FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view being a substantial mirror image thereof;

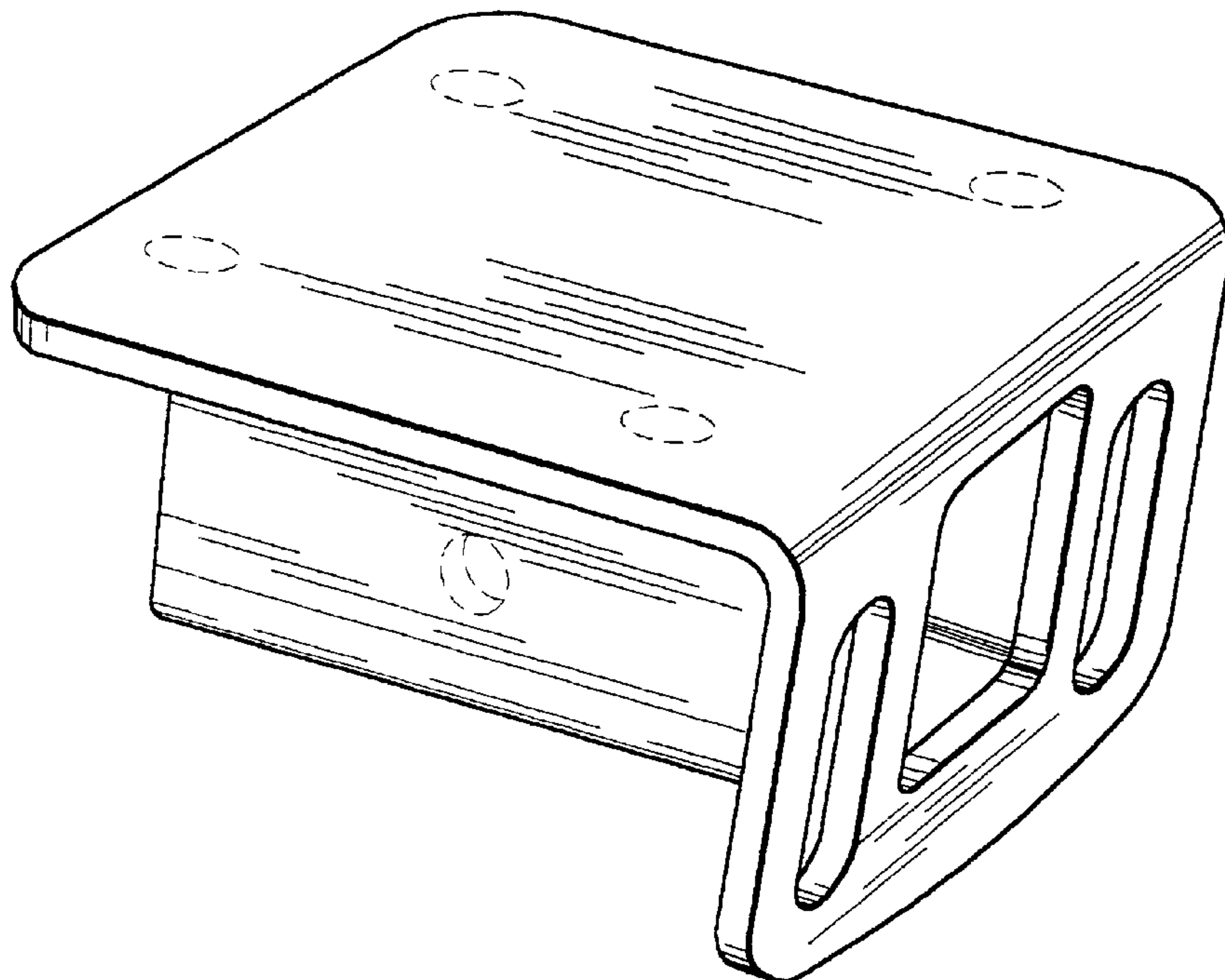
