(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a lounge chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of one preferred embodiment of a lounge chair in accordance with my invention;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevation view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 17 is a rear elevation view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 15;

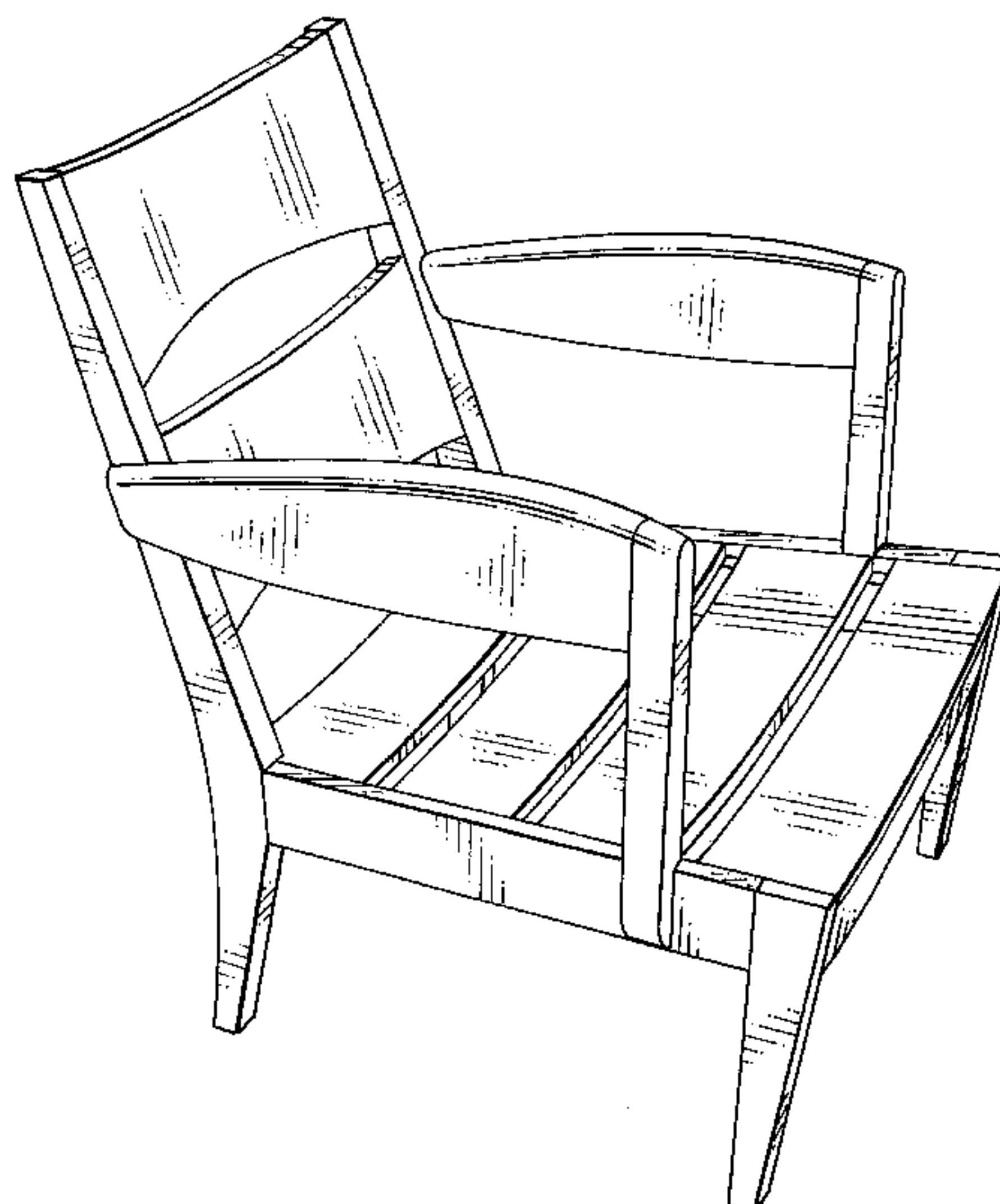
FIG. 18 is a right side elevation view of the lounge chair shown in FIG. 15;

