FIG. 1 is a left-side perspective view of a scalpel handle showing my new design;

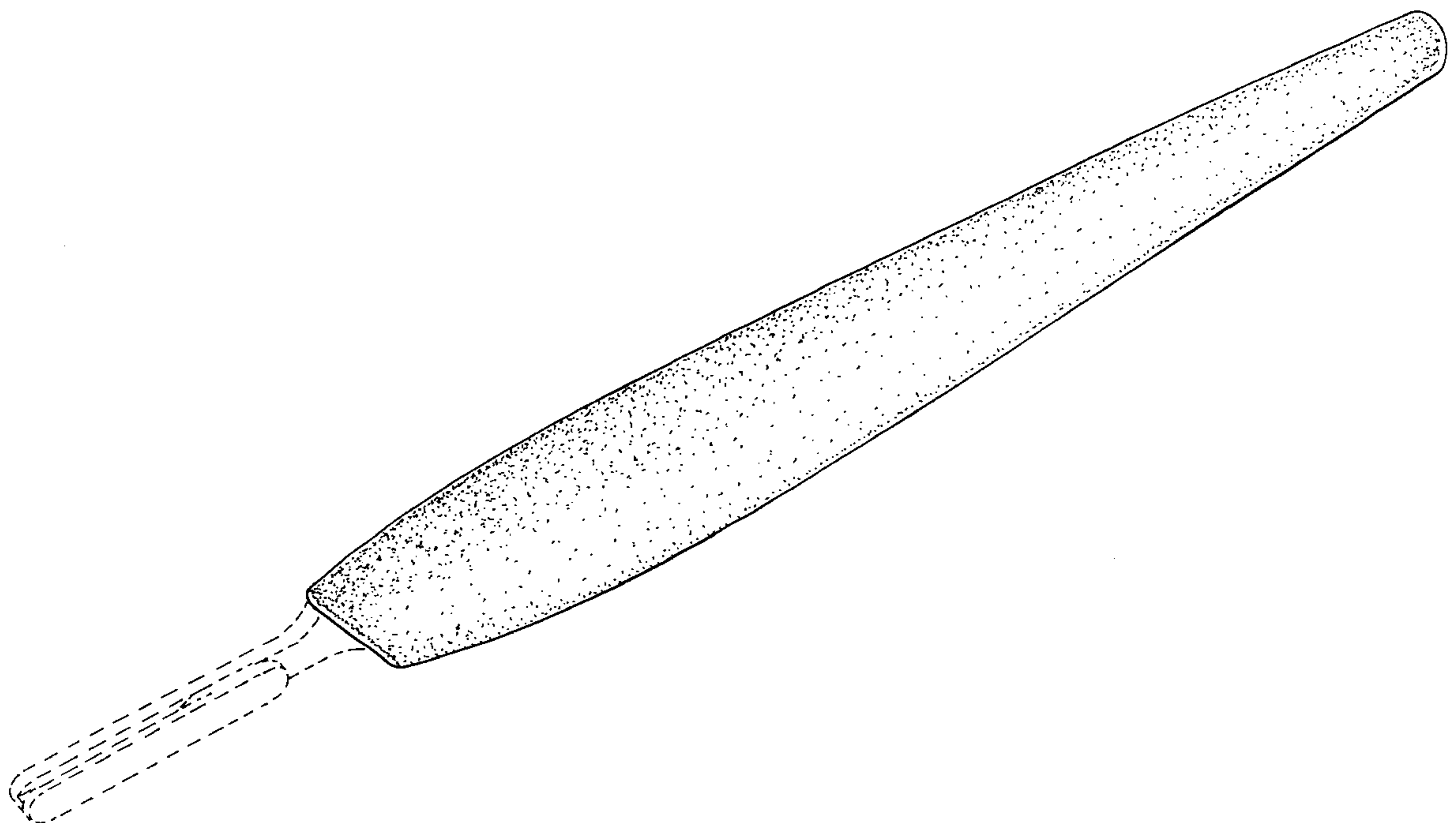
FIG. 2 is a