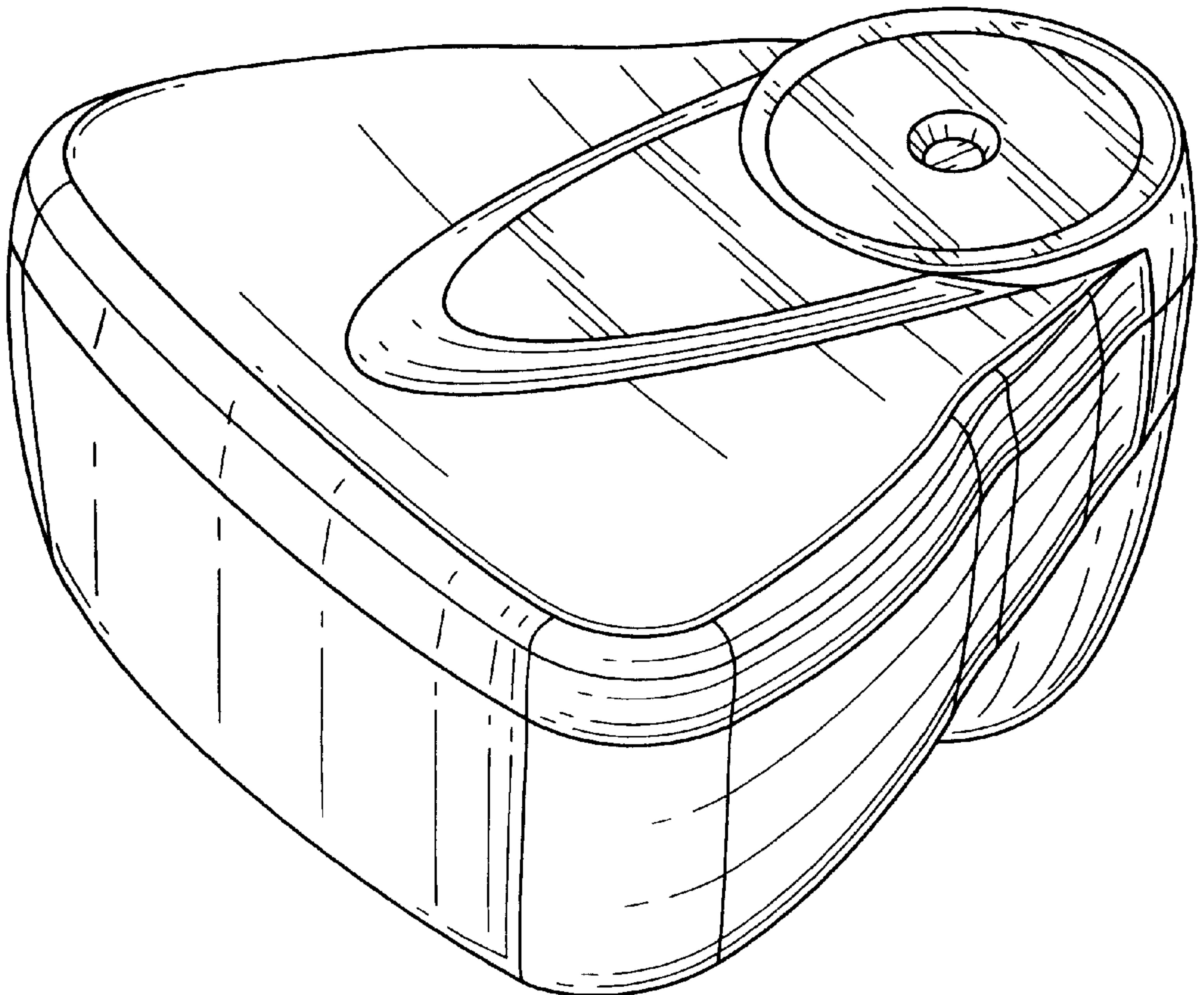
FIG. 1 