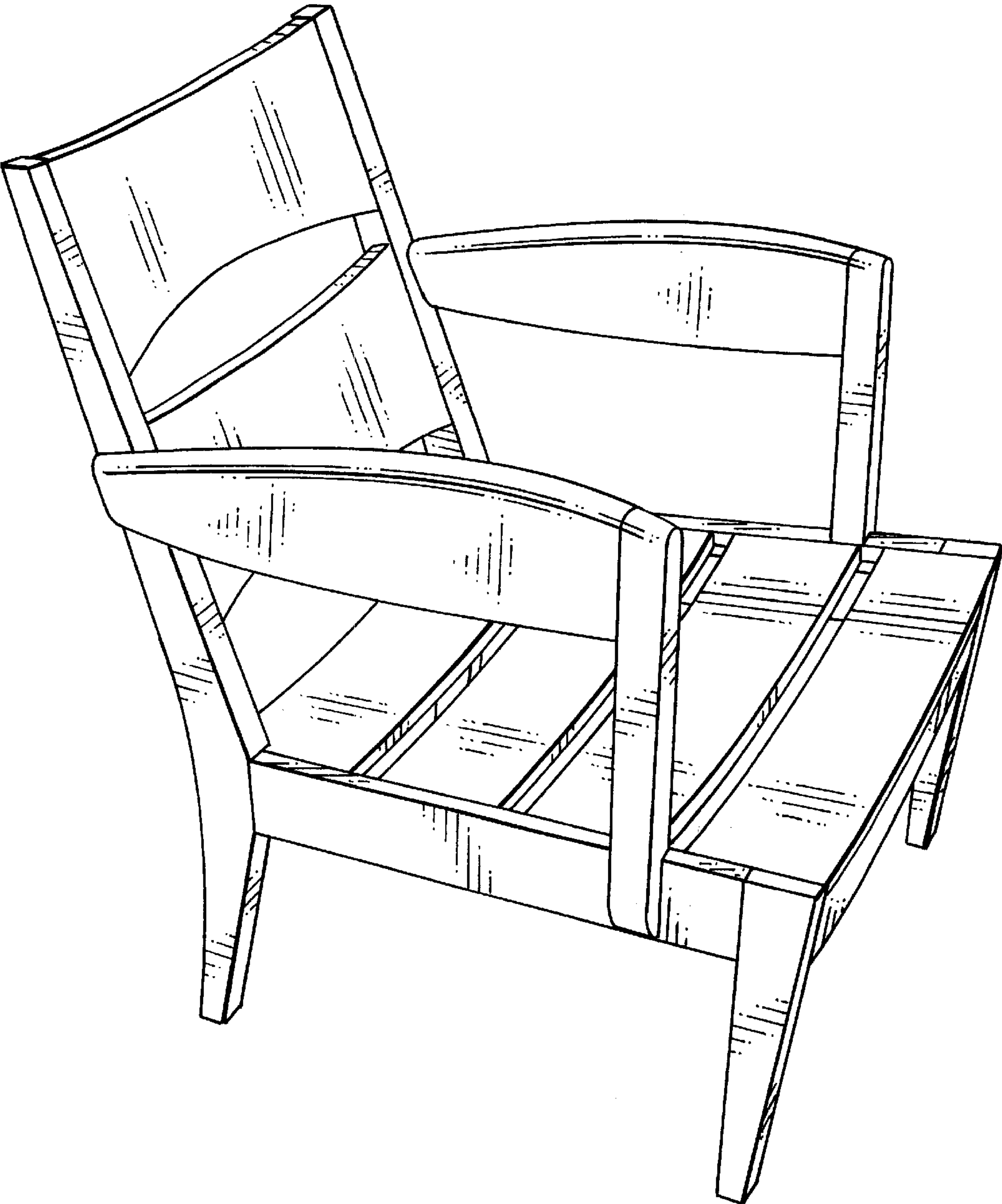

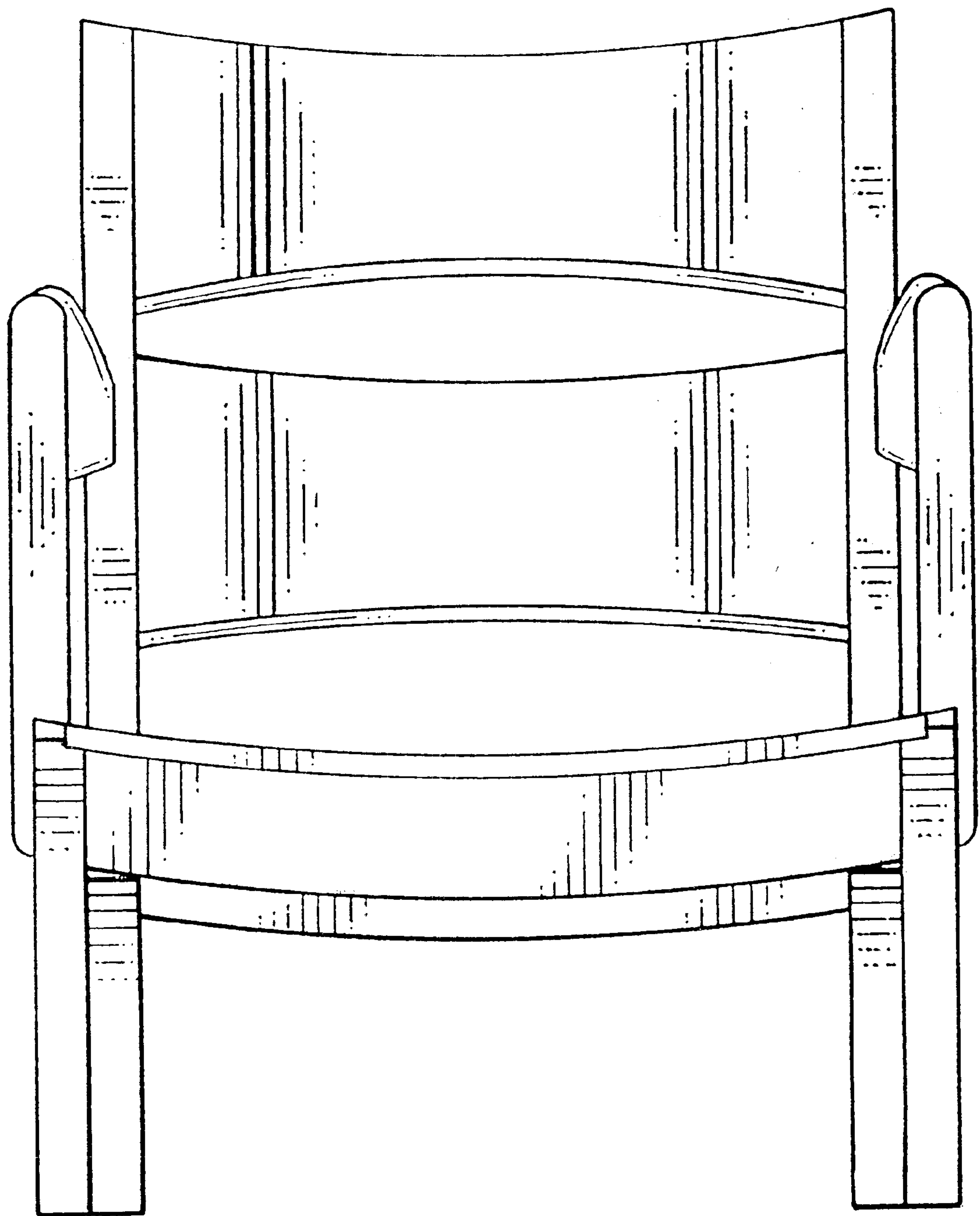

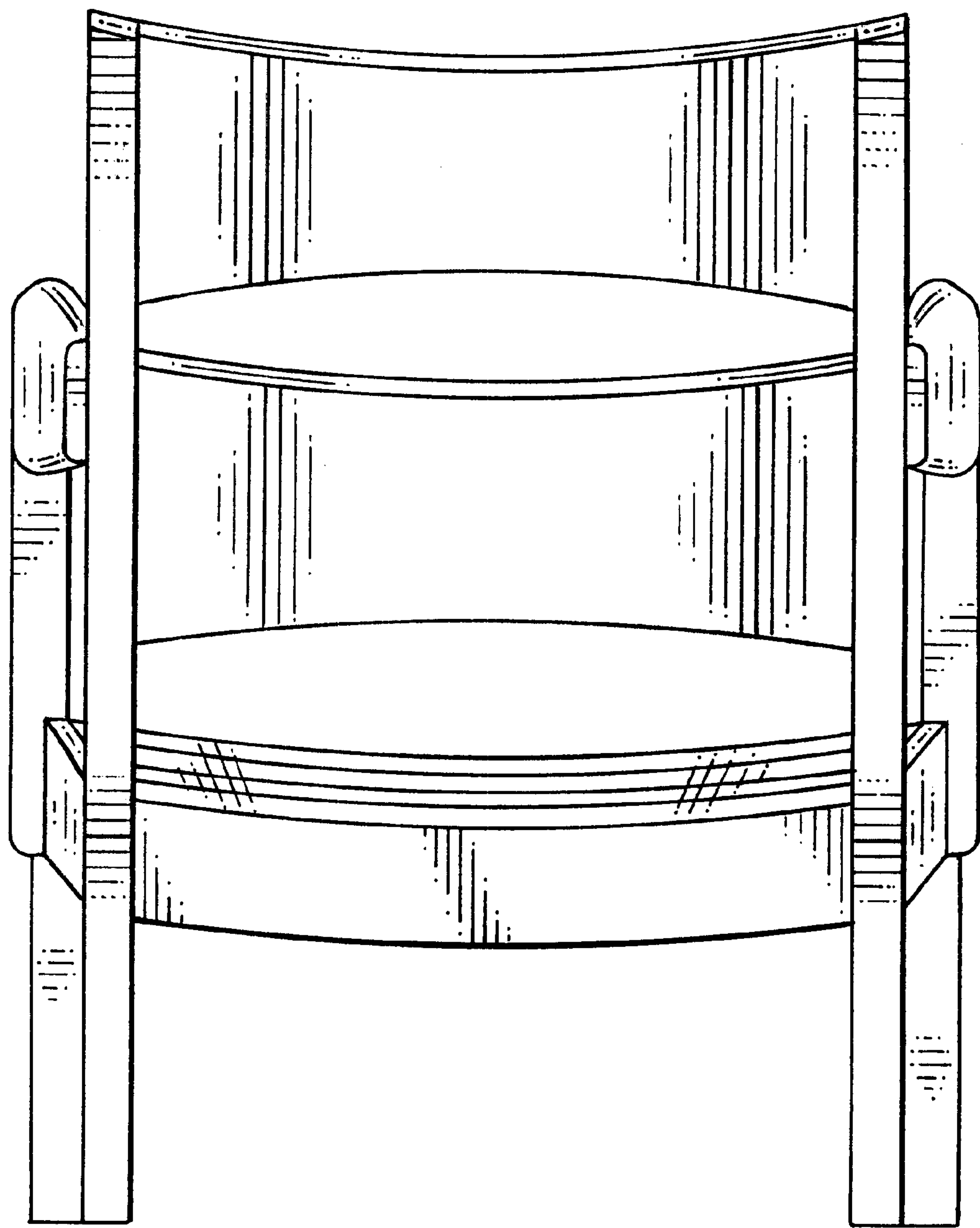

