(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a feeding bowl, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a feeding bowl showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevation thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view thereof, taken opposite the view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a side elevation view thereof, taken at 90° to the view of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a side elevation view thereof, taken opposite the view of FIG. 6.

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a feeding bowl showing my new design;

FIG. 9 is a side elevation thereof;

FIG. 10 is a side elevation view thereof, taken opposite the view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof;

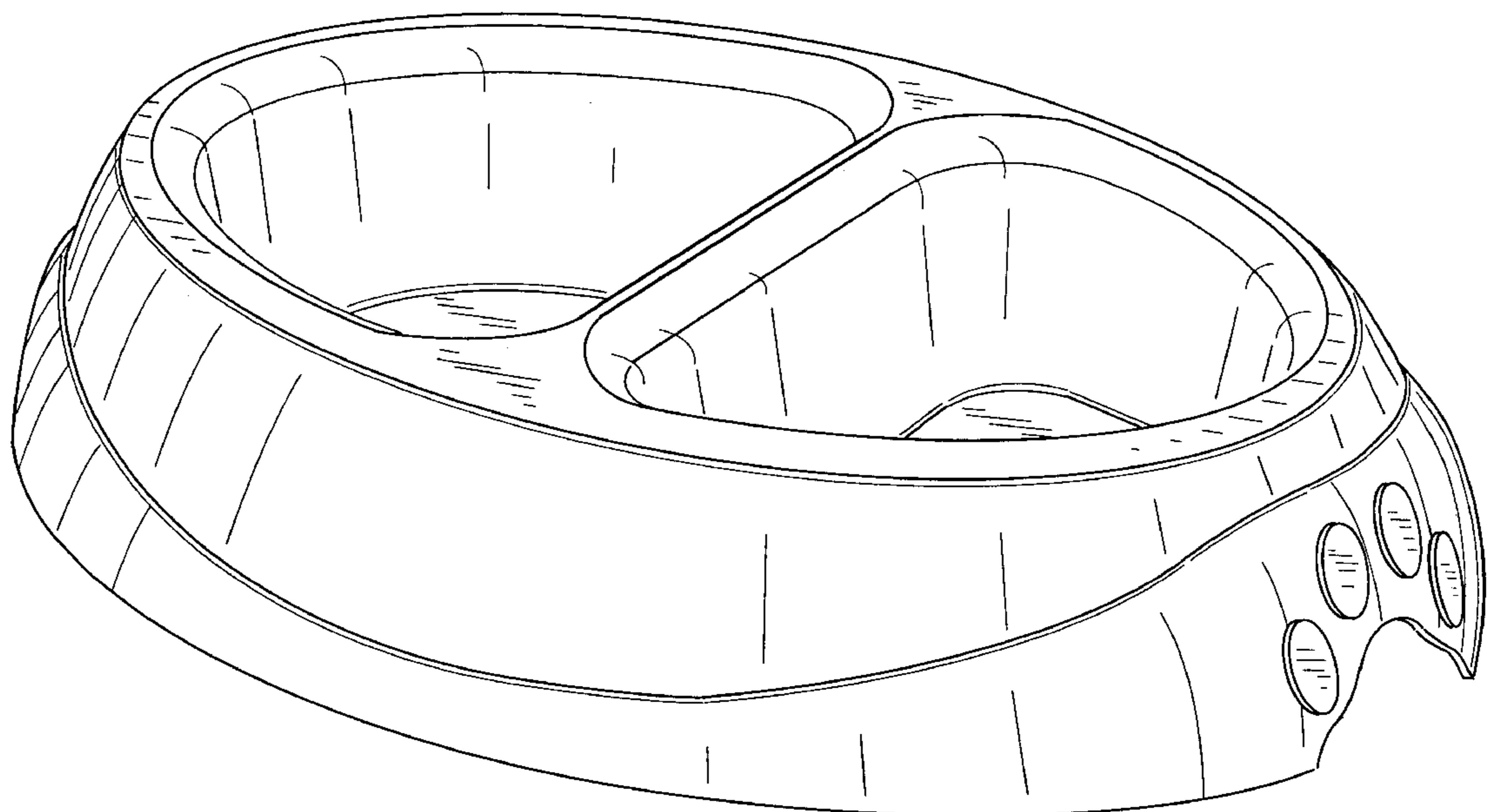
FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 13 is a side elevation view thereof, taken at 90° to the view of FIG. 9; and,

FIG. 14 is a side elevation view thereof, taken opposite the view of FIG. 13.

The random pattern on the lower portion of the side of the feeding bowl in the second embodiment is understood to extend continuously around the surface of said bowl.

