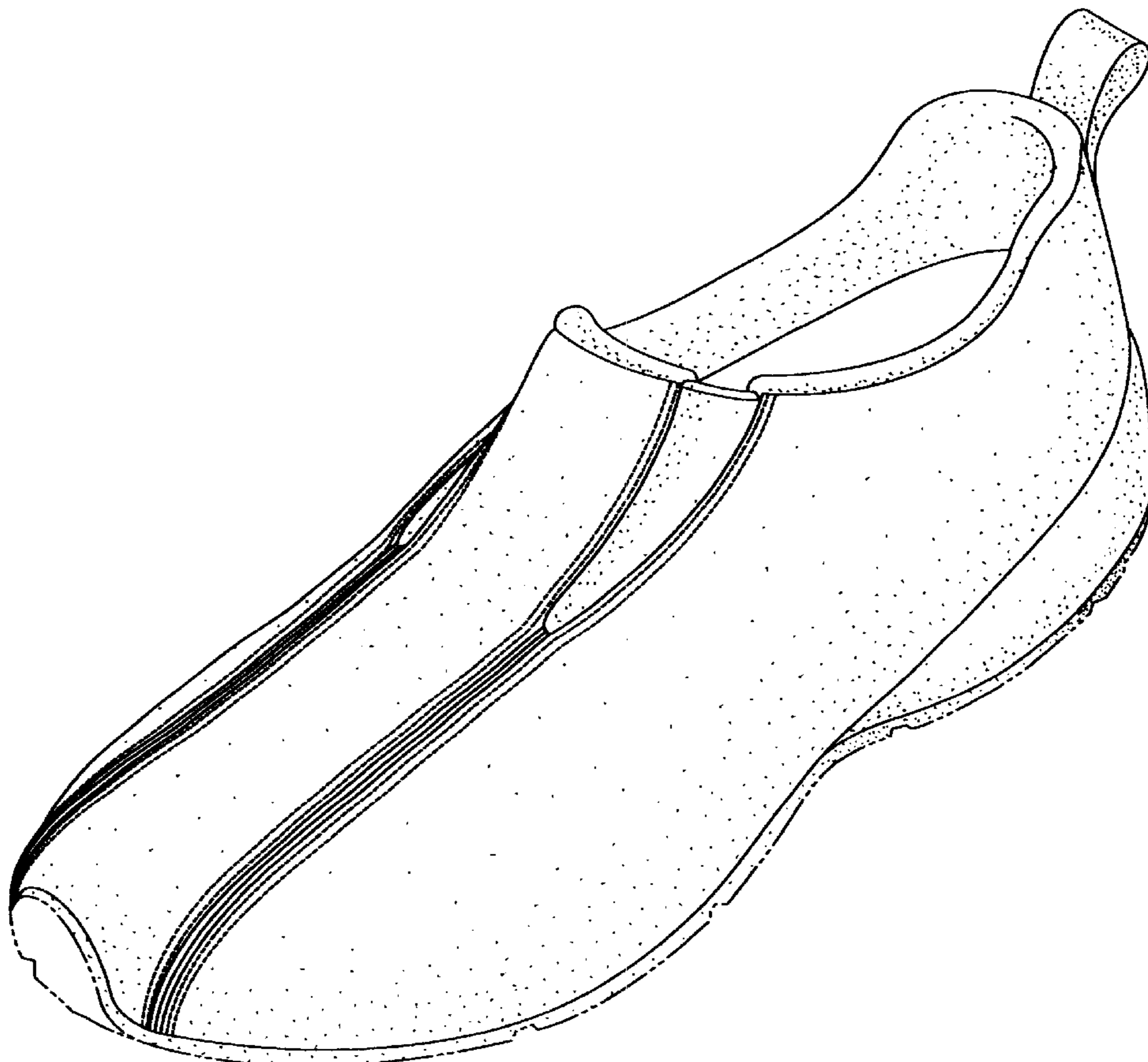
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for footwear portion, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the footwear portion embodying the new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
FIGS. 1-6 show an undersurface of an outsole in broken lines. The undersurface of an outsole does not form any part of the claimed design.