right-side perspective view thereof;

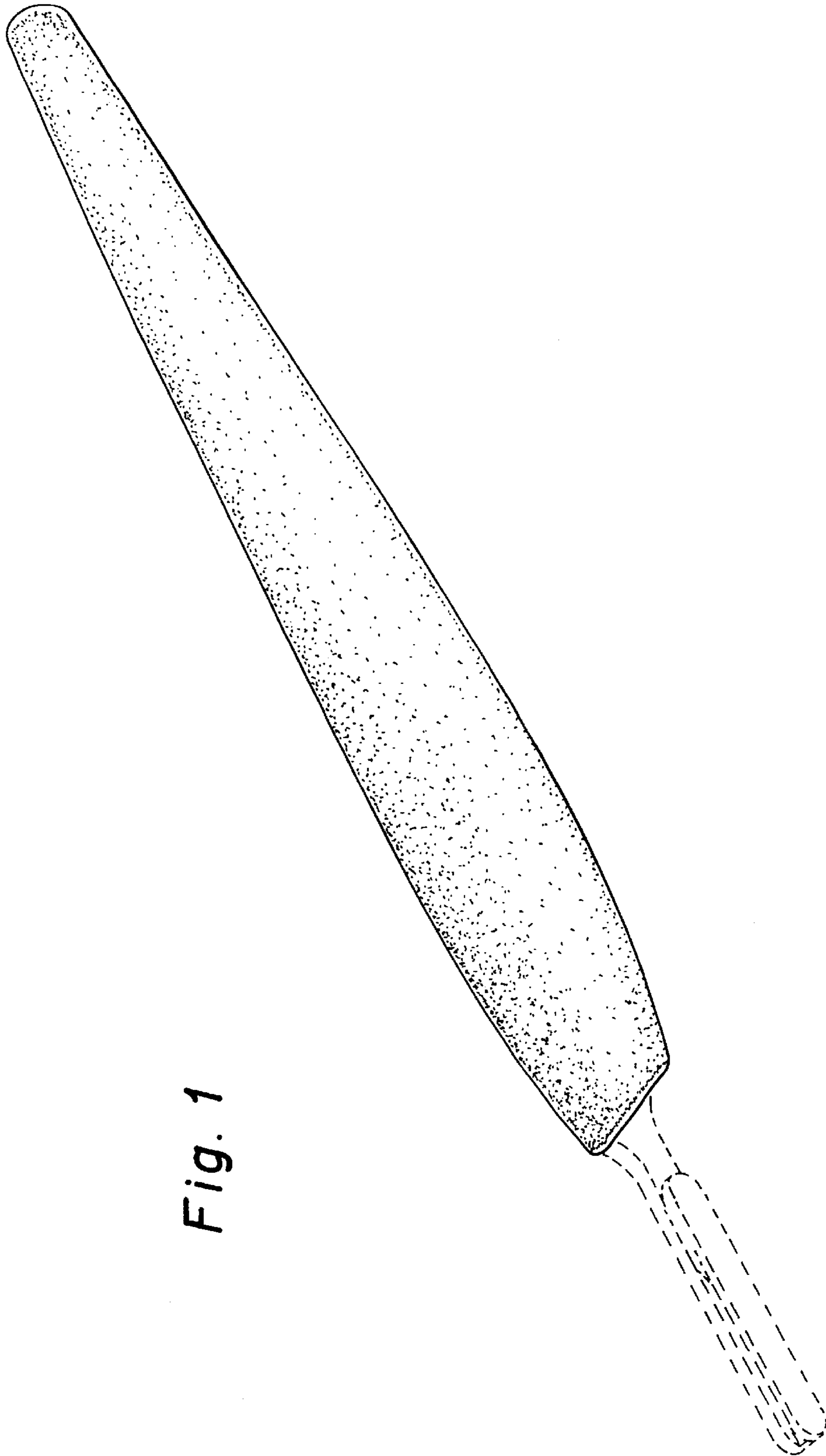