is a top perspective view showing the new design;

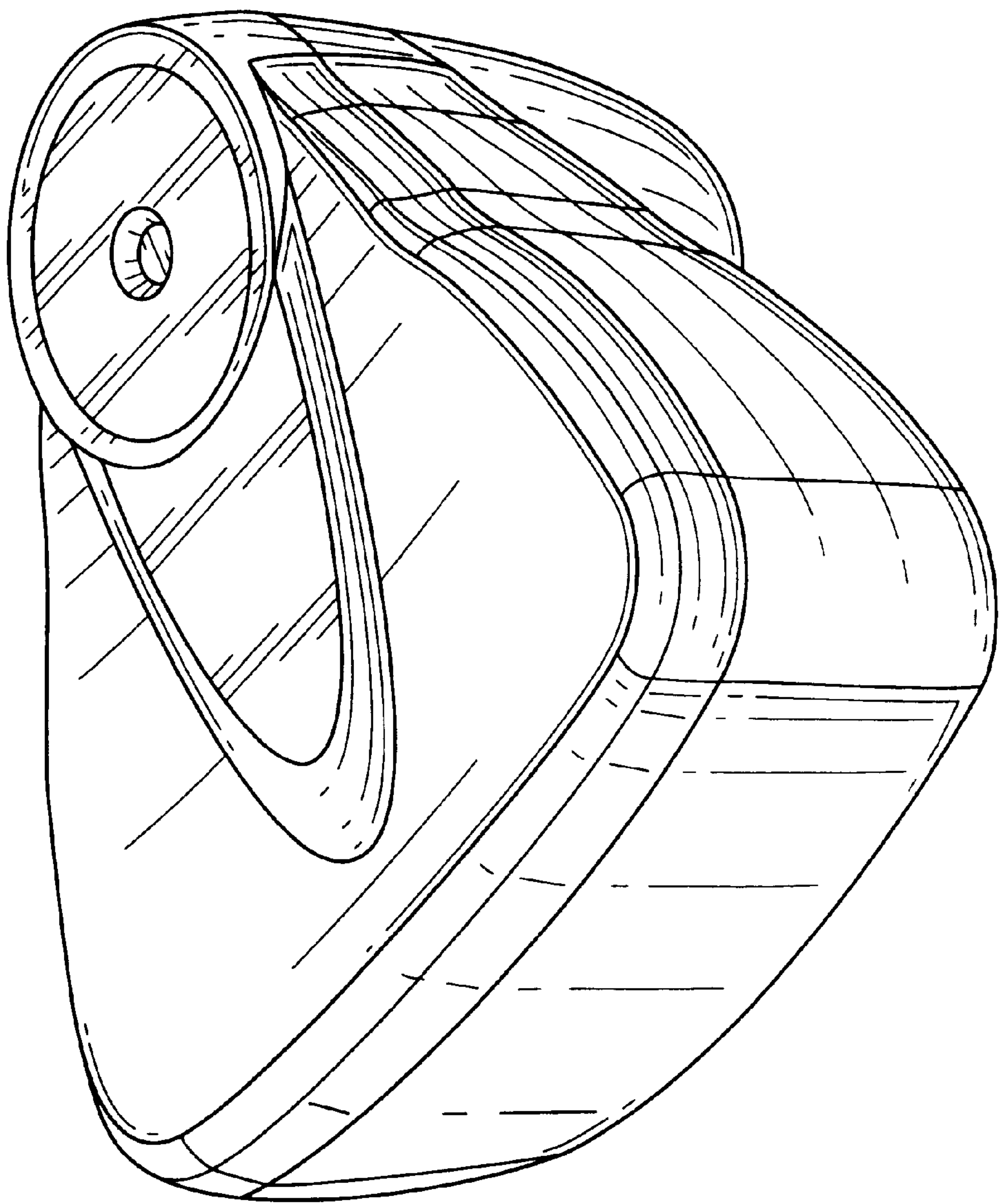

