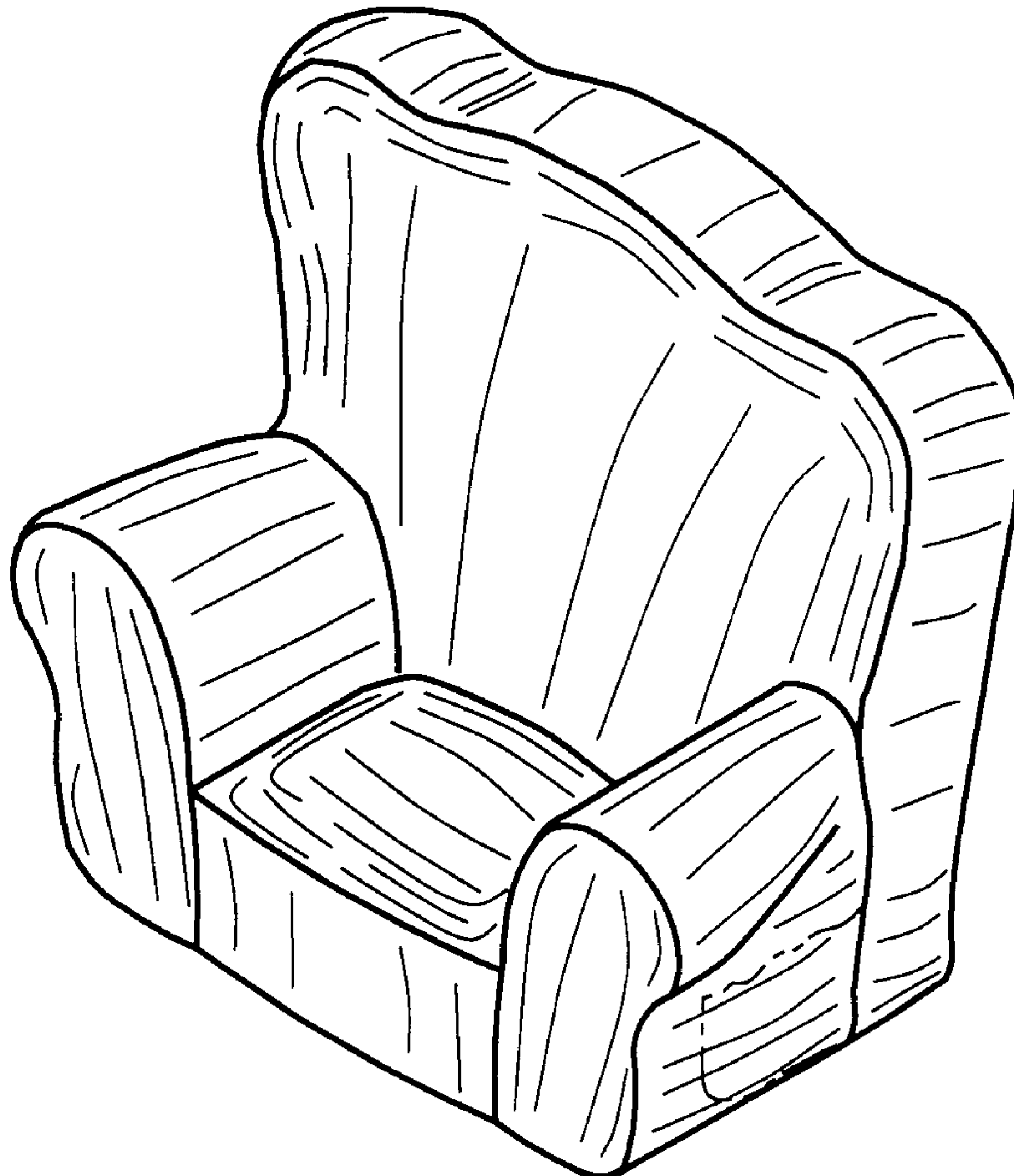
The