FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof;

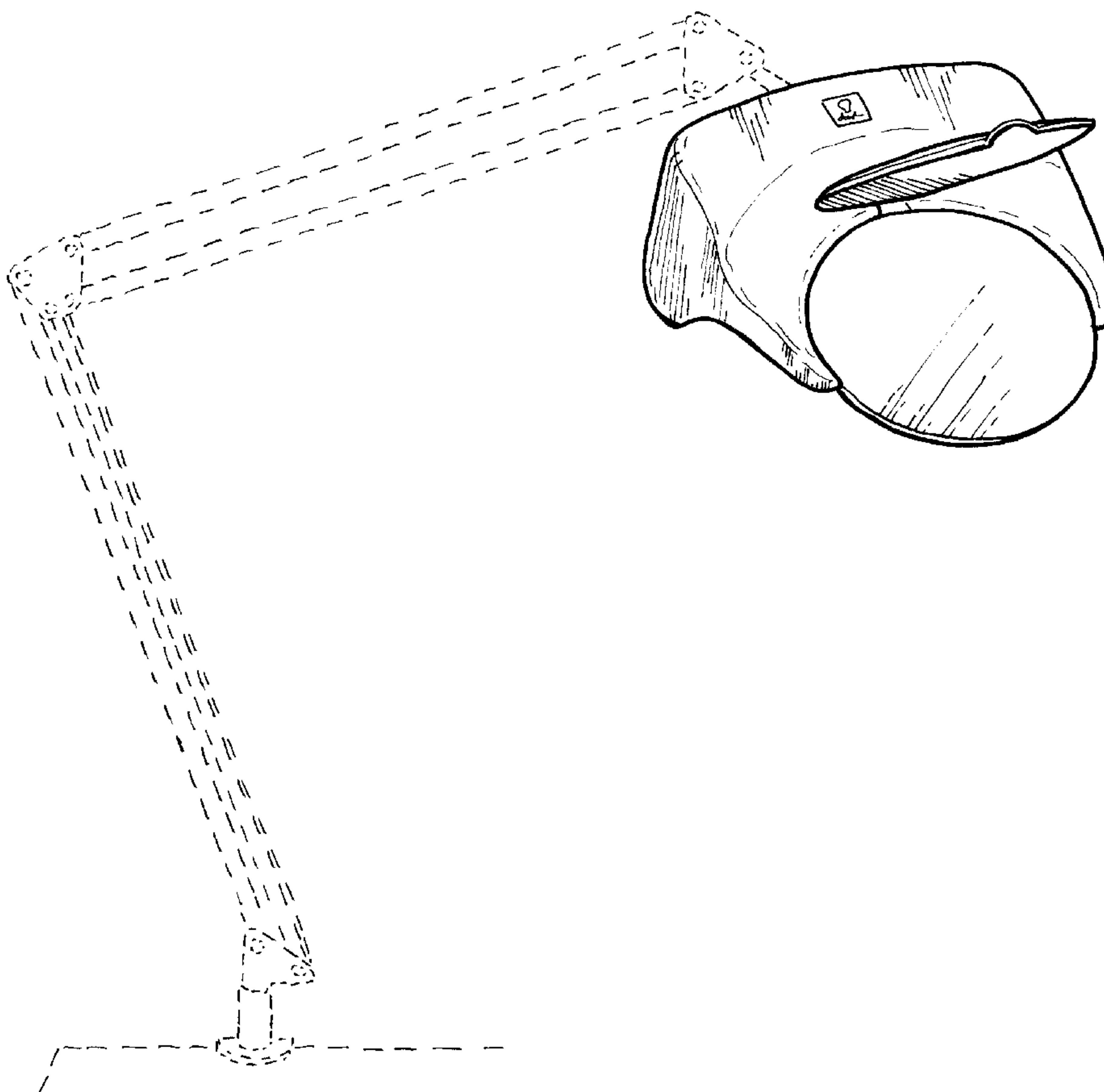
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof (cover open); and,

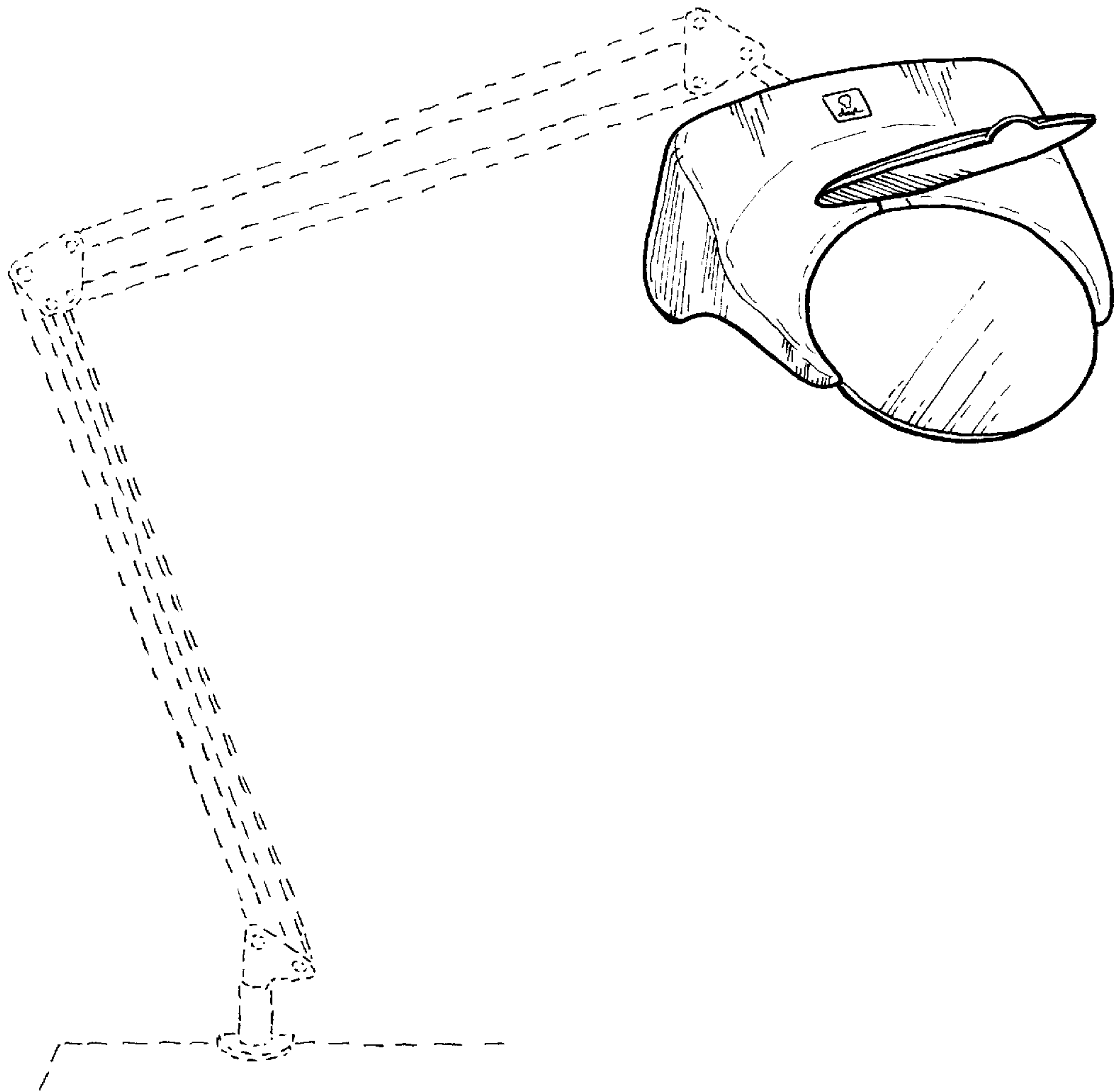

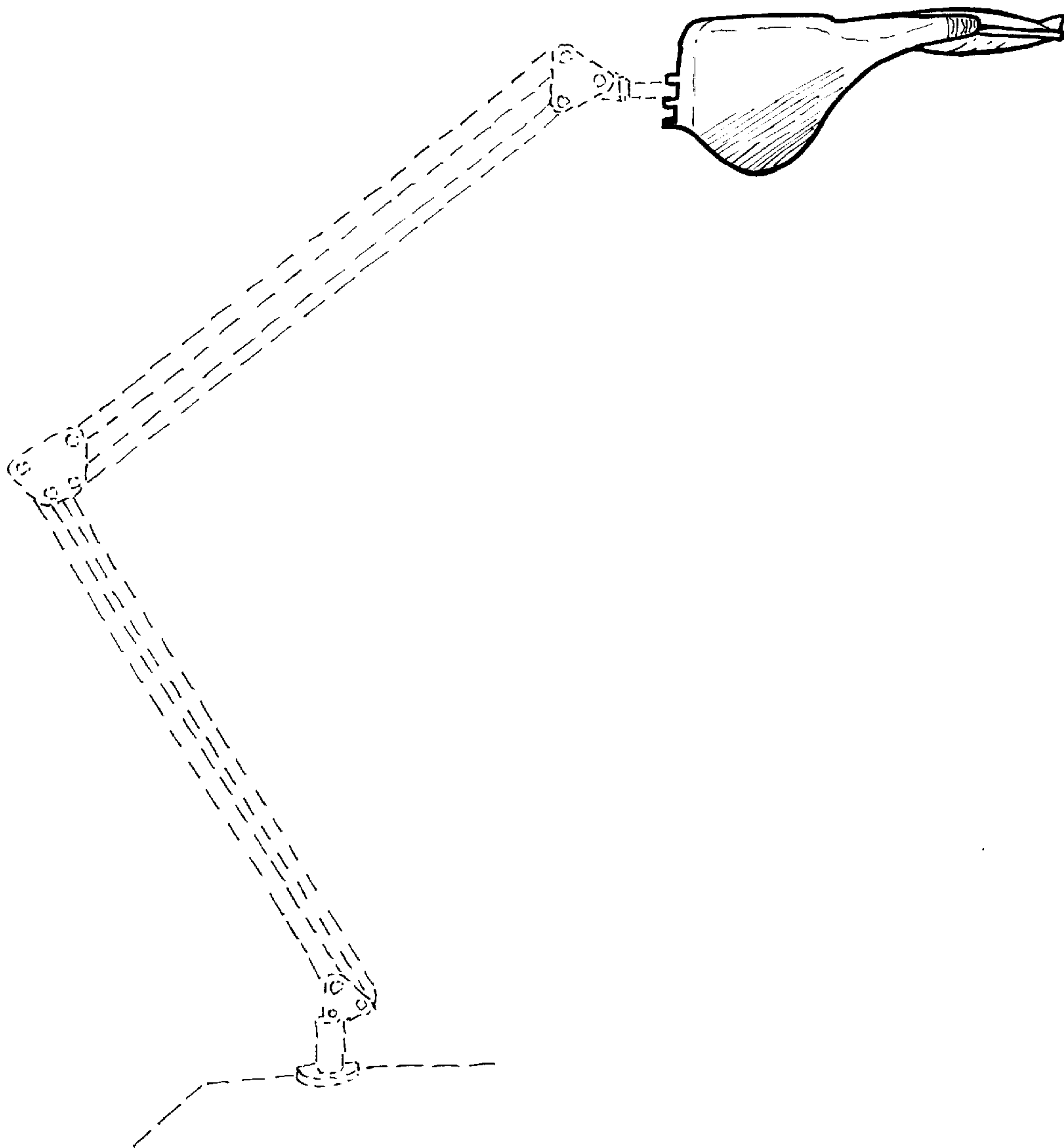

