DESCRIPTION

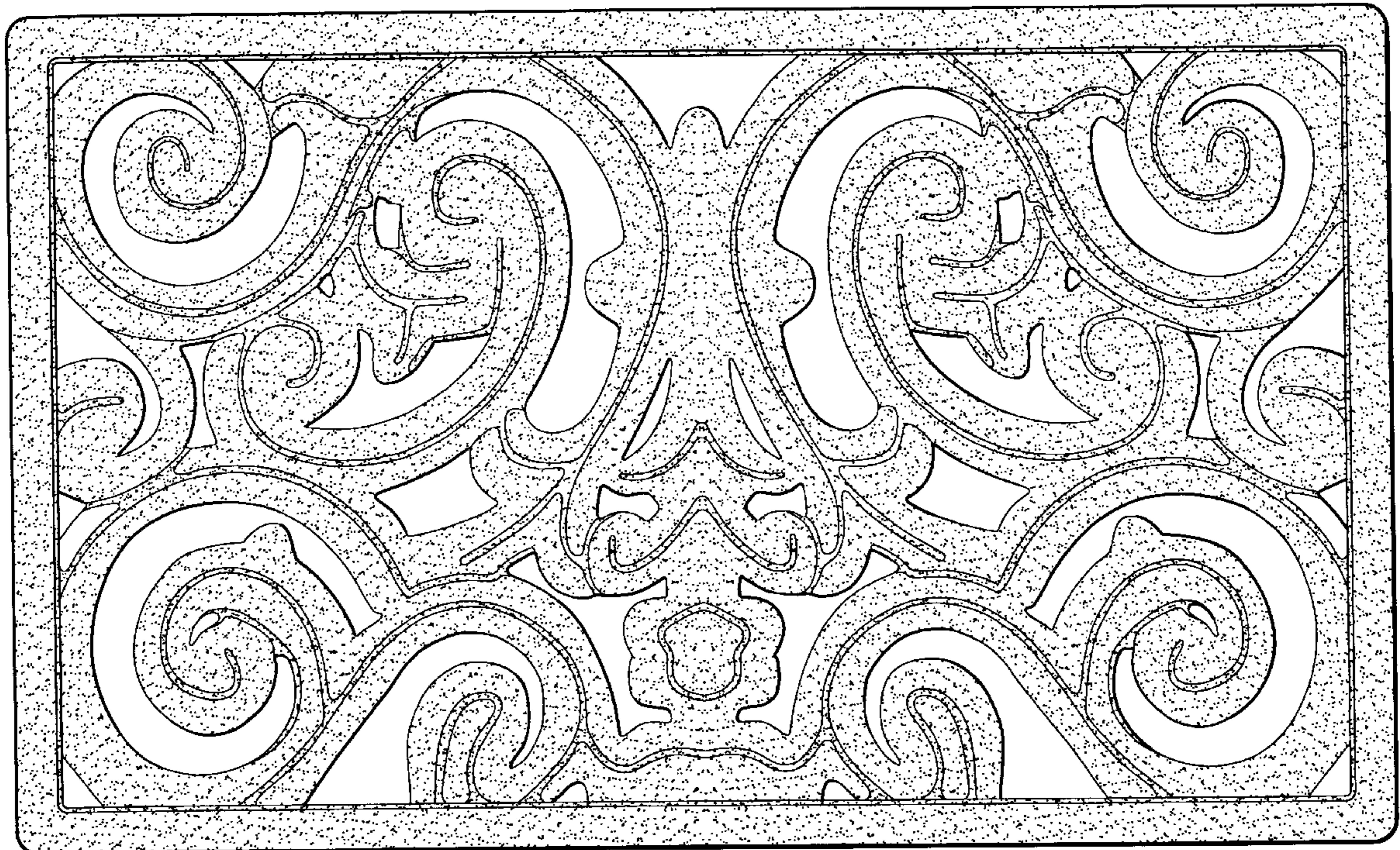
FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