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

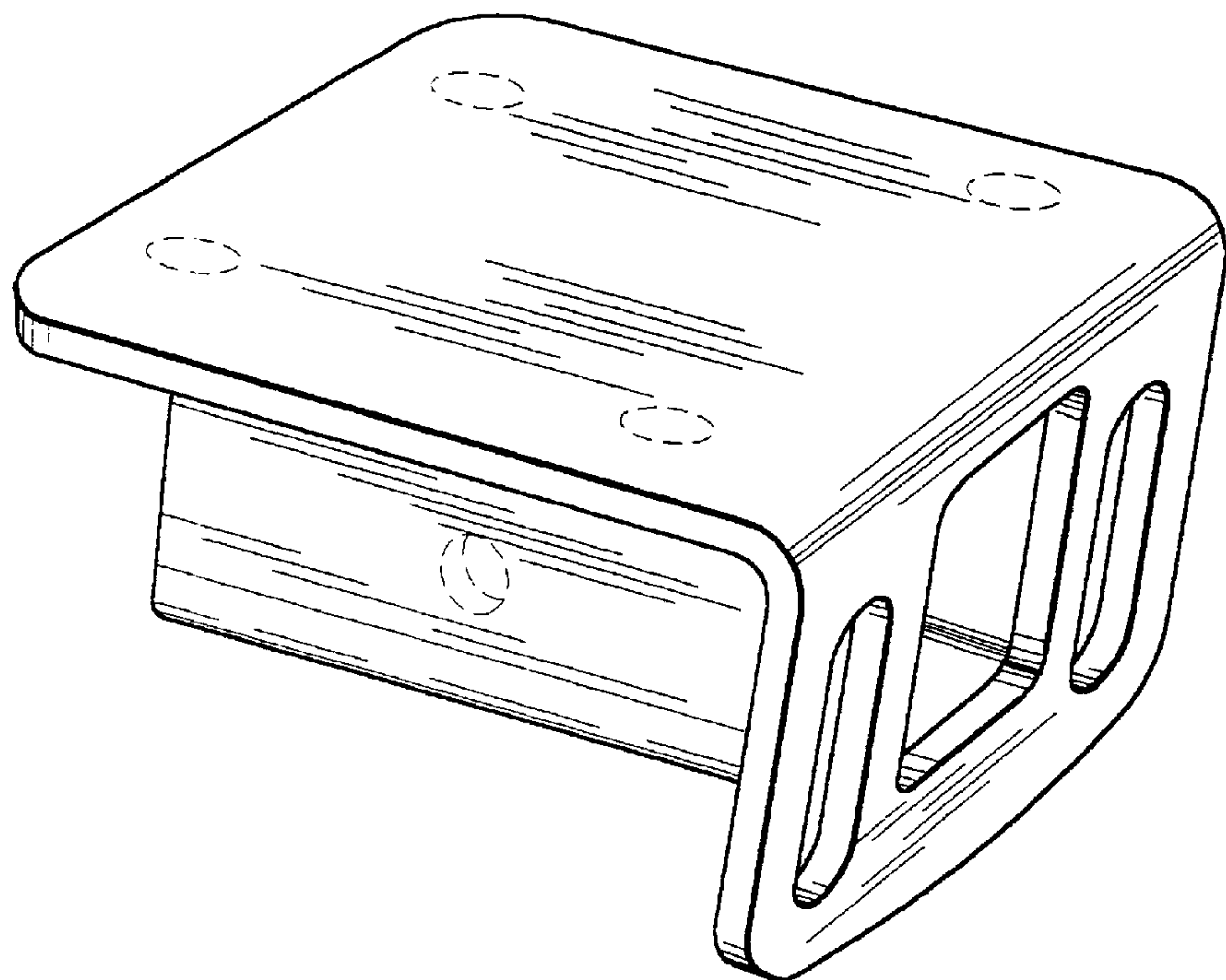

