The ornamental design for a threaded cap, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a plan view of the bottom of the cap looking into the open end of the cap;

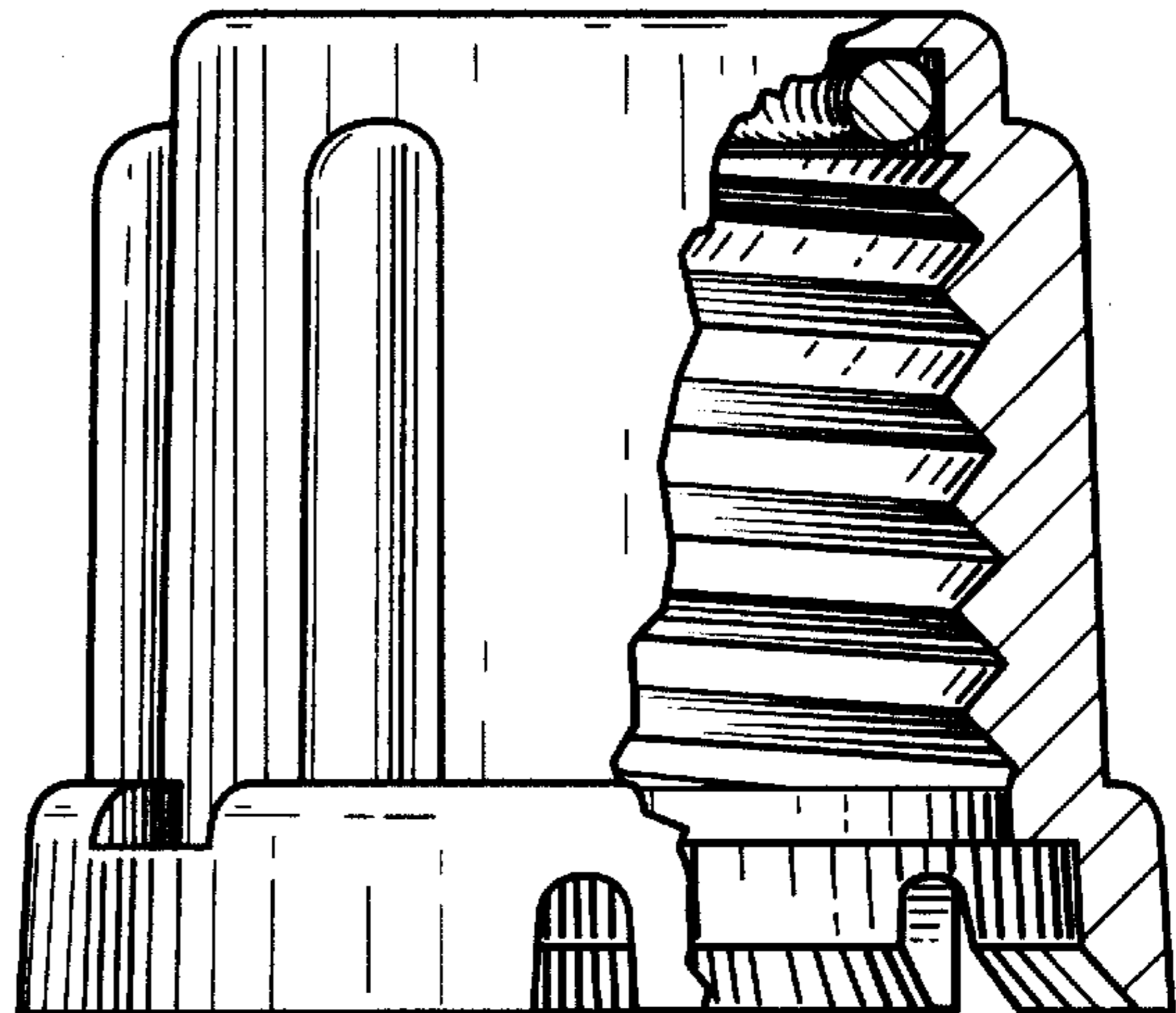
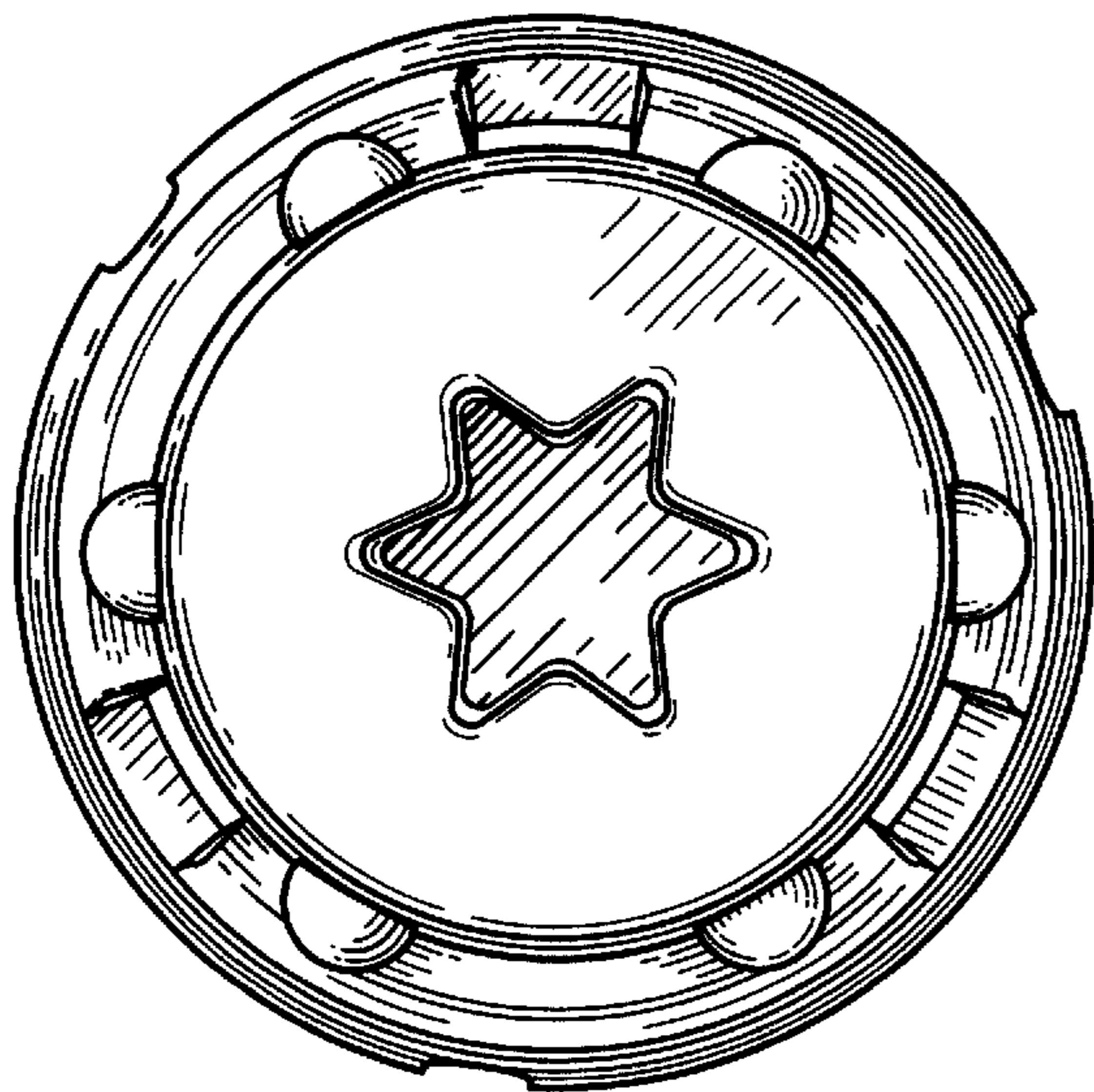
FIG. 2 is a plan view of