FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof;

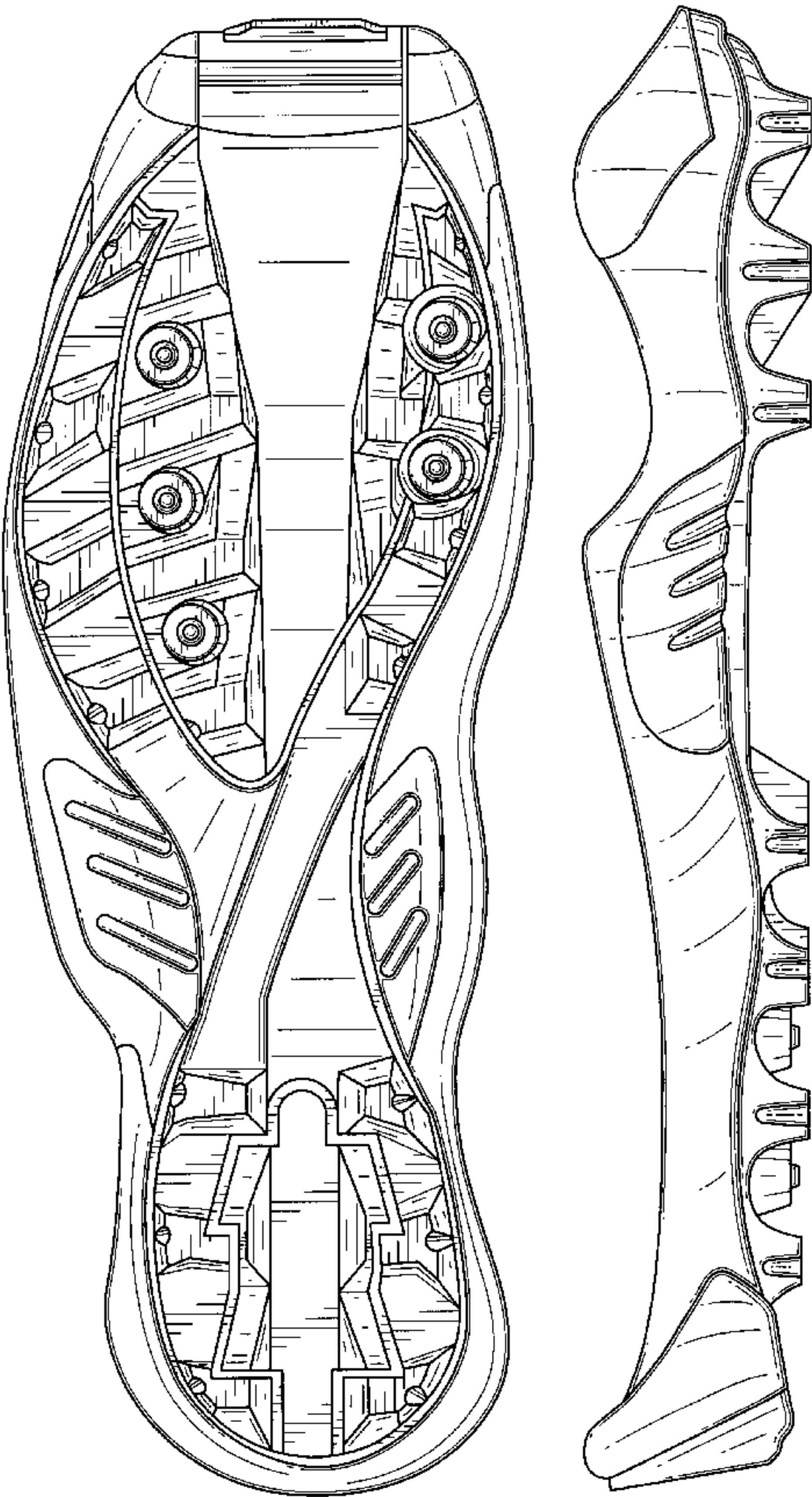
FIG. 3 is a front end view thereof;

