(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a motorcycle headlight cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the motorcycle headlight cover, shown in position of use from the right side of a motorcycle.

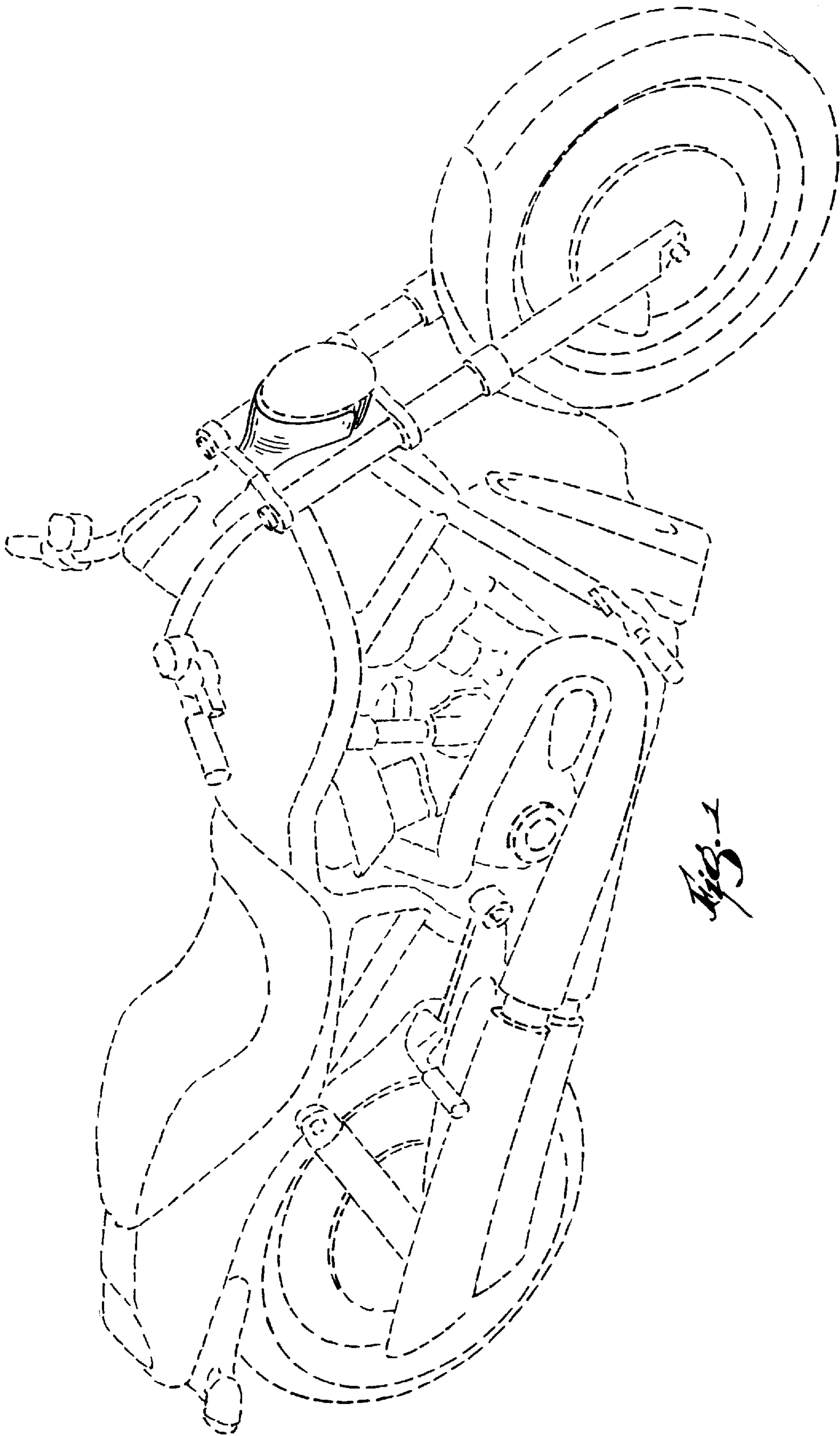
FIG. 2 is an enlarged top view of the motorcycle headlight cover.

