FIG. 6 is a rear view of the present invention; and,

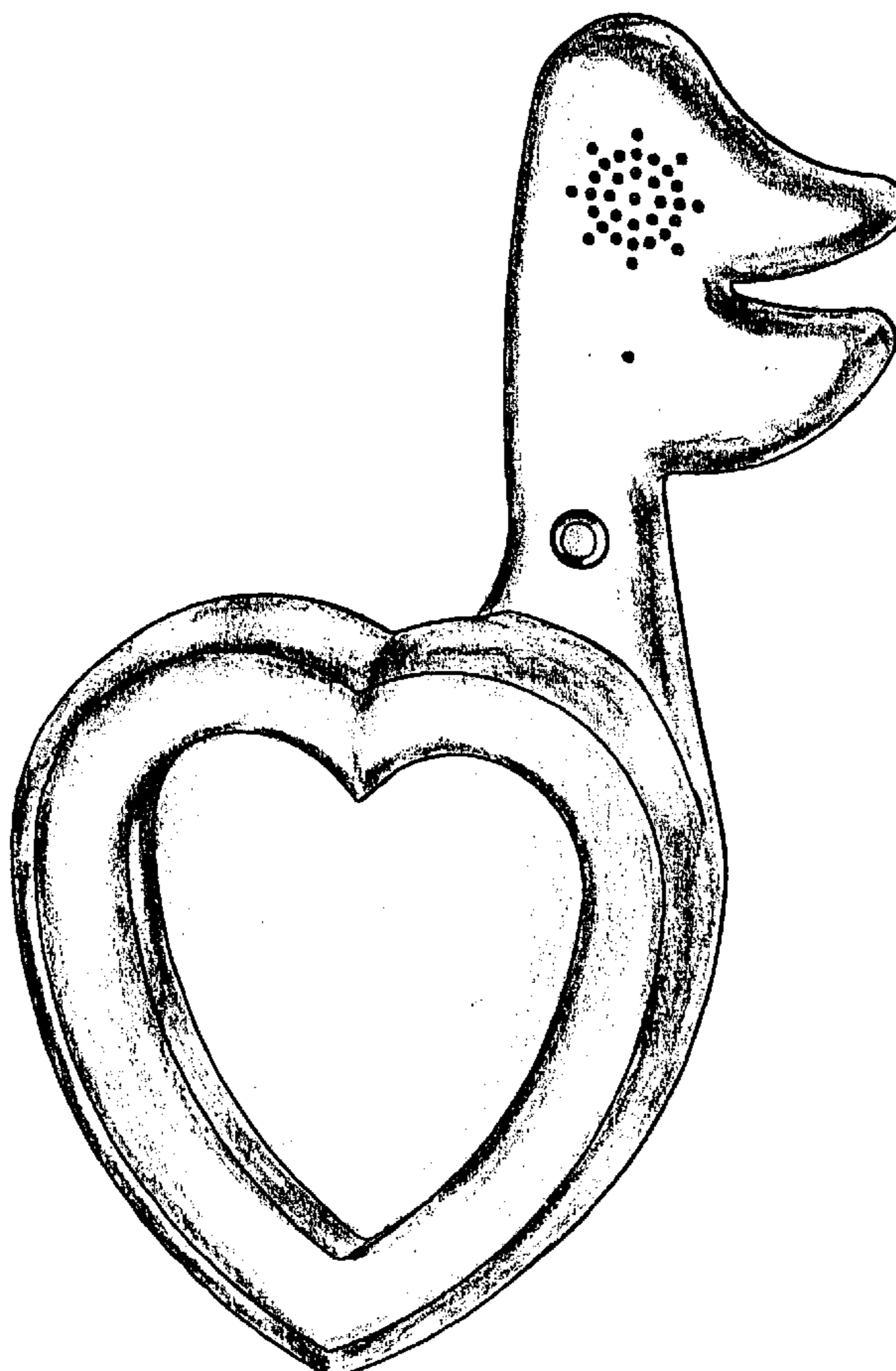
FIG. 7 is a view of the left side of the present invention.

