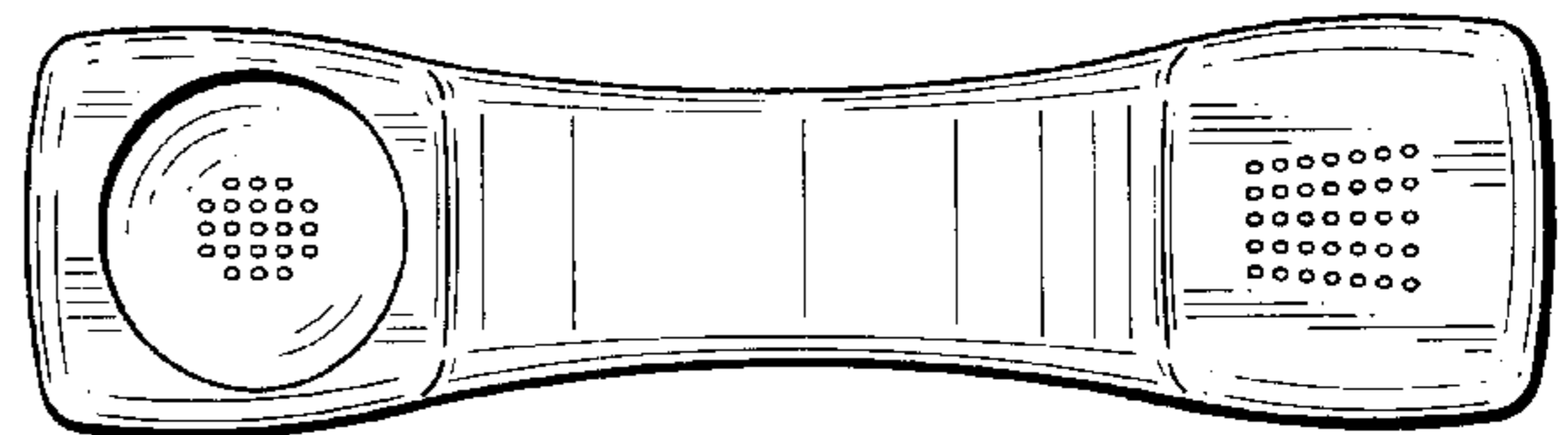
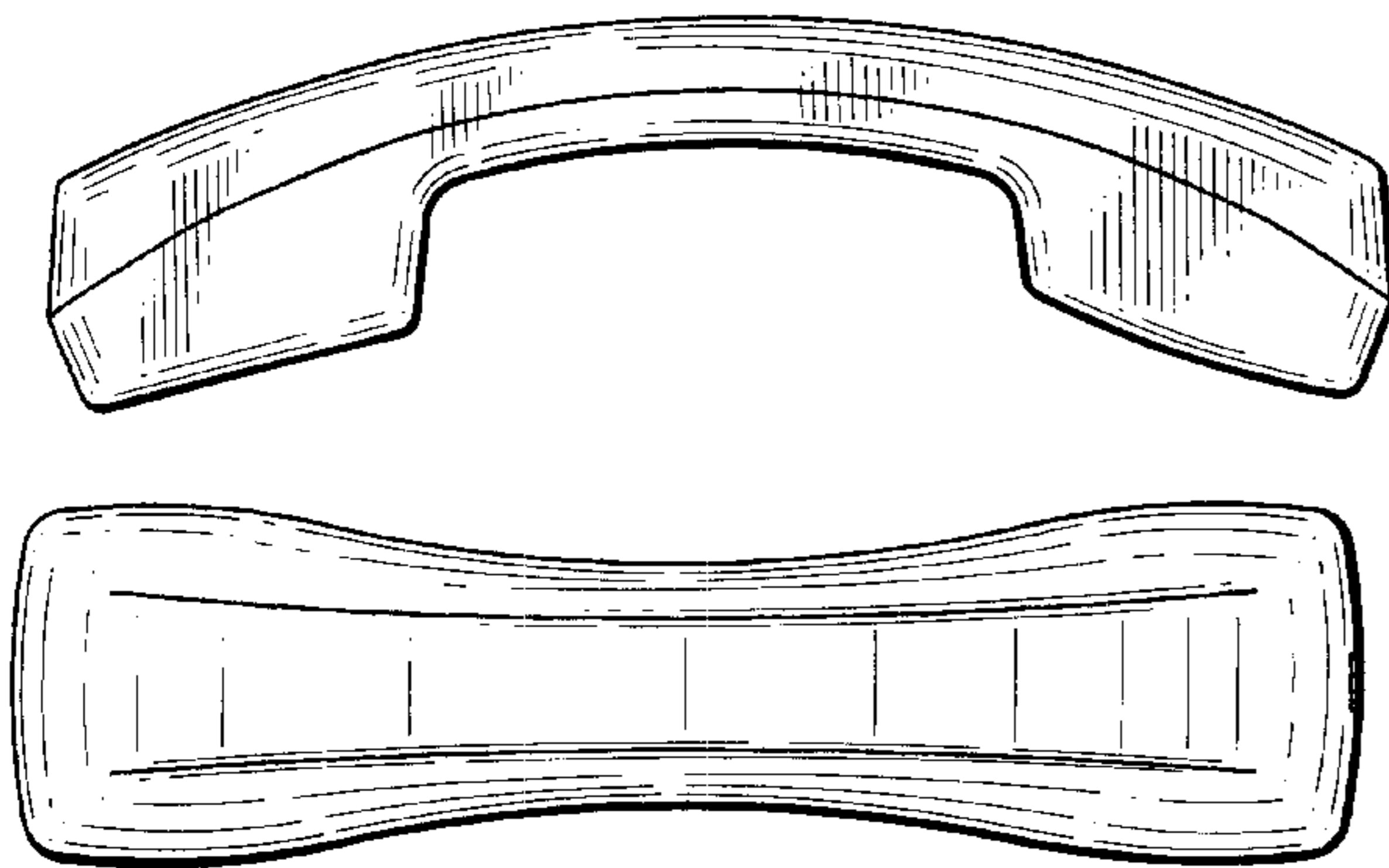
