FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

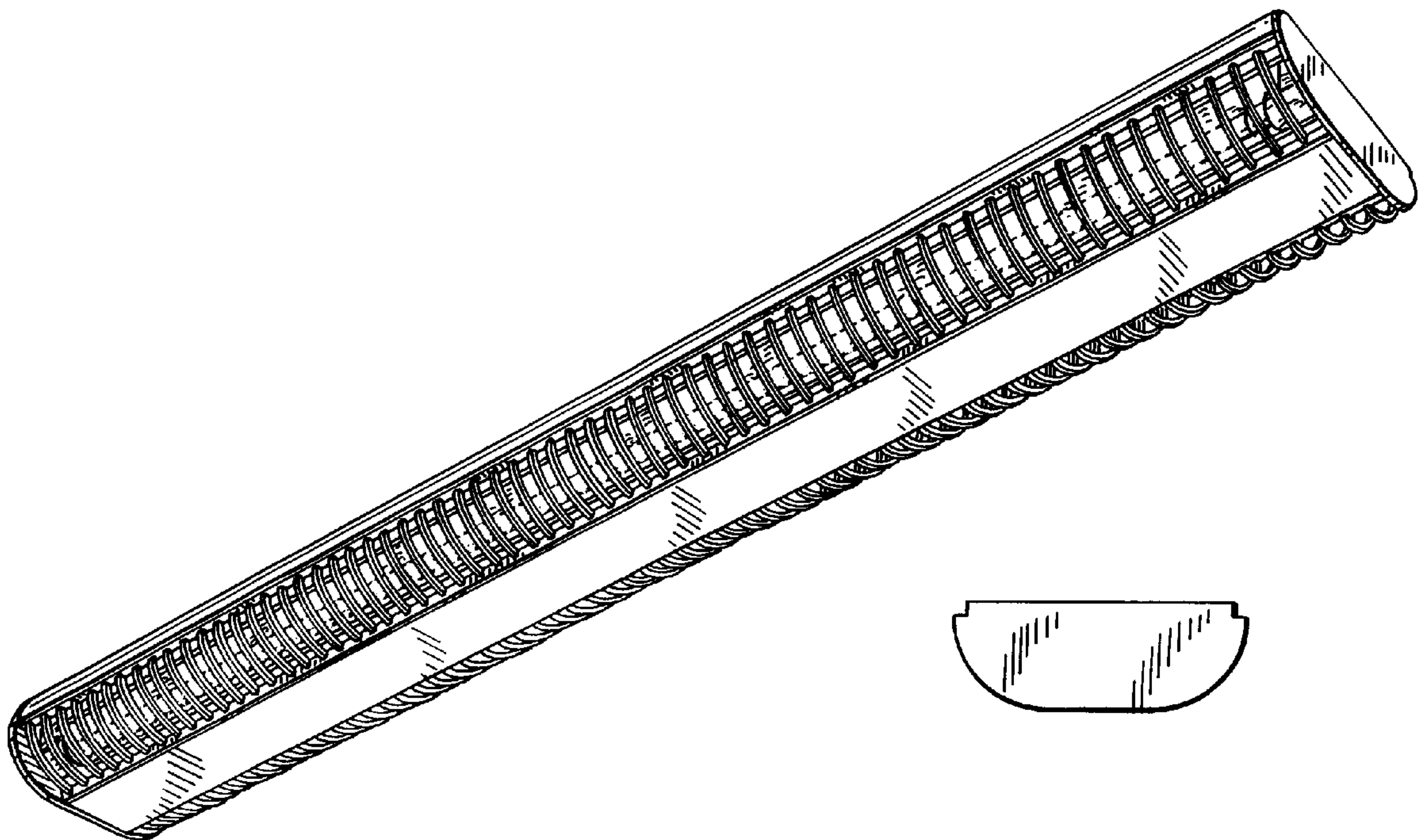