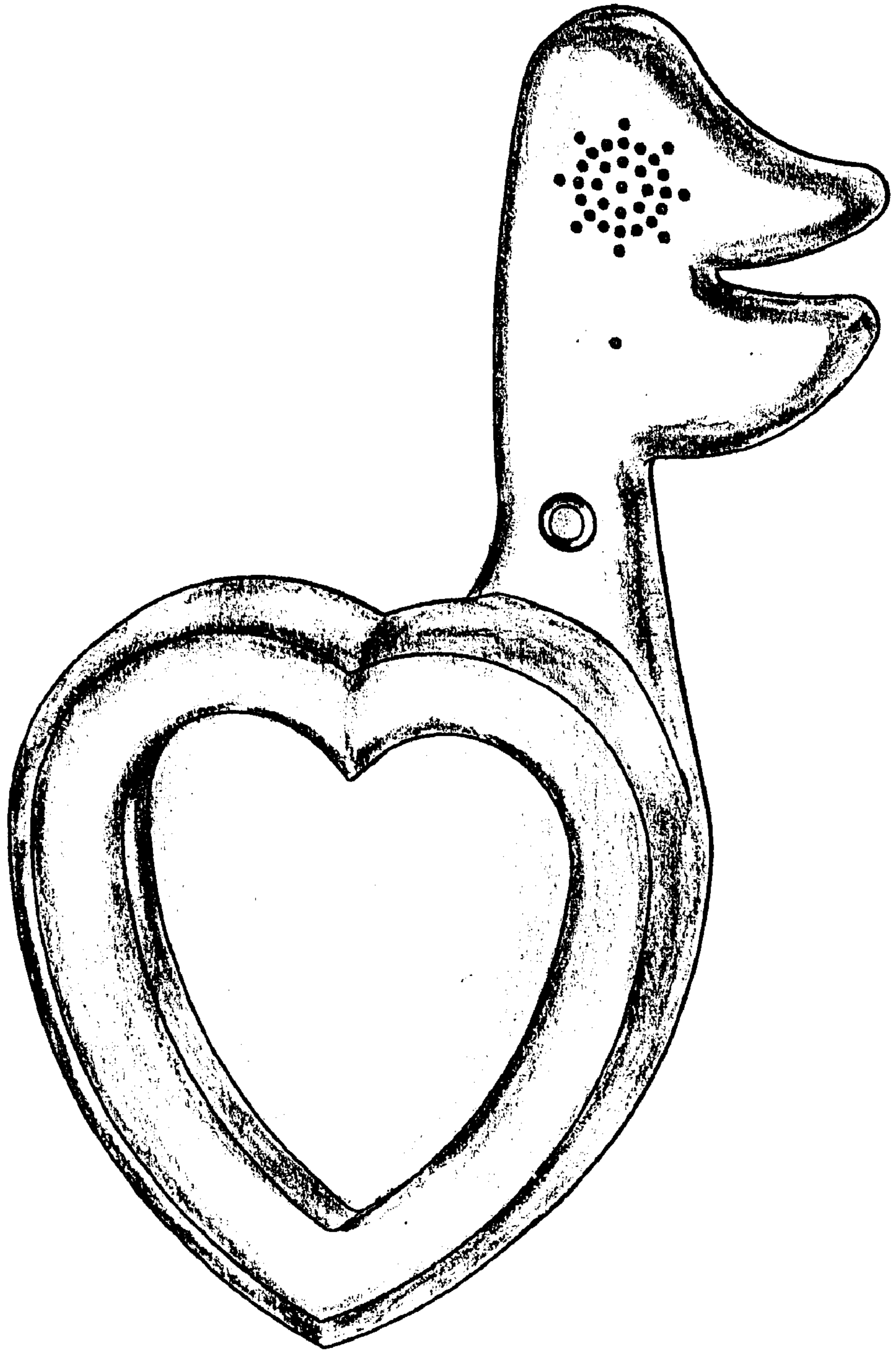

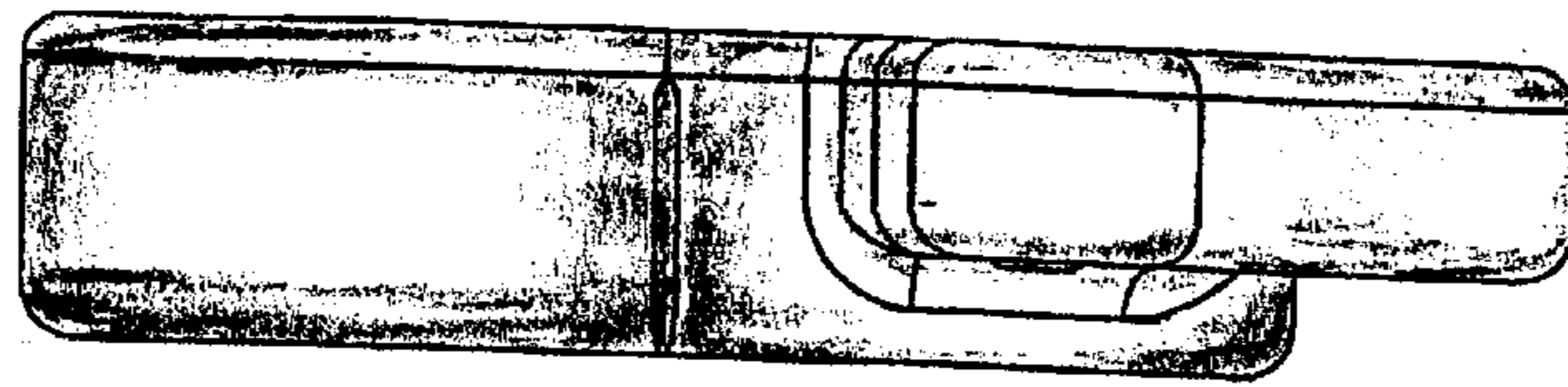

