FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof.

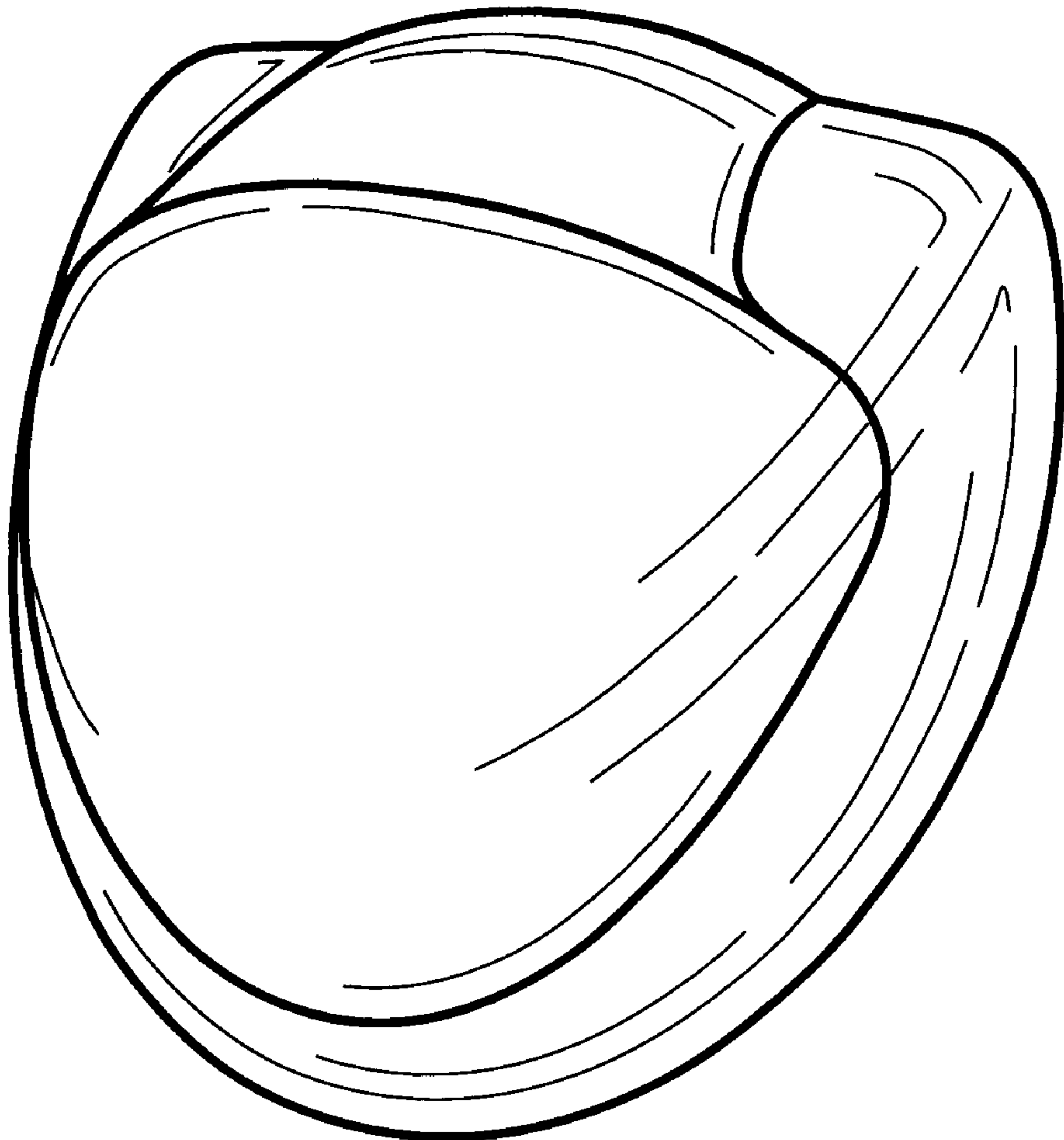
The rear and the bottom of the taillight are not visible during normal use.

