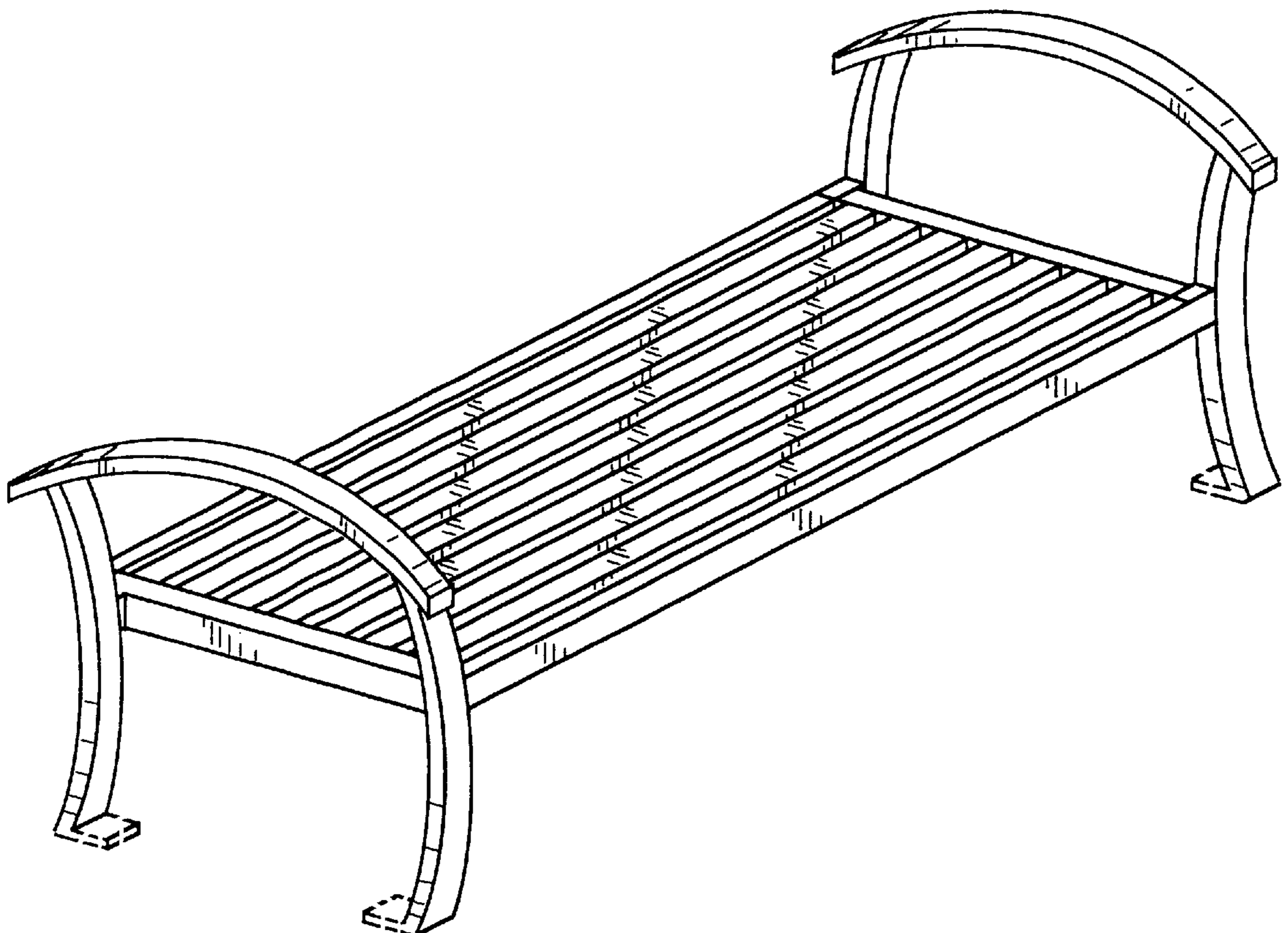