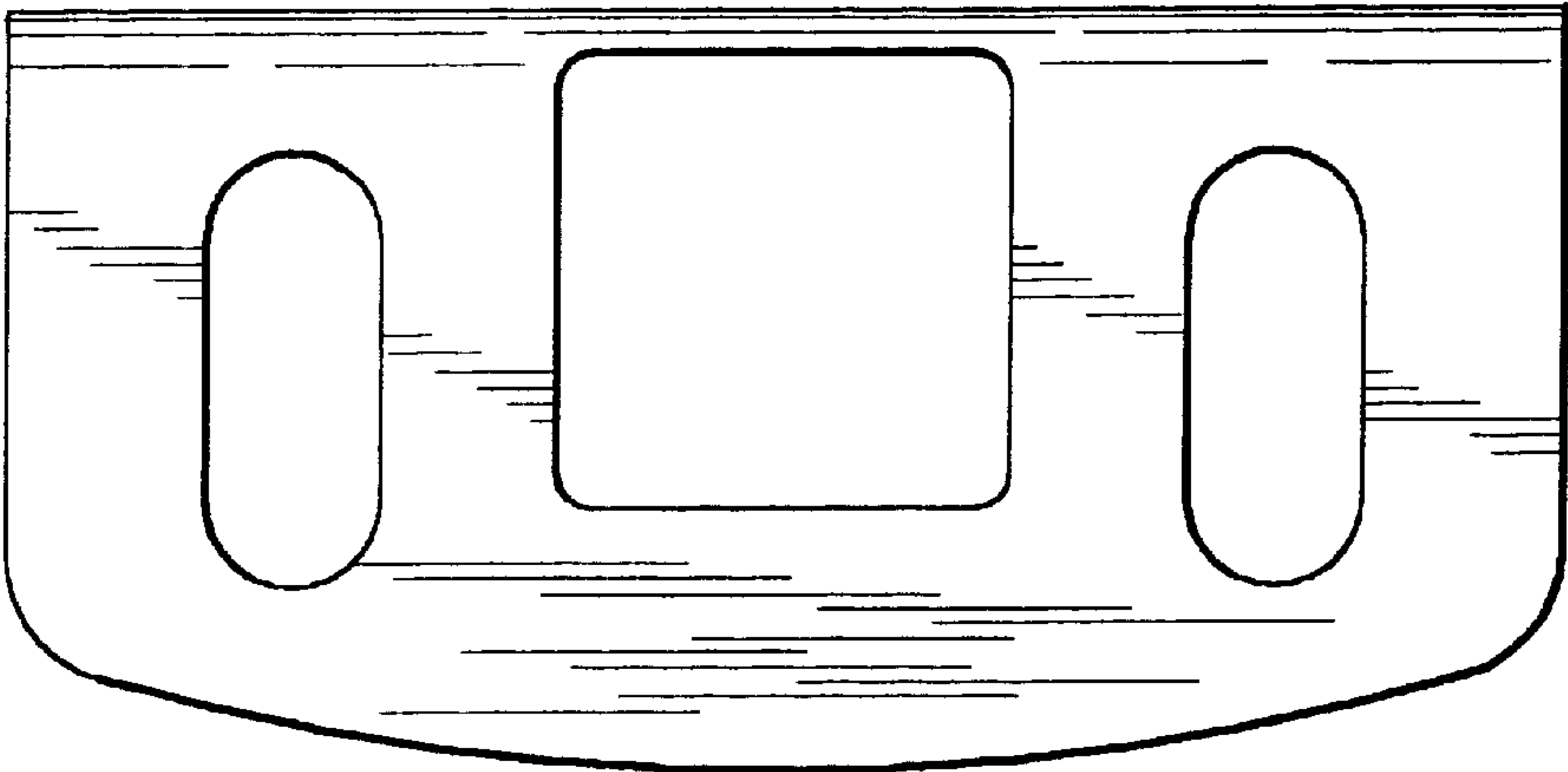

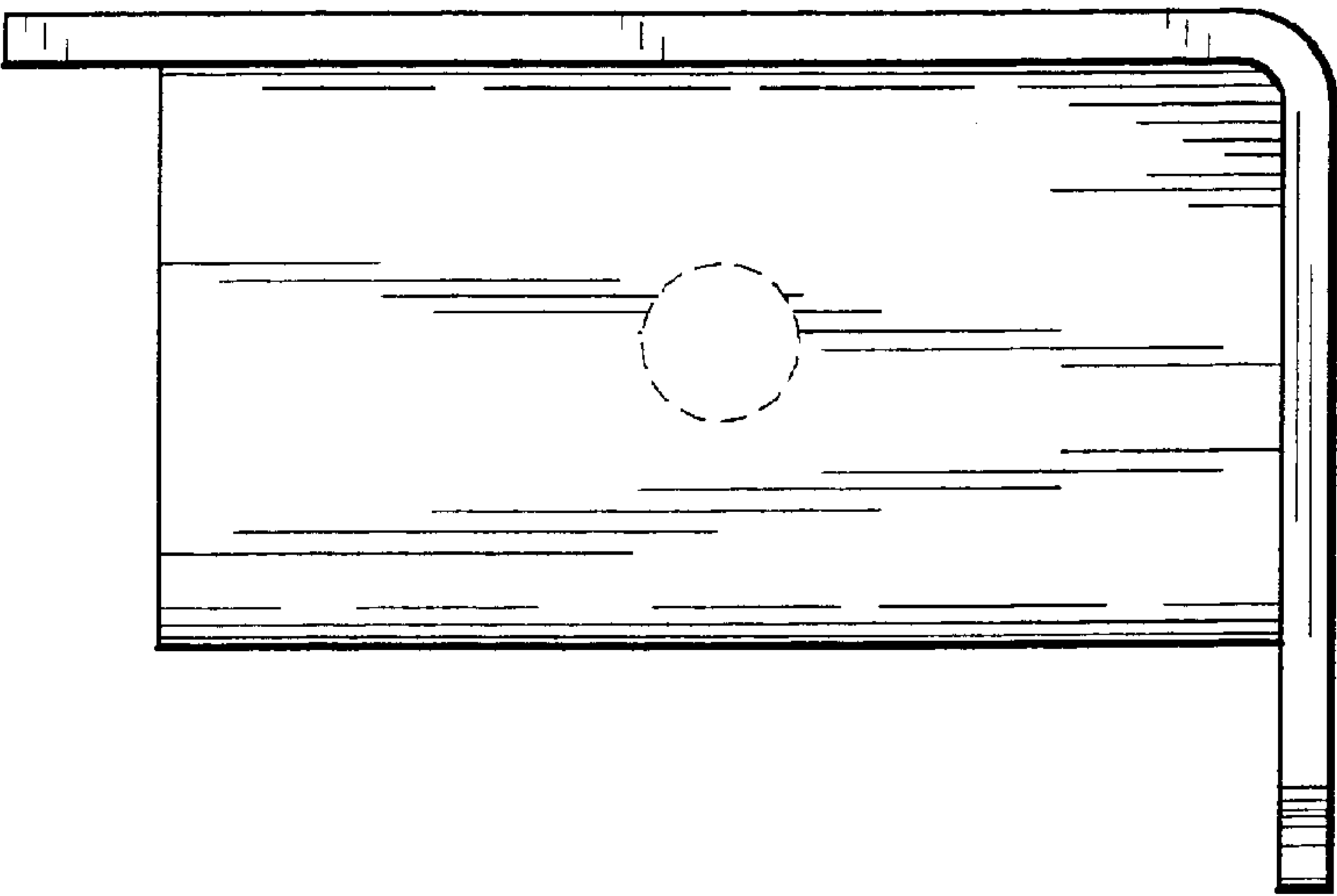

