(57) **CLAIM**

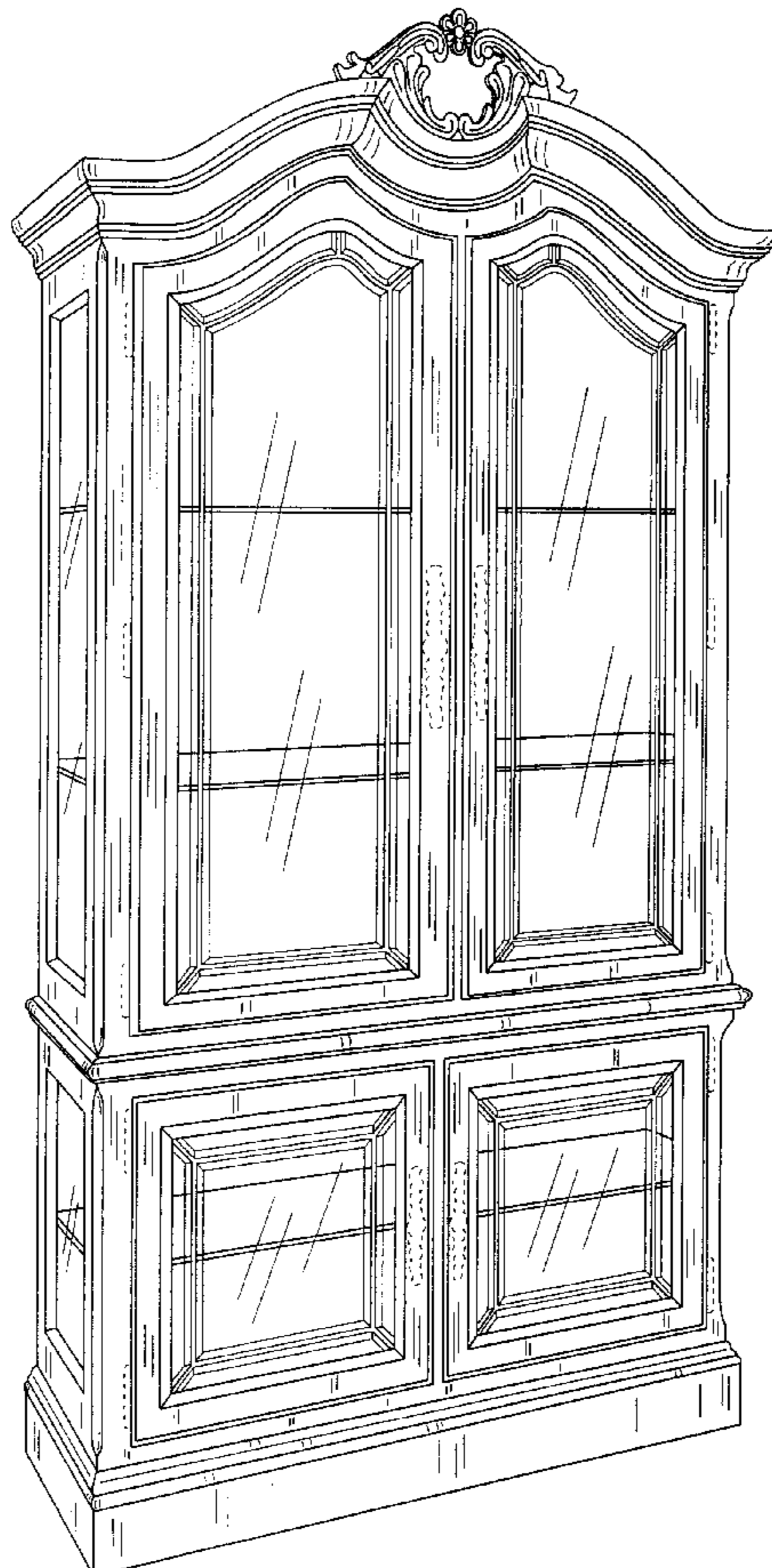
The ornamental design for a display china, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front perspective view of a display china showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; and, FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof.

The bottom and rear views of the display china are not shown and form no part of the claimed design. The dashed lines represent environmental elements only and form no part of the claimed design.