ornamental design for a toy chair, as shown and

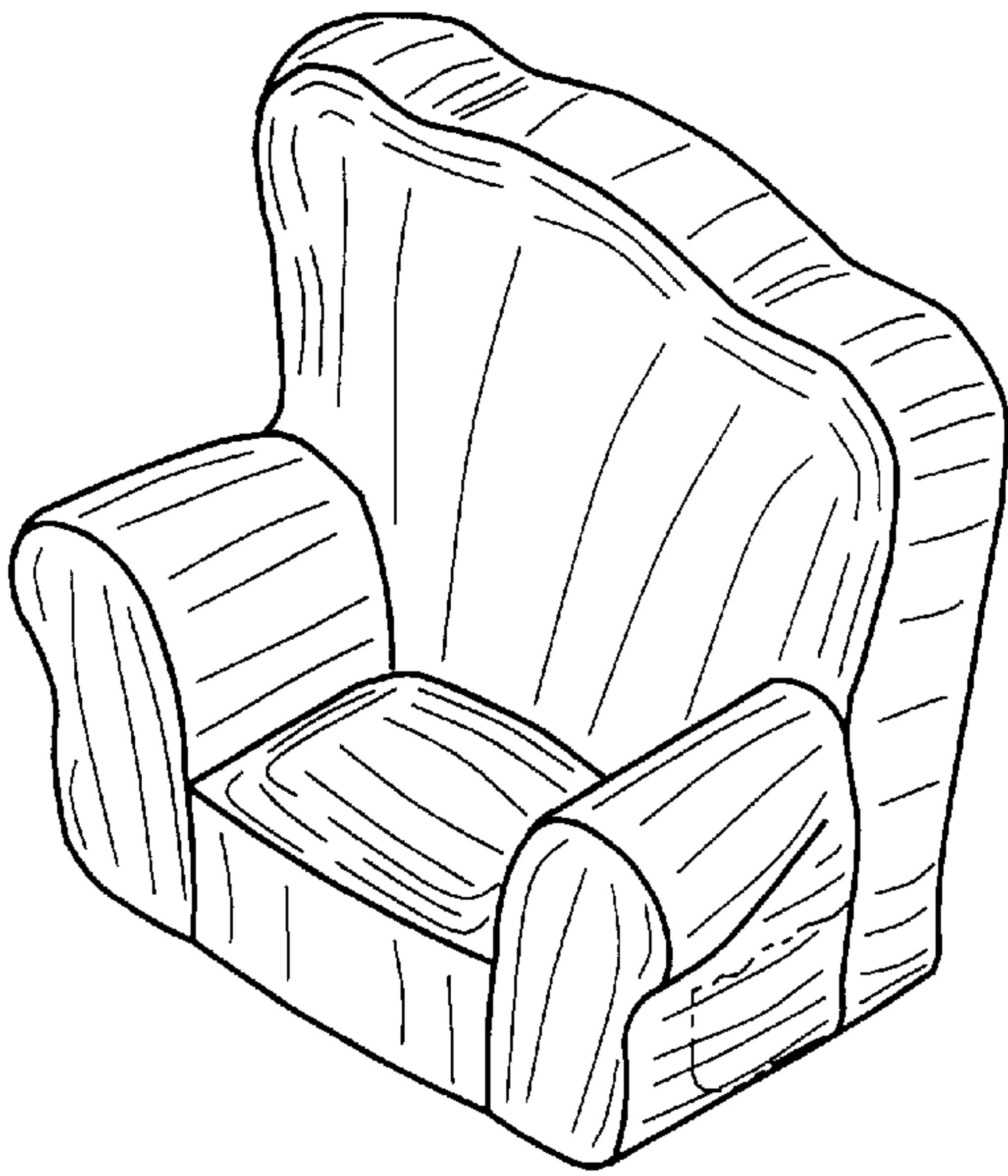

