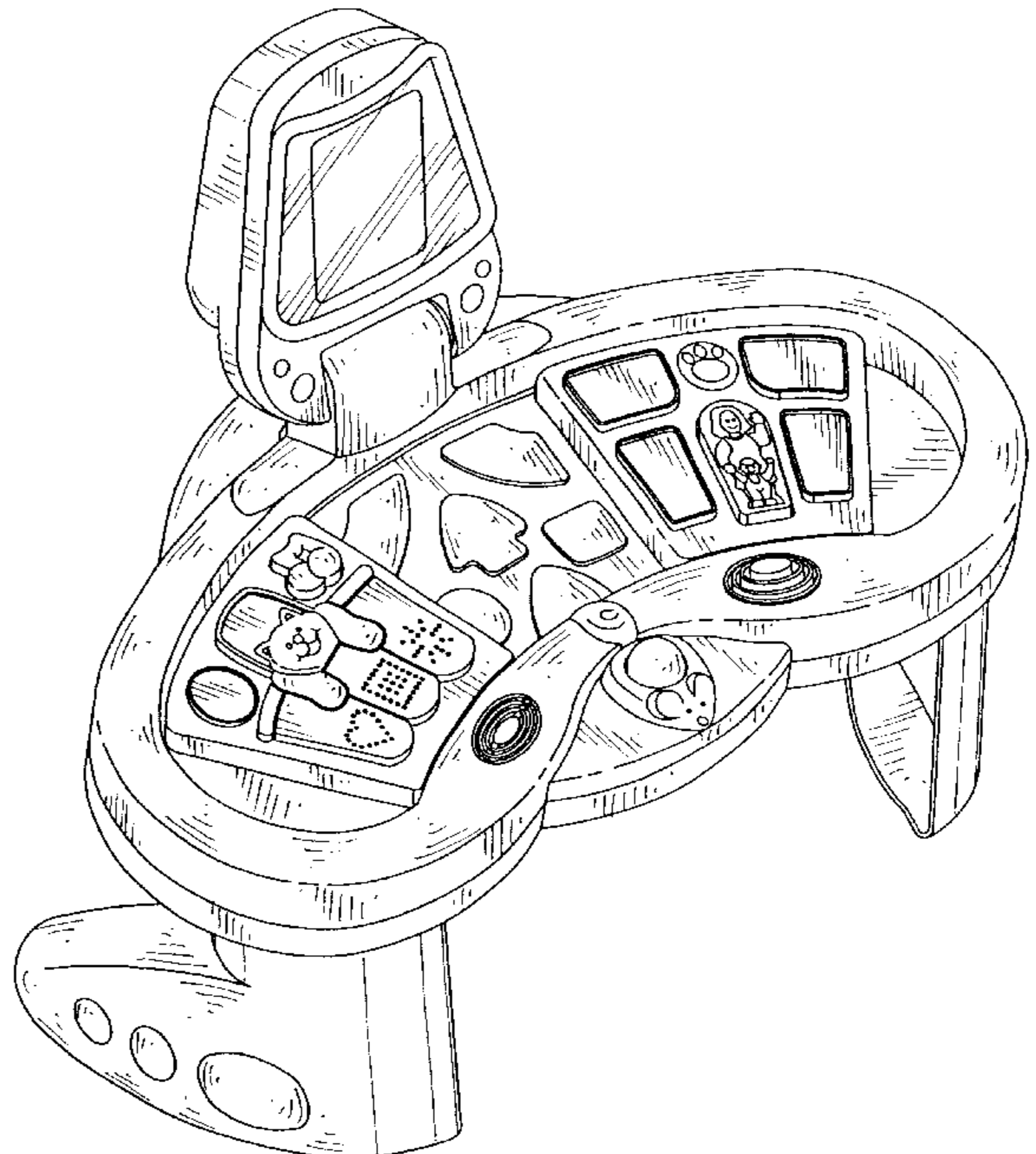
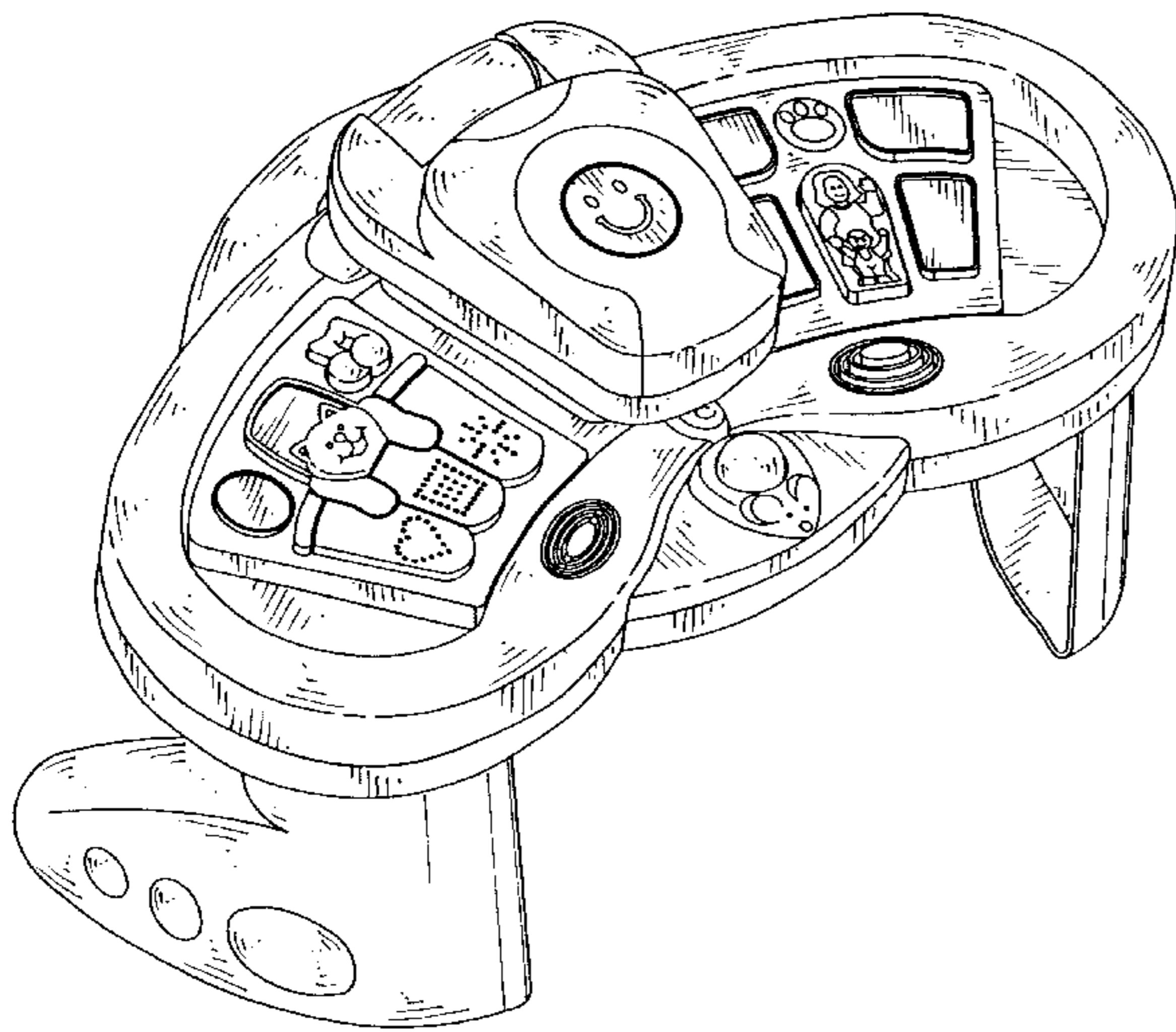