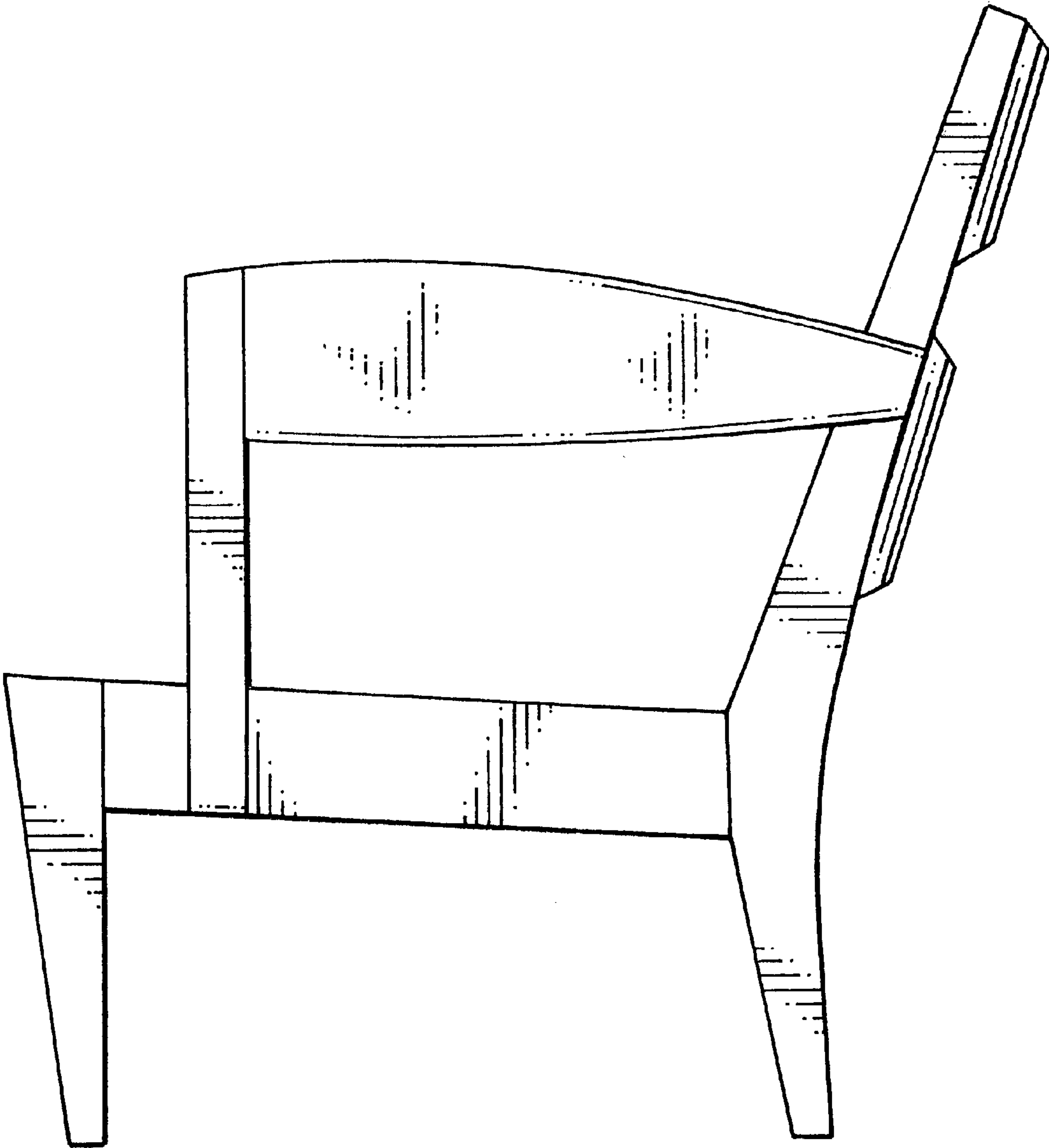

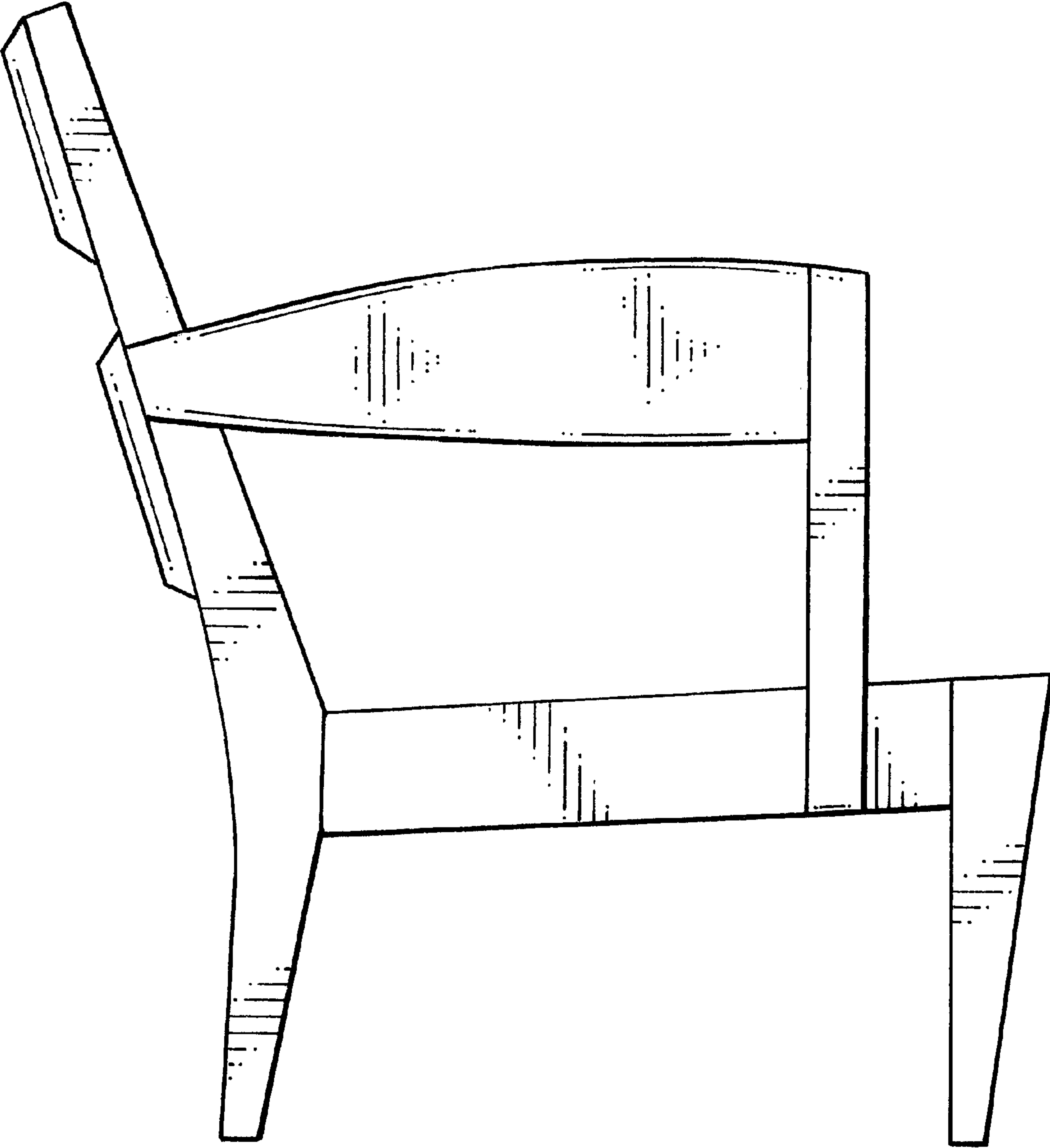

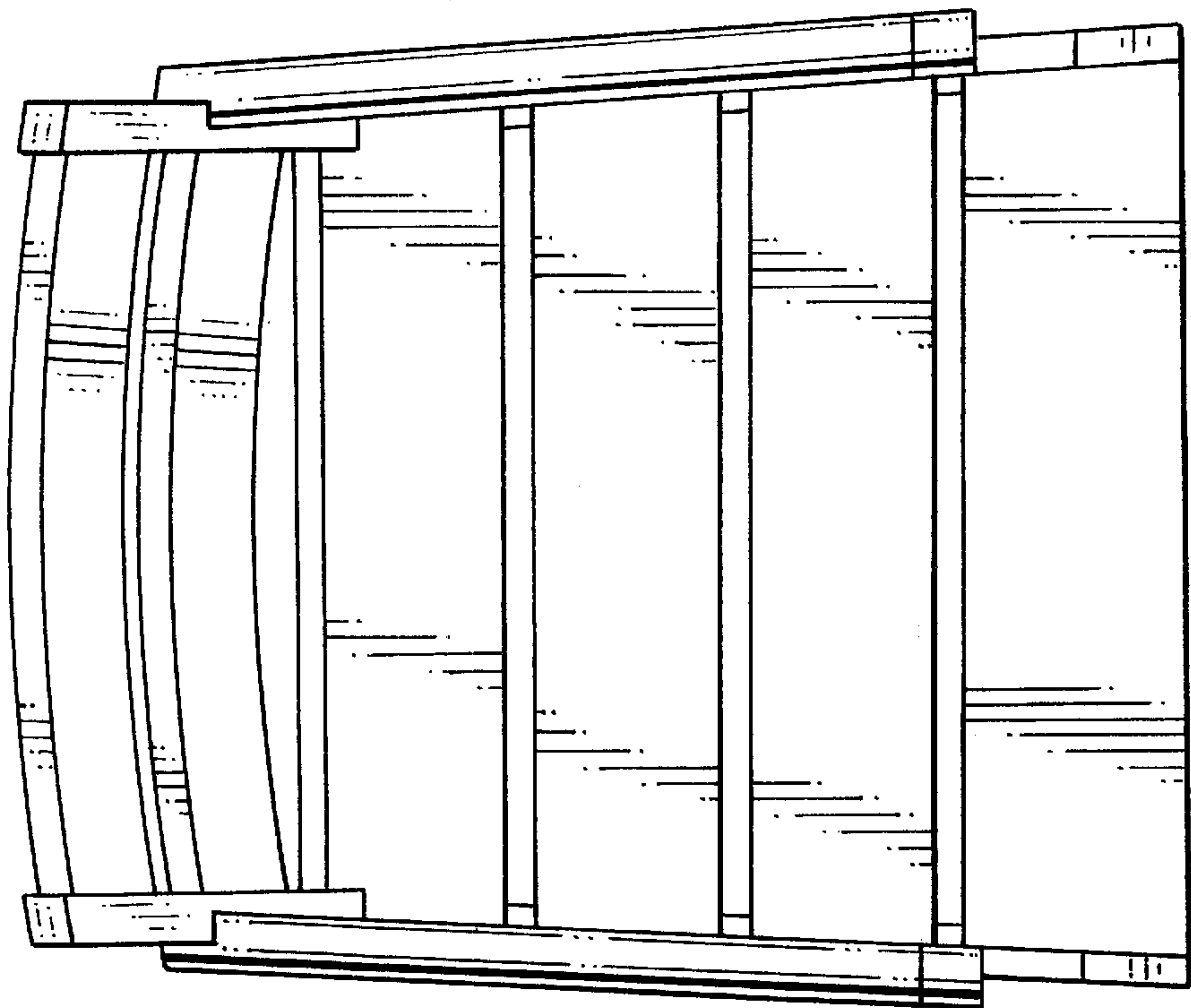