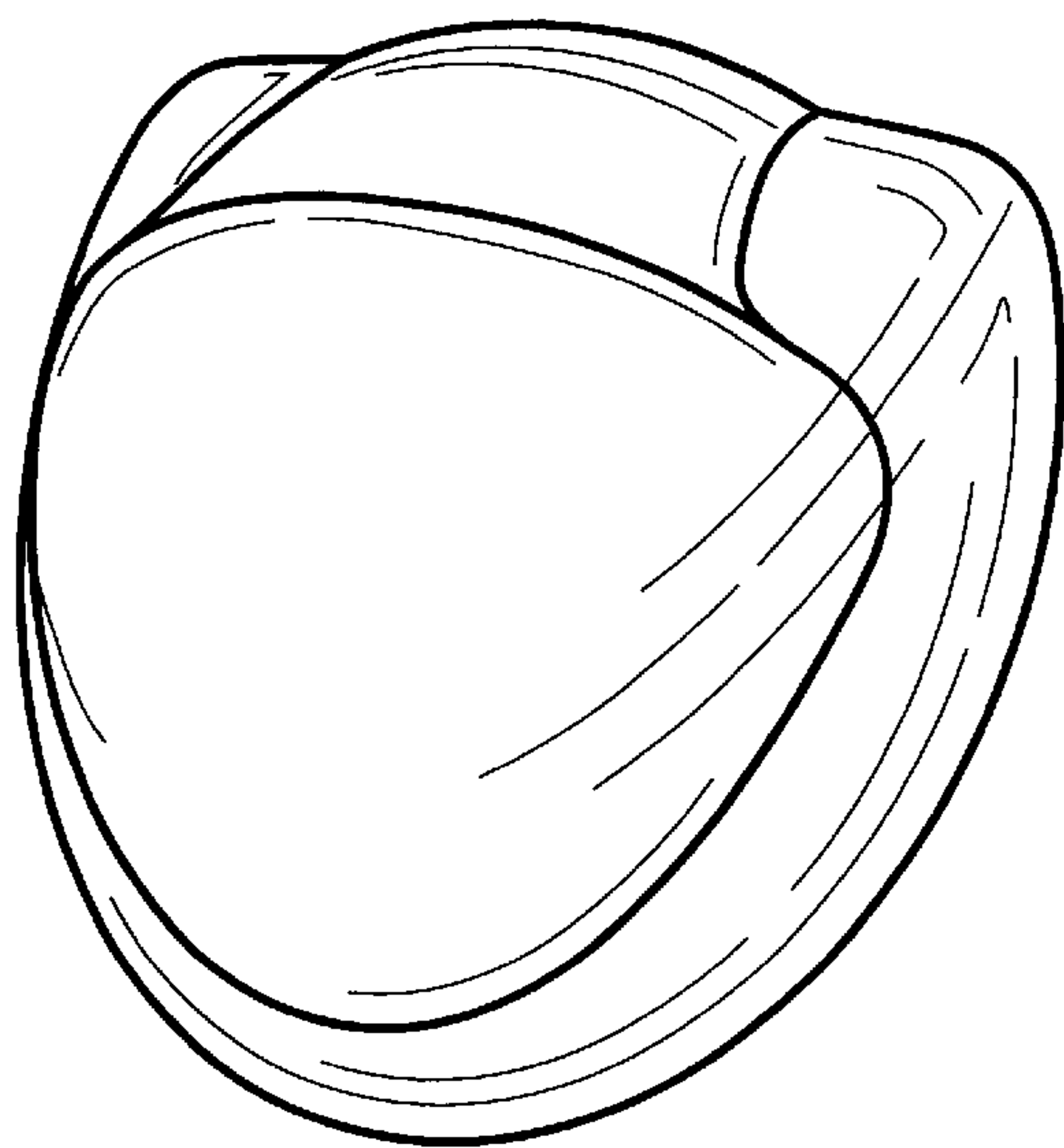

