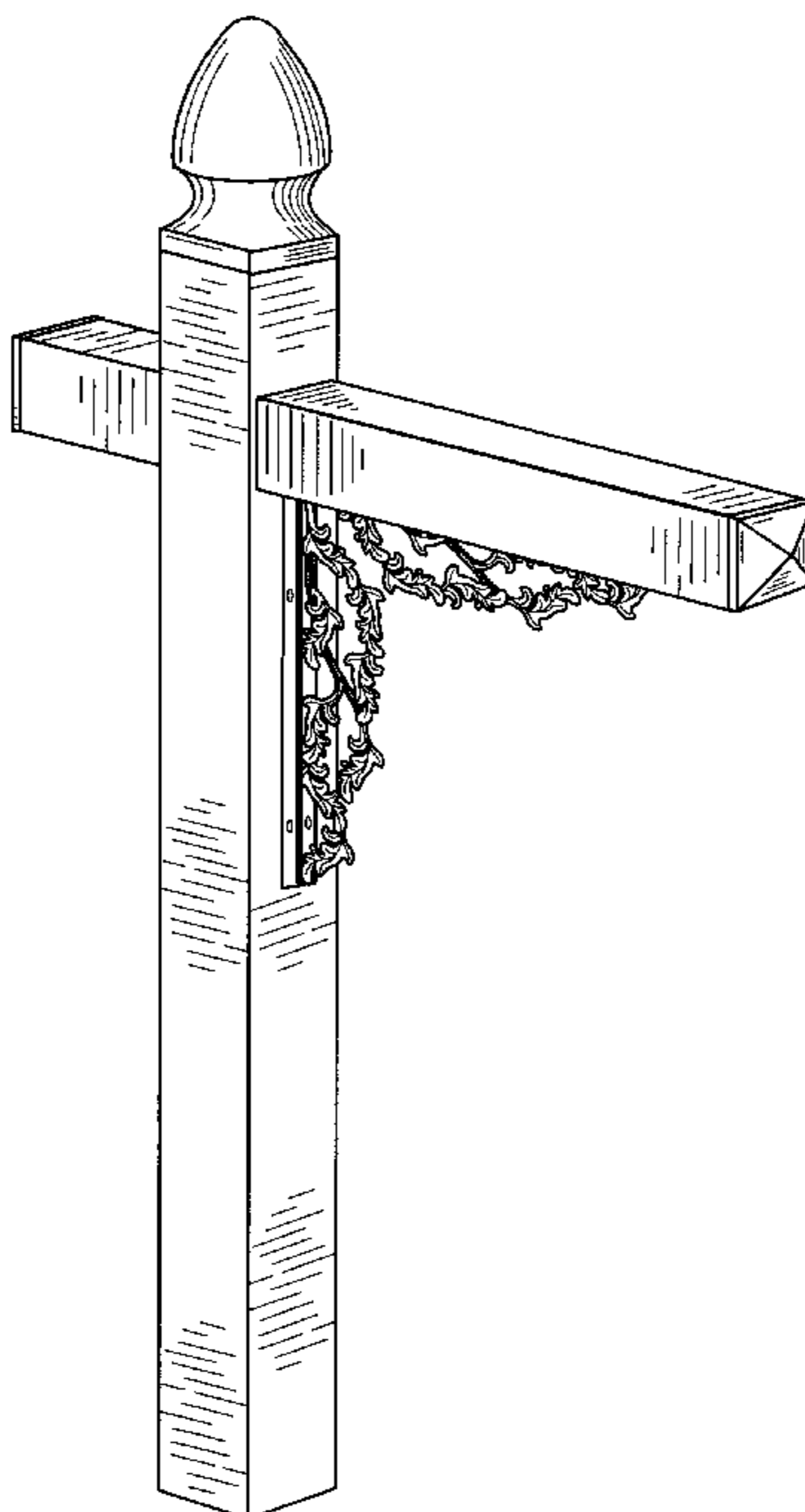
I claim the ornamental design for an mailbox post assembly, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective illustration of an mailbox post assembly according to a preferred form of the invention; FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view of the mailbox post assembly of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a rear view of the mailbox post assembly of FIG. 1; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view of the mailbox post assembly of FIG. 1; FIG. 5 is a front view of the mailbox post assembly of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is an exploded side perspective view of the mailbox post assembly shown in an alternate stored position for purposes of illustration; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the mailbox post assembly with the cap removed for ease of illustration.

