FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a motorcycle head lamp showing our new design;

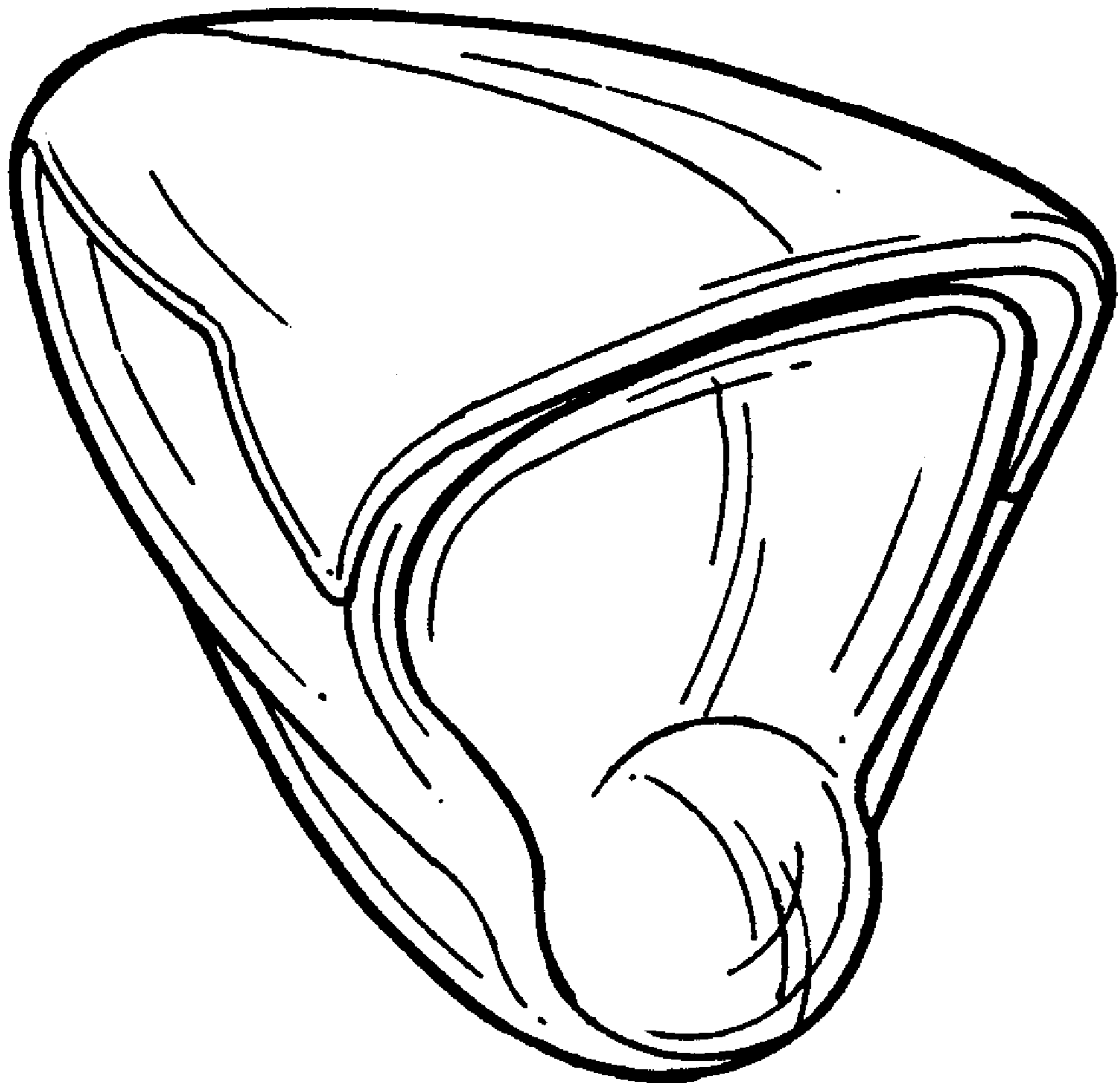
