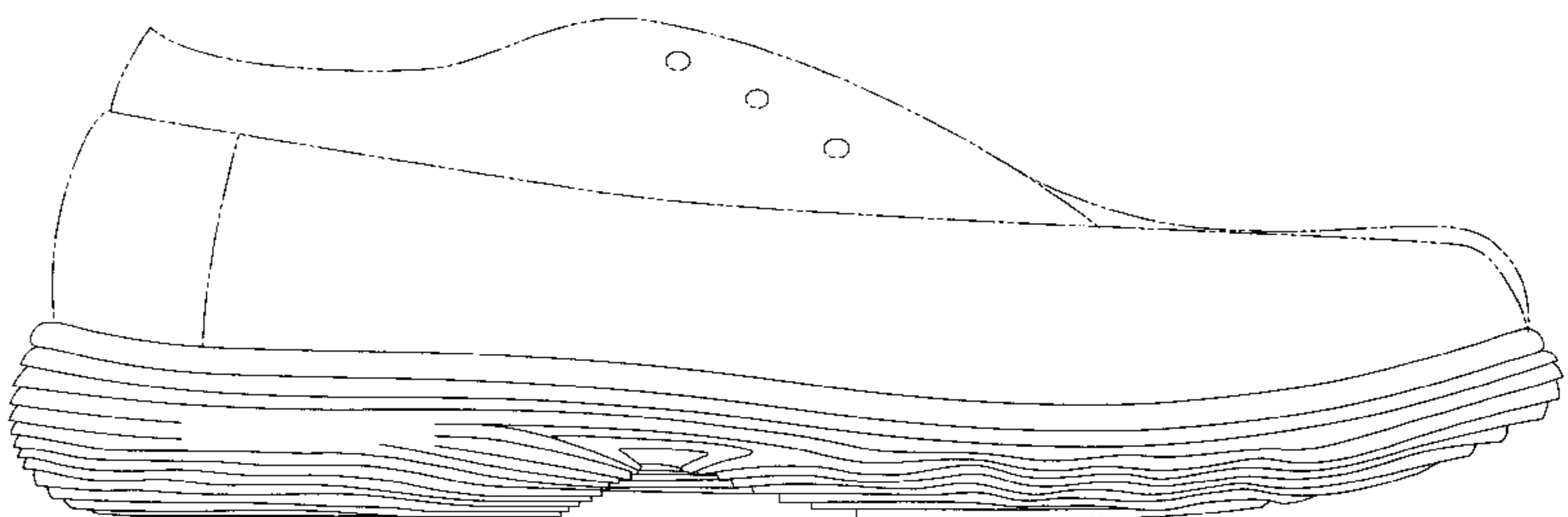
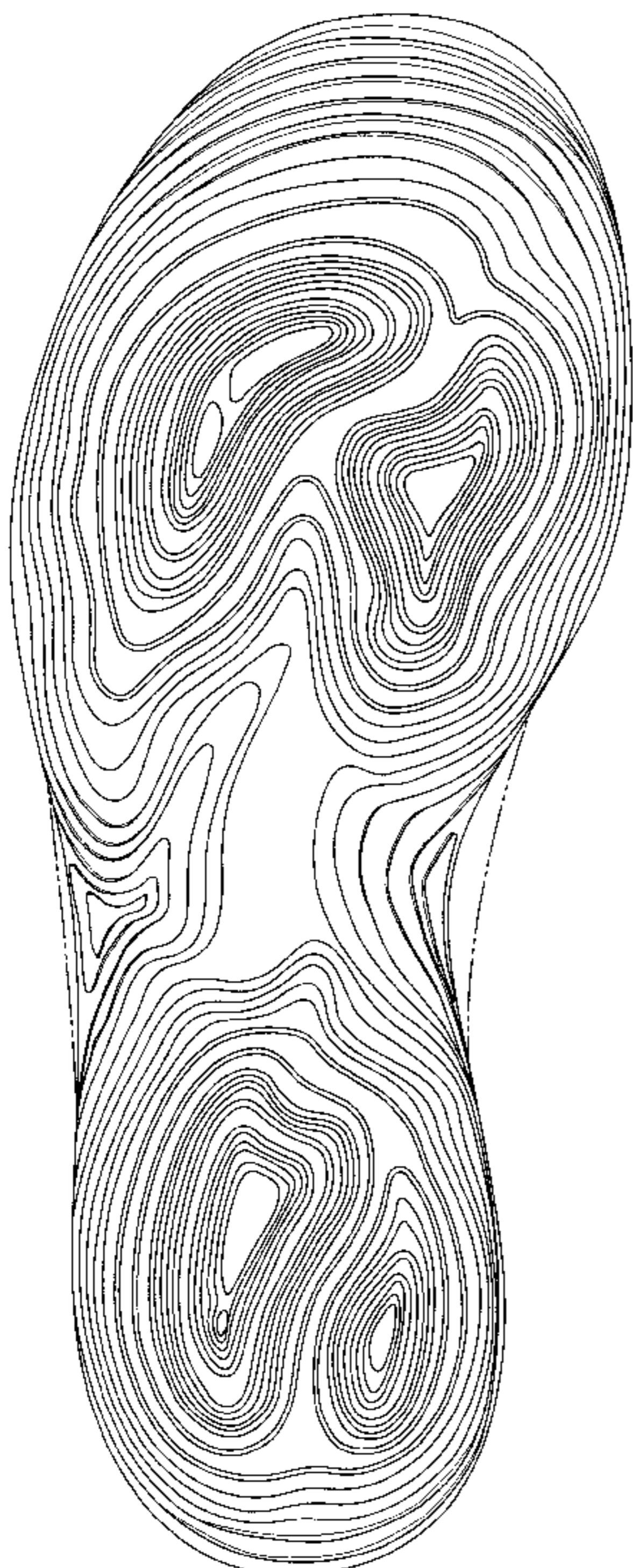
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for