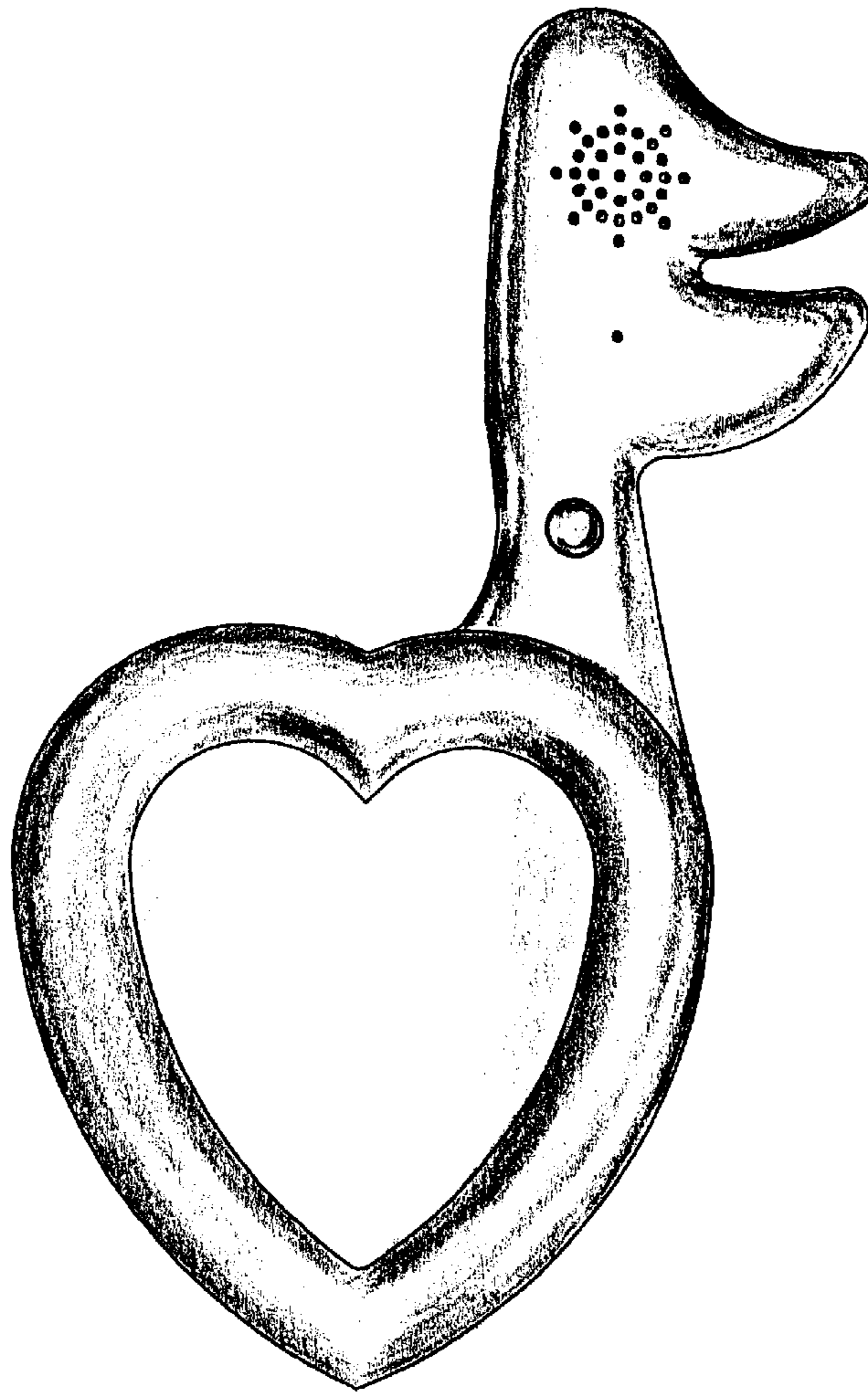