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of site furniture in the form of a bench showing our new design;

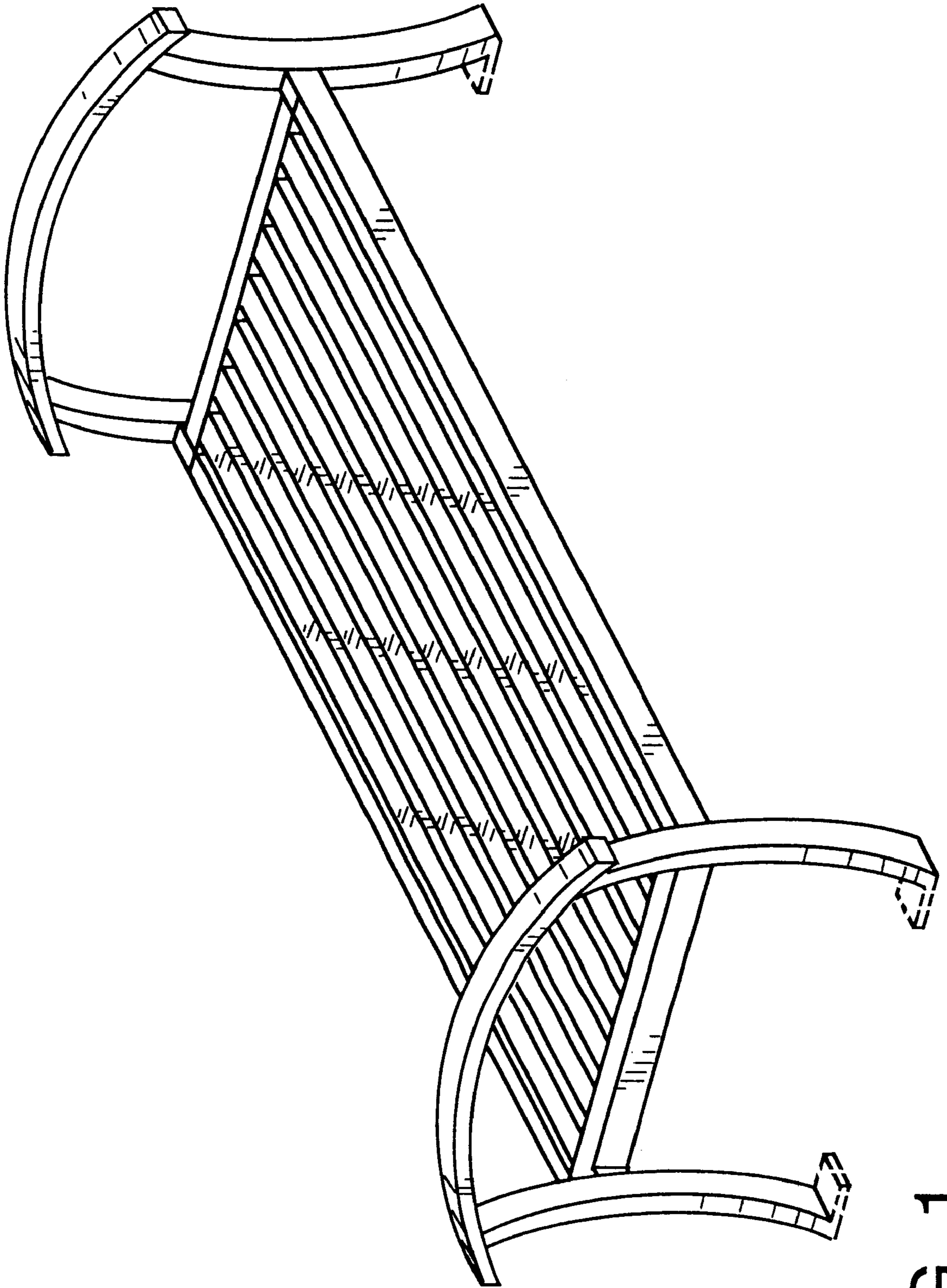