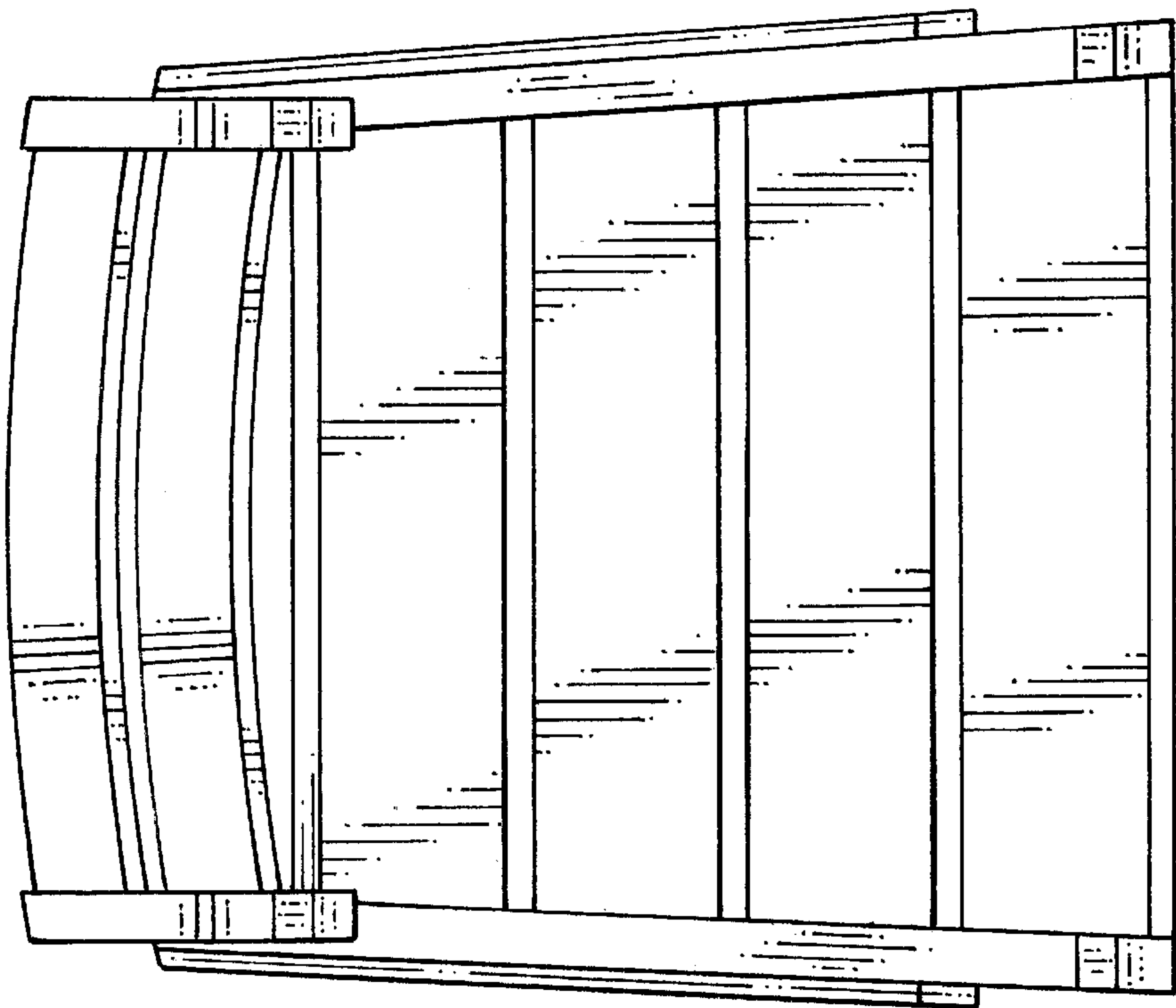

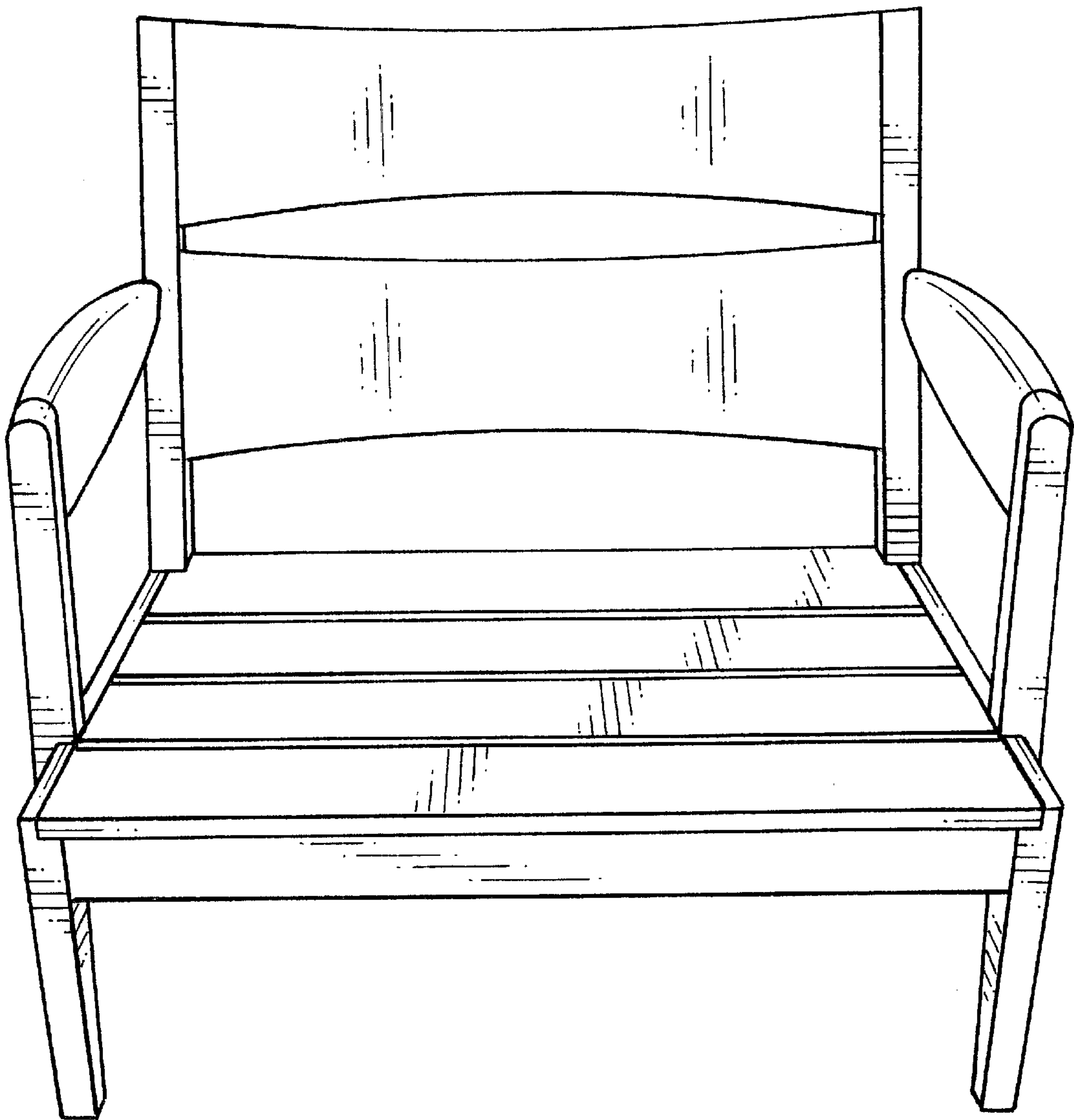

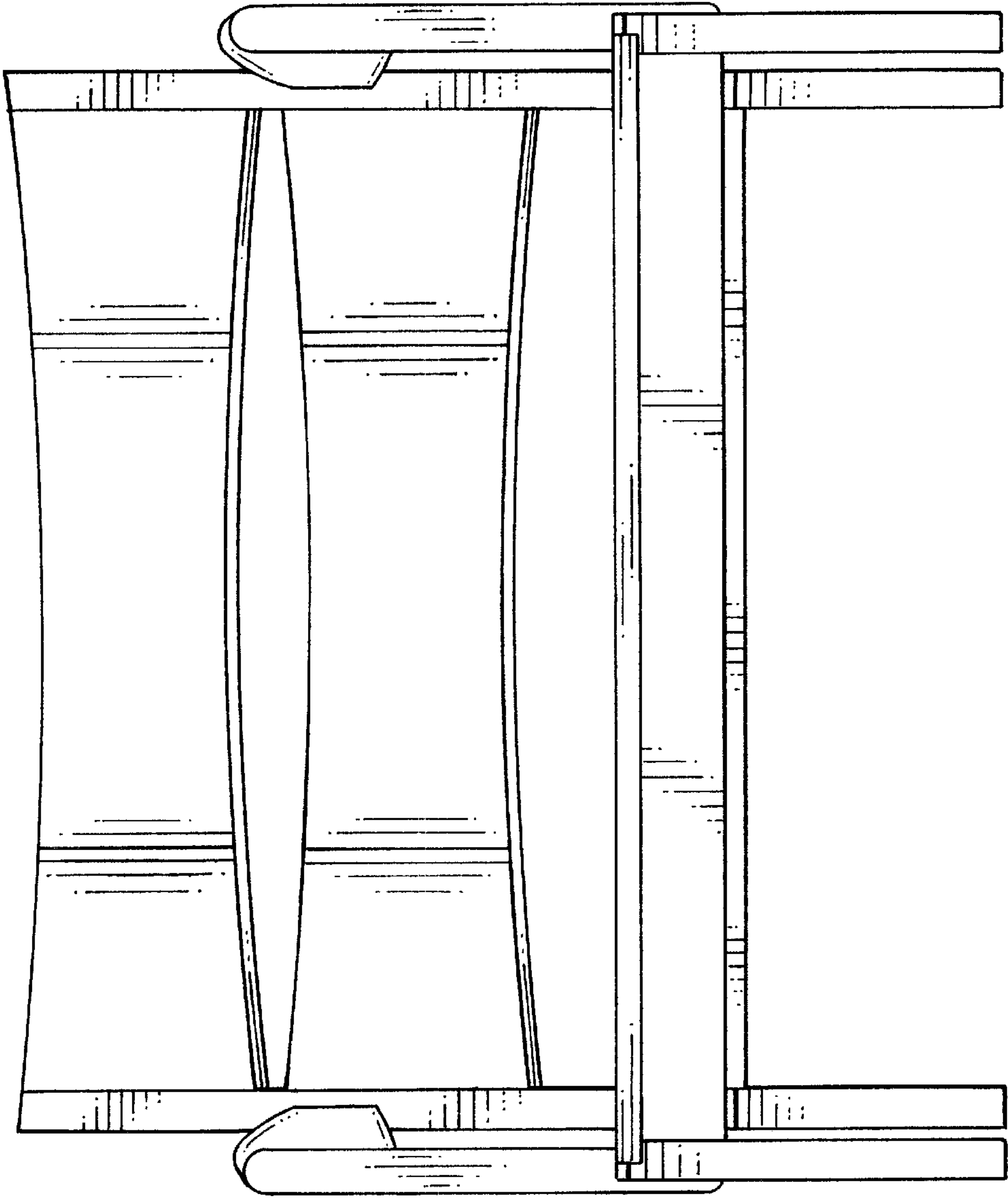