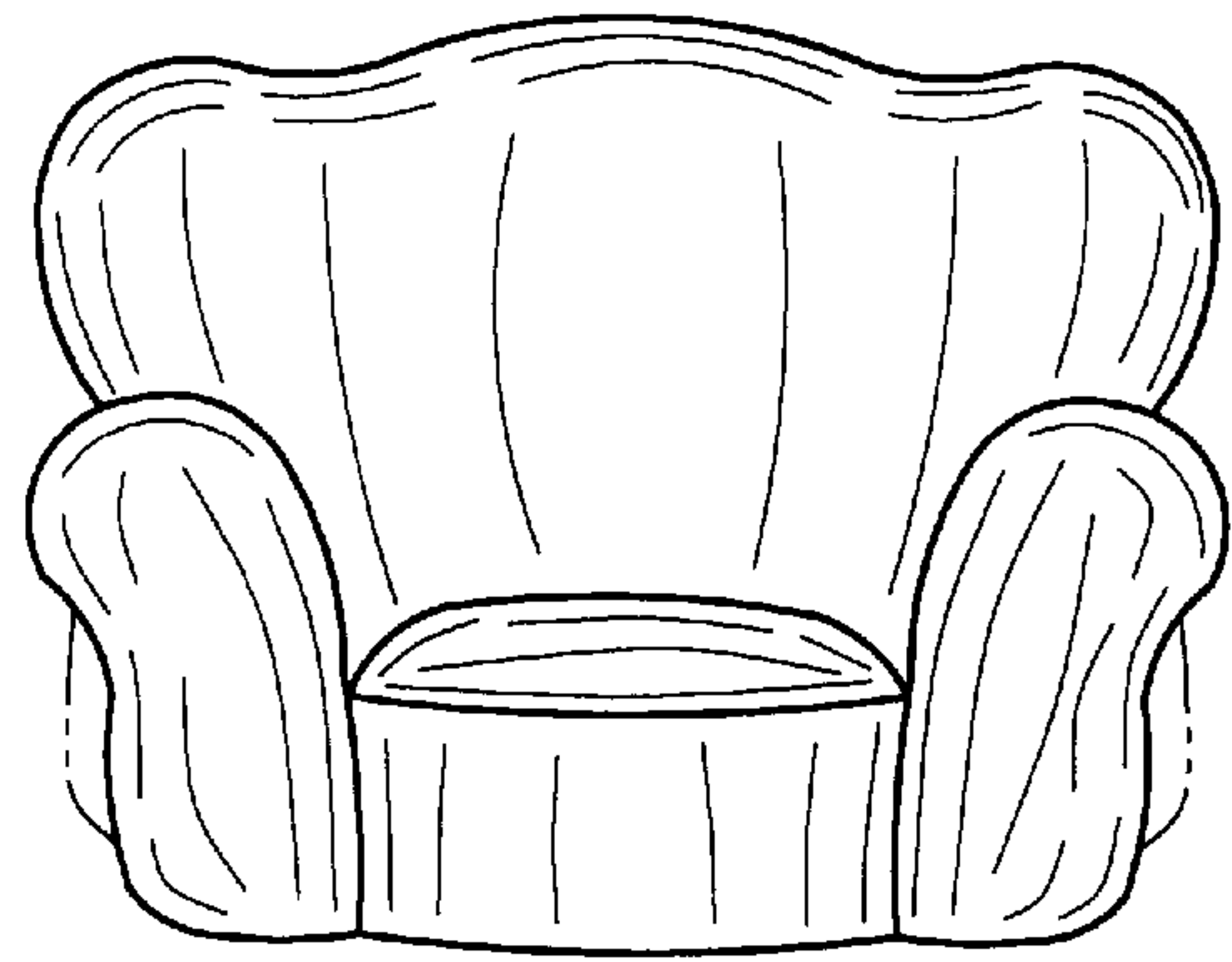

