FIG. 6 is a rear view of the chair of FIG. 1.

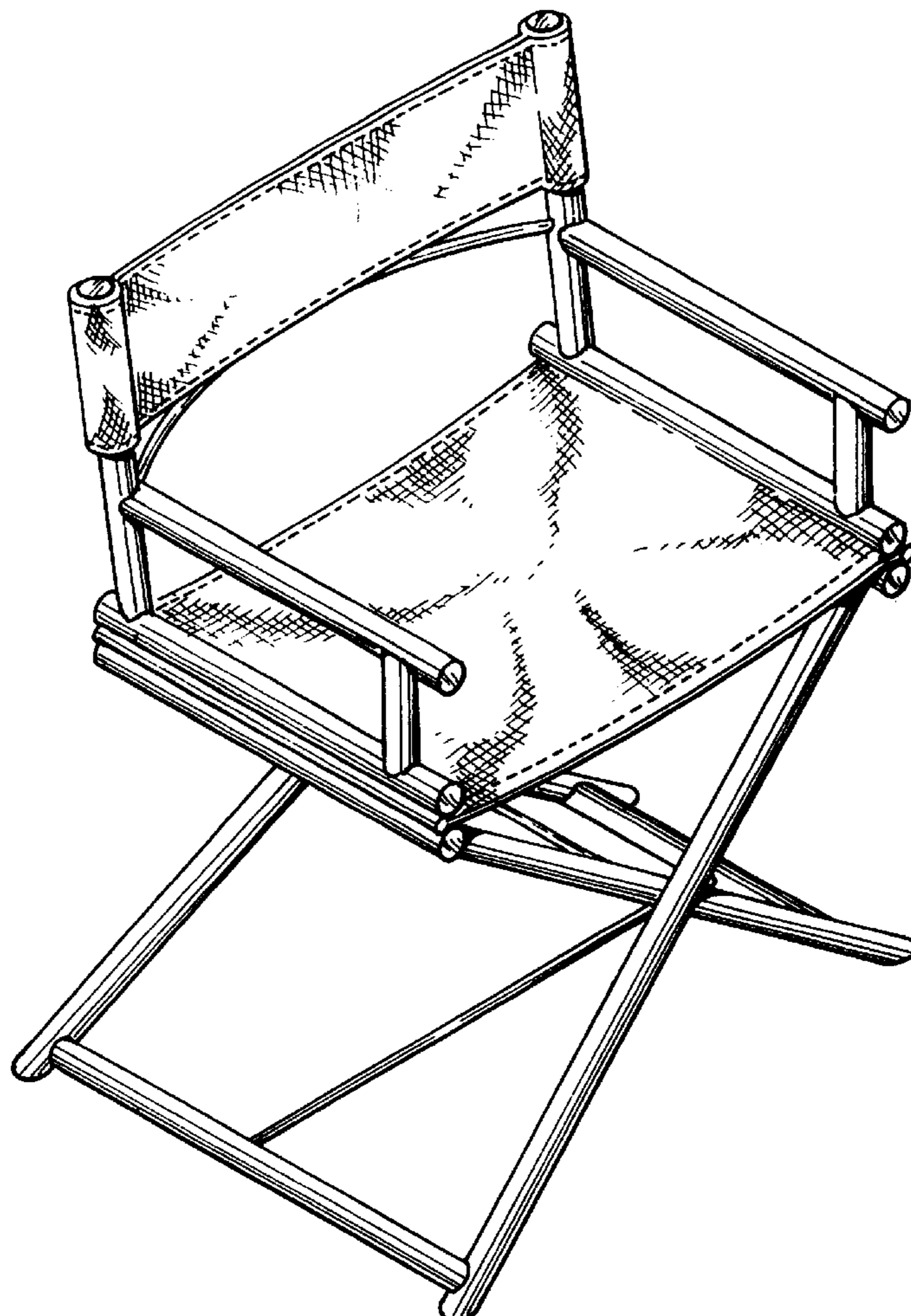