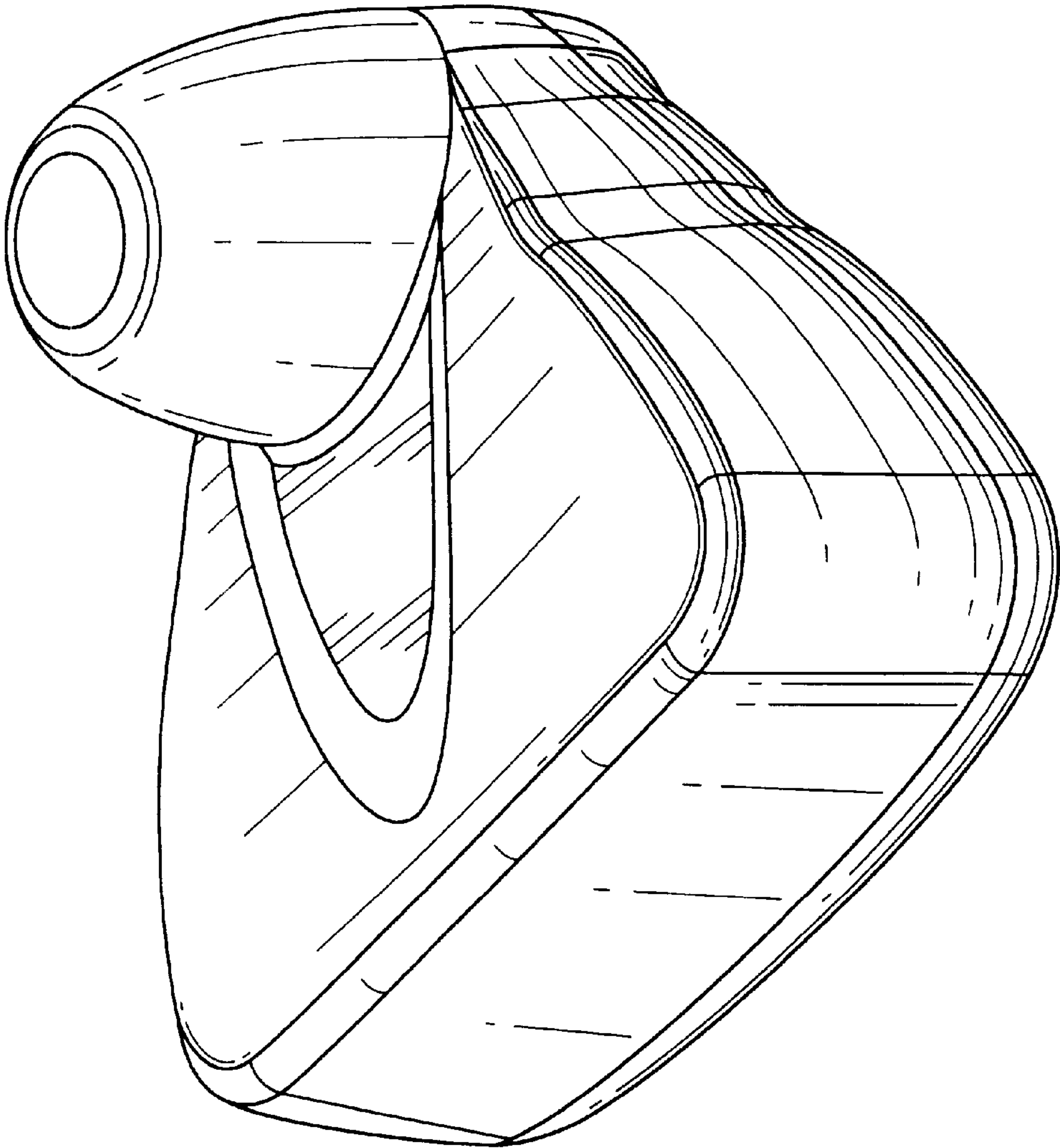