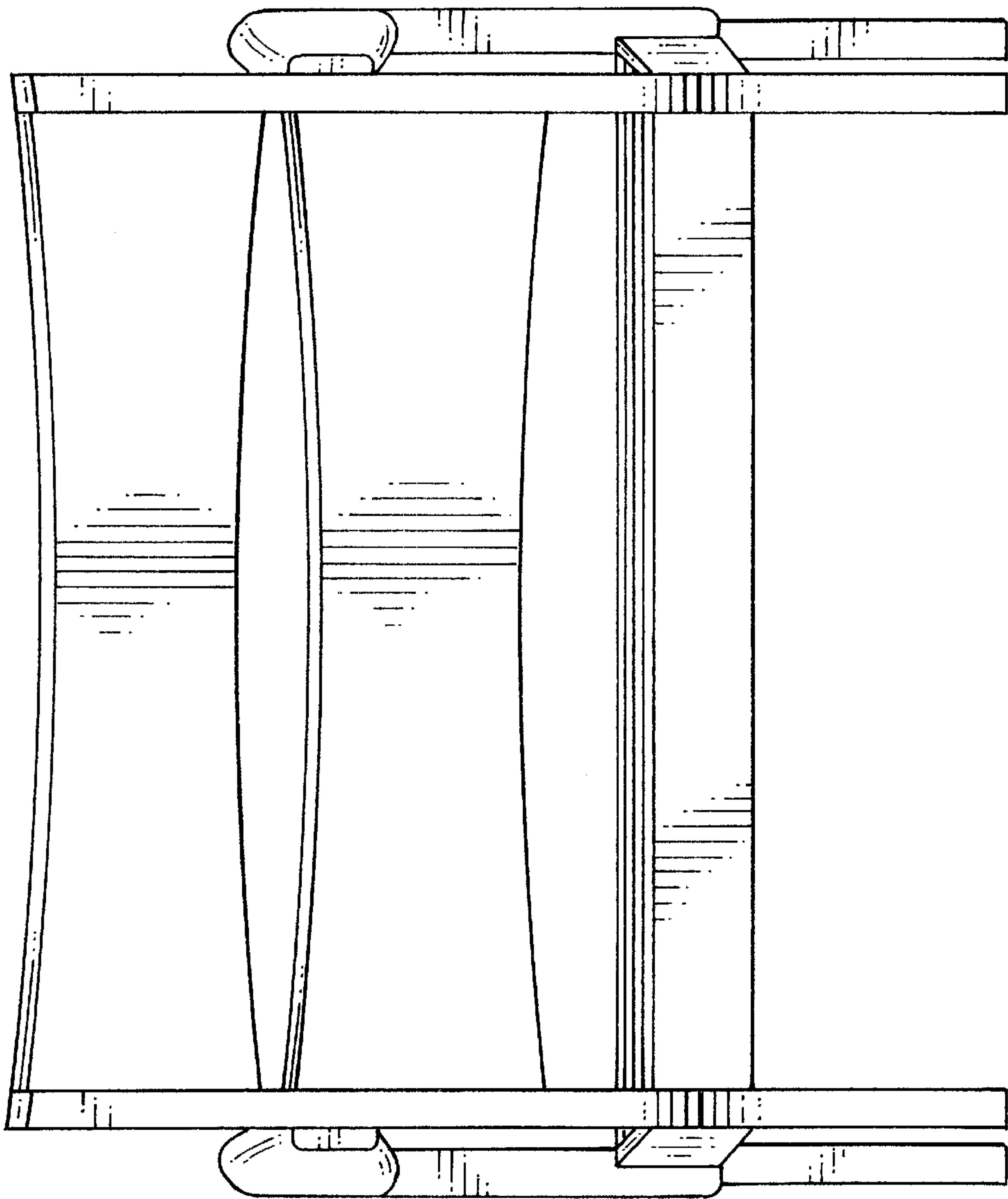

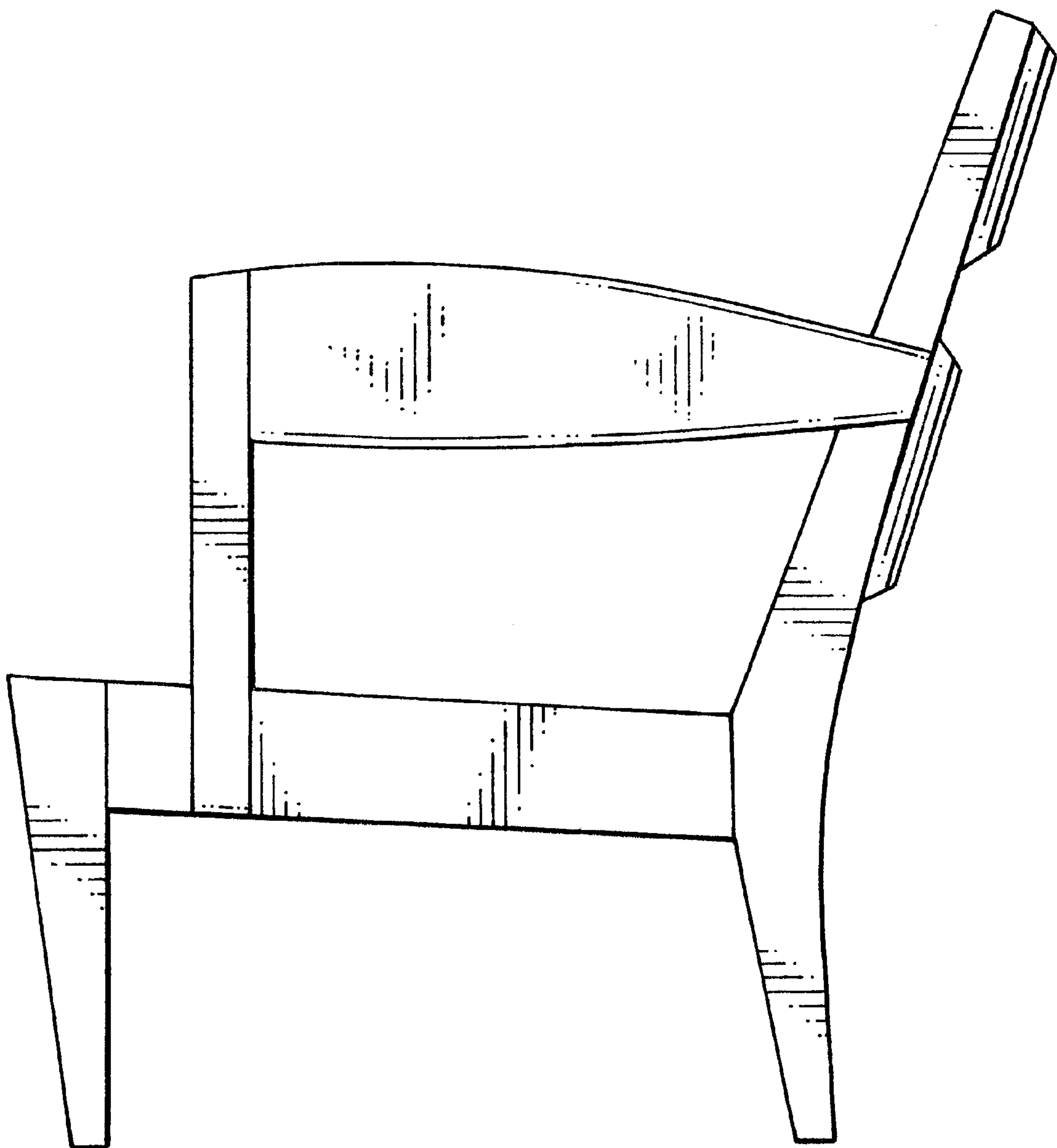

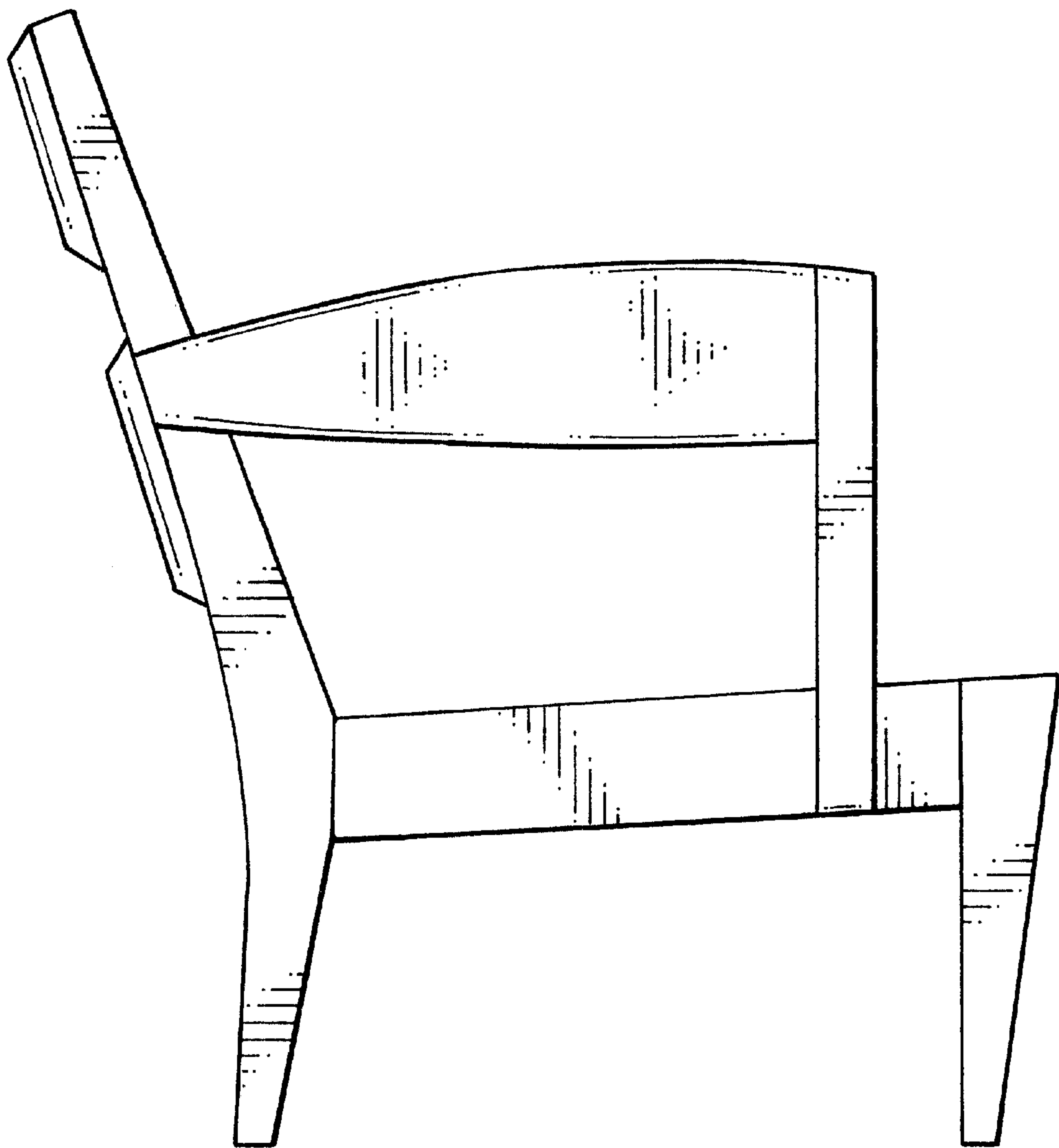