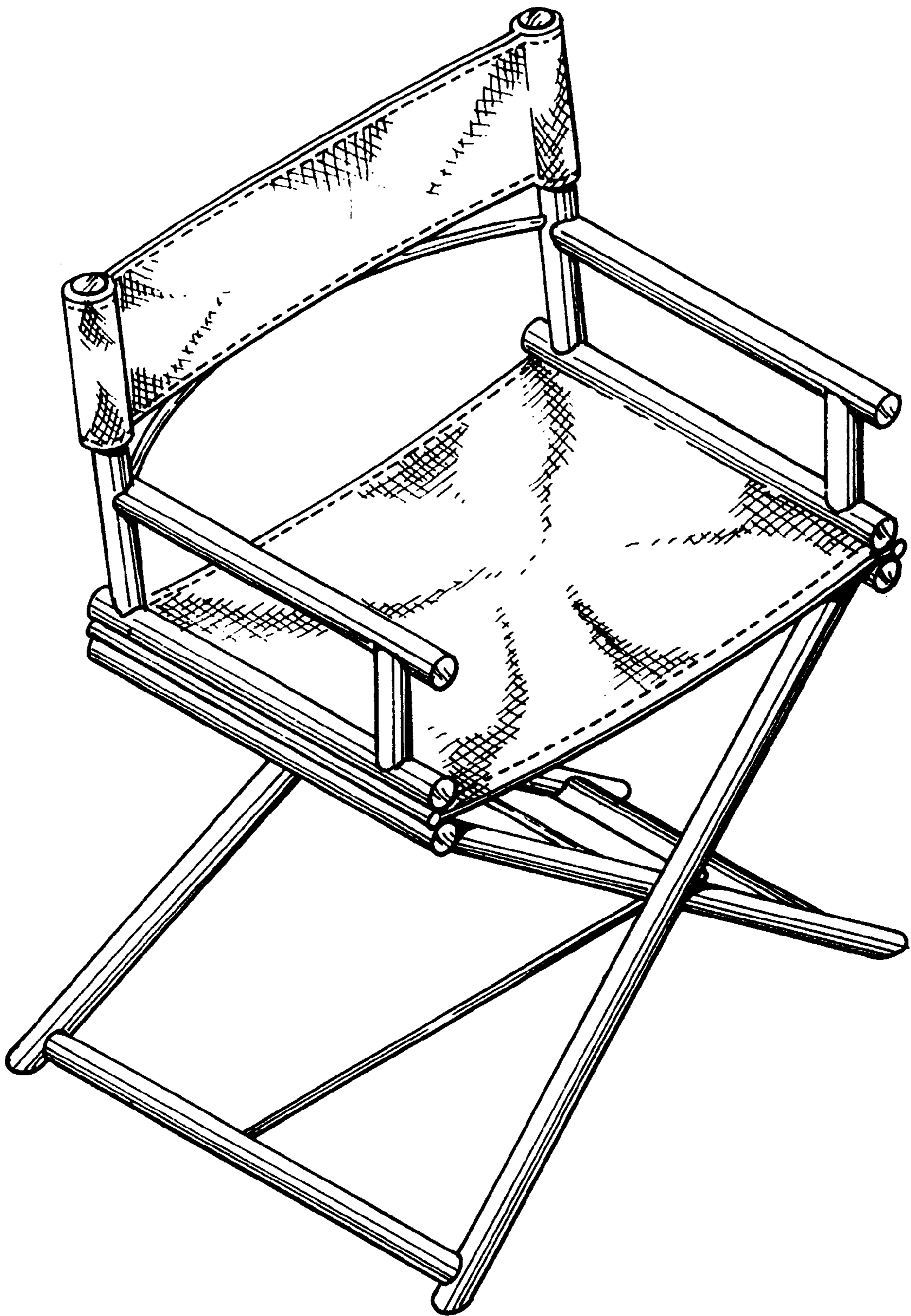