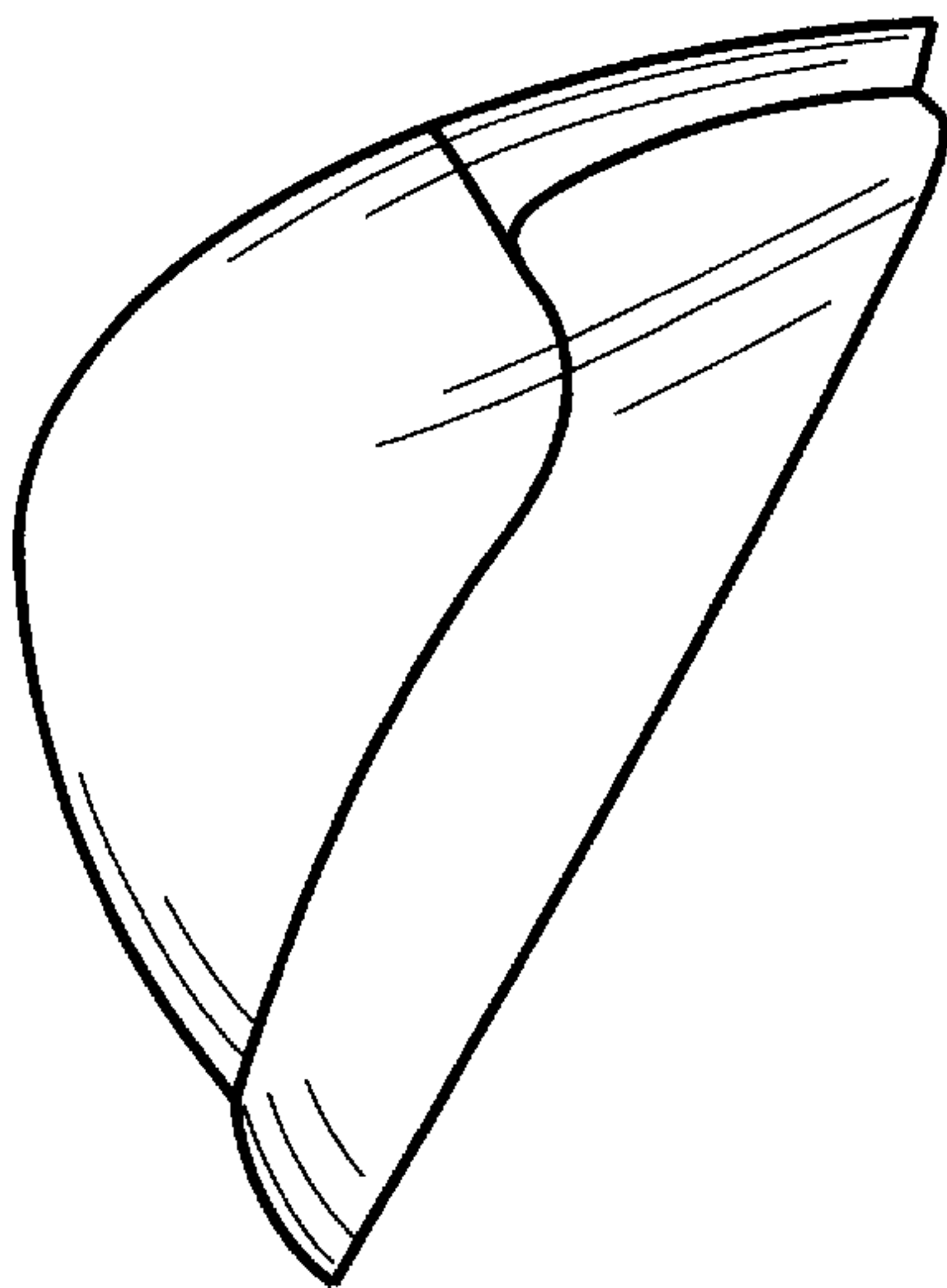

