(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for medication container having timer, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a first embodiment of a medication container having timer, embodying our new design, the portions shown in broken lines forming no part of the design sought to be patented;

FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a left end elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right end elevation view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a medication container having timer, the portion shown in broken lines forming no part of the design sought to be patented;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the design shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view of the design shown in FIG. 7;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view of the design depicted in FIG. 7;

FIG. 11 is a left end elevational view of the design depicted in FIG. 7; and,

FIG. 12 is a right end elevational view of the design depicted in FIG. 7.

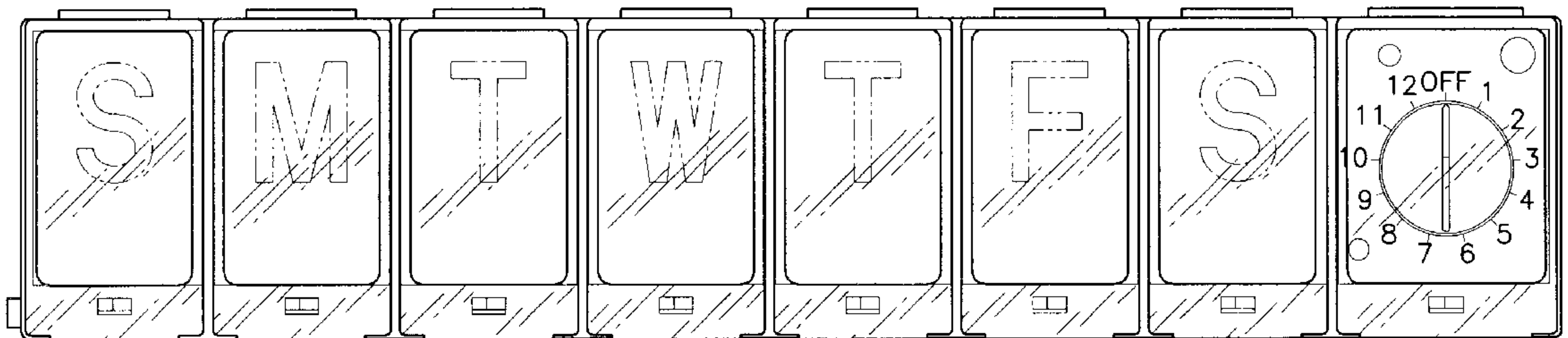

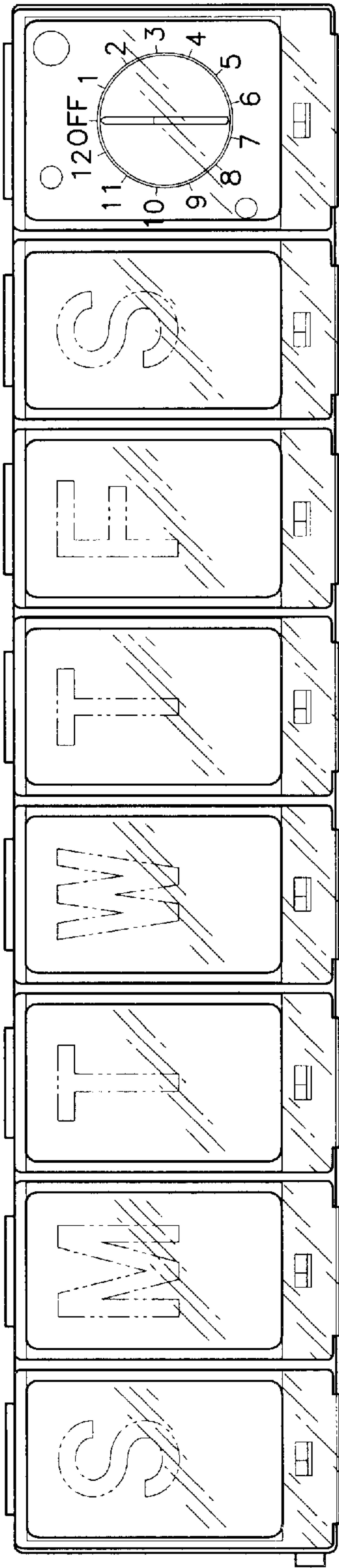

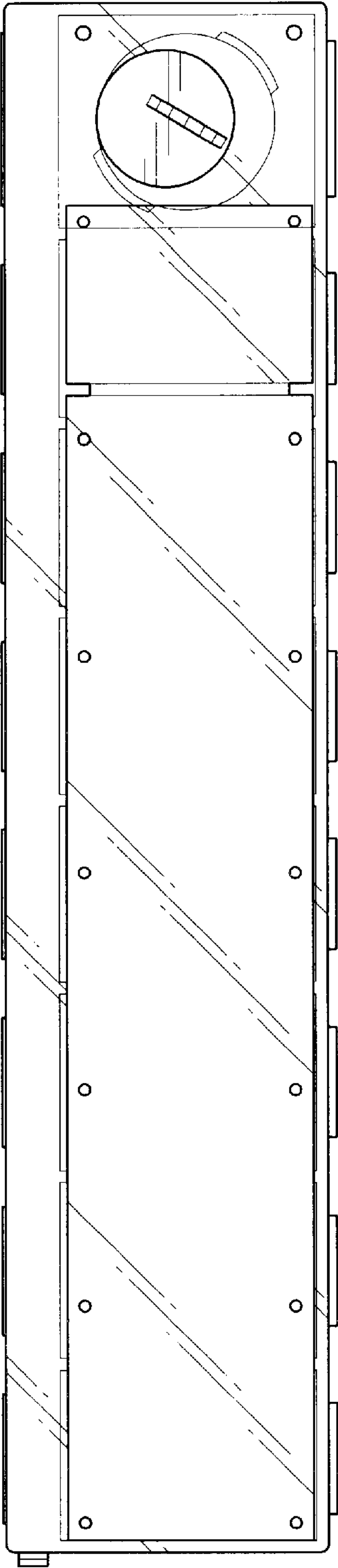

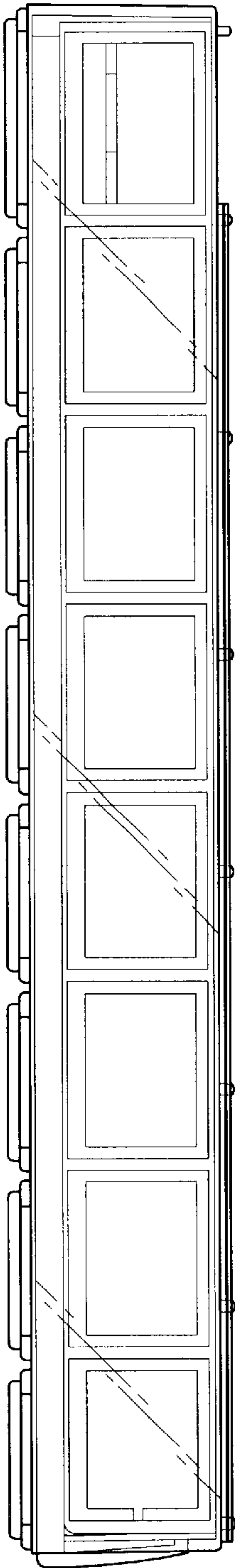

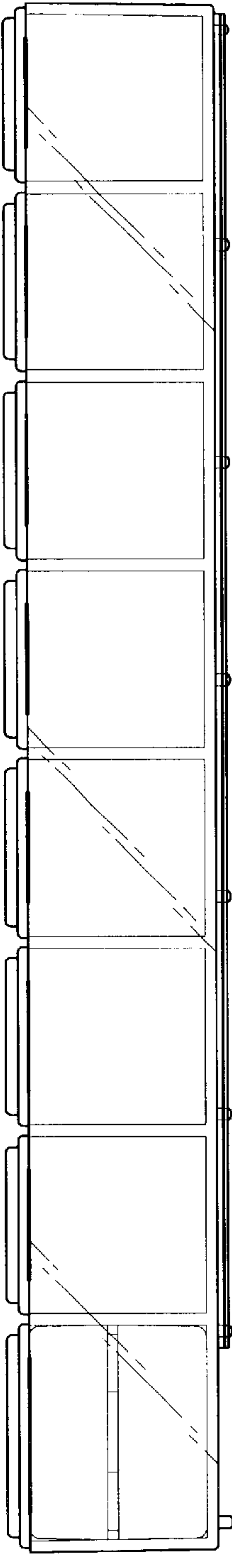

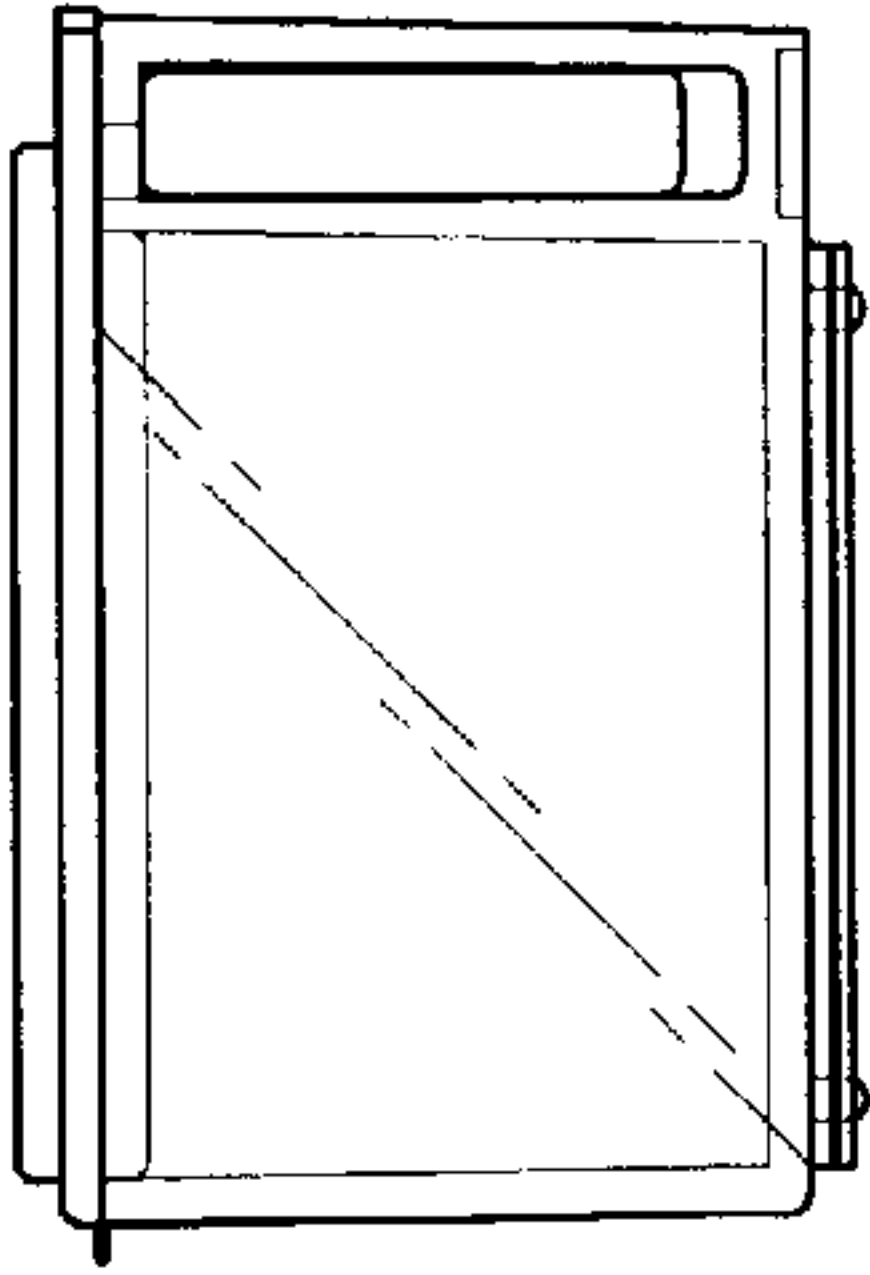

