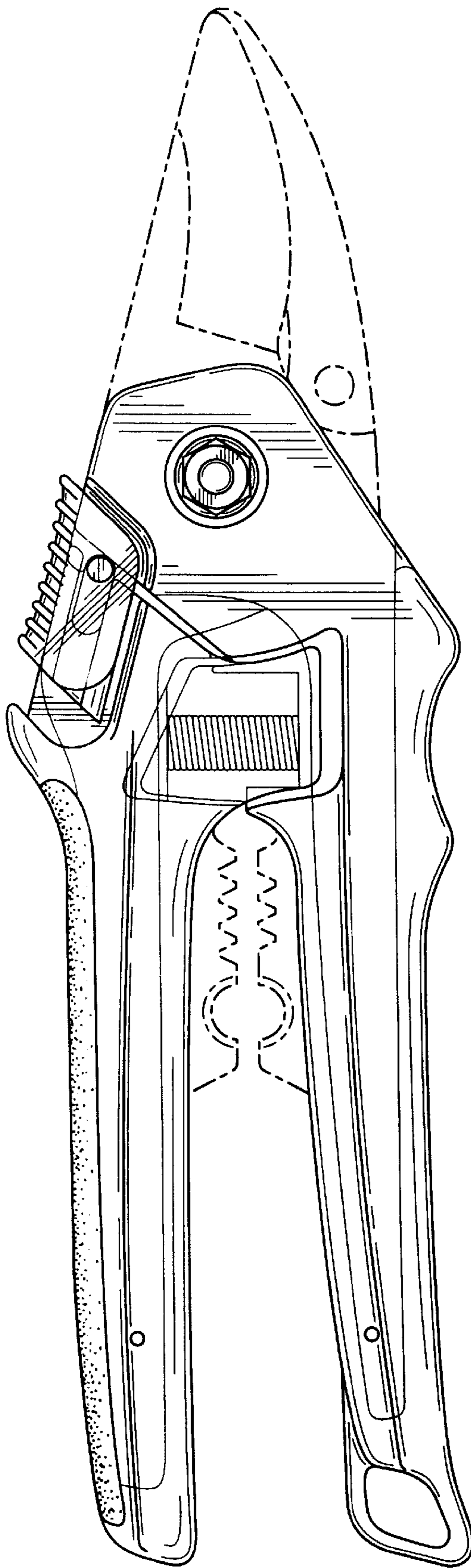

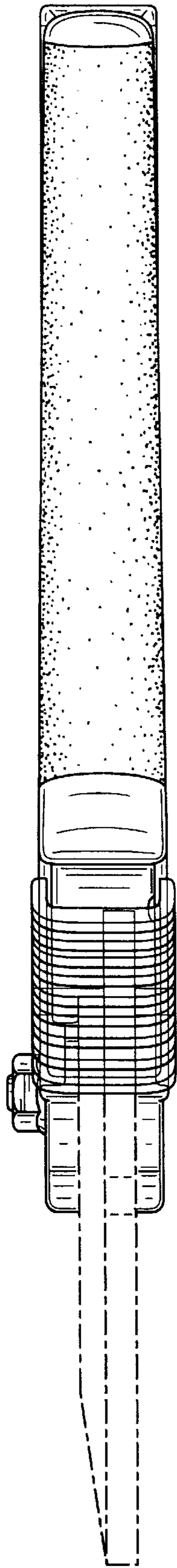

