FIG. 3 is a top view of the preferred embodiment of the invention of the curved decorative picket edge landscape stone;


FIG. 4 is a left view of the preferred embodiment of the invention of the curved decorative picket edge landscape stone;

FIG. 6 is a front view of the preferred embodiment of the invention of the curved decorative picket edge landscape stone; and,


FIG. 7 is a bottom view of the preferred embodiment of the invention of curved decorative picket edge landscape stone.









