DESCRIPTION

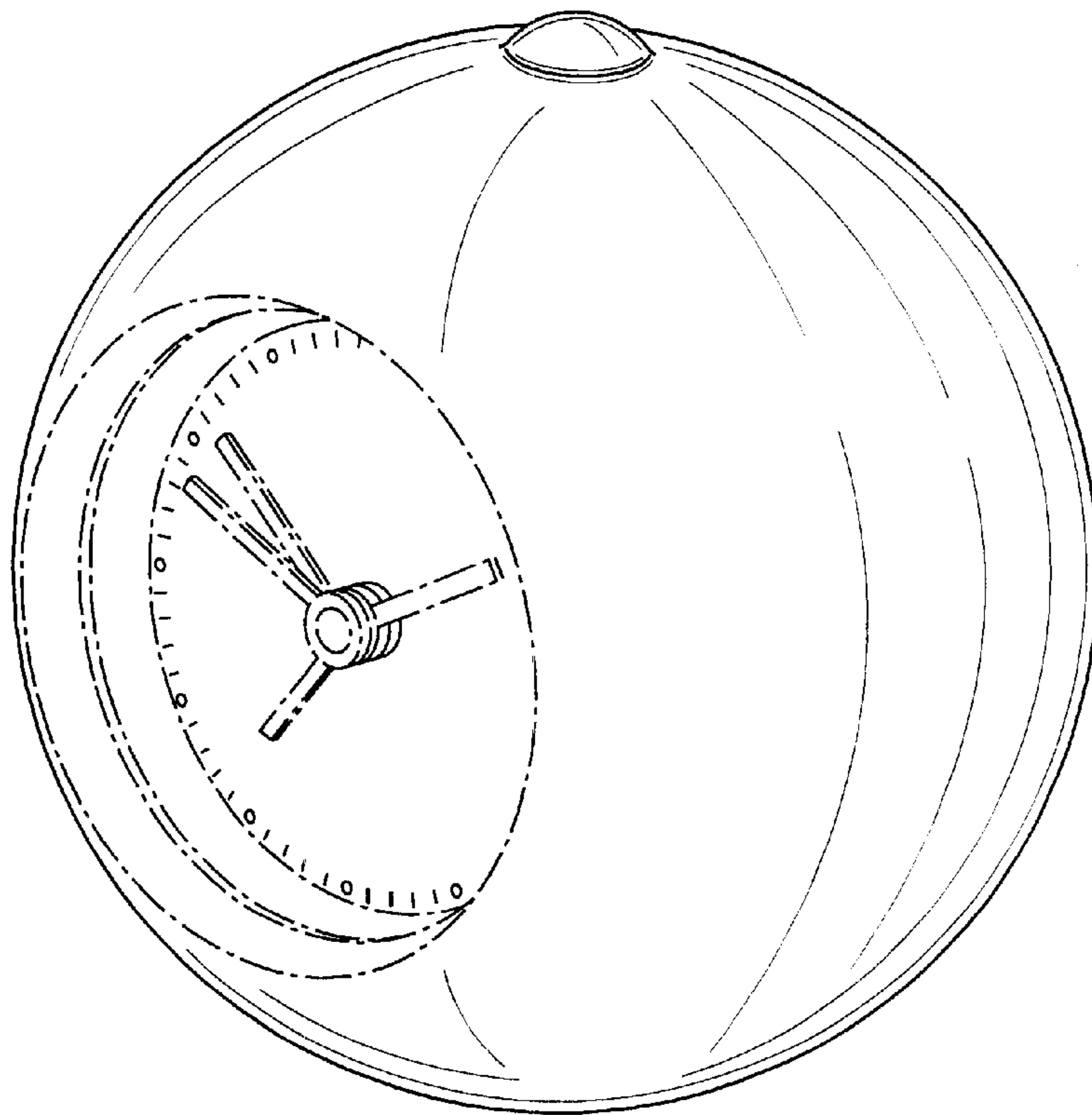