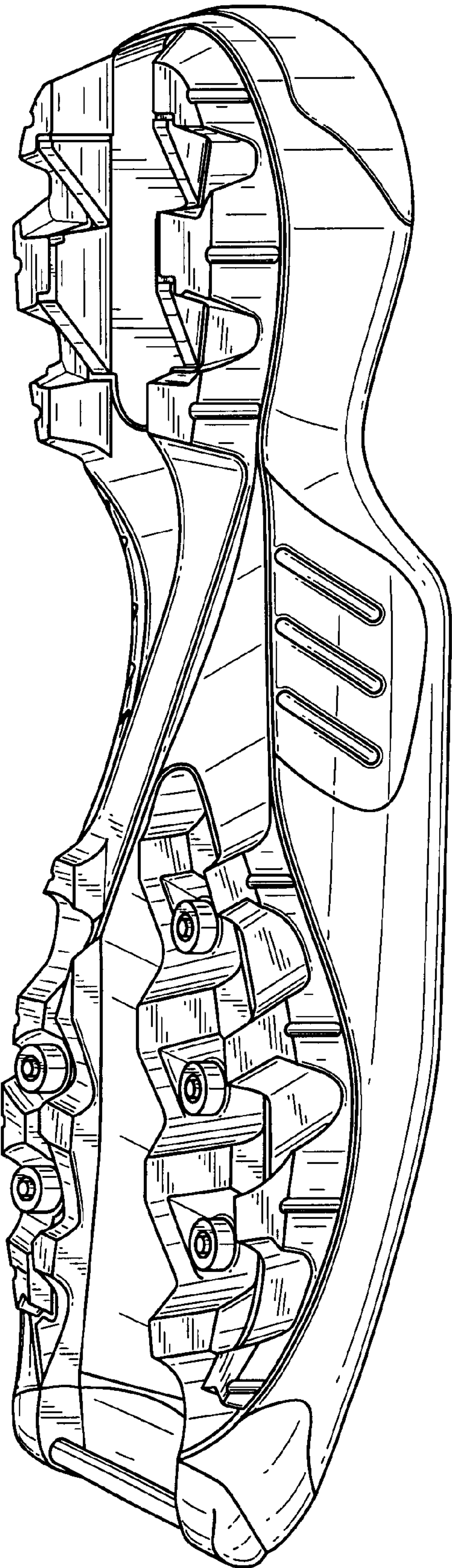

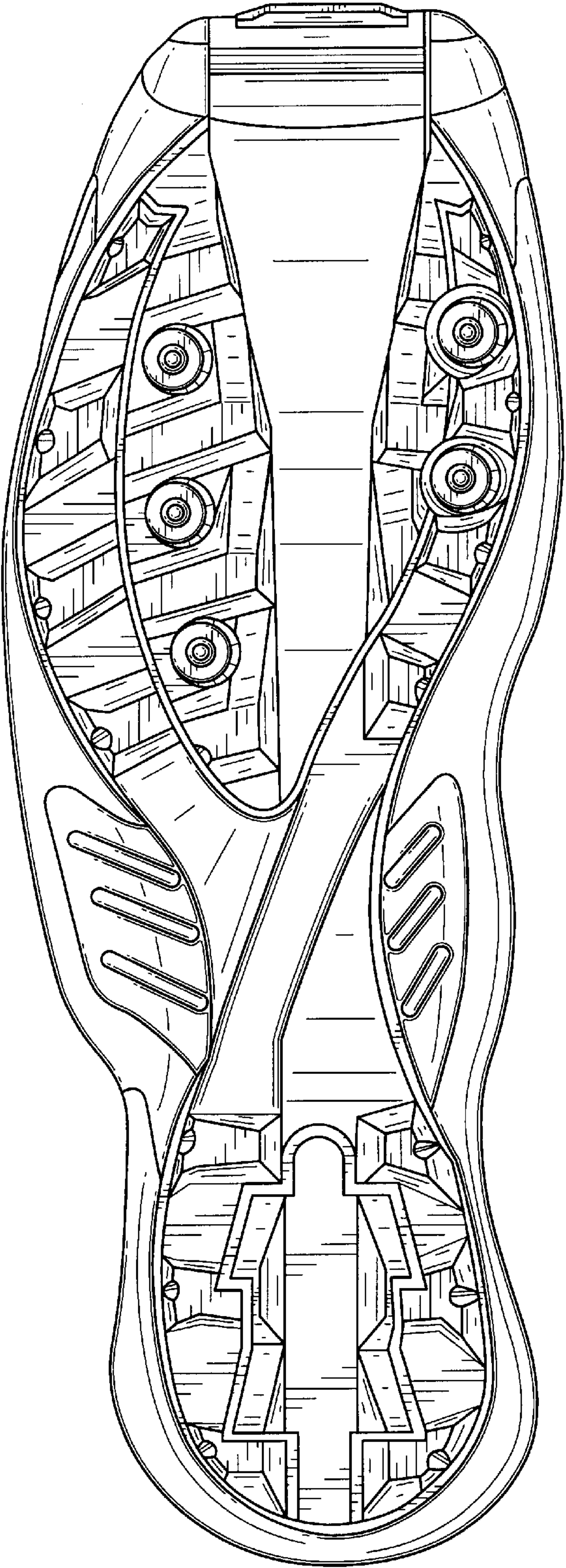