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image;

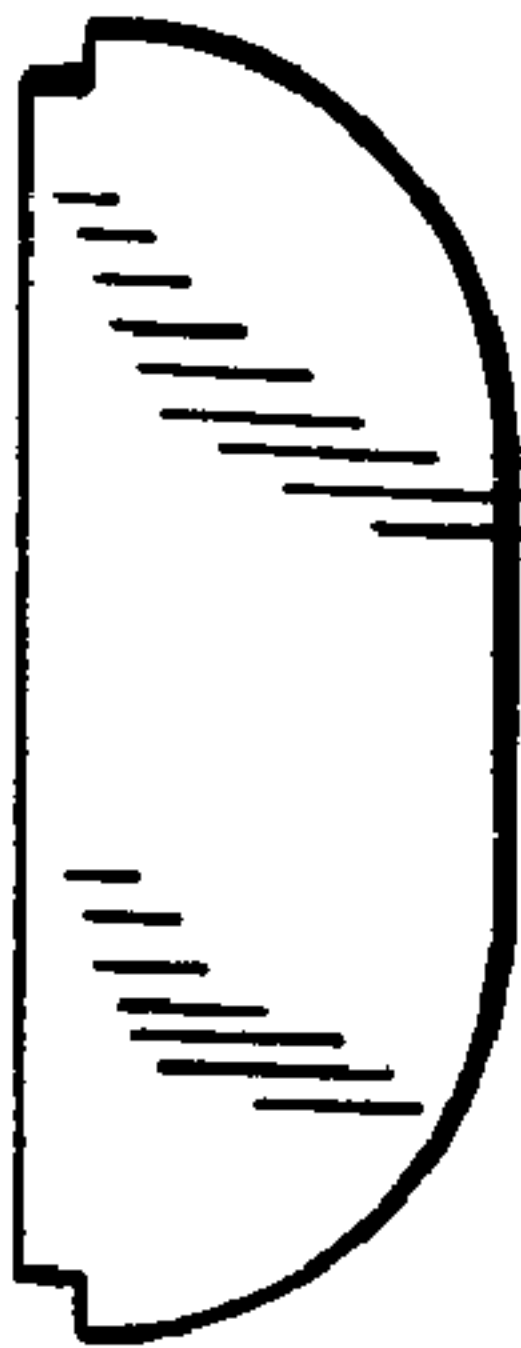