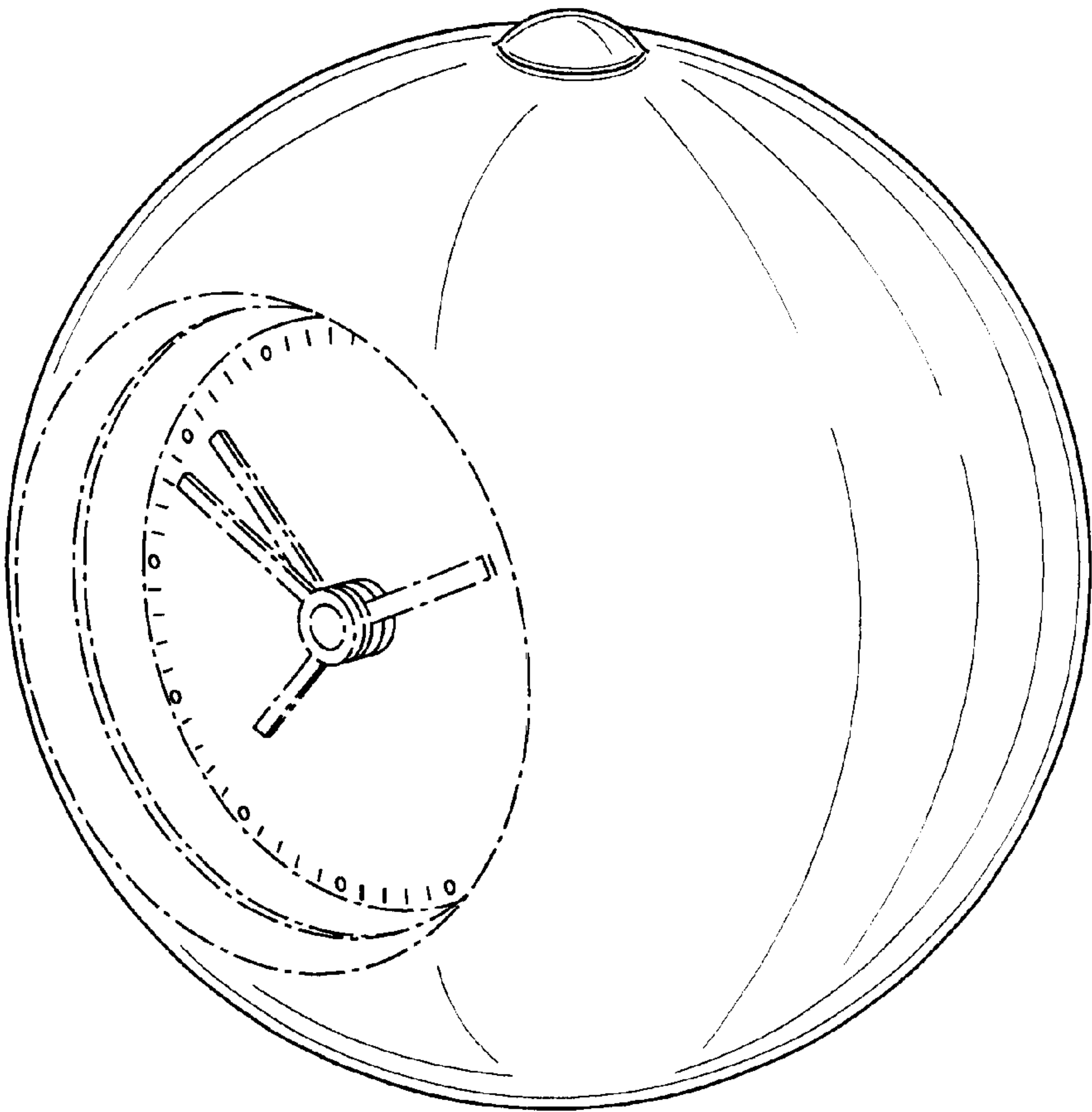