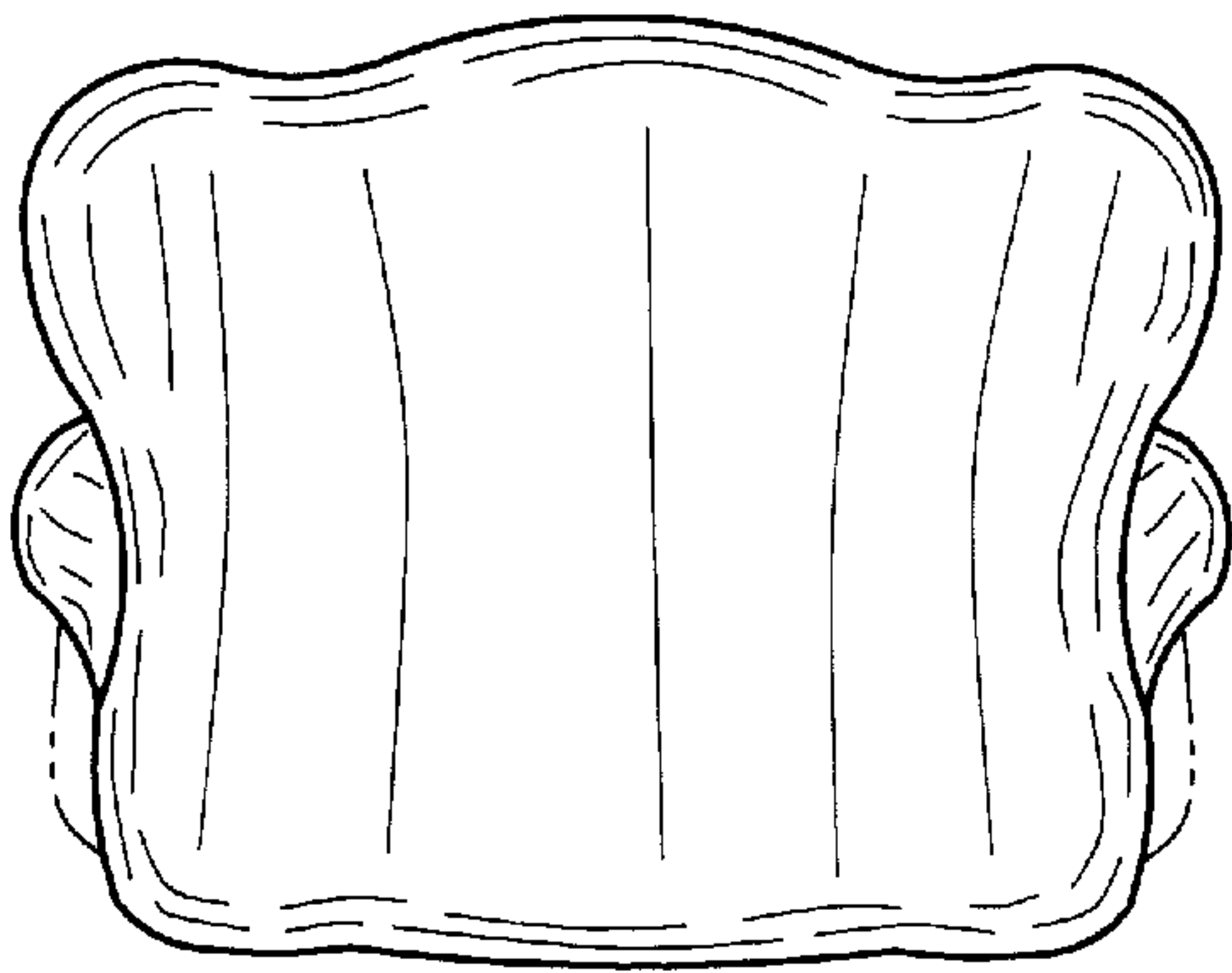

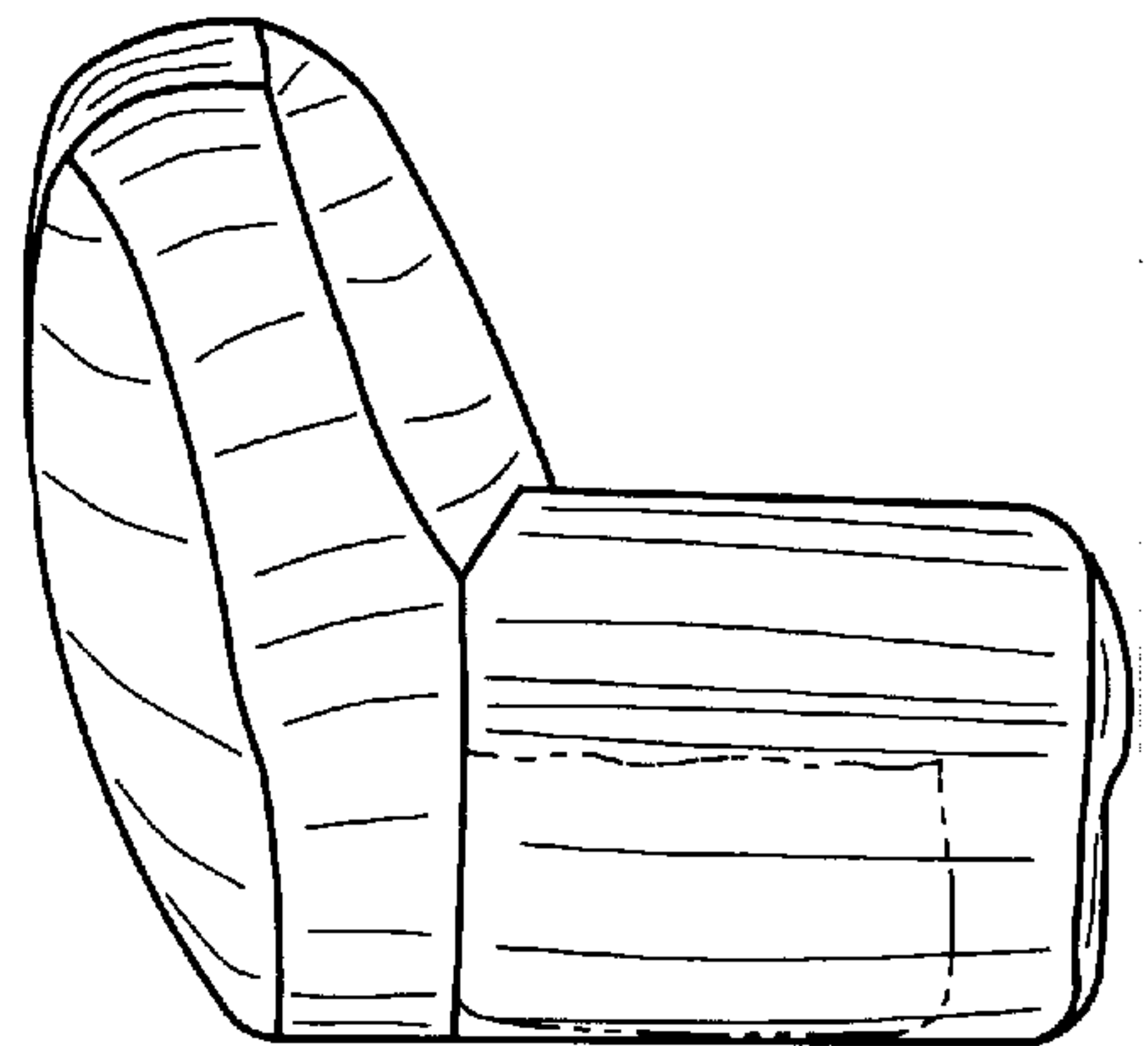