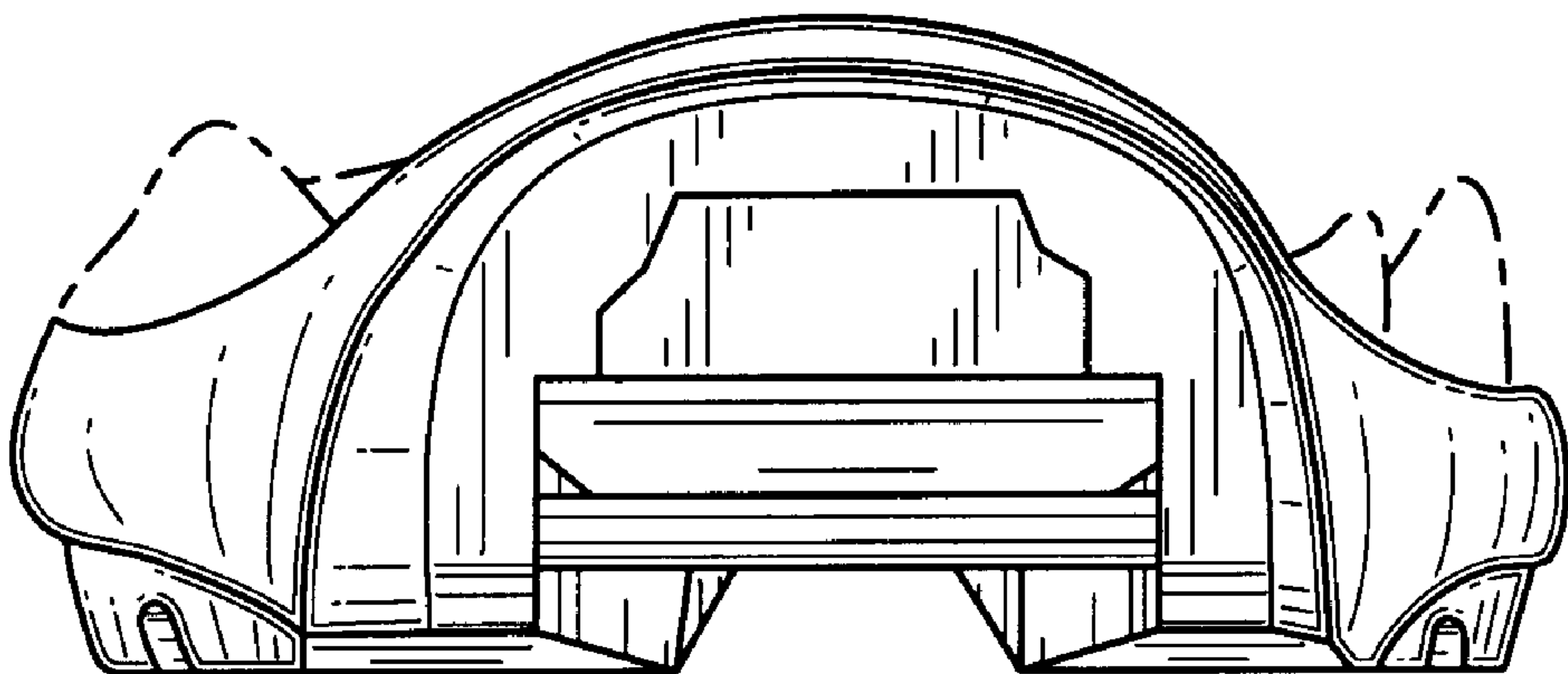

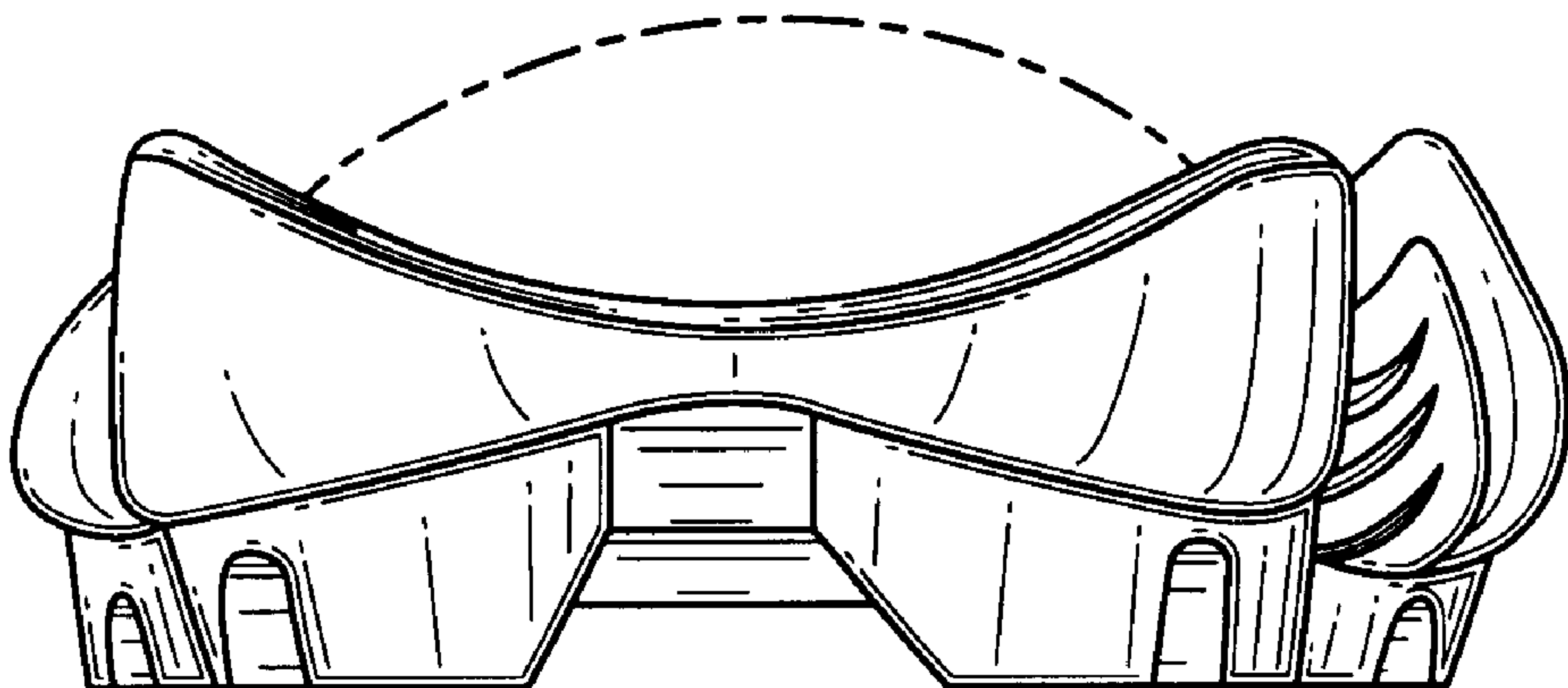