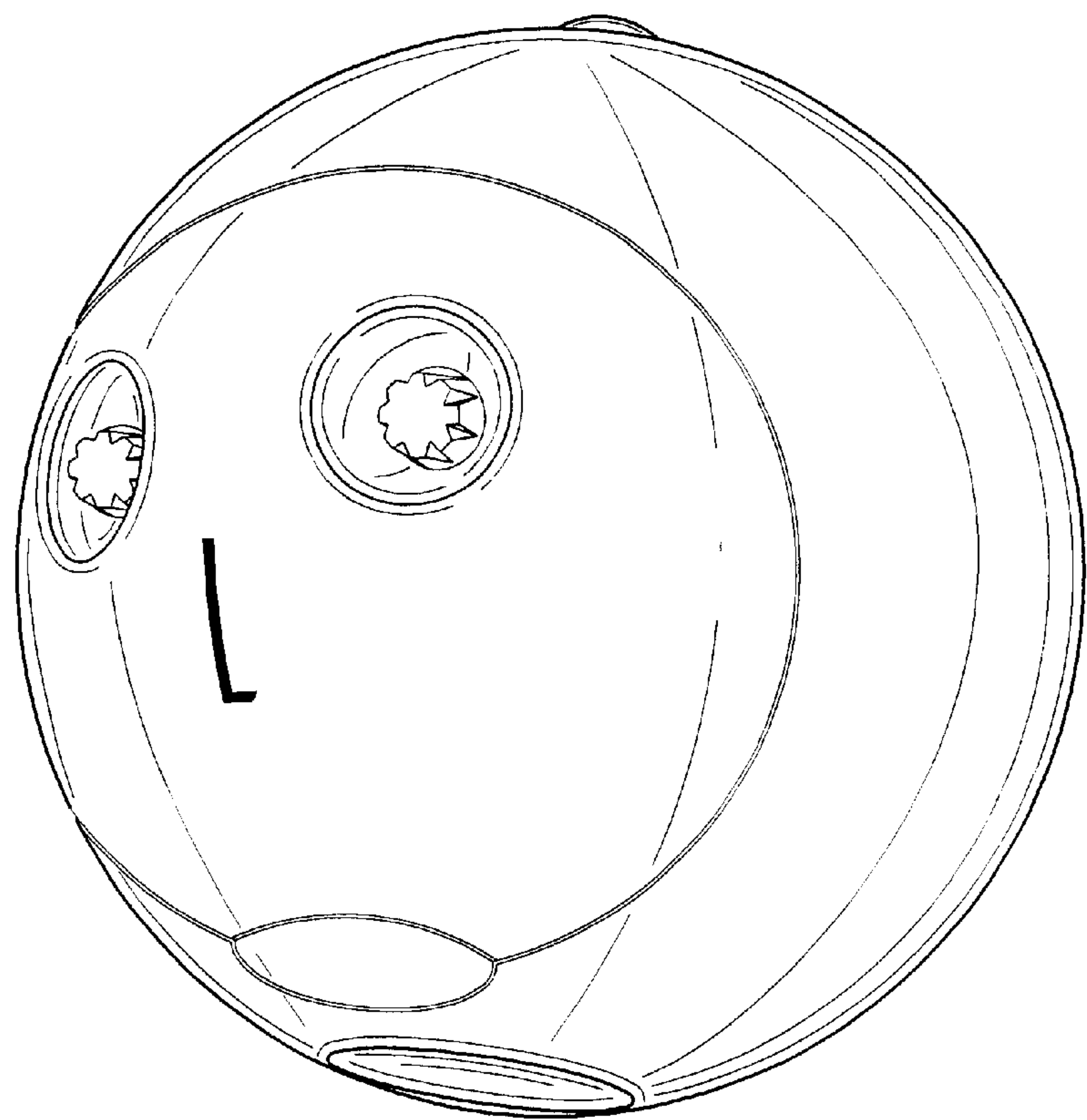