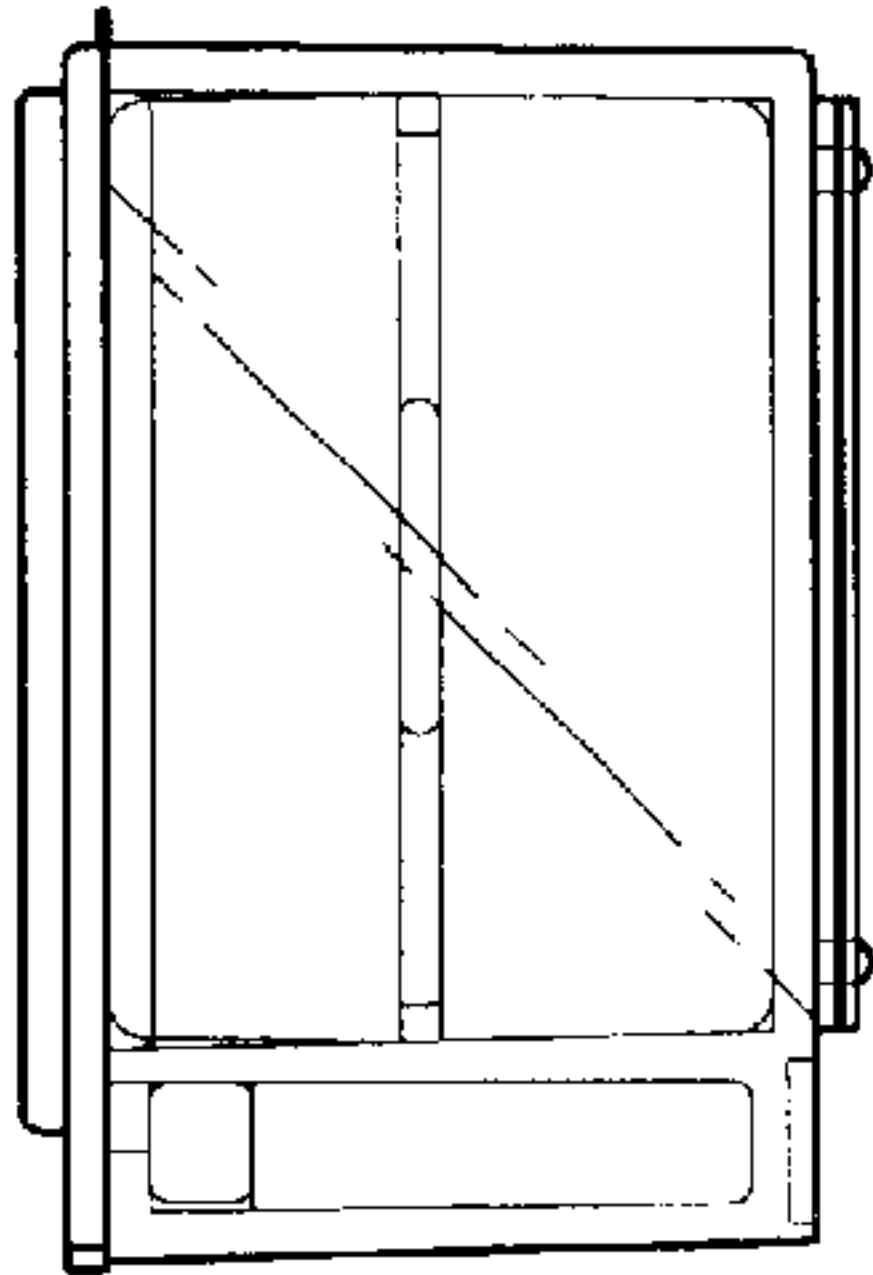

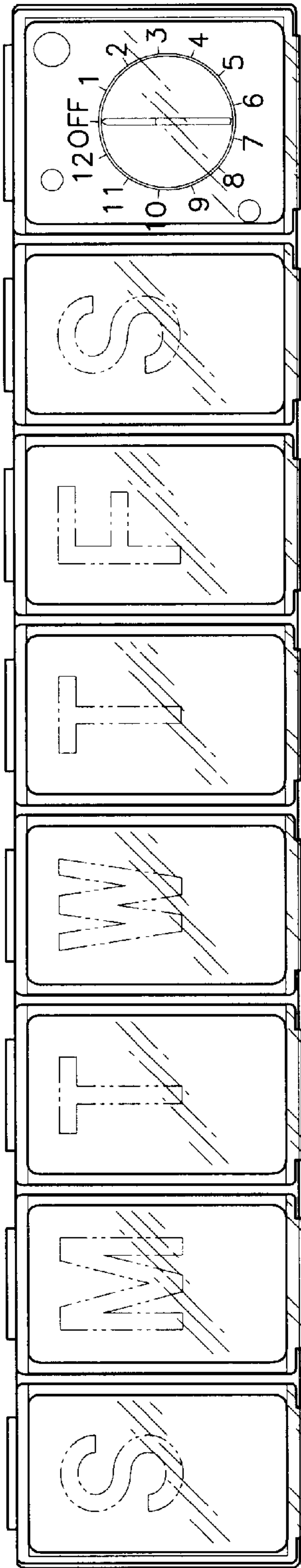

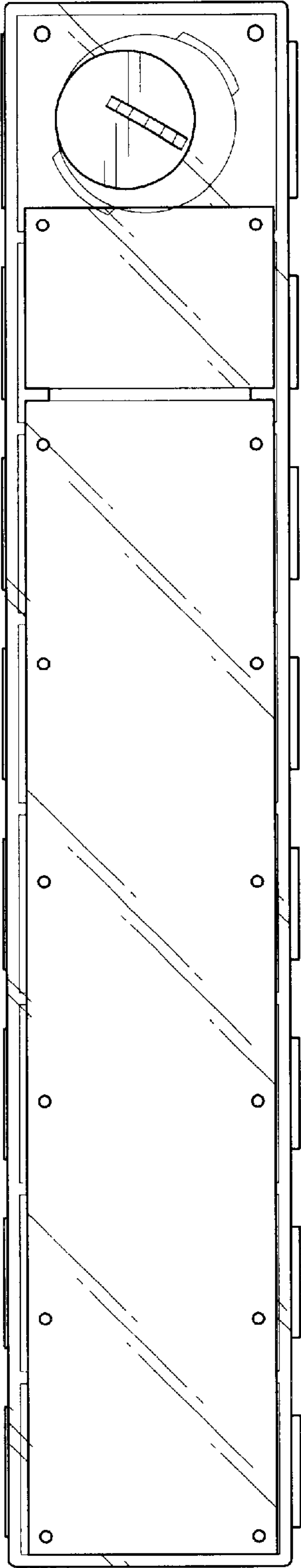

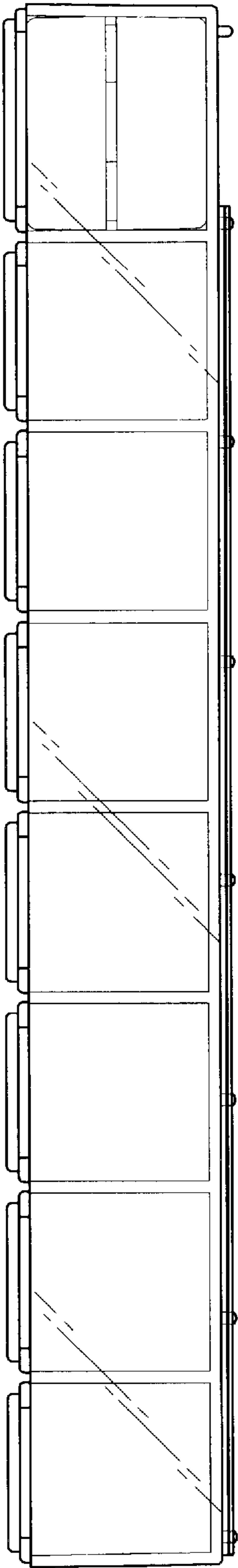

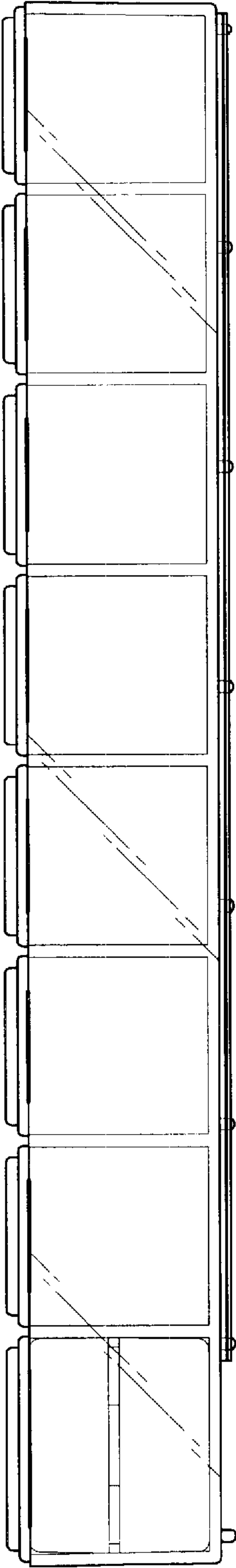

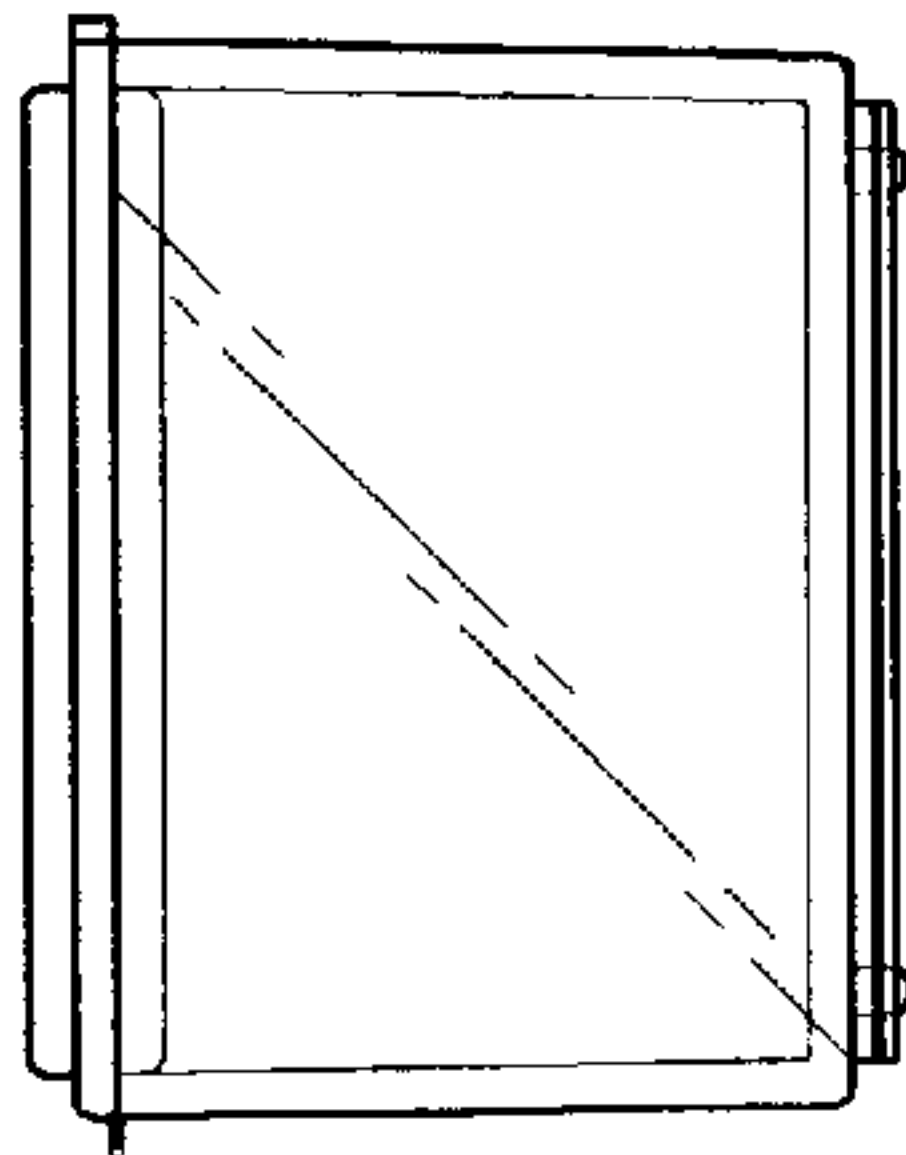
