(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a portable compact disc player case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a portable compact disc player case, showing the new design with environment, the broken lines forming no part of my claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevation view of the invention shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a left elevation view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a right elevation view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 2;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 8 is a front perspective view of the invention illustrated in FIG. 1 with a flap in an open position, the broken lines representing environment and forming no part of my claimed design.

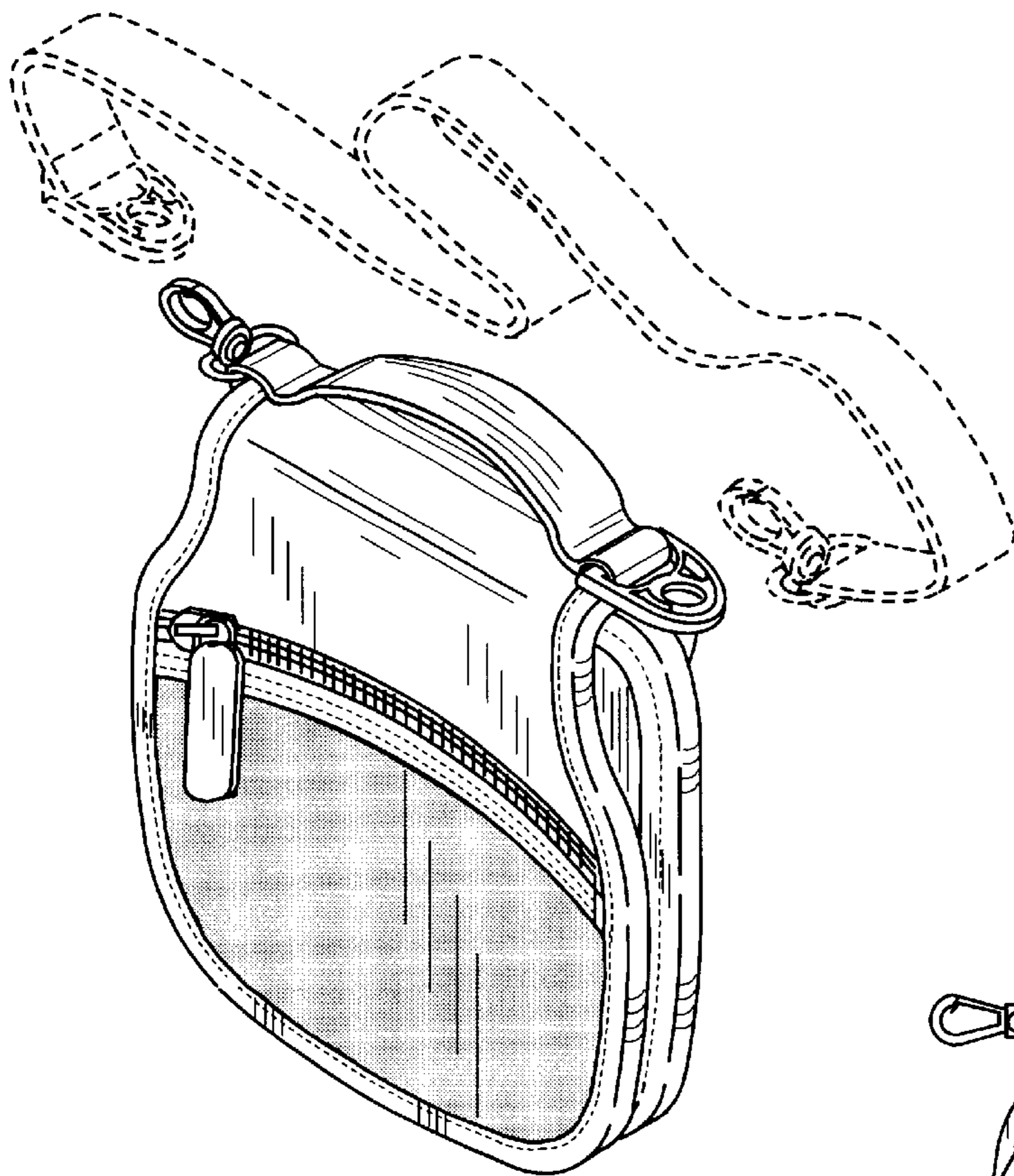