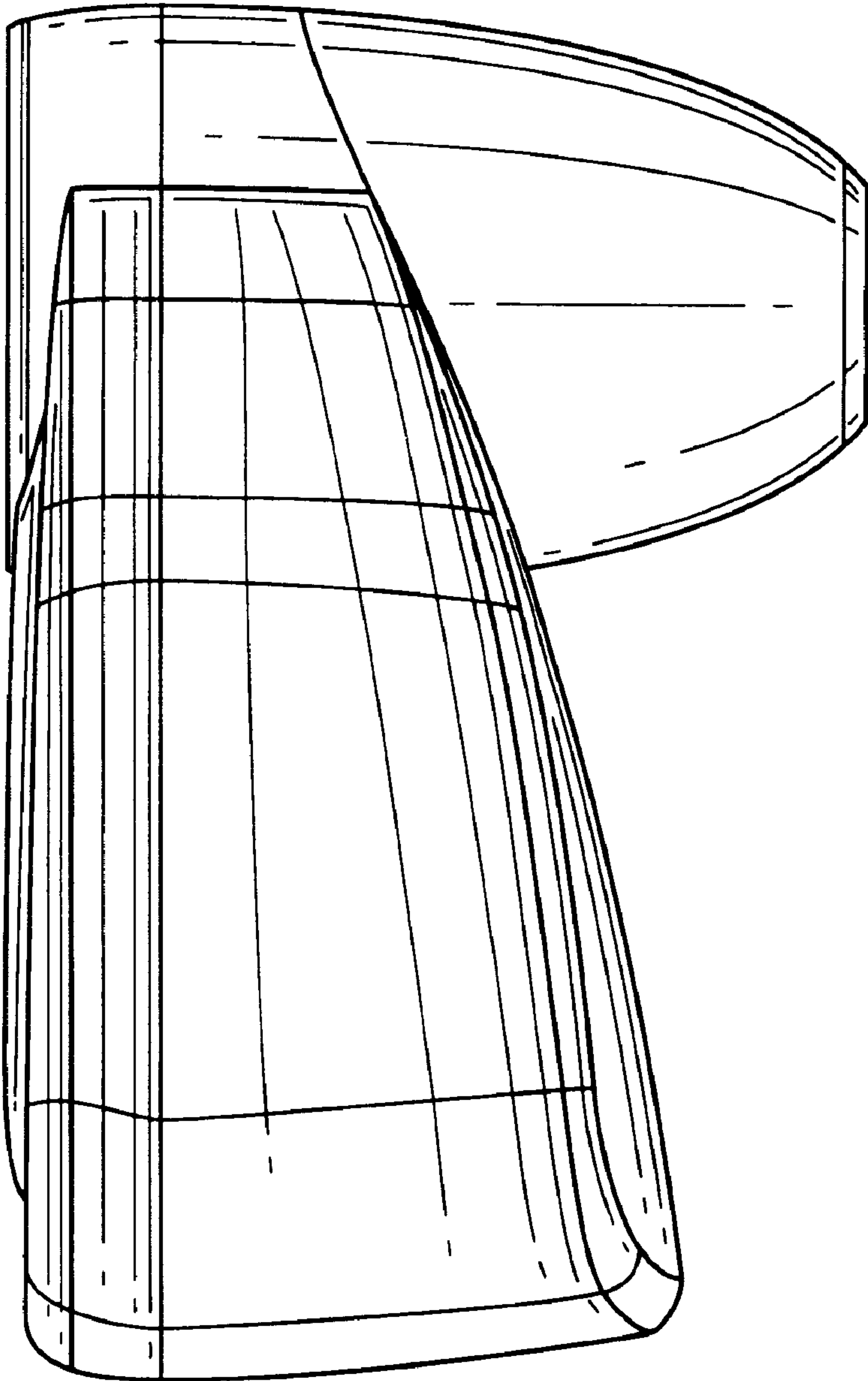