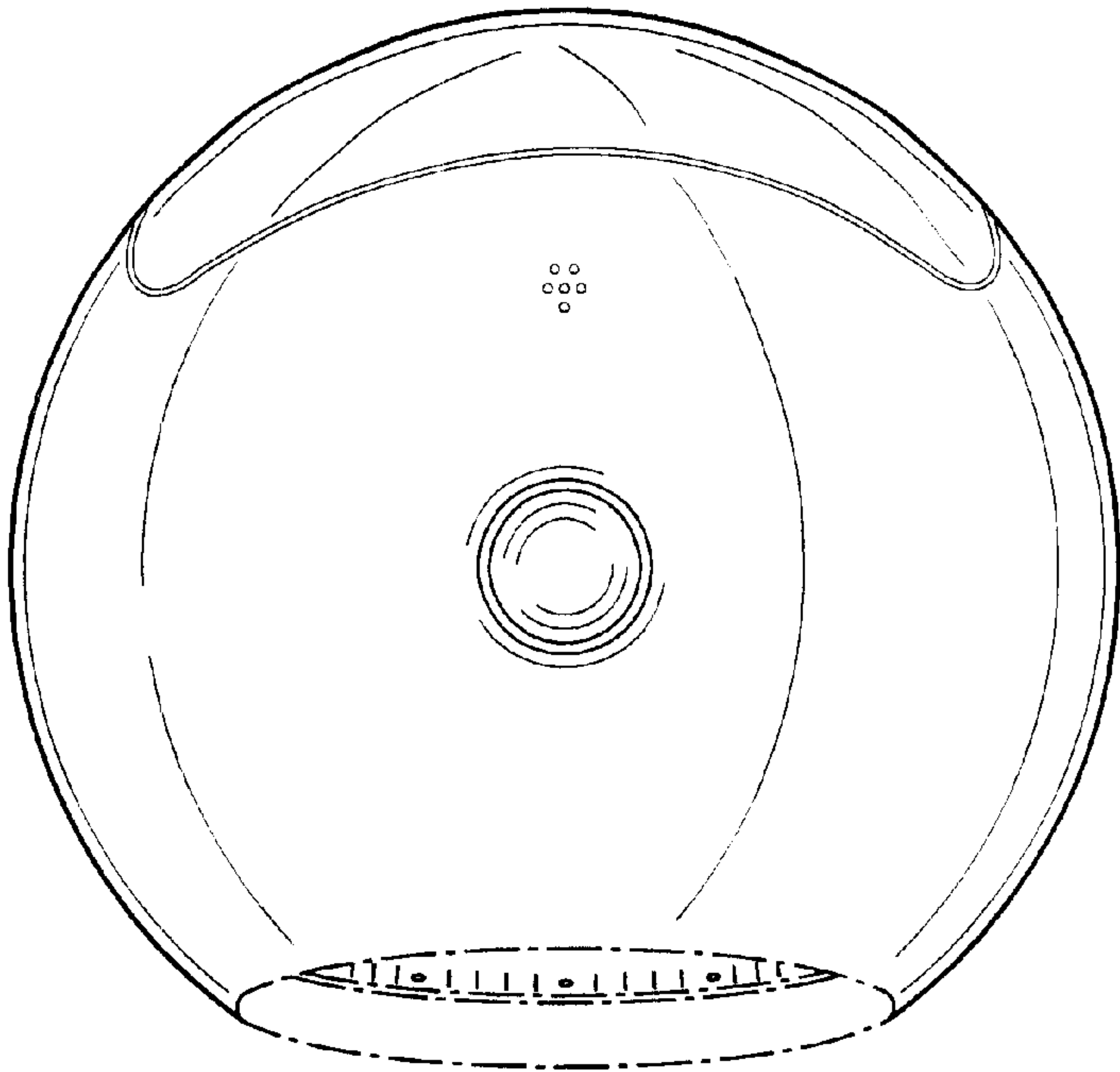