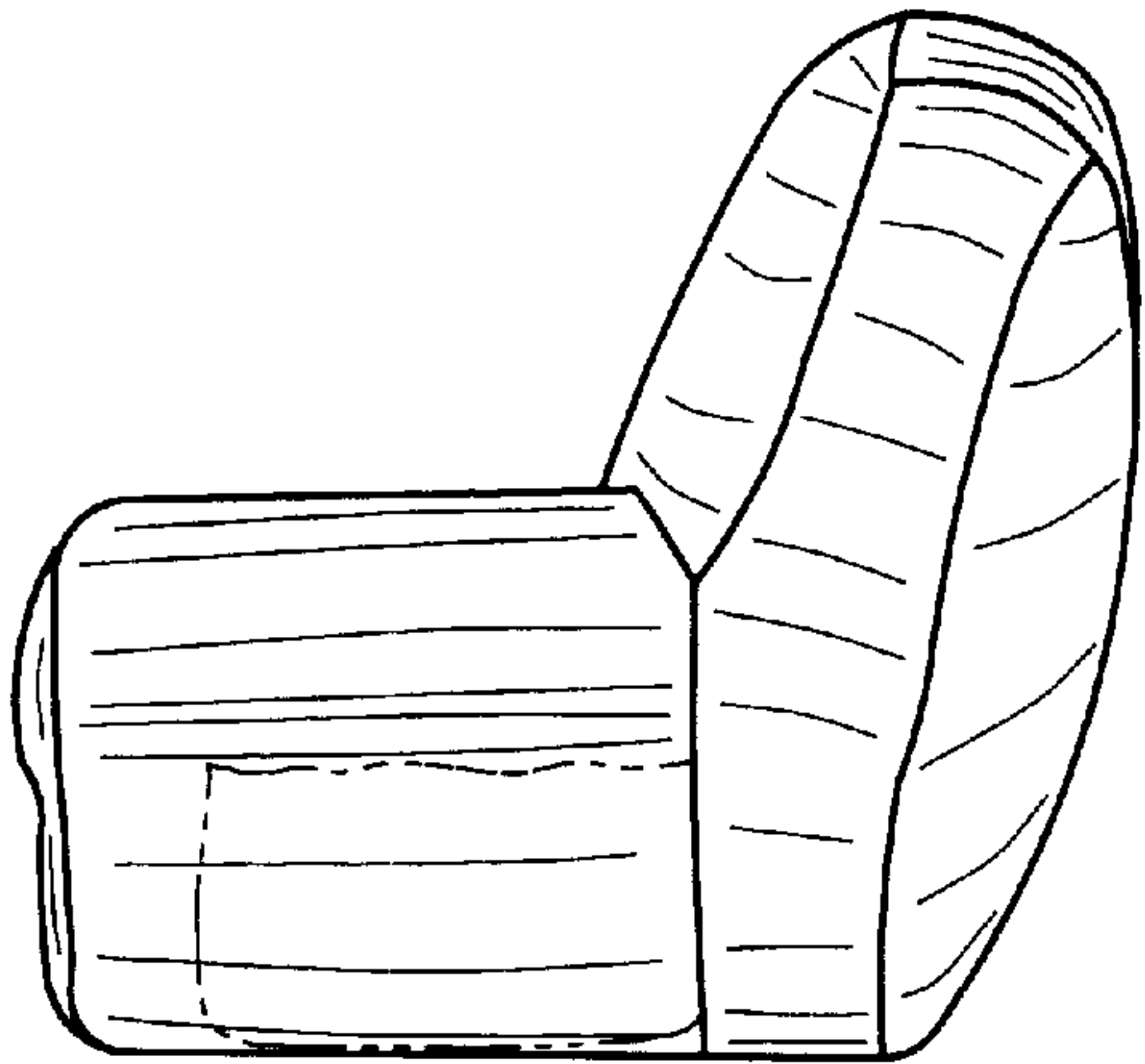