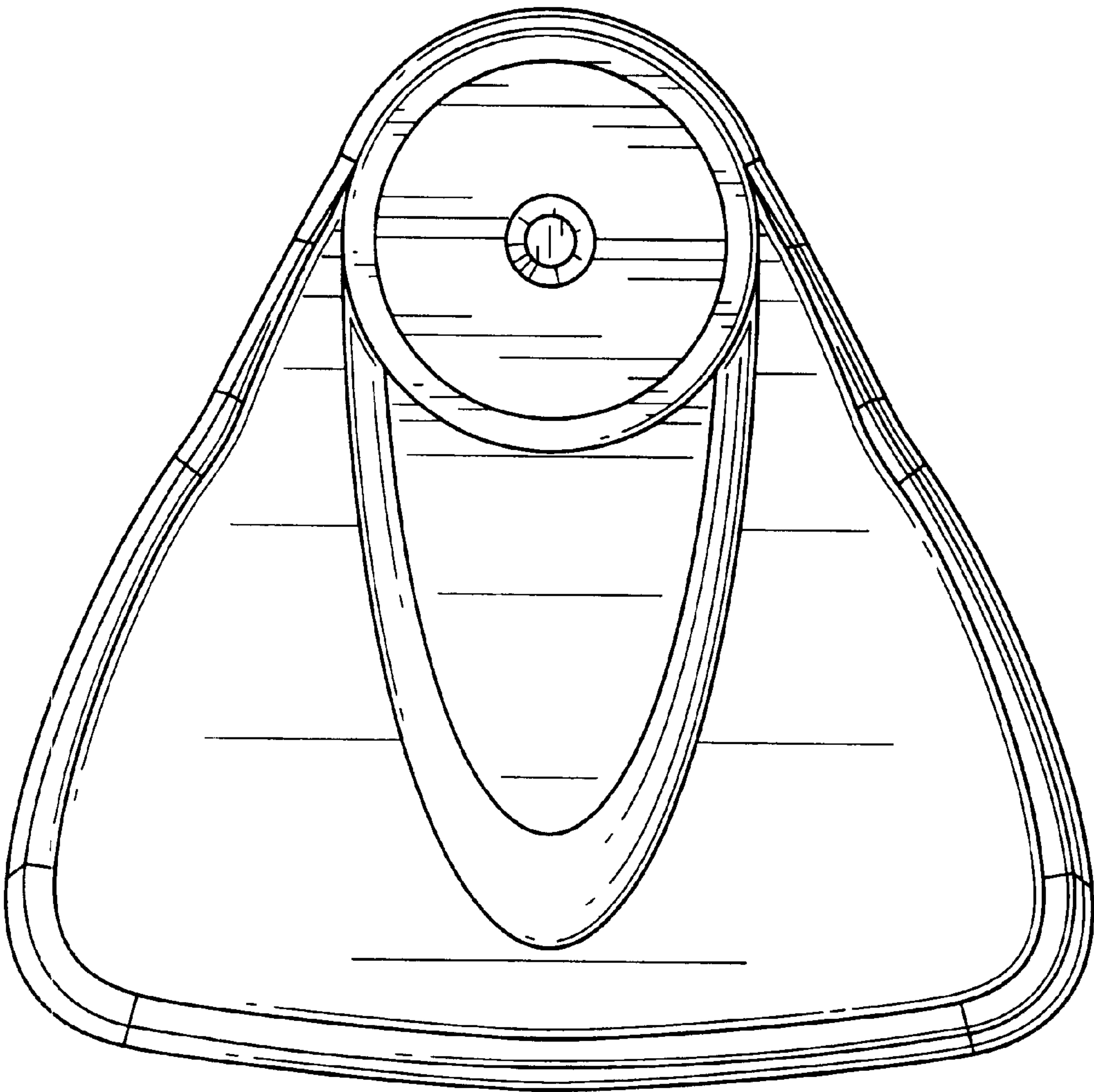

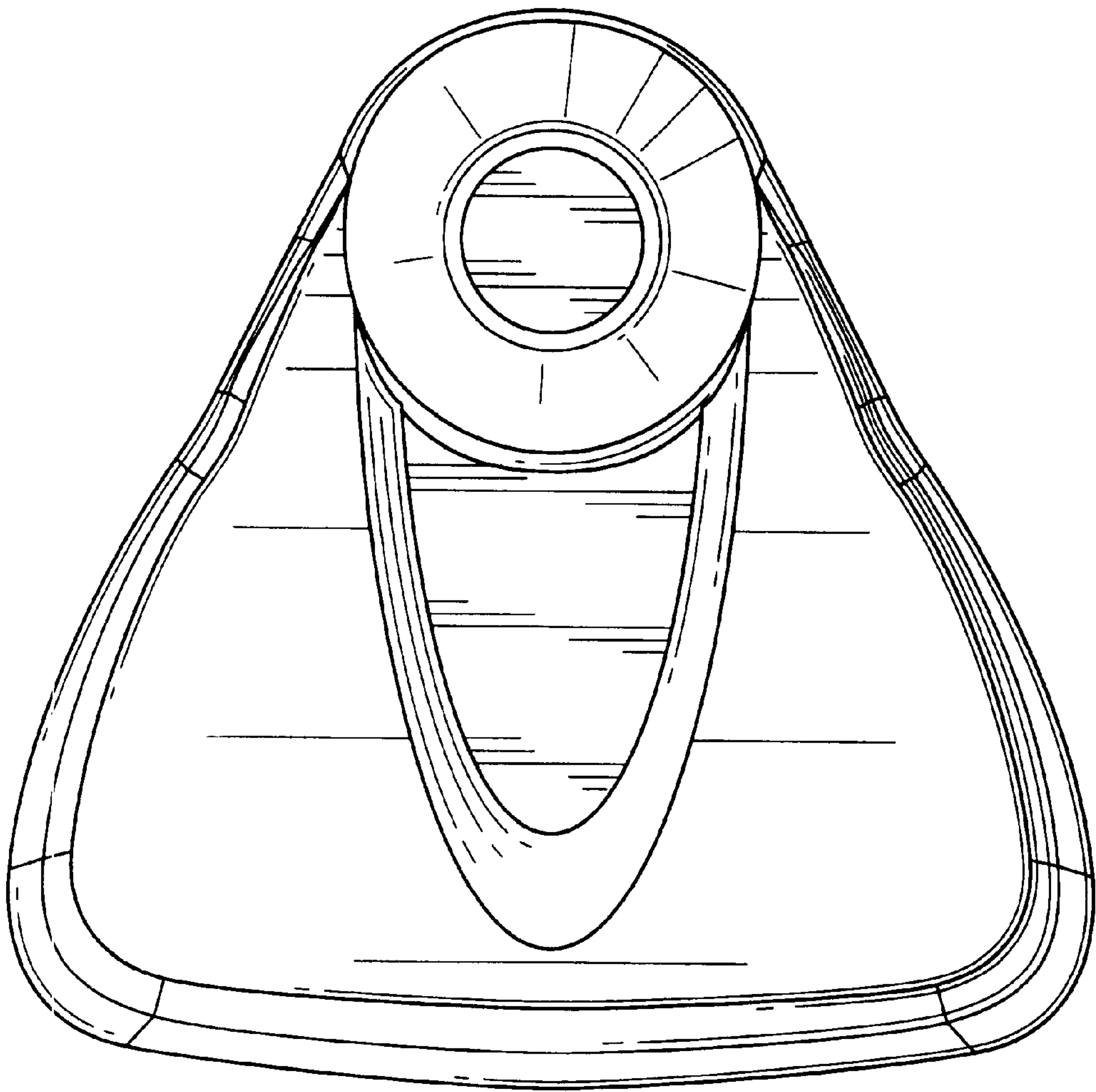