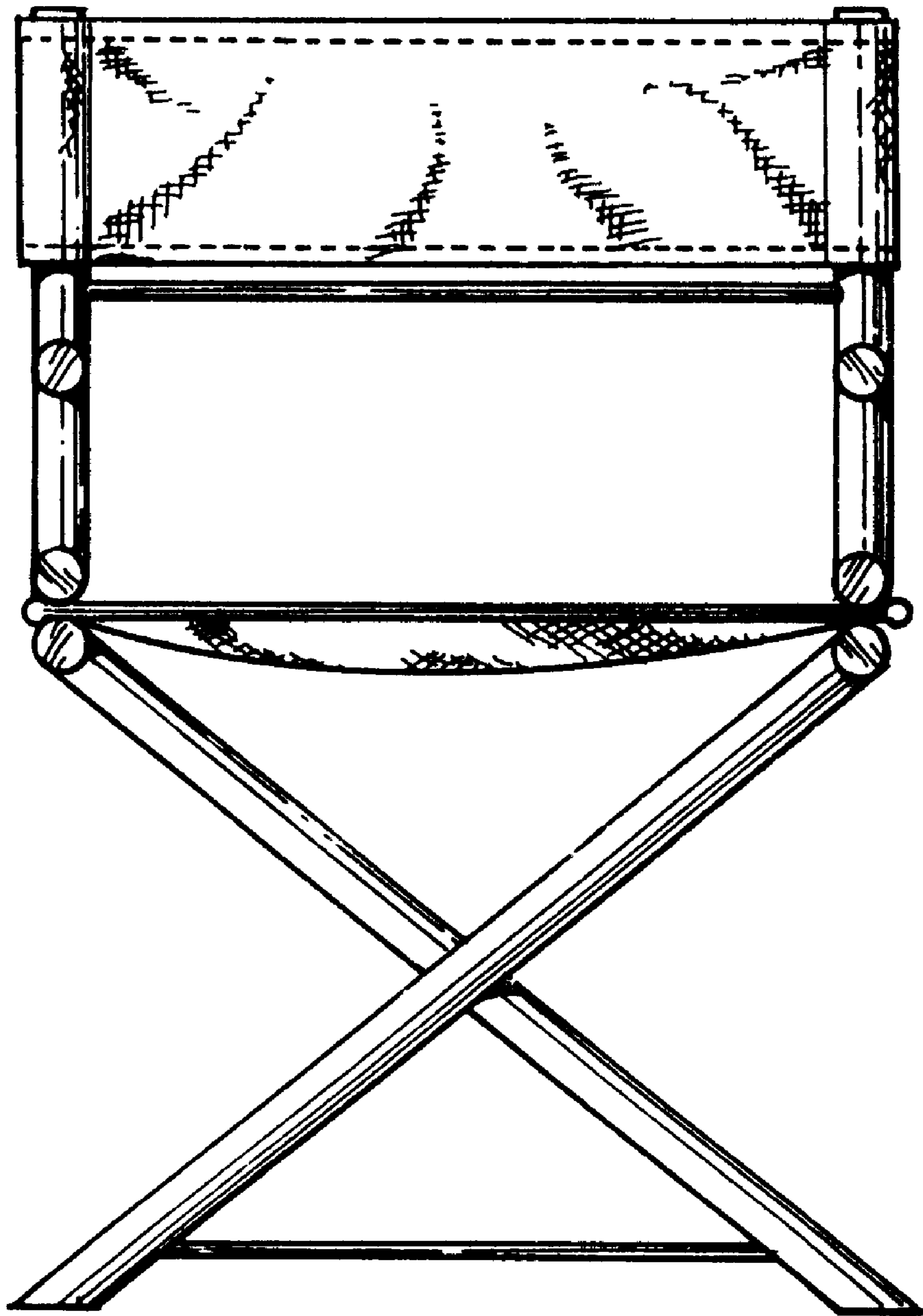

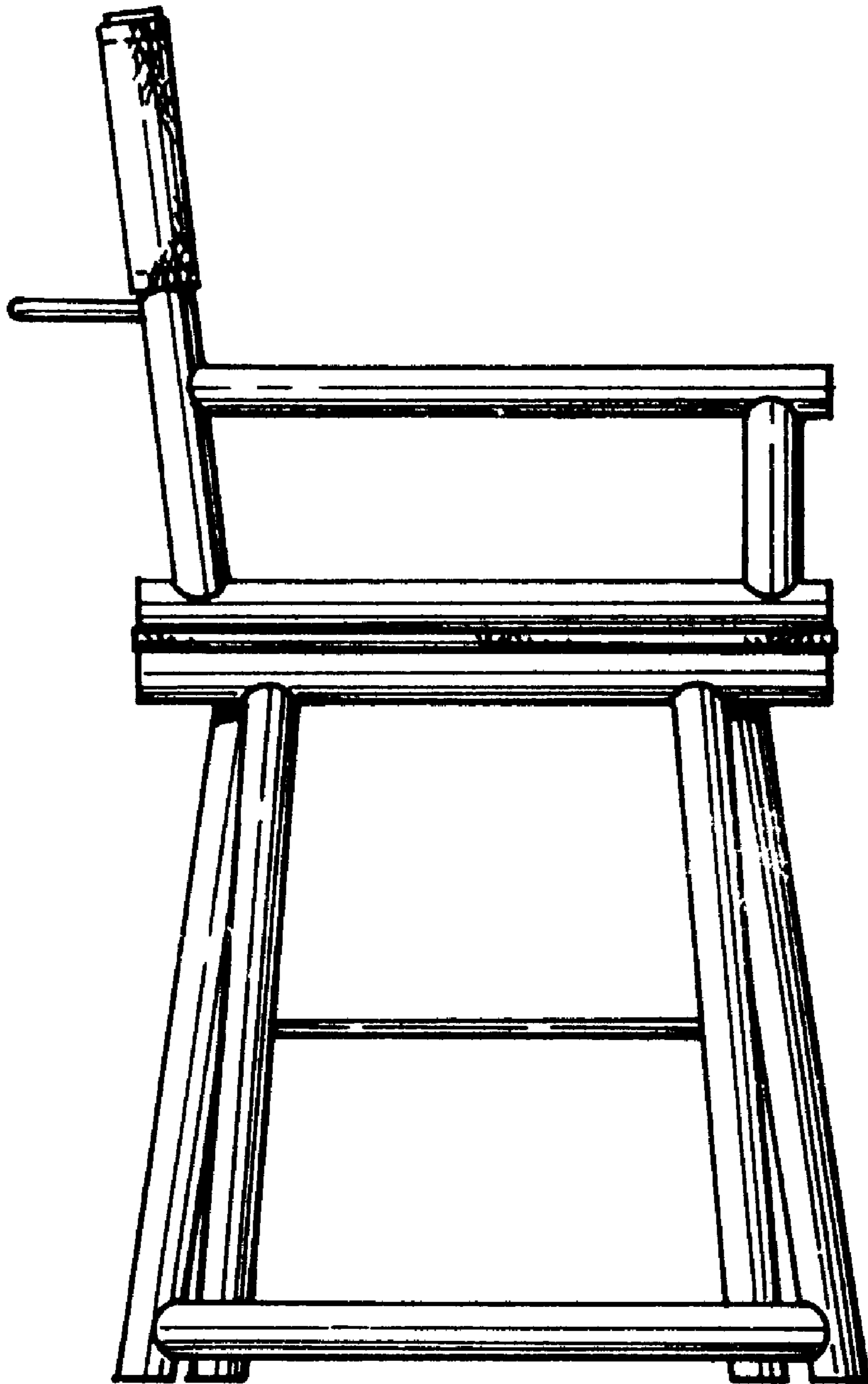