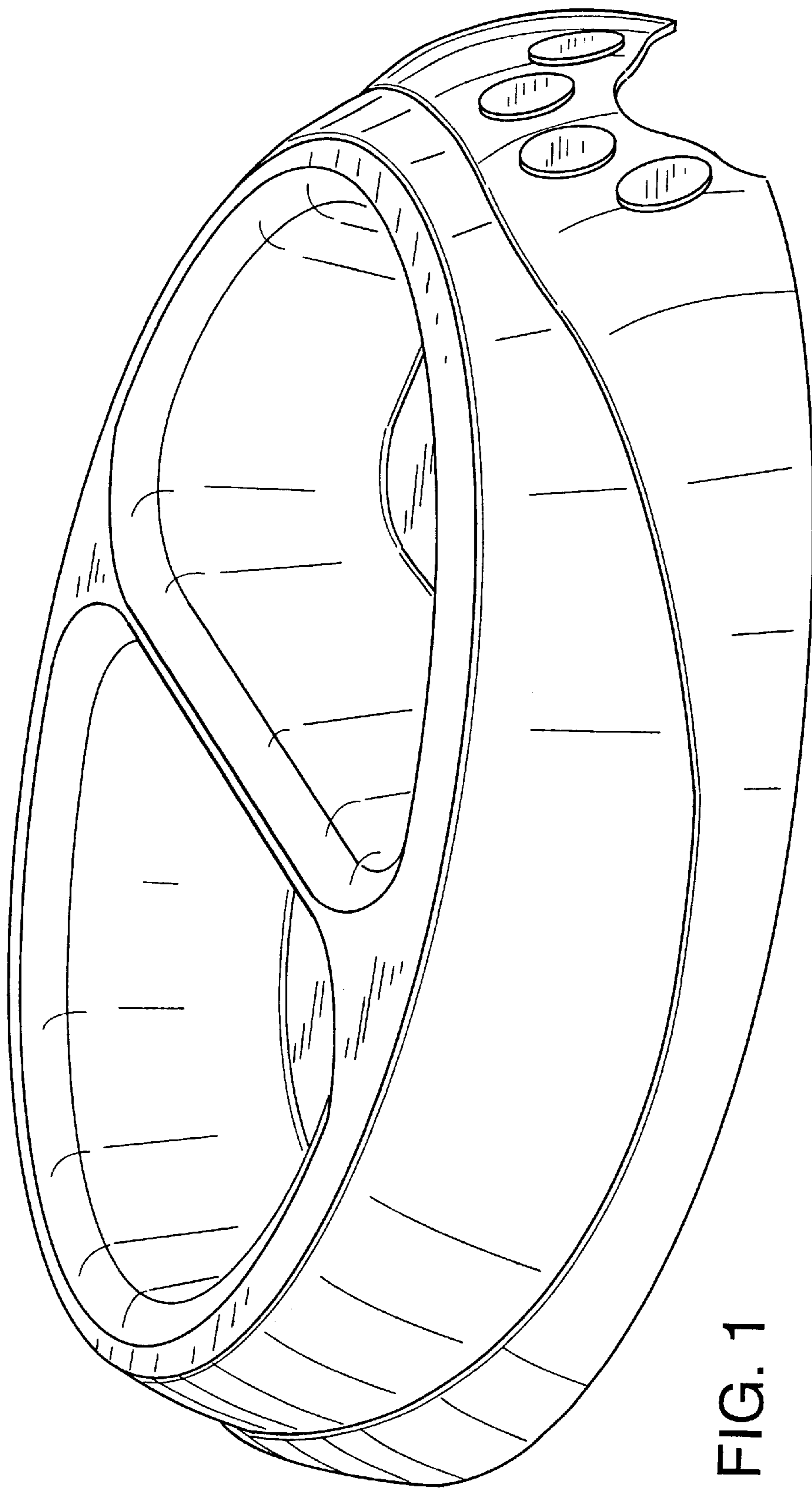

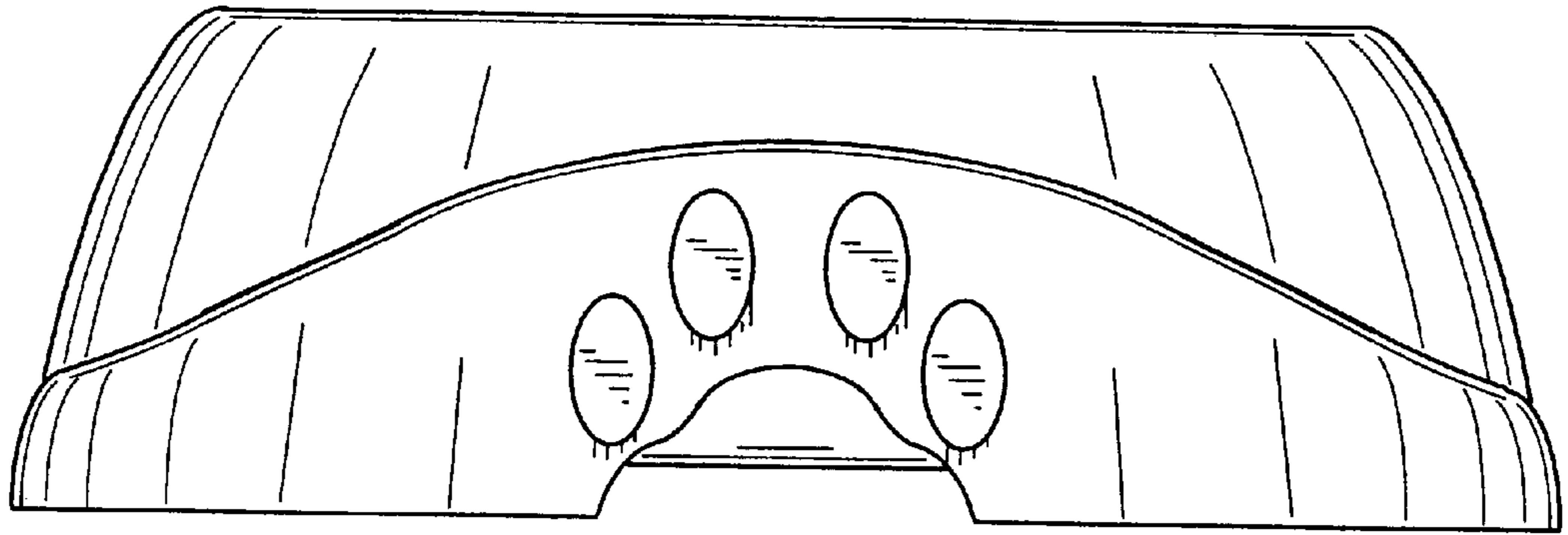