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the activity desk for a child of the instant invention;

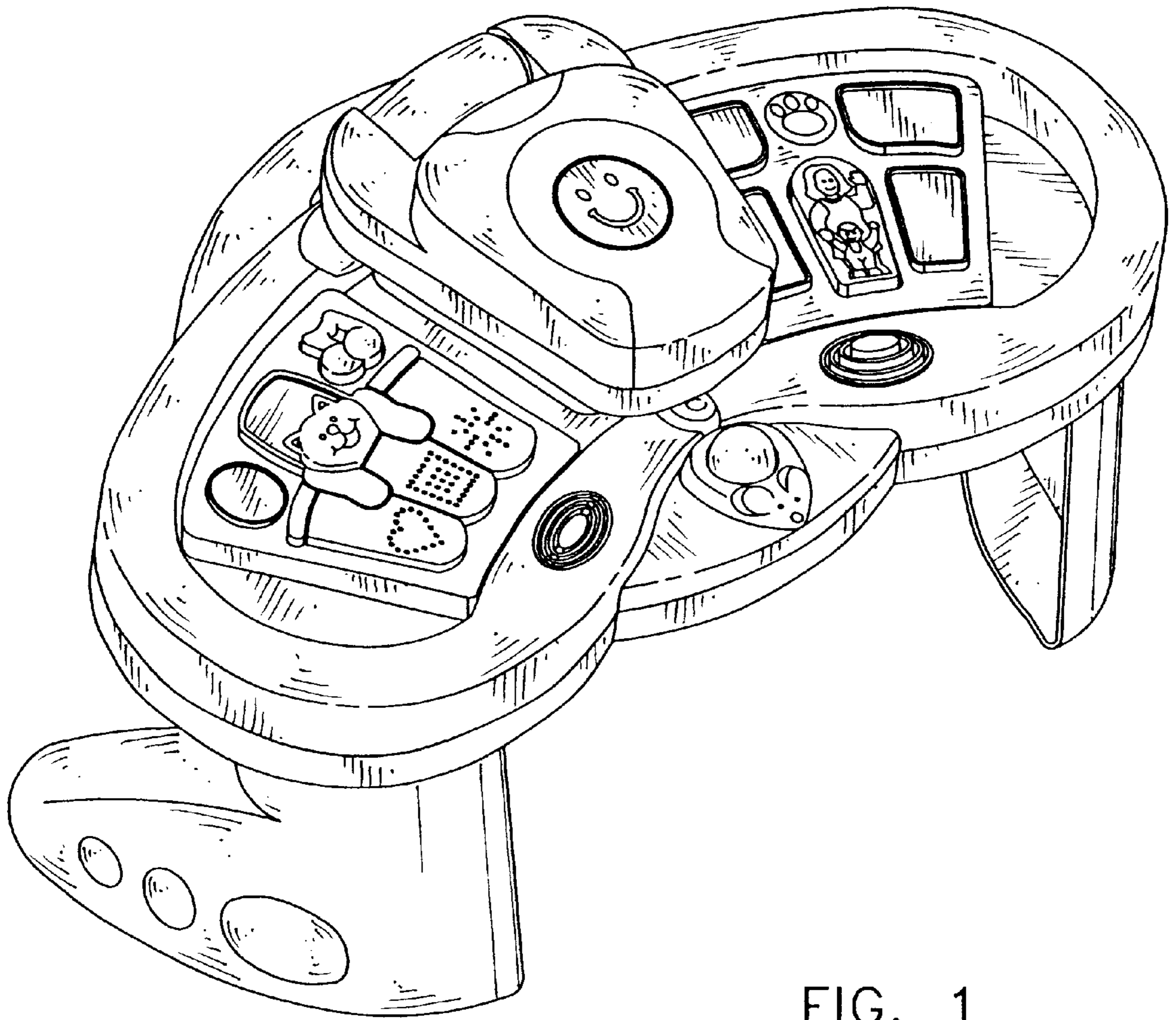

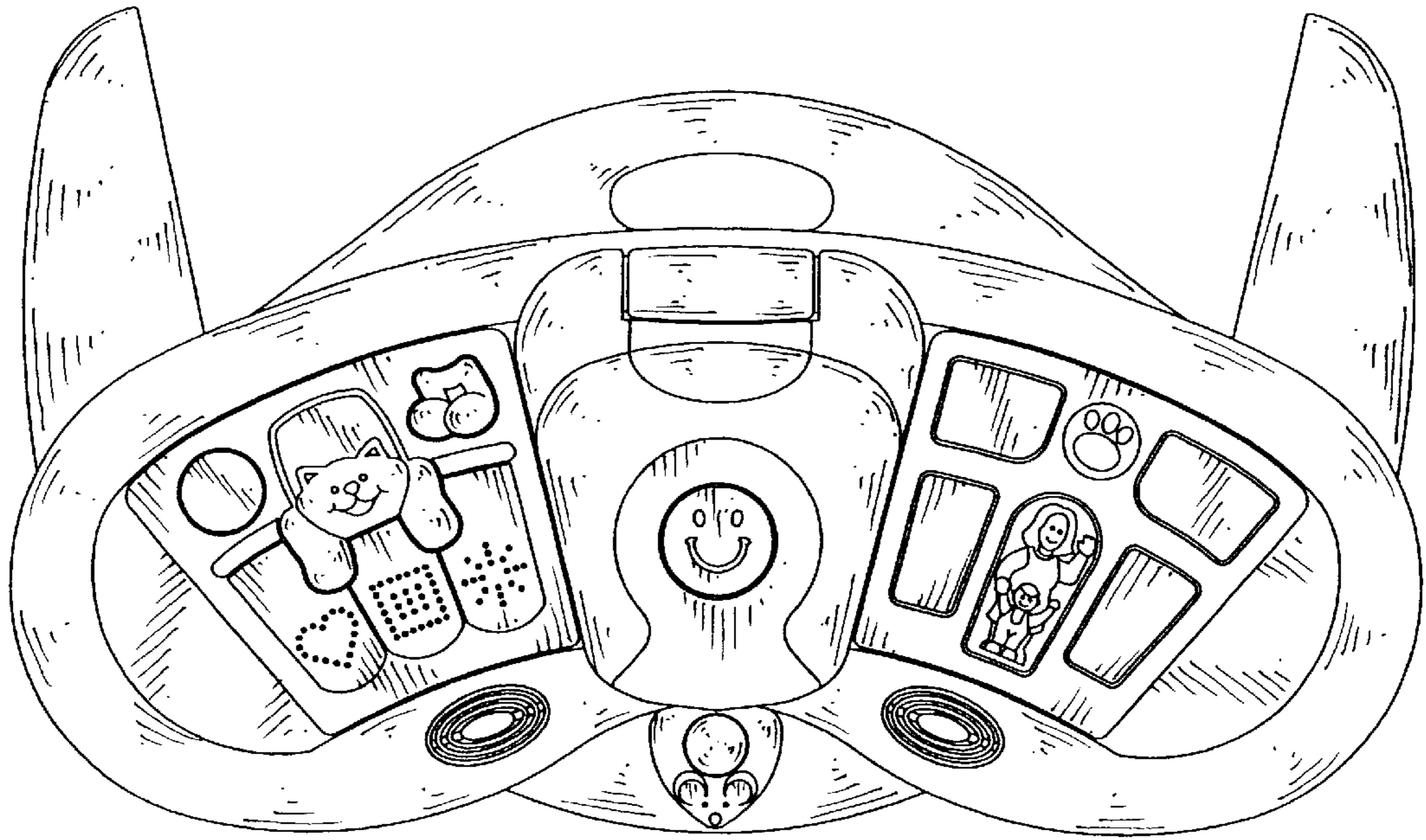