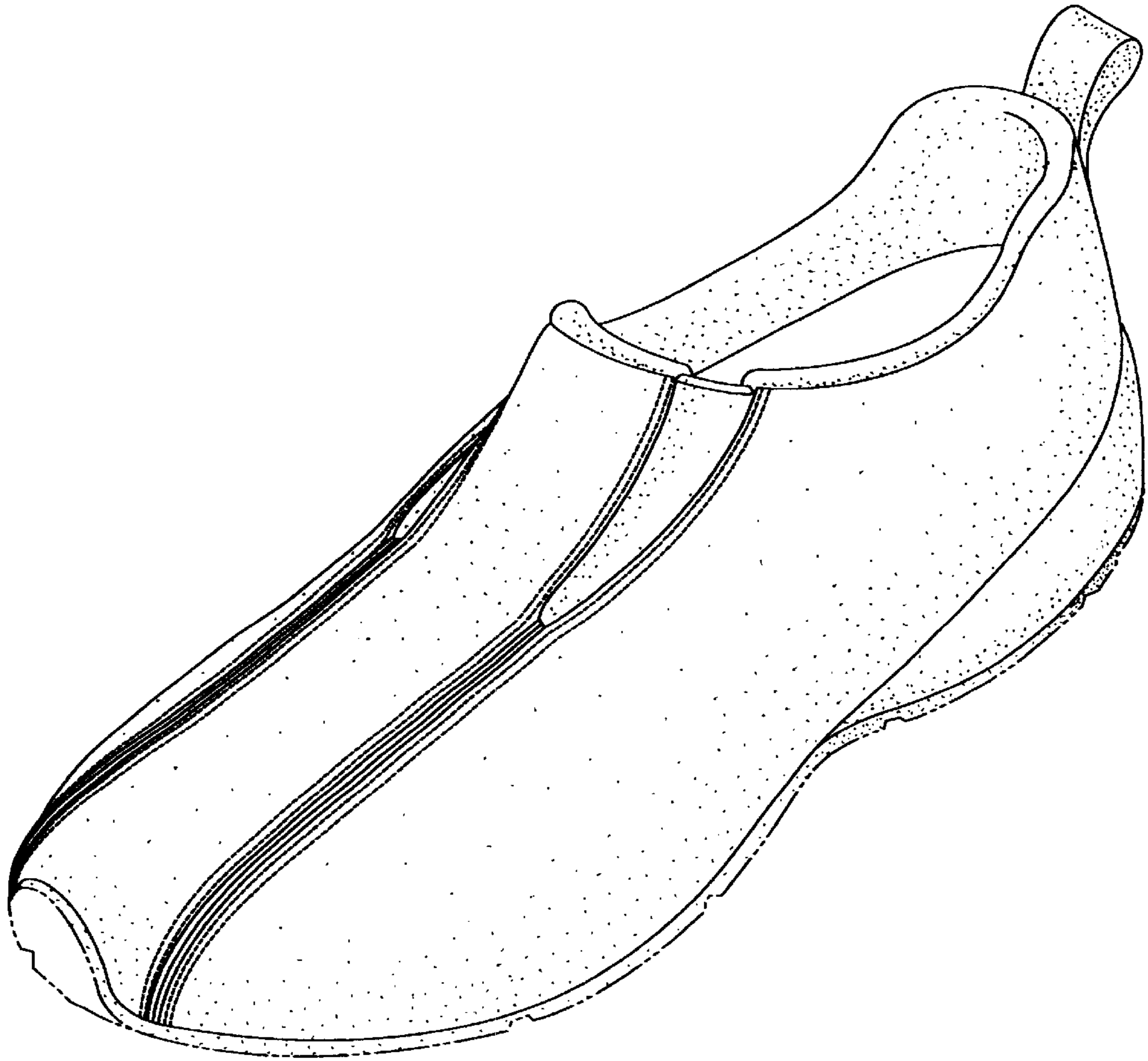