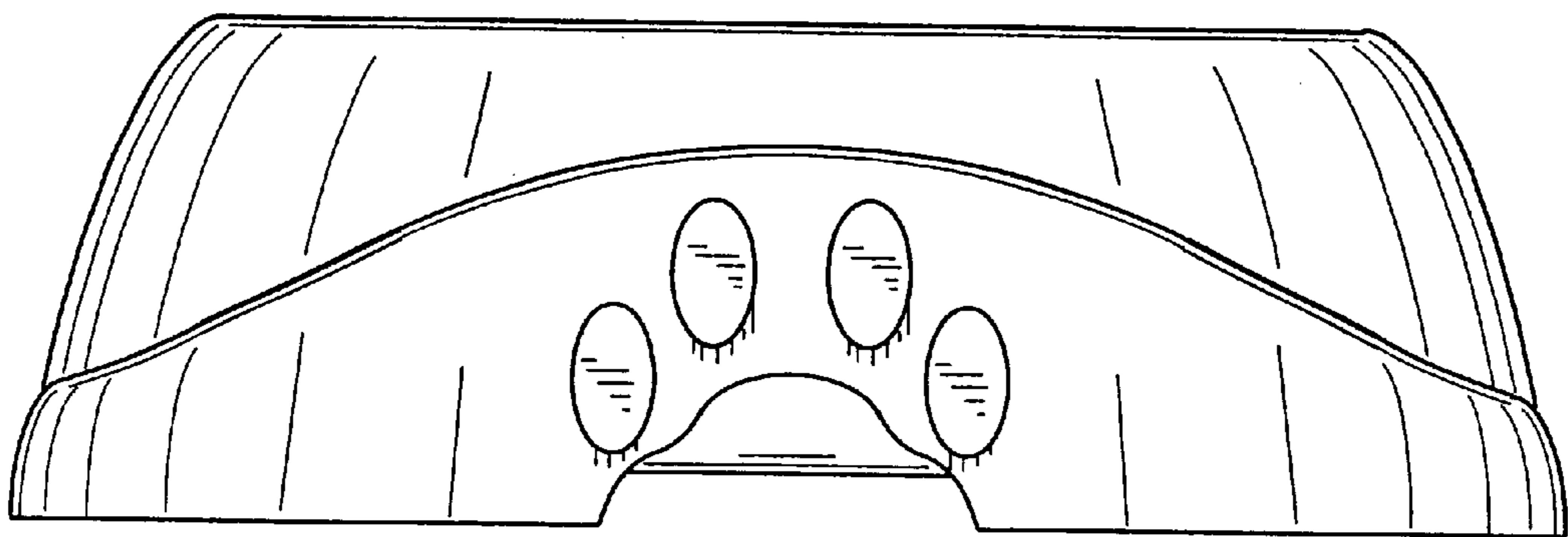

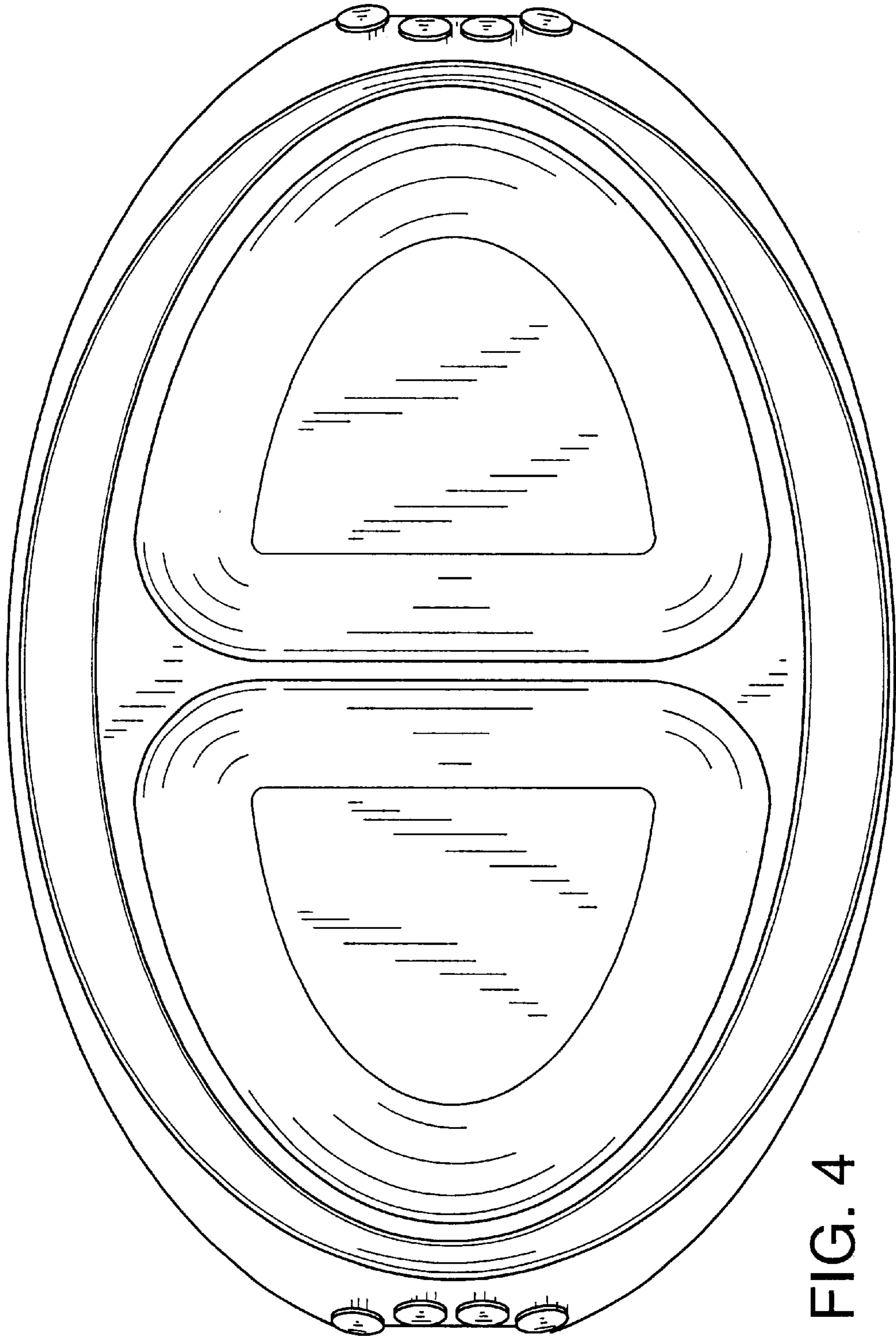