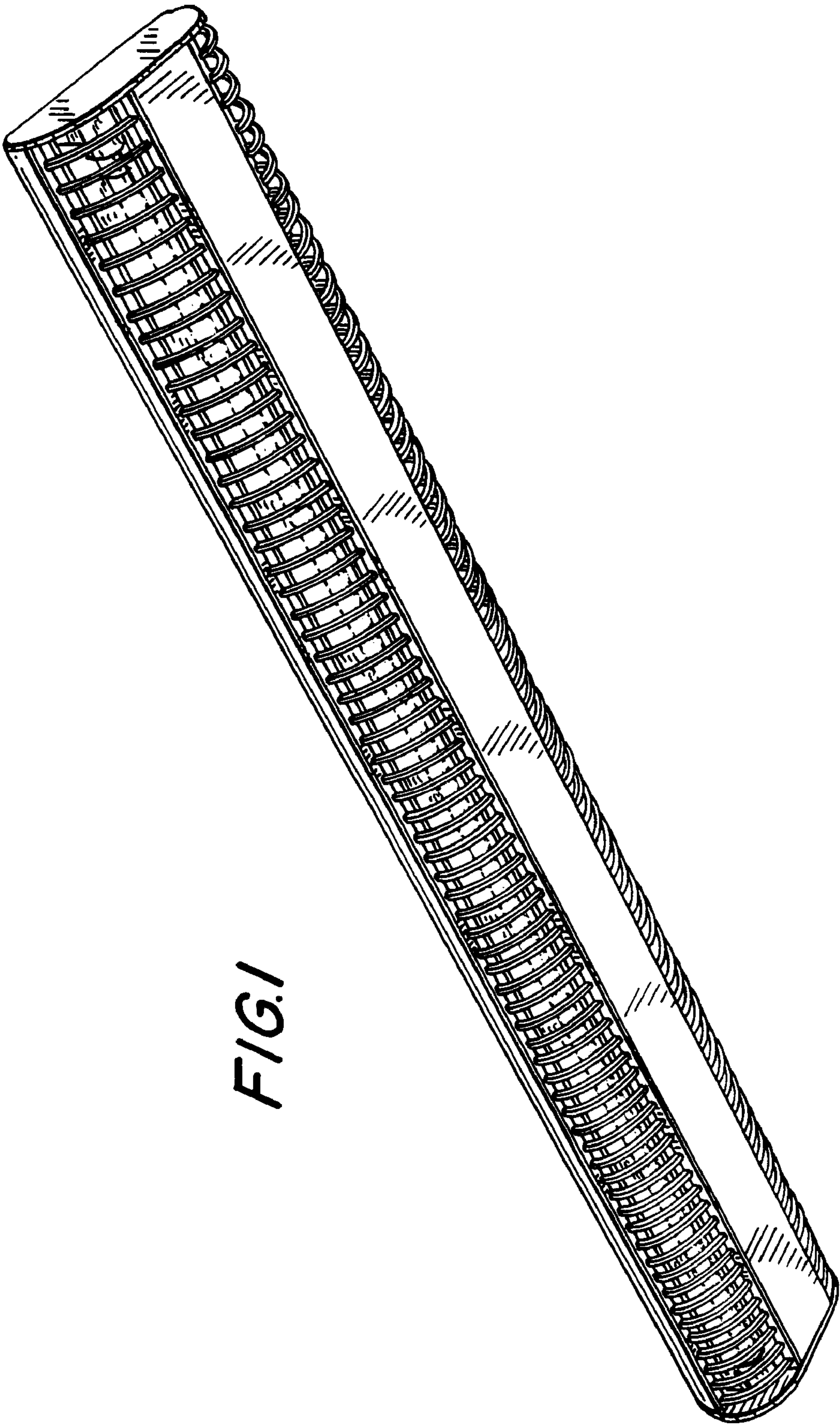

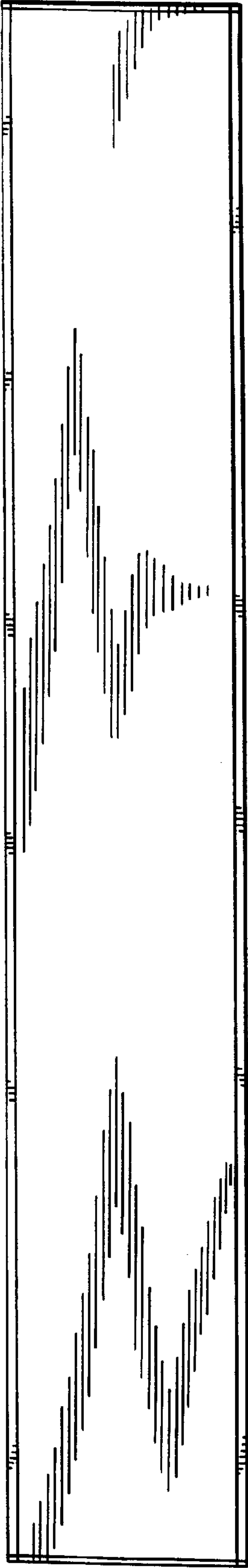

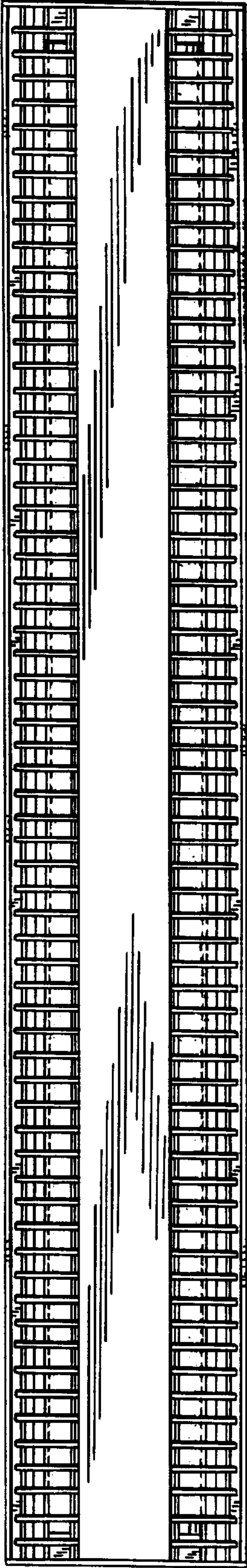
