**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an annular step light;

FIG. 2 is a right hand elevational view of the annular step light;

FIG. 3 is a left hand elevational view of the annular step lights;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the annular step light;

FIG. 5 is a rearward view of the annular step light;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the annular step light showing a second embodiment of the design, the sole difference being a substantially cross shaped member across the front thereof;


FIG. 7 is a right hand elevational view of the annular step light showing a second embodiment of the design, the sole difference being a substantially cross shaped member across the front thereof;

FIG. 8 is a left hand elevational of the annular step light showing a second embodiment of the design, the sole difference being a substantially cross shaped member across the front thereof;

FIG. 9 is a top perspective view of the annular step light showing a second embodiment of the design, the sole difference being a substantially cross shaped member across the front thereof; and,

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of the annular step light showing a second embodiment of the design, the sole difference being a substantially cross shaped member across the front thereof.




















