The ornamental design for a faucet handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a rear perspective view of the faucet handle showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof;

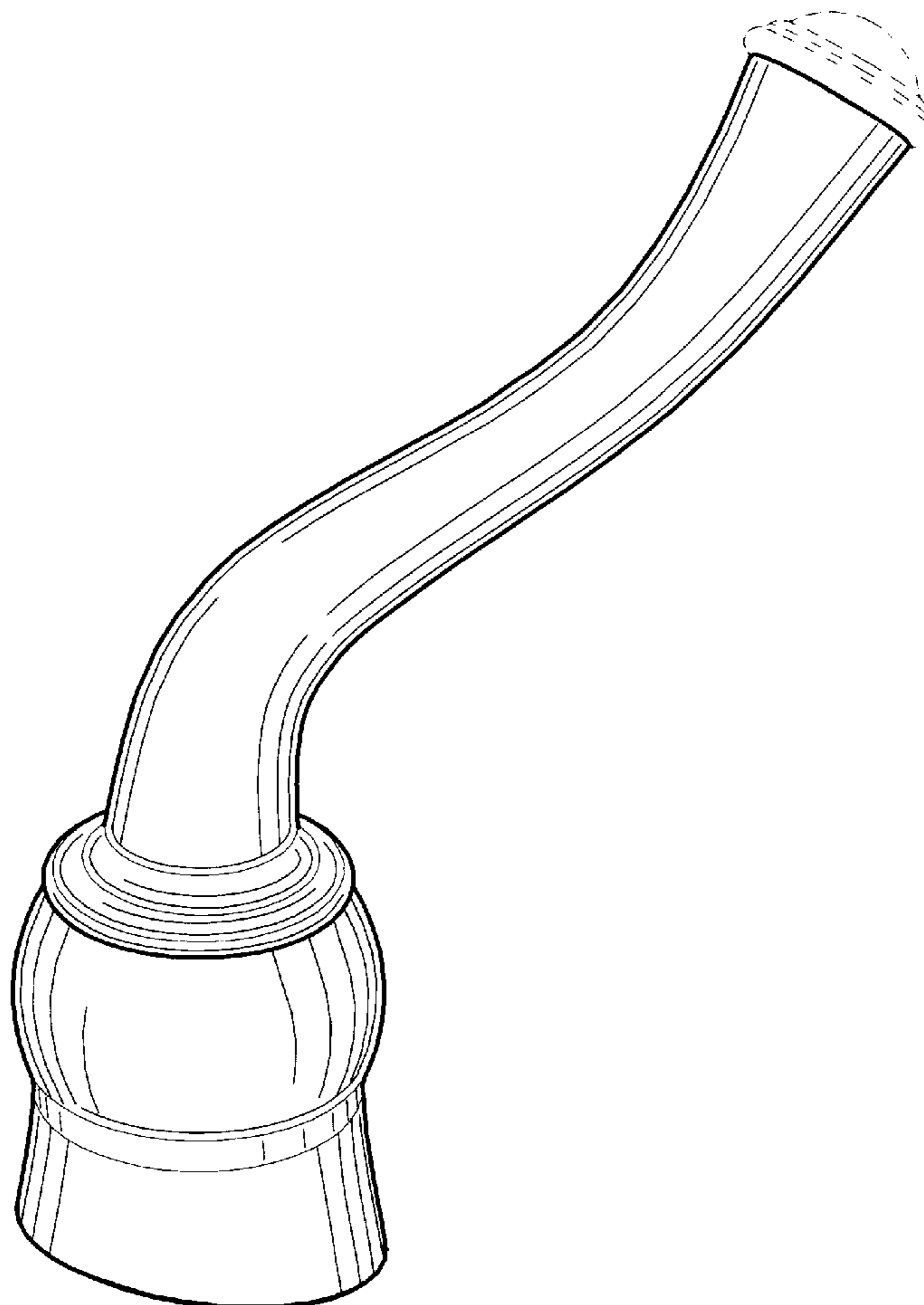