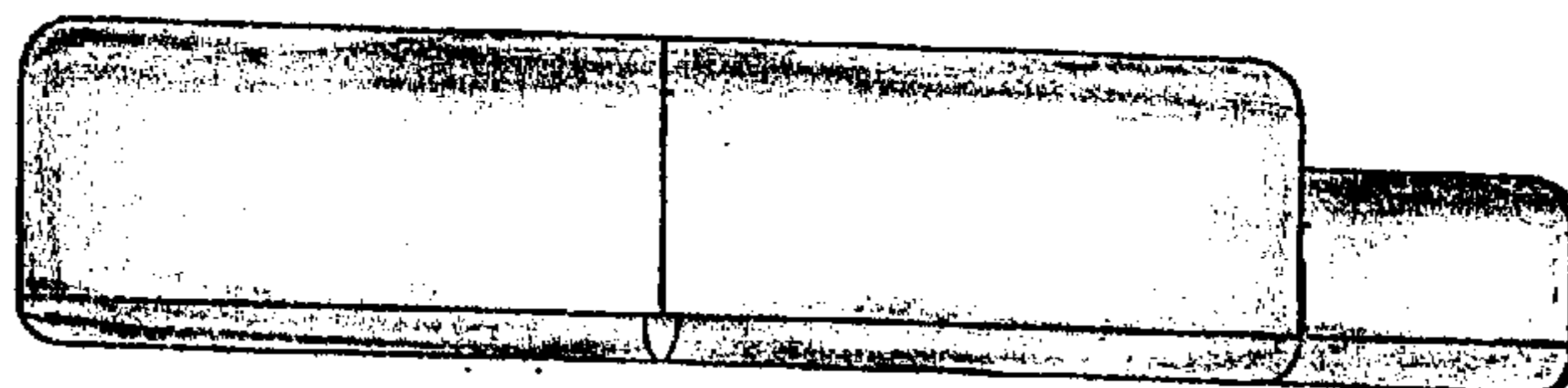

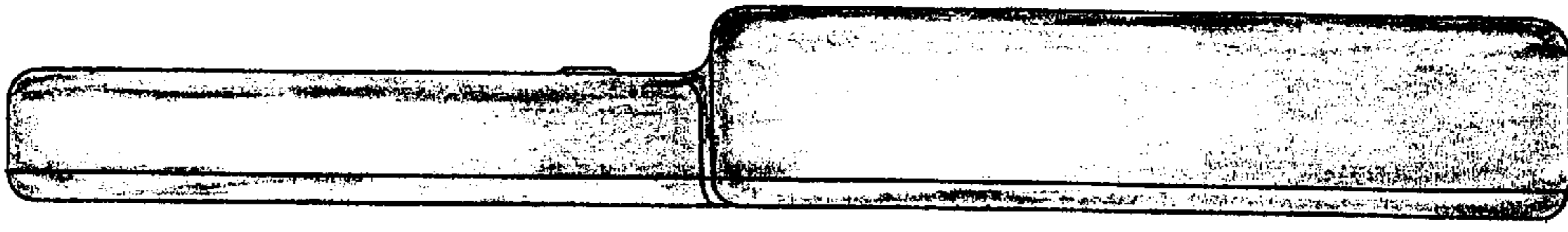