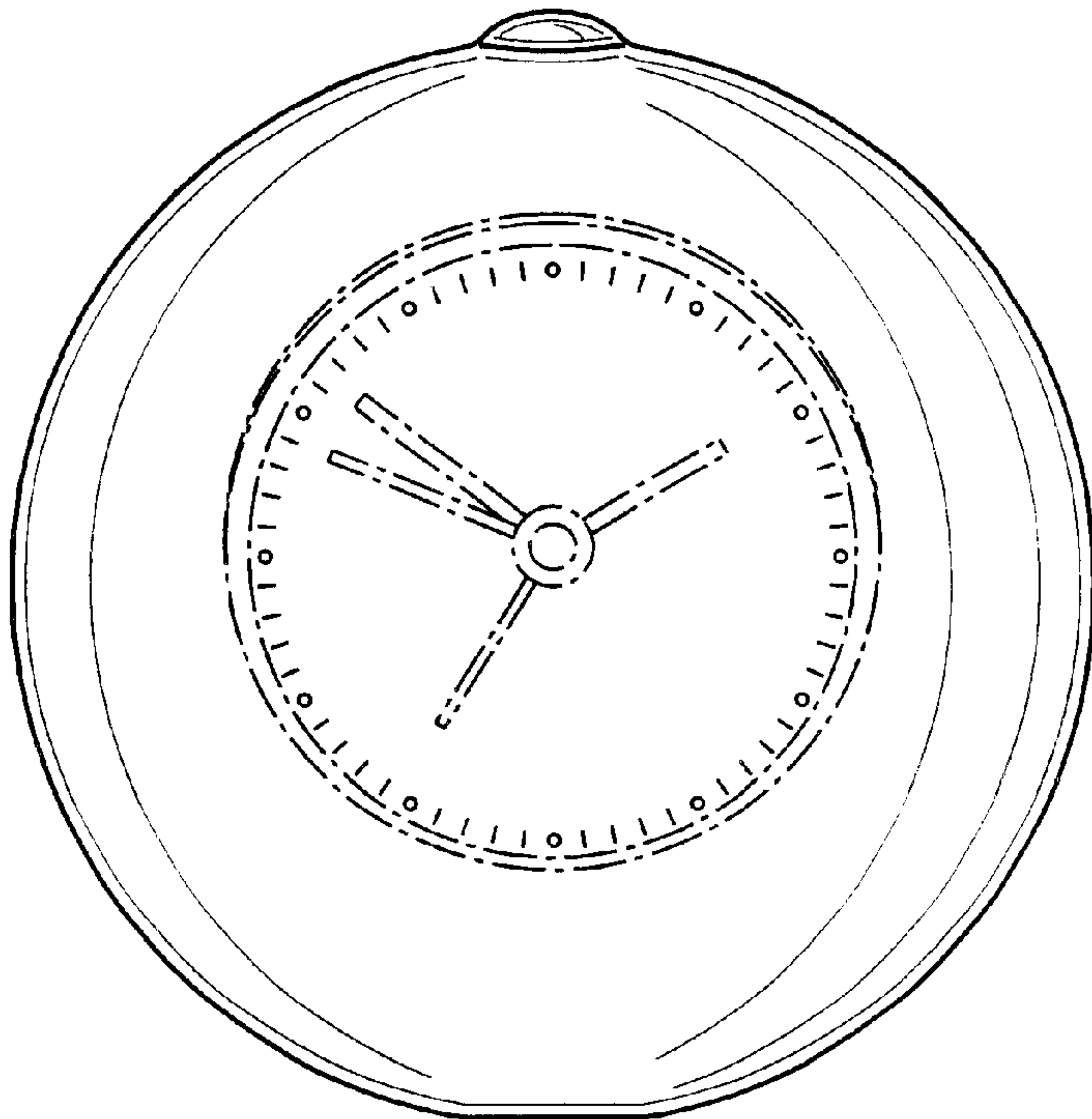