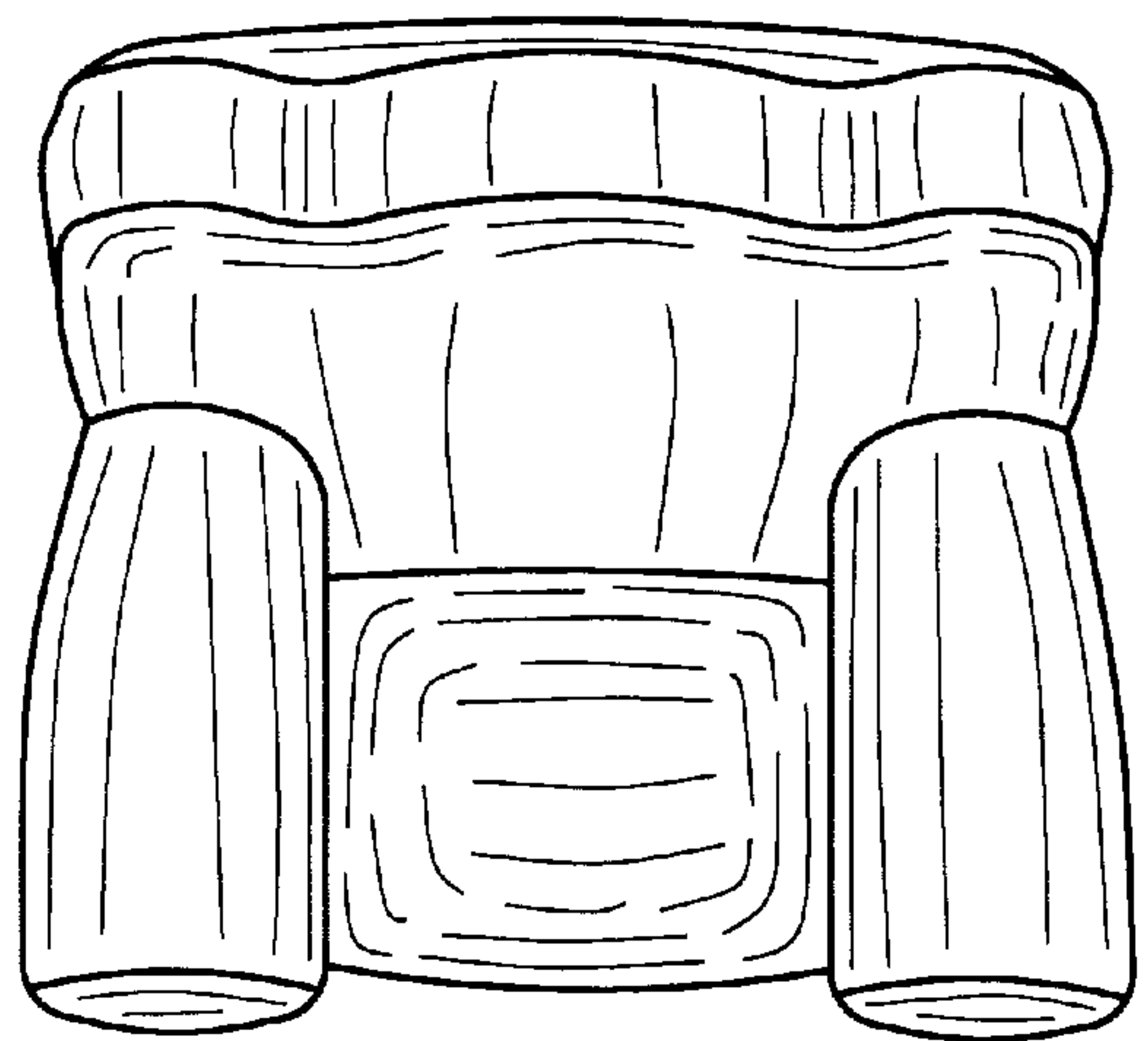