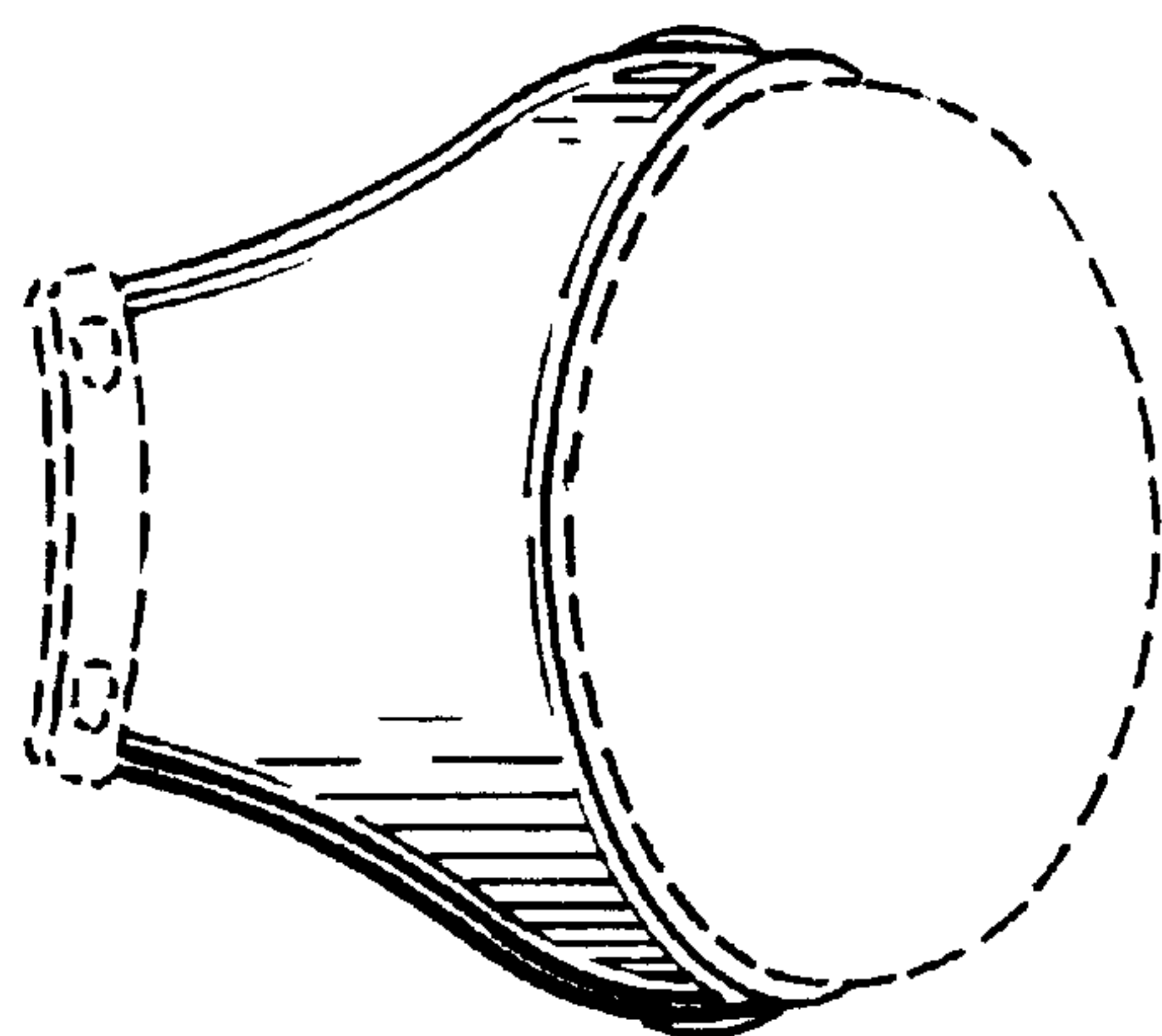