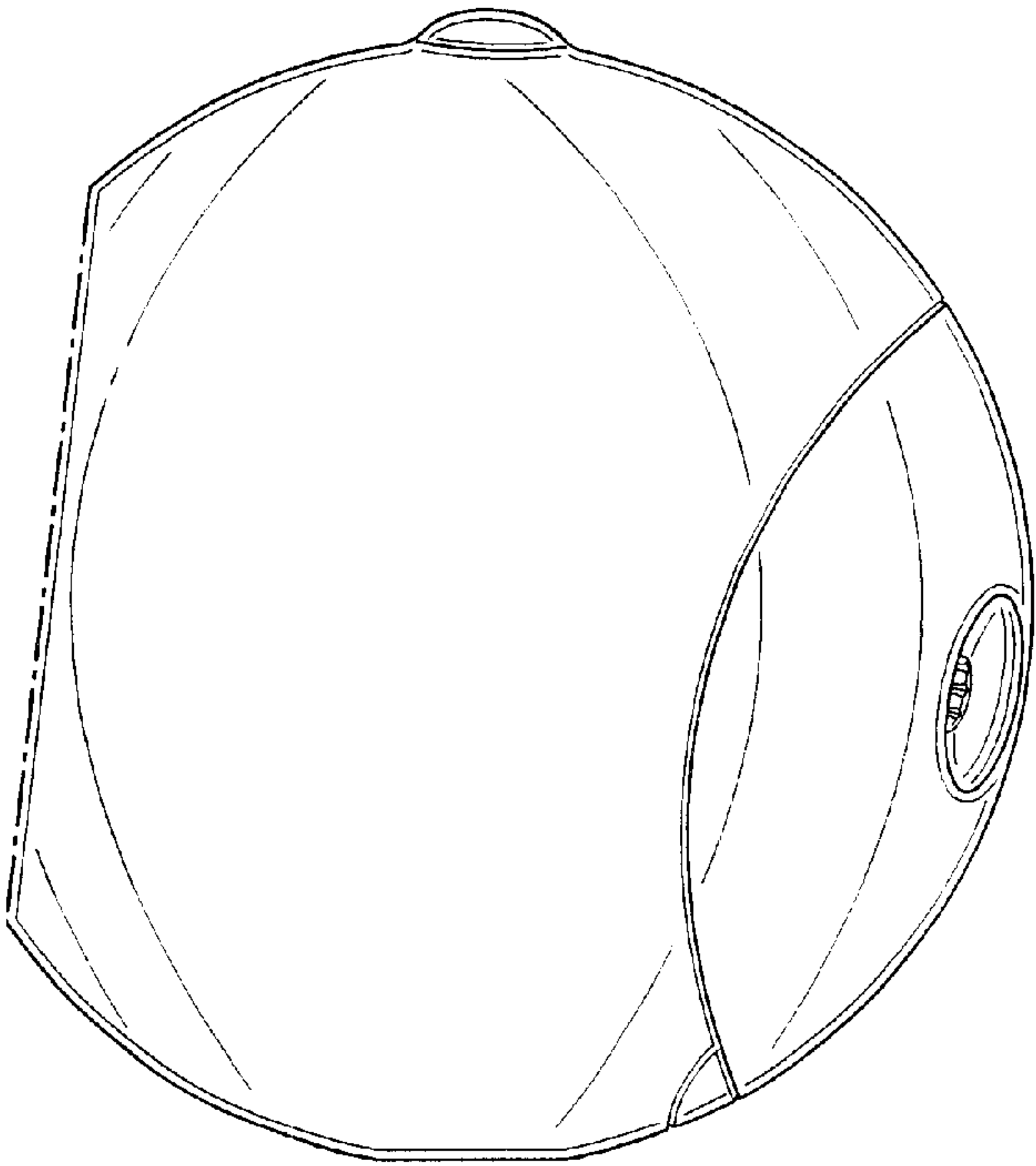