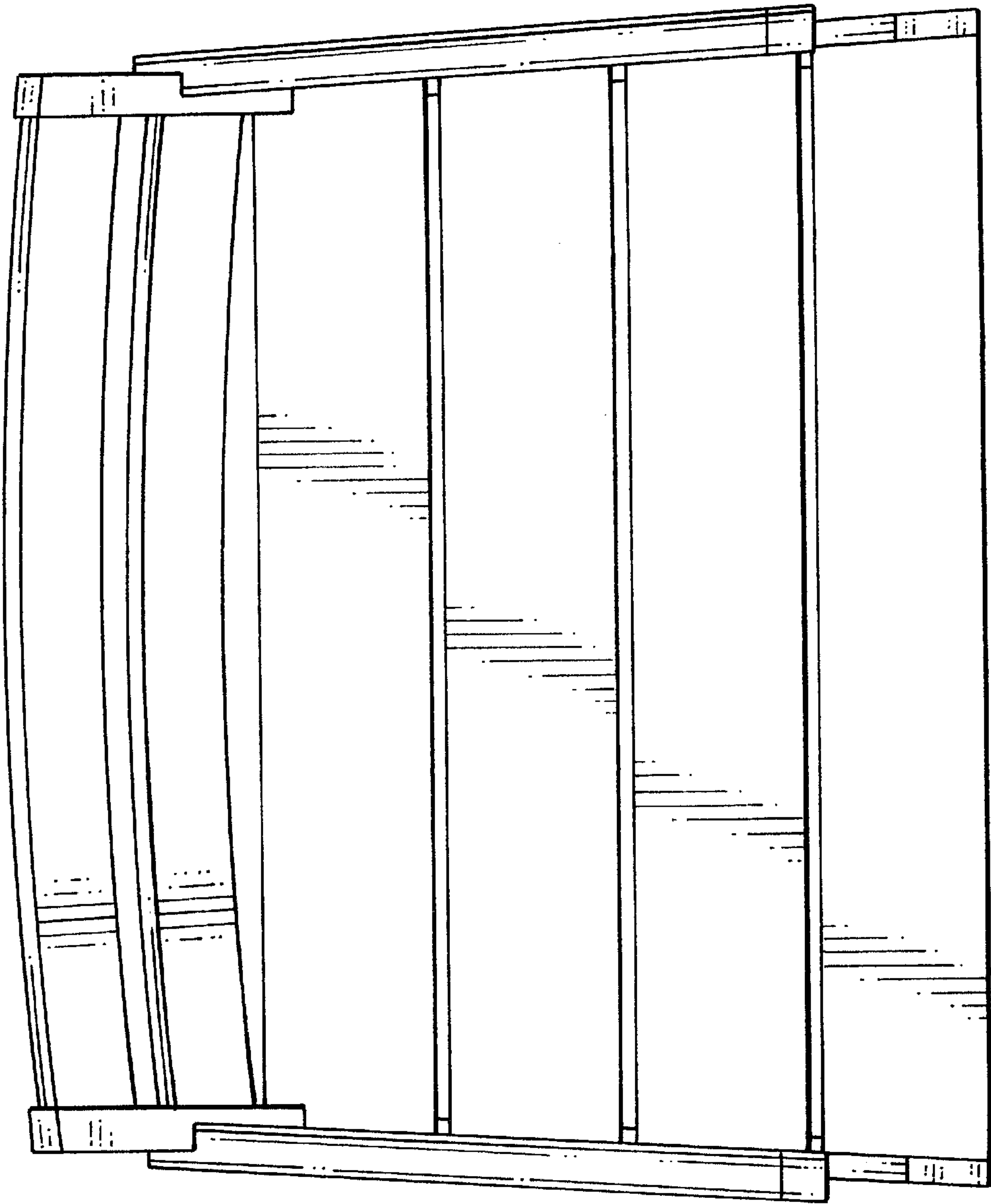

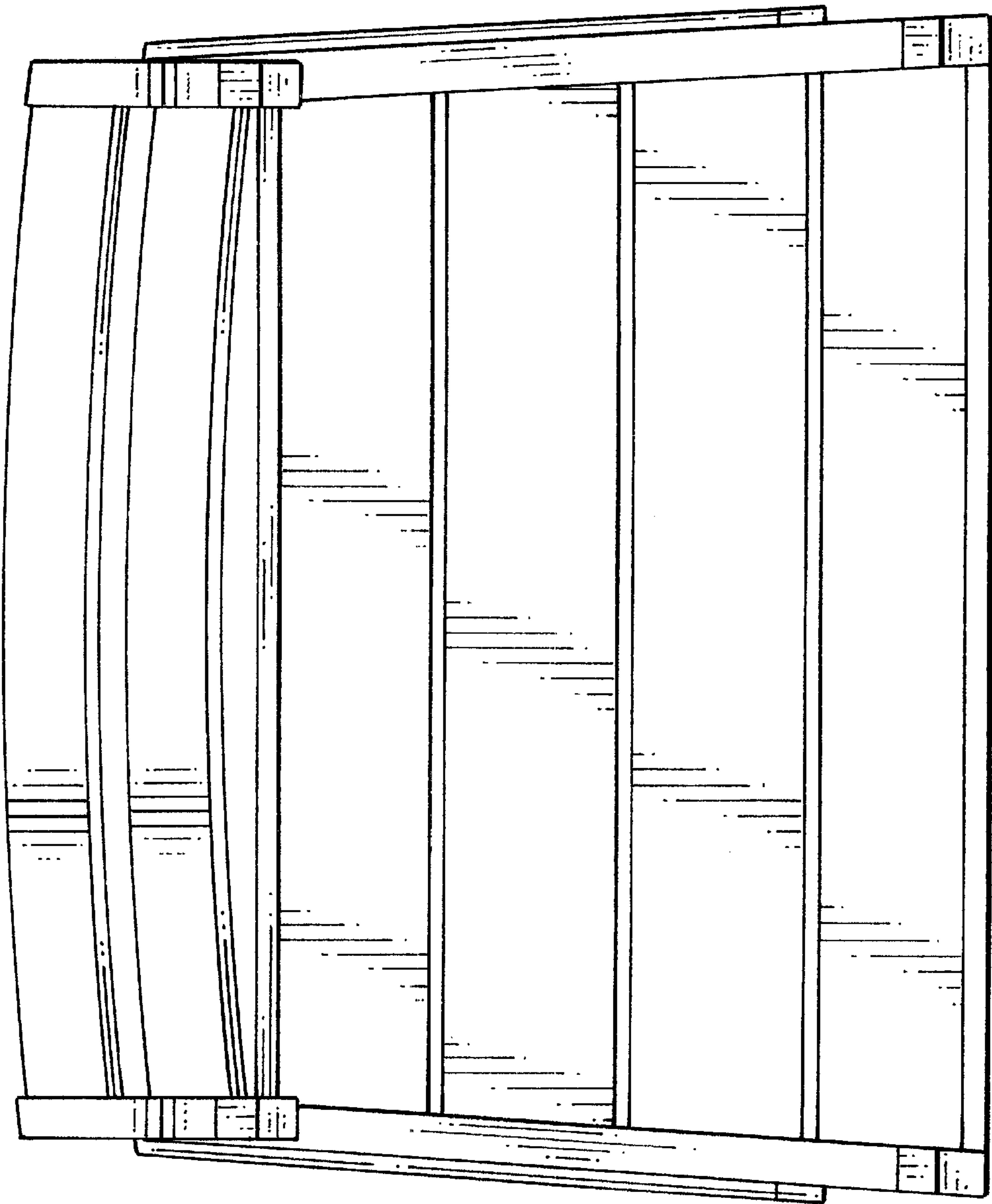

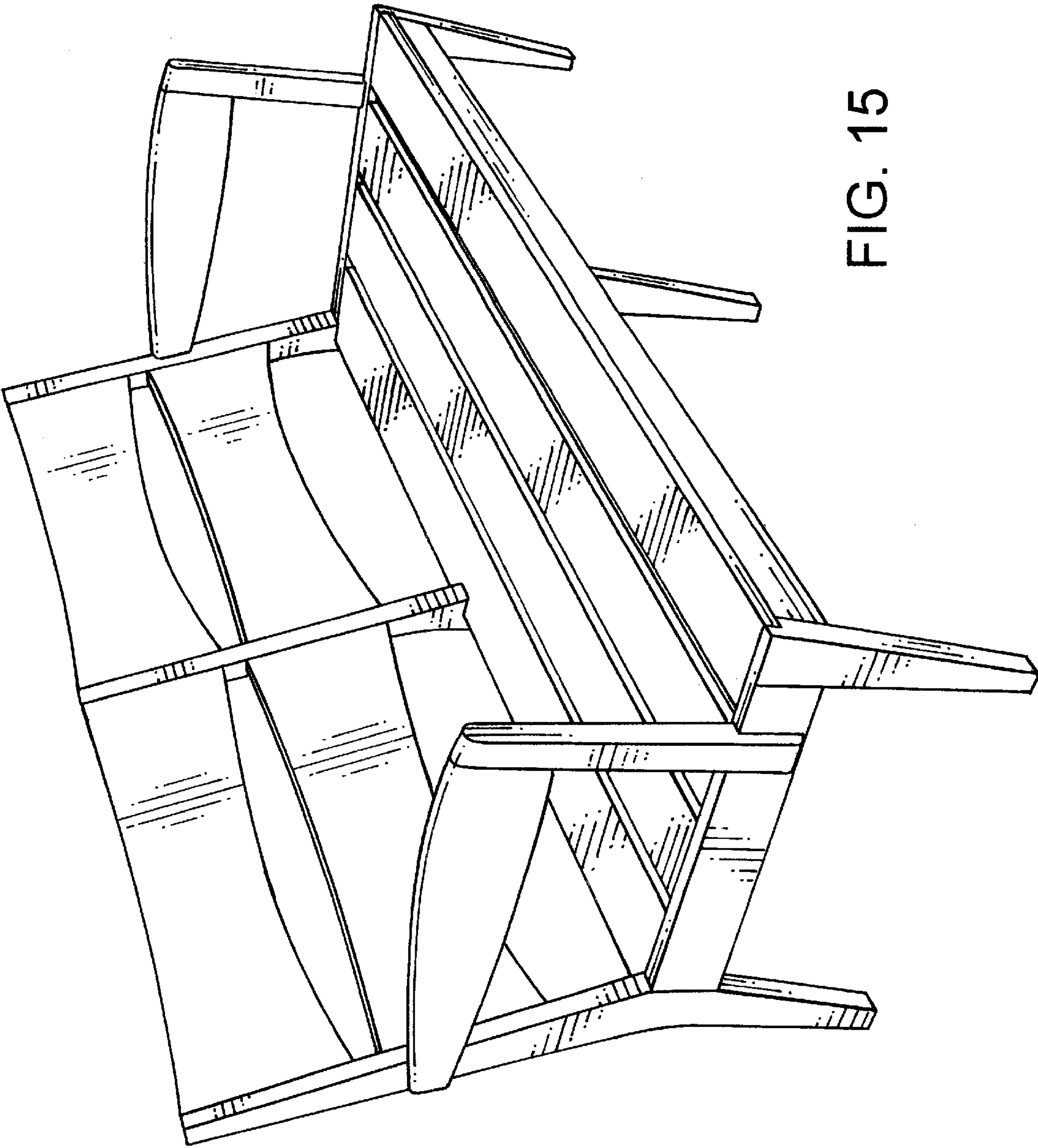