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

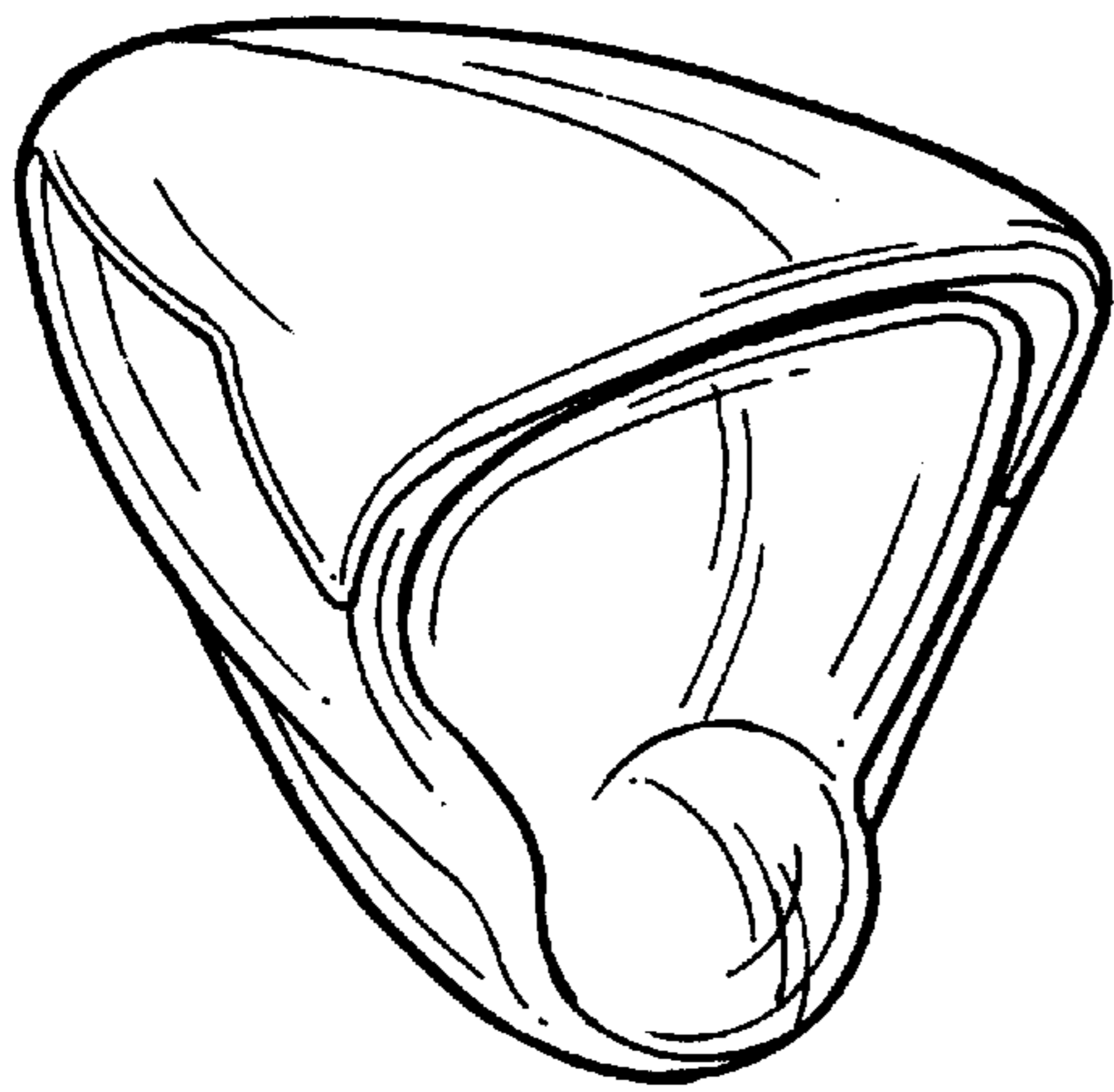

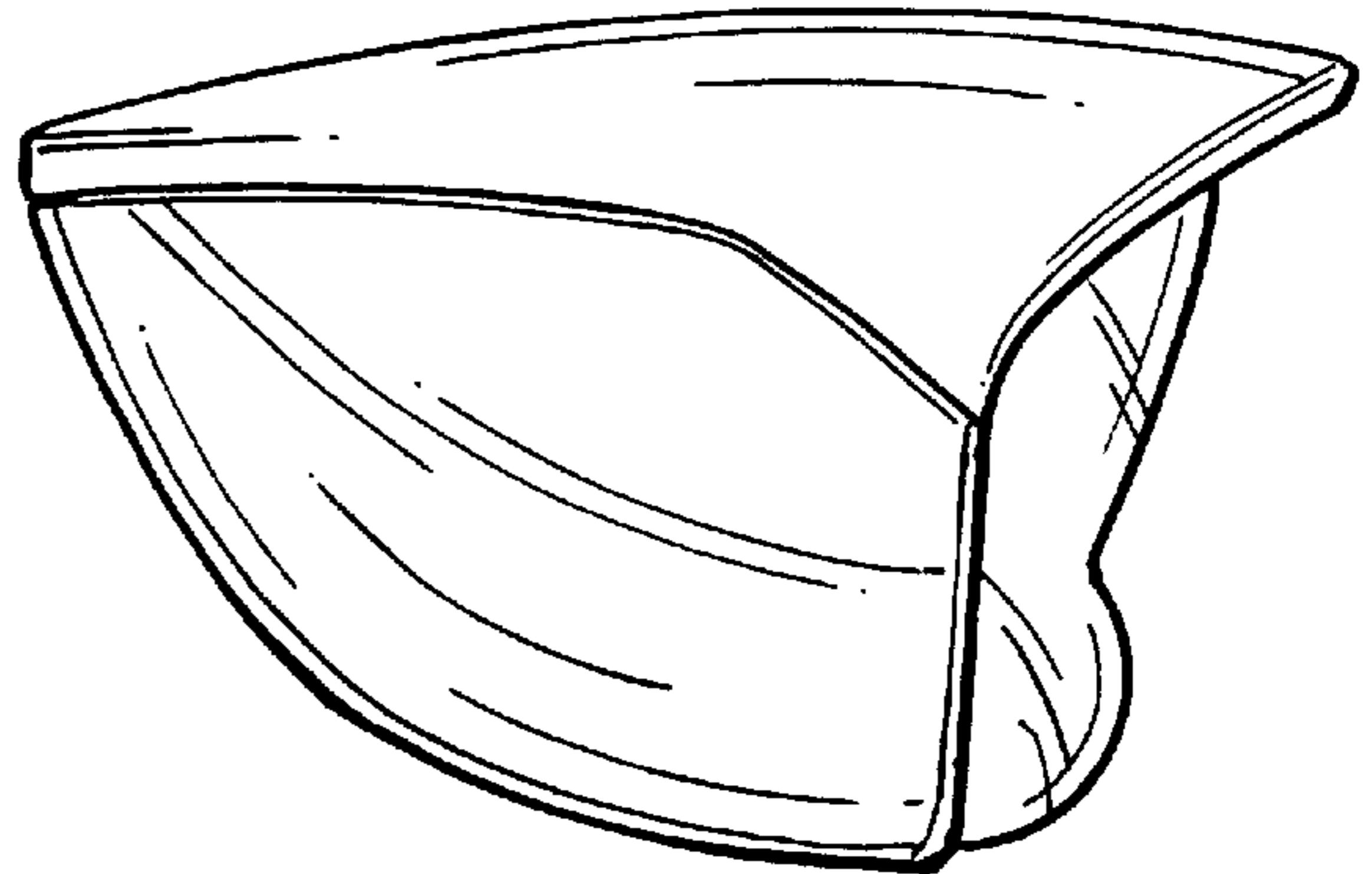

