FIG. 4 is a right elevation view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1;

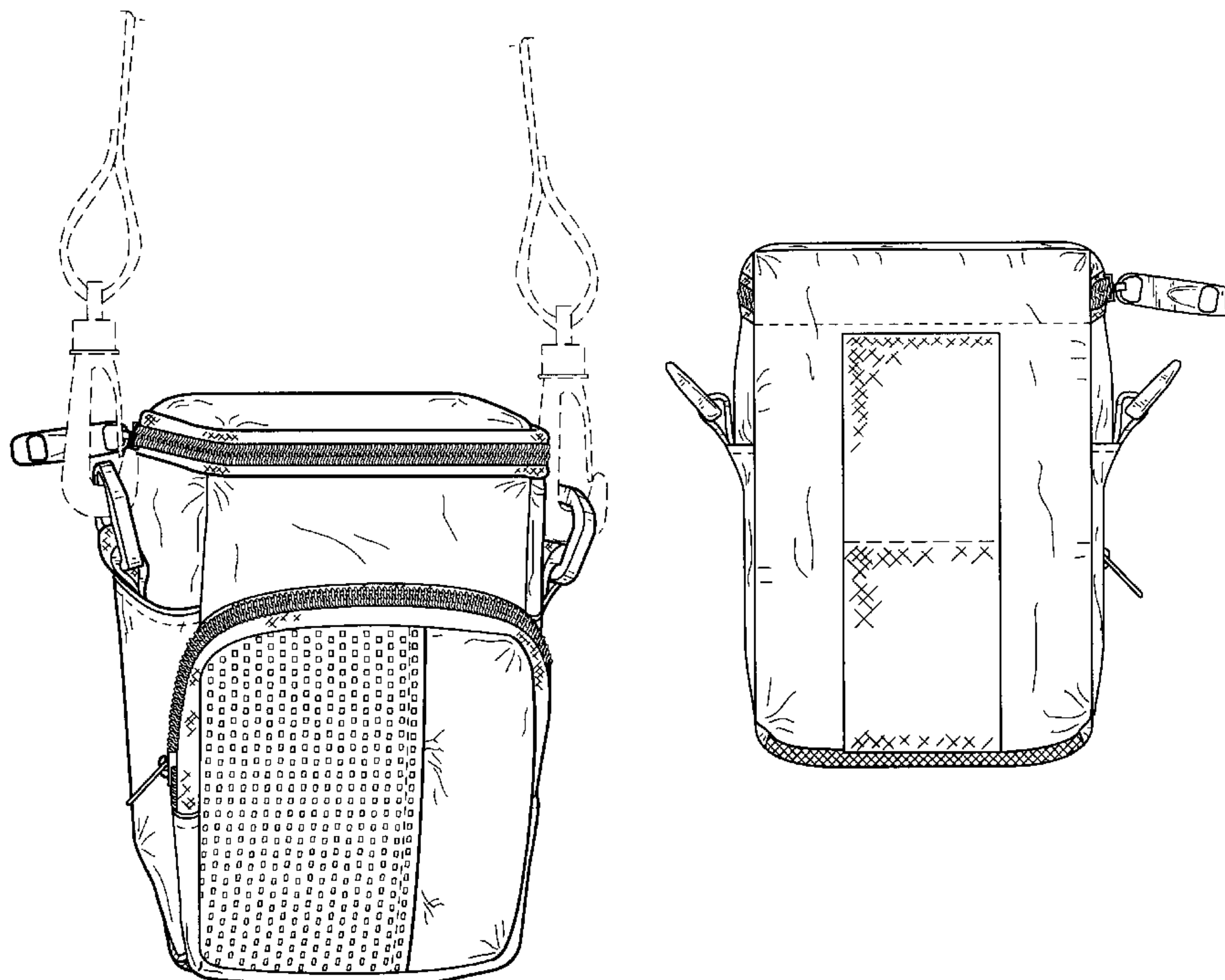