the top of the cap;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view of a first side of the cap, partially broken away to reveal inside details; and,

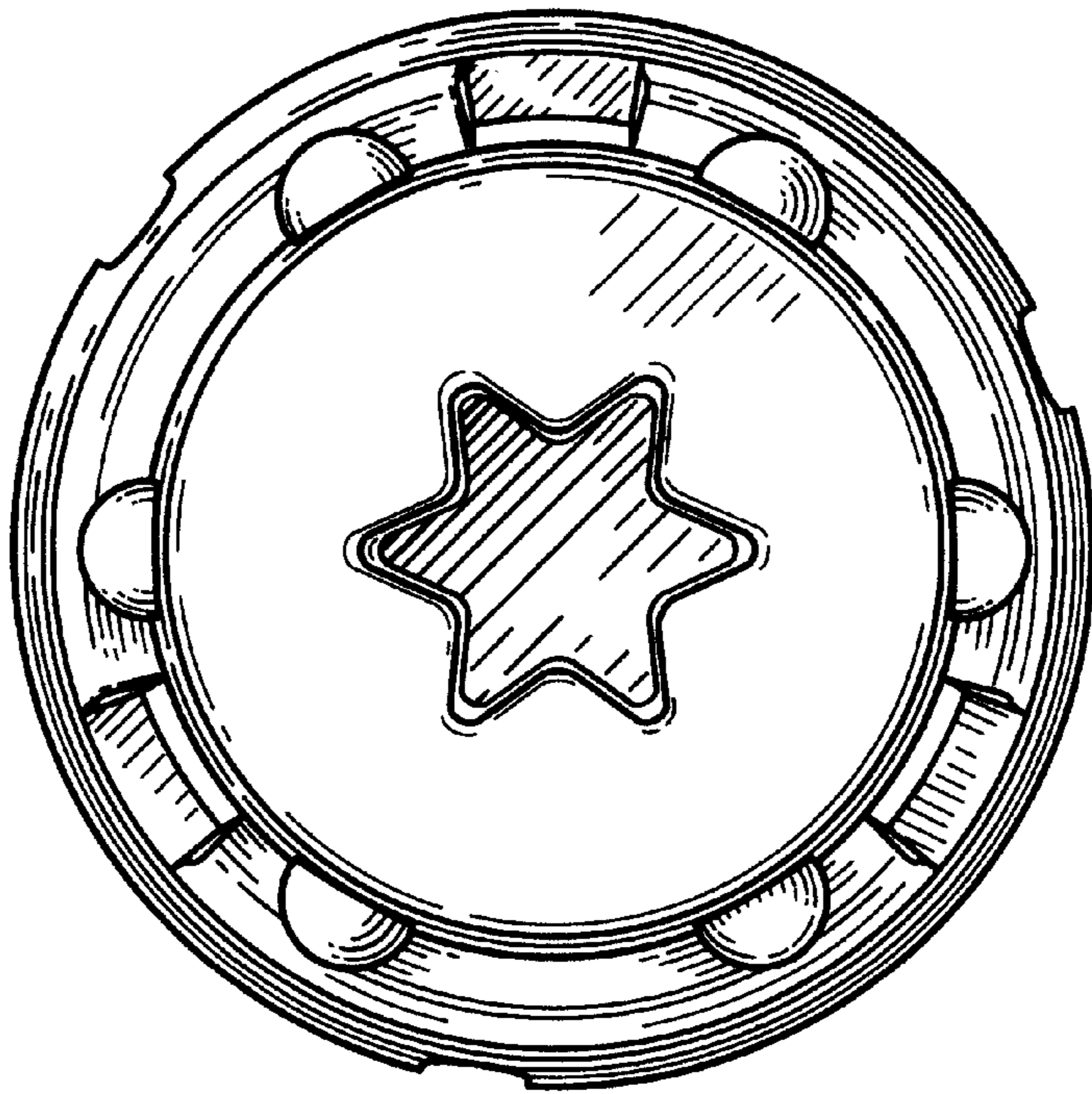