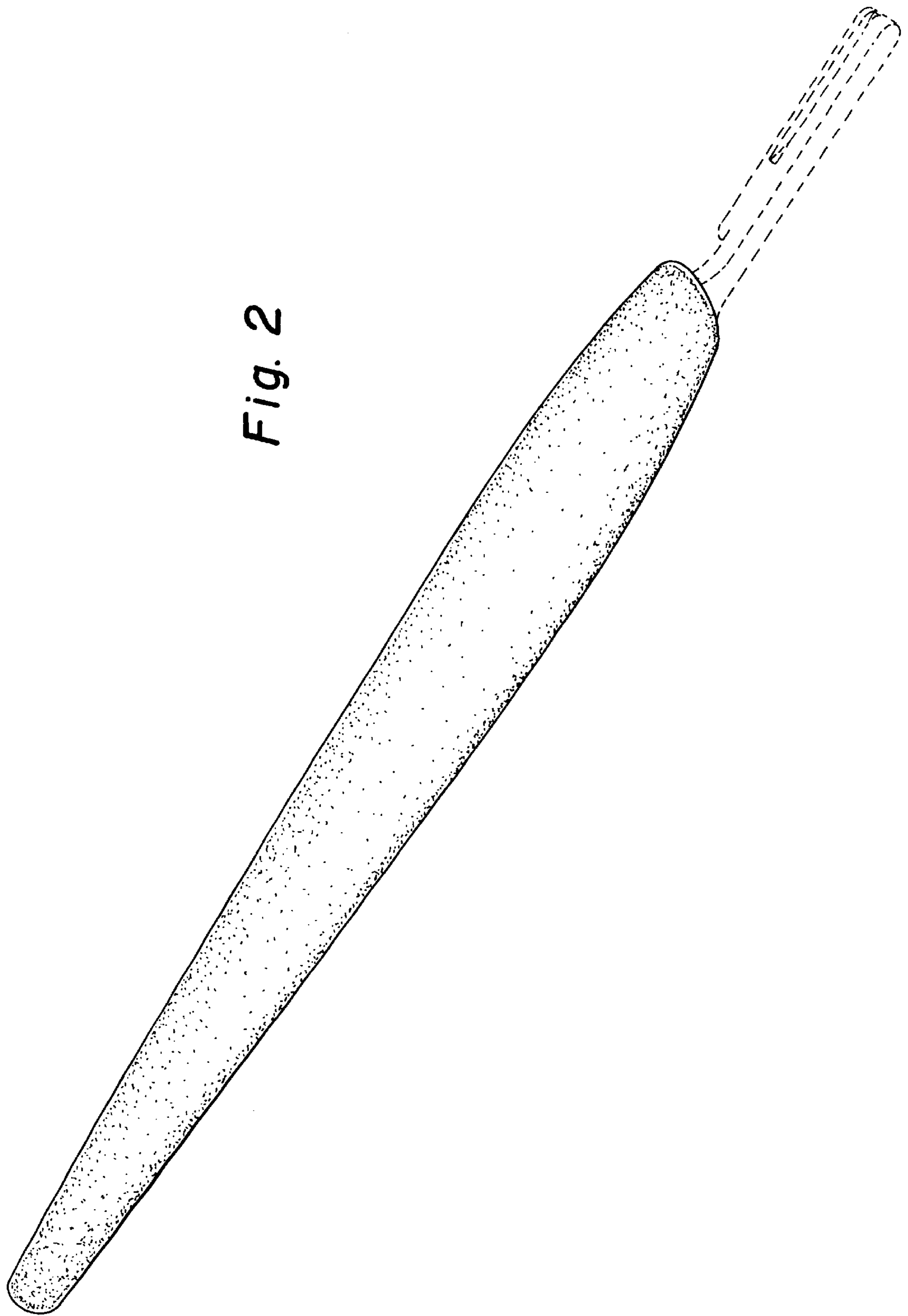