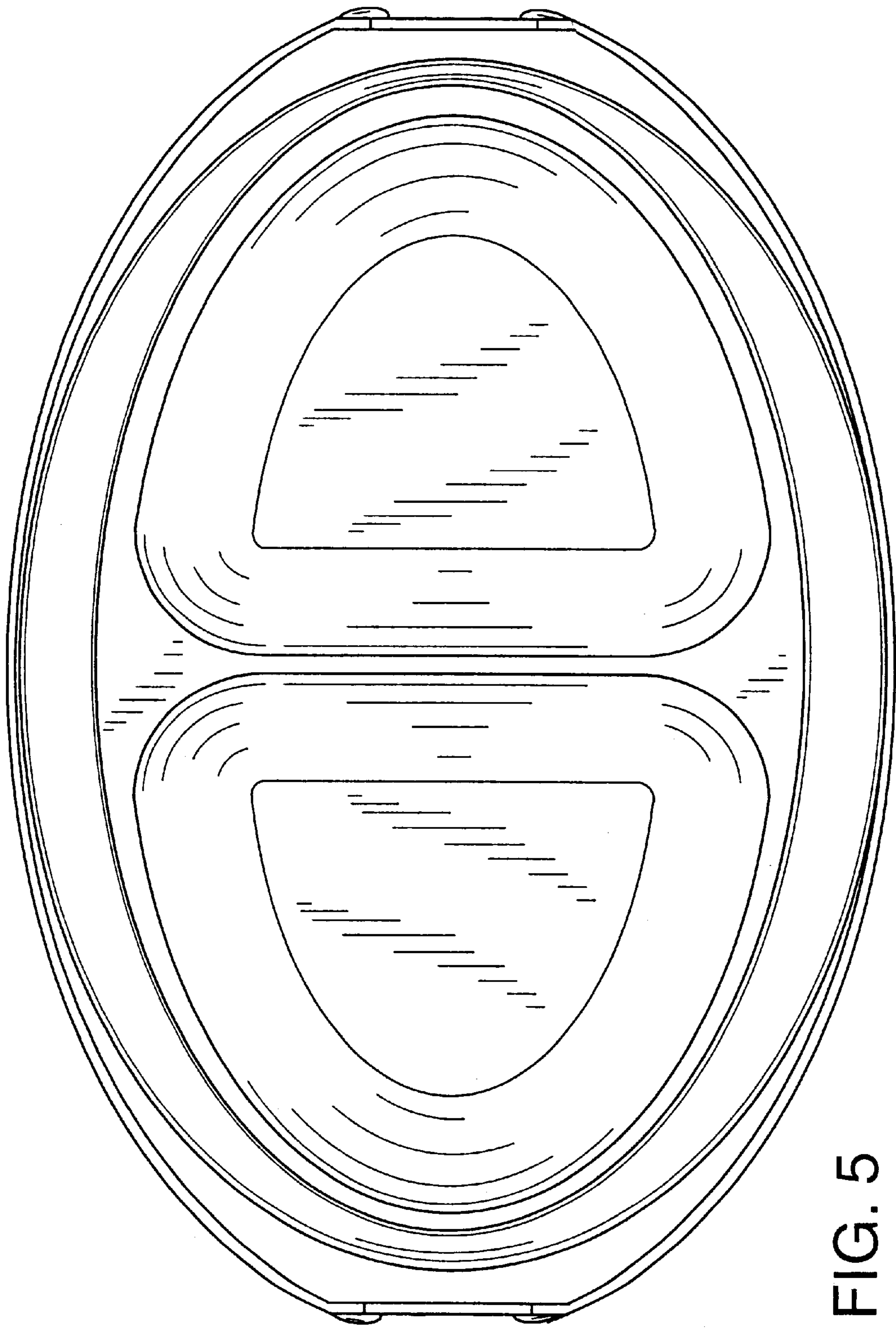

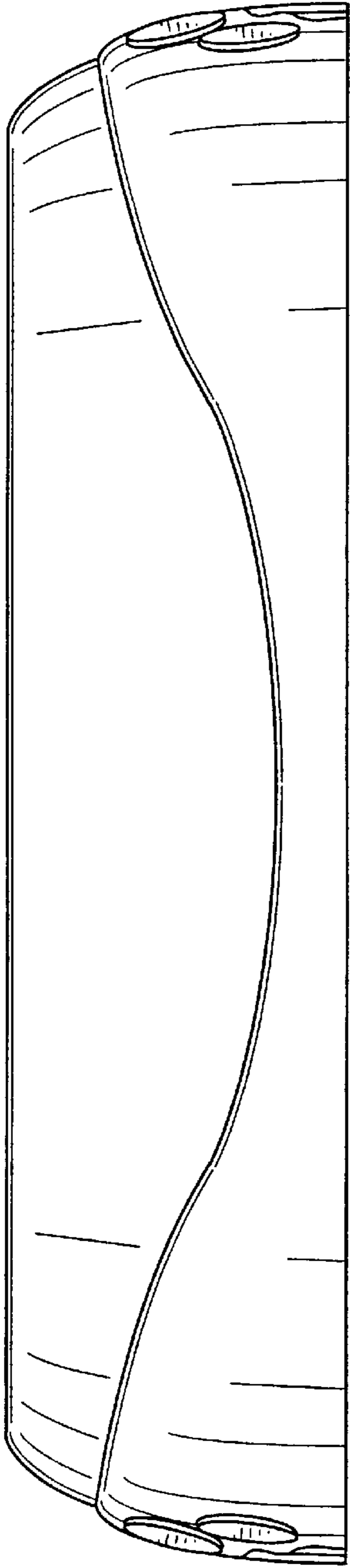

