mobile, as shown and described.

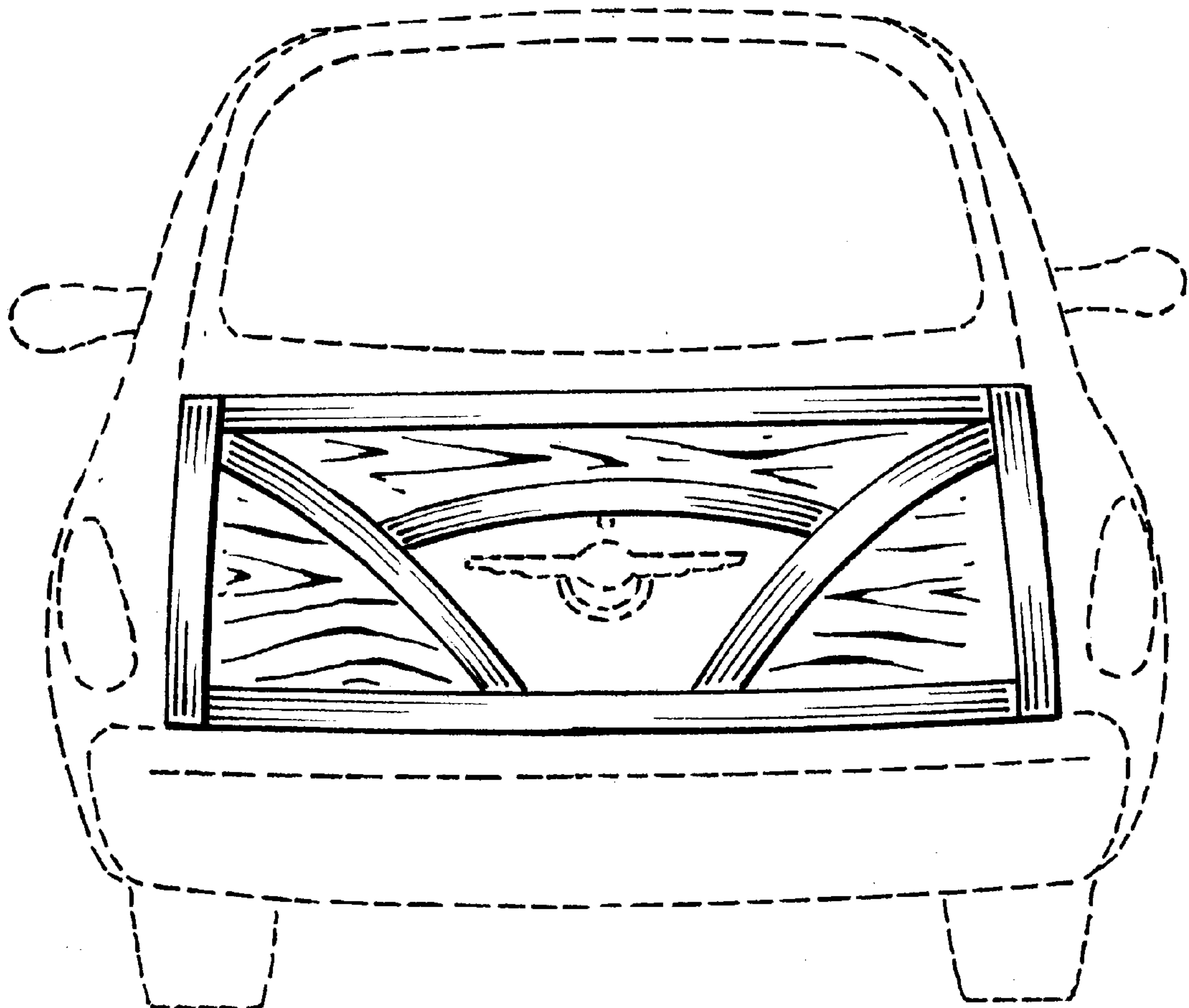
DESCRIPTION

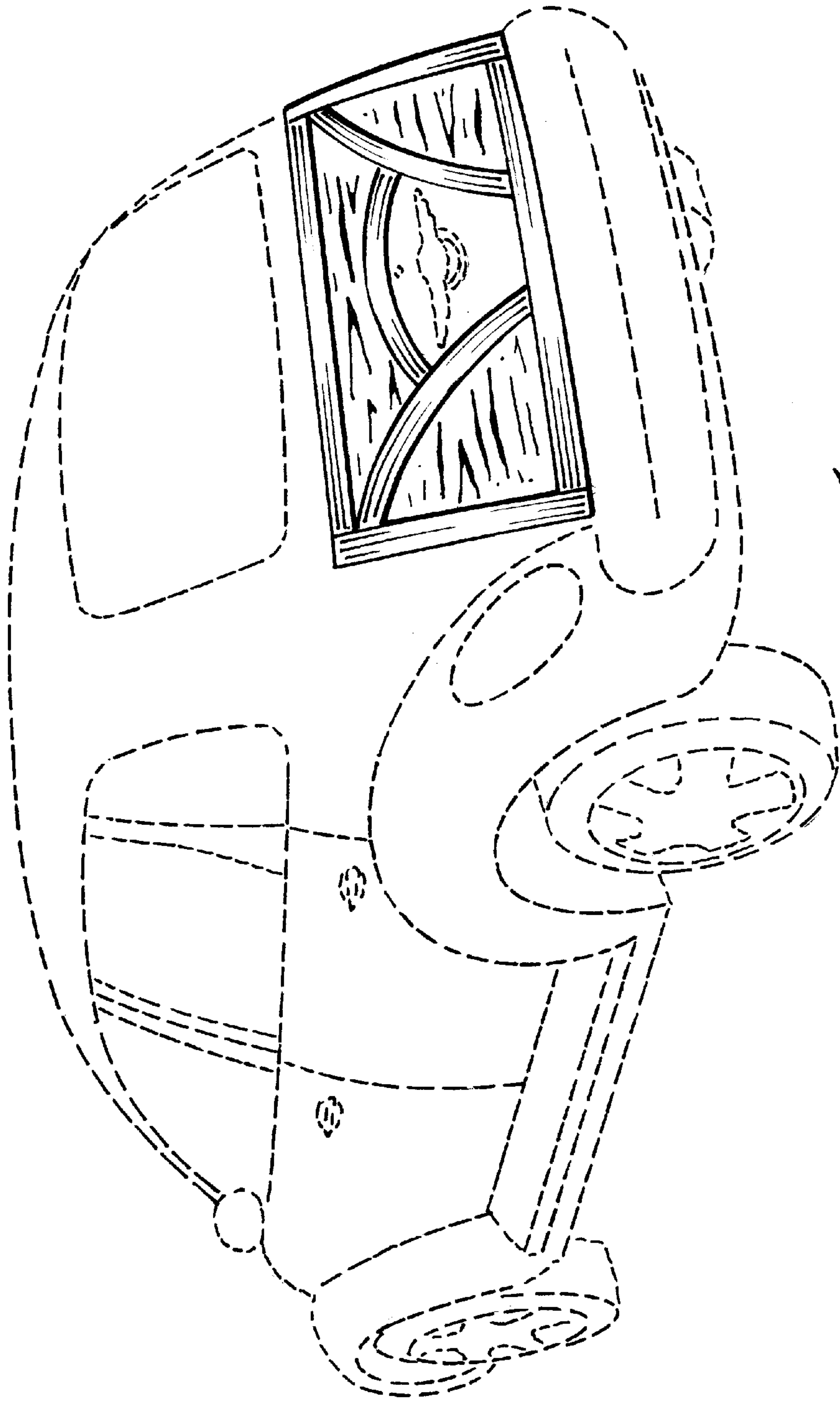
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of exterior rear panels for an
automobile embodying the invention; and,

FIG. 2 is a rear view of the design shown in FIG. 1.

The broken line showing of the environment is for illustra-
tive purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.
The top, sides, front, and bottom views are not part of the
claimed design. The portions of the design shown in solid
lines are constructed of wood or a material conveying the
ornamental appearance of wood. The automobile to which
the exterior rear panels are applied in the illustrated embodi-
ment is a Chrysler PT Cruiser.