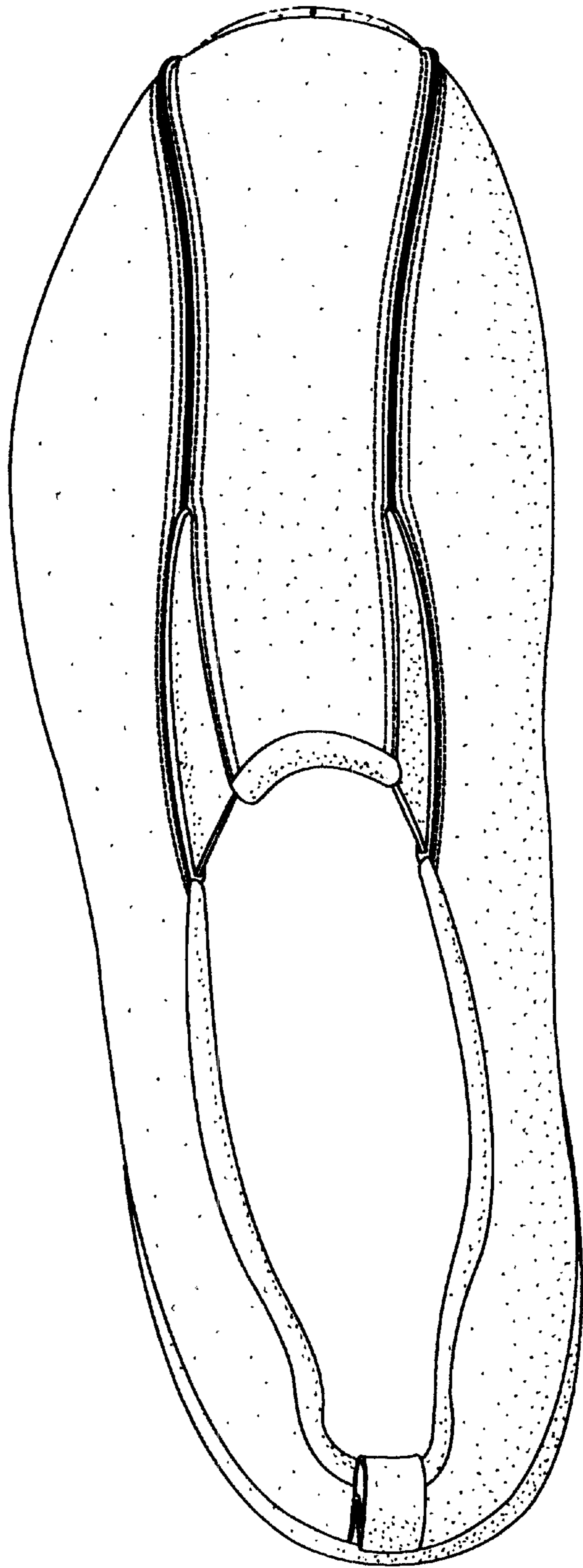

