
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental designs for a top portion of a writing table, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of the top portion of a writing table, showing the vertical supports for the top portion of a writing table in broken lines.
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the top portion of a writing table, showing the vertical supports for the top portion of a writing table in broken lines.
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the top portion of a writing table, showing the vertical supports for the top portion of a writing table in broken lines. The left side elevational view (not shown) would be a mirror image of the right side elevational view.
FIG. 4 is a top elevational view of the top portion of a writing table.
FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view of the top portion of a writing table, showing the vertical supports for the top portion of a writing table in broken lines.
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the top portion of a writing table, showing the vertical supports for the top portion of a writing table in broken lines; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom elevational view of the top portion of a writing table, showing the vertical supports for the top portion of a writing table in broken lines.
The broken lines in the figures are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.