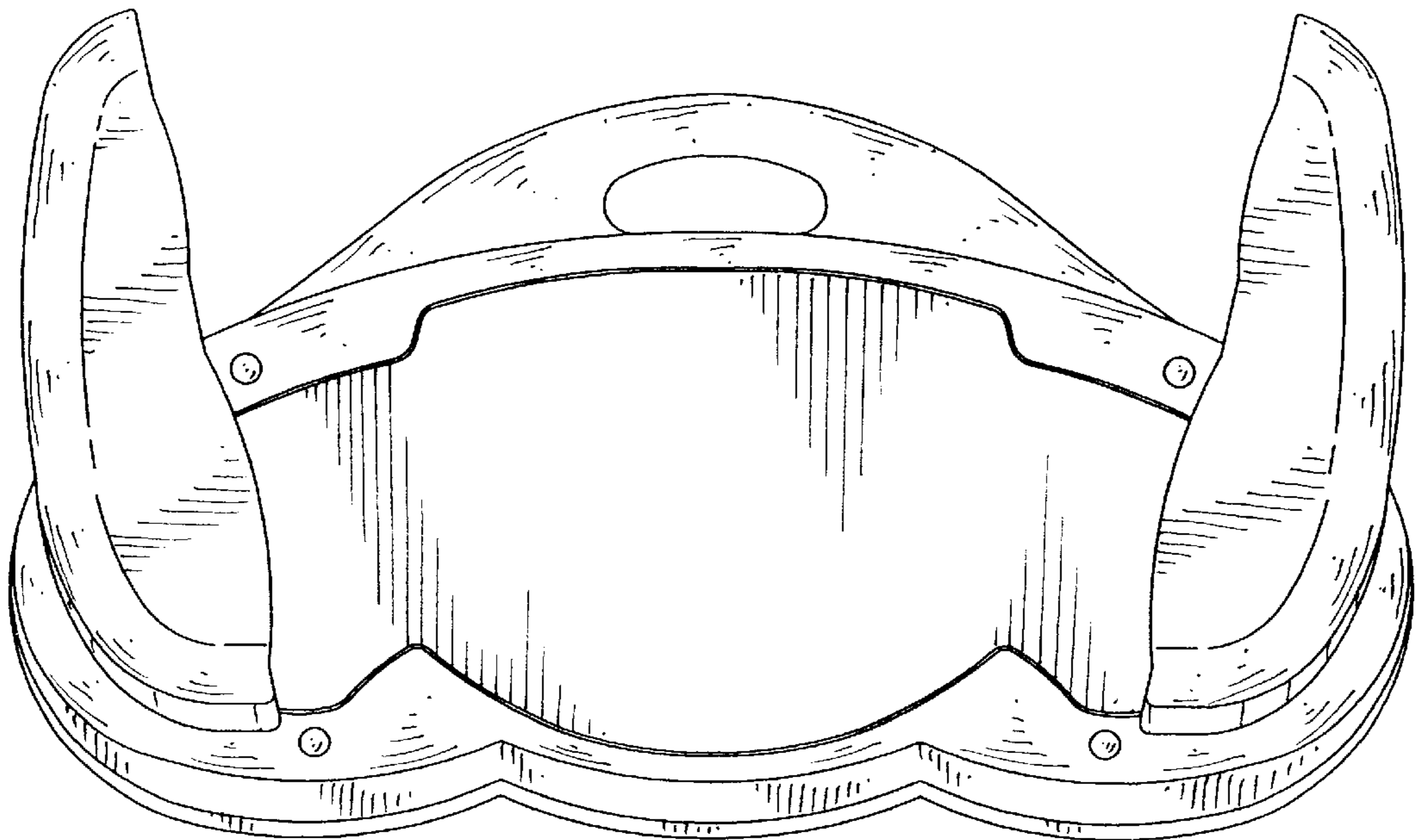

