DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bottle portion showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view of the bottle portion depicted in FIG. 1, the opposite rear view and the side views being identical;

FIG. 3 is a top view of the bottle portion depicted in FIG. 2; and,

FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the bottle portion depicted in FIG. 2.

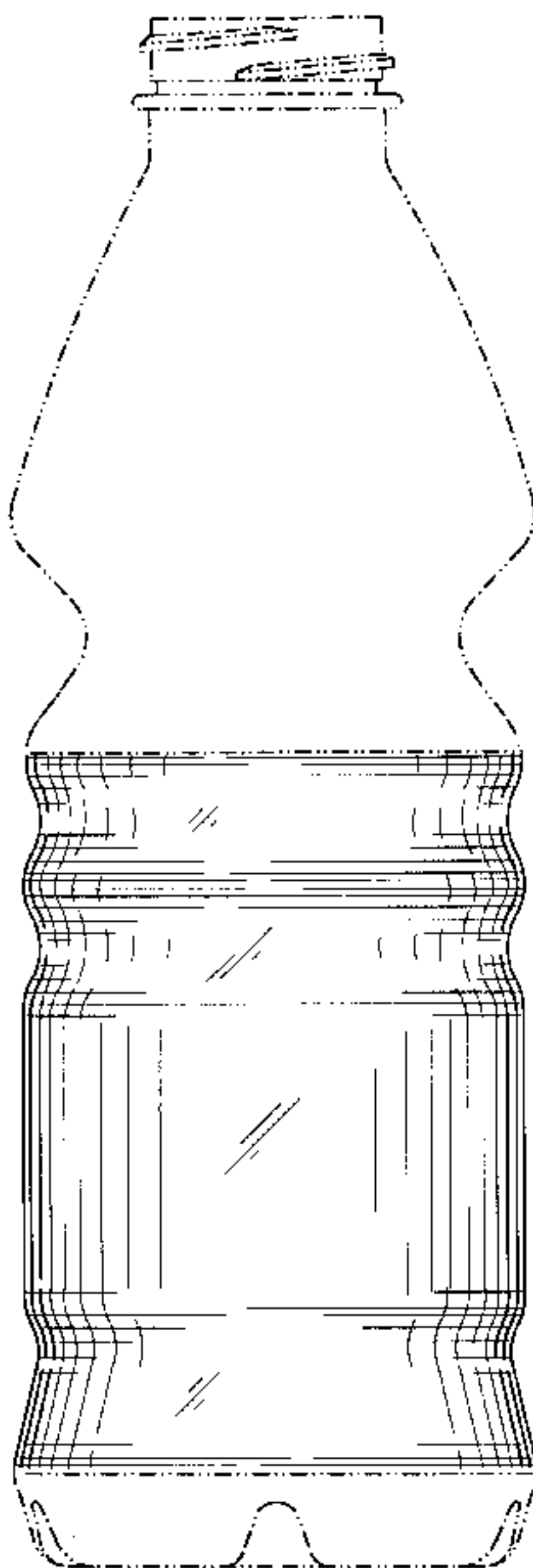

