The ornamental design for a portion of a shoe outsole, as shown and described.

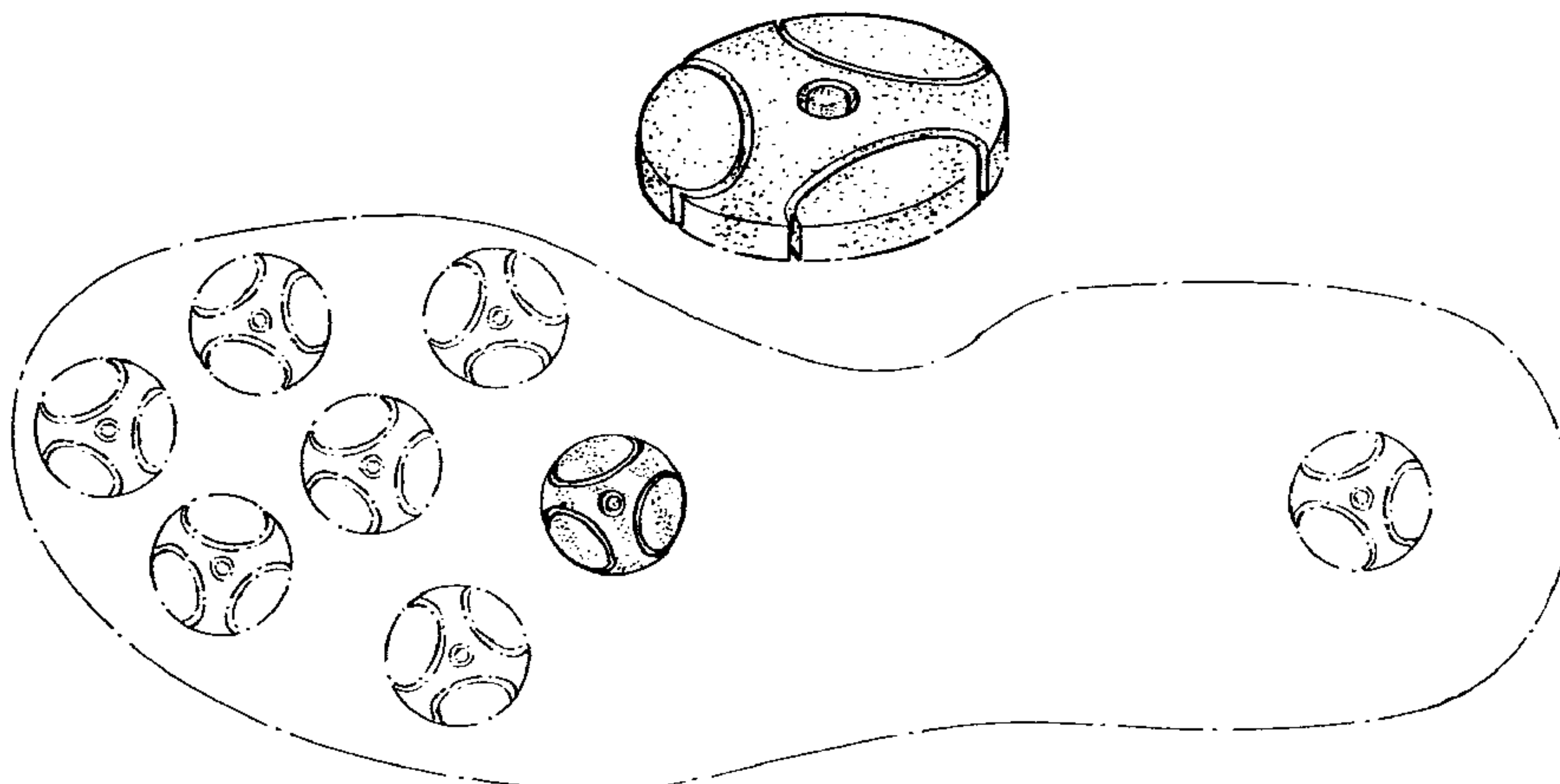
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portion of a shoe outsole showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of FIG. 2;  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 2; and,  
FIG. 5 is a plan view thereof shown within an outsole environment.