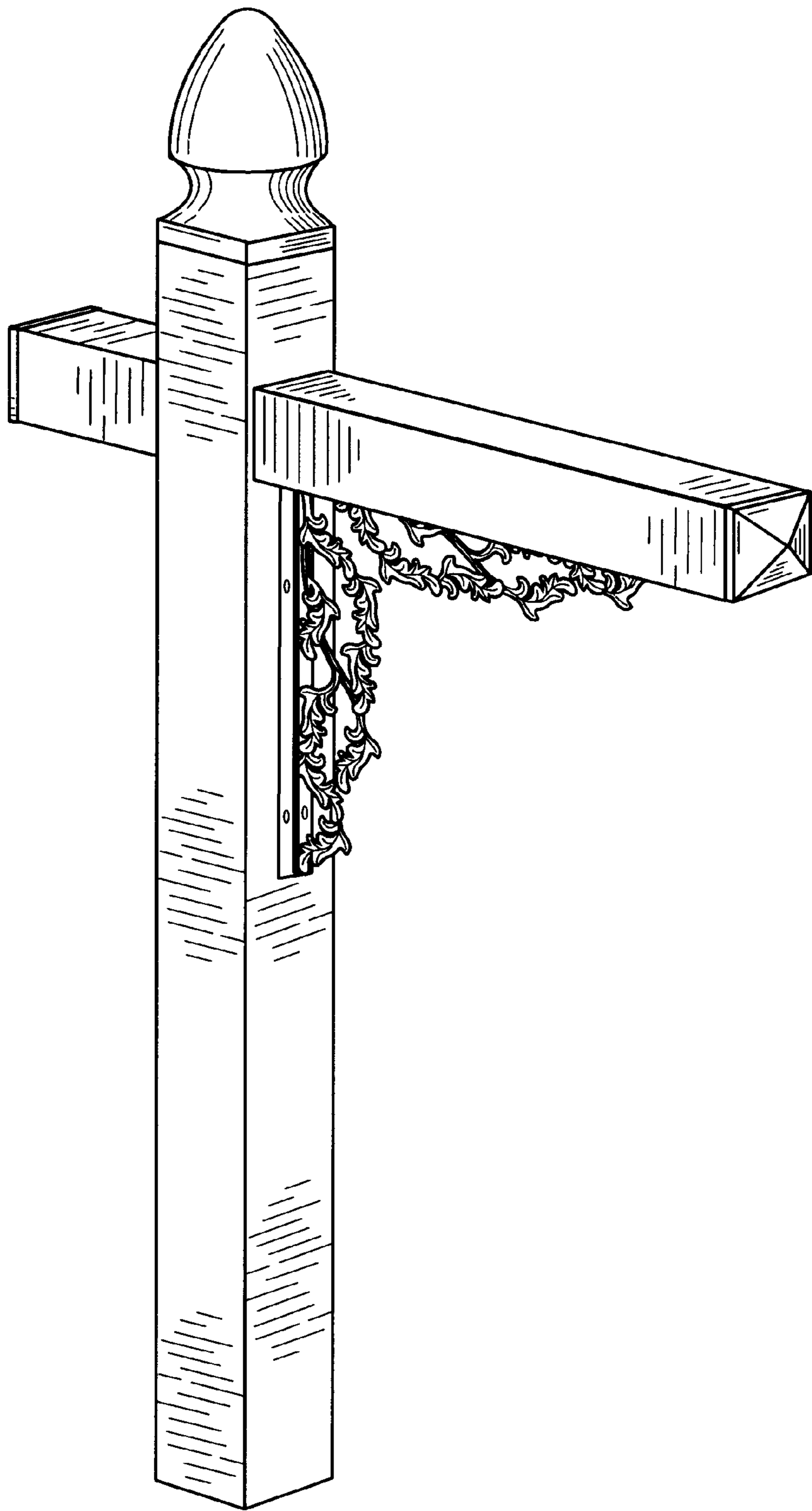