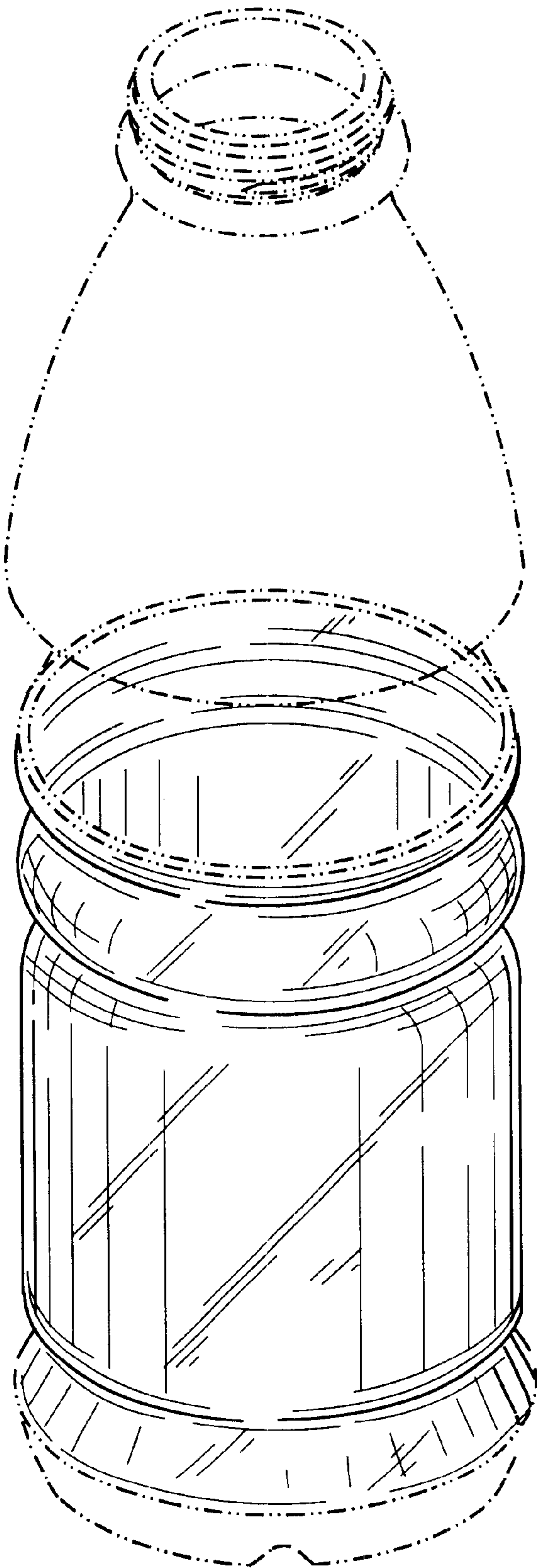

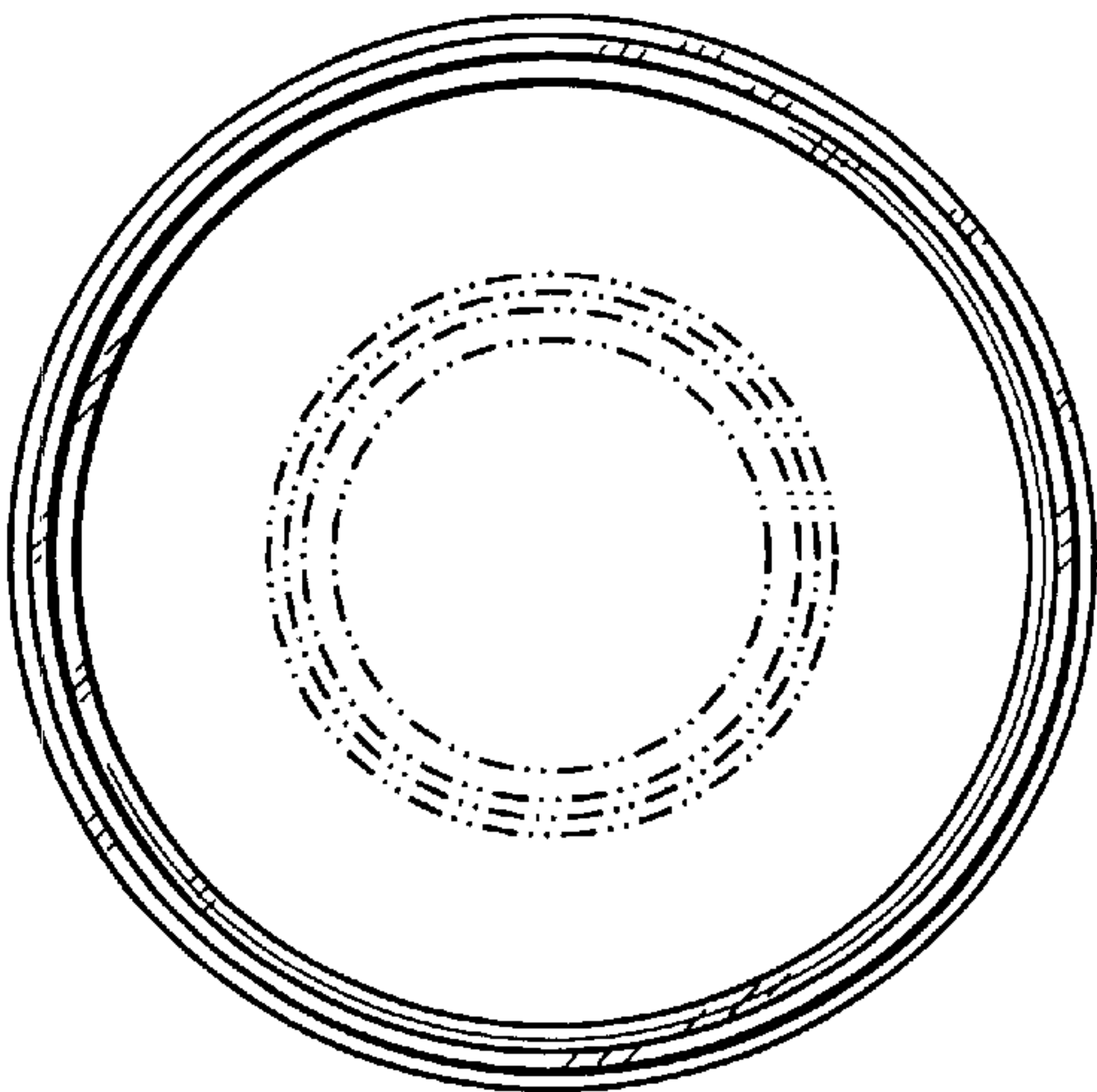
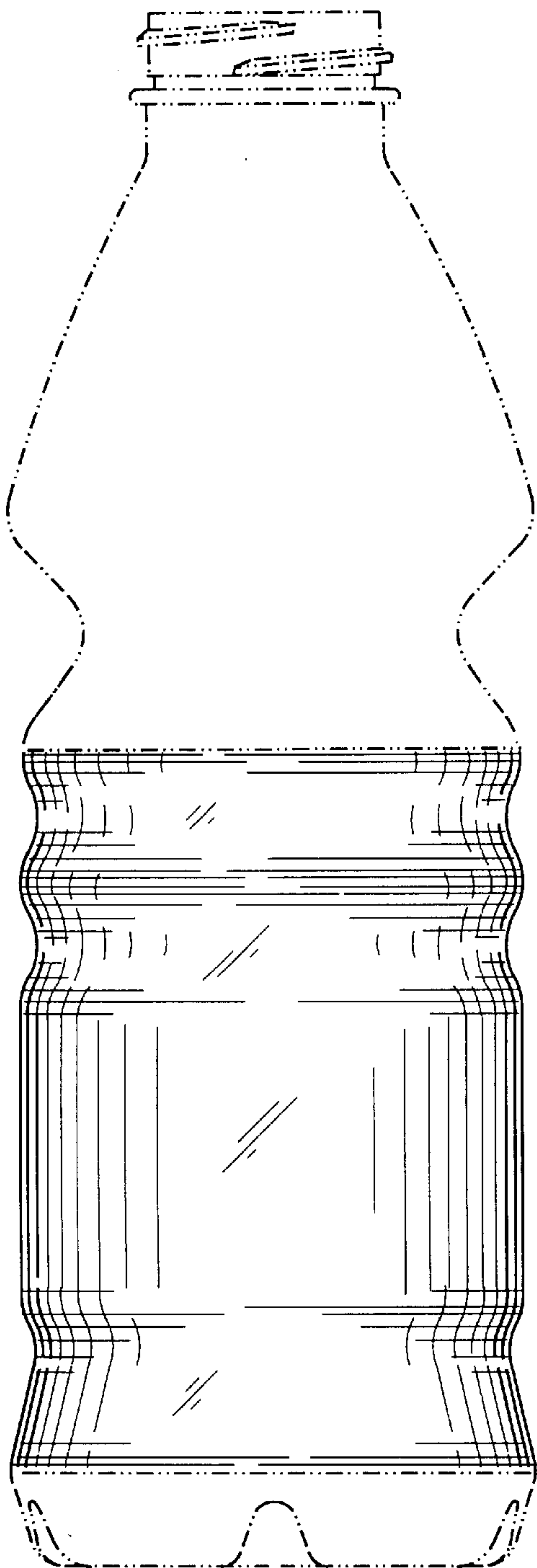

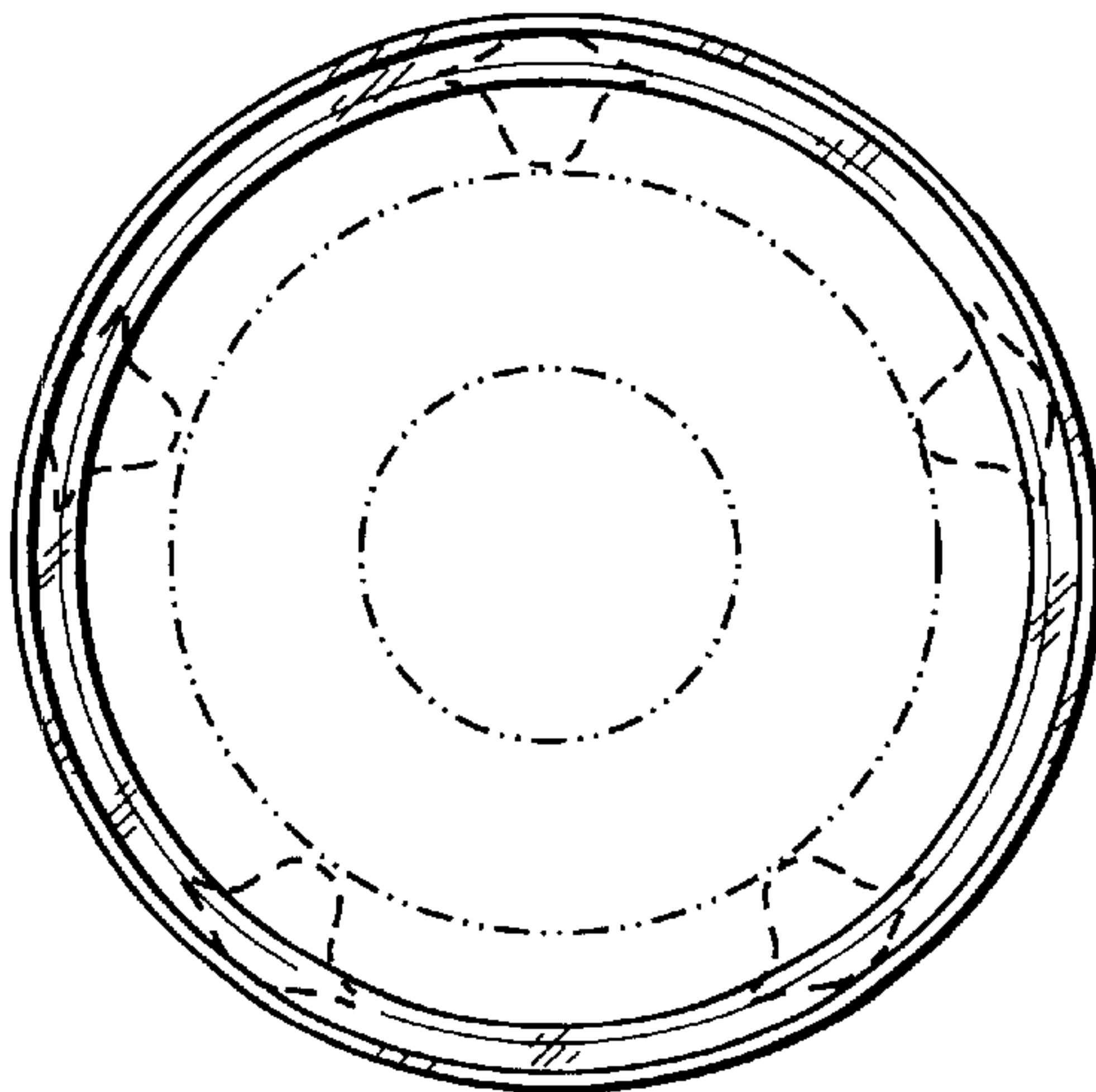