In FIG. 5, the uneven broken line showing of the shoe outsole, the uneven broken line showing of other features on the shoe outsole, and the particular location and orientation of the claimed portion with respect to the remainder of the outsole are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

Other broken lines in the Figures are also for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

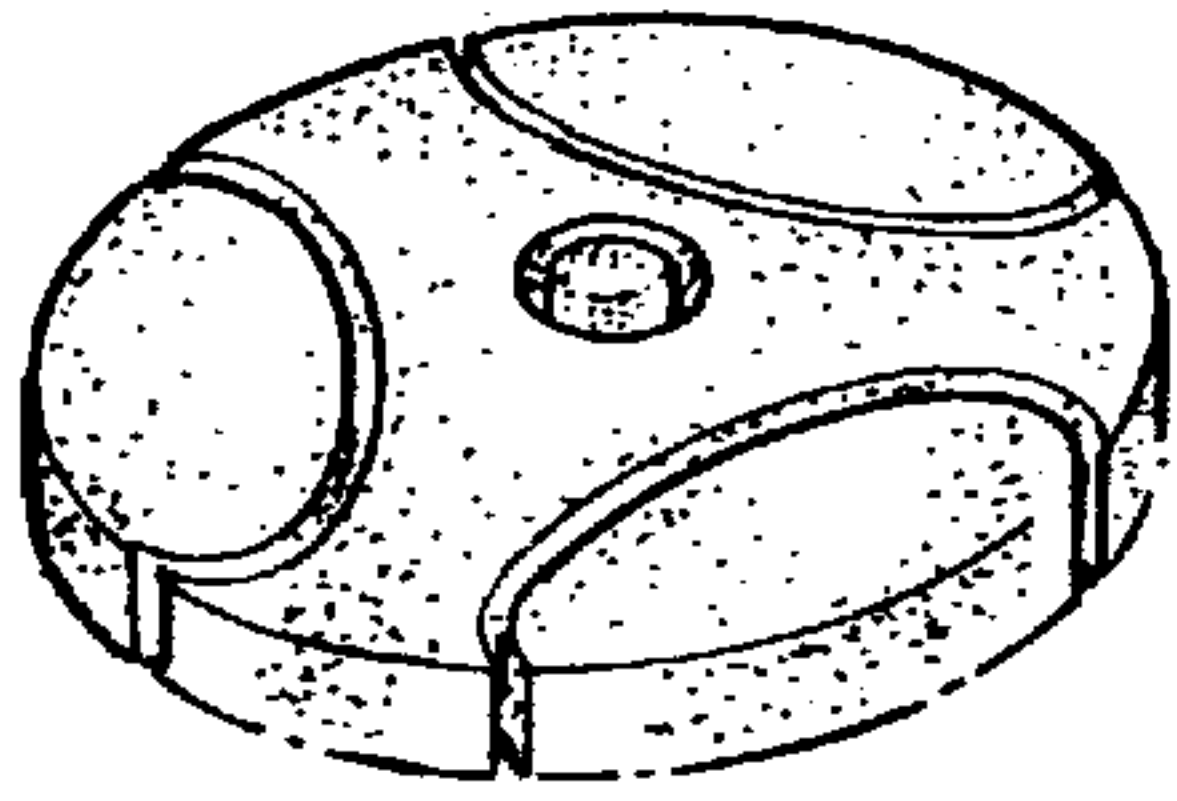

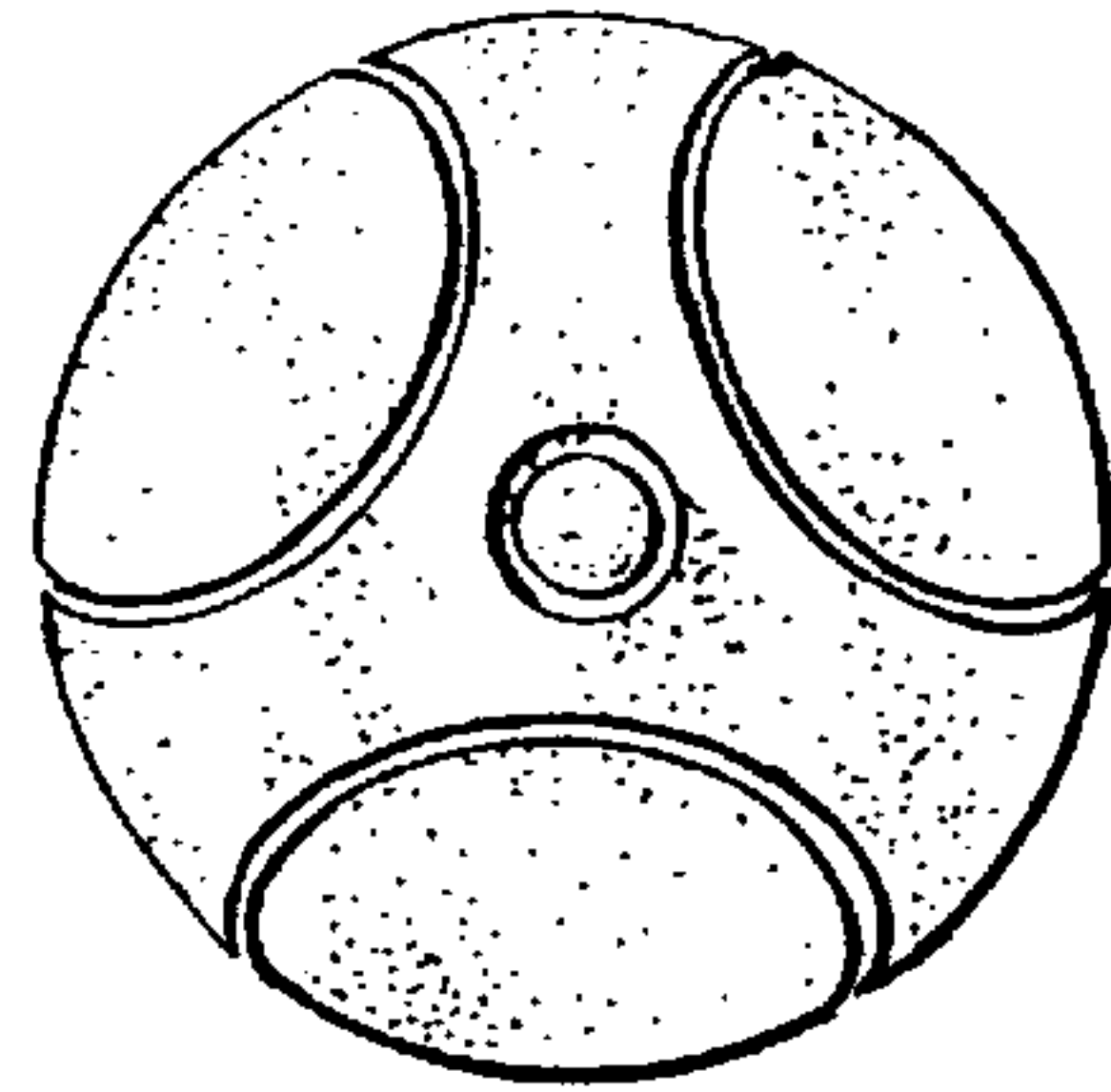

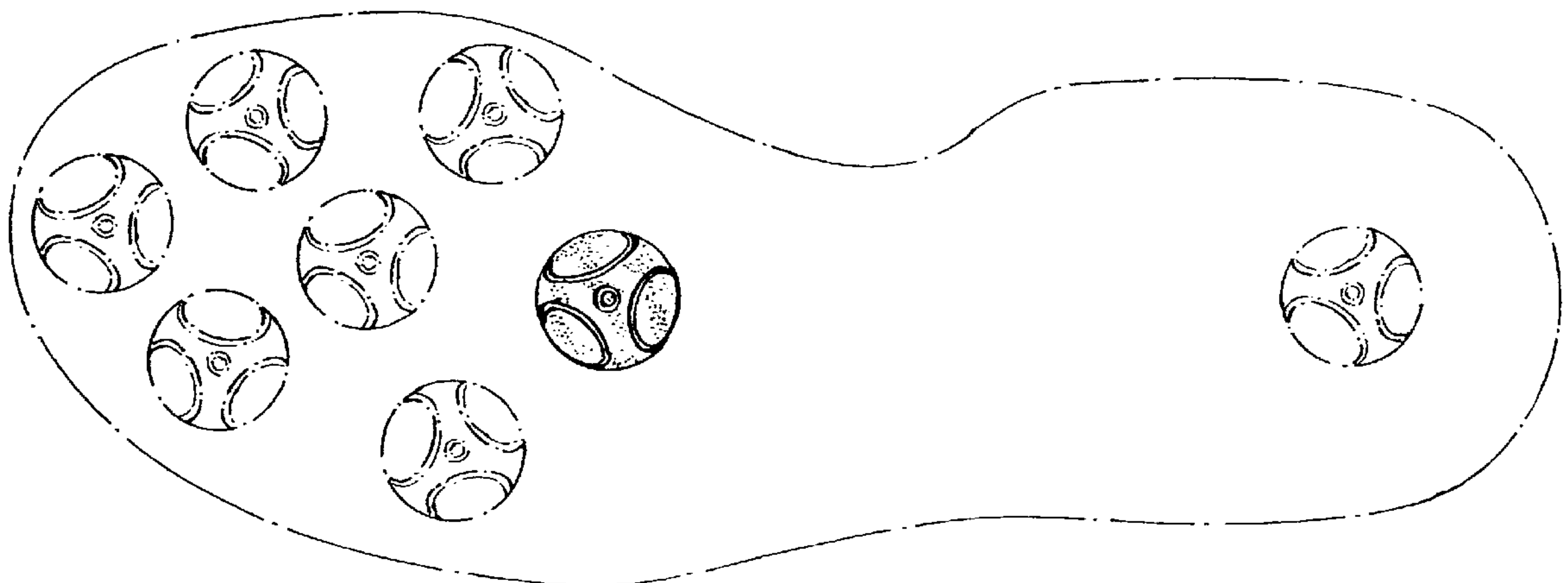