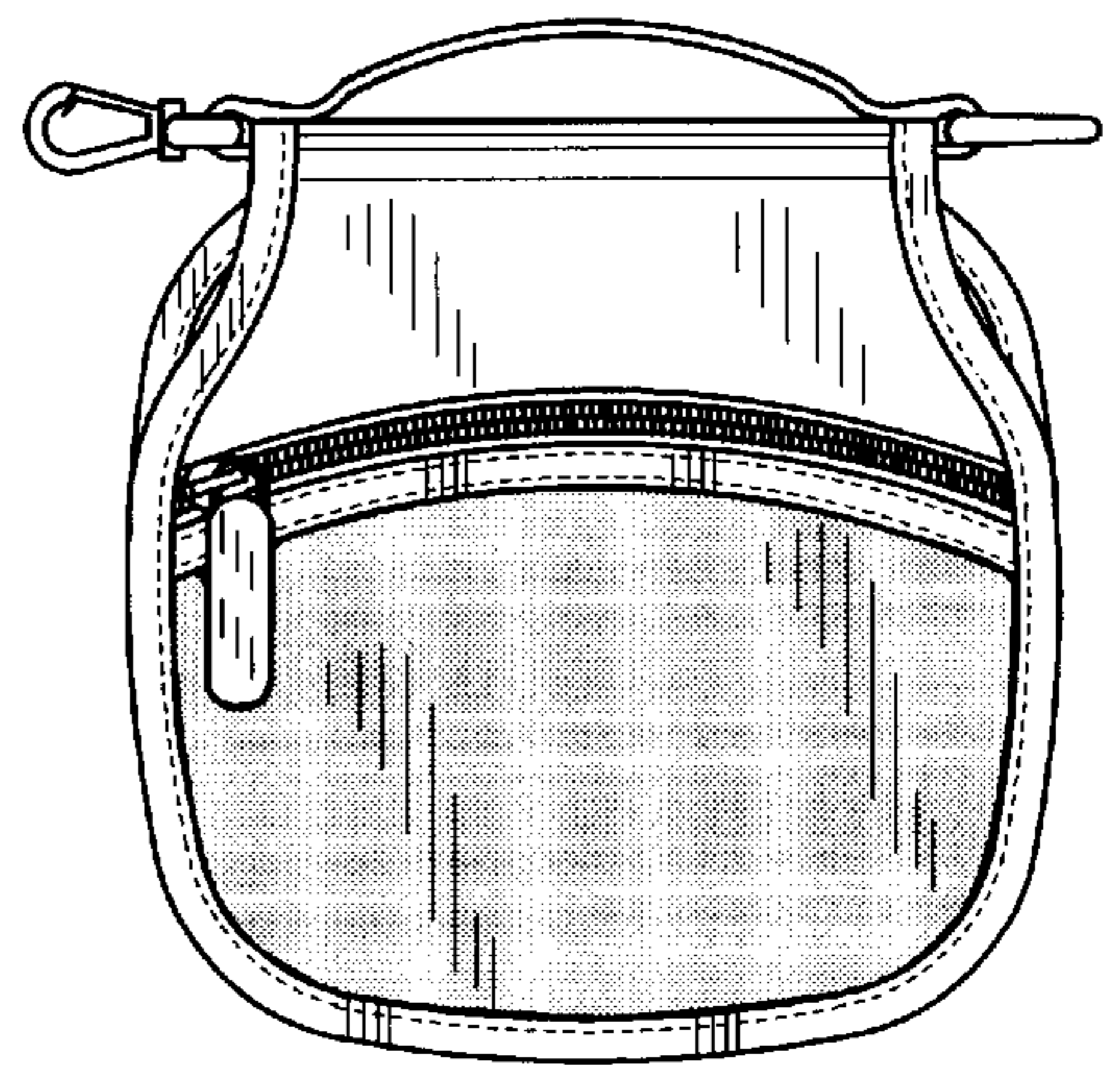

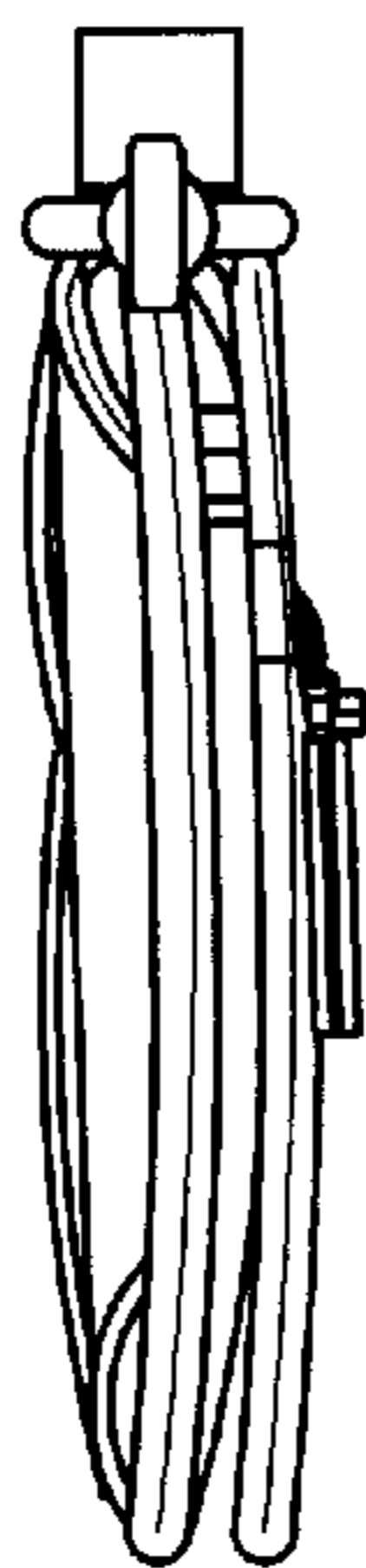

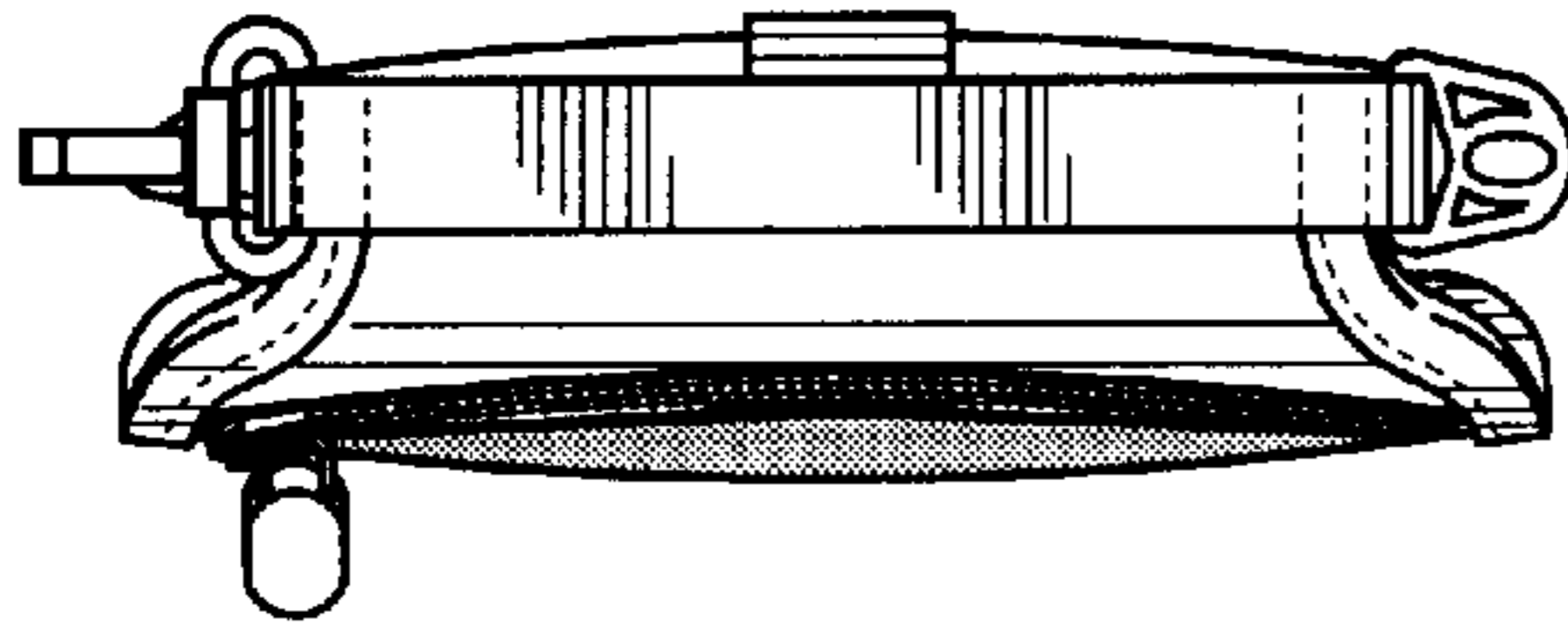

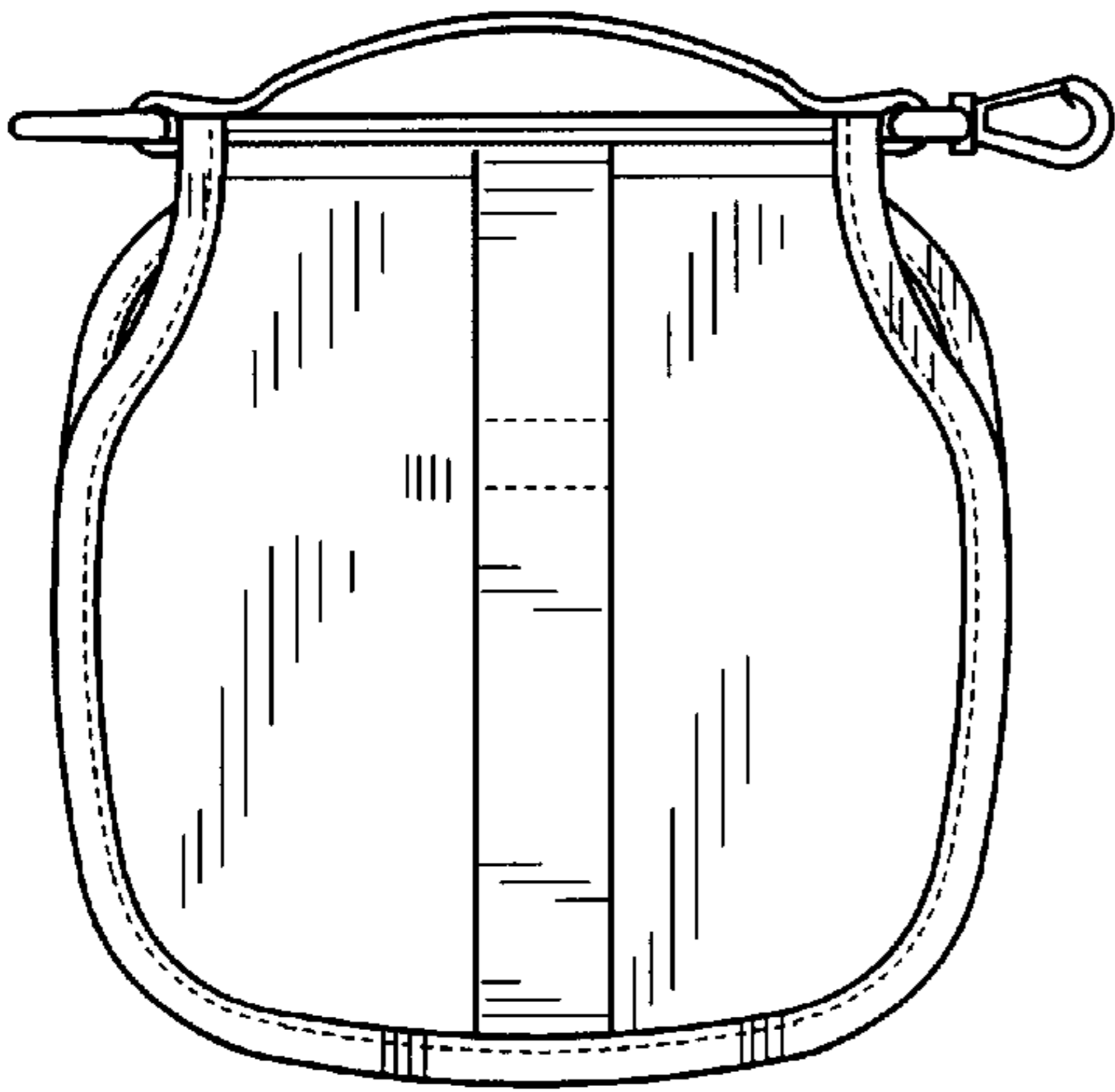
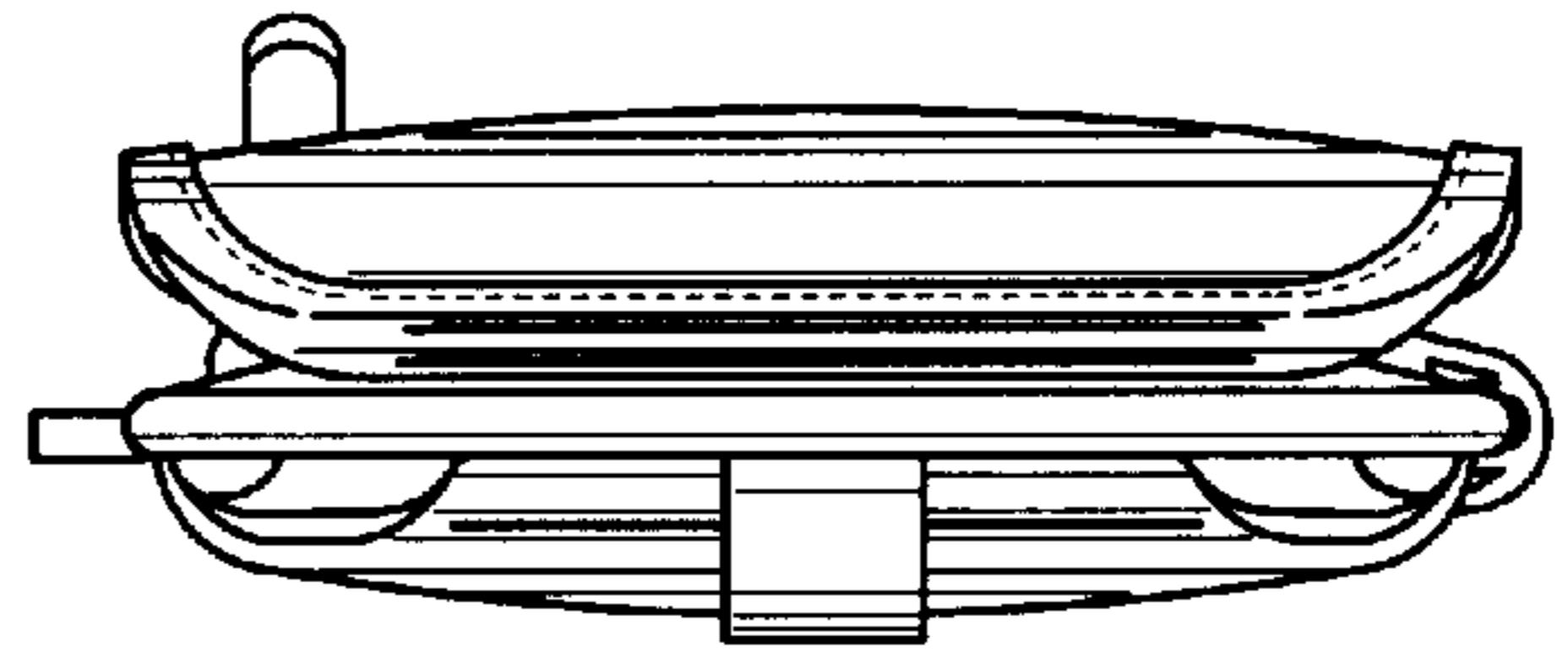