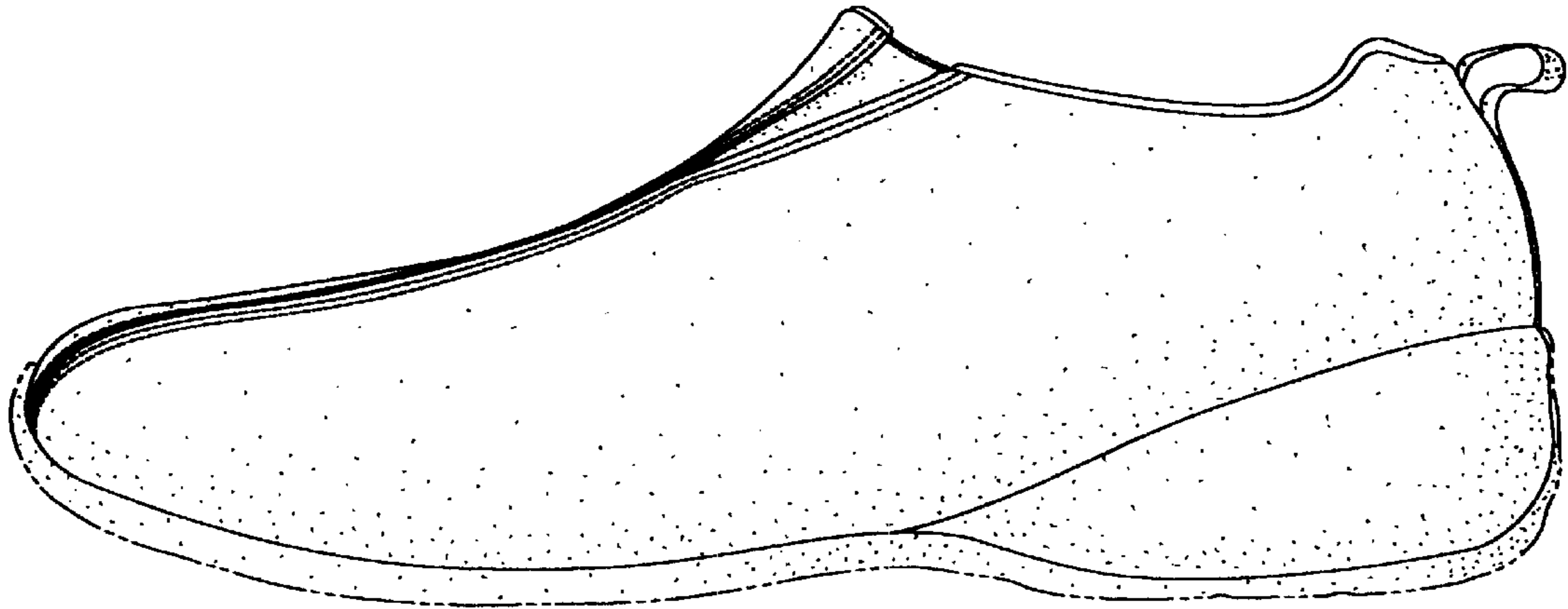

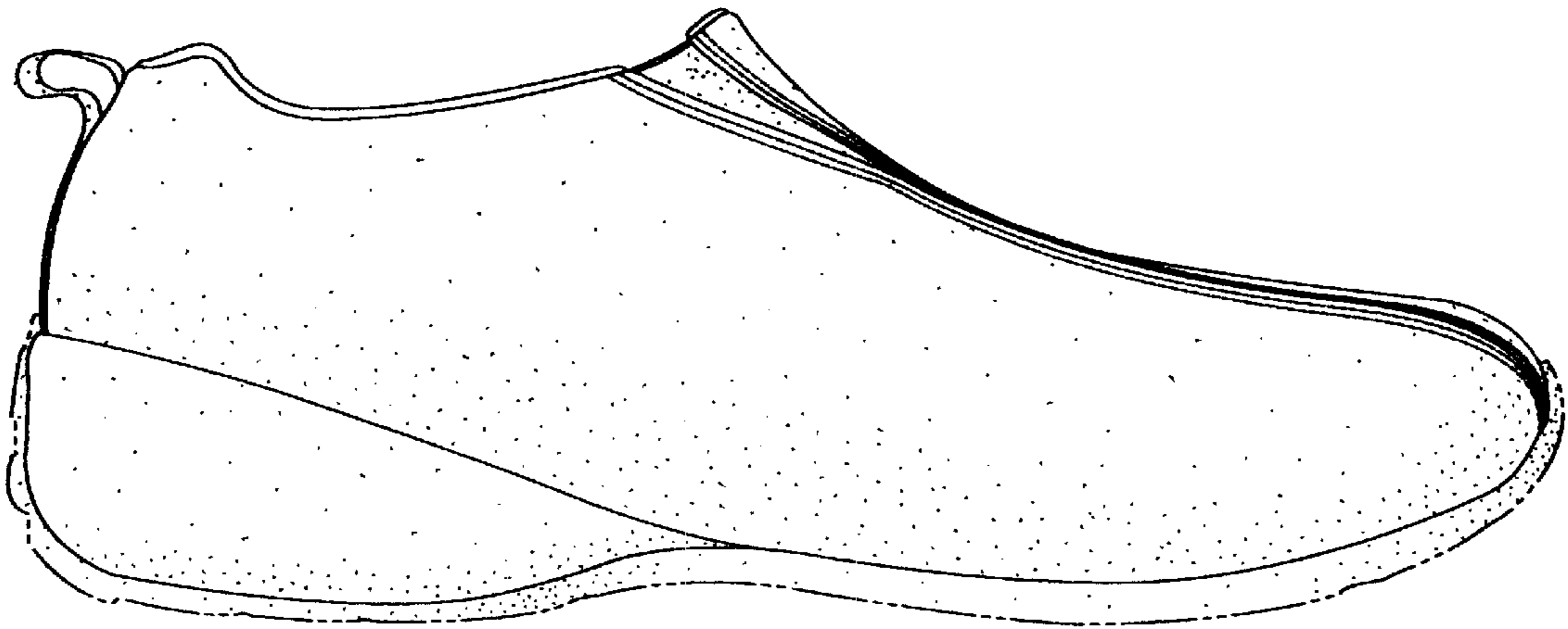