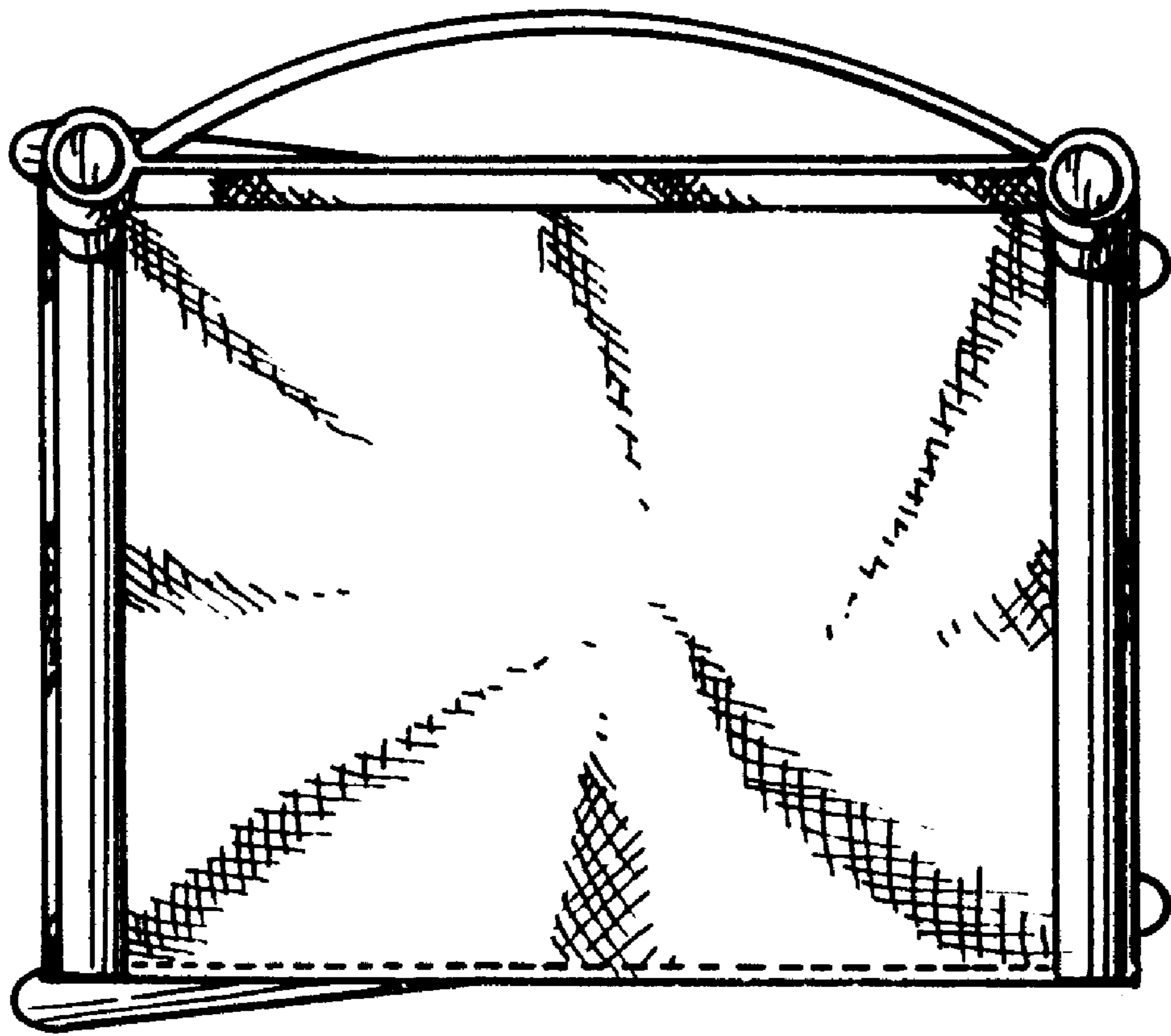