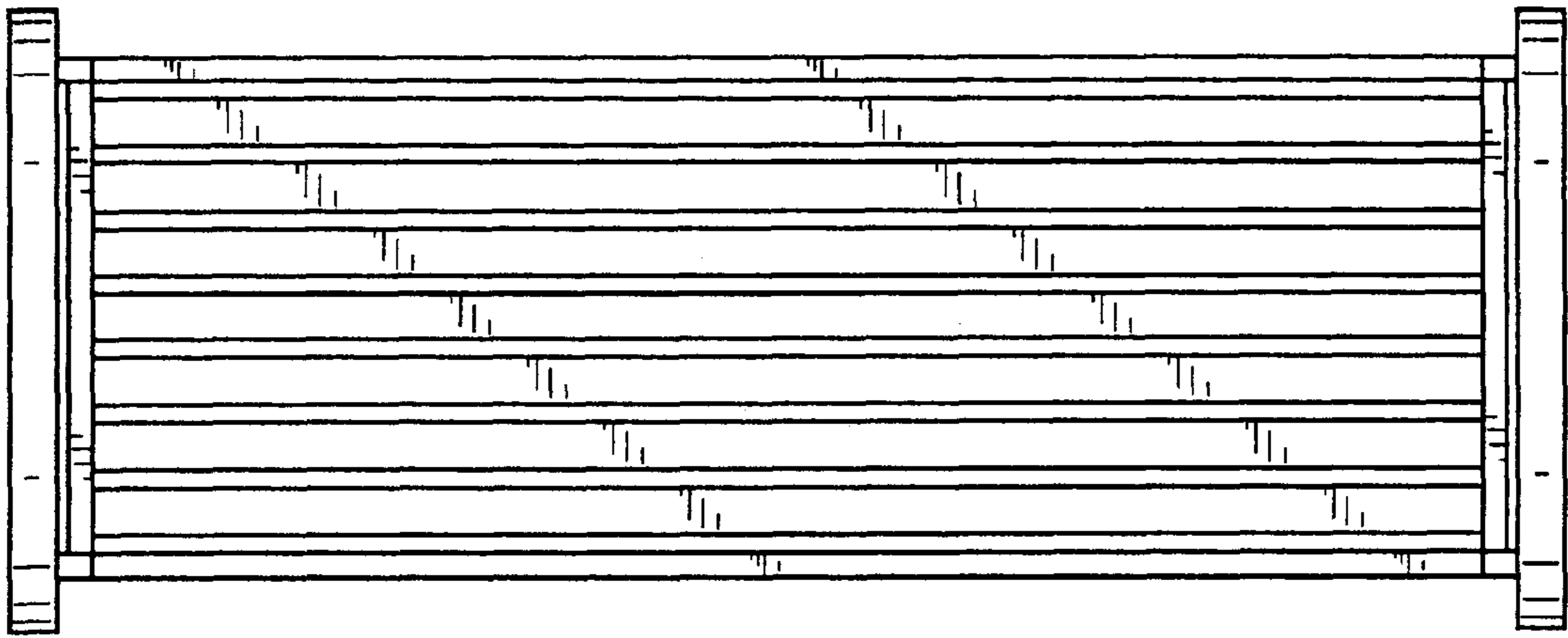