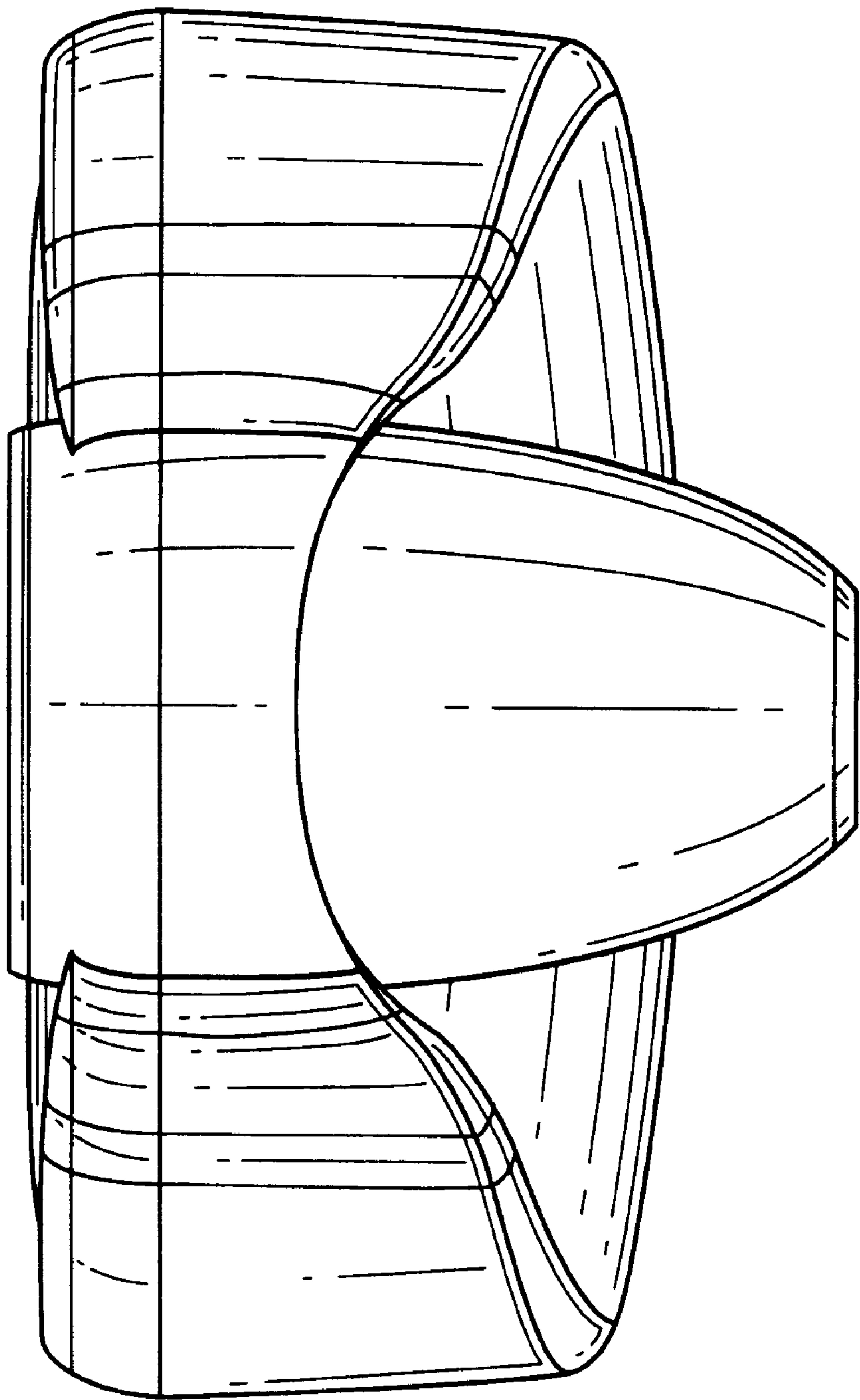