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;

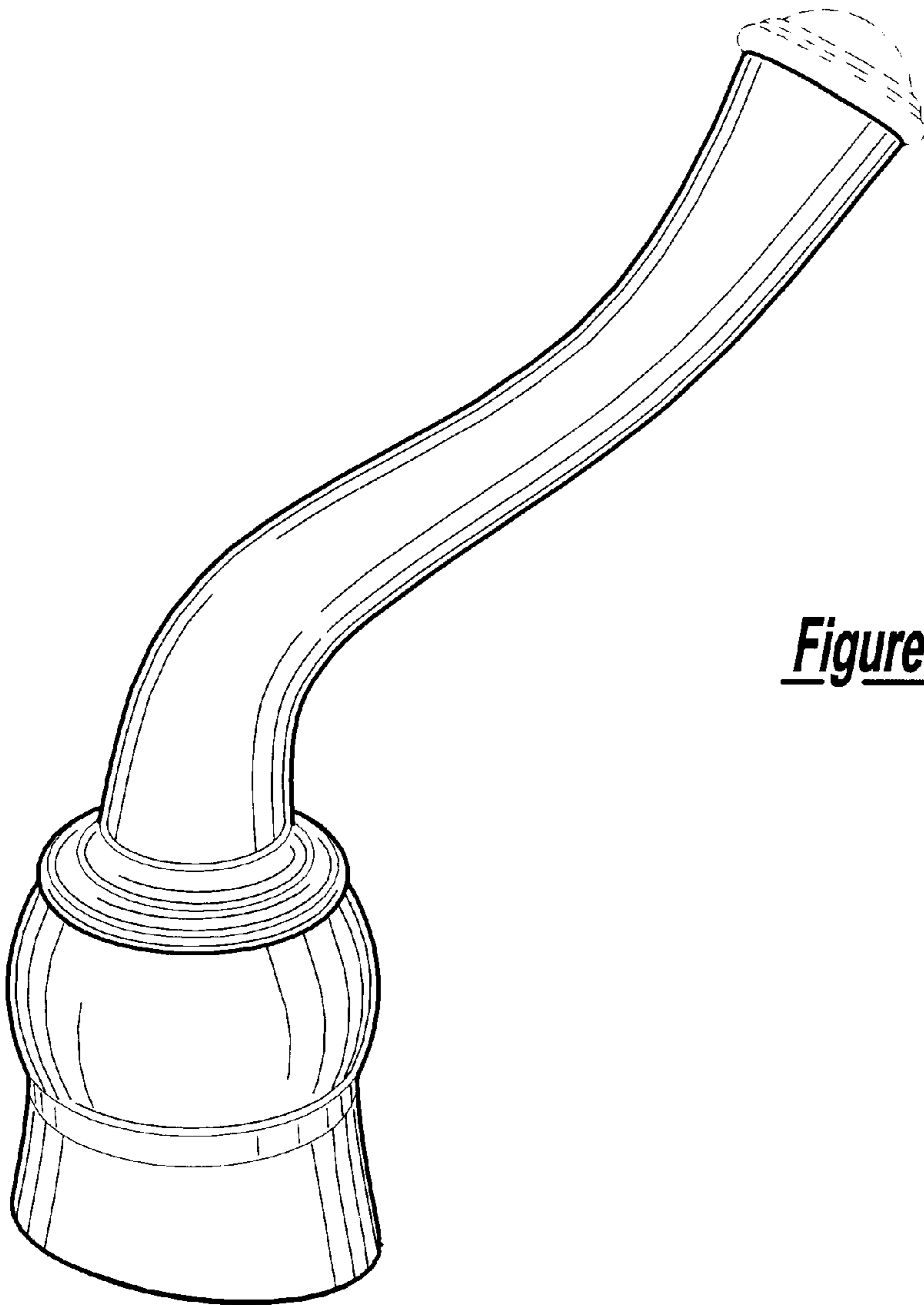

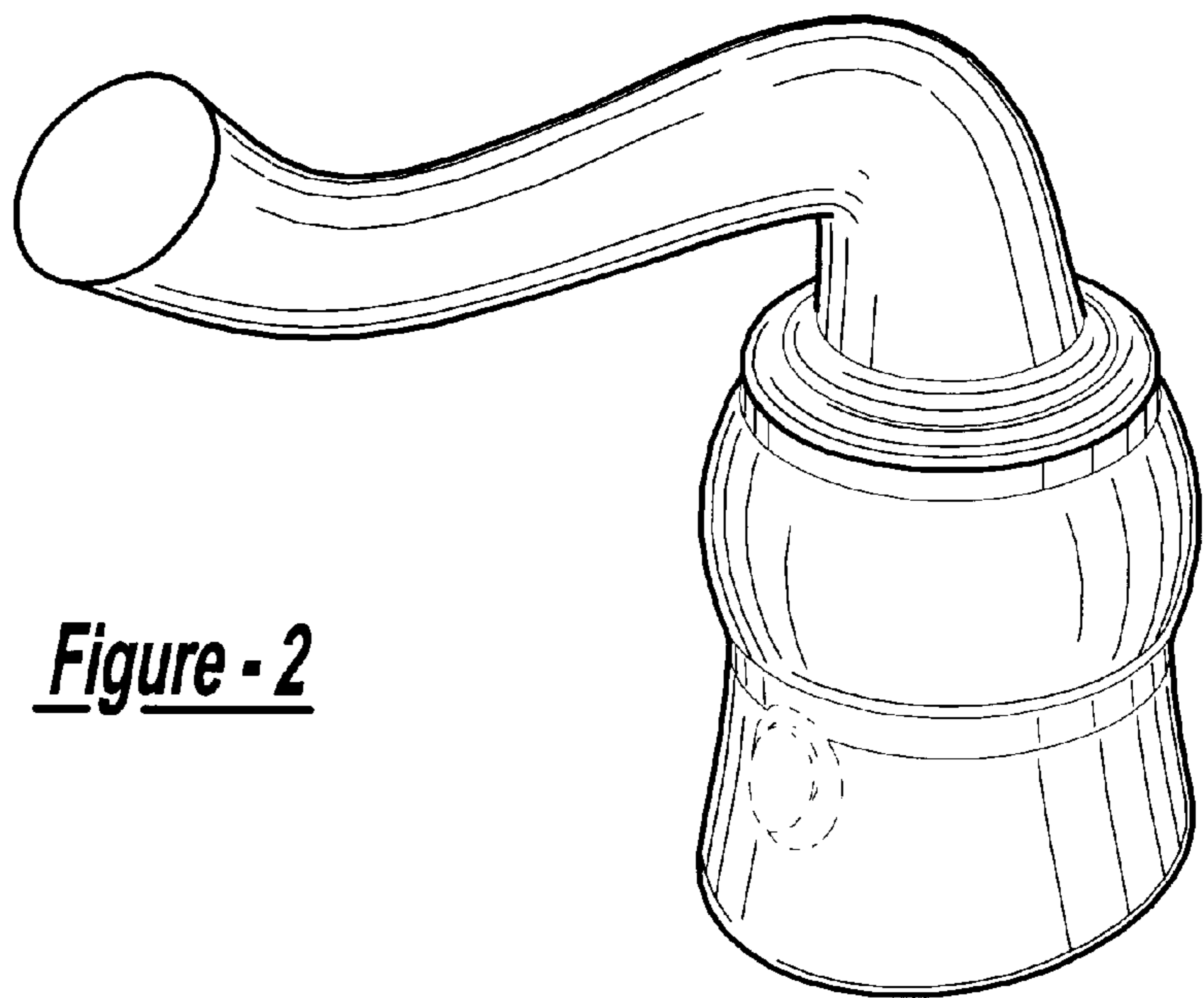

