(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for double-sided jewelry setting, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the double-sided jewelry setting of my new design, with a gem and mountings shown in hidden line;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top end view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom end view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.

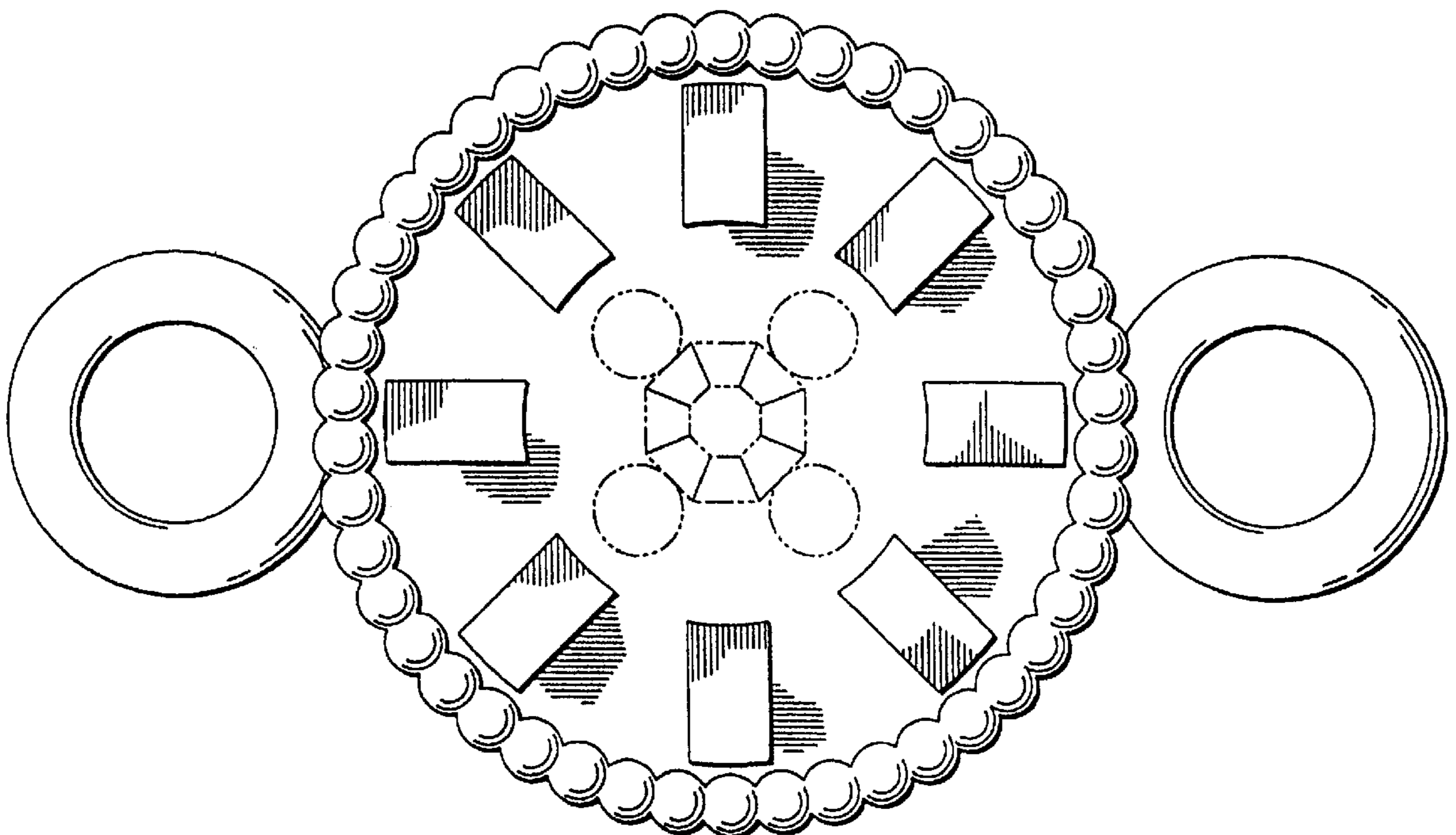

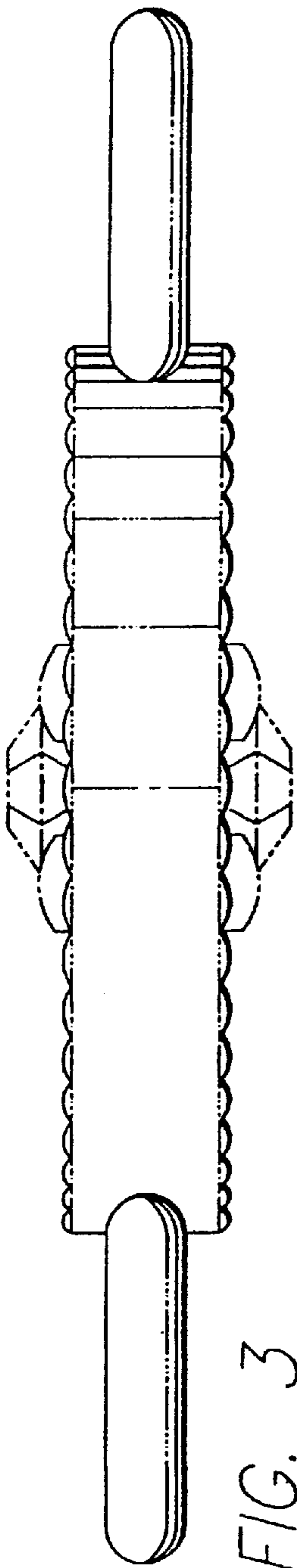