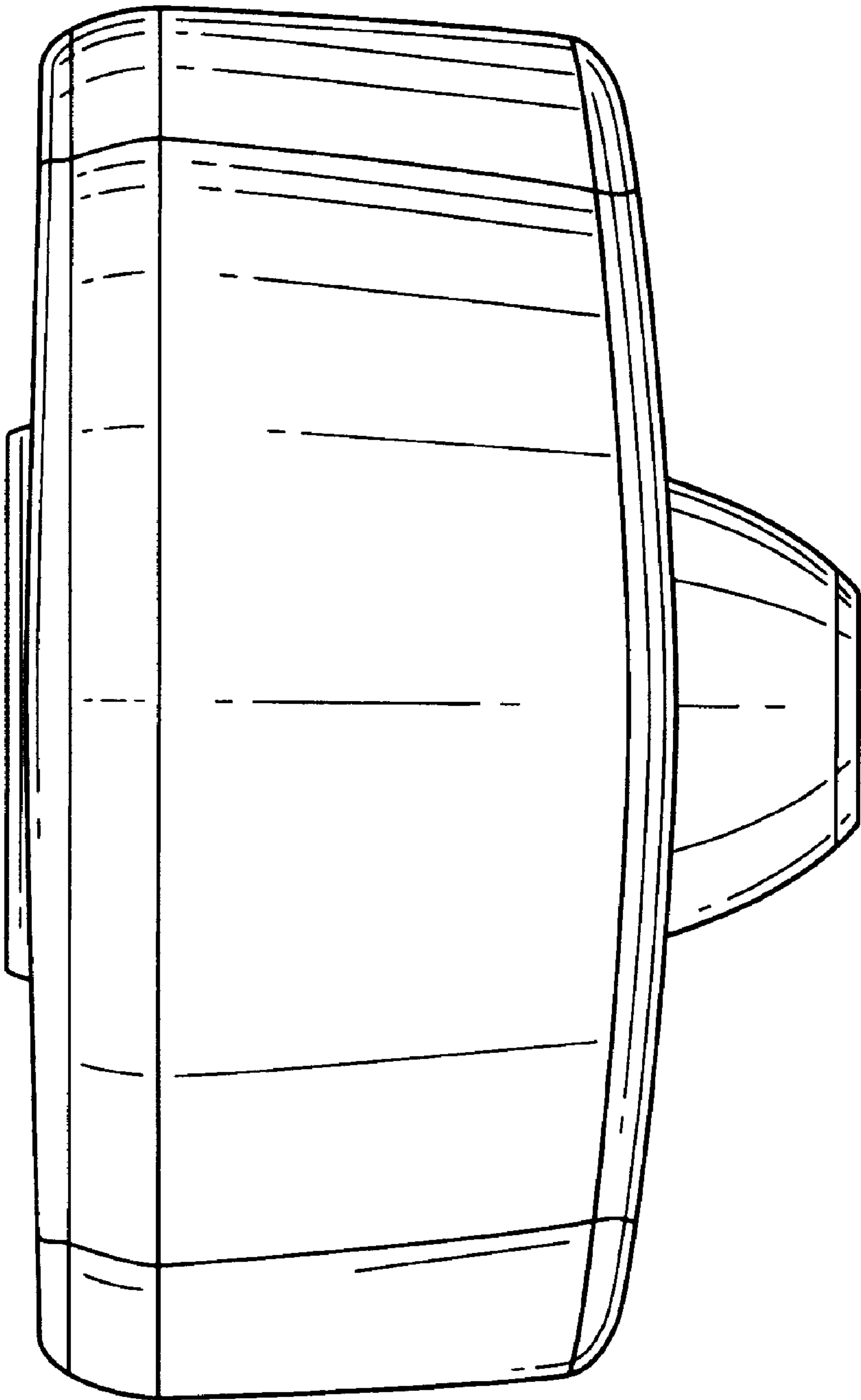