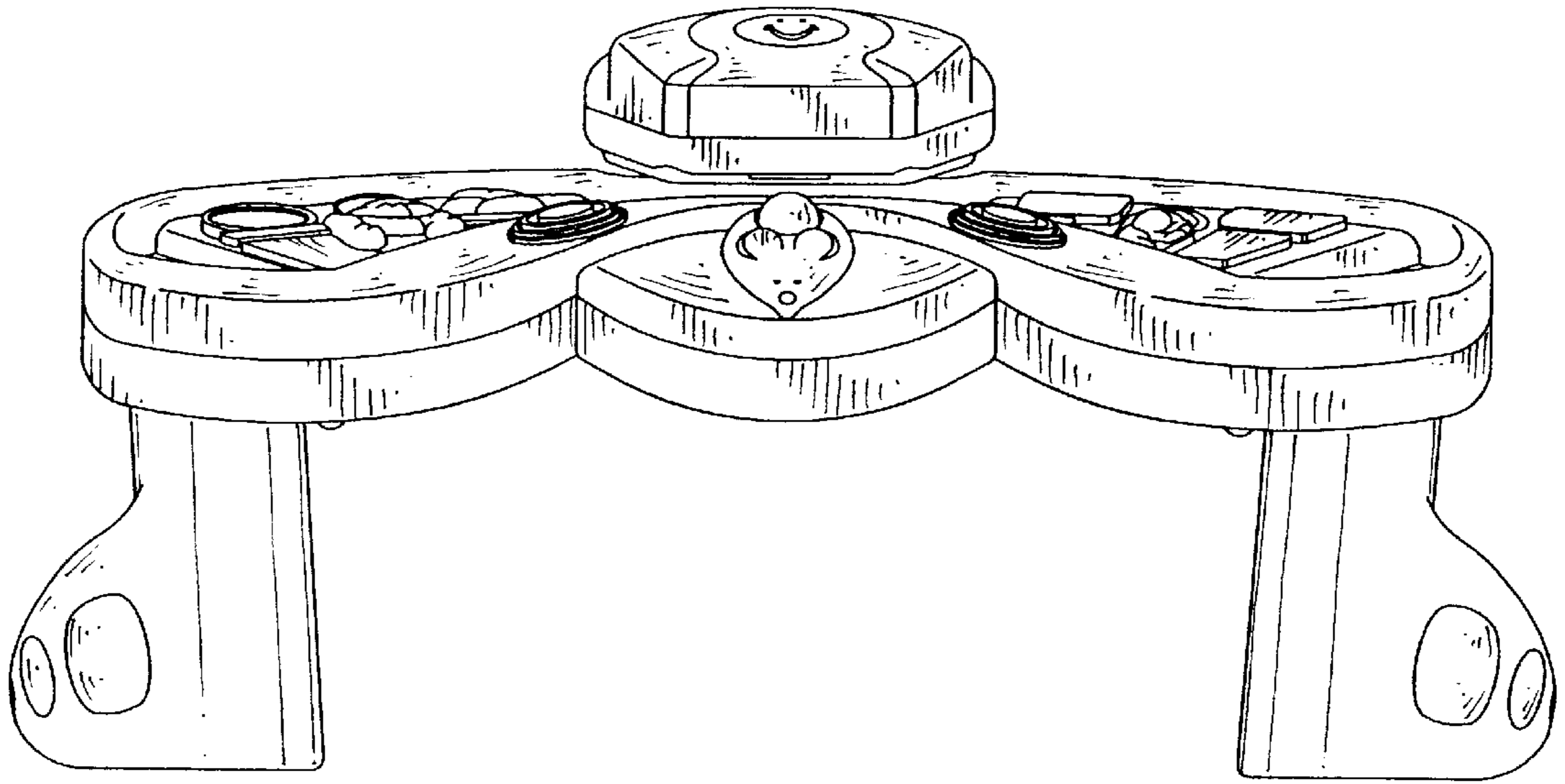

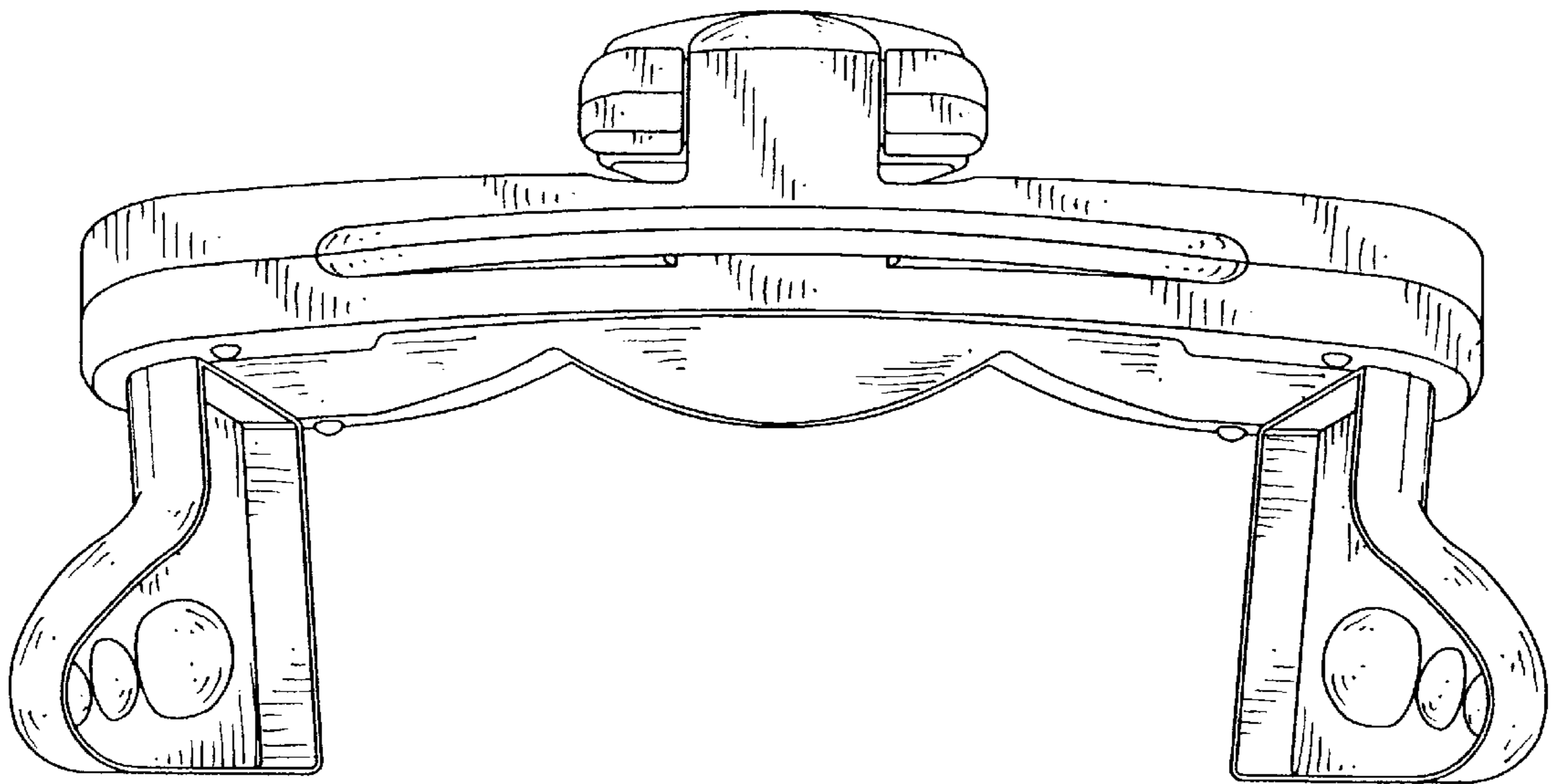