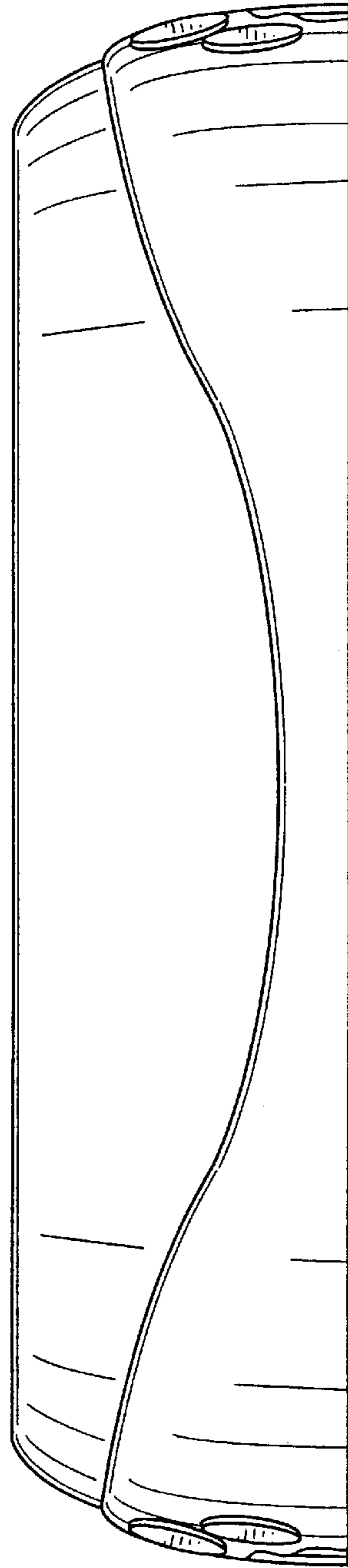

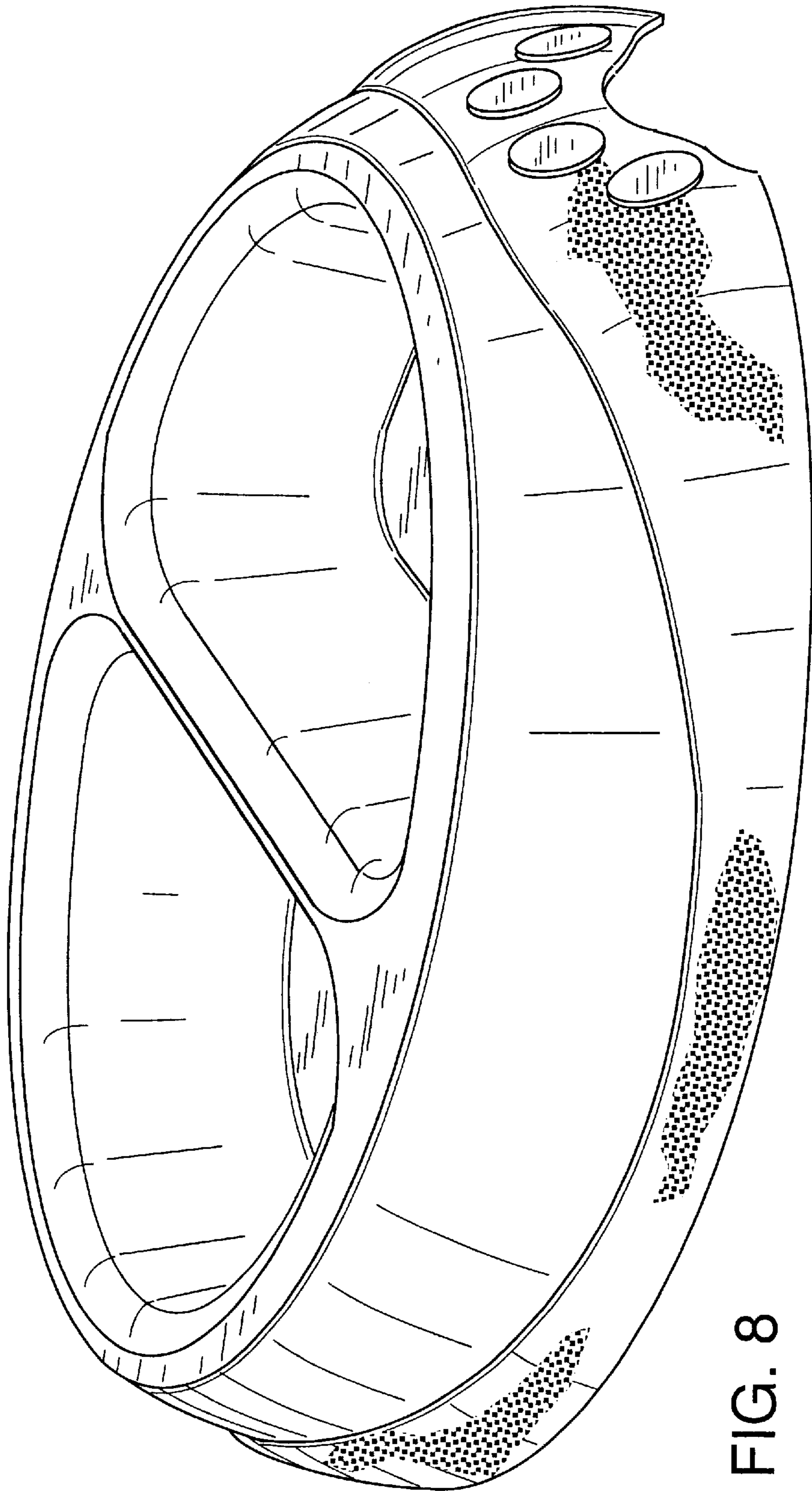