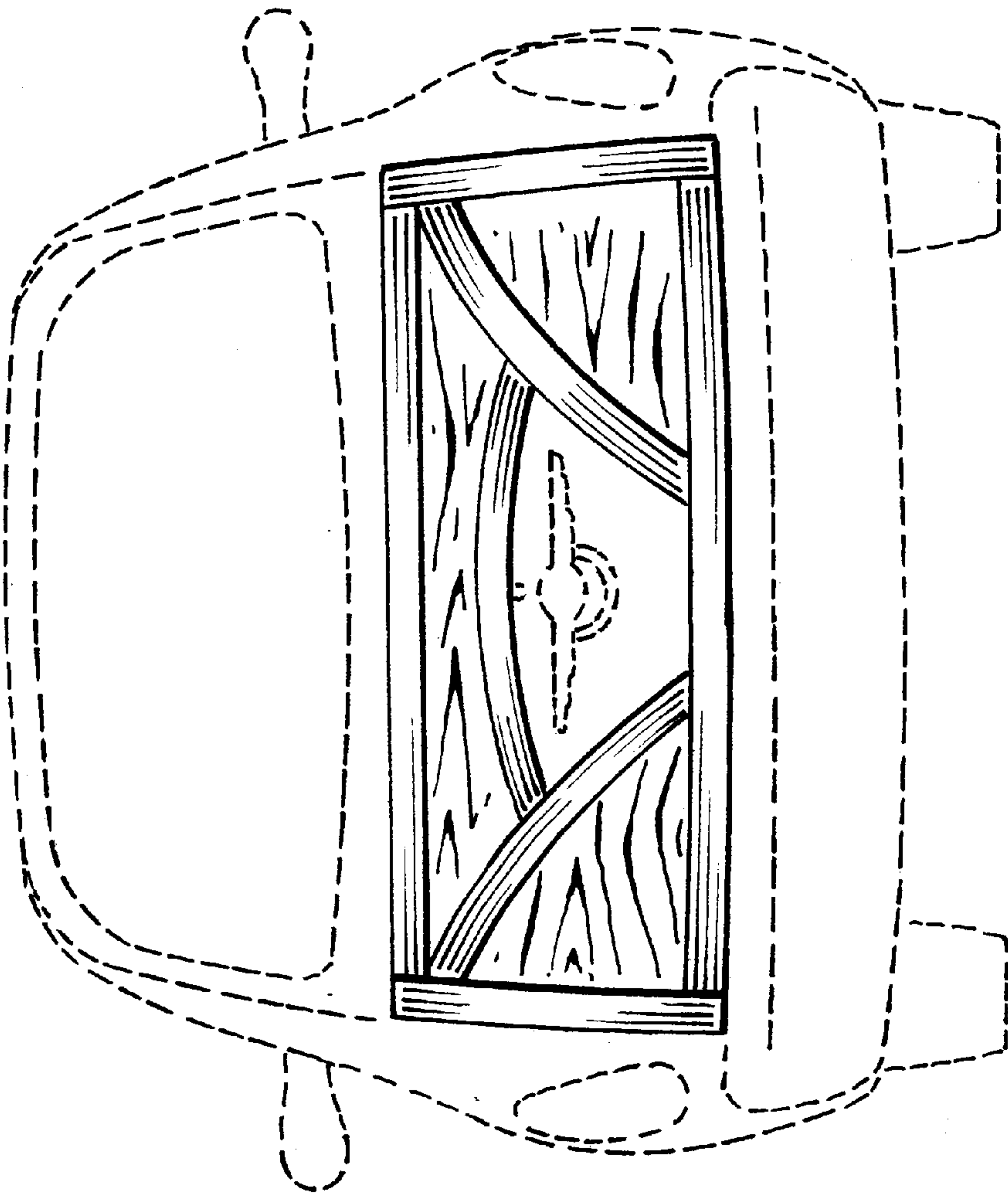