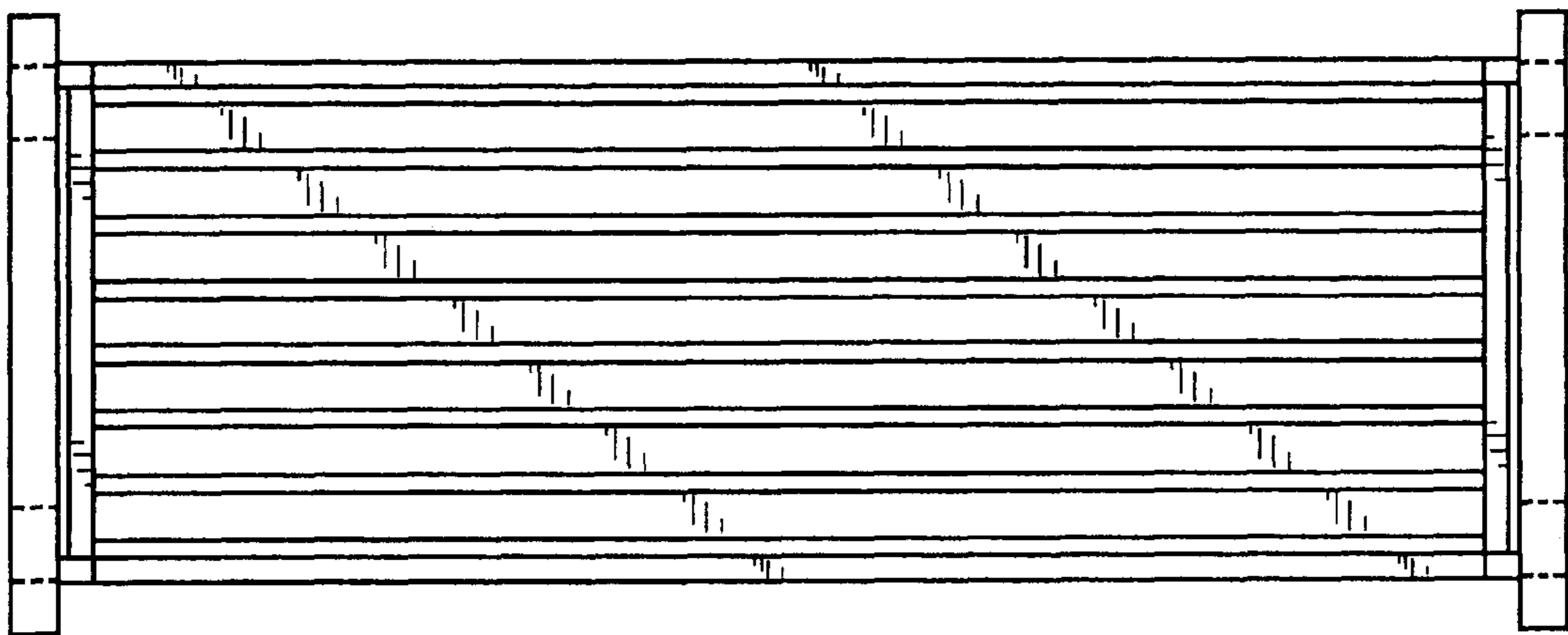

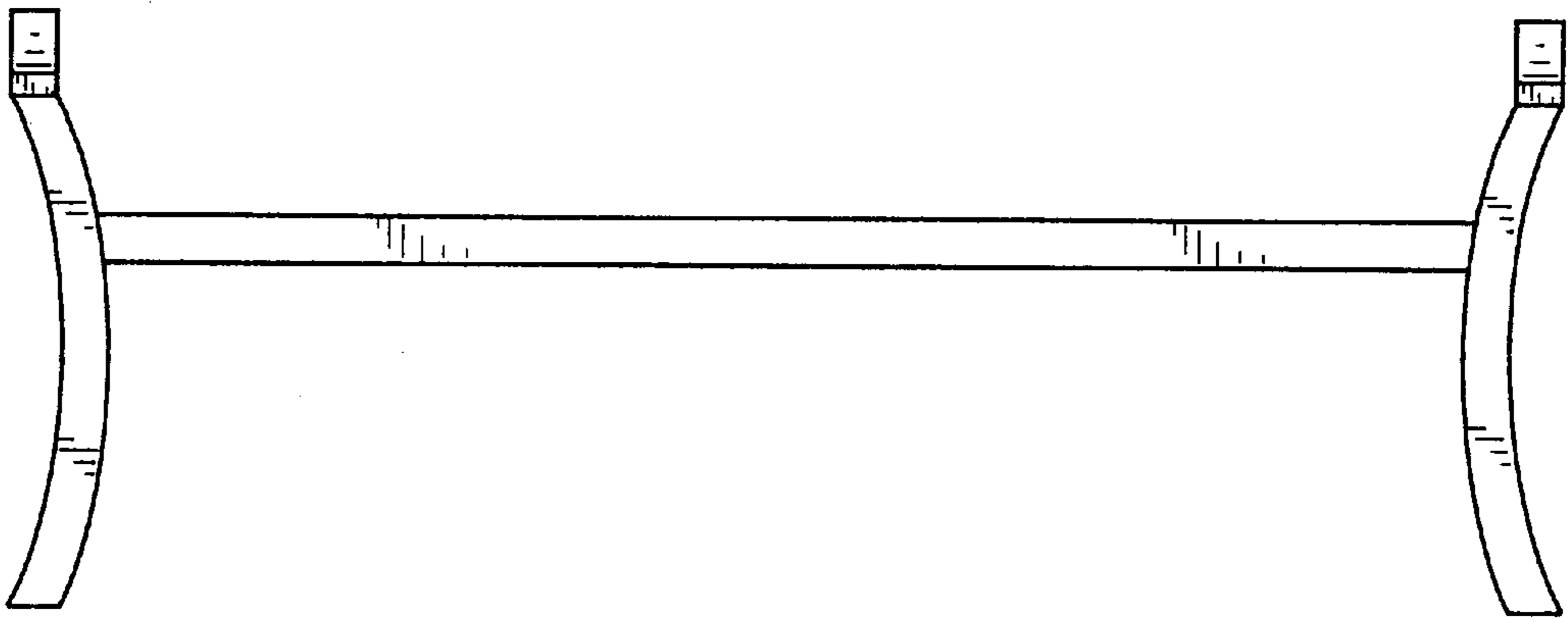