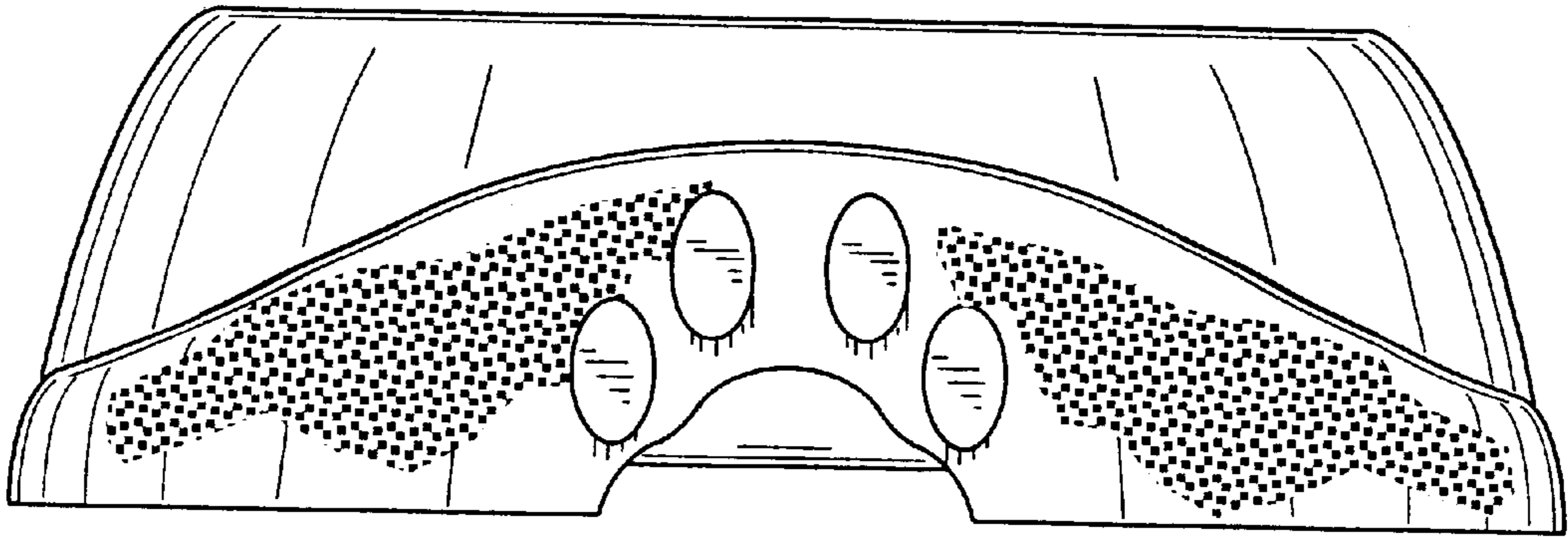

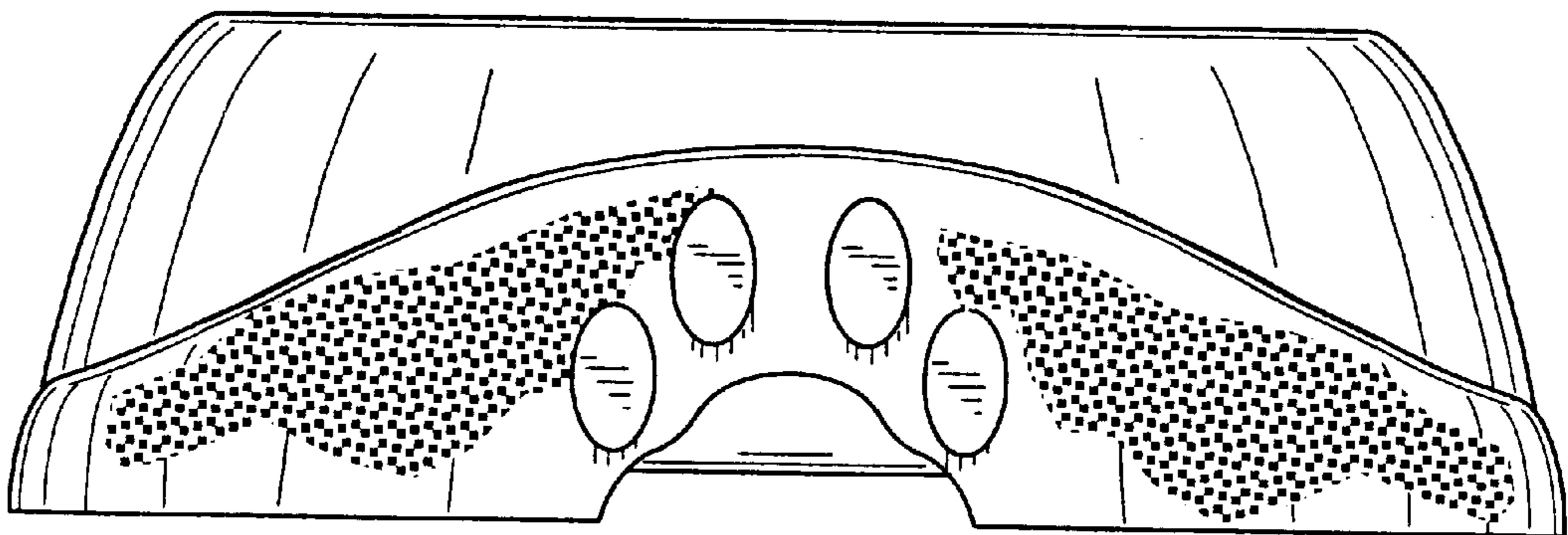