FIG. 5 is left elevation view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1;

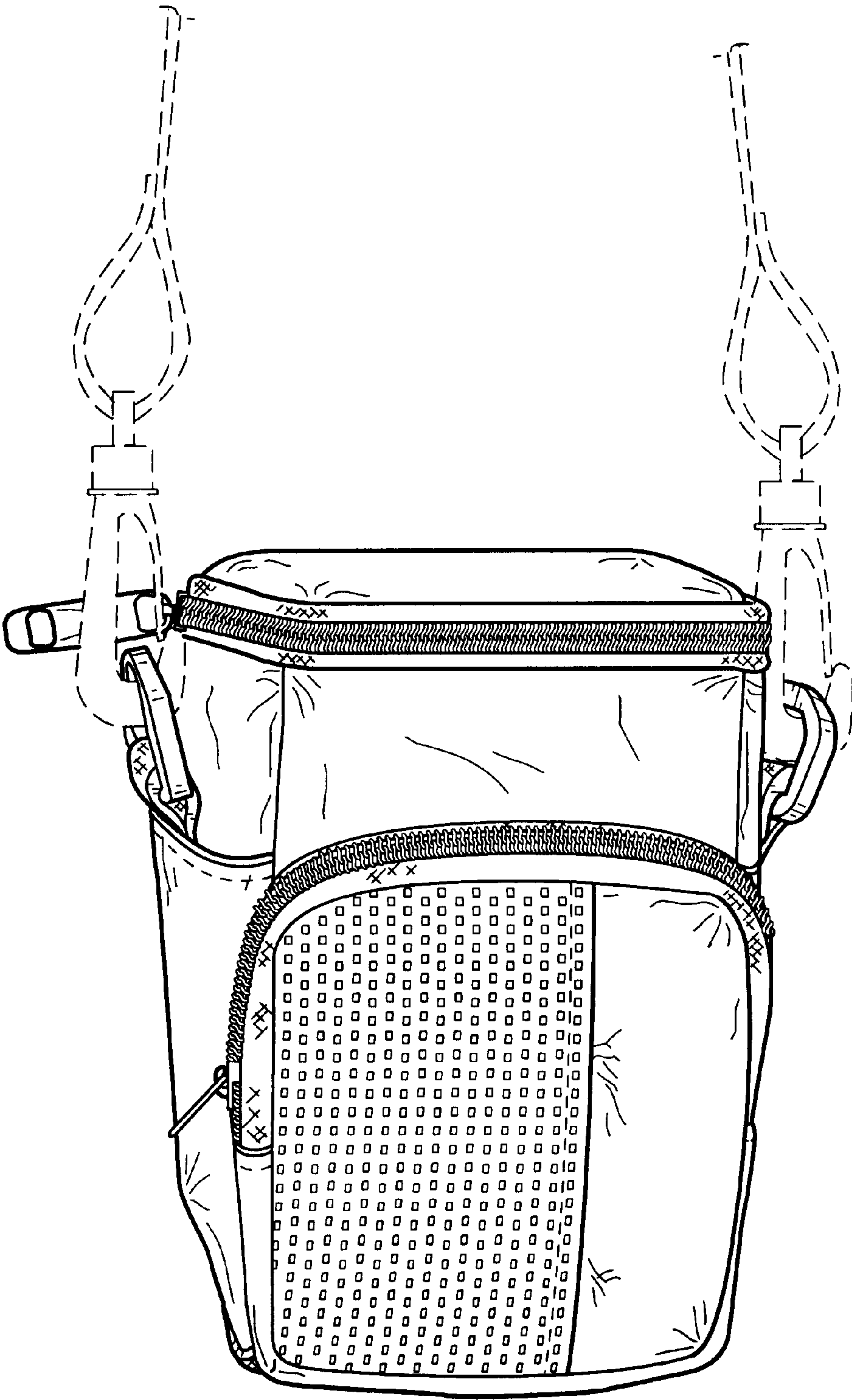

