FIG. 1 is an isometric, environmental view of an X-light personal flashlight showing my new design.


FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the design.

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the design, the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.


FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of the design; and,


FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the design, the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof.