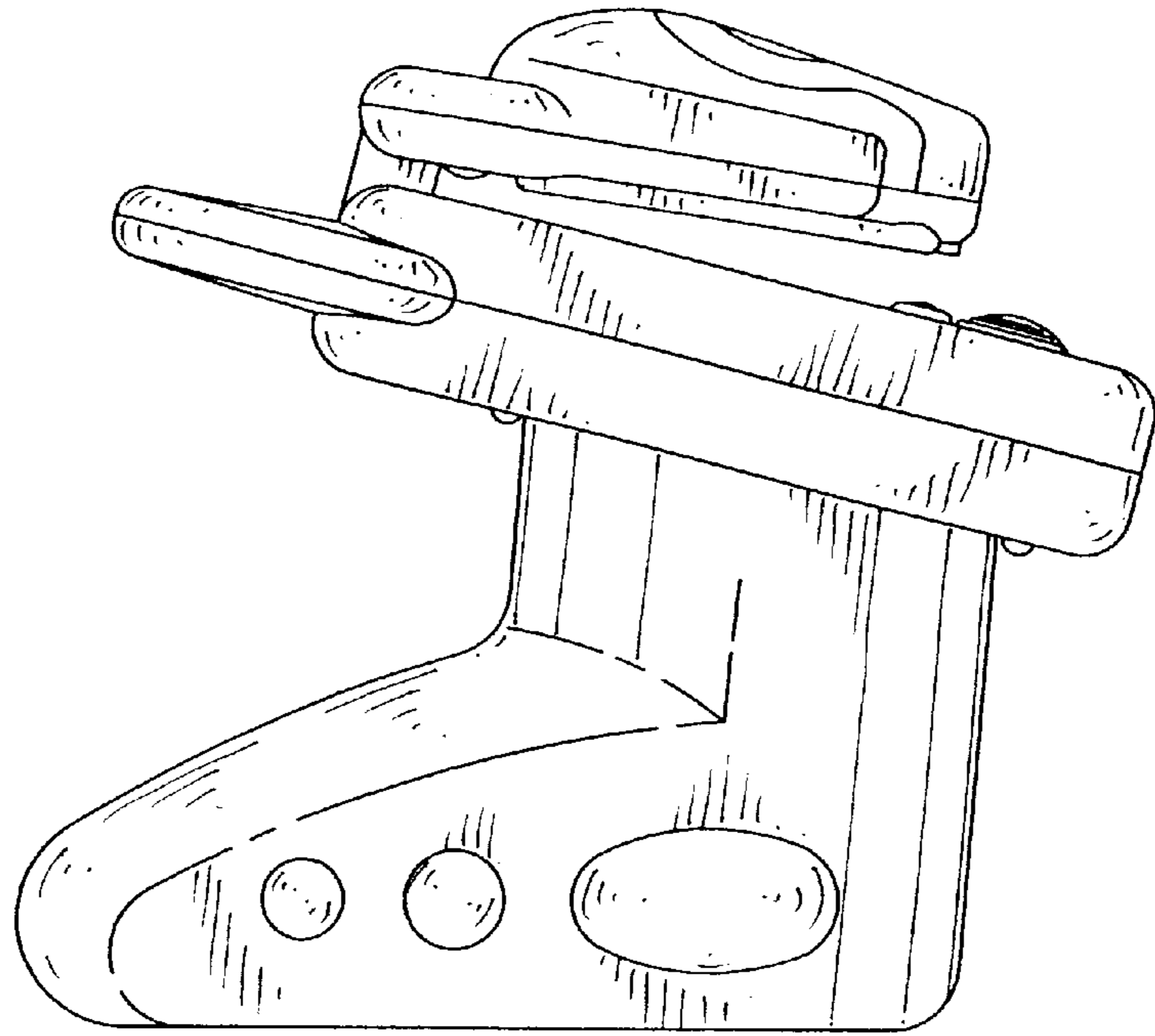