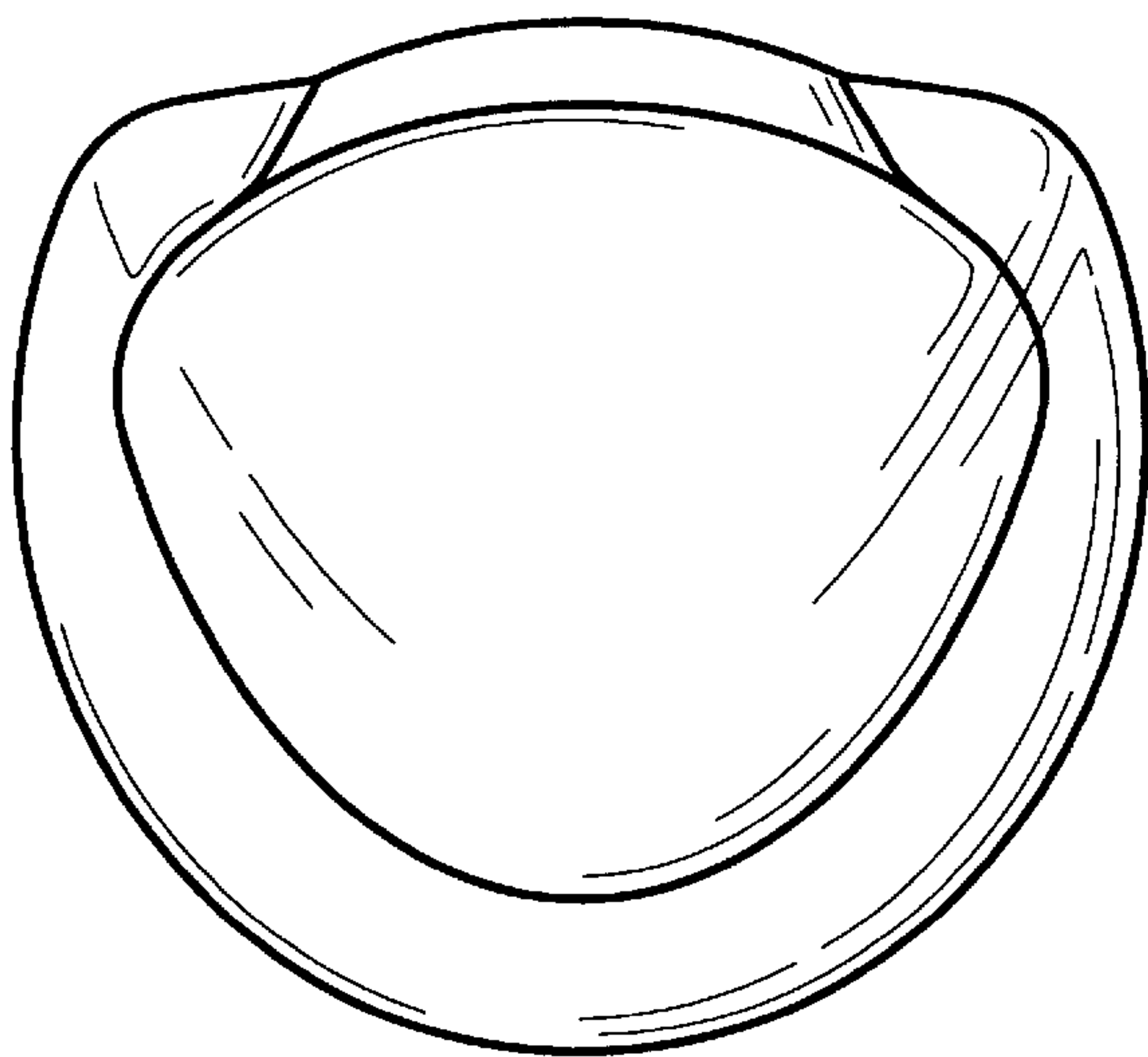