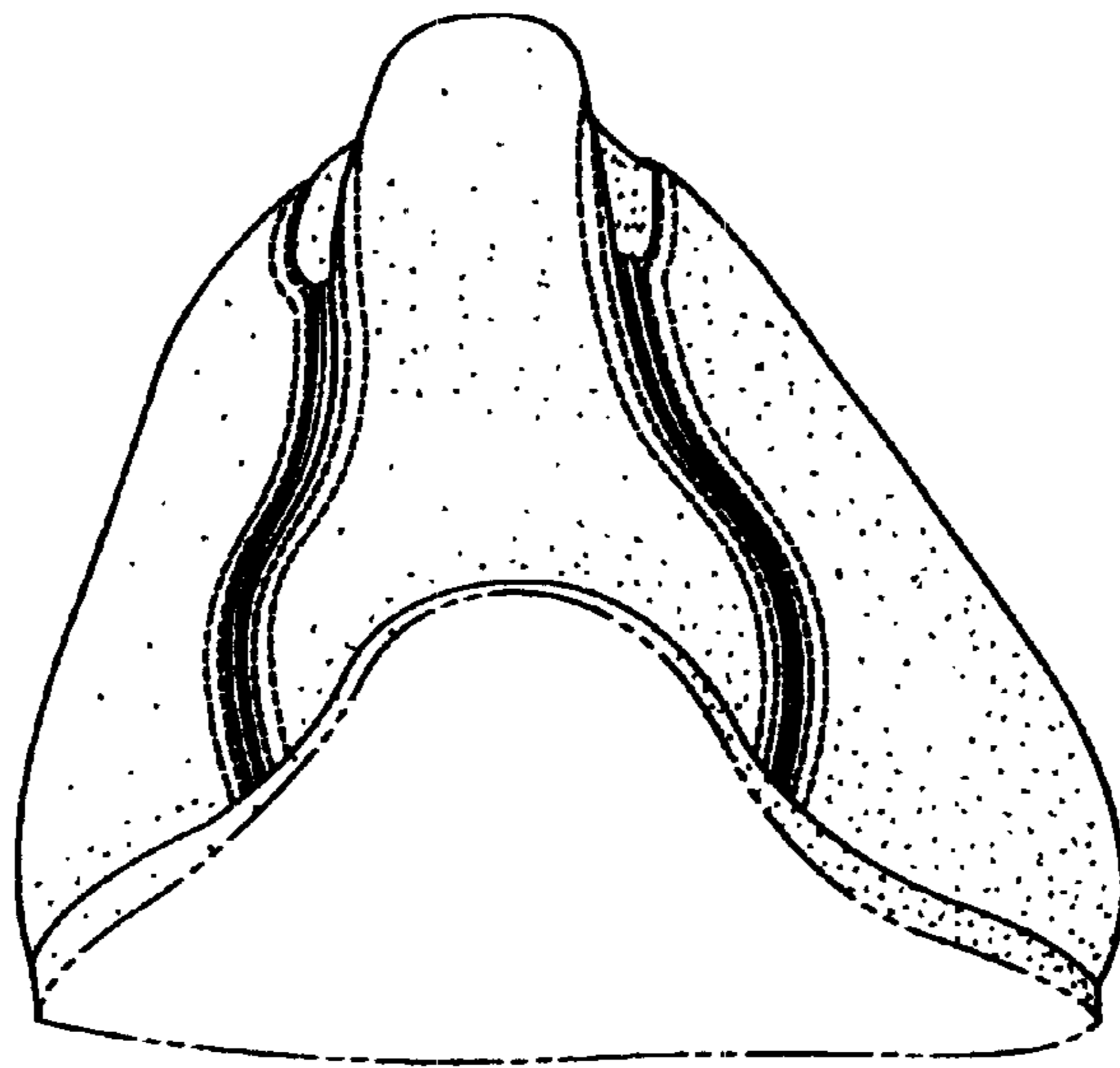