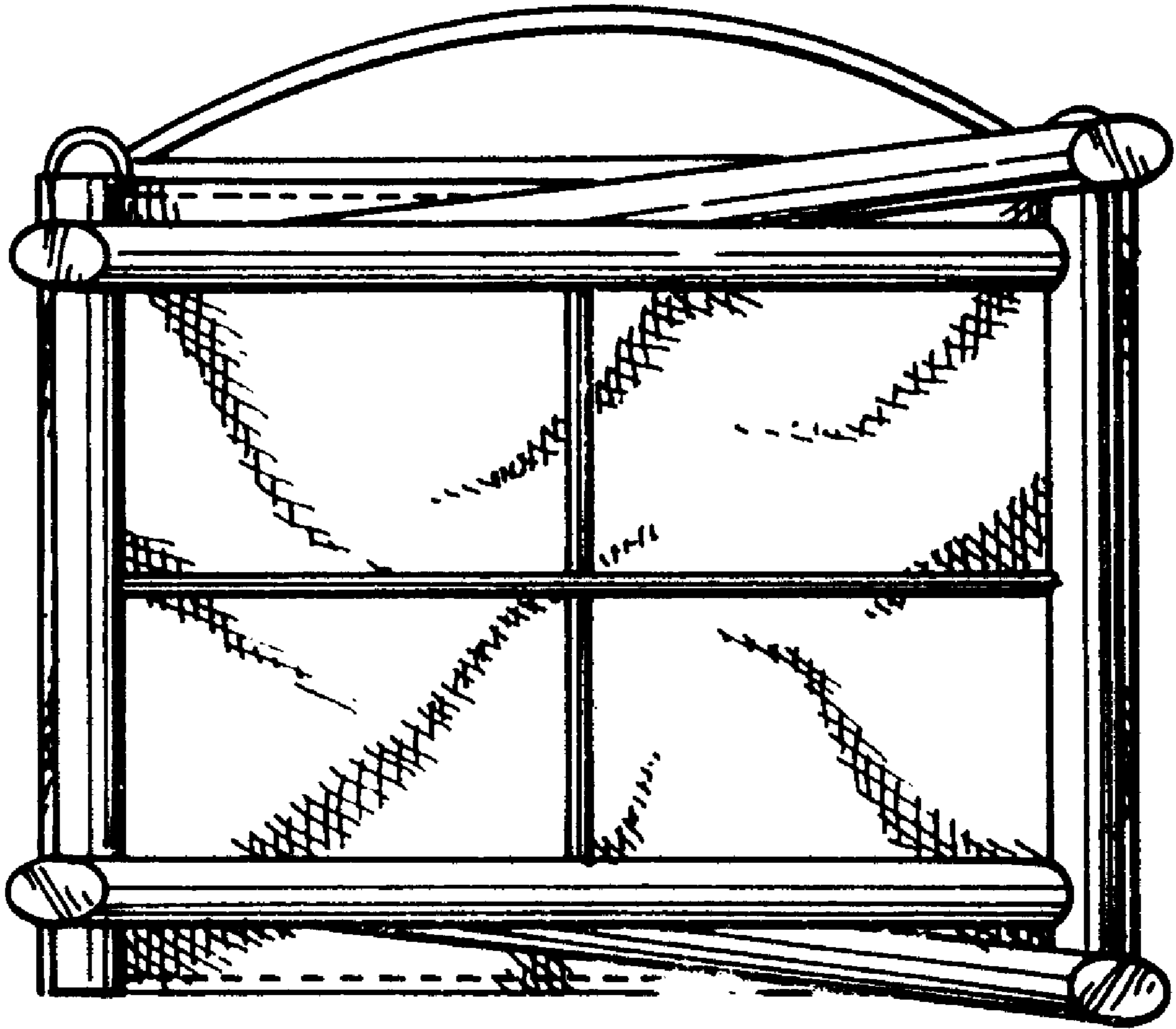