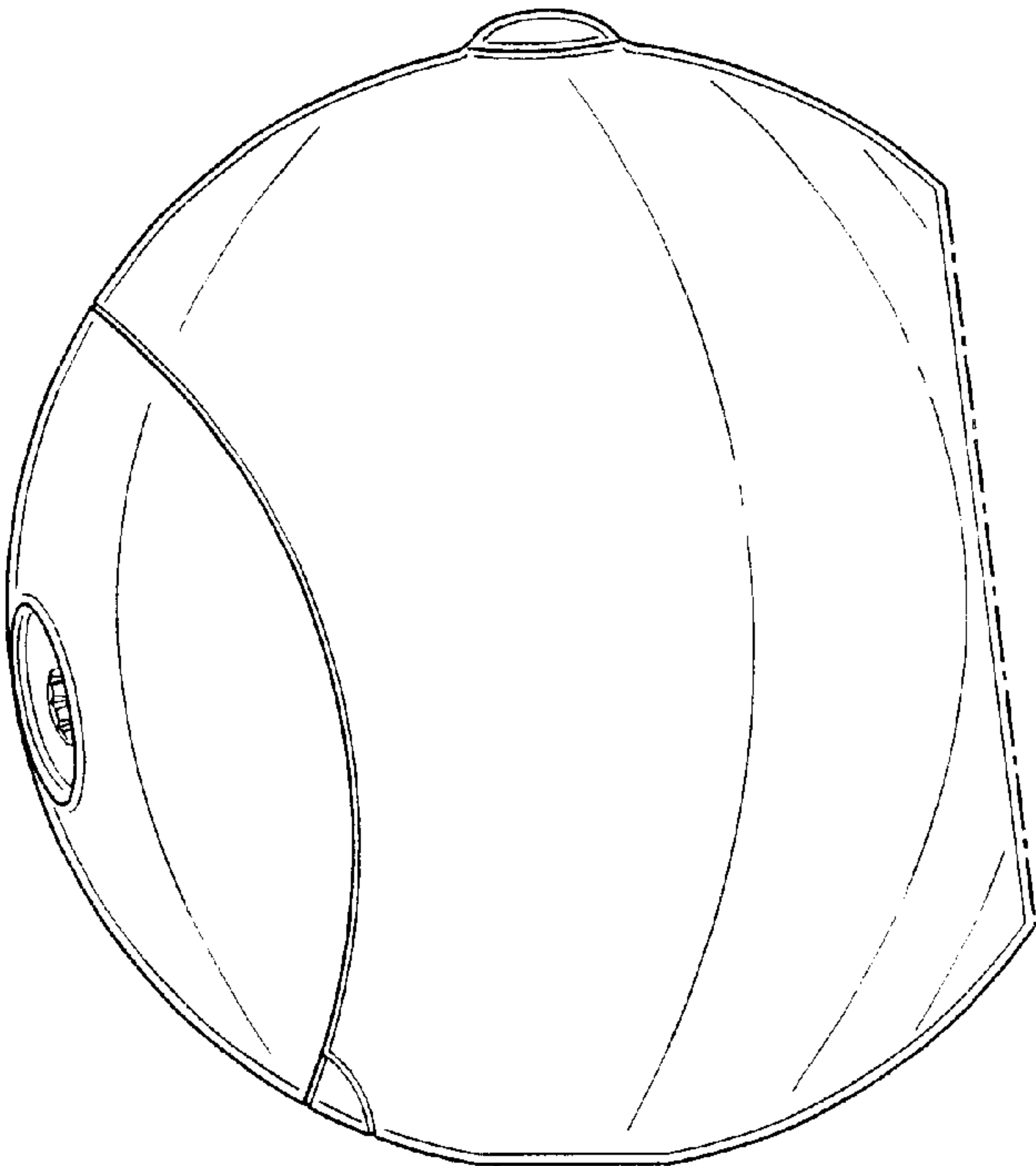