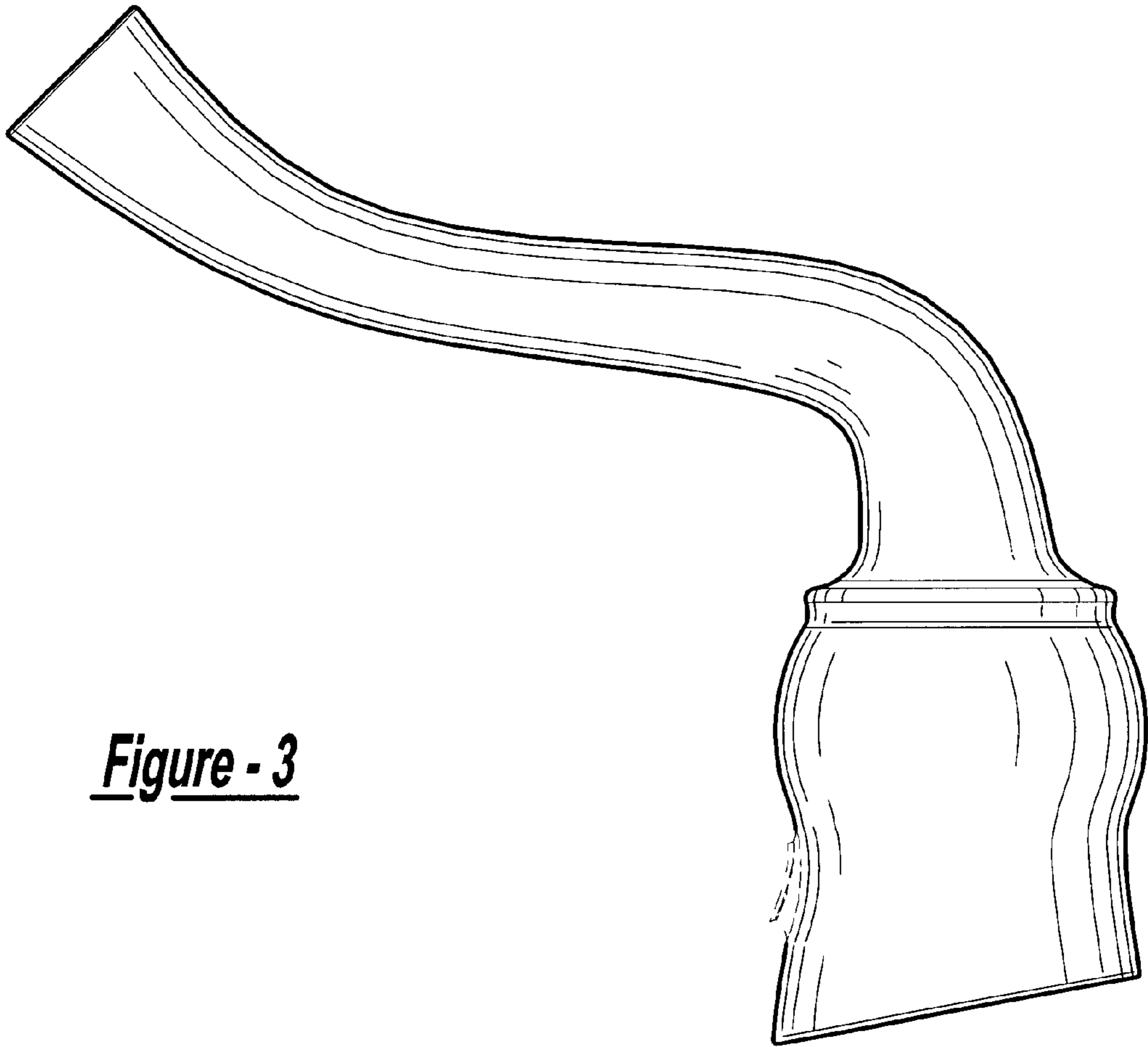

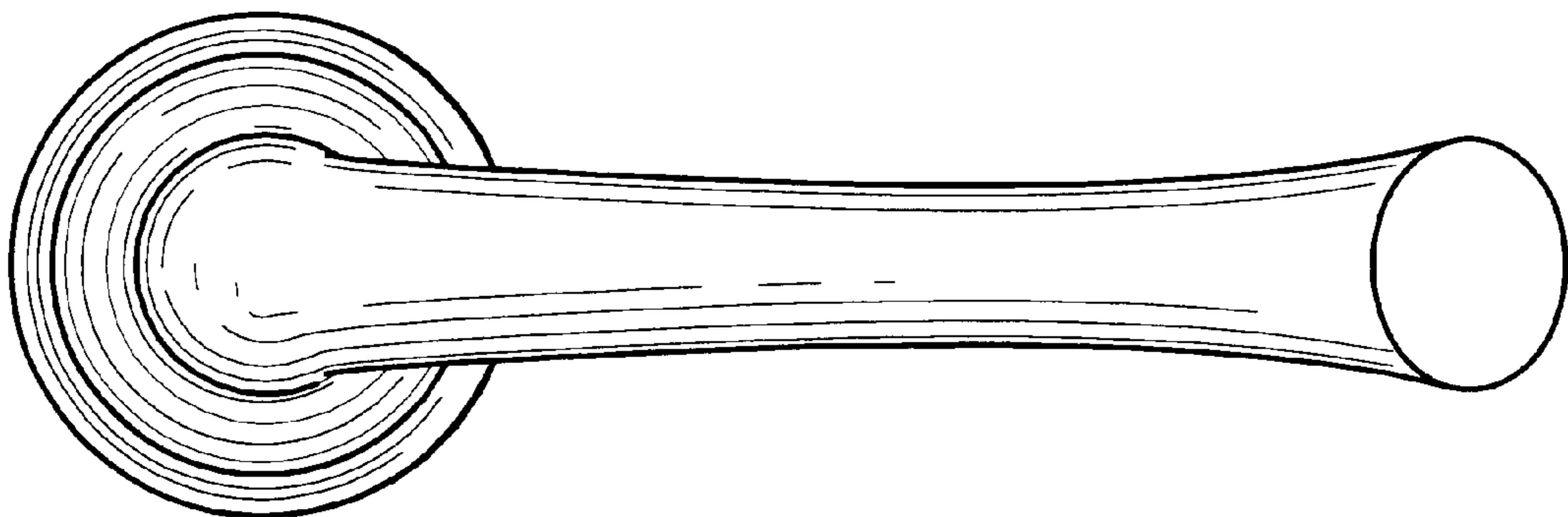