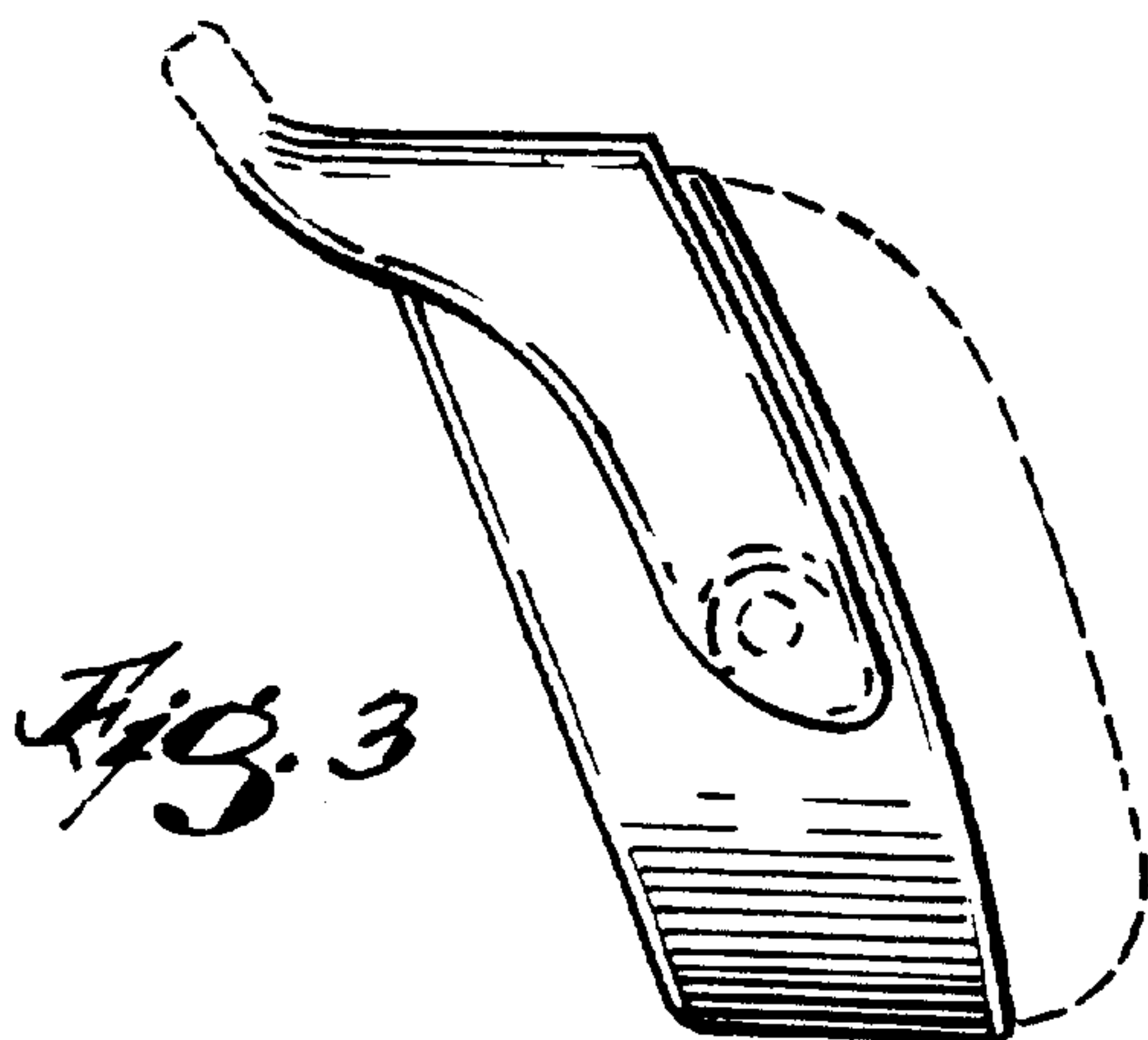