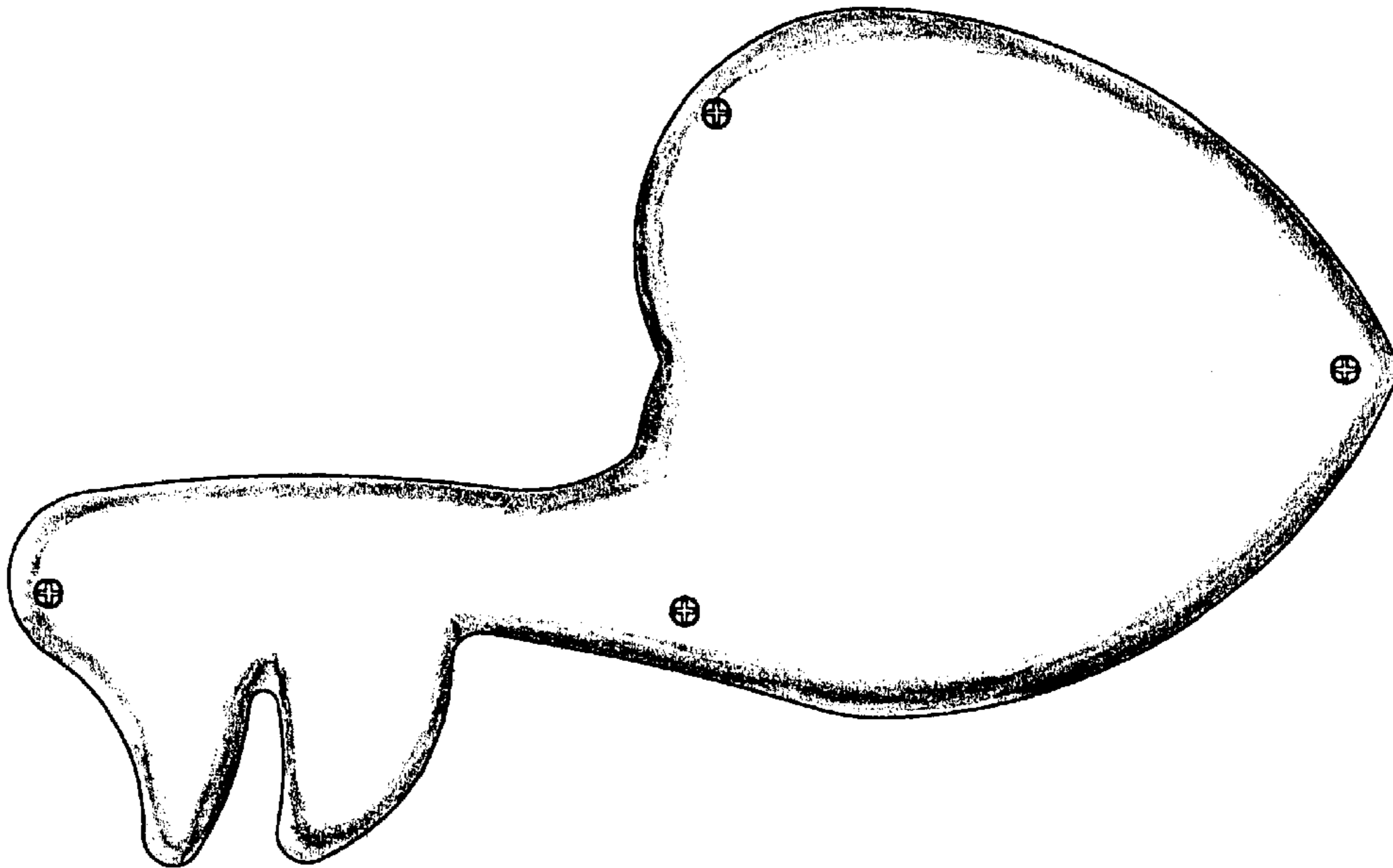

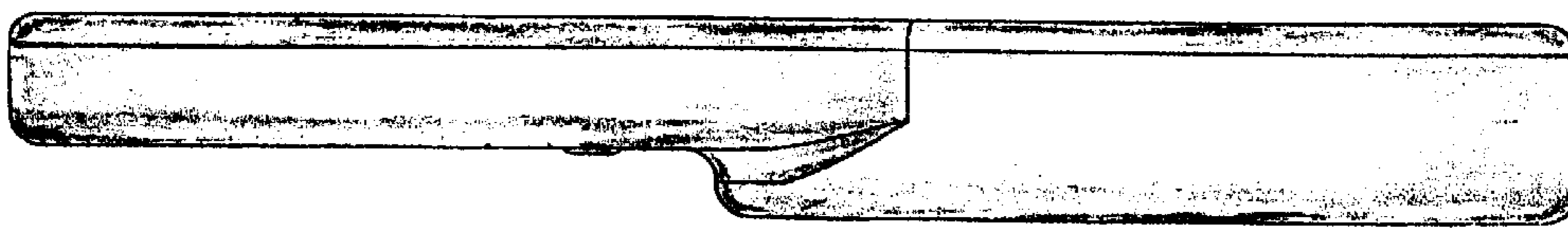