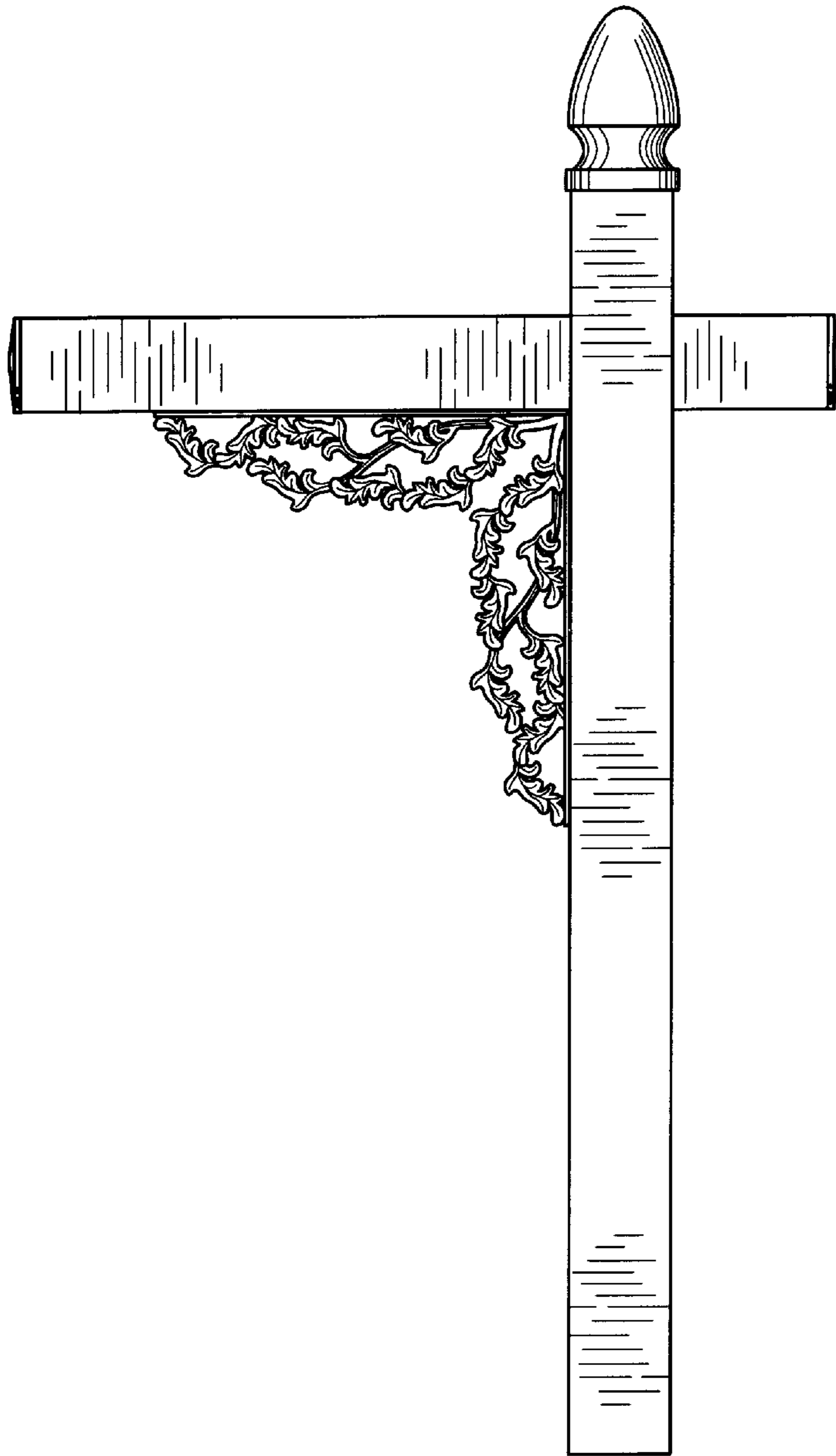

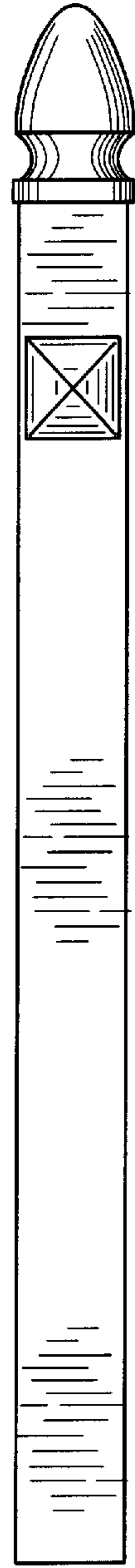

