ice fishing scoop and skewer showing my new design;

The pick on the bottom is removable (screws in). The handle
is telescopic. It extends to different lengths.

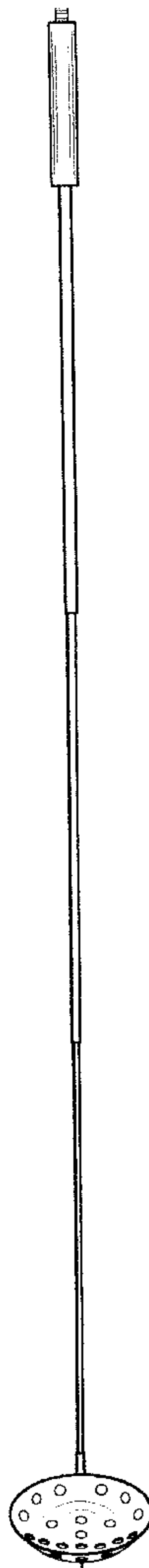

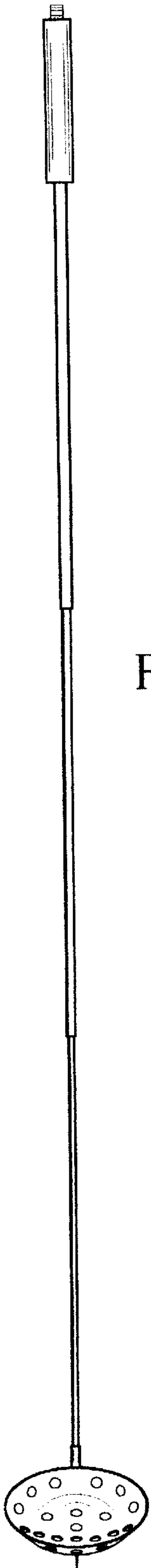

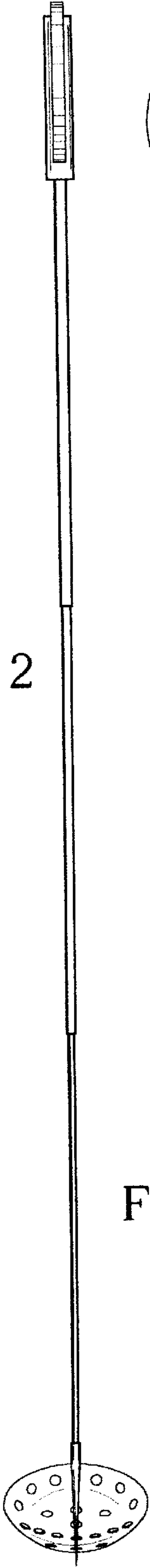

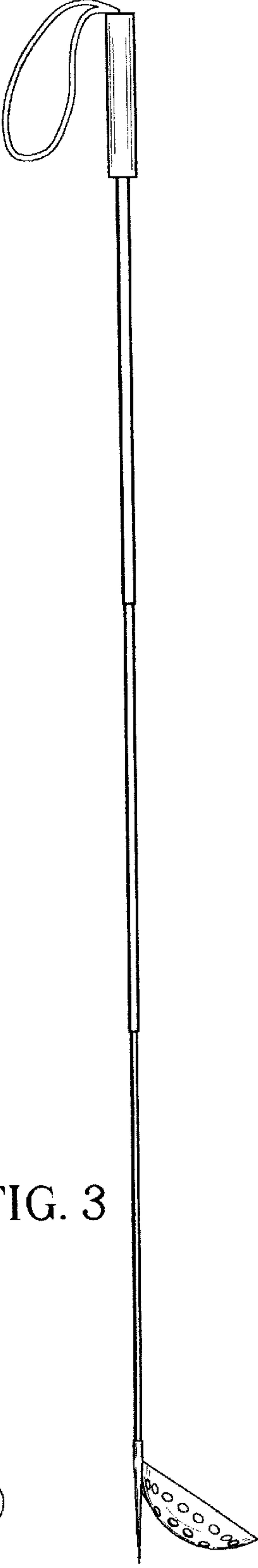

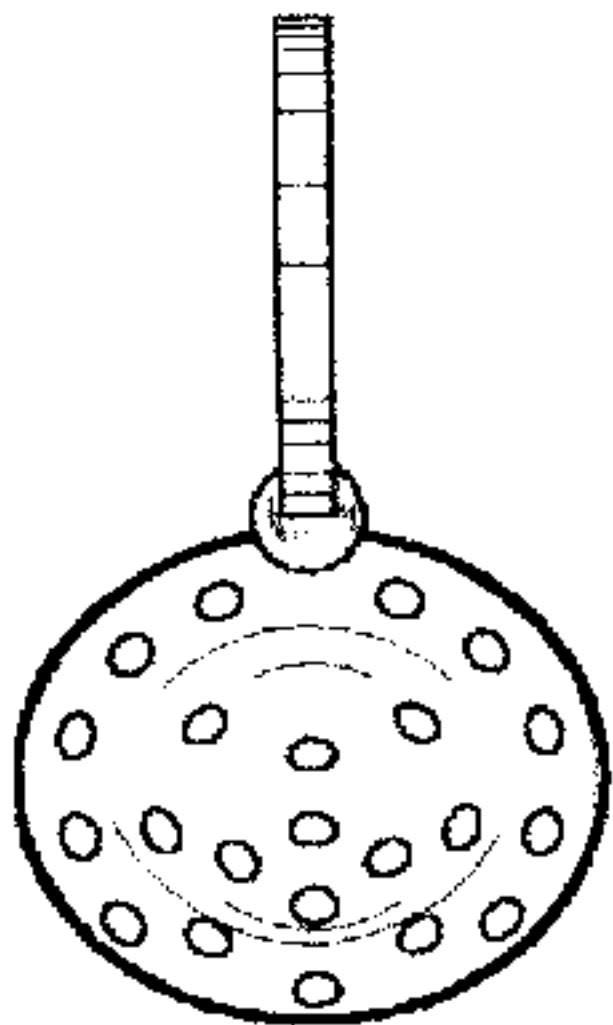