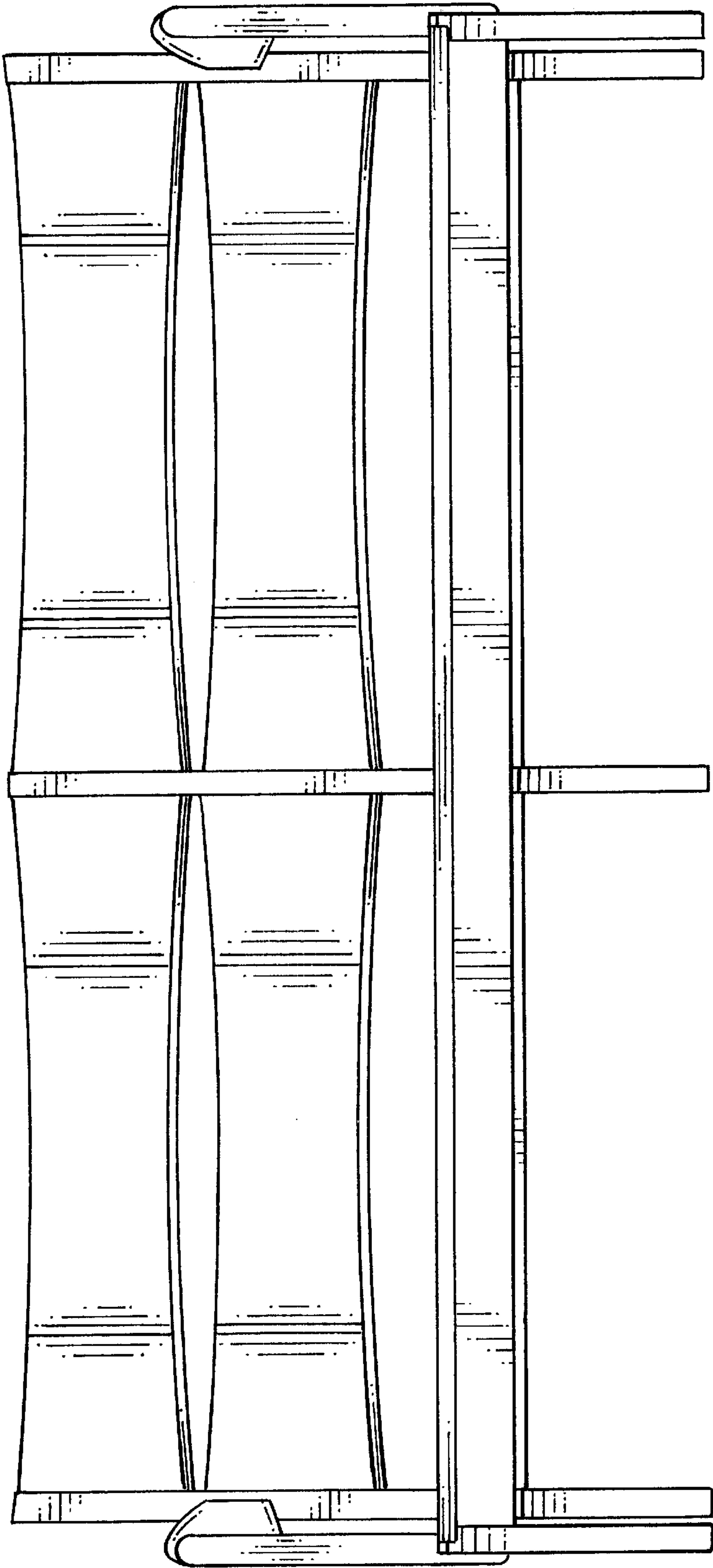

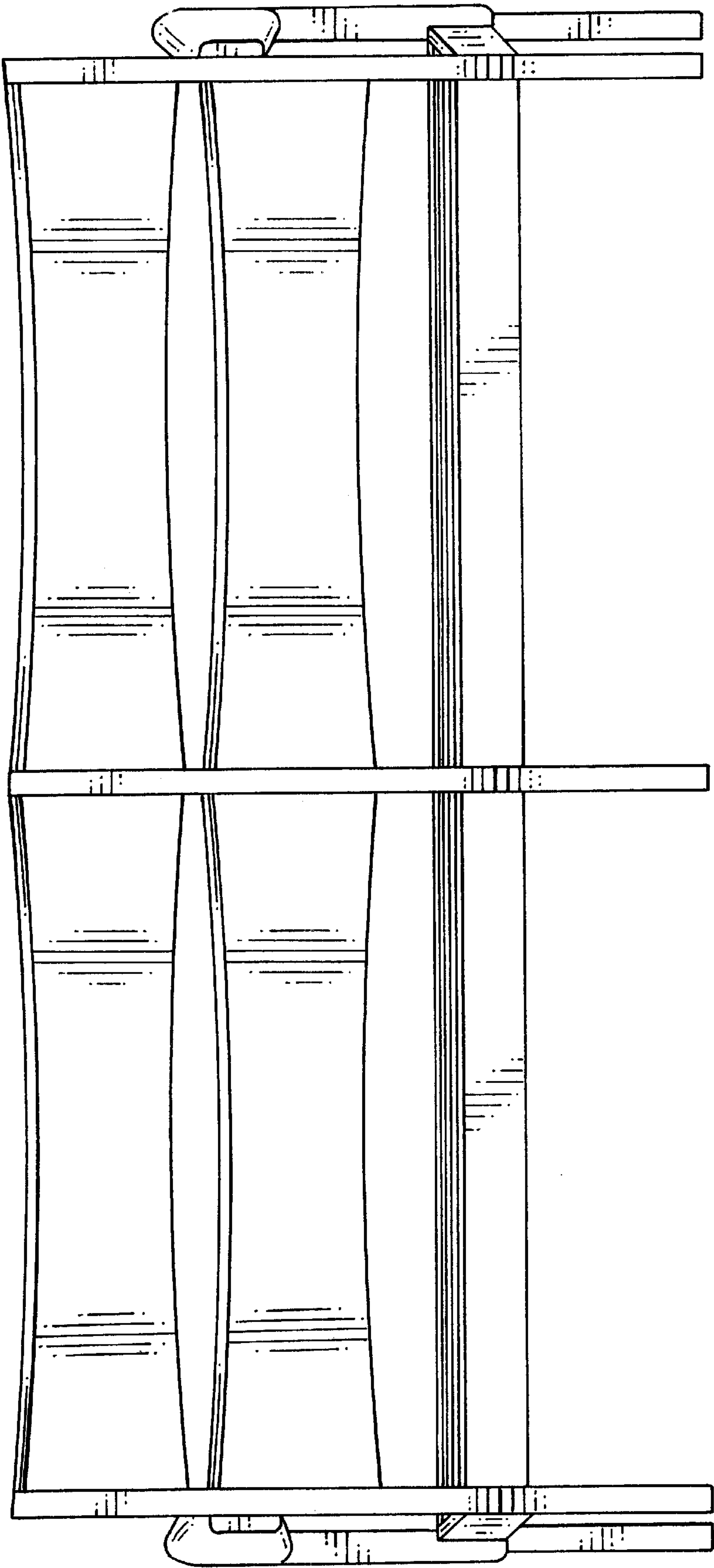

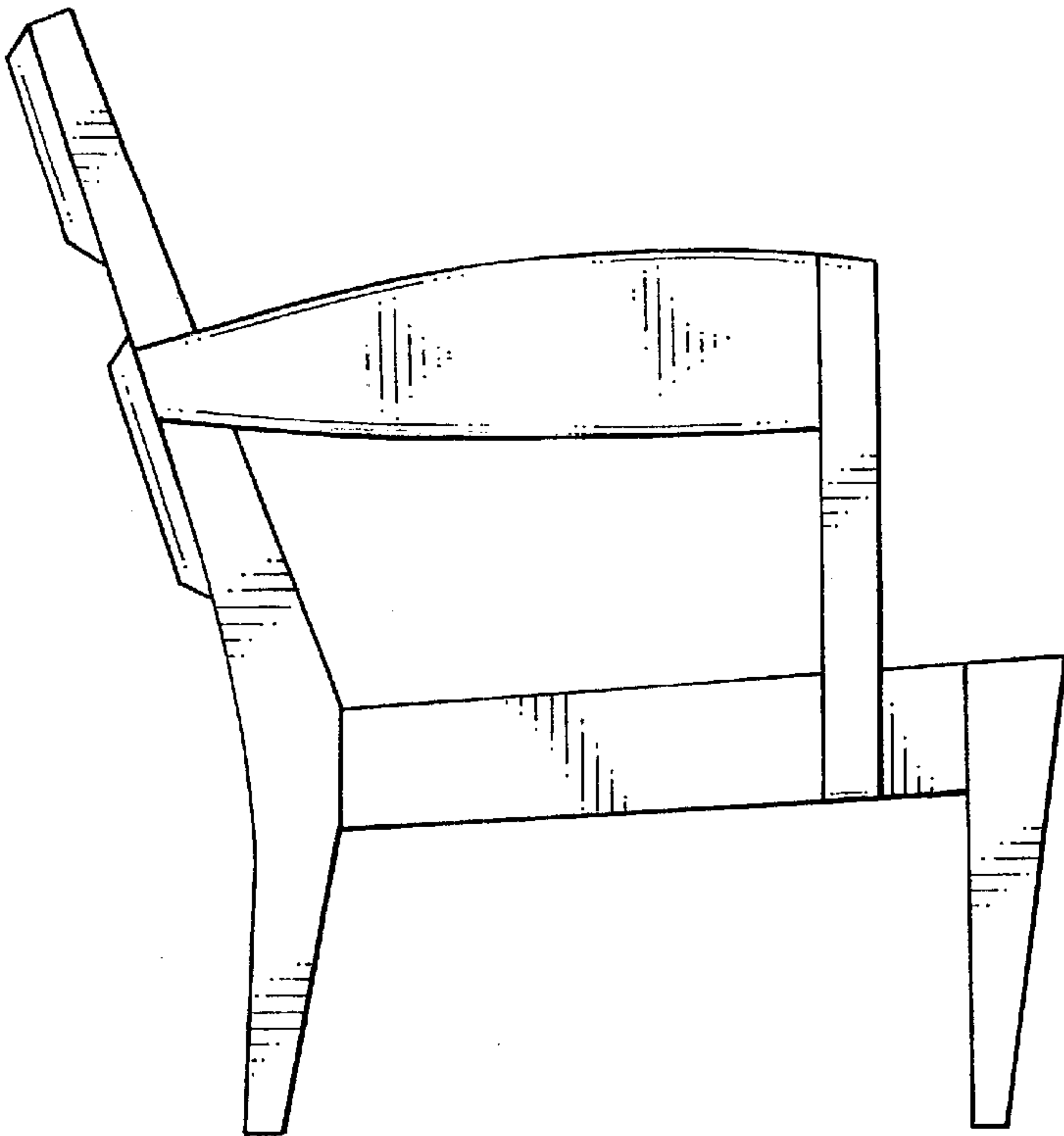