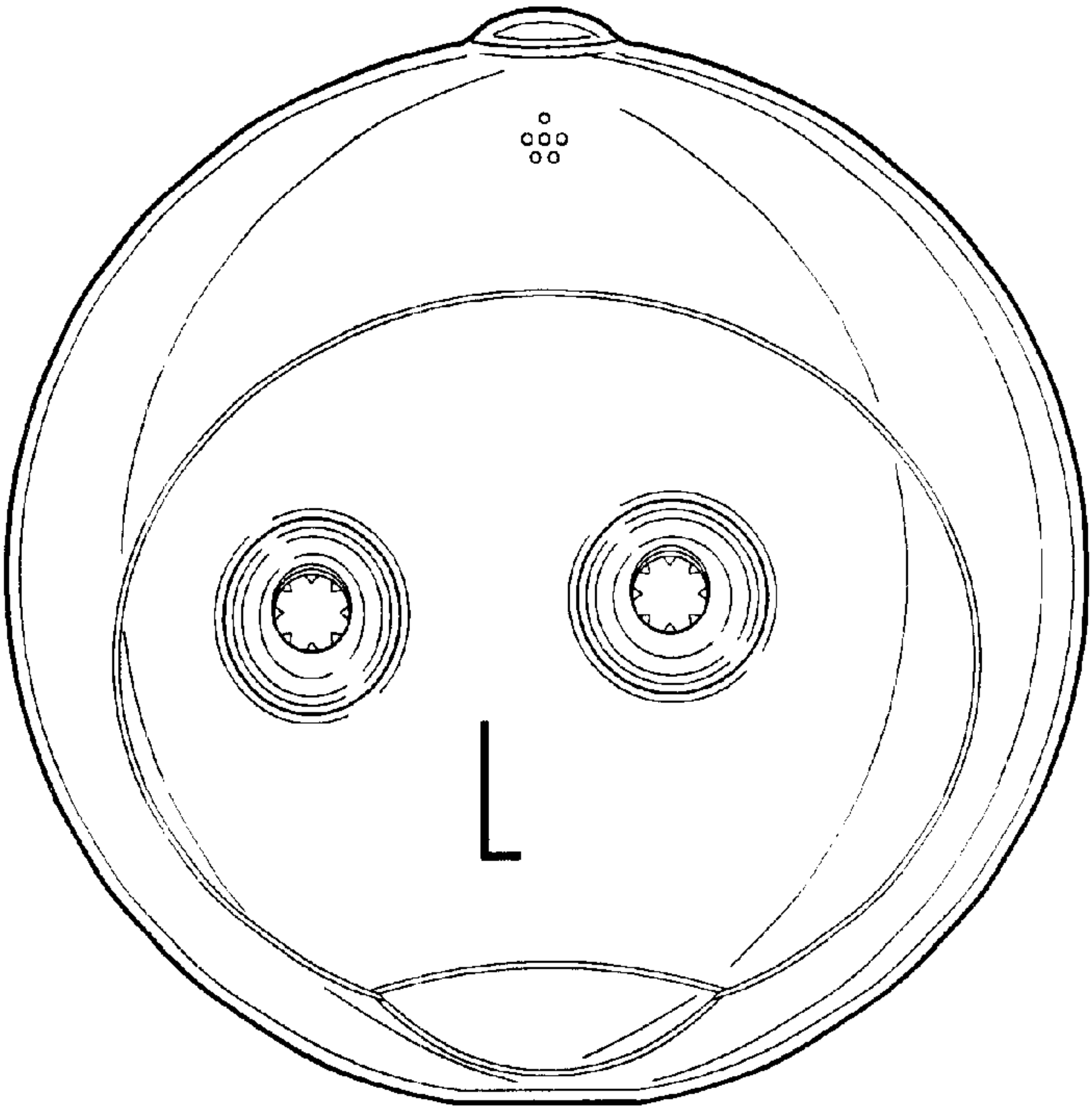