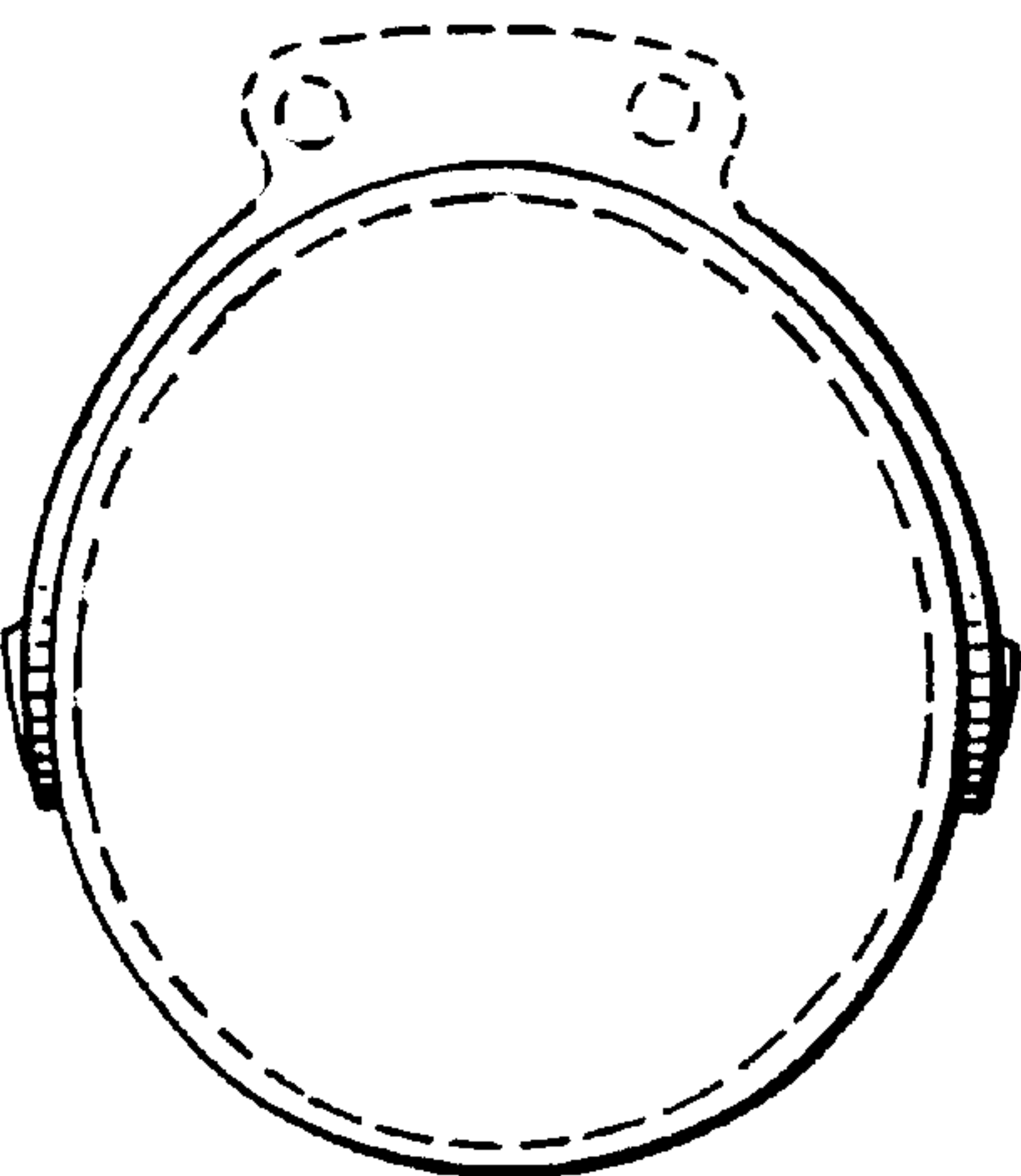