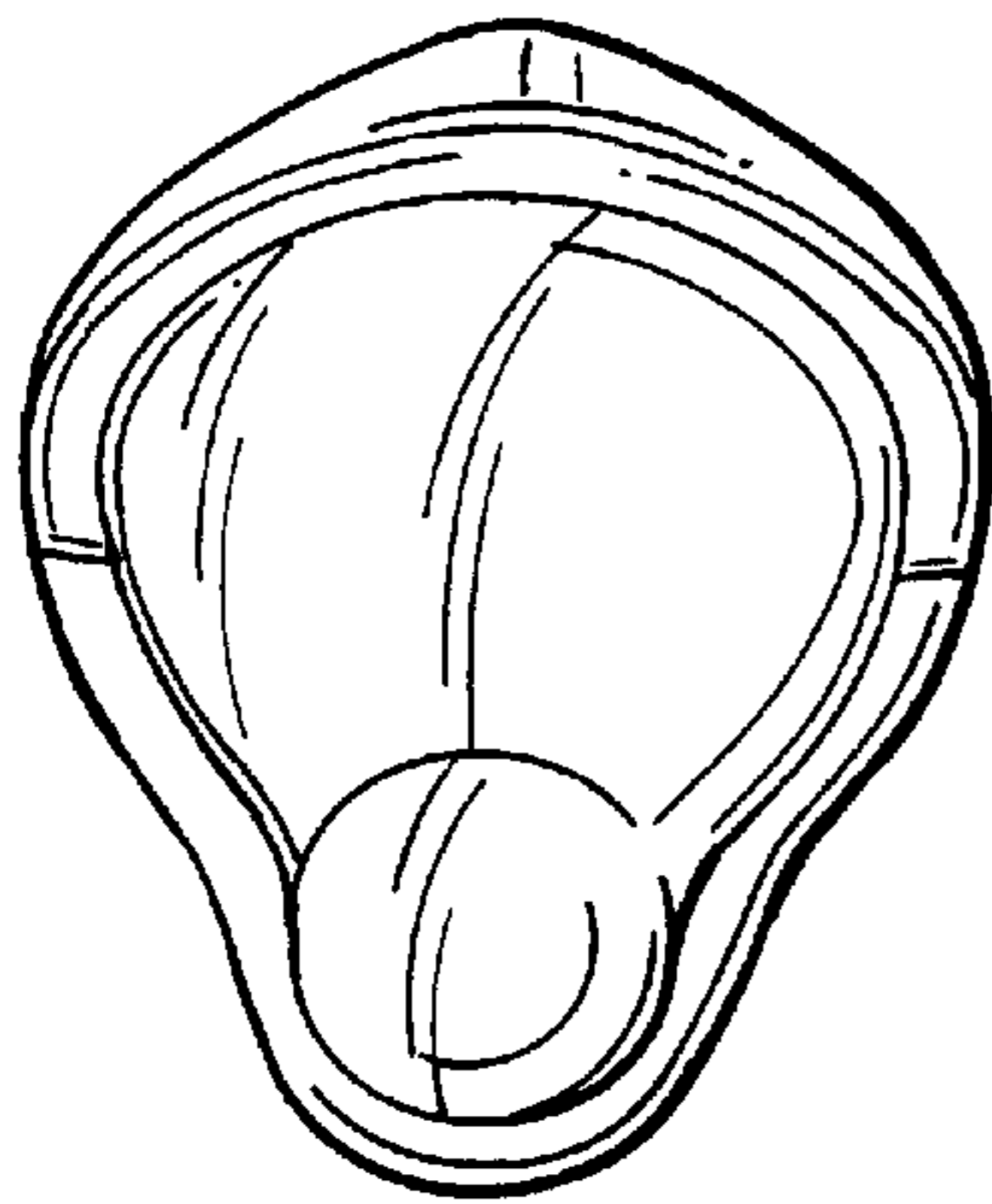