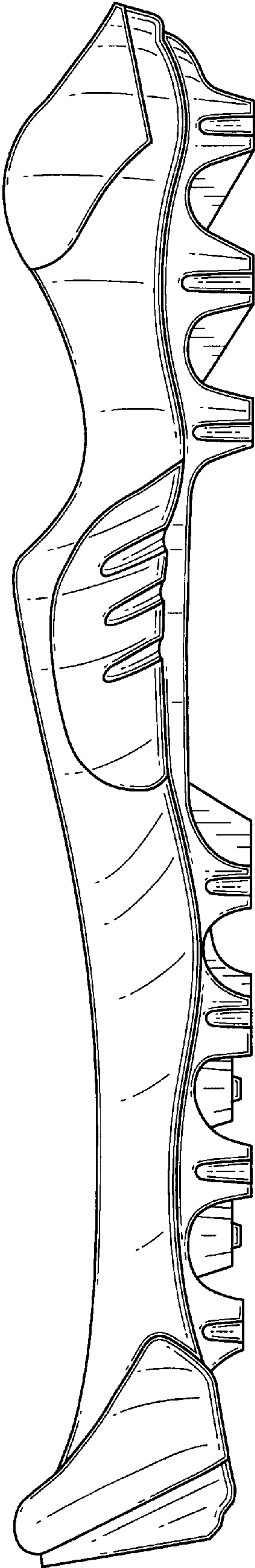

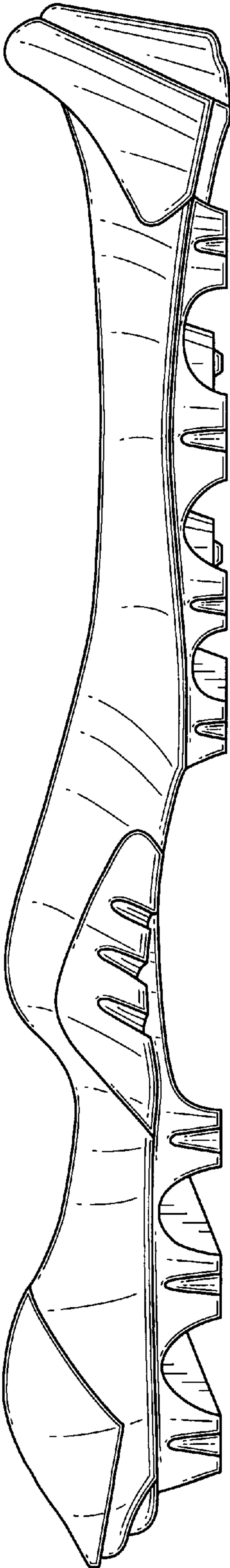