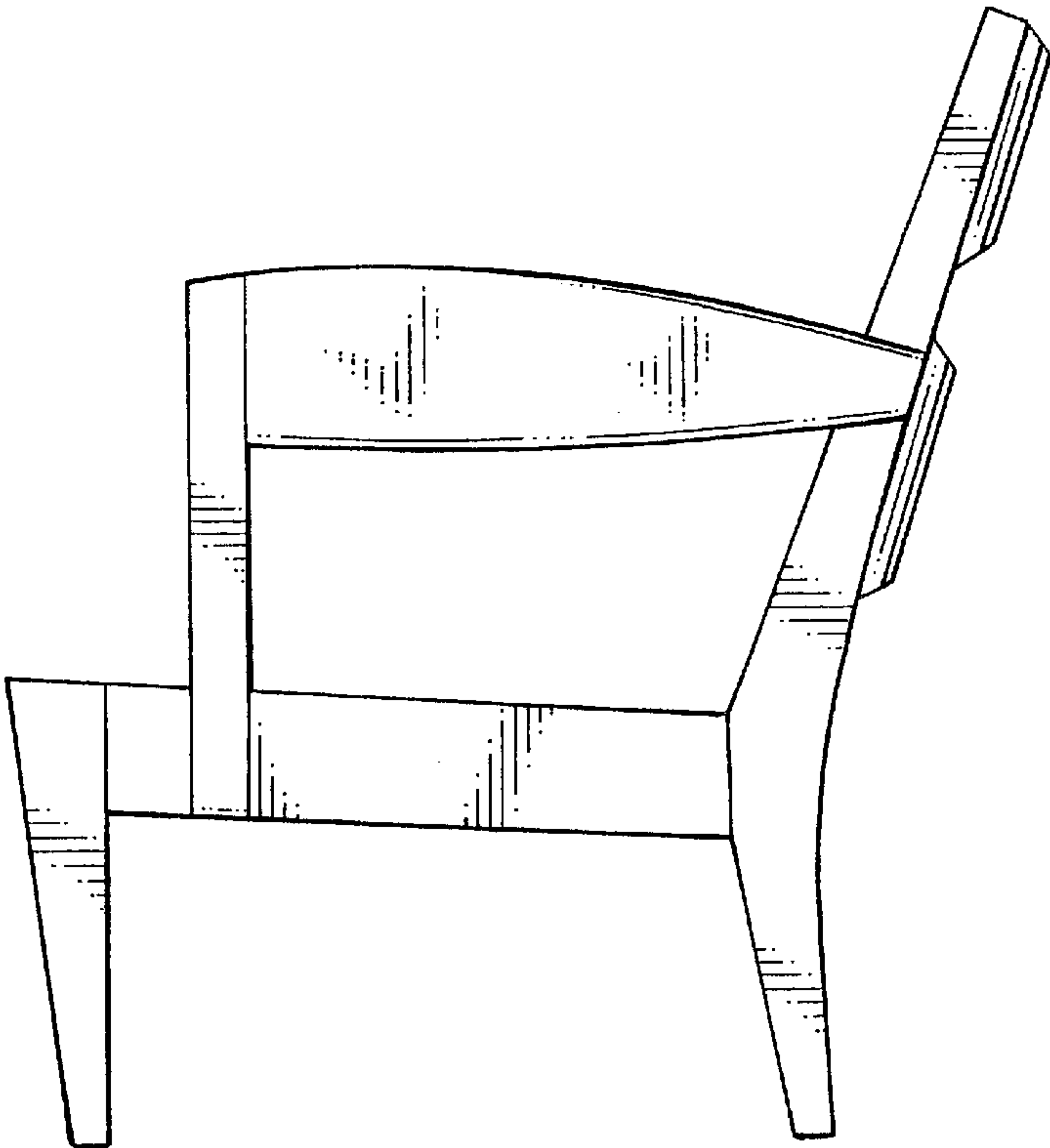

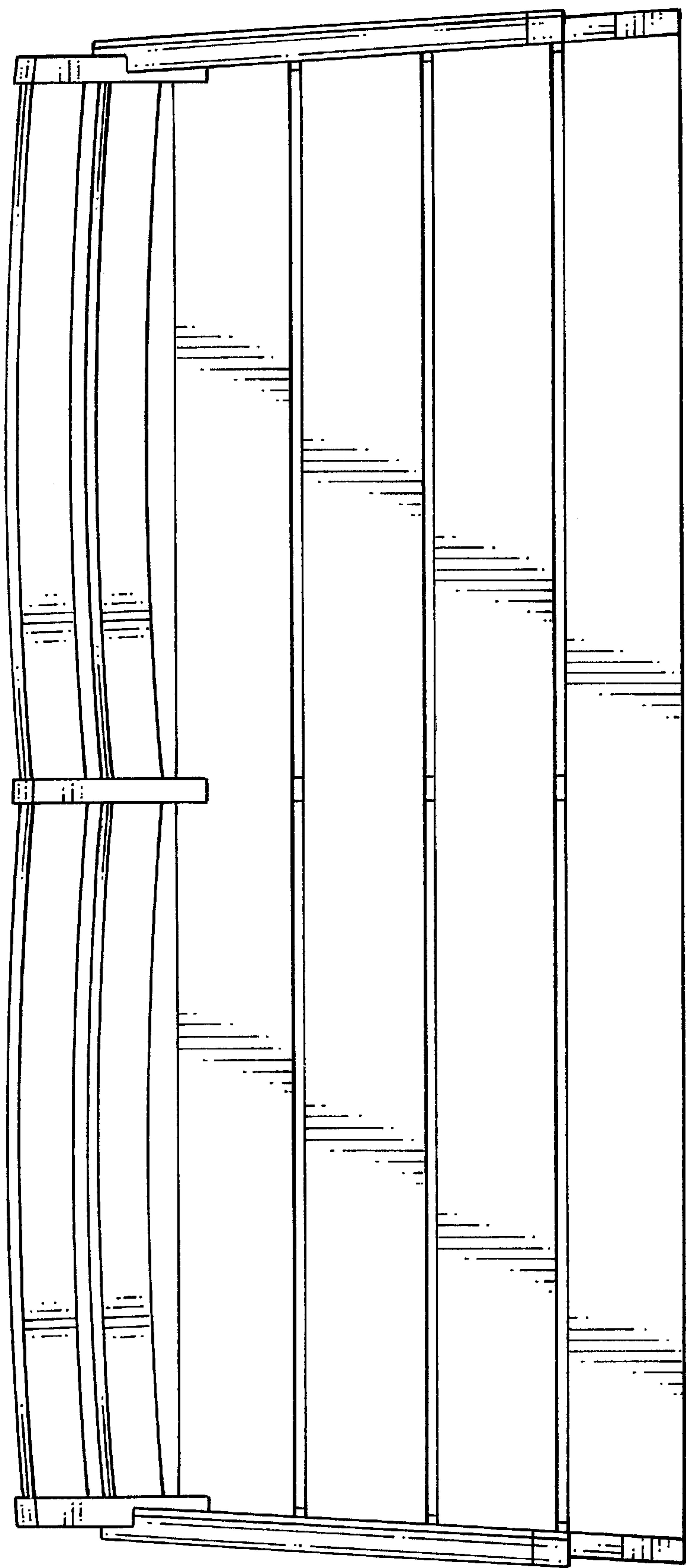

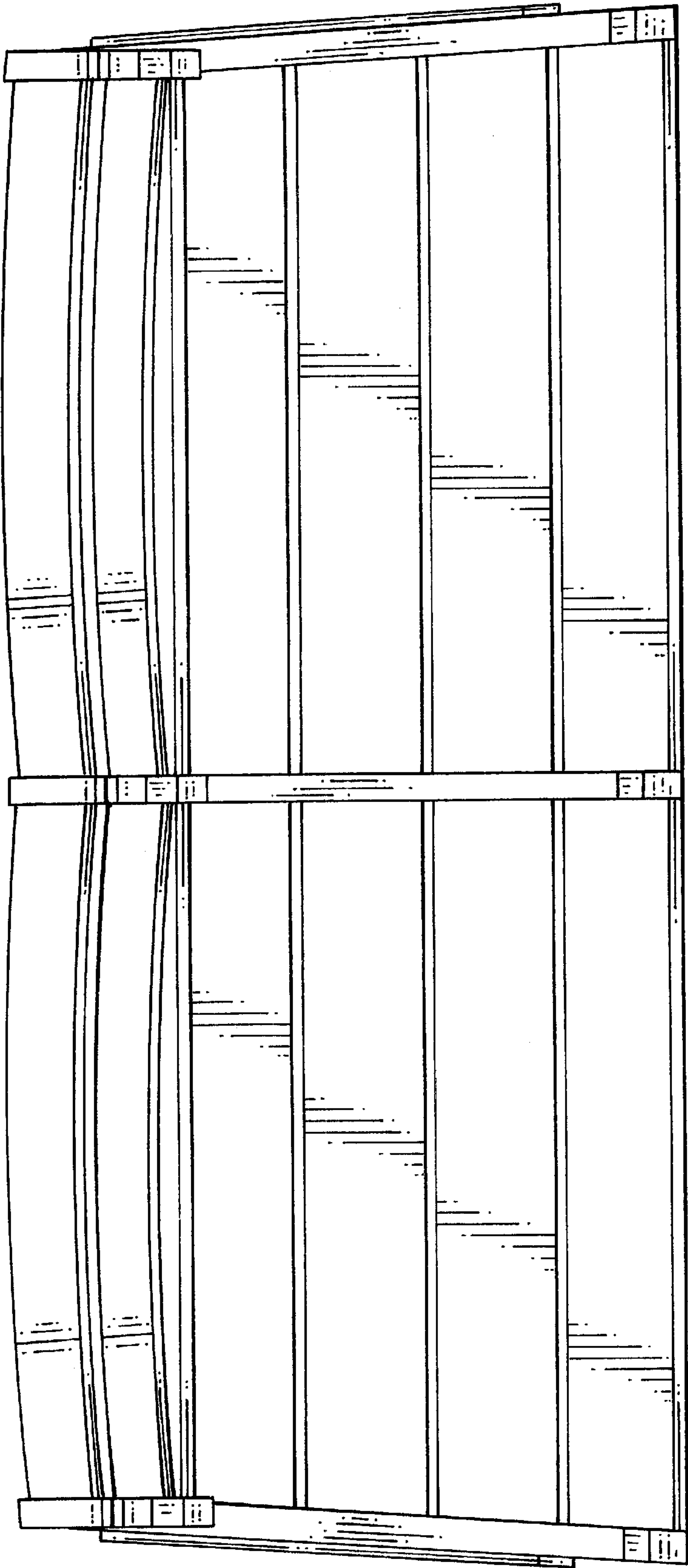