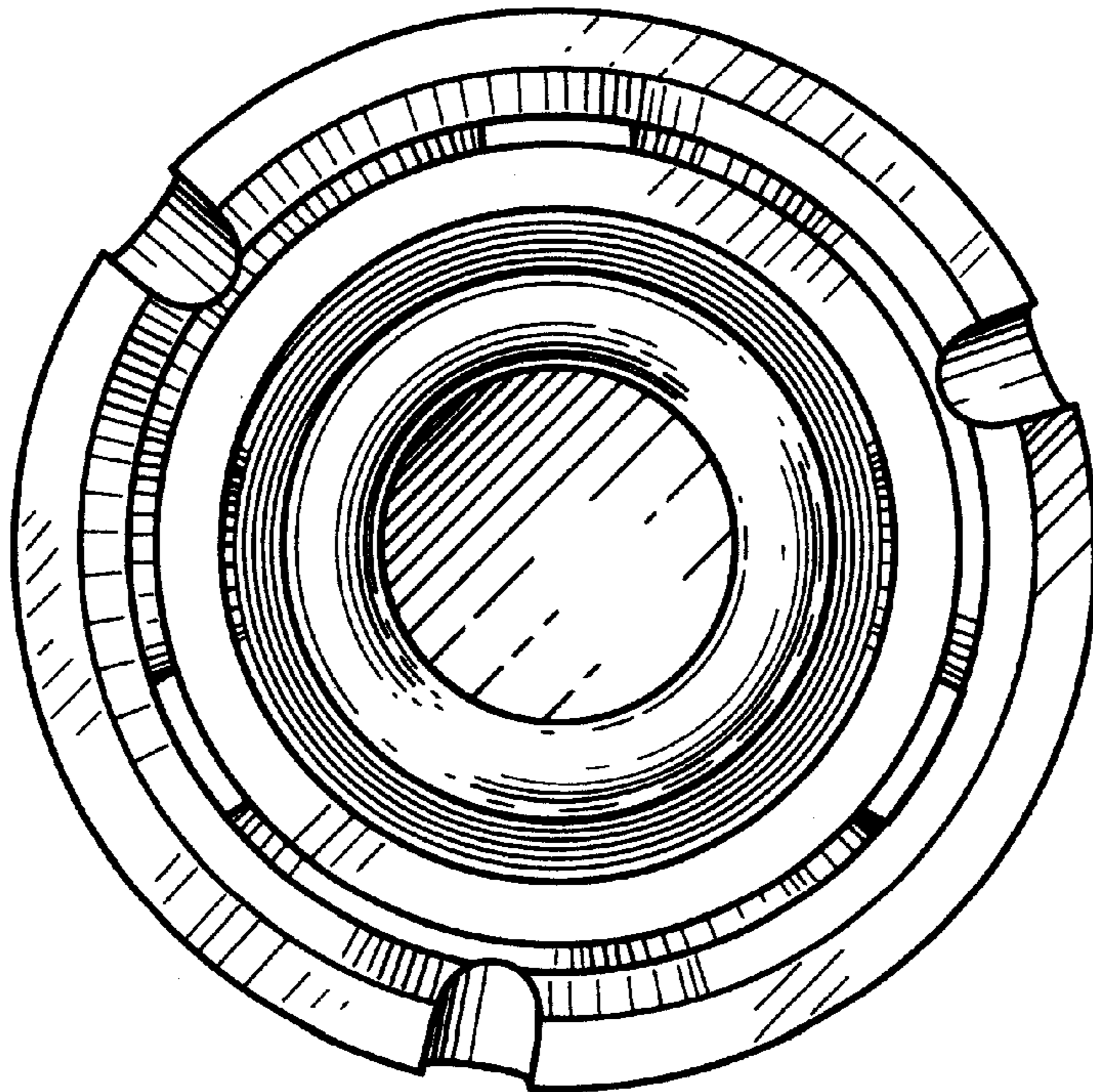

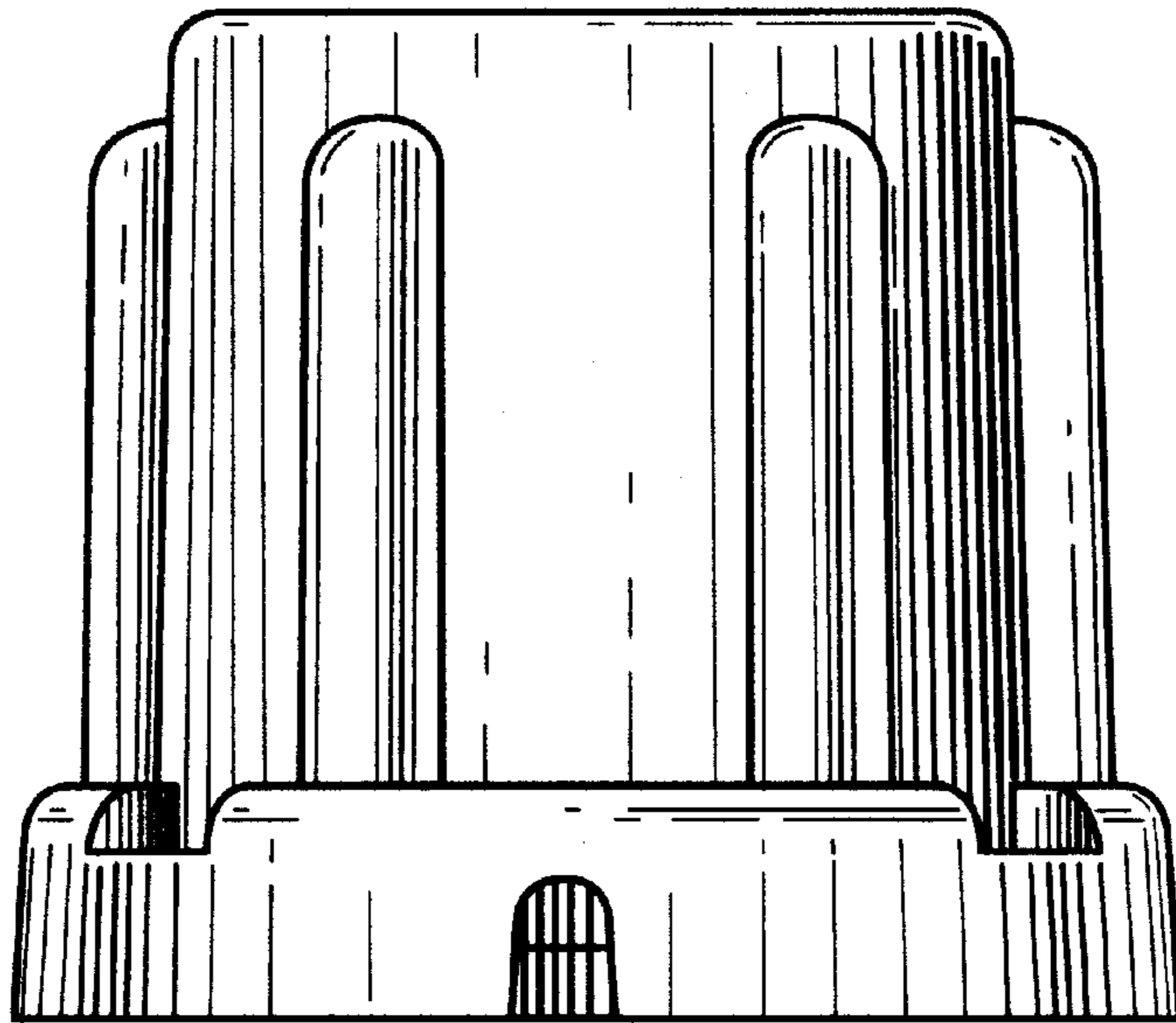