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a handset for a telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a handset for a telephone showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.

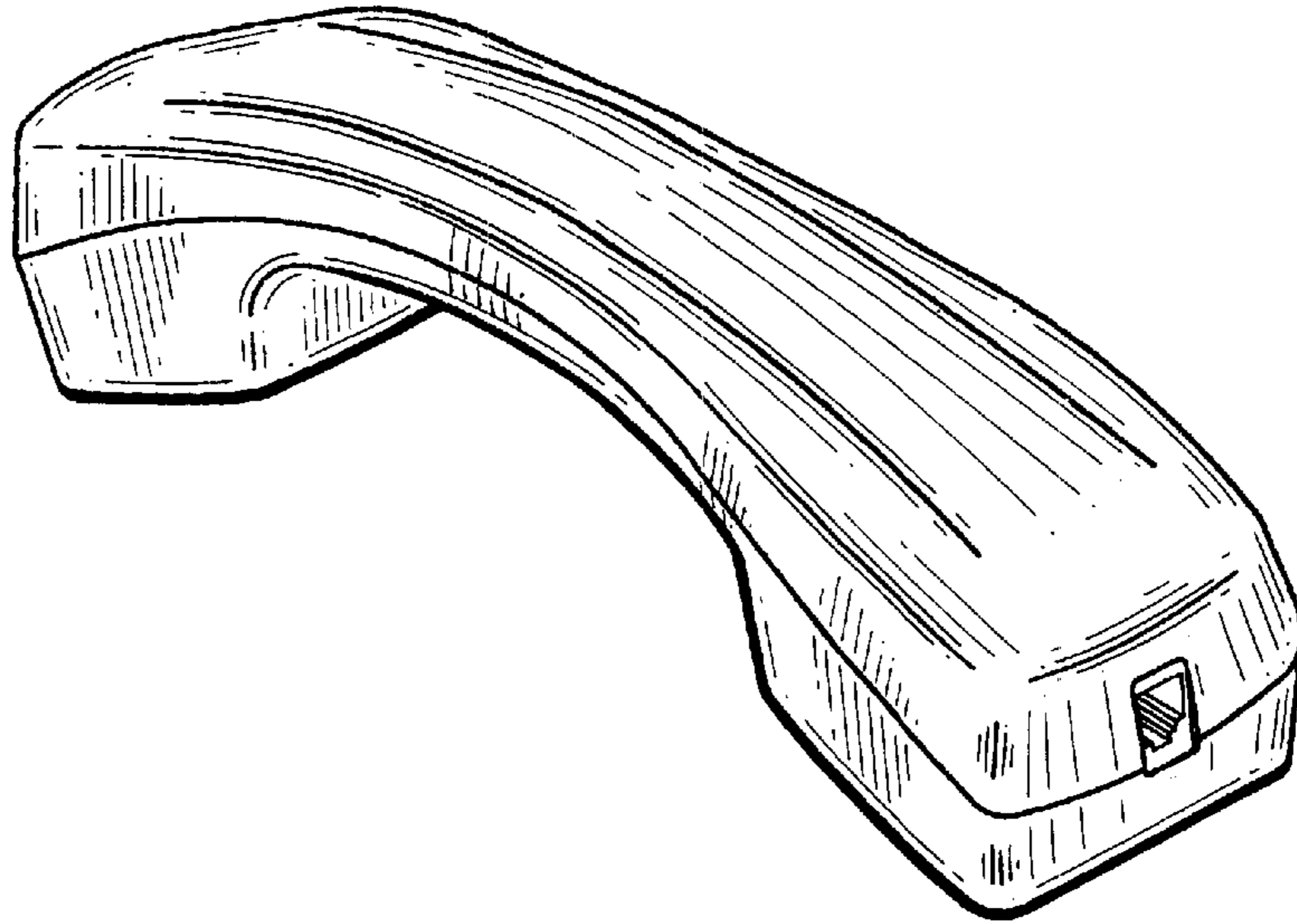

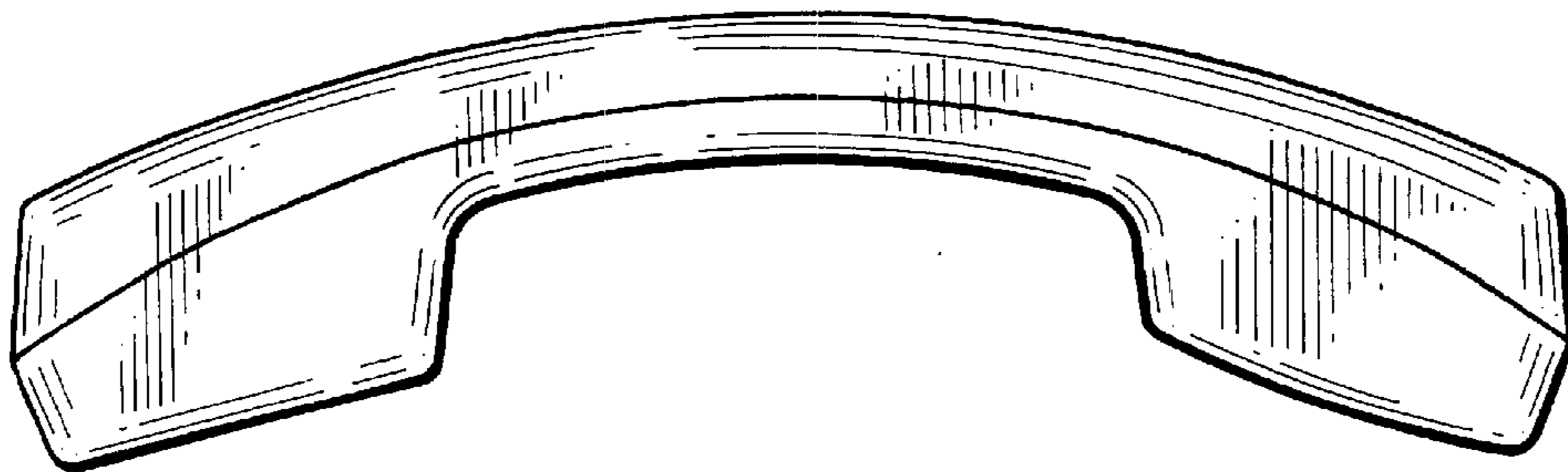