footwear sole, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a right, front perspective view of the shoe sole embodying the new design;  
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.  
FIGS. 1-6 show portions of an upper in broken lines. The broken lines are for environmental purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

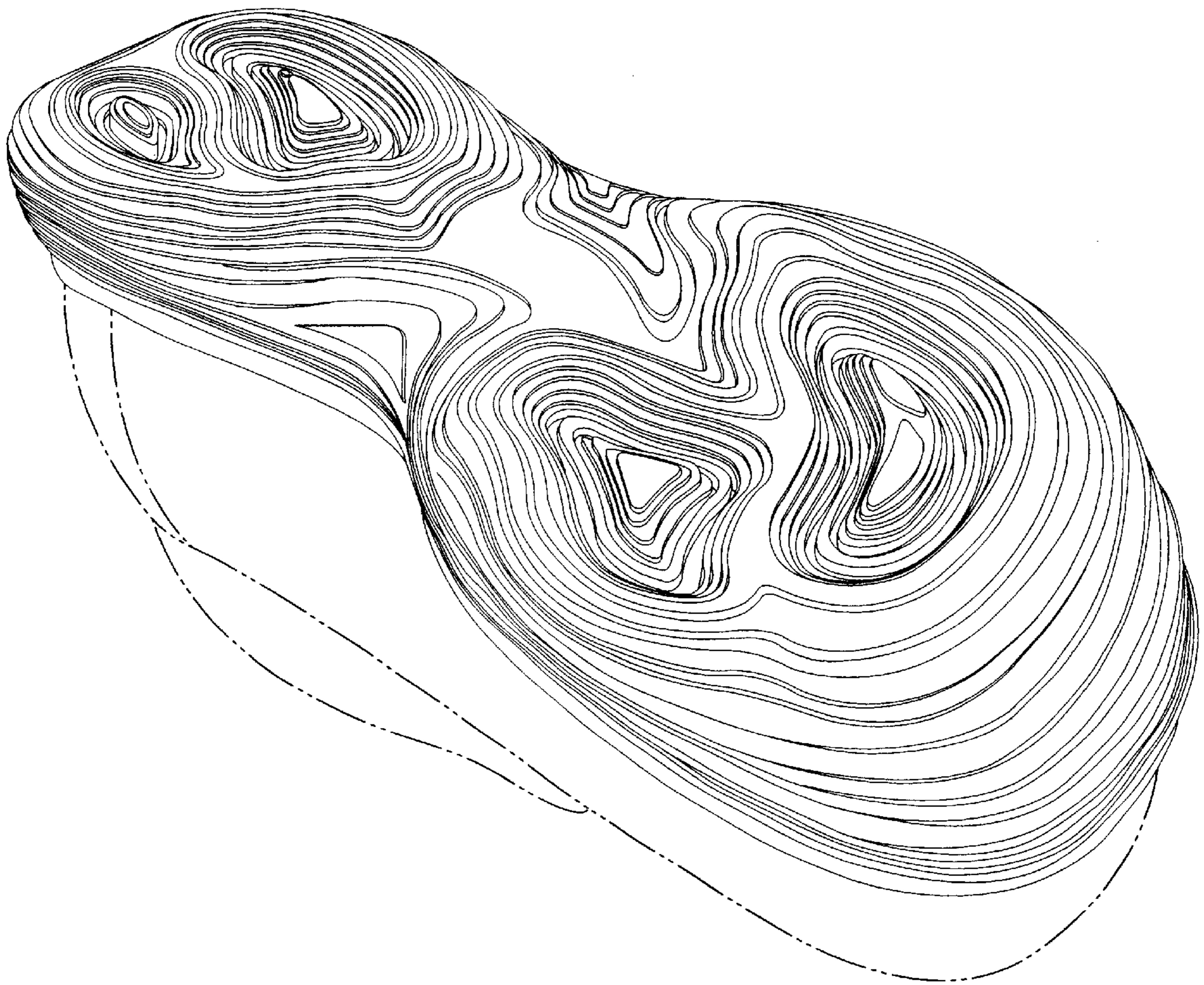

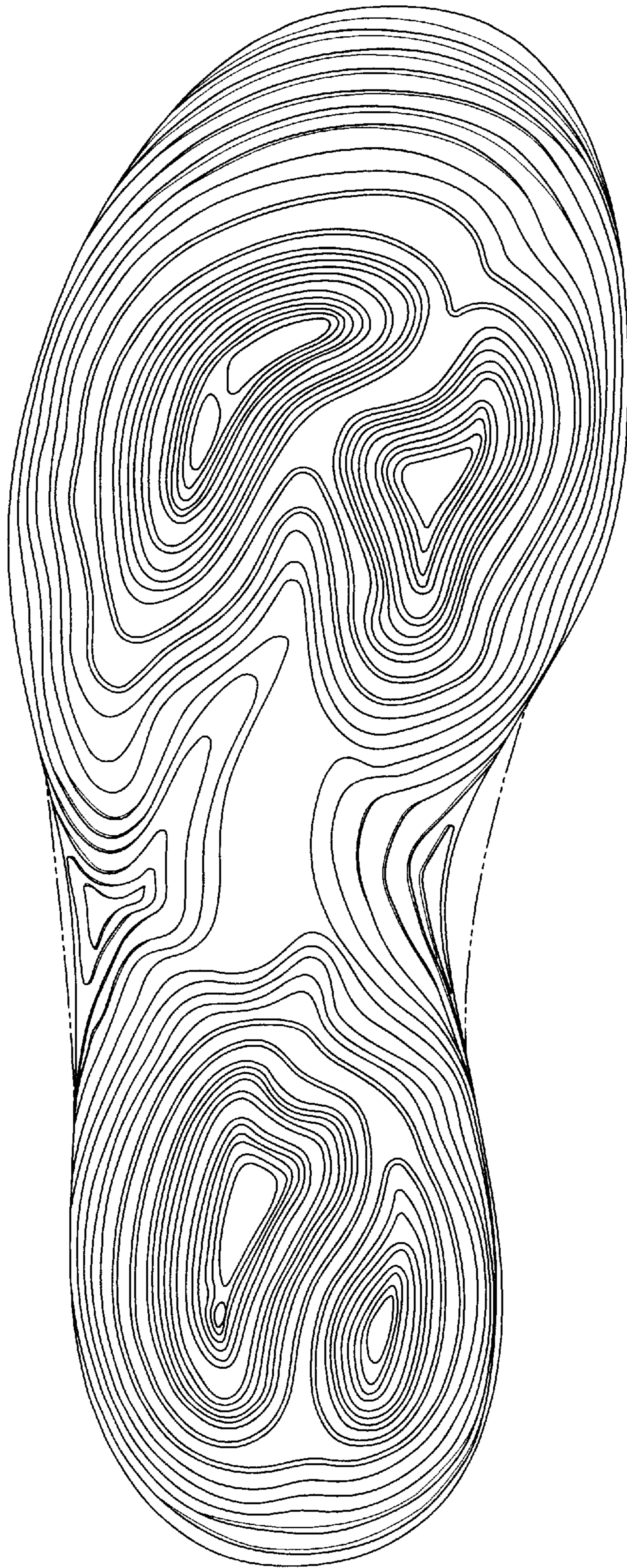

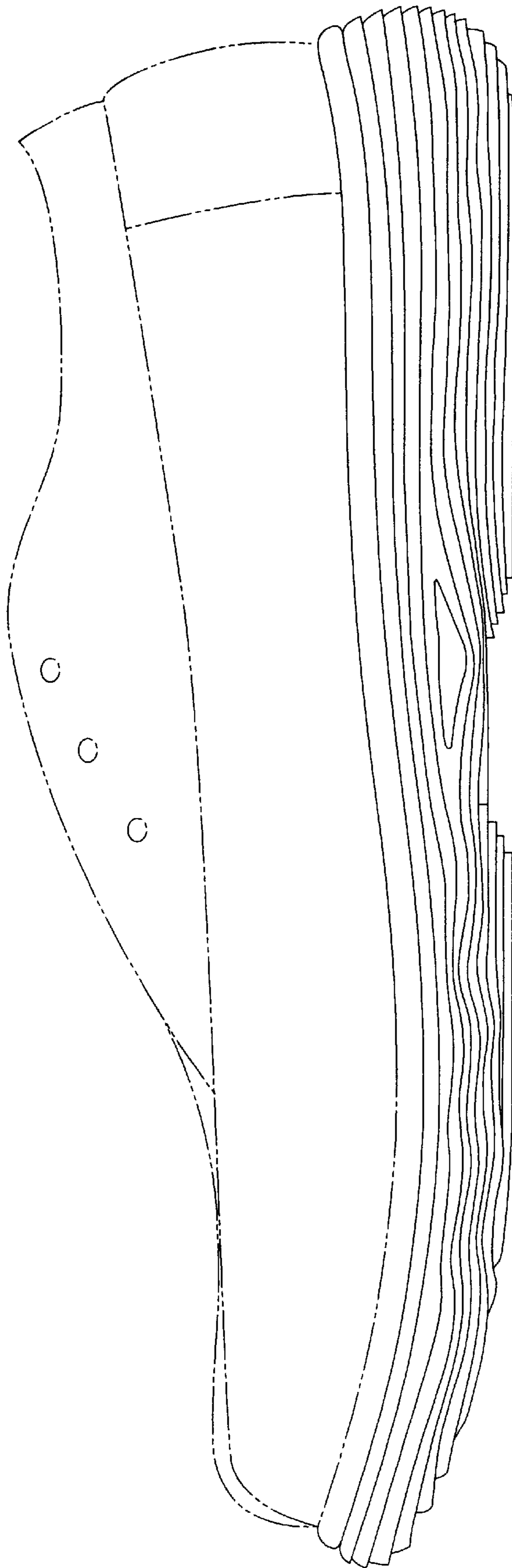