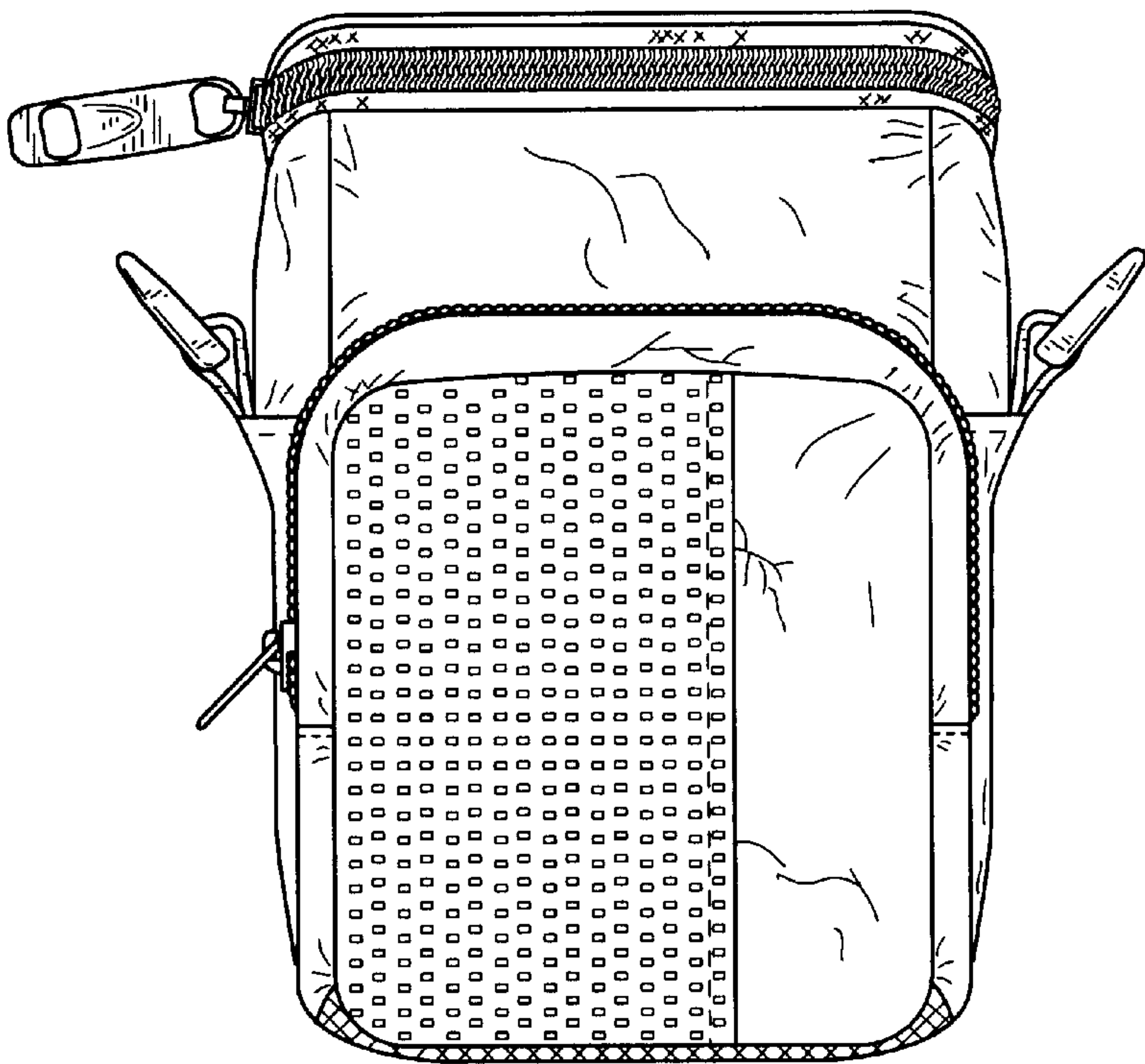