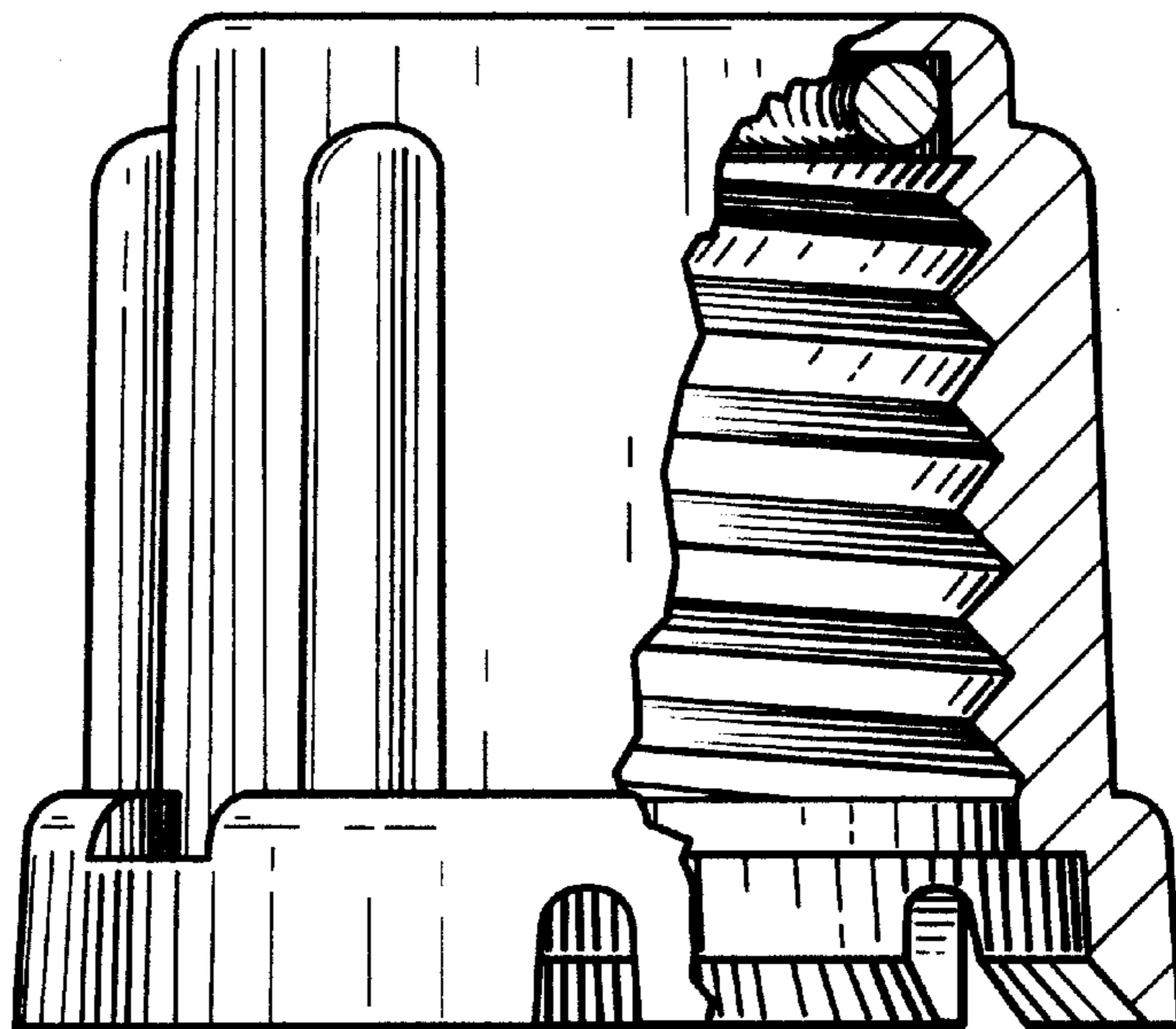

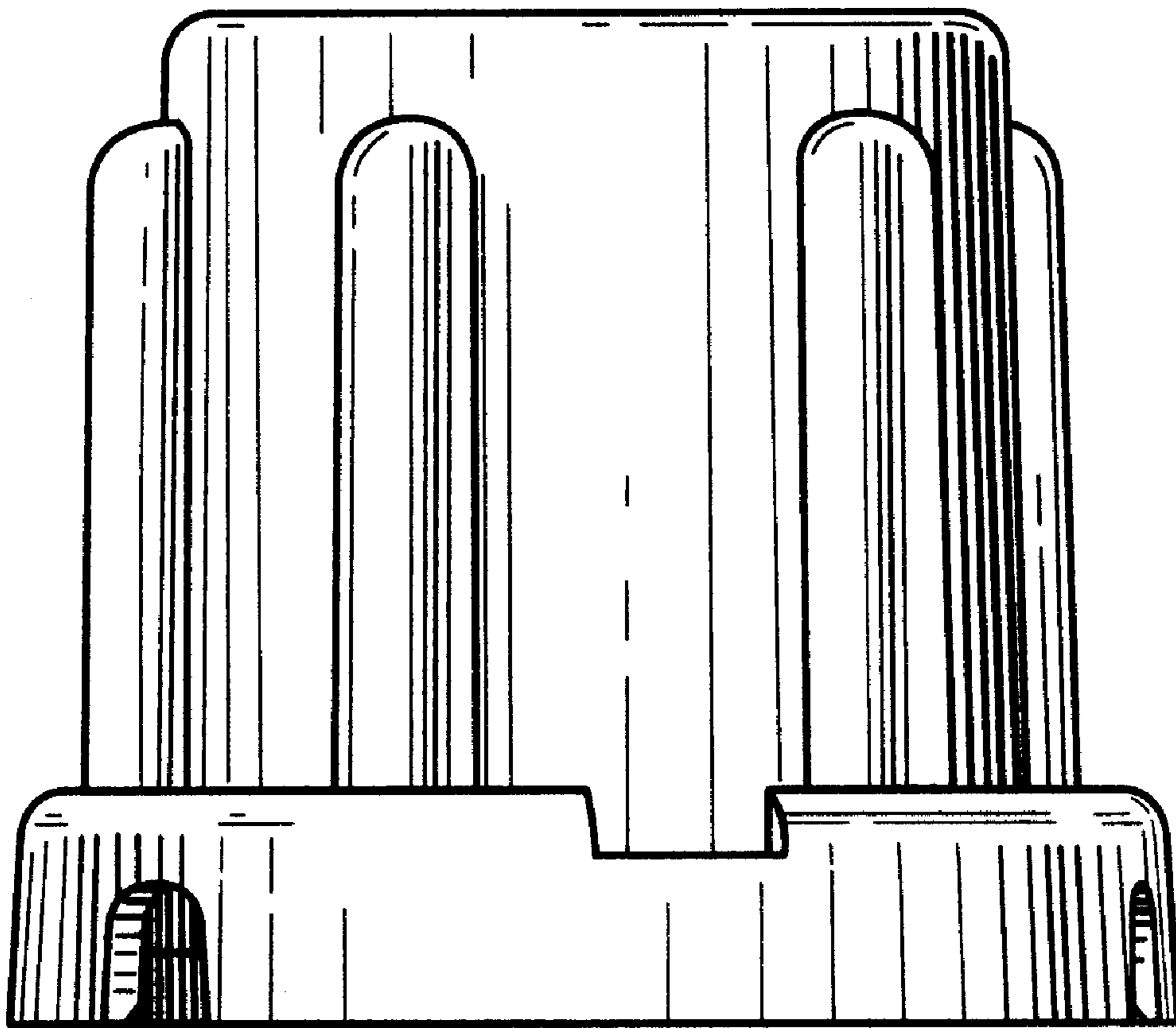