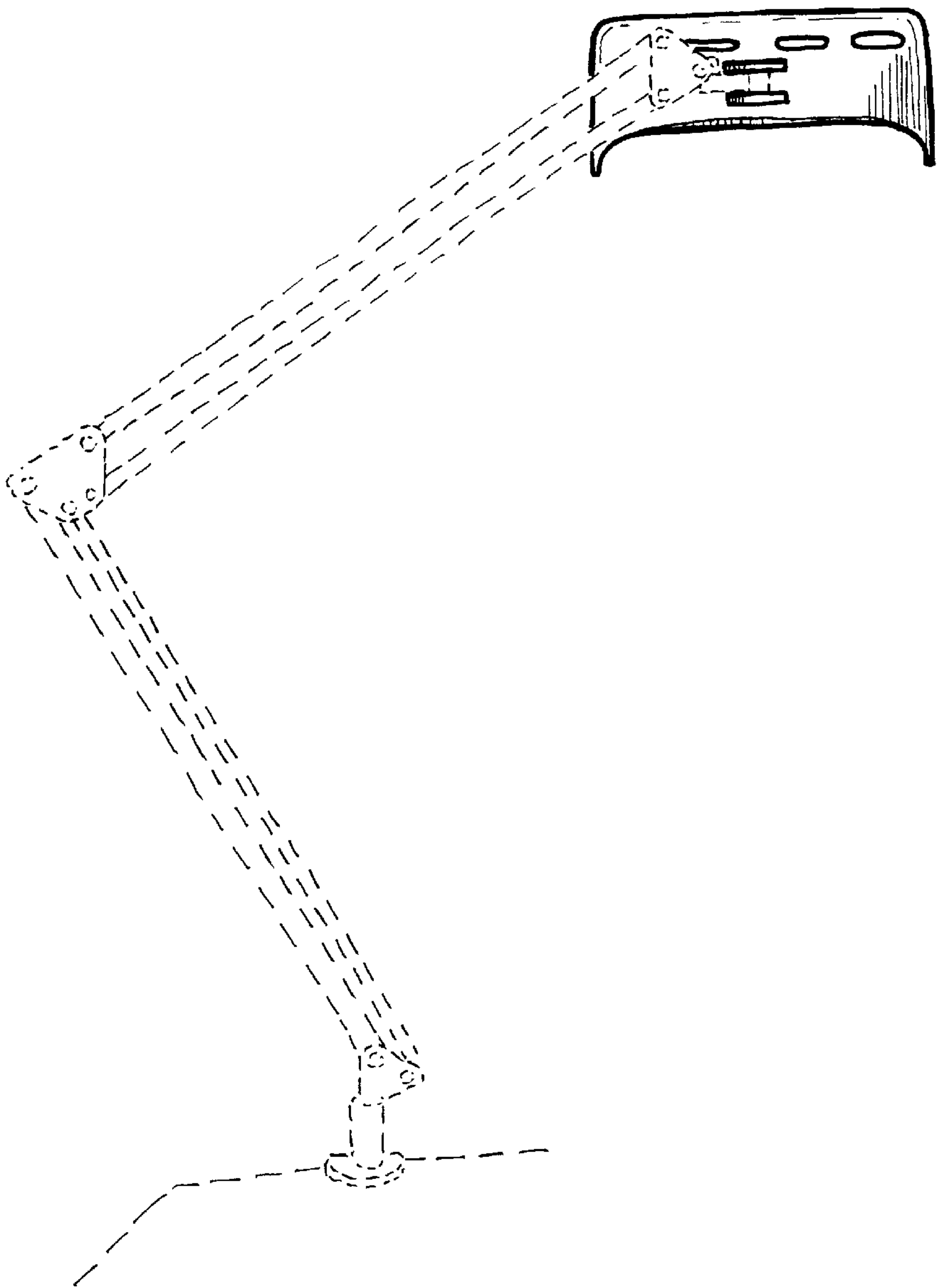