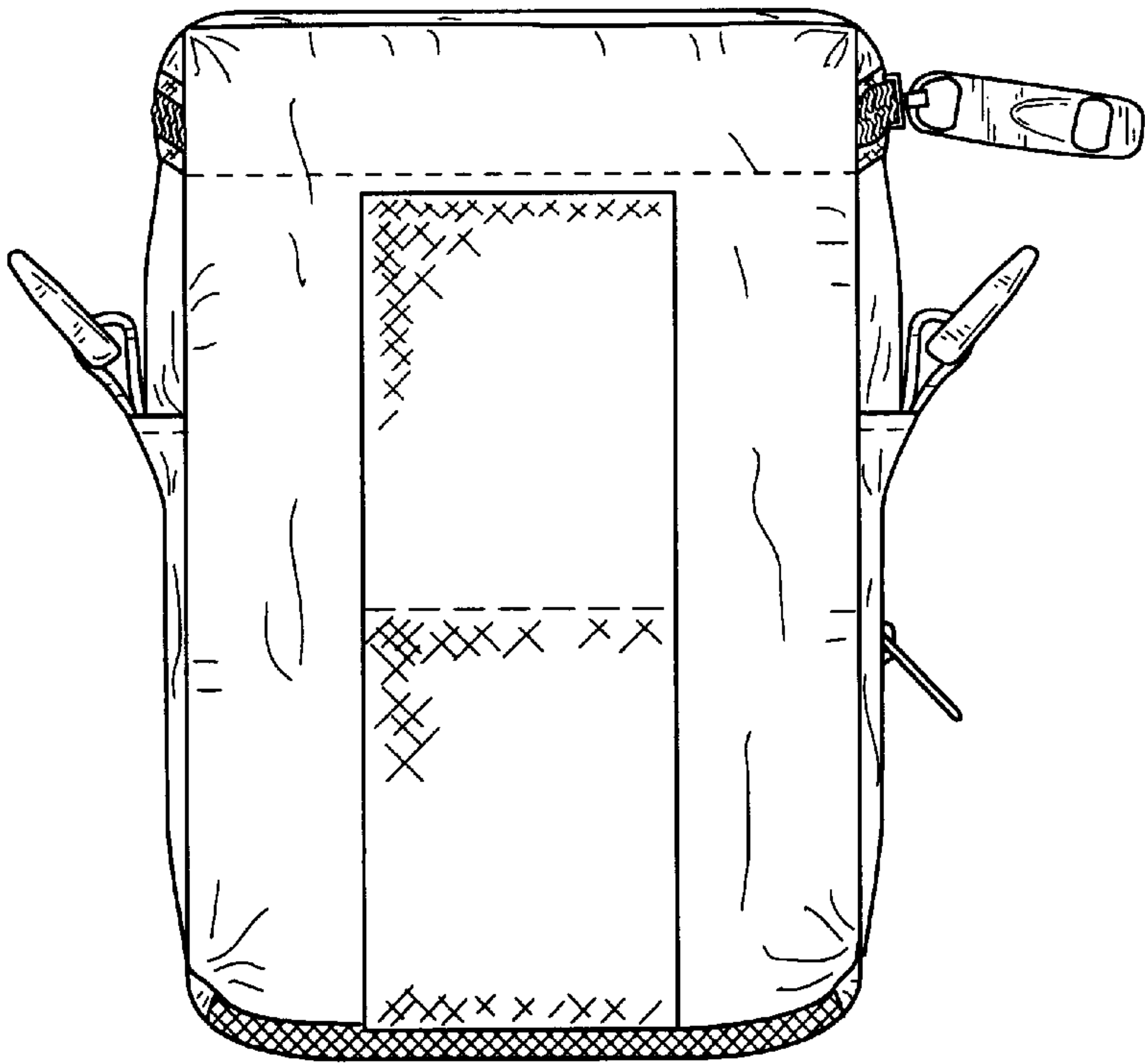

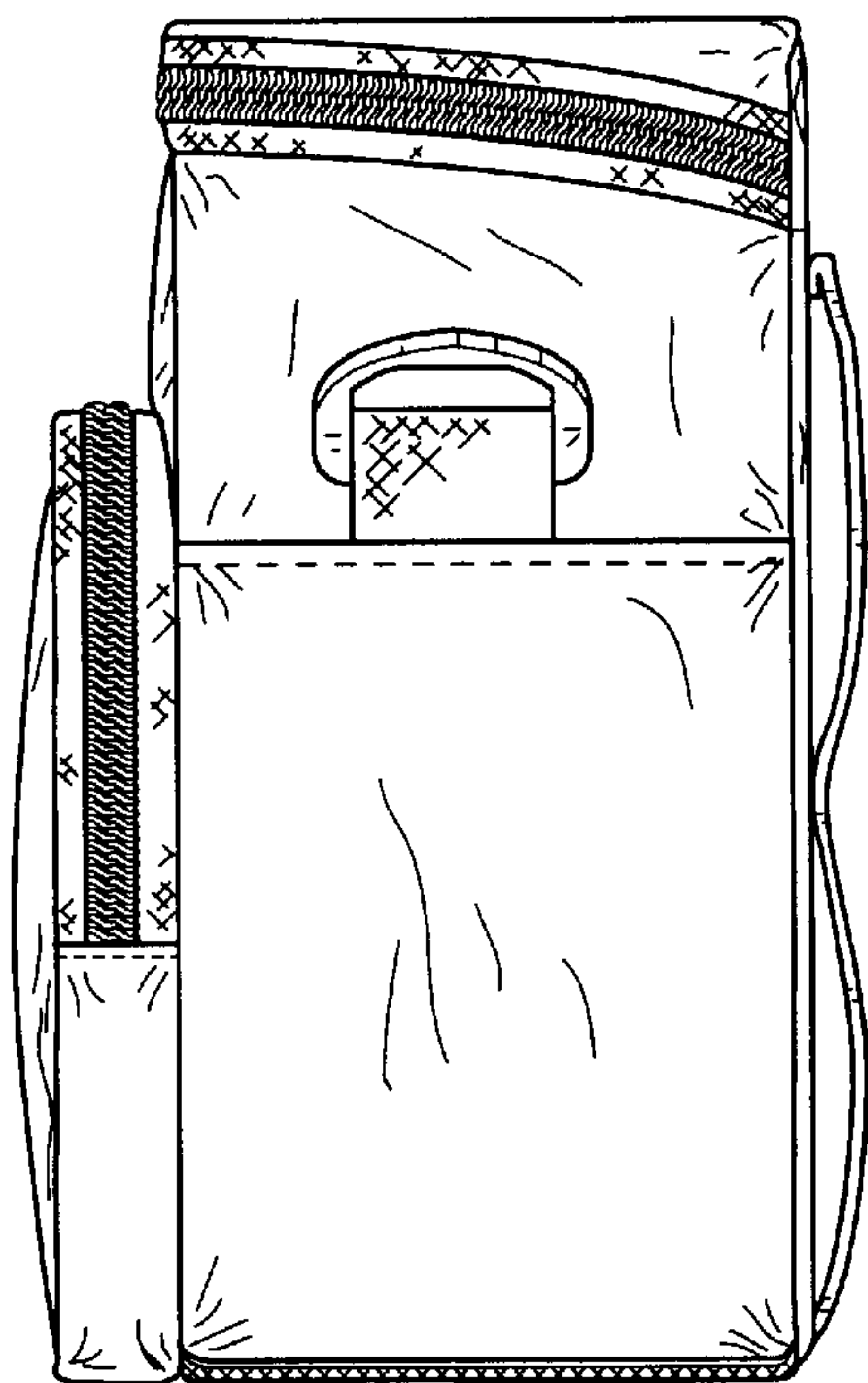