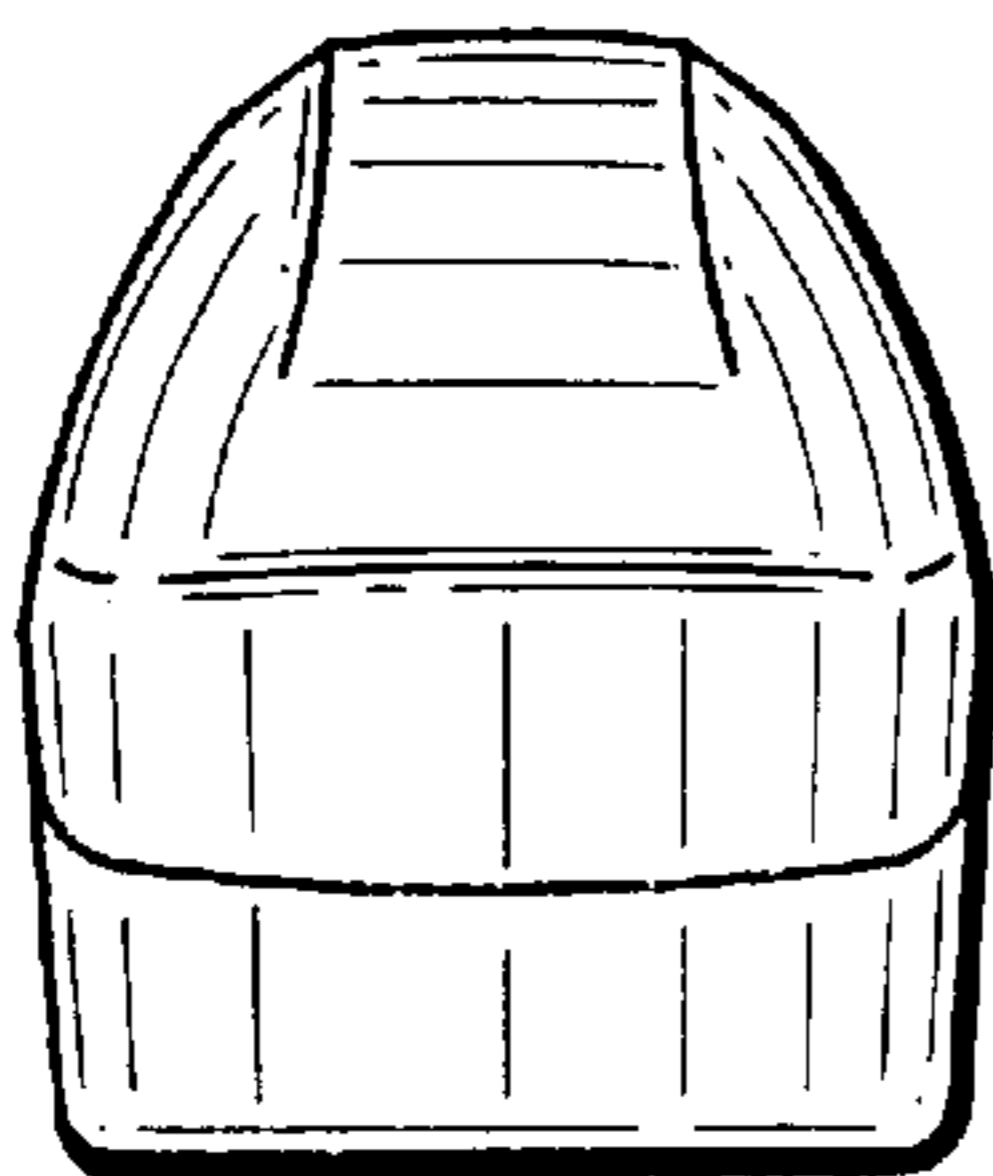

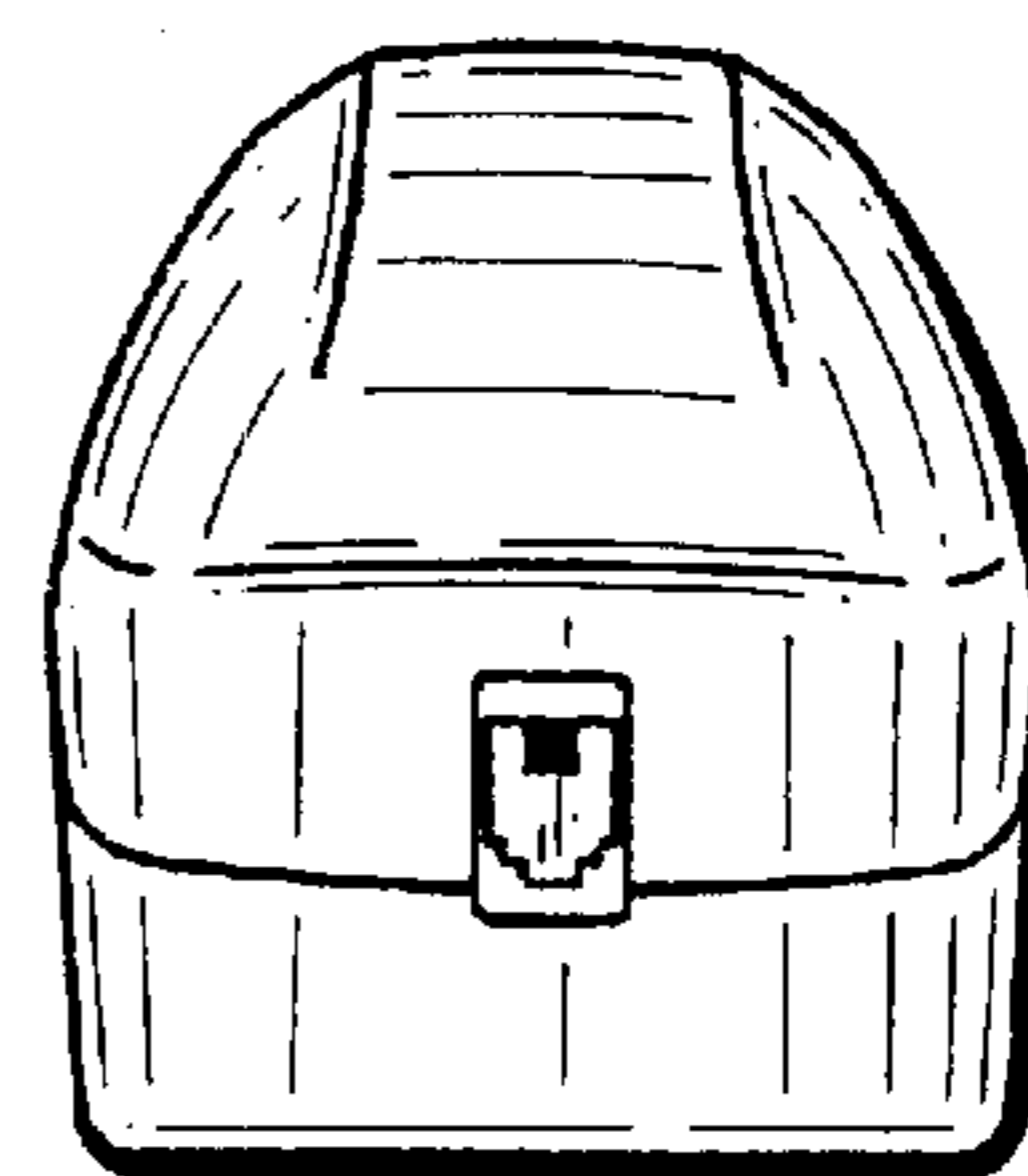