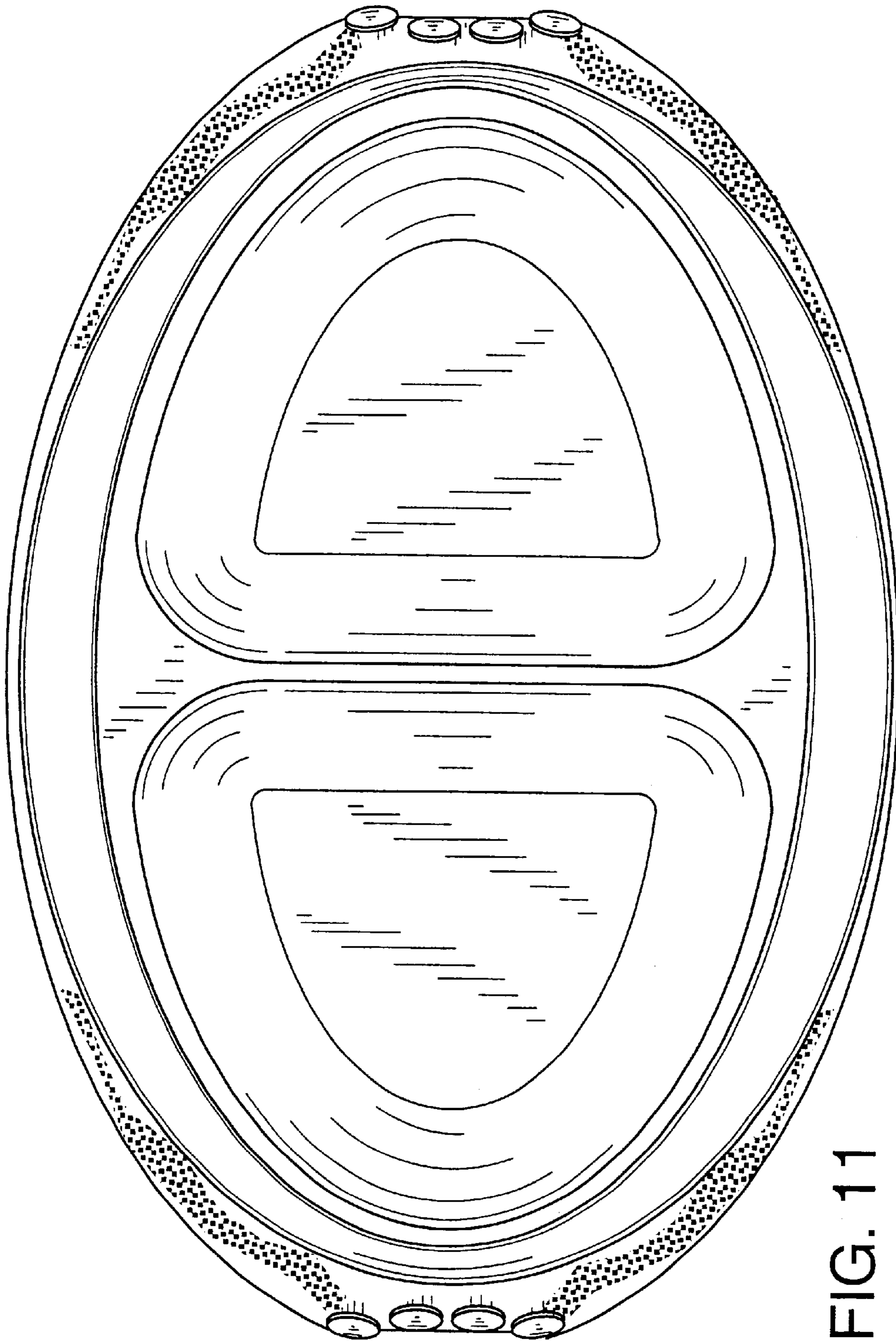

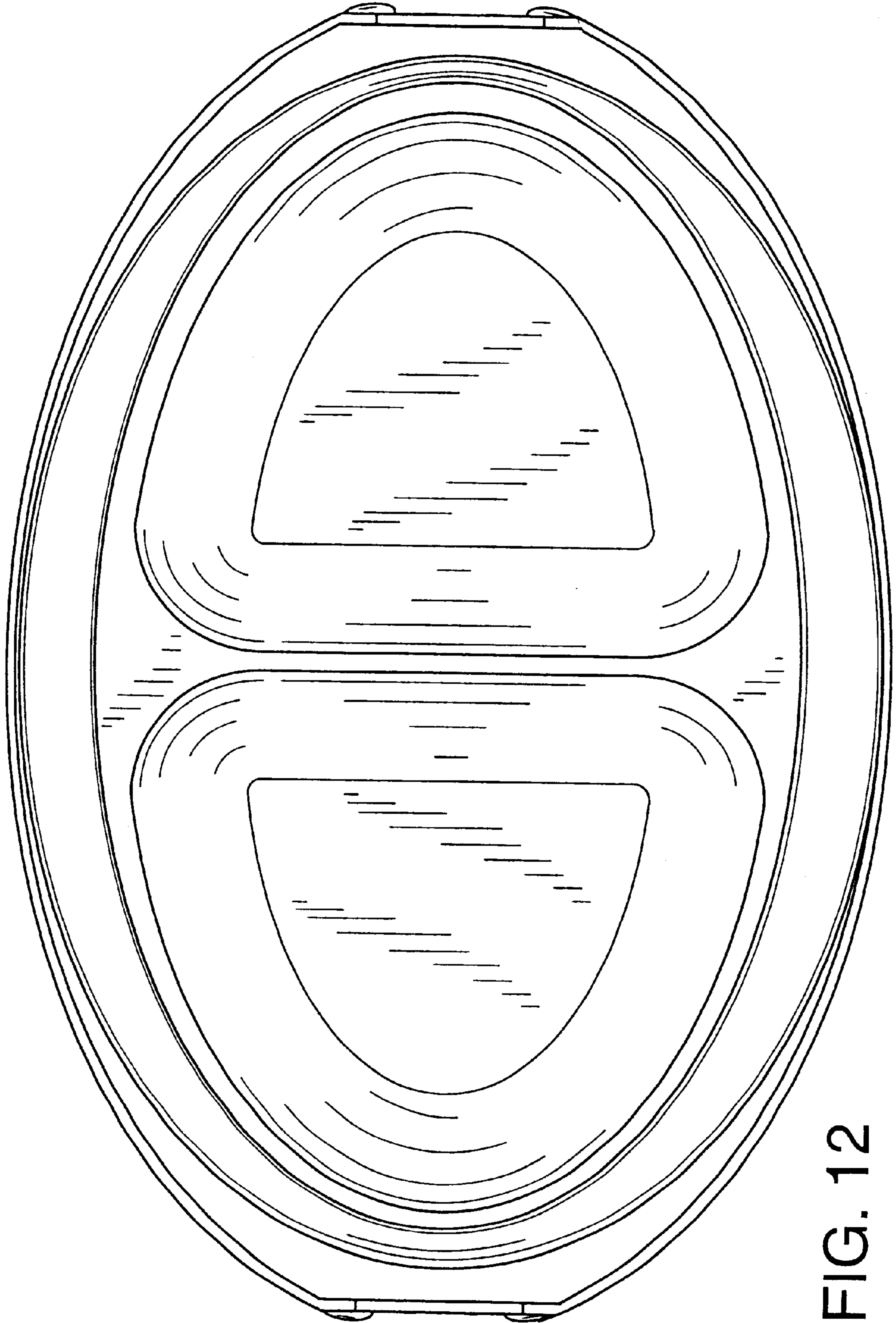