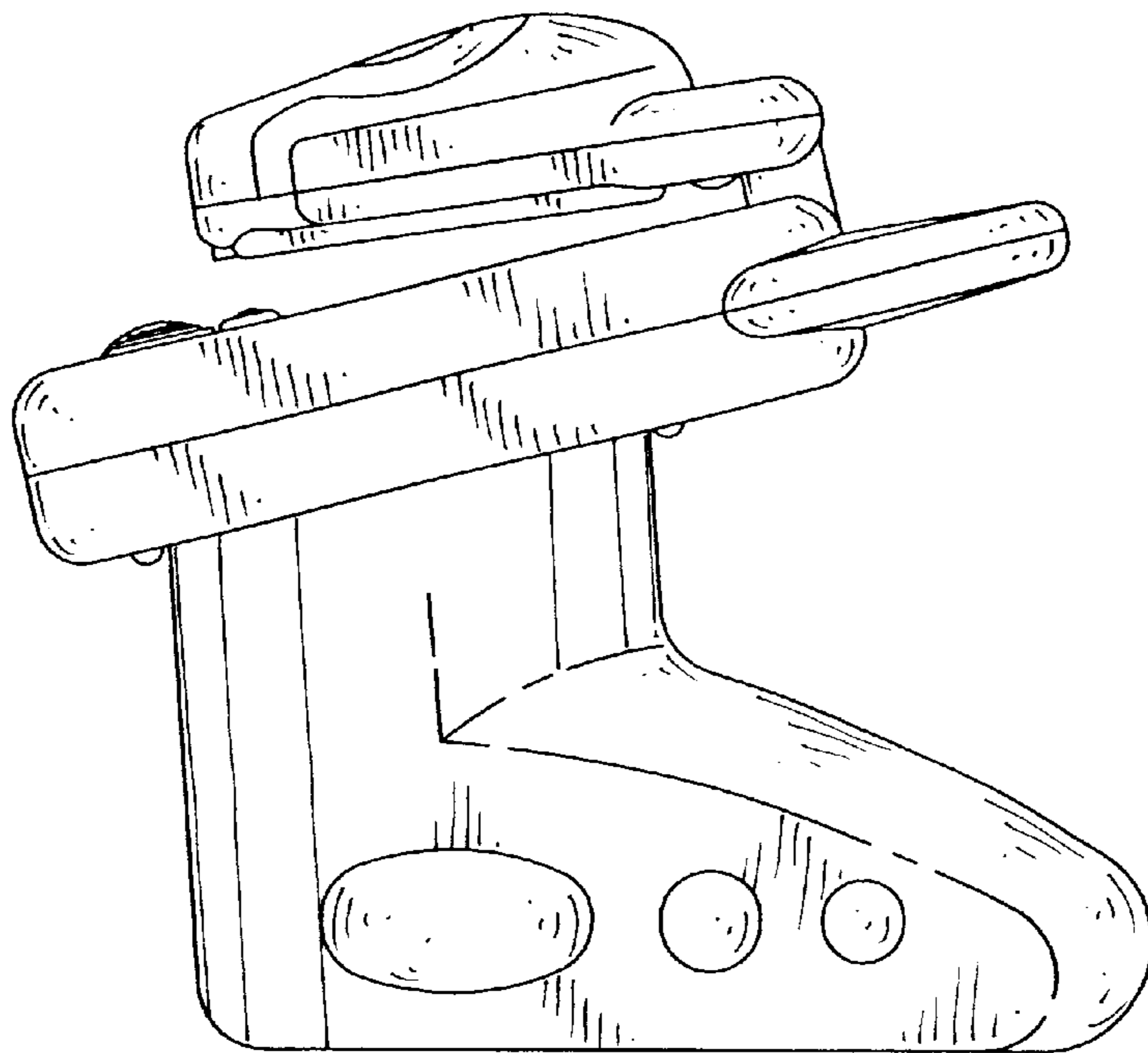

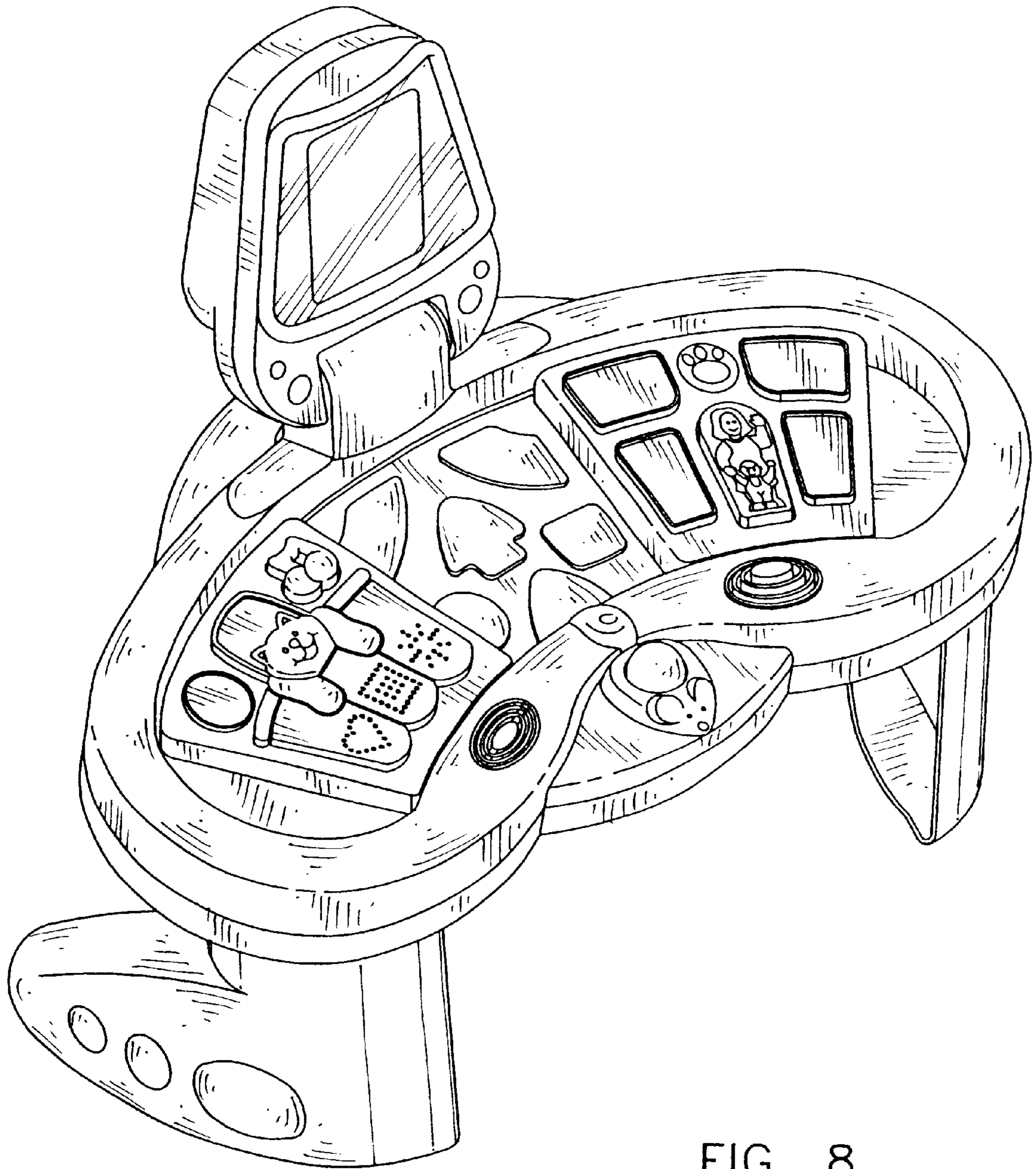
