FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof.

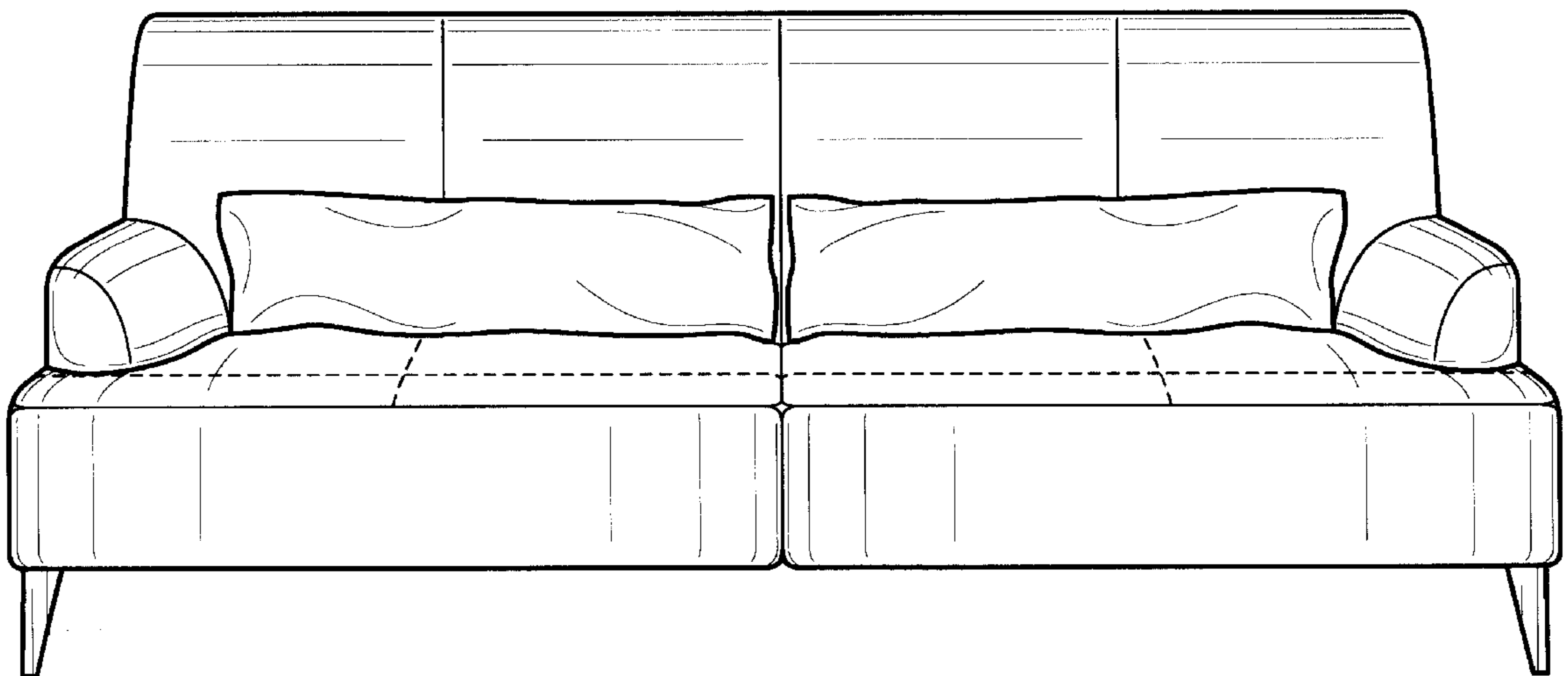
The broken lines shown on the seat cushion are