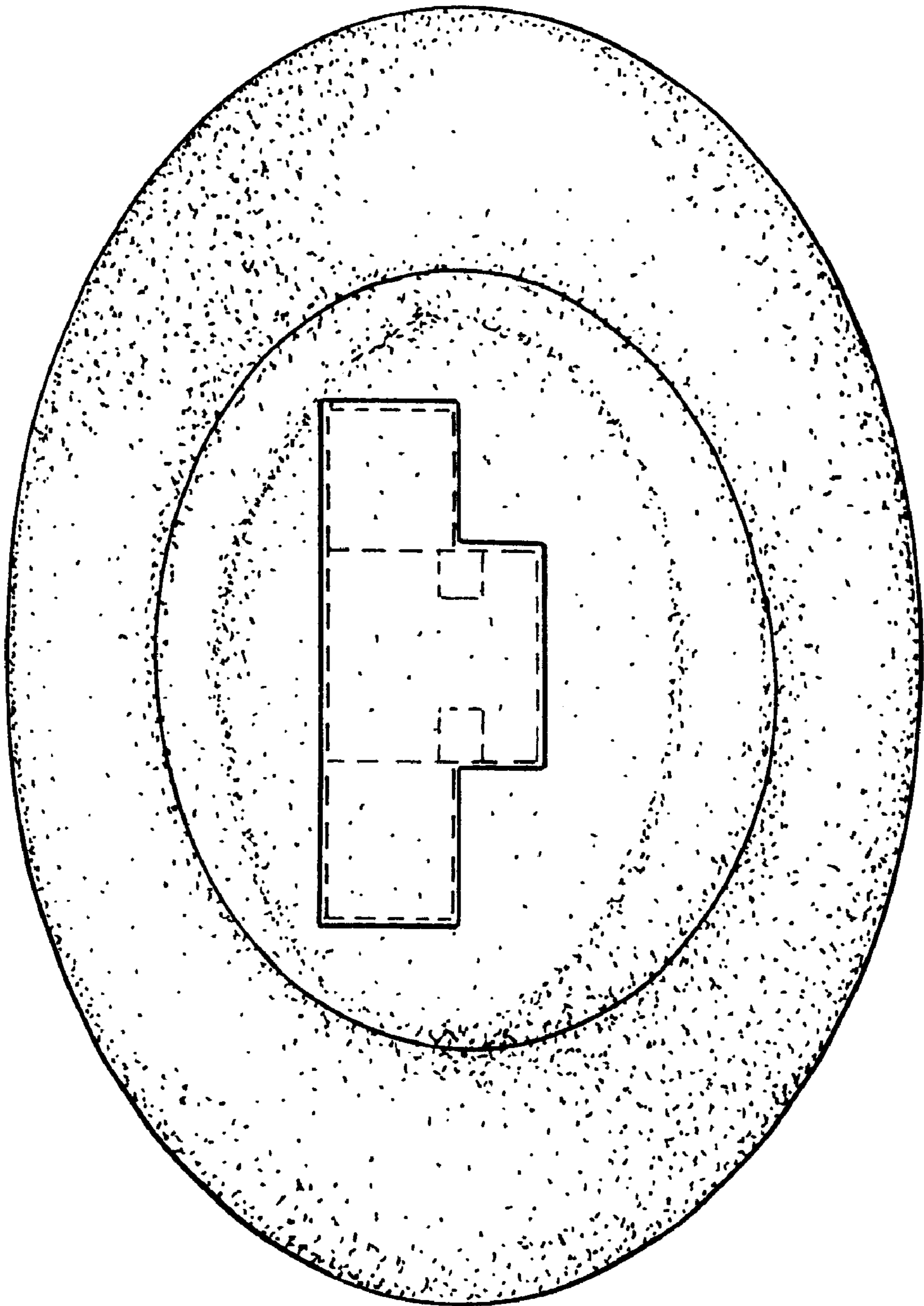

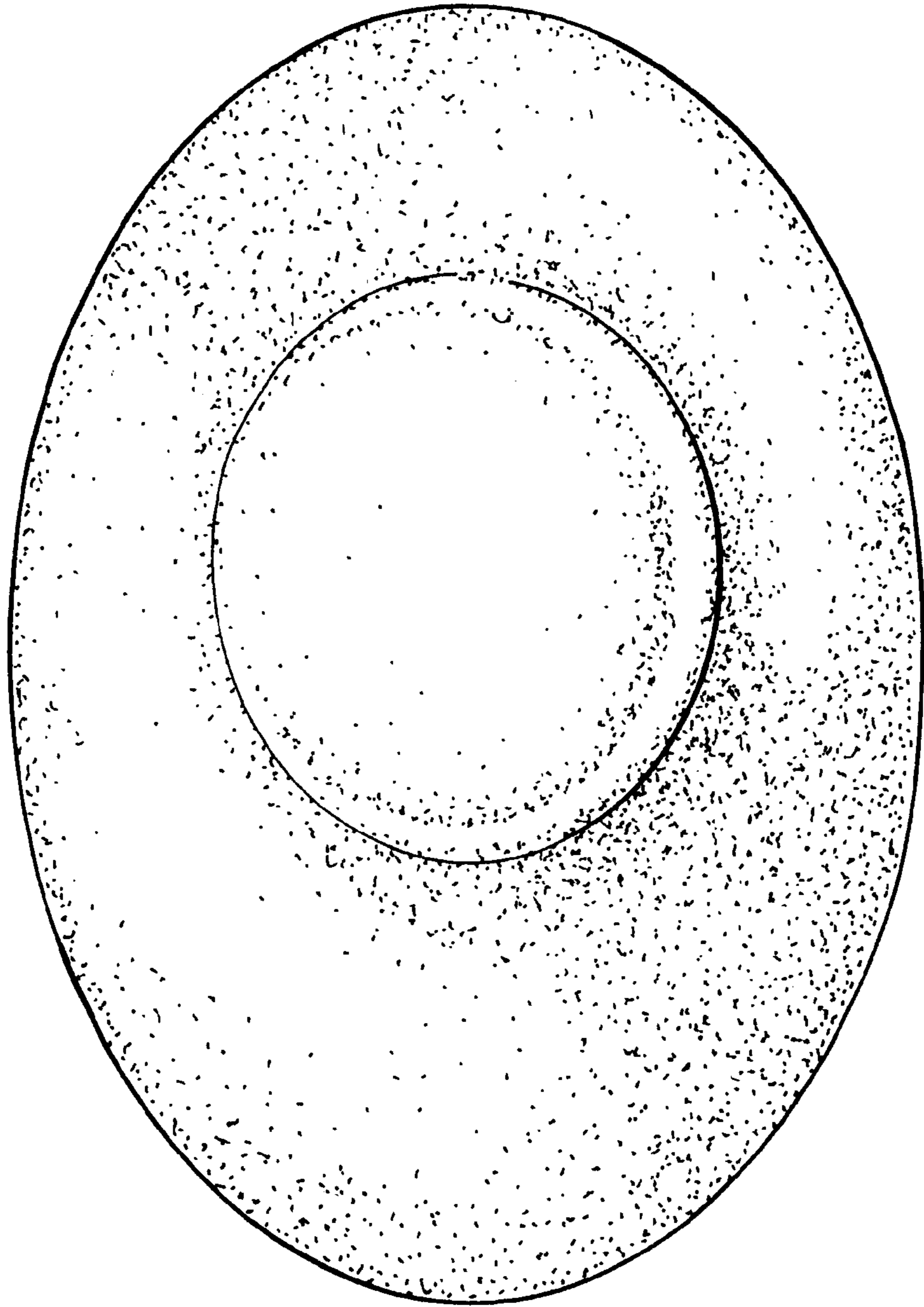