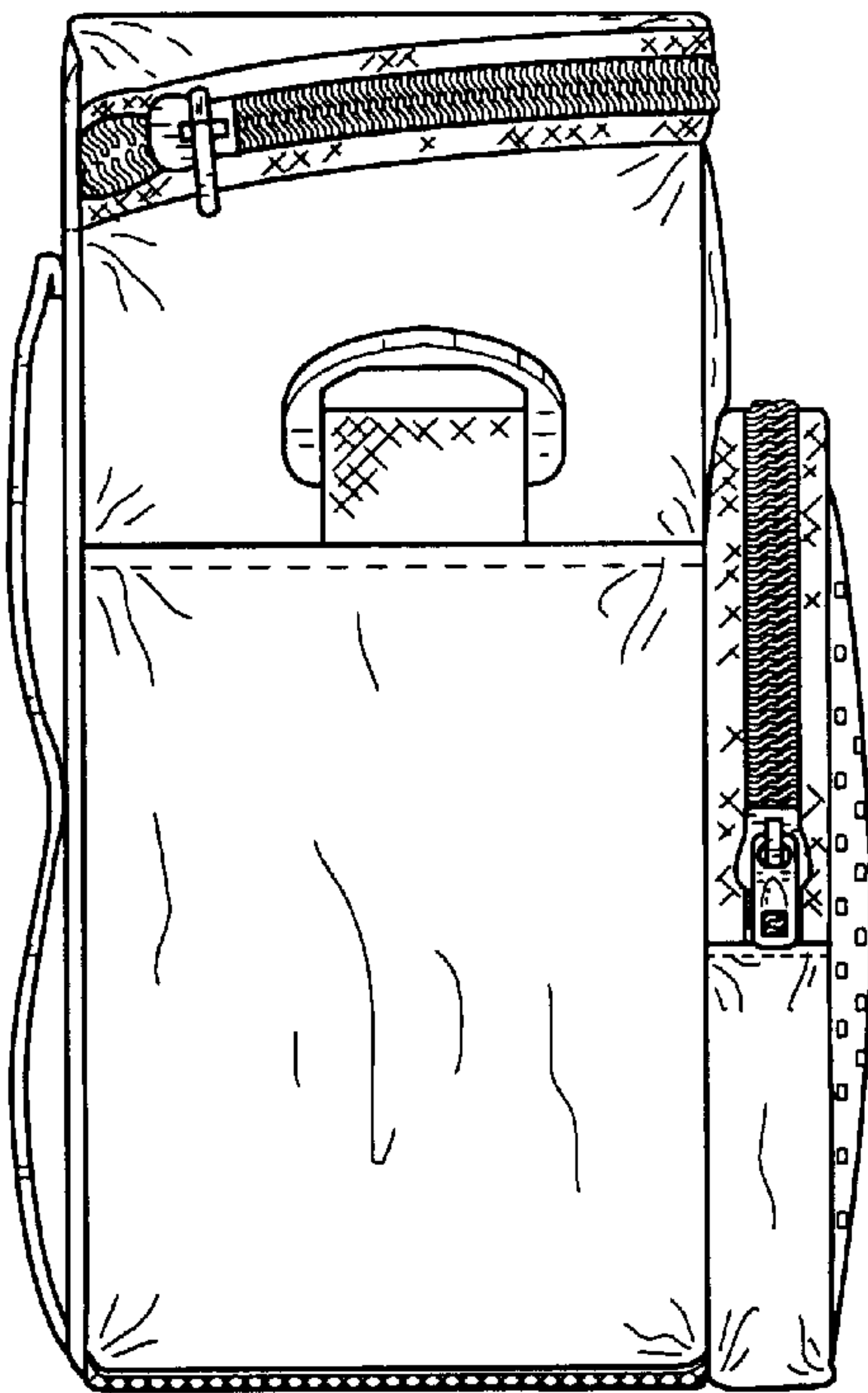