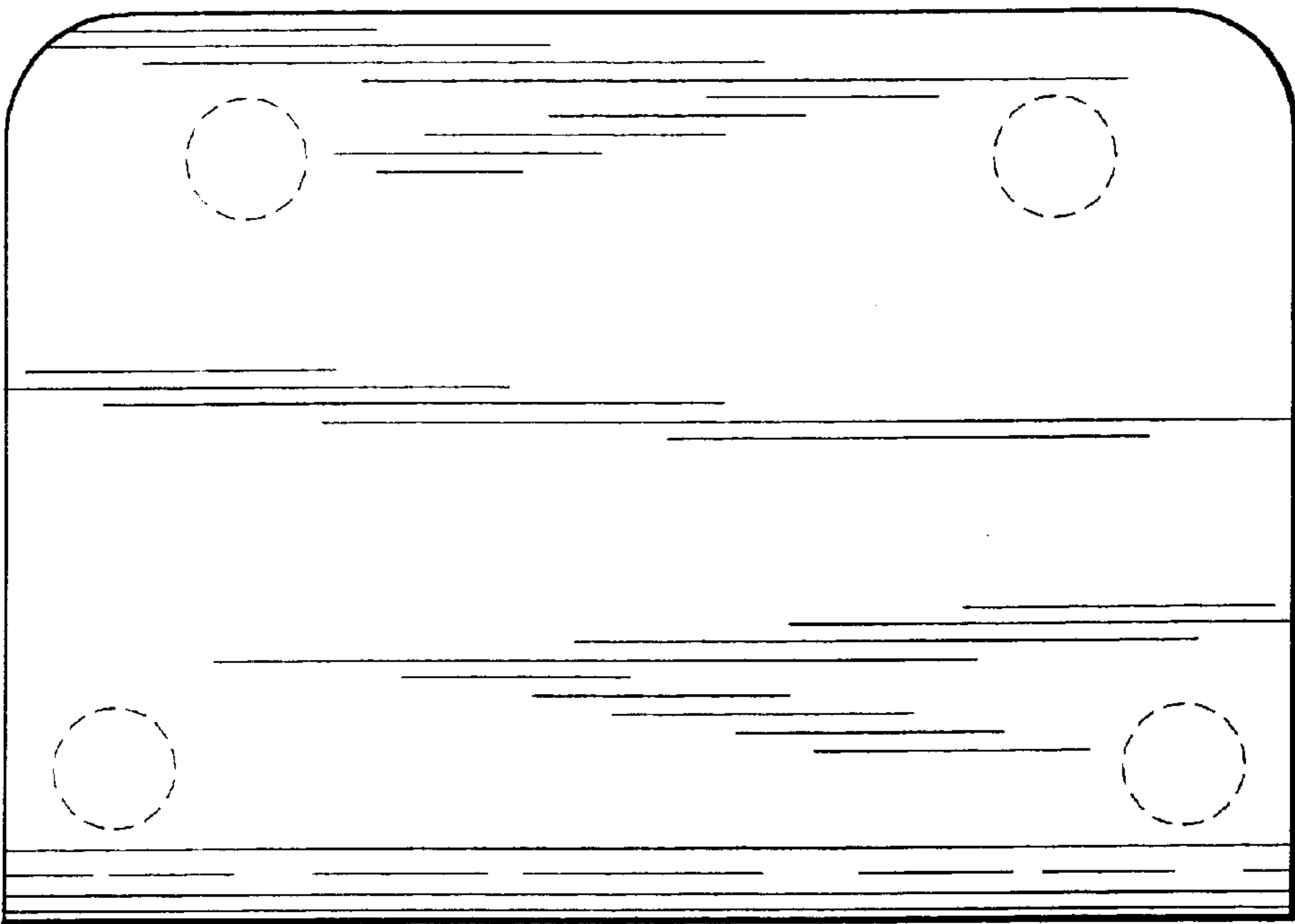

