FIG. 2 is an elevational view of a second embodiment of a surface ornamentation for a door window showing my new design.

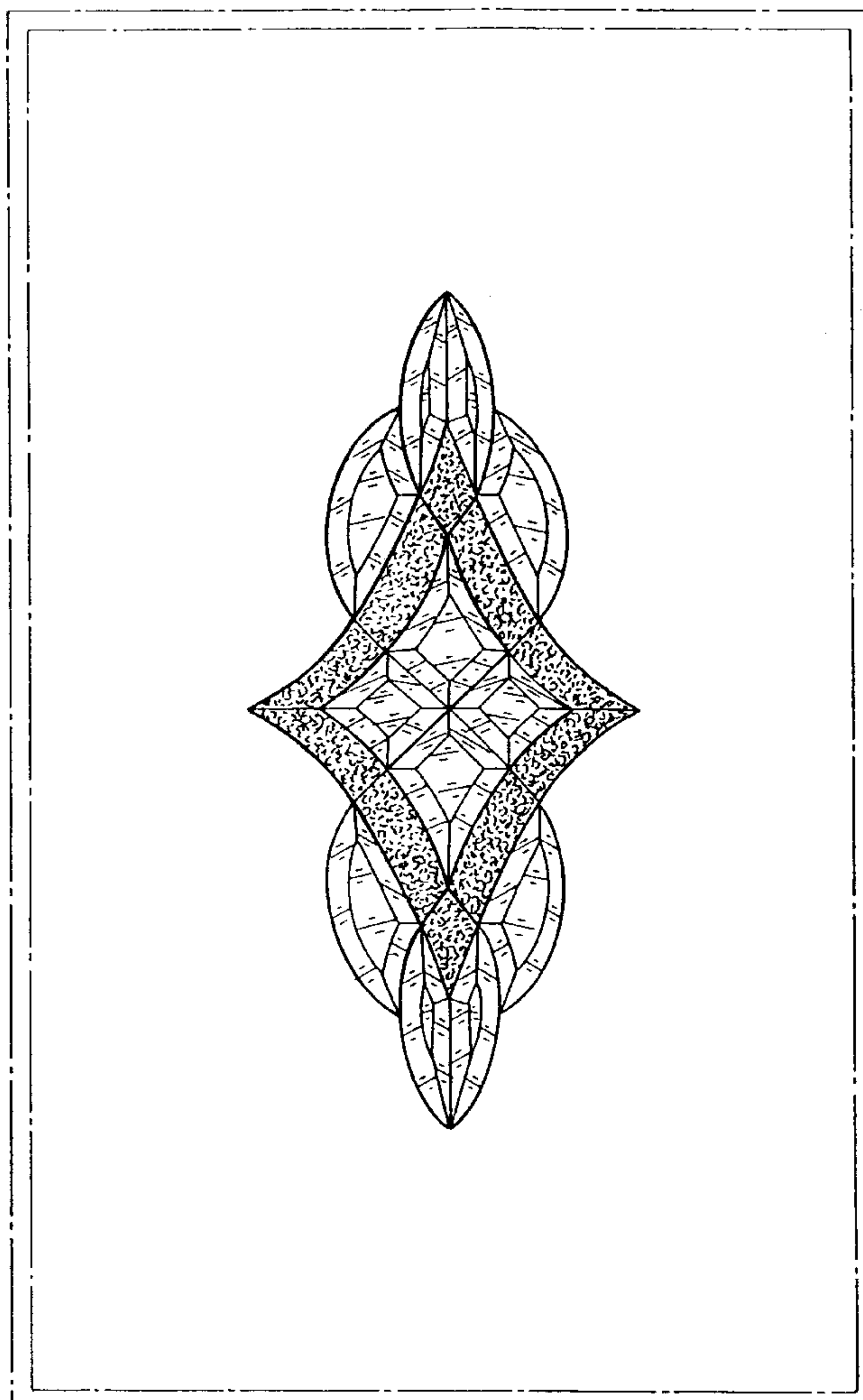

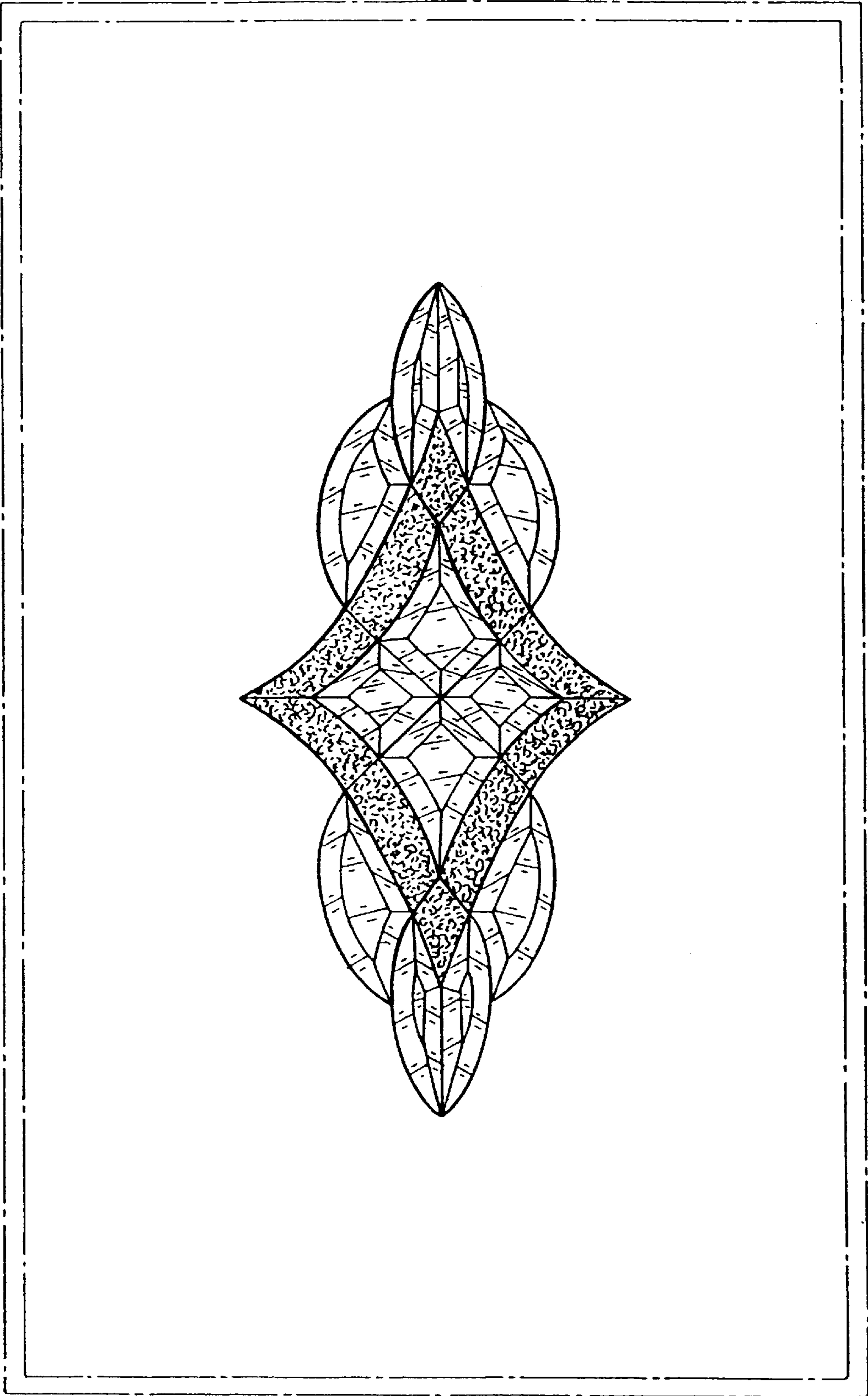

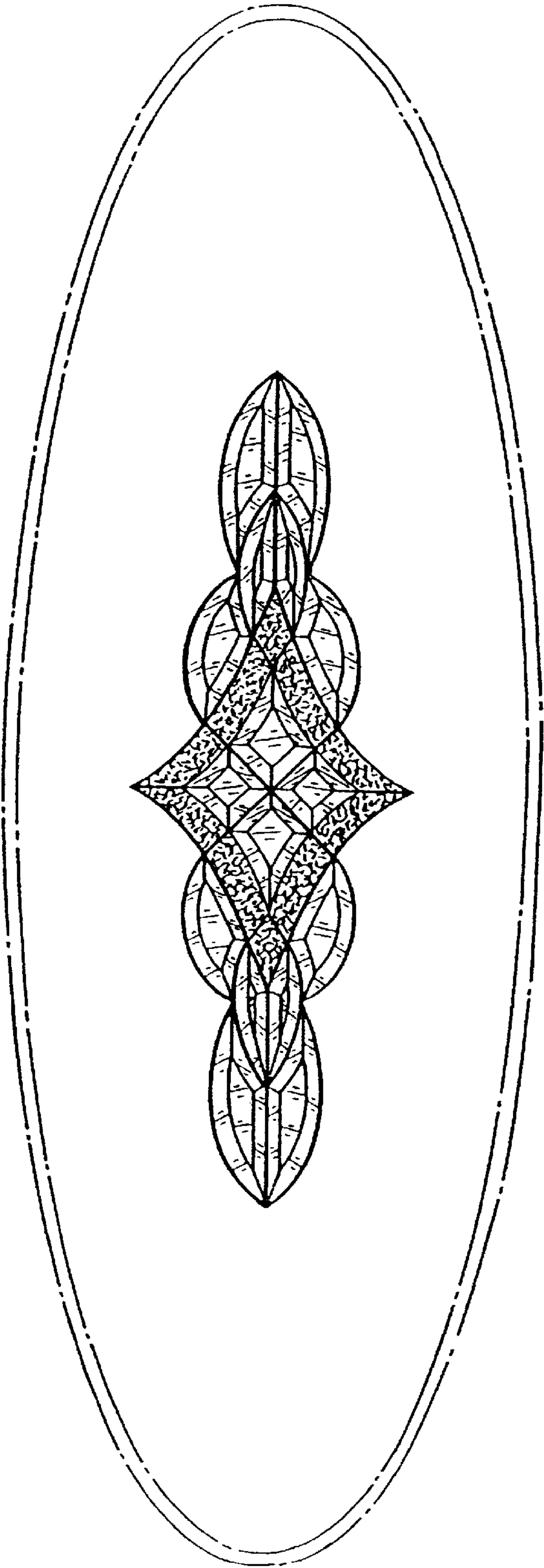