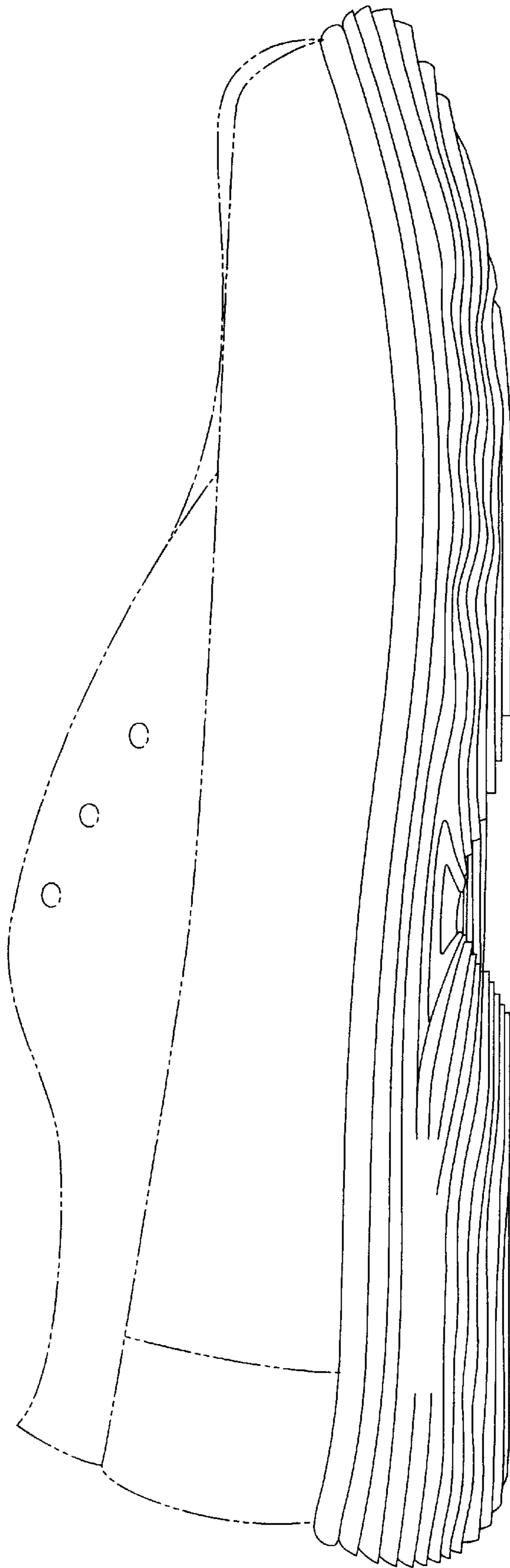

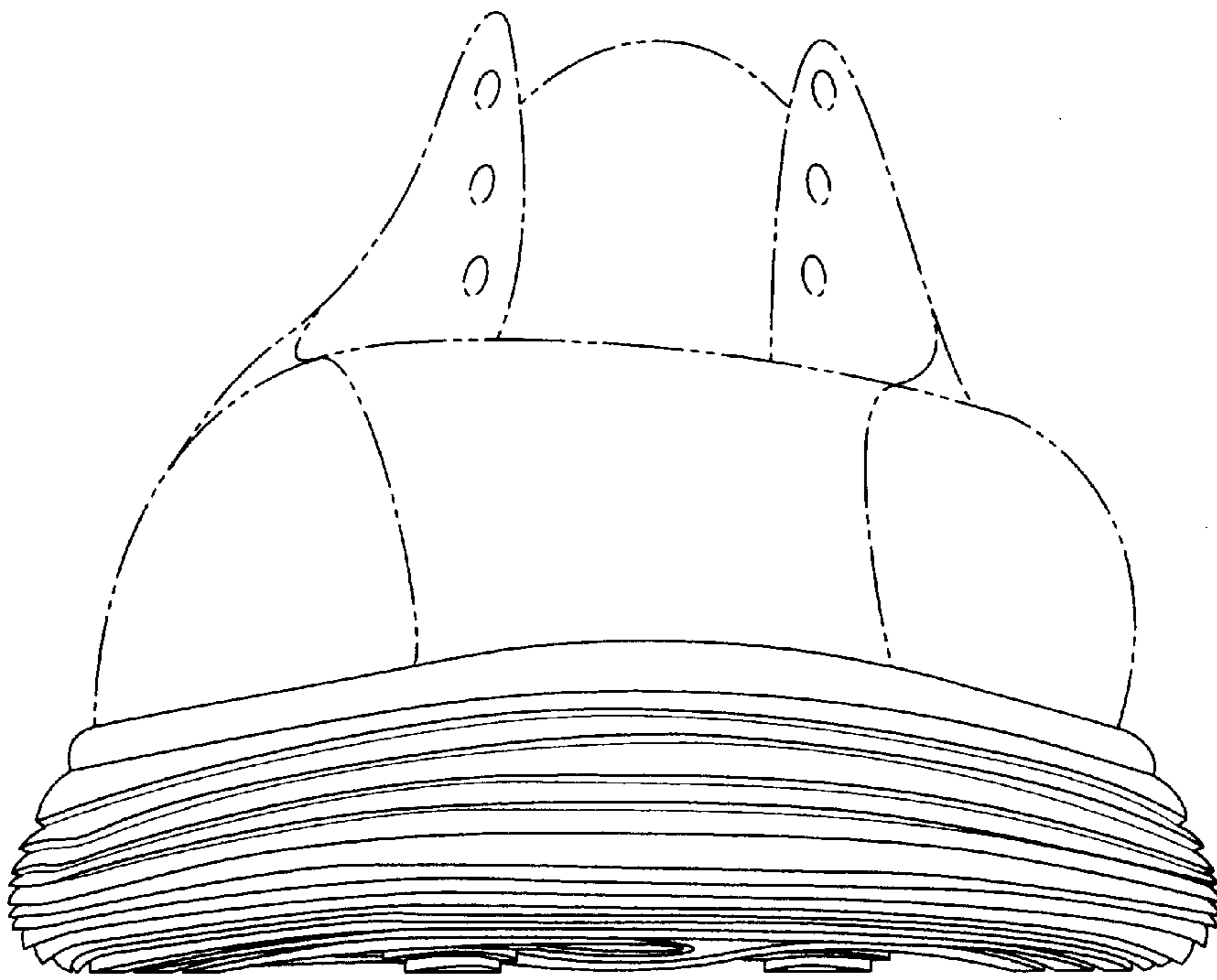

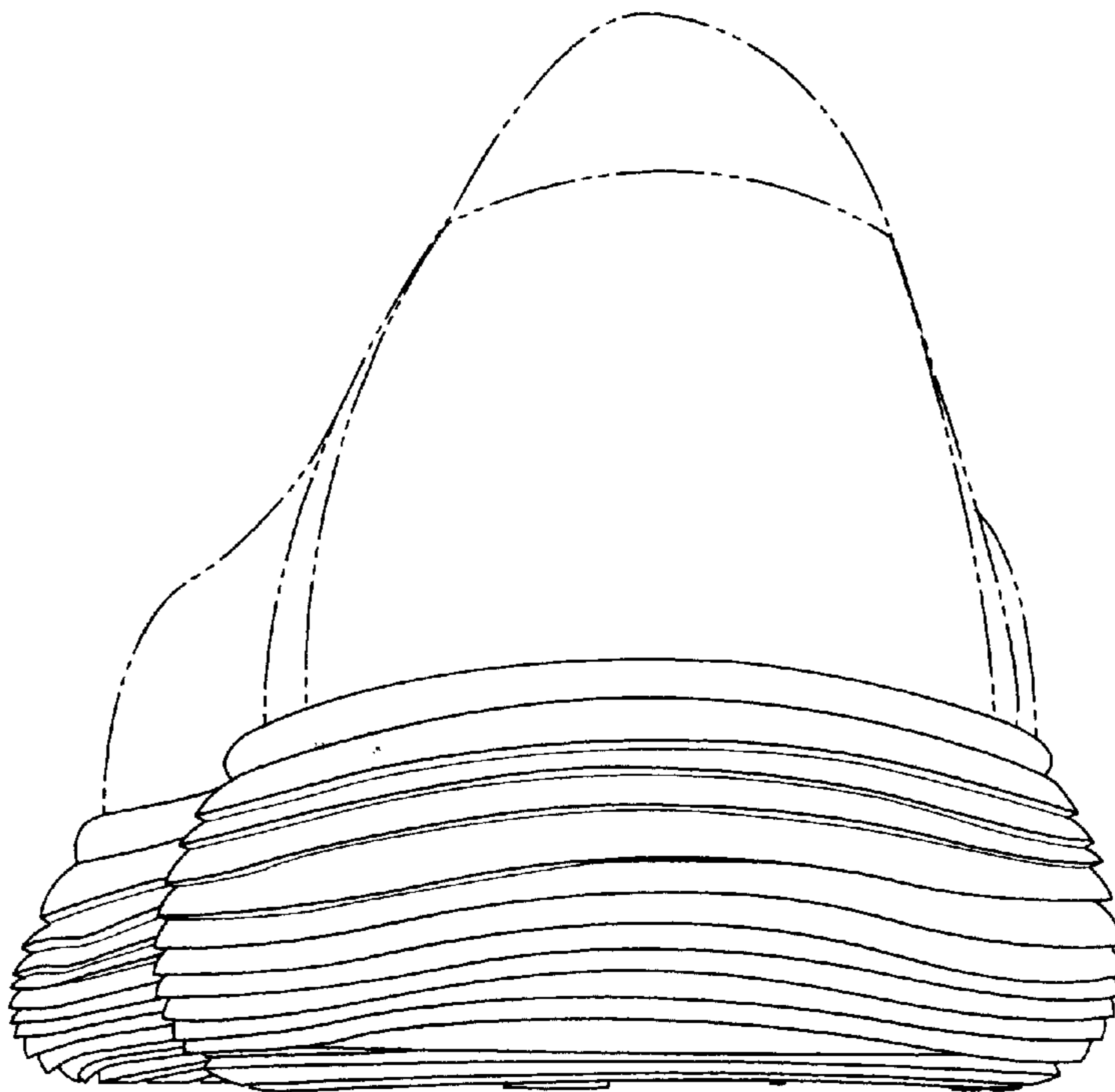