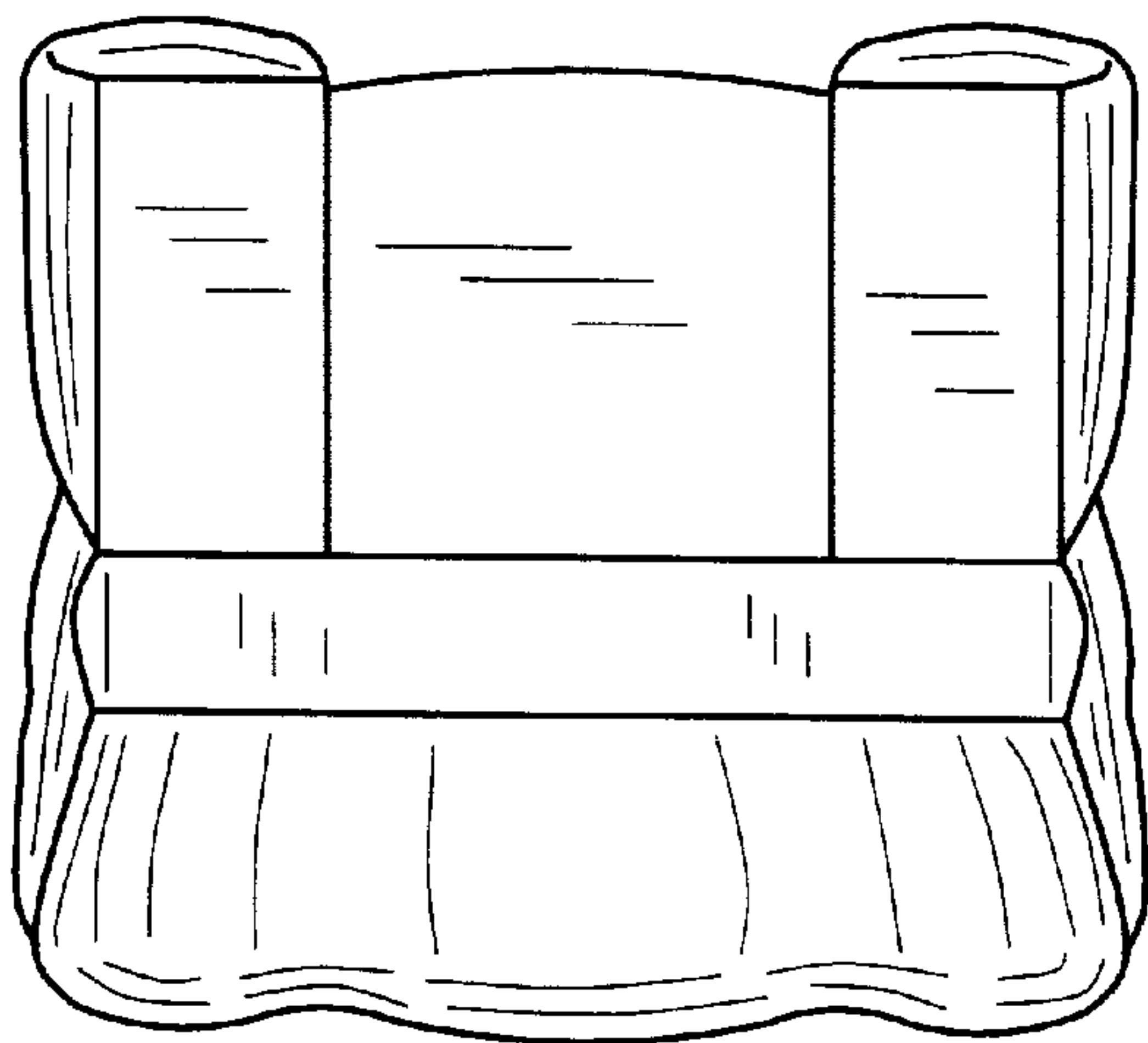