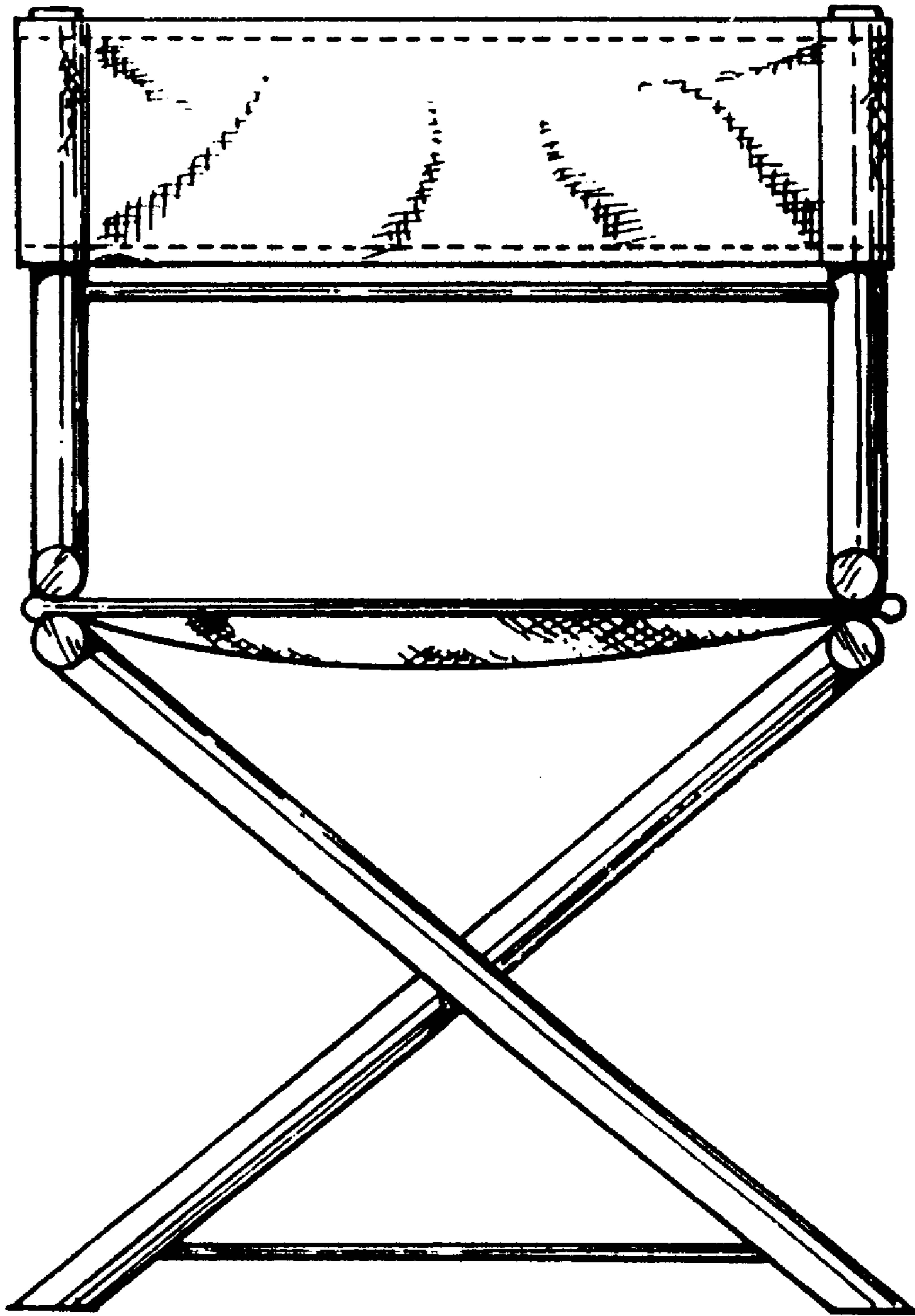