understood

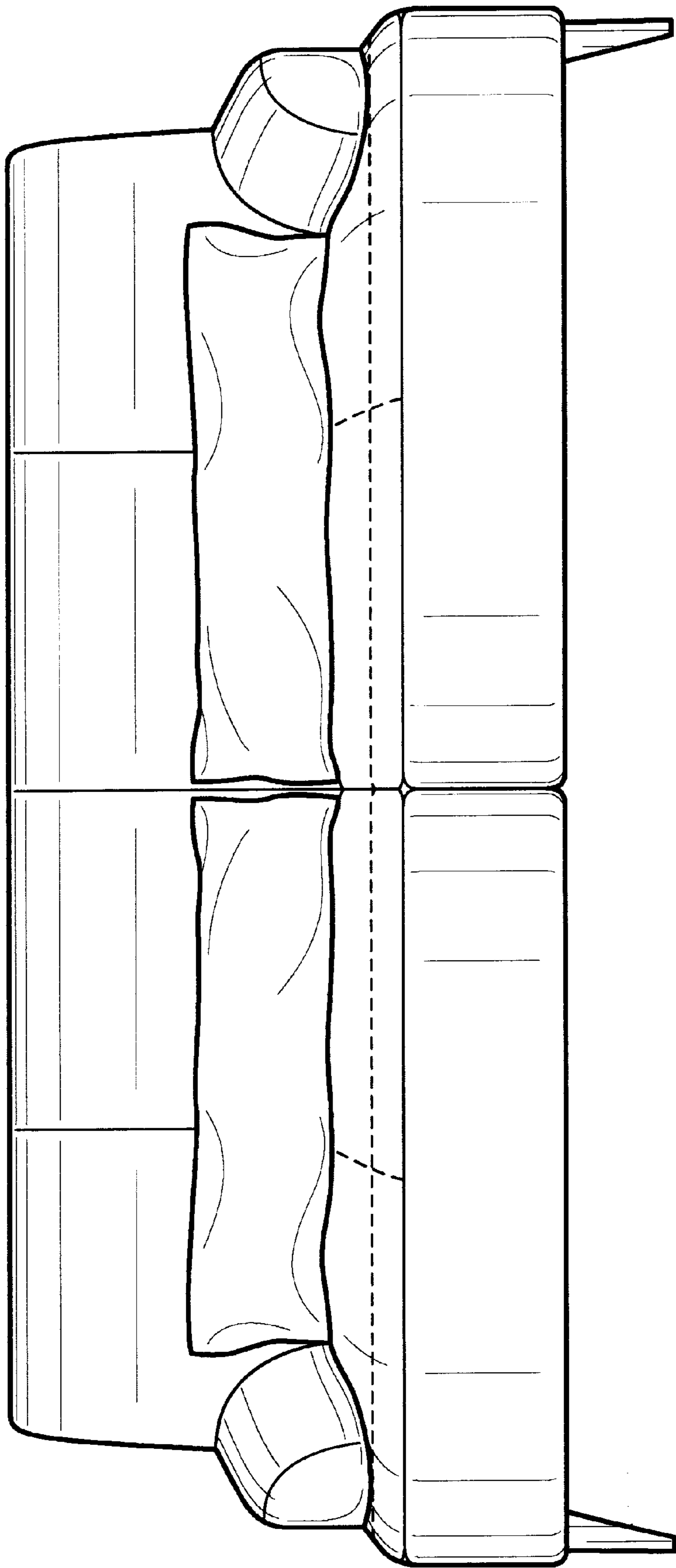