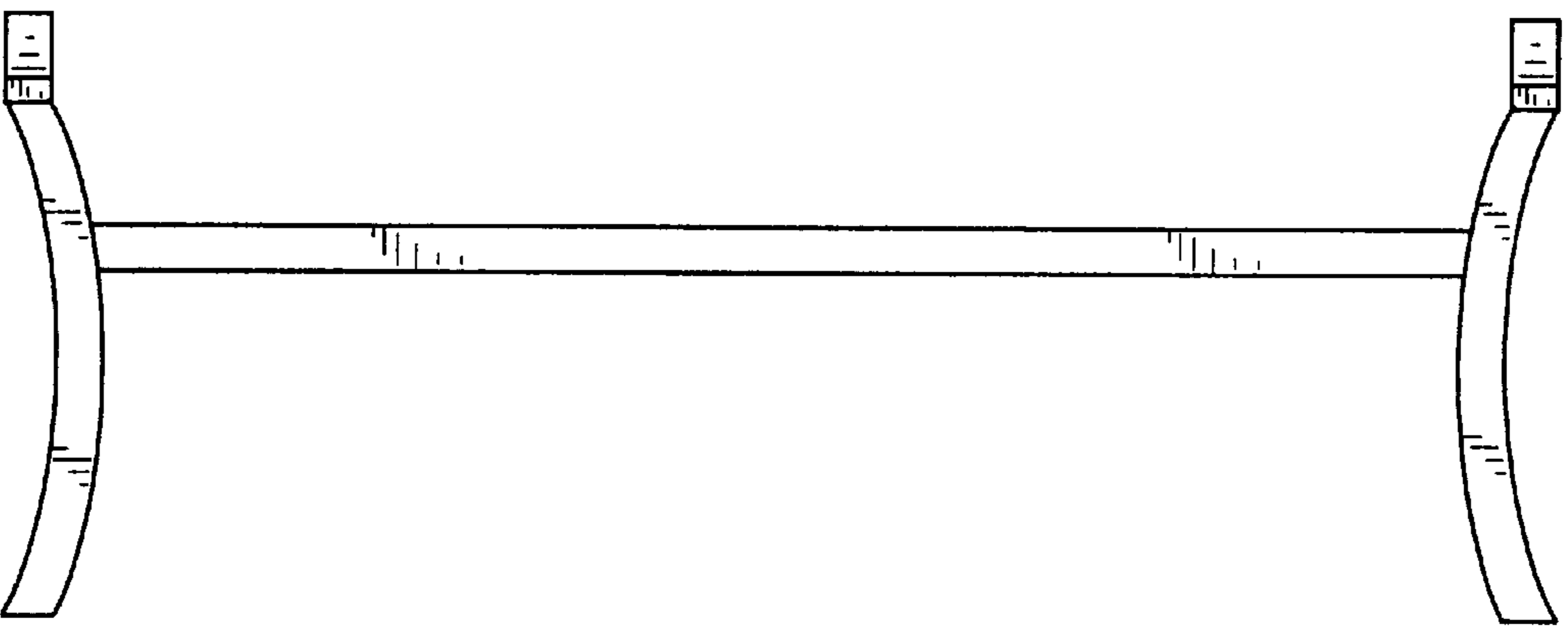