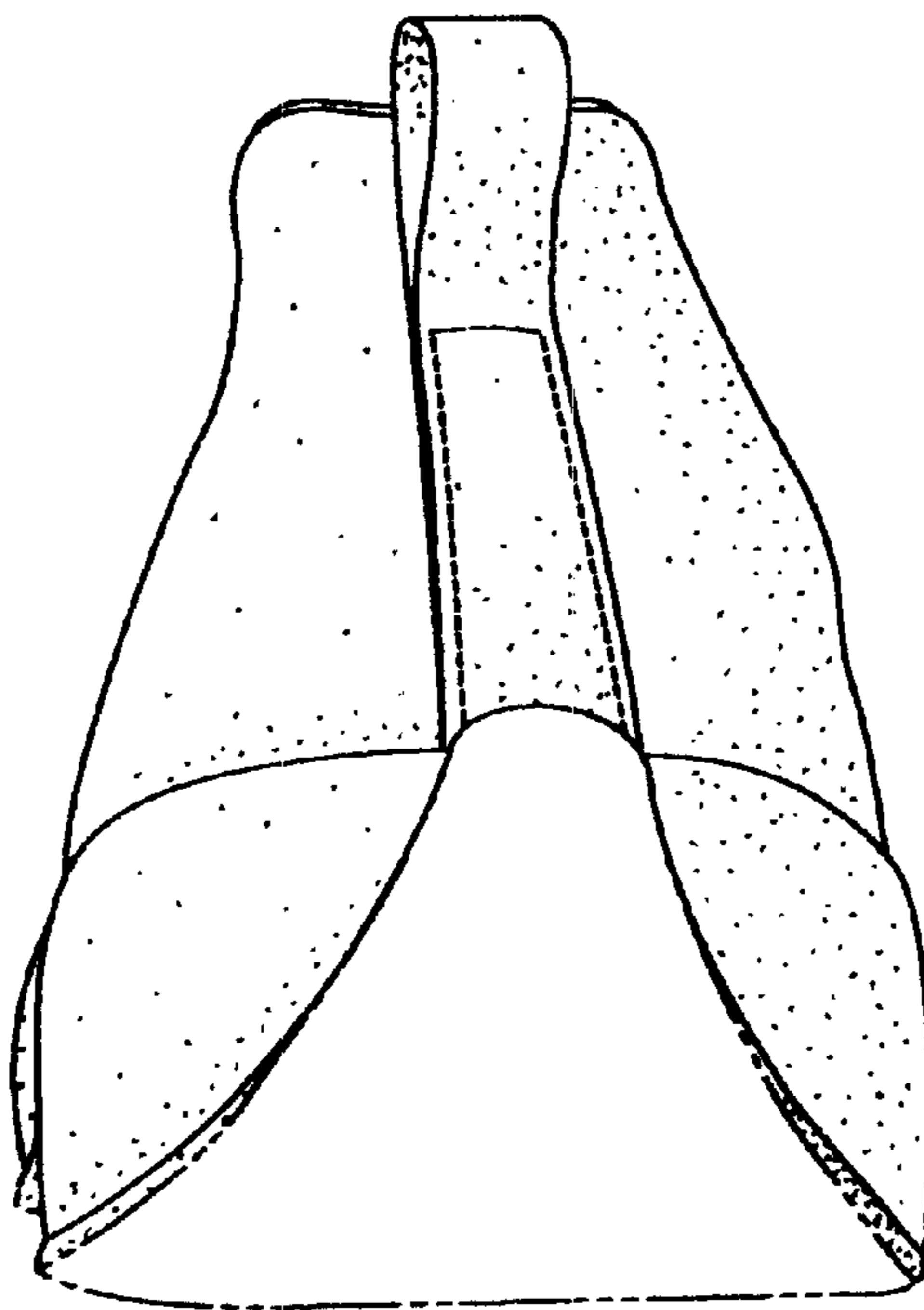