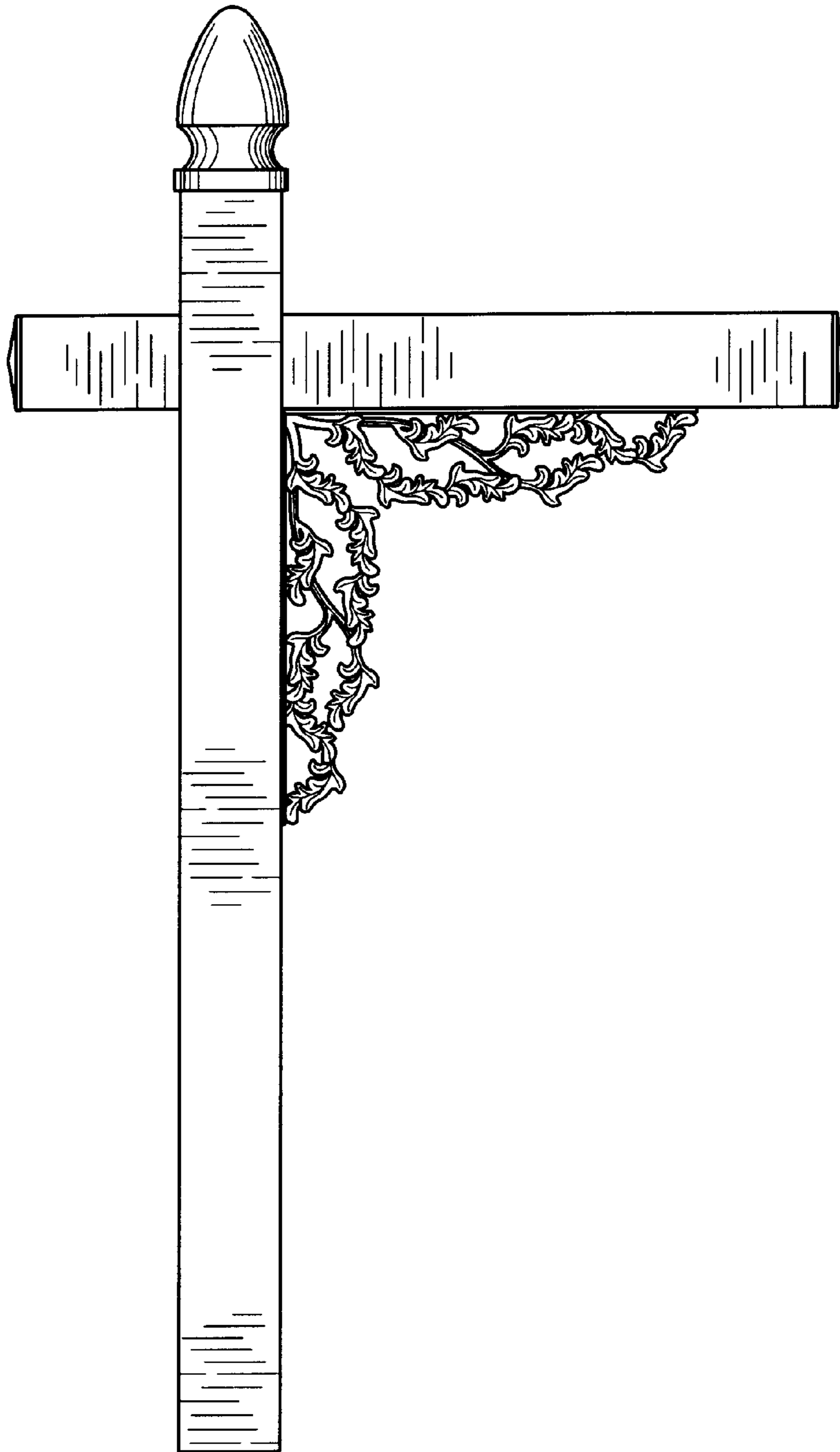