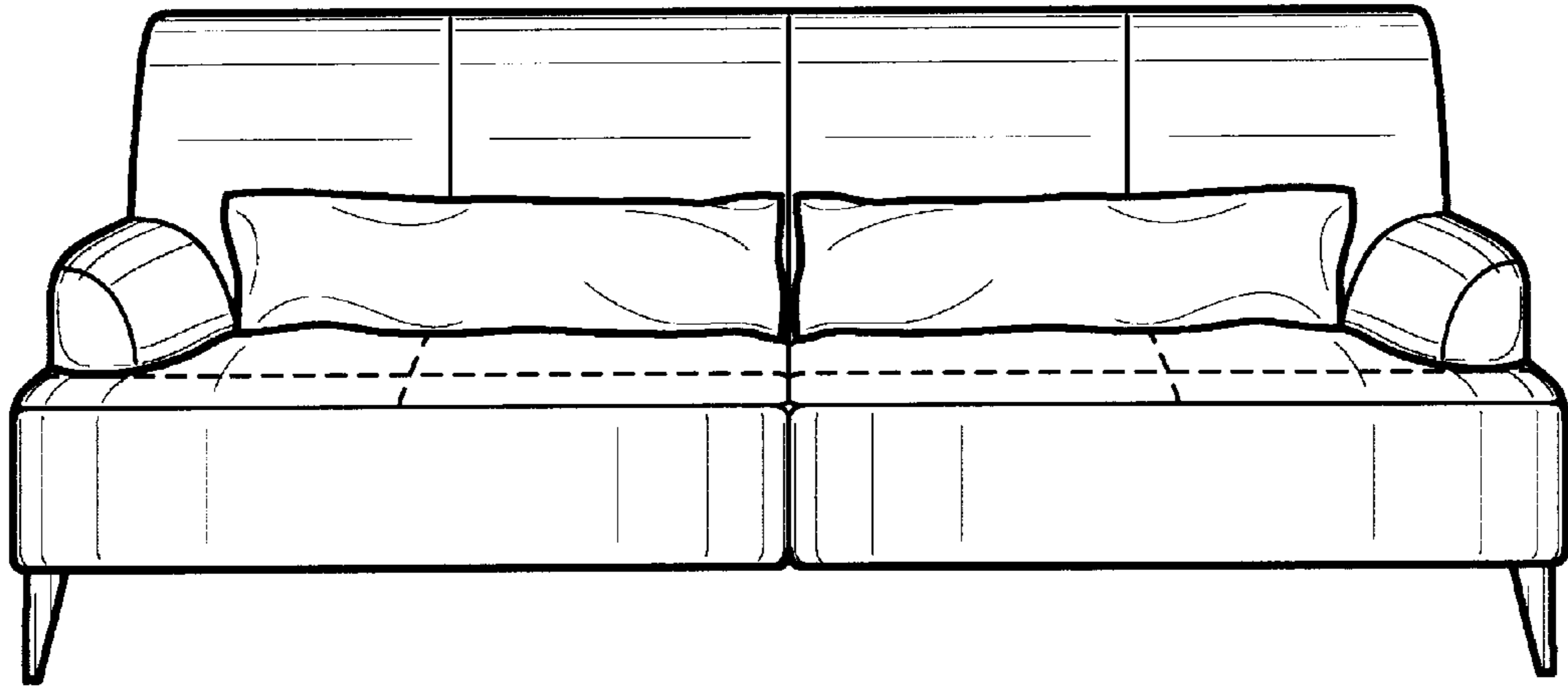
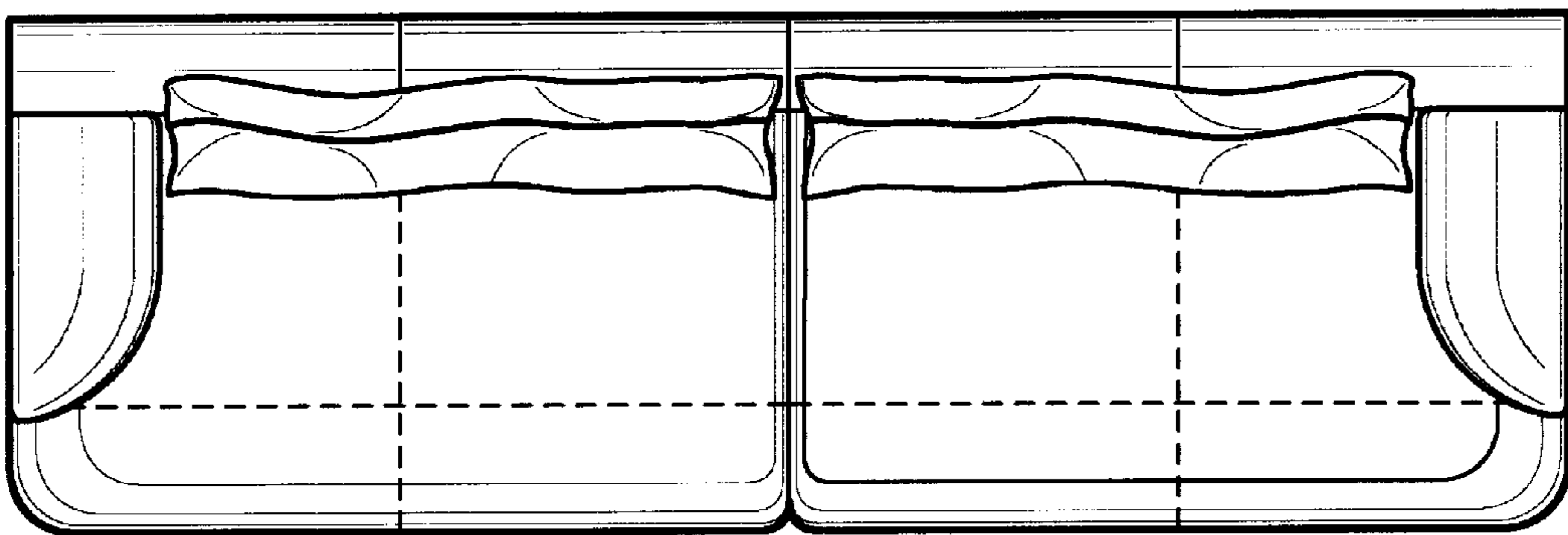