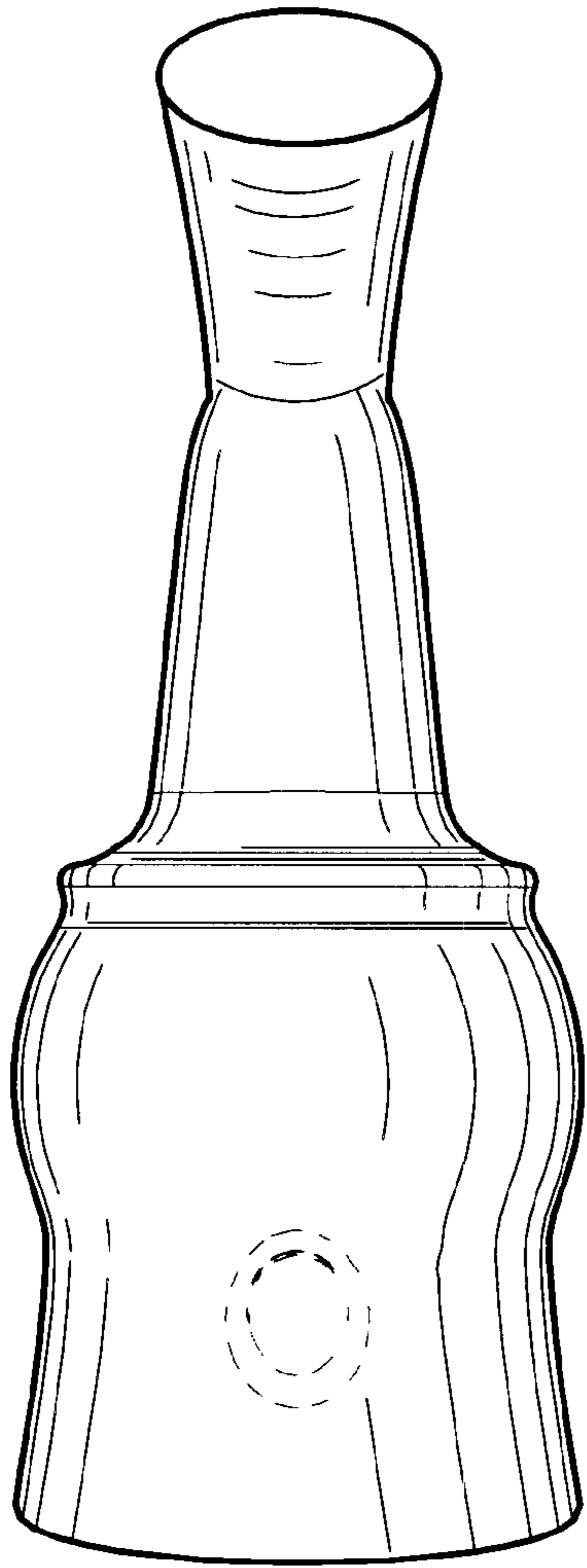

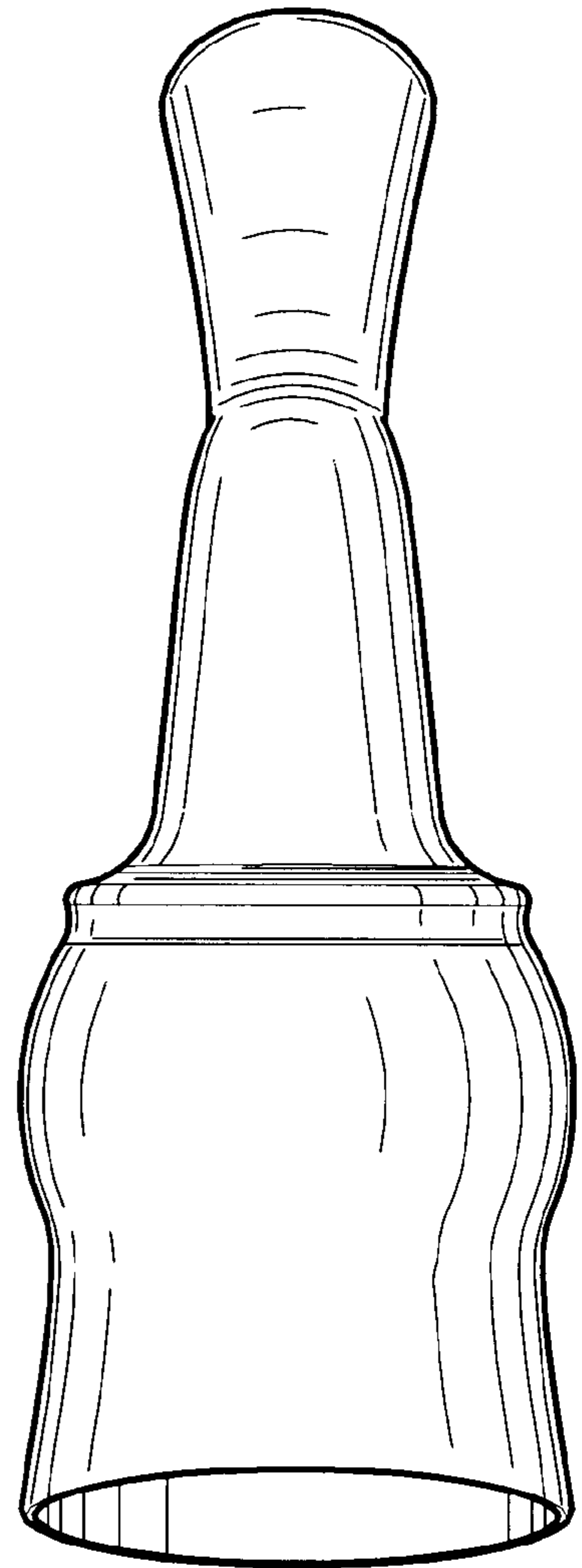