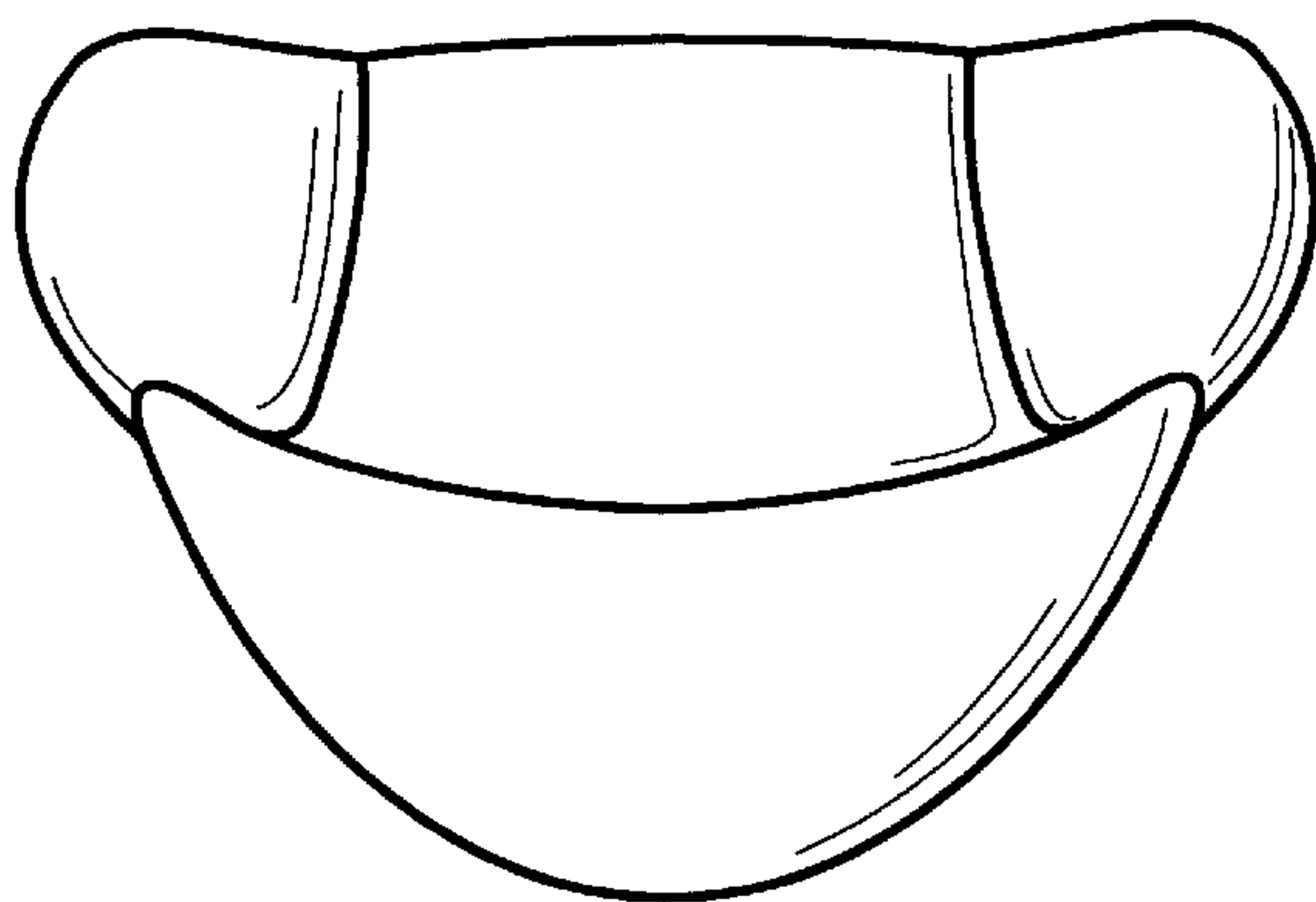