a doormat showing my new design;

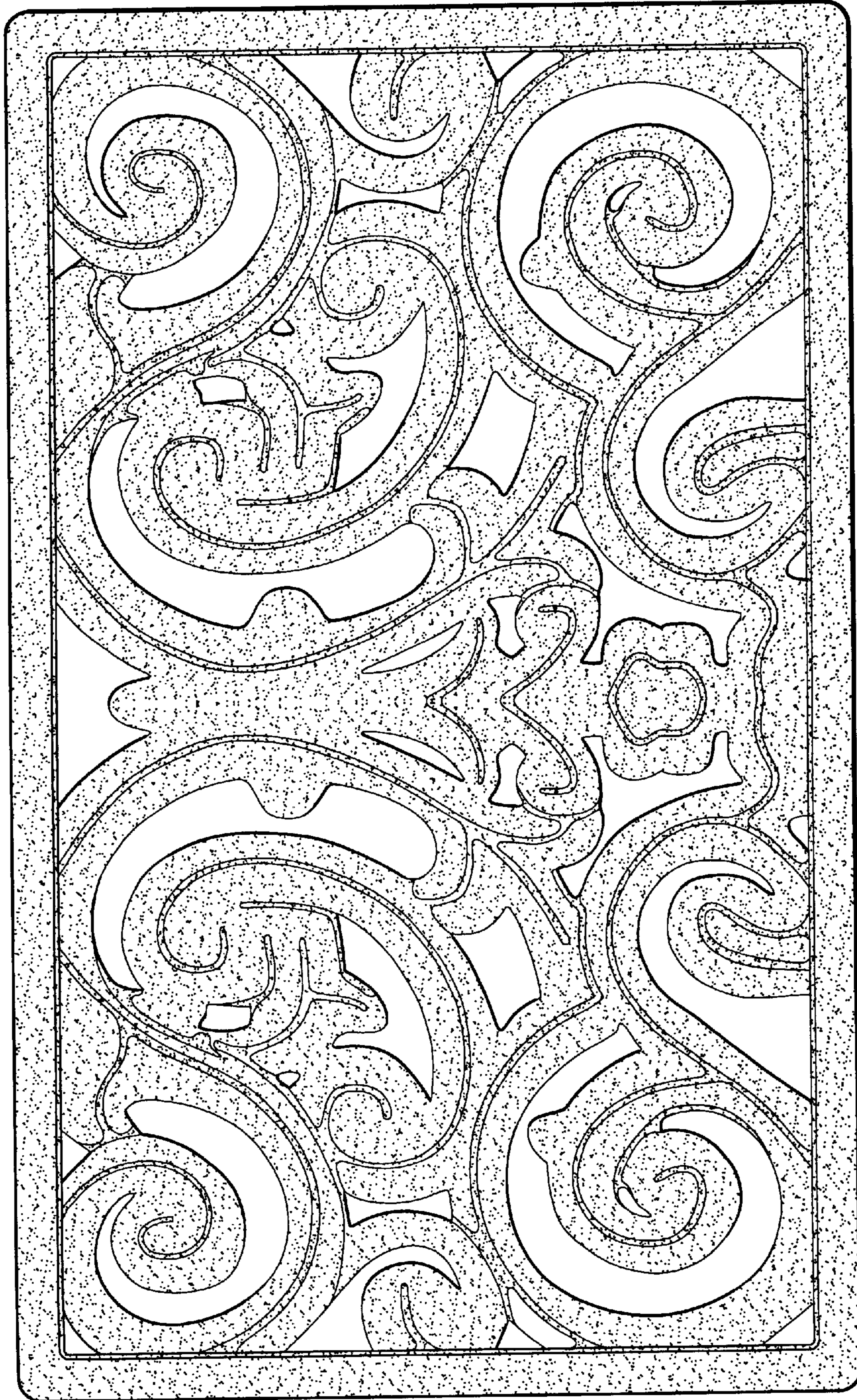