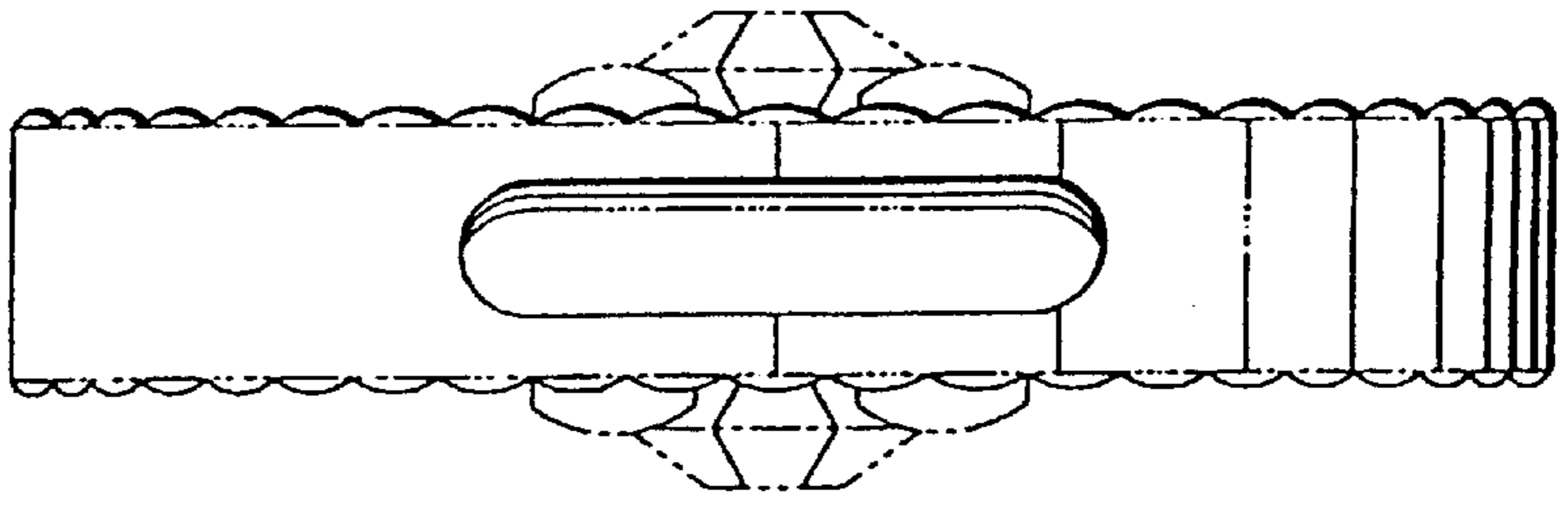

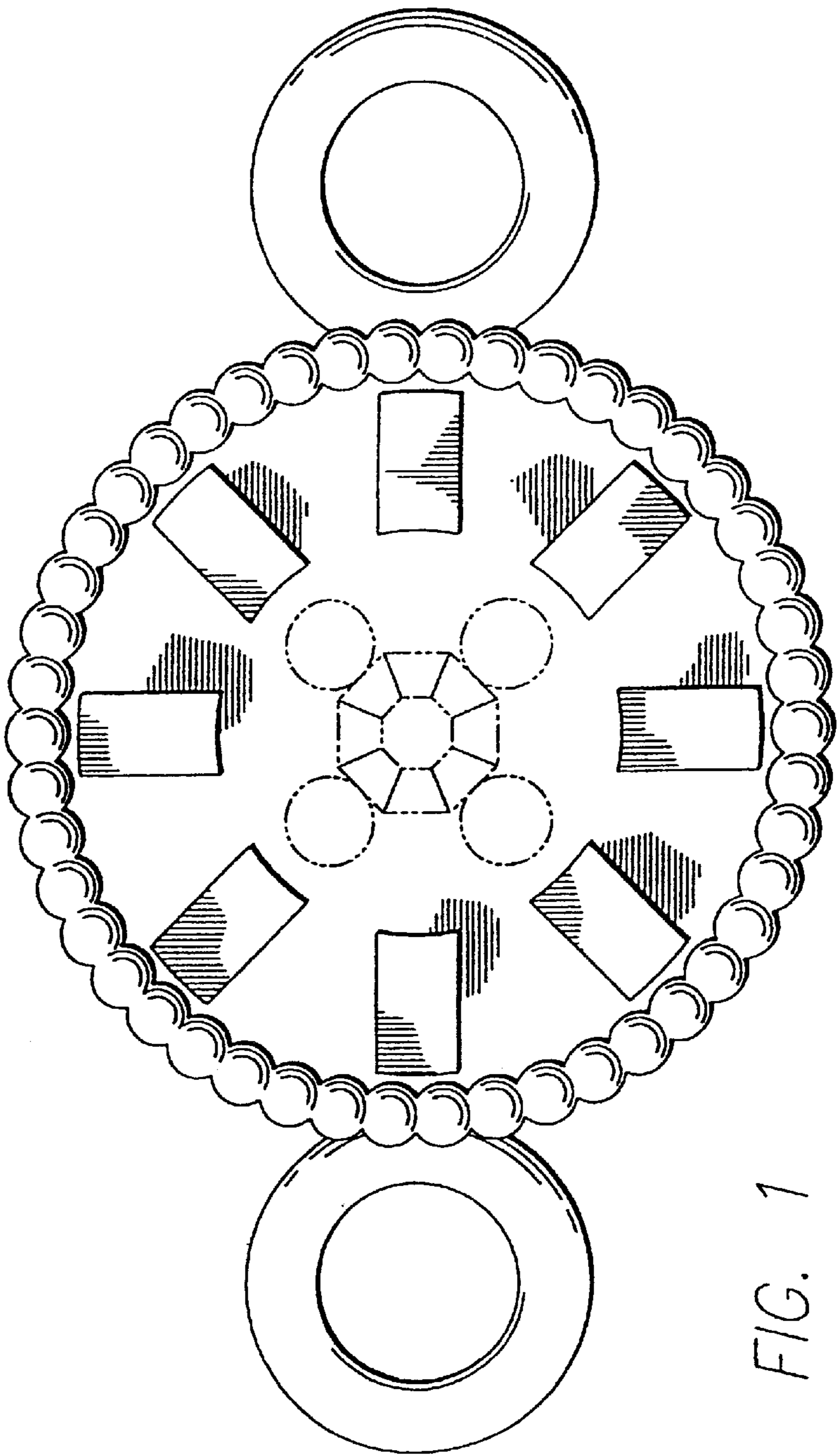

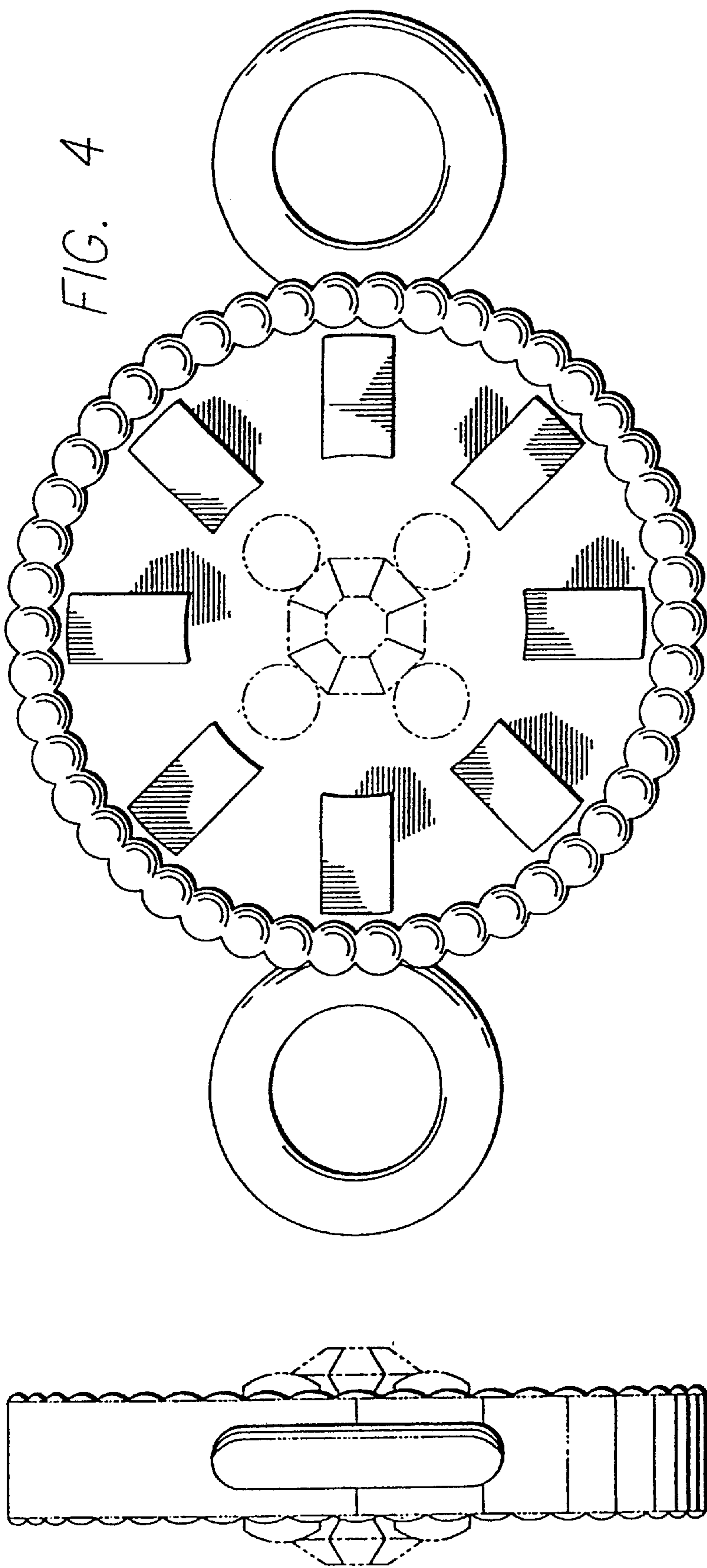

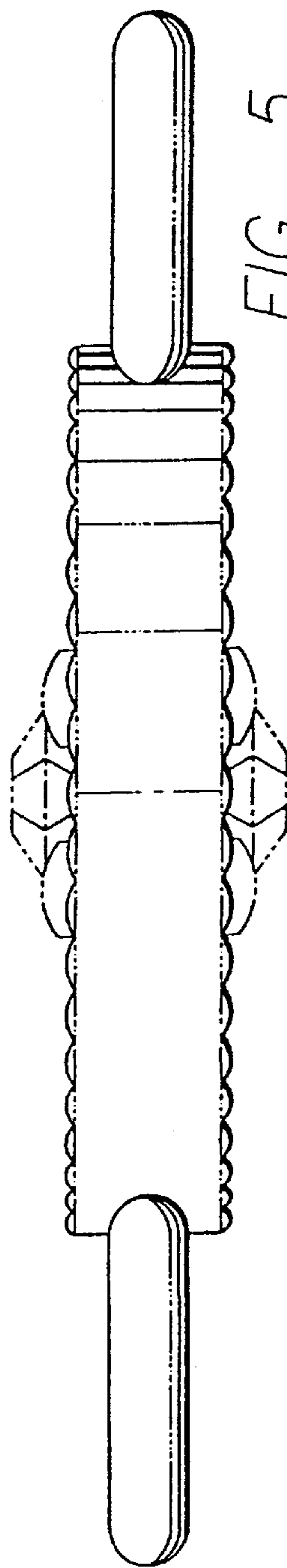