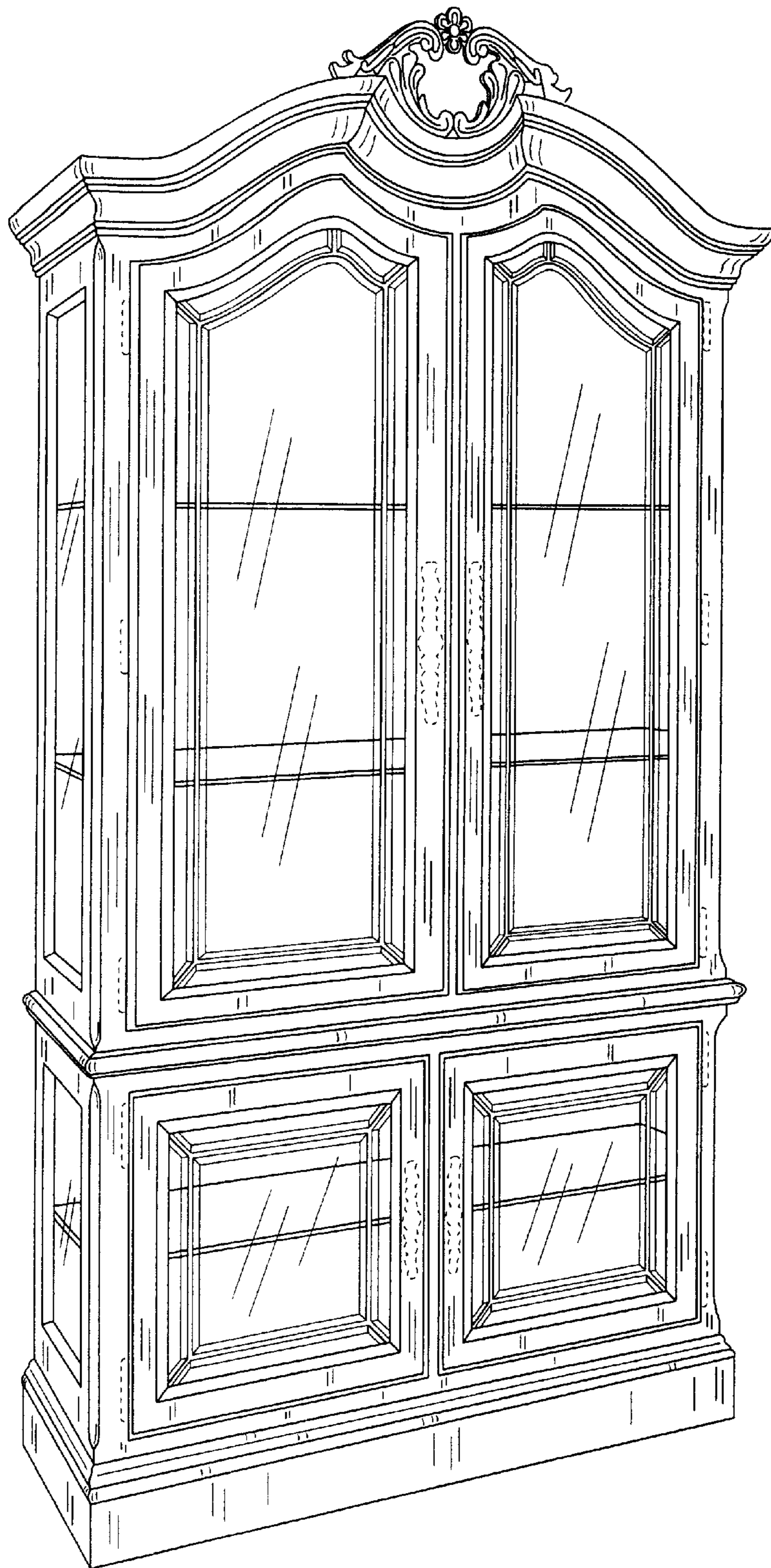