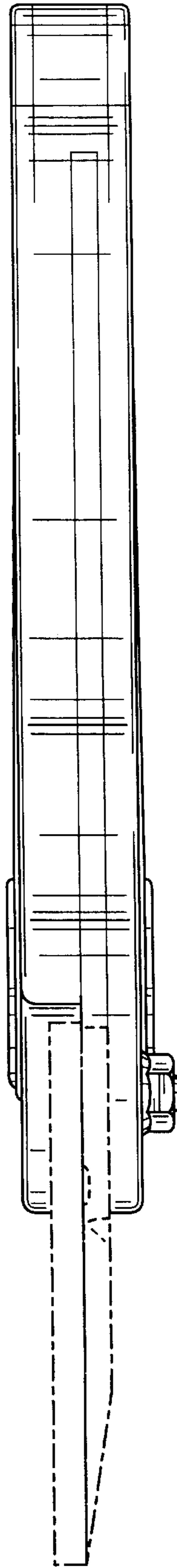

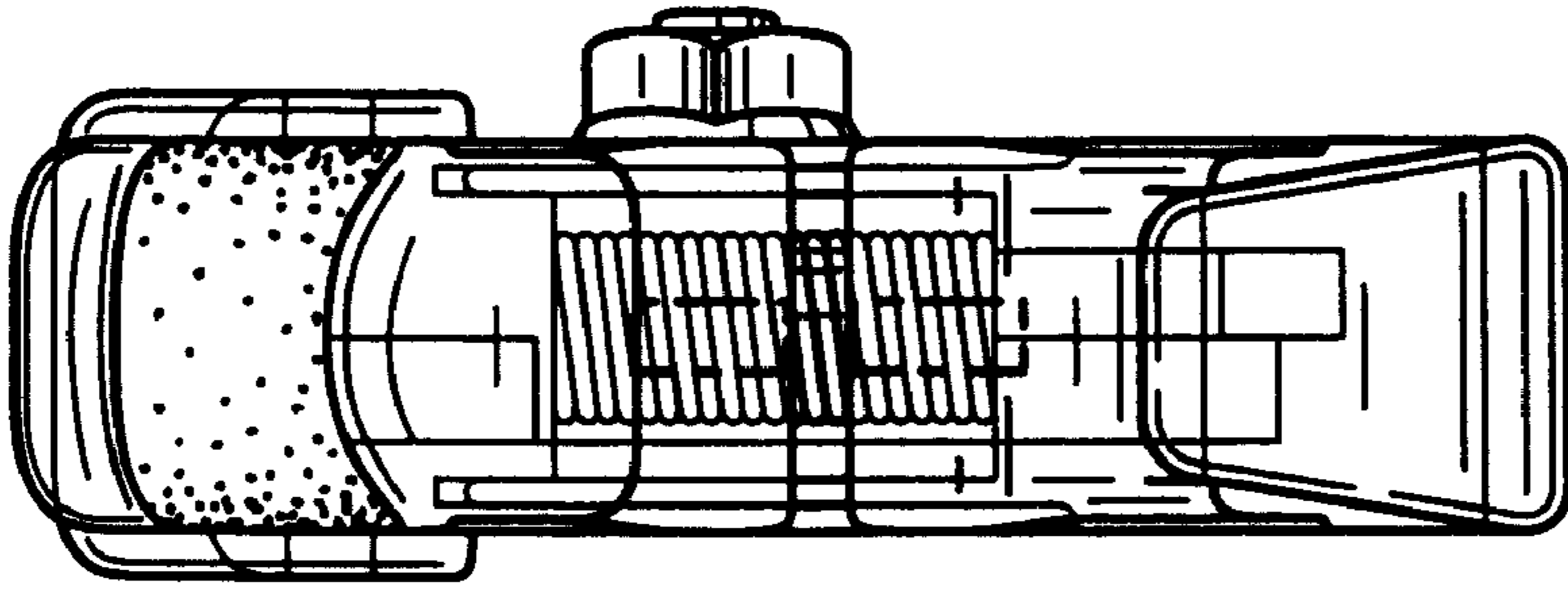

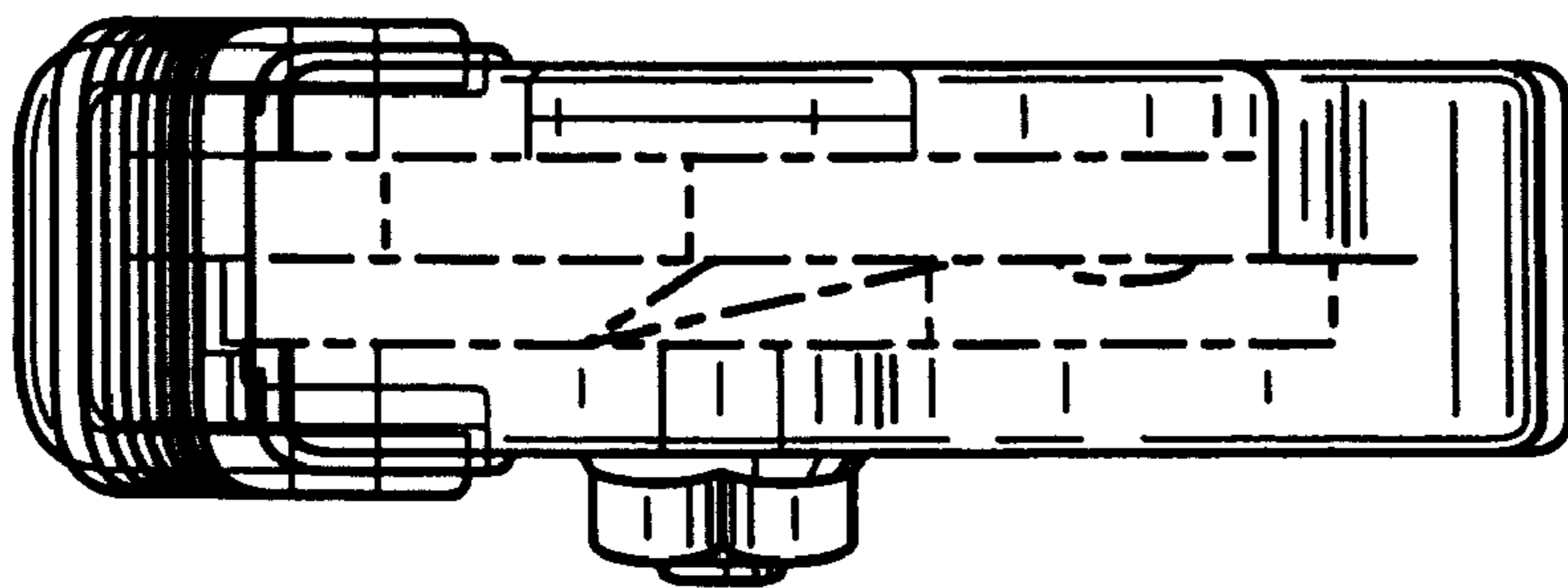