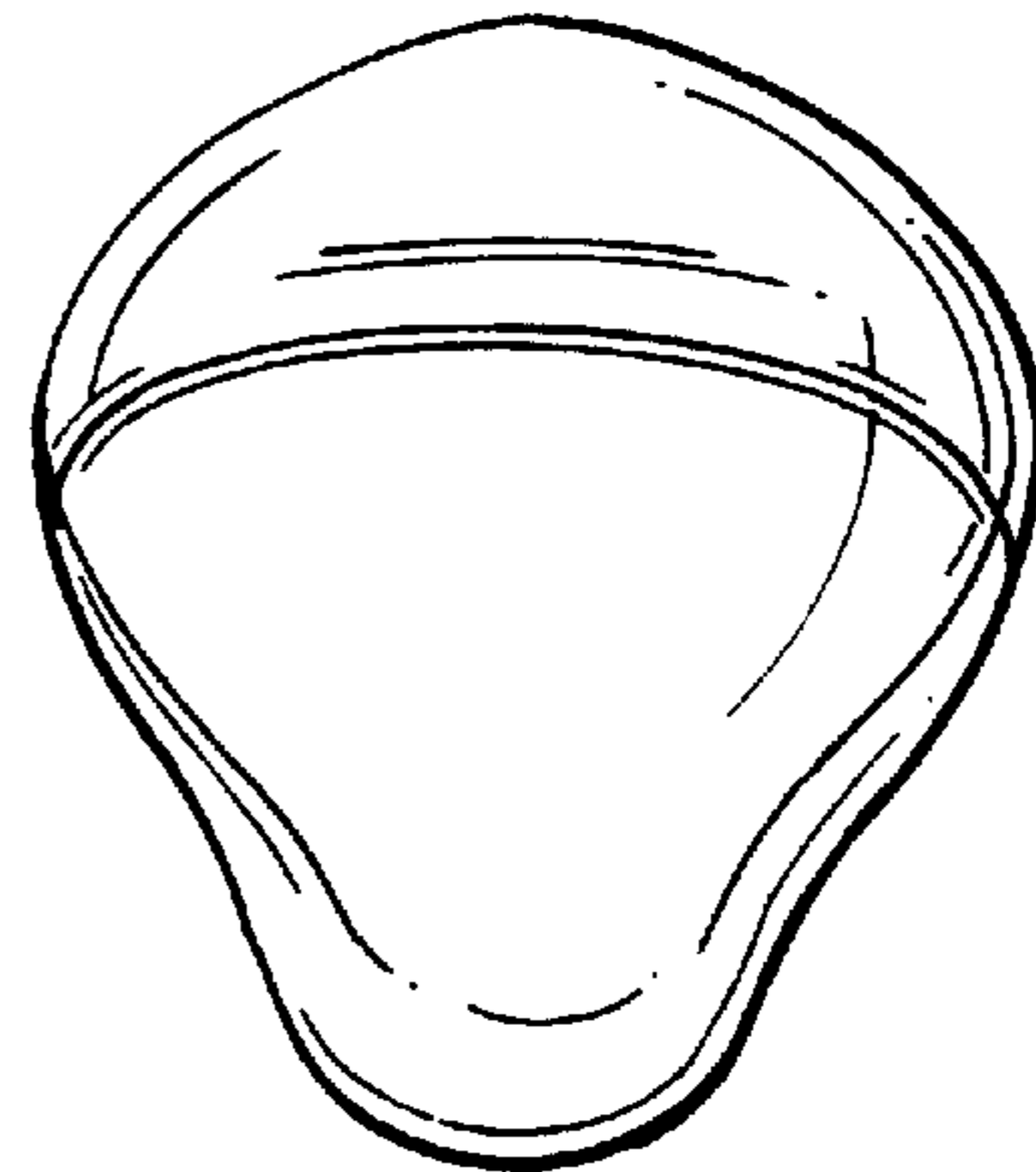

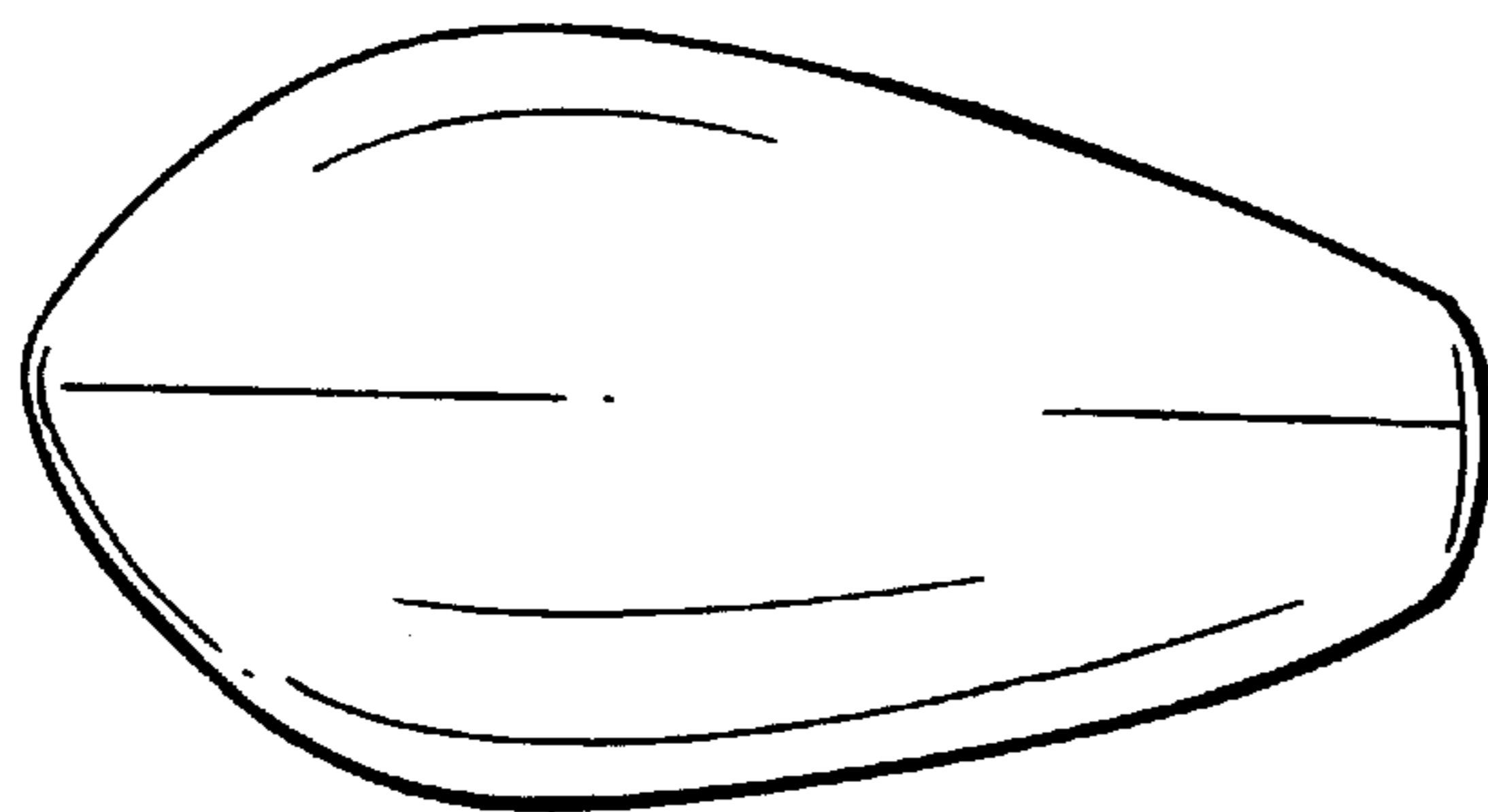