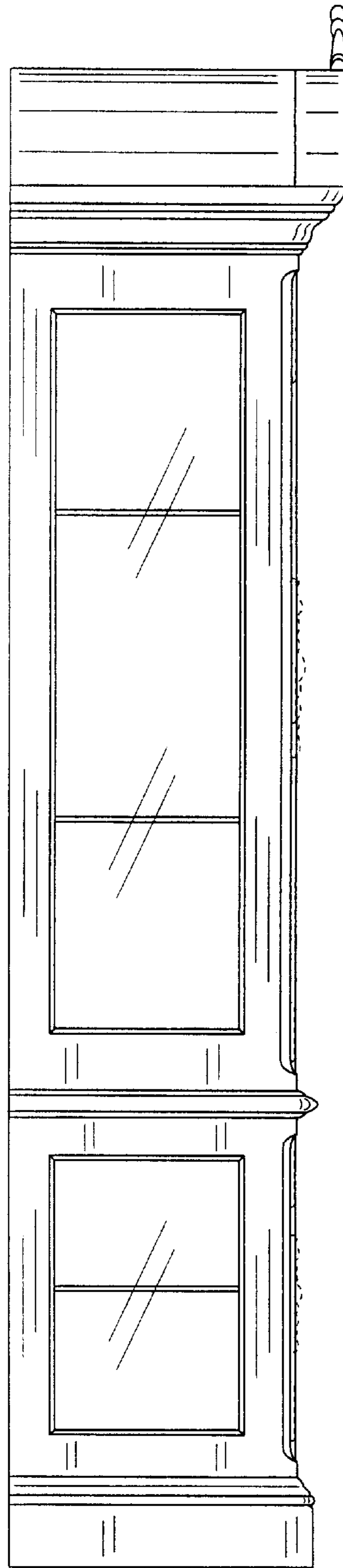

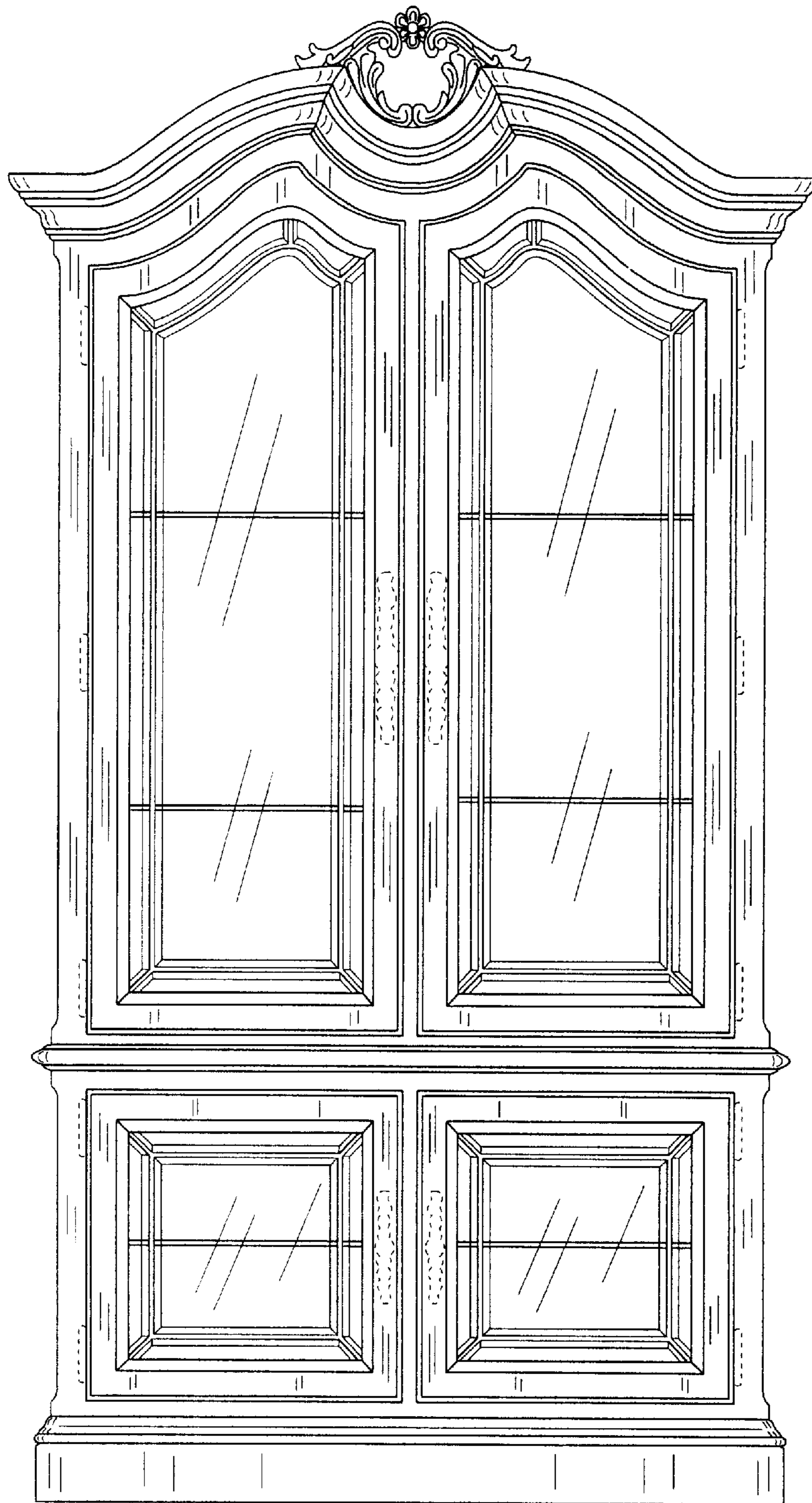
