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(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jewelry setting, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of my new design shown in a method of use;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of my new design; and,

FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof, the right side view being a mirror image thereof.

The broken lines showing of a tether and loop in FIG. 1 are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design. The jewelry setting of the present invention may be adapted for use as a finger ring or earring.

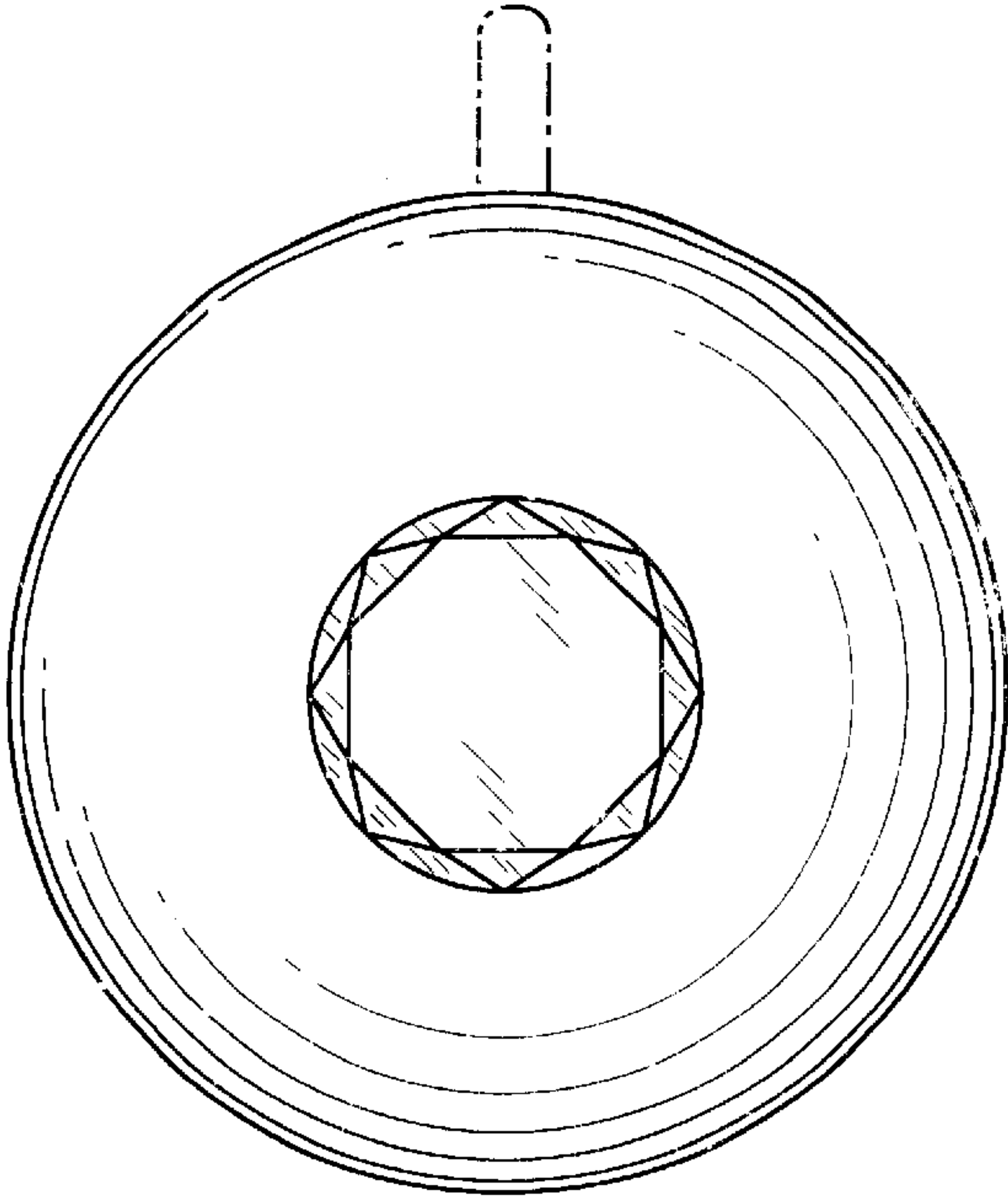

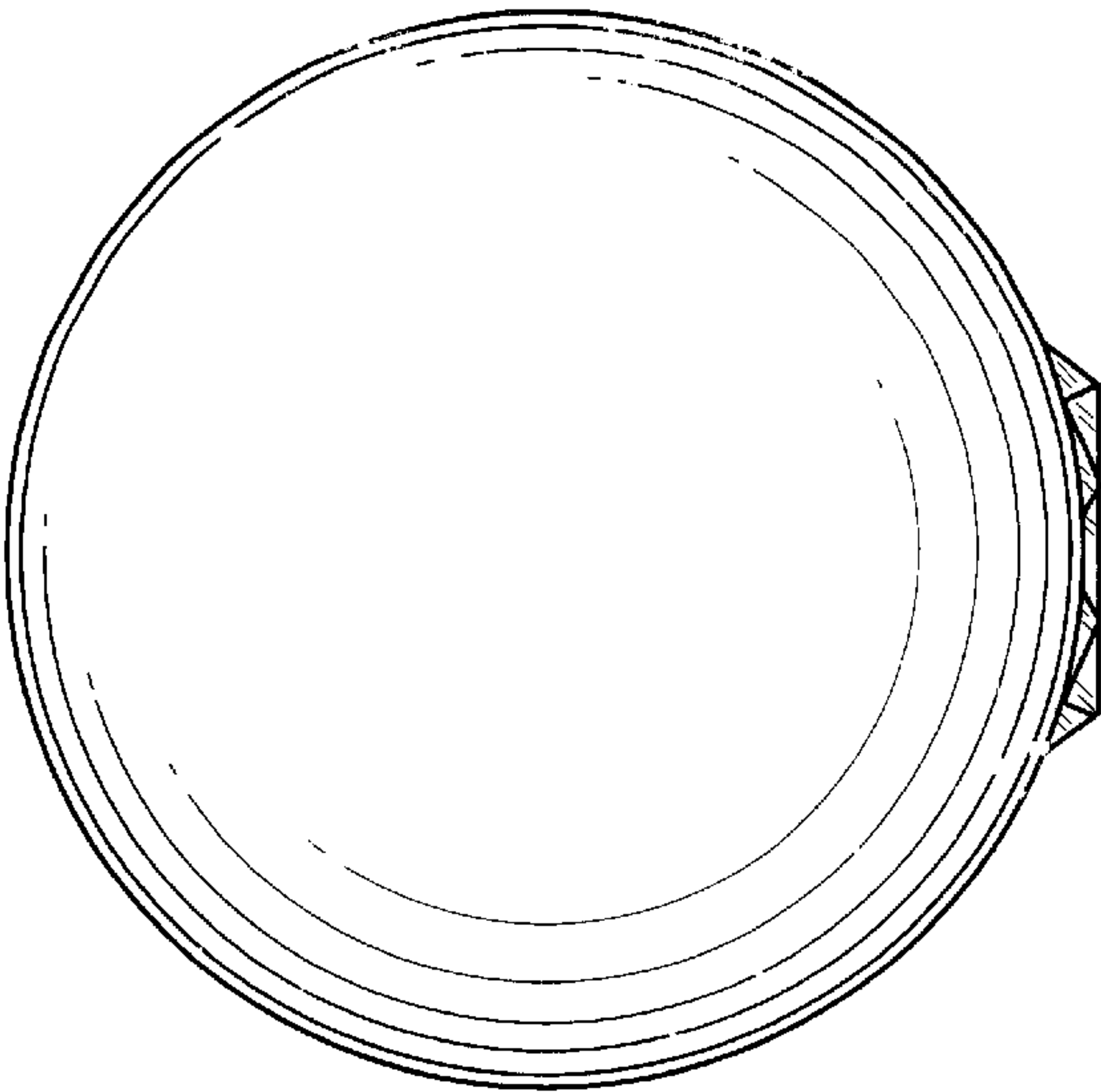

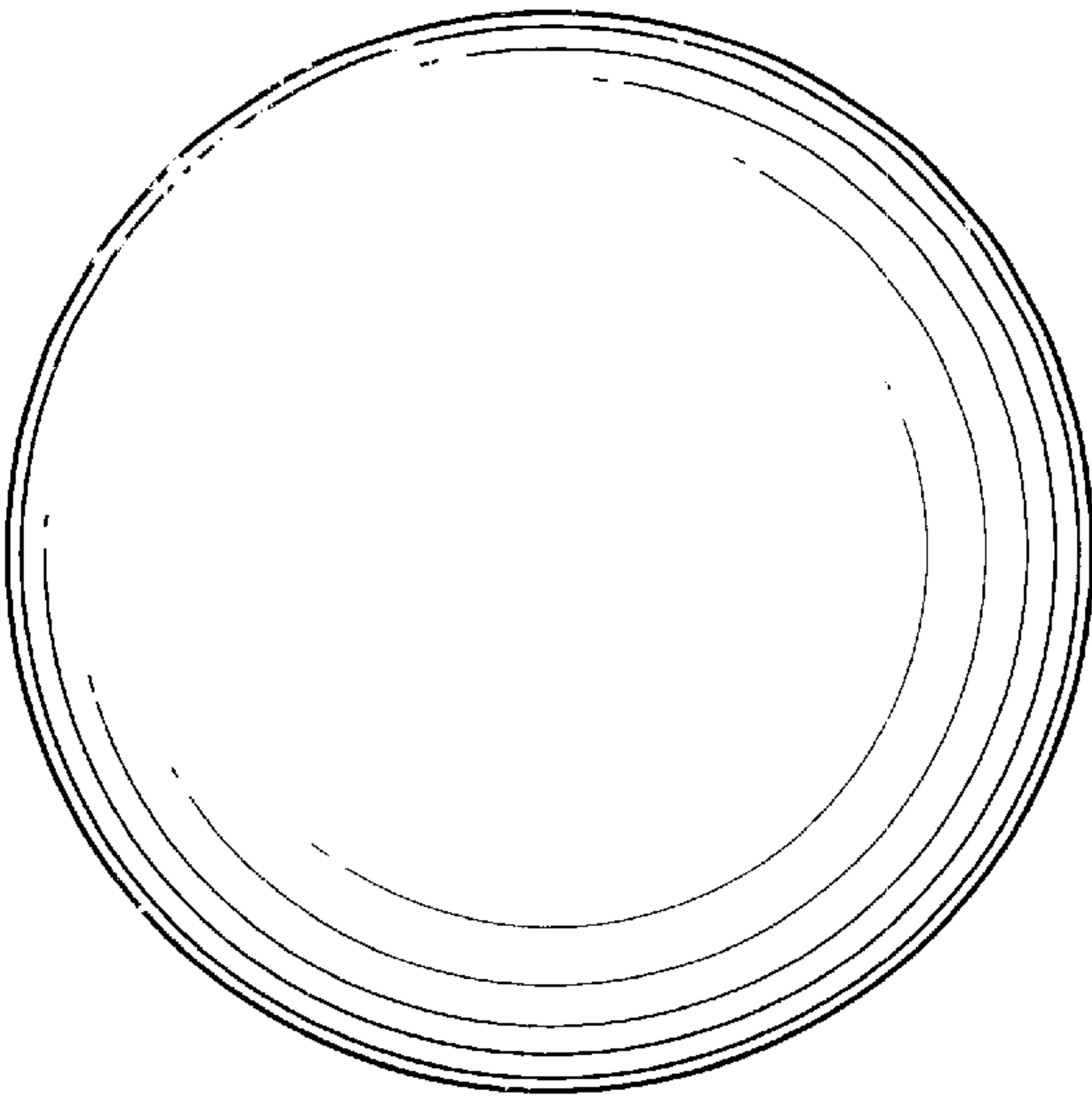

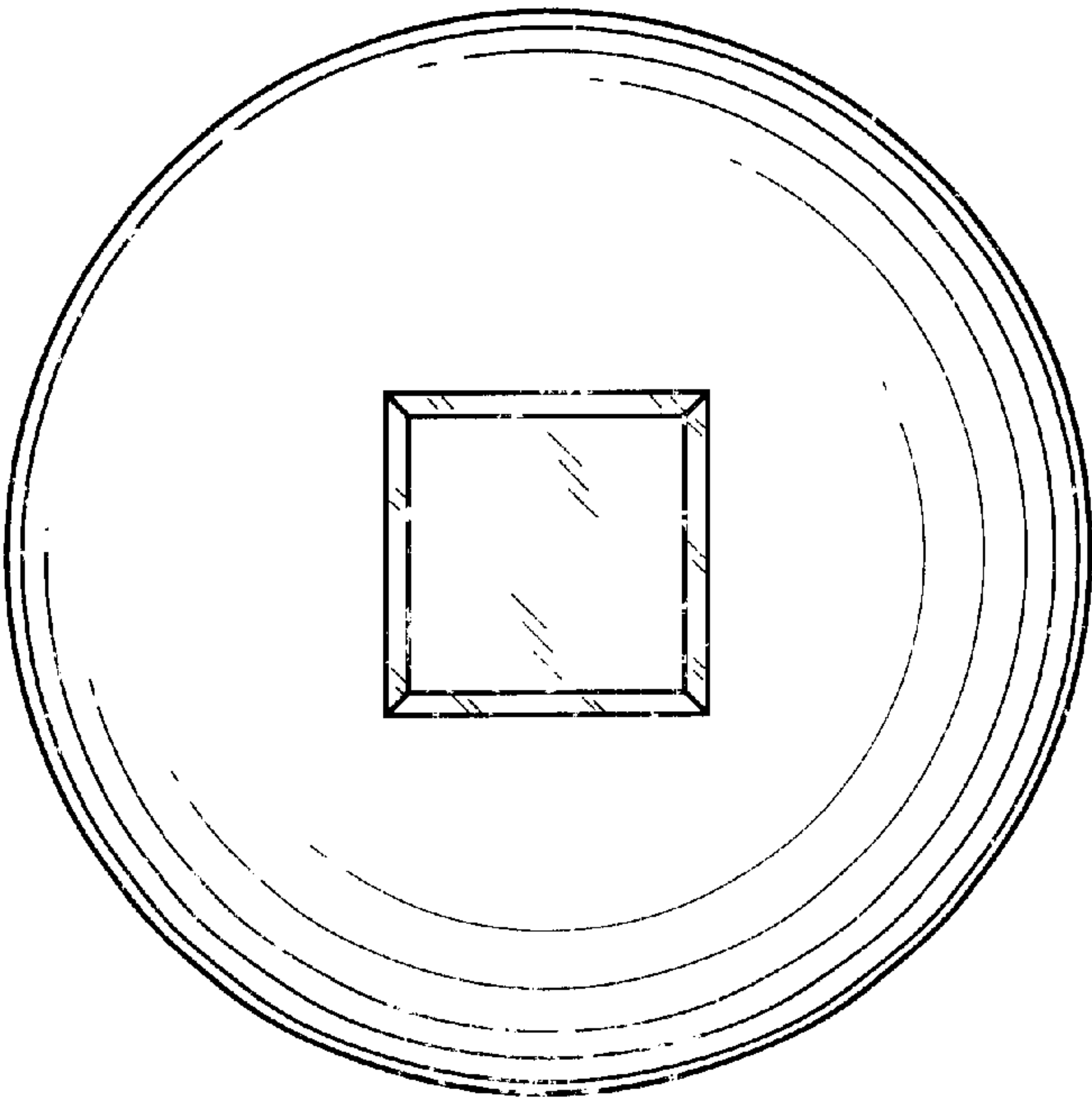