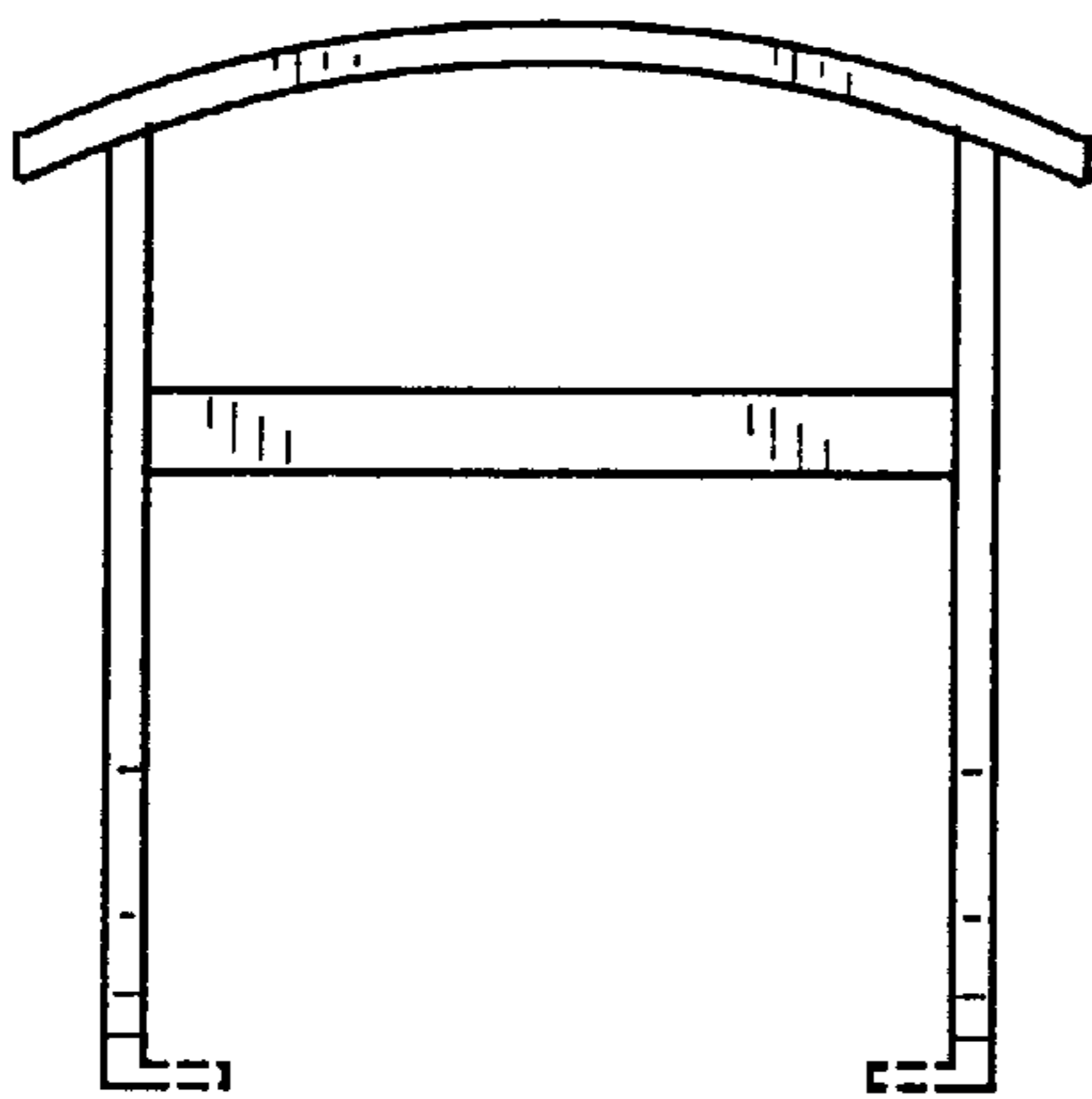

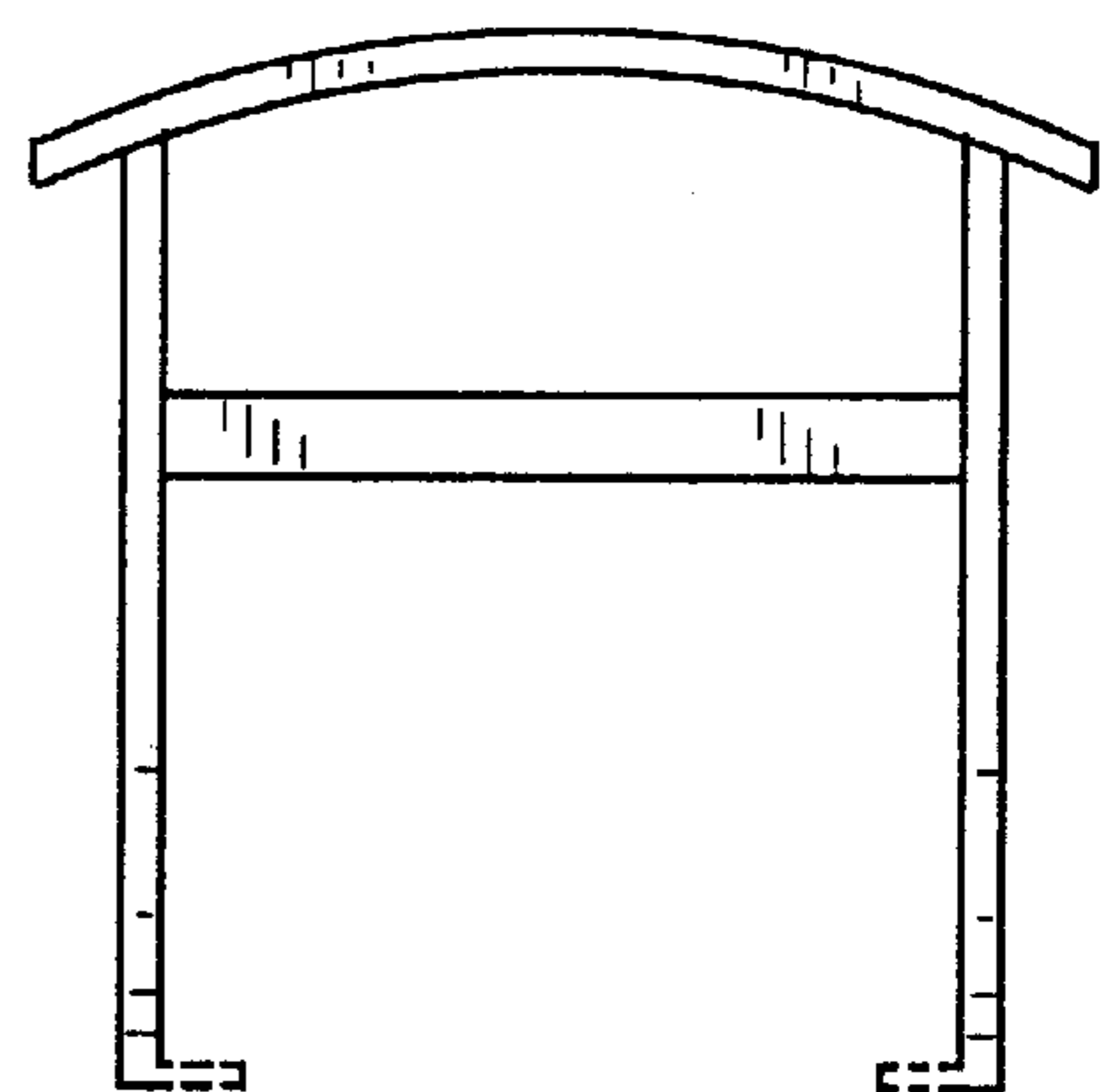