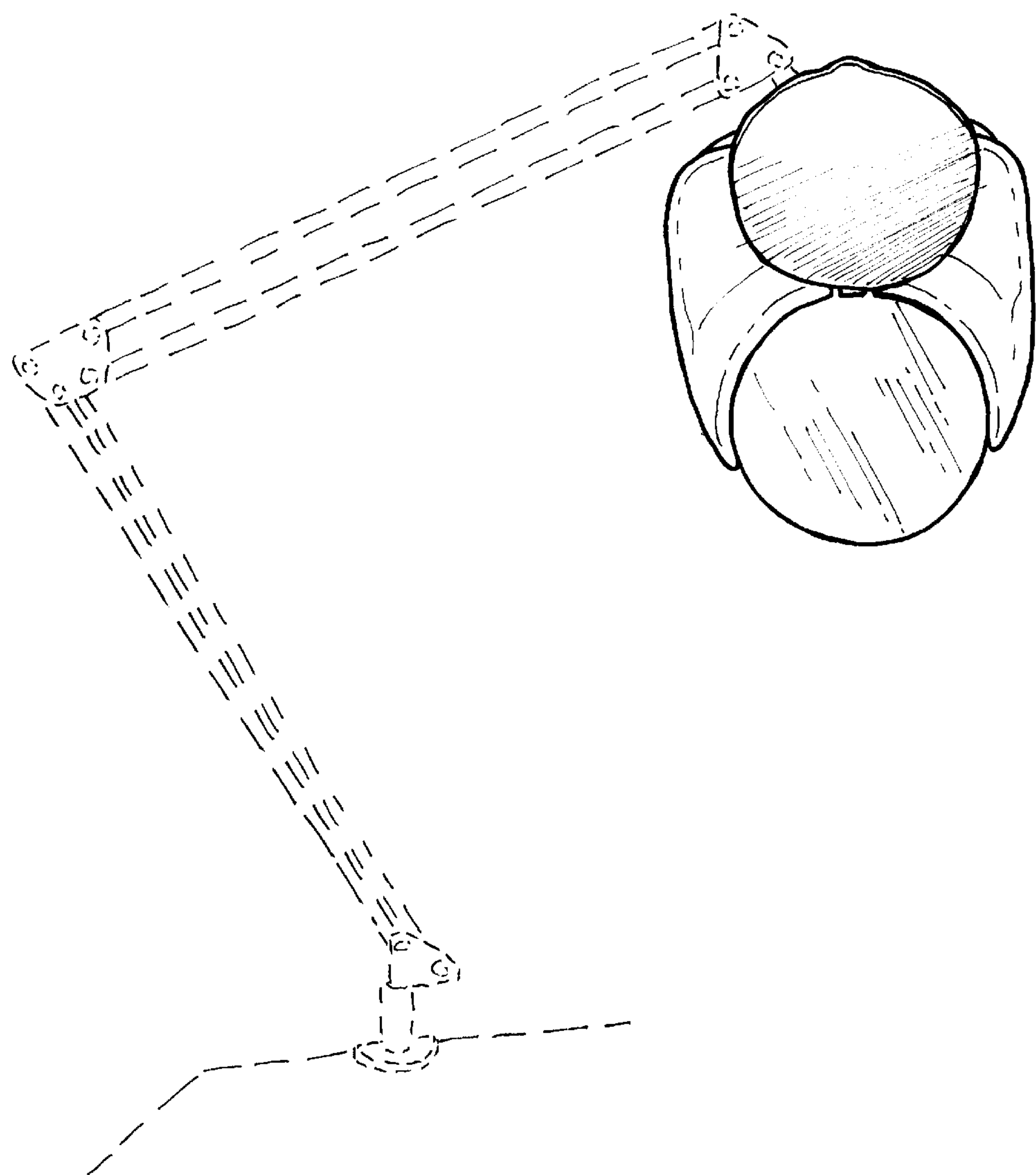

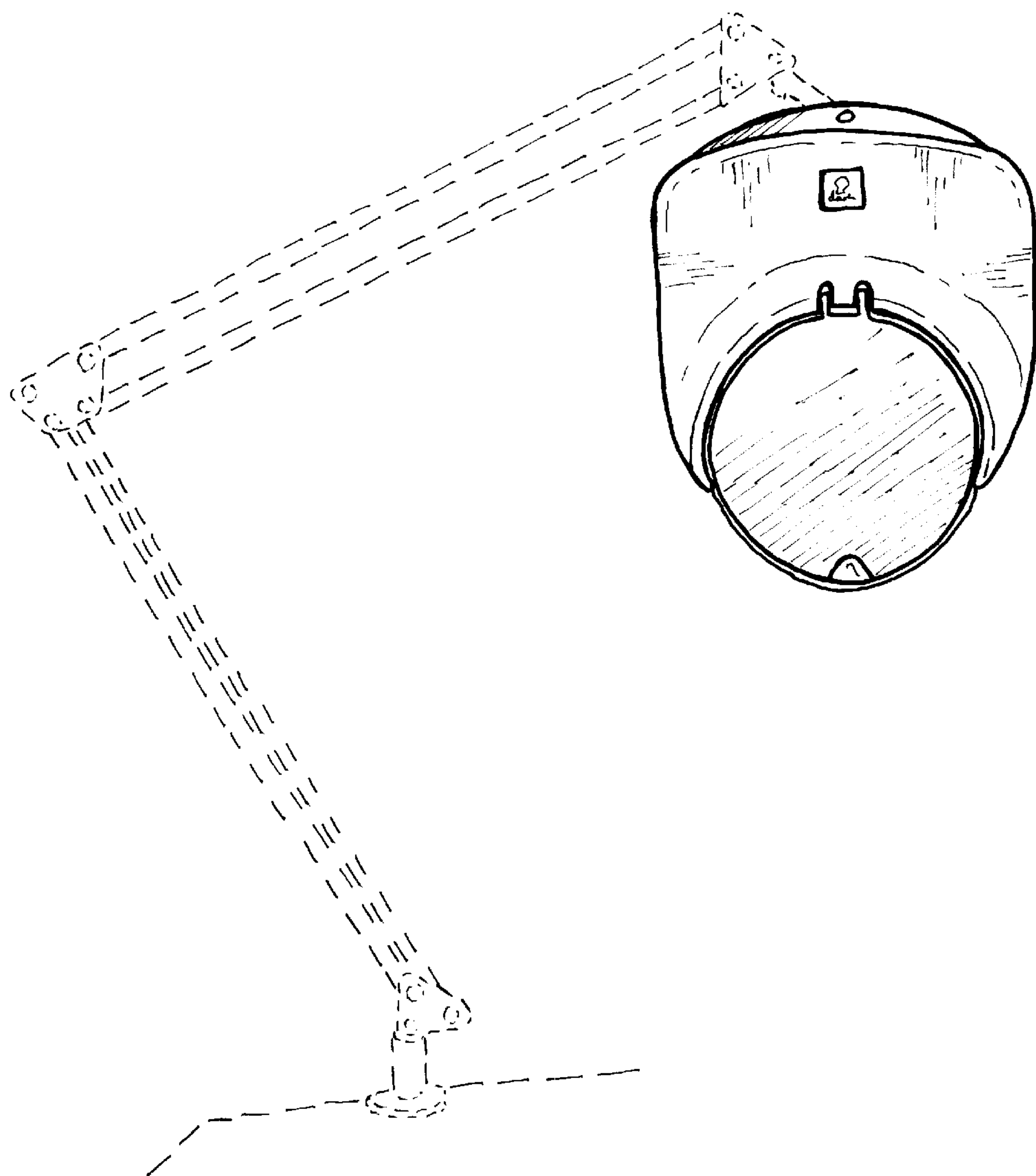
