(57)CLAIM

The ornamental design for a juvenile booster seat, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a juvenile booster seat in accordance with my design with a seating pad which forms the environment of the juvenile seat and forms no part the claimed design, the seating pad being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only; FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.