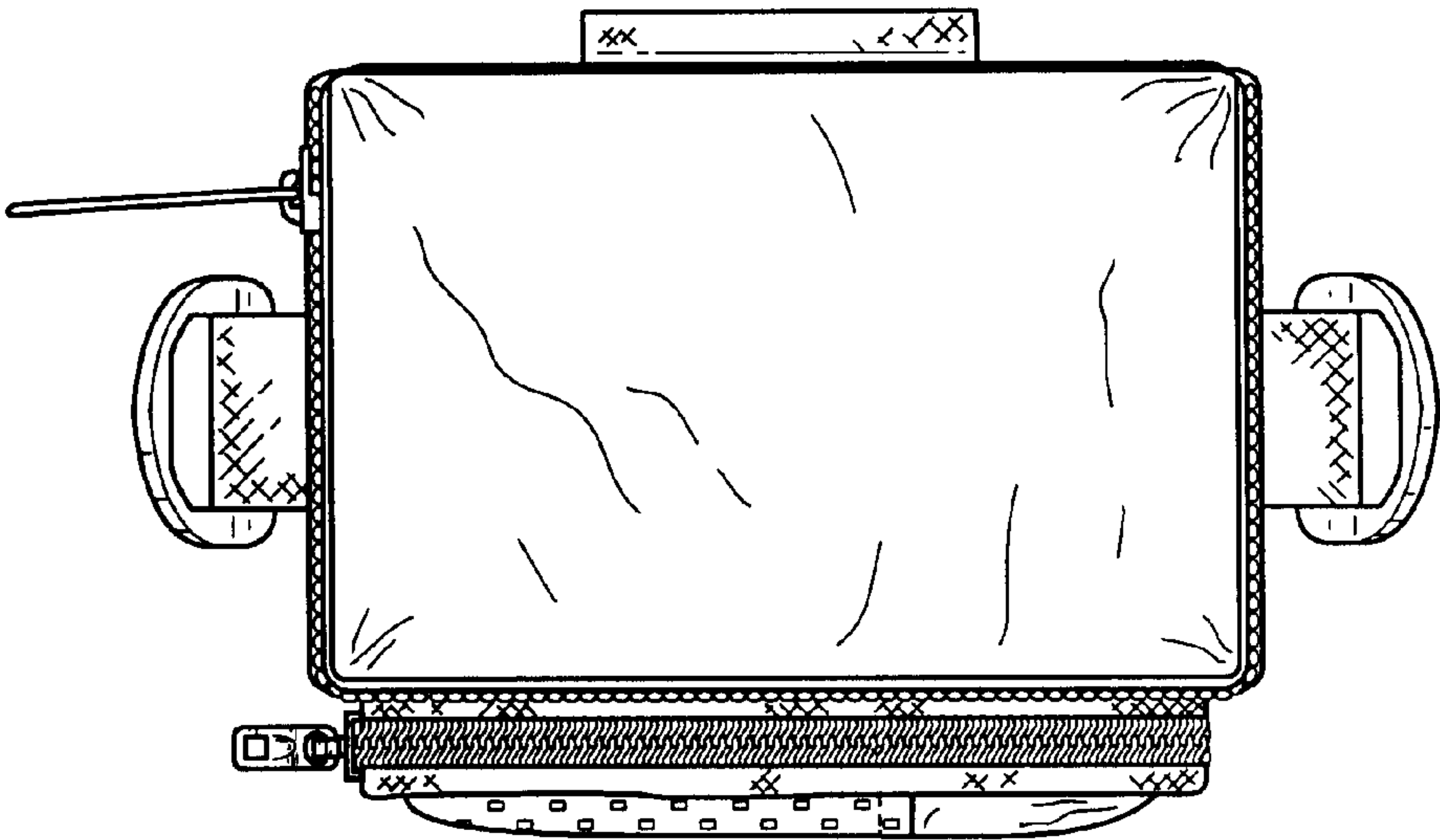

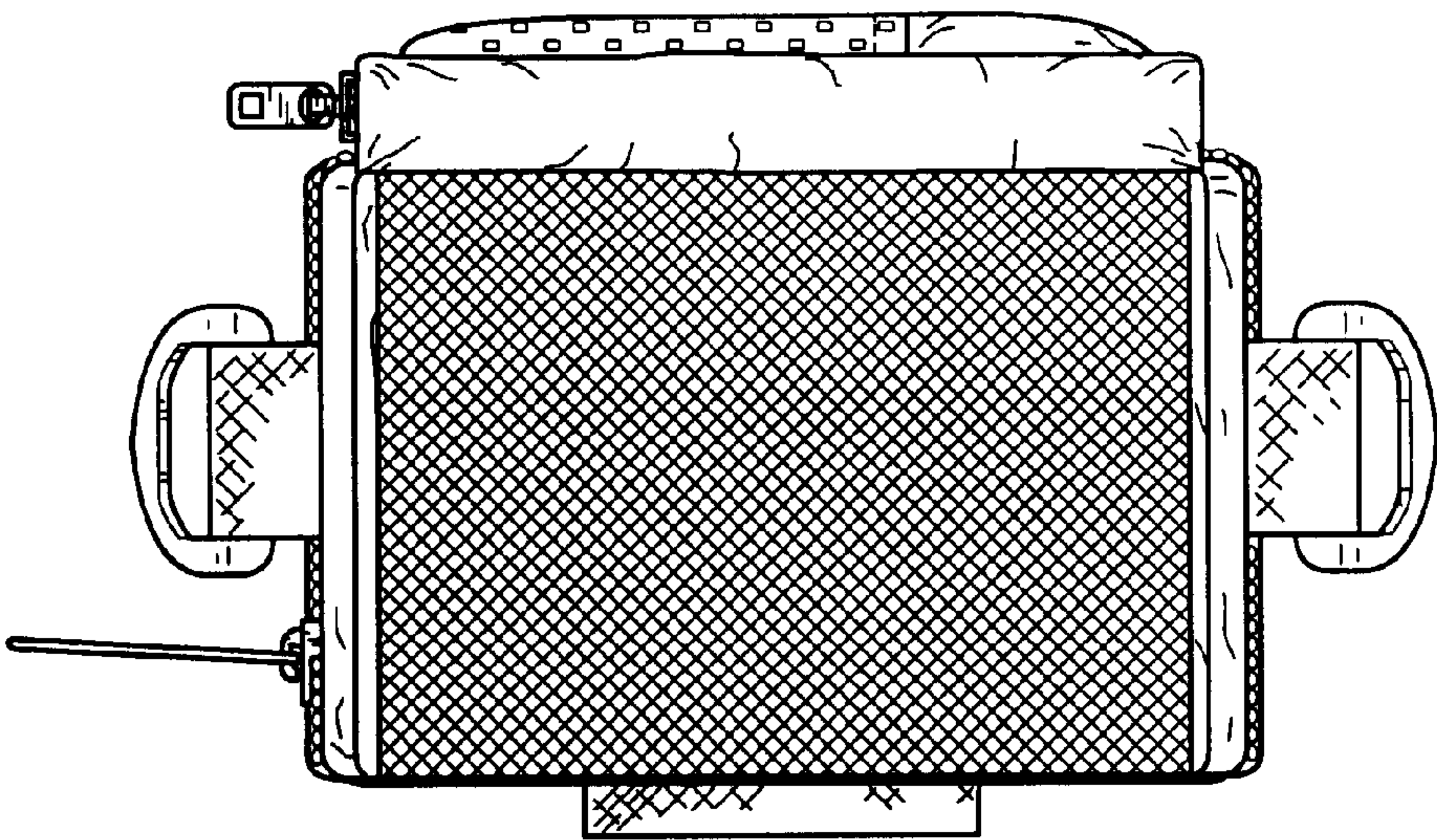