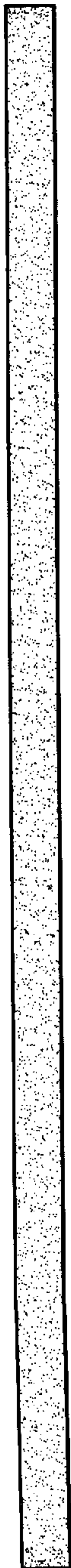

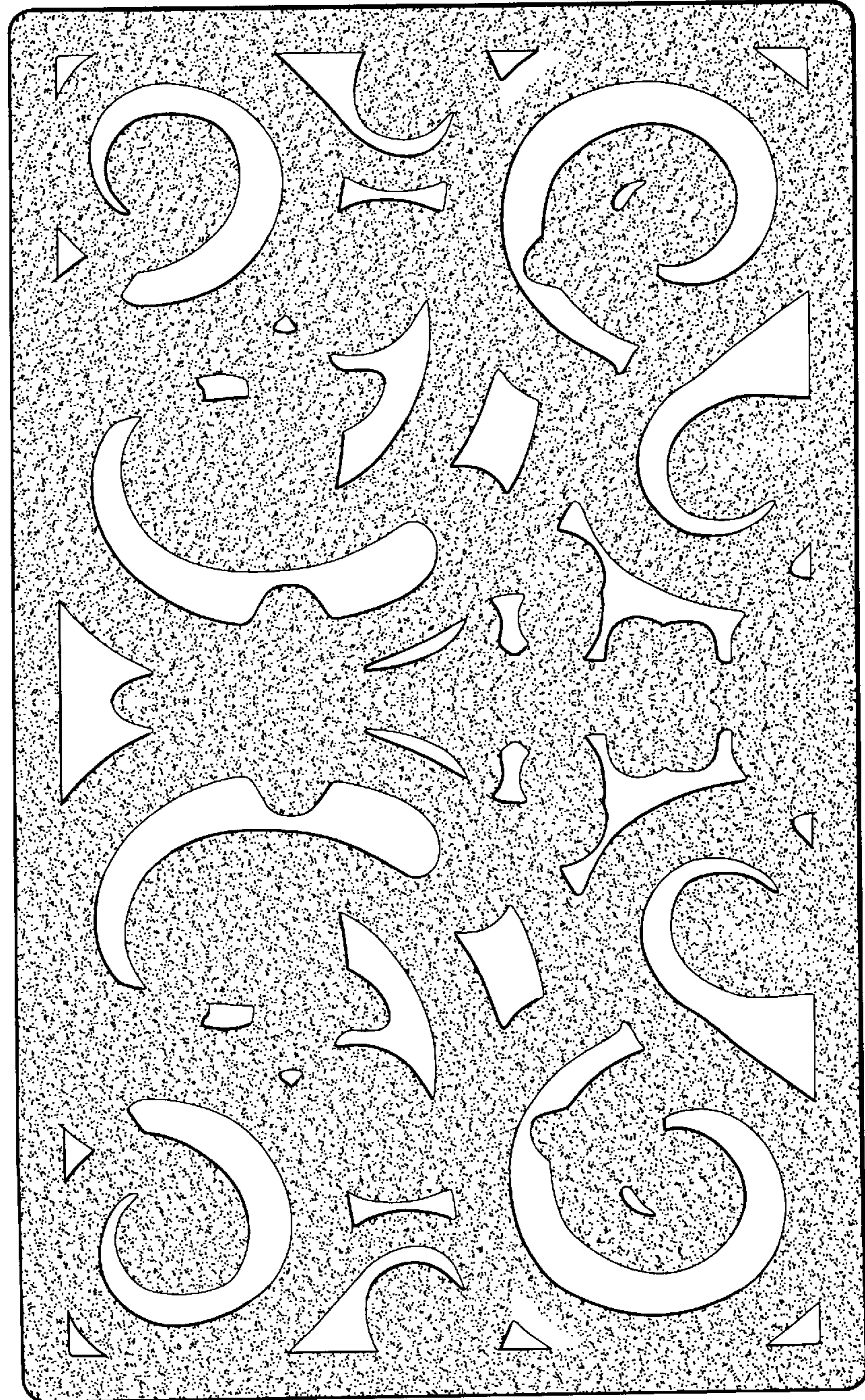