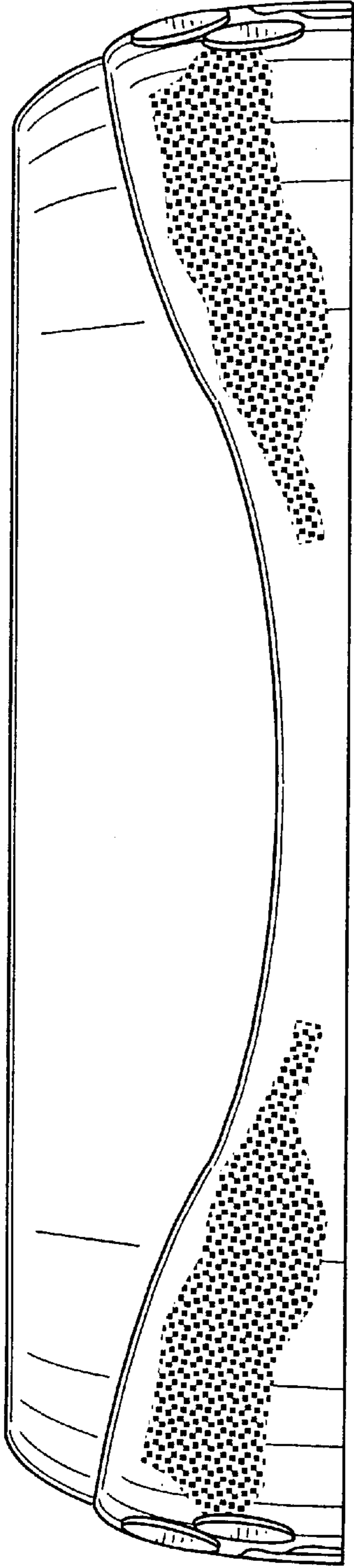

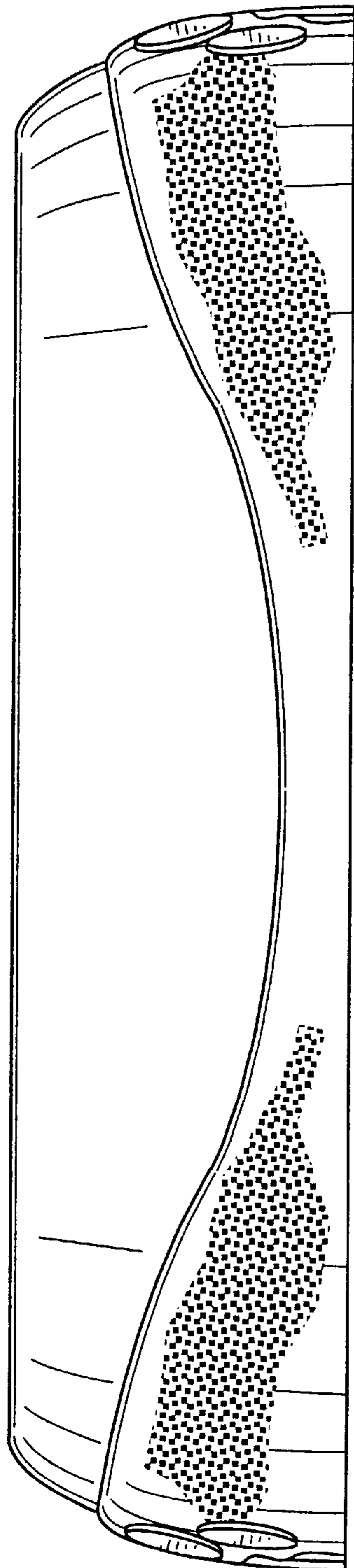