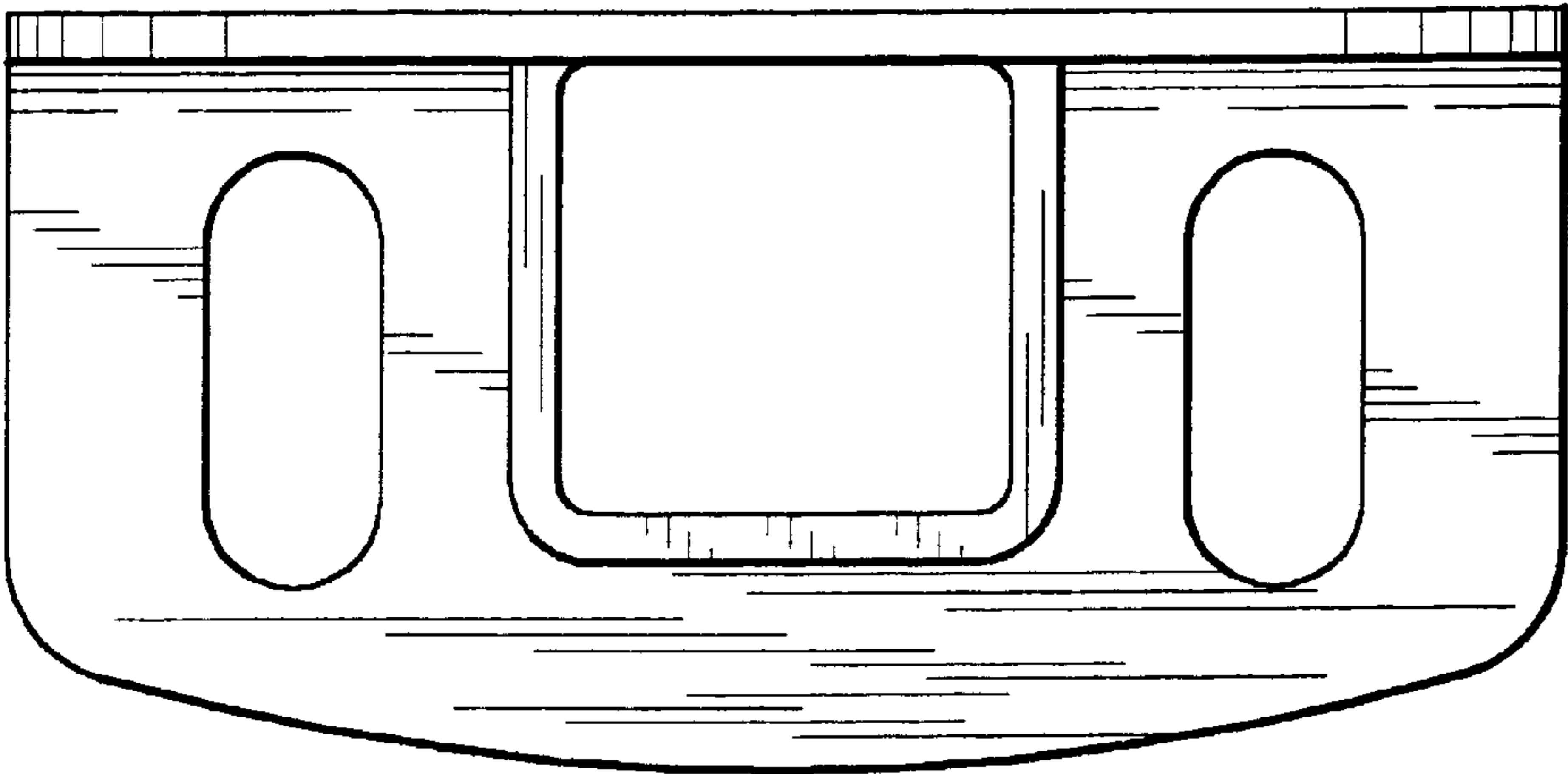

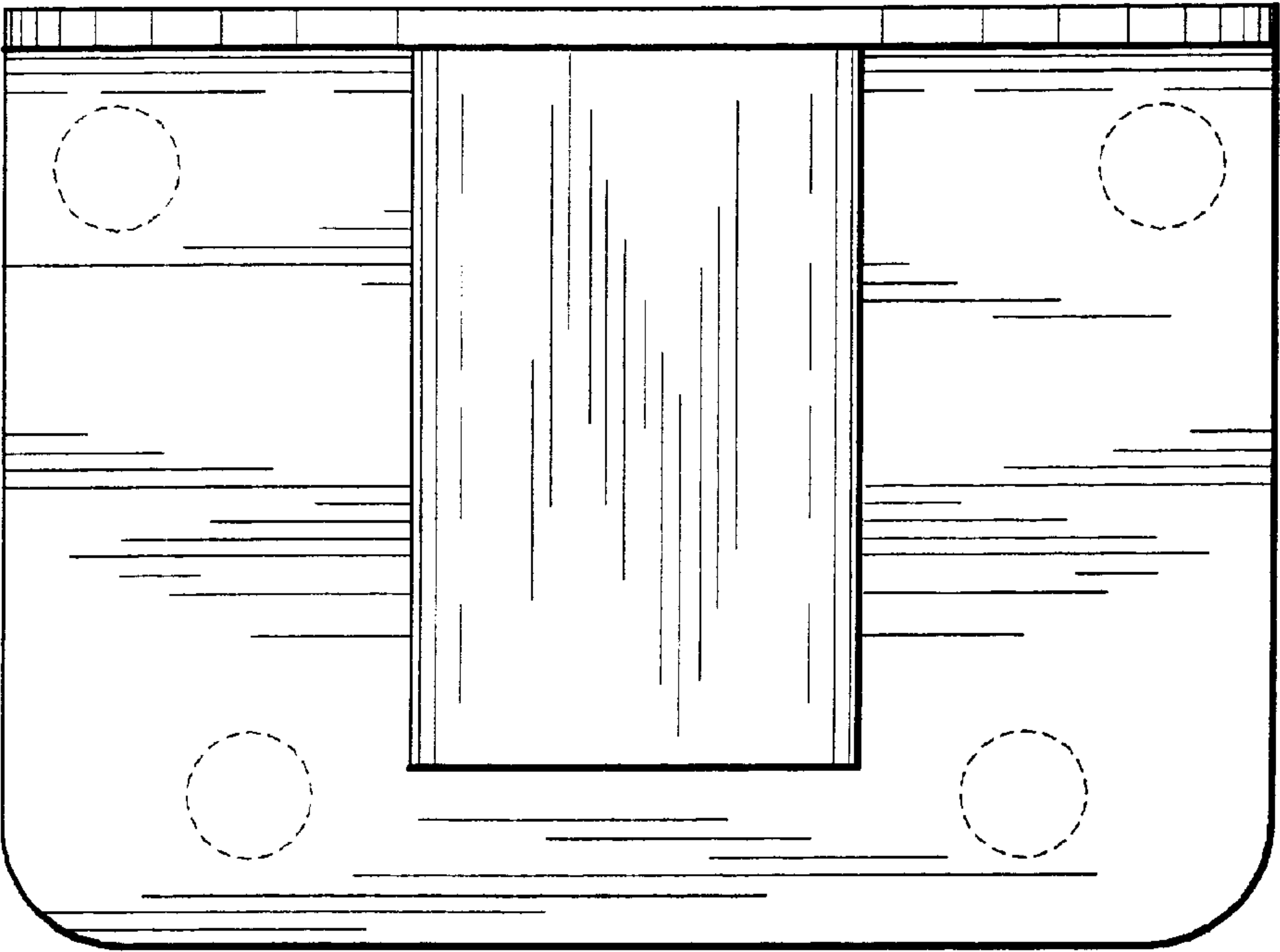