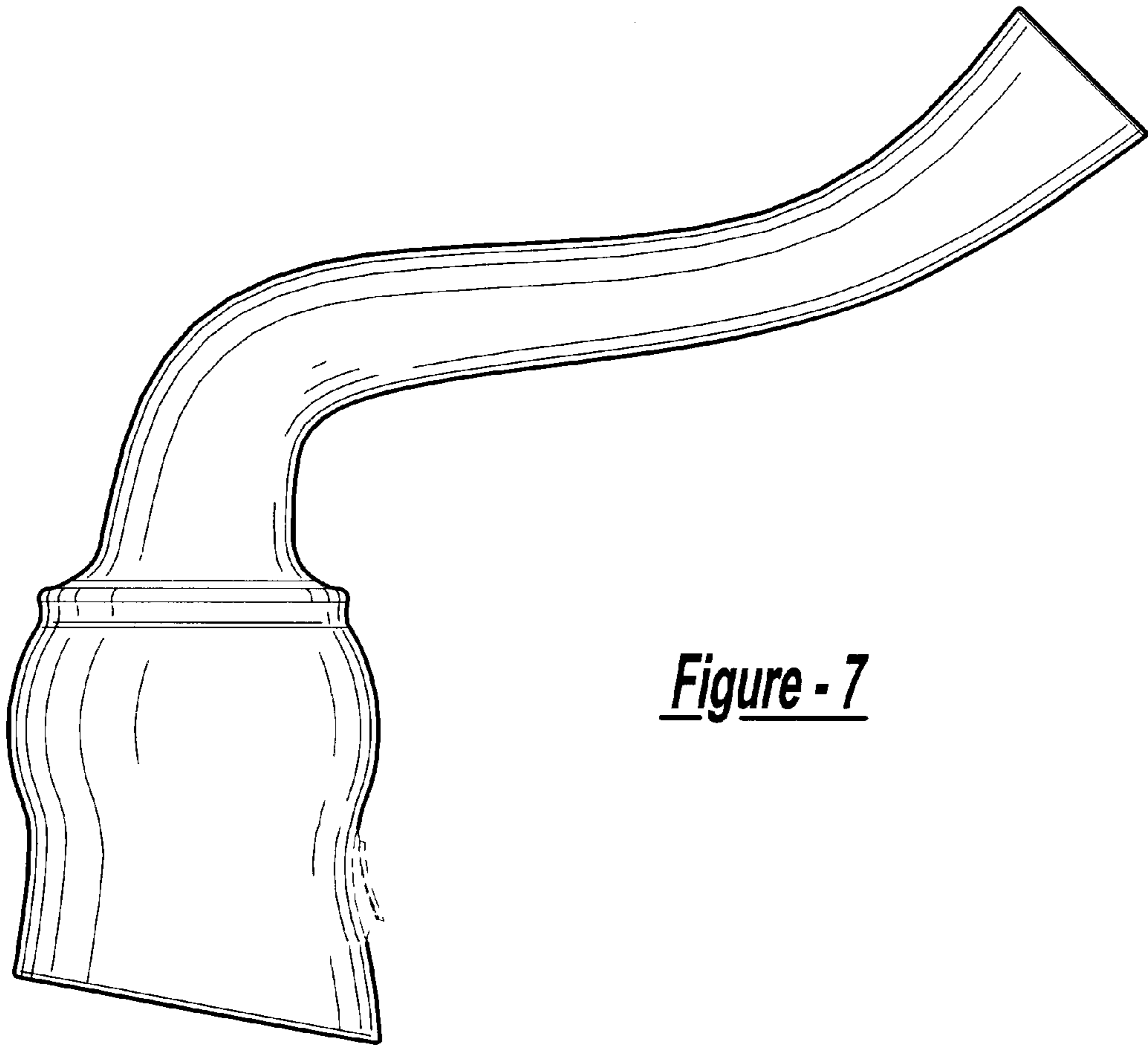

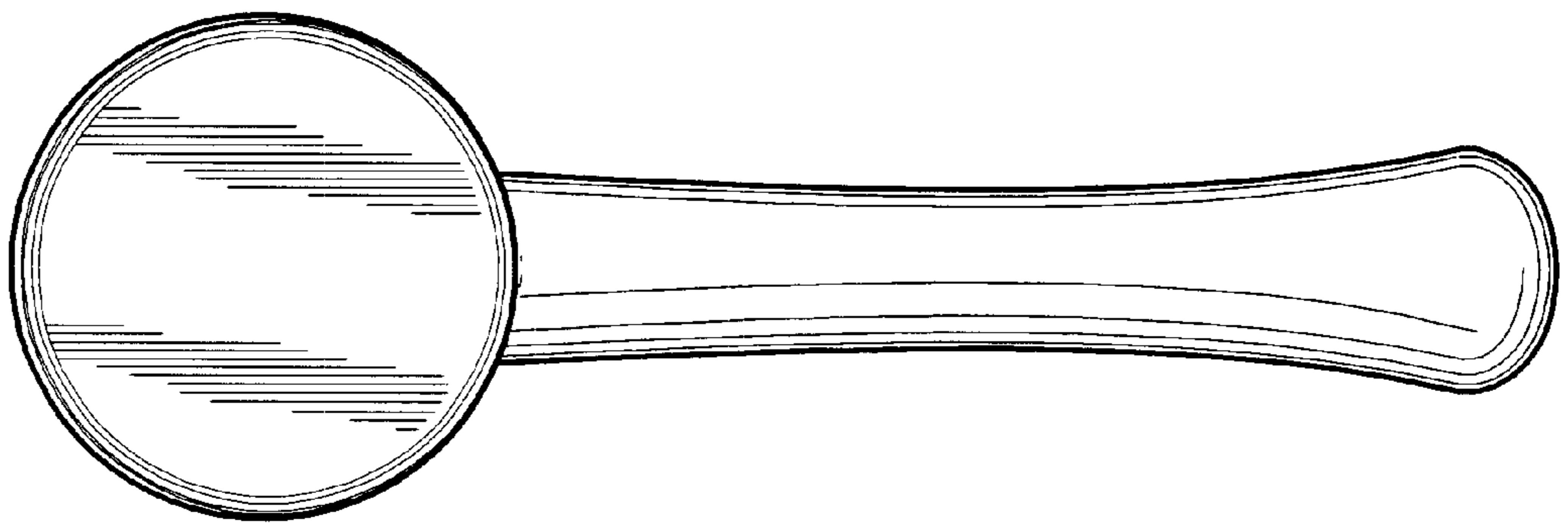