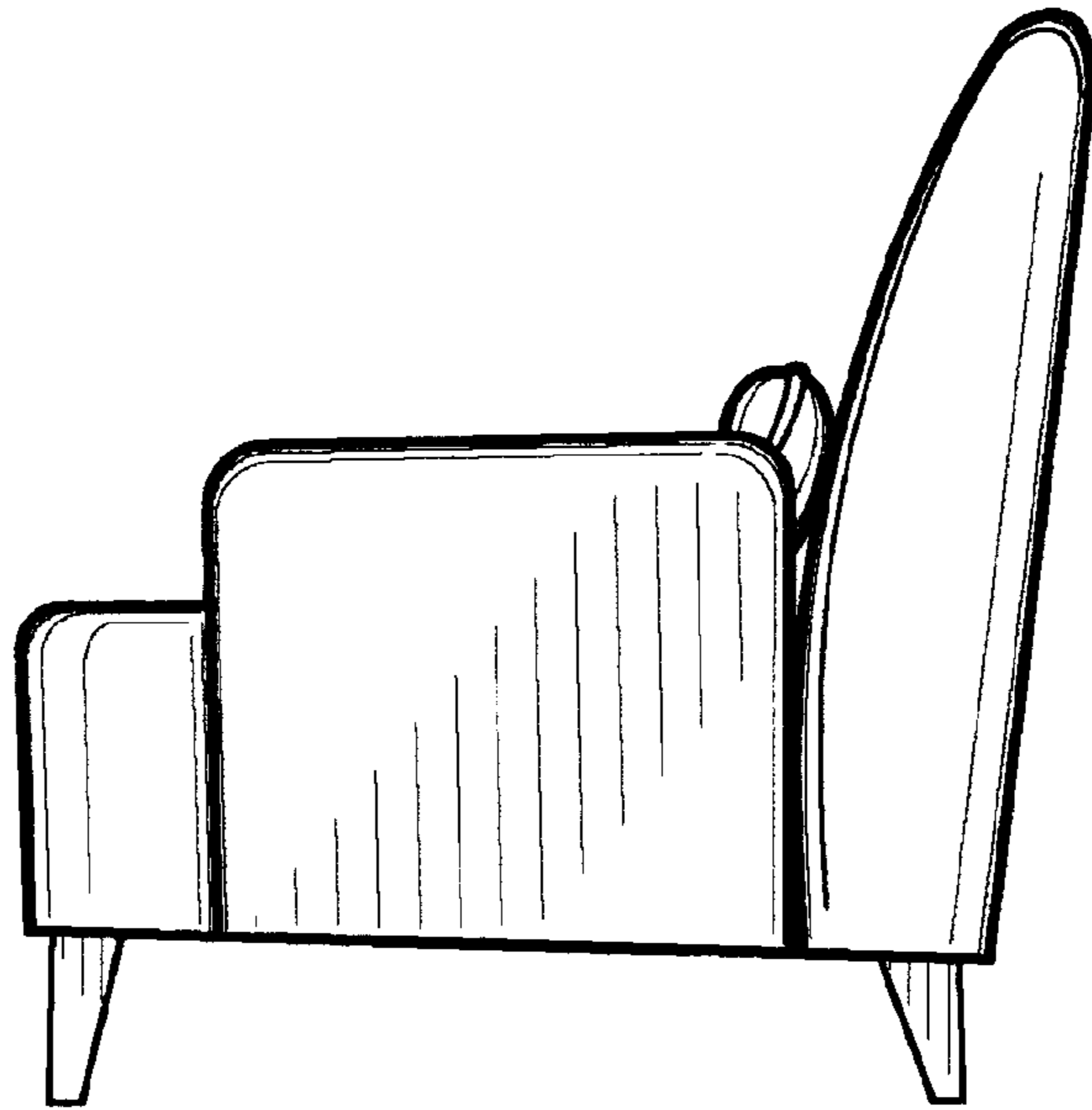

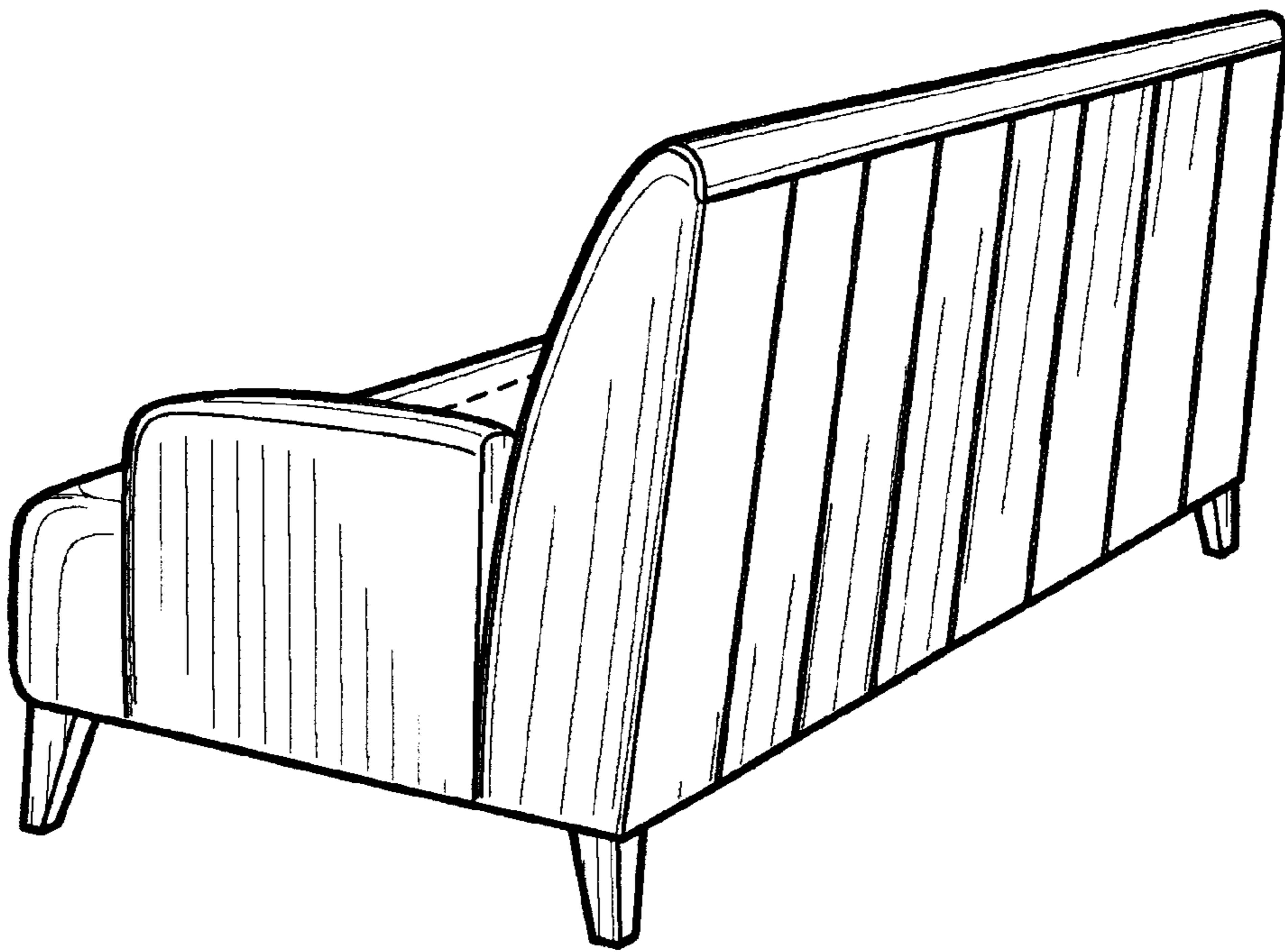