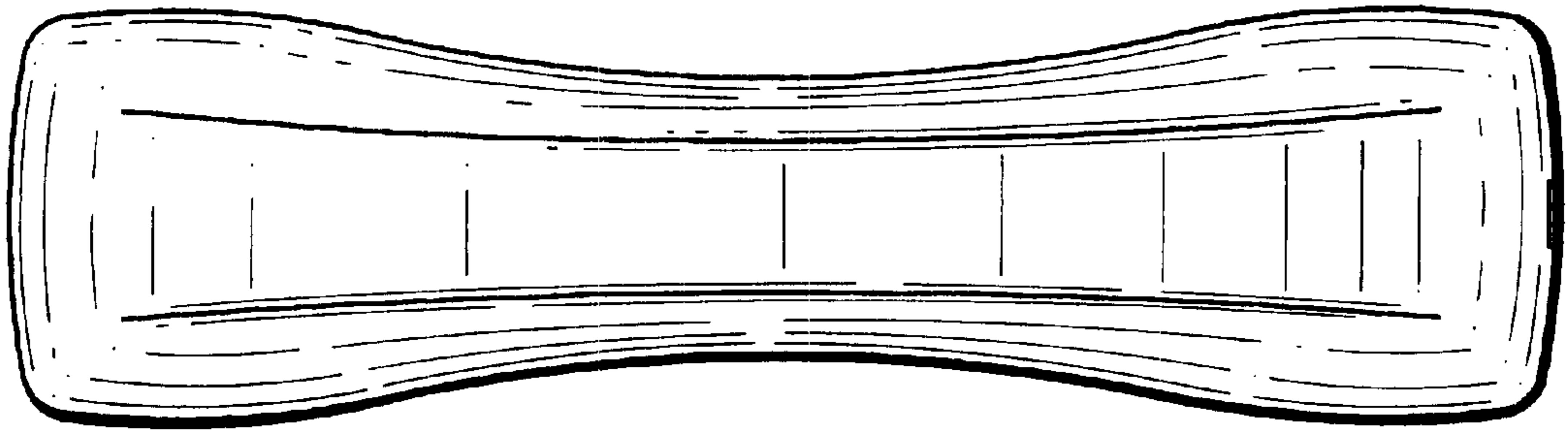

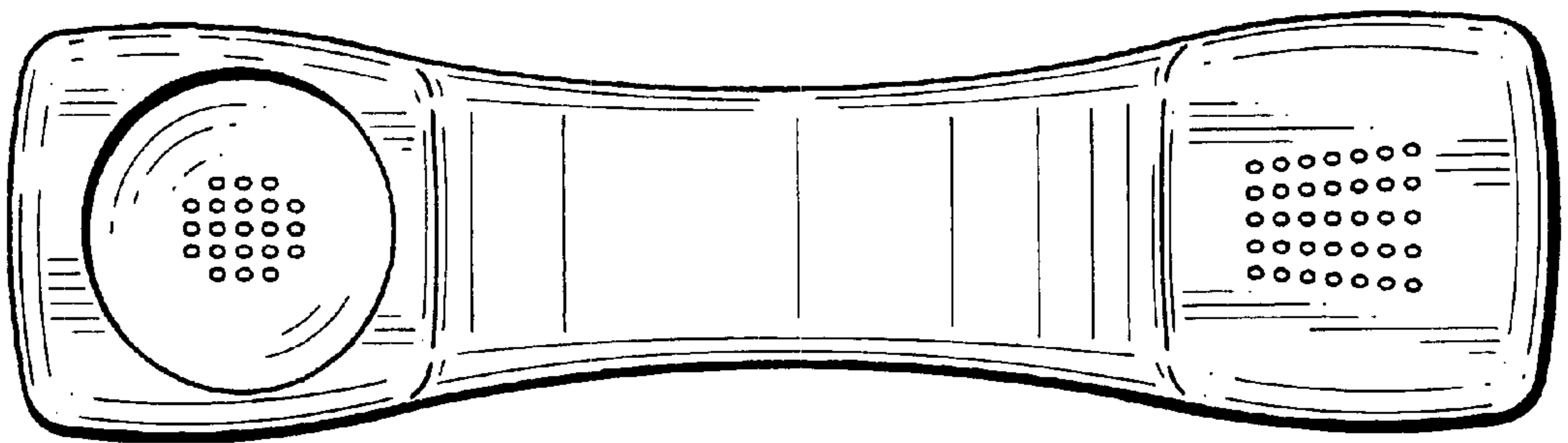
