(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a transaction card, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a transaction card showing my new design;  
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the transaction card, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof;  
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the transaction card; and,  
 FIG. 4 is a left elevational view of the transaction card, with the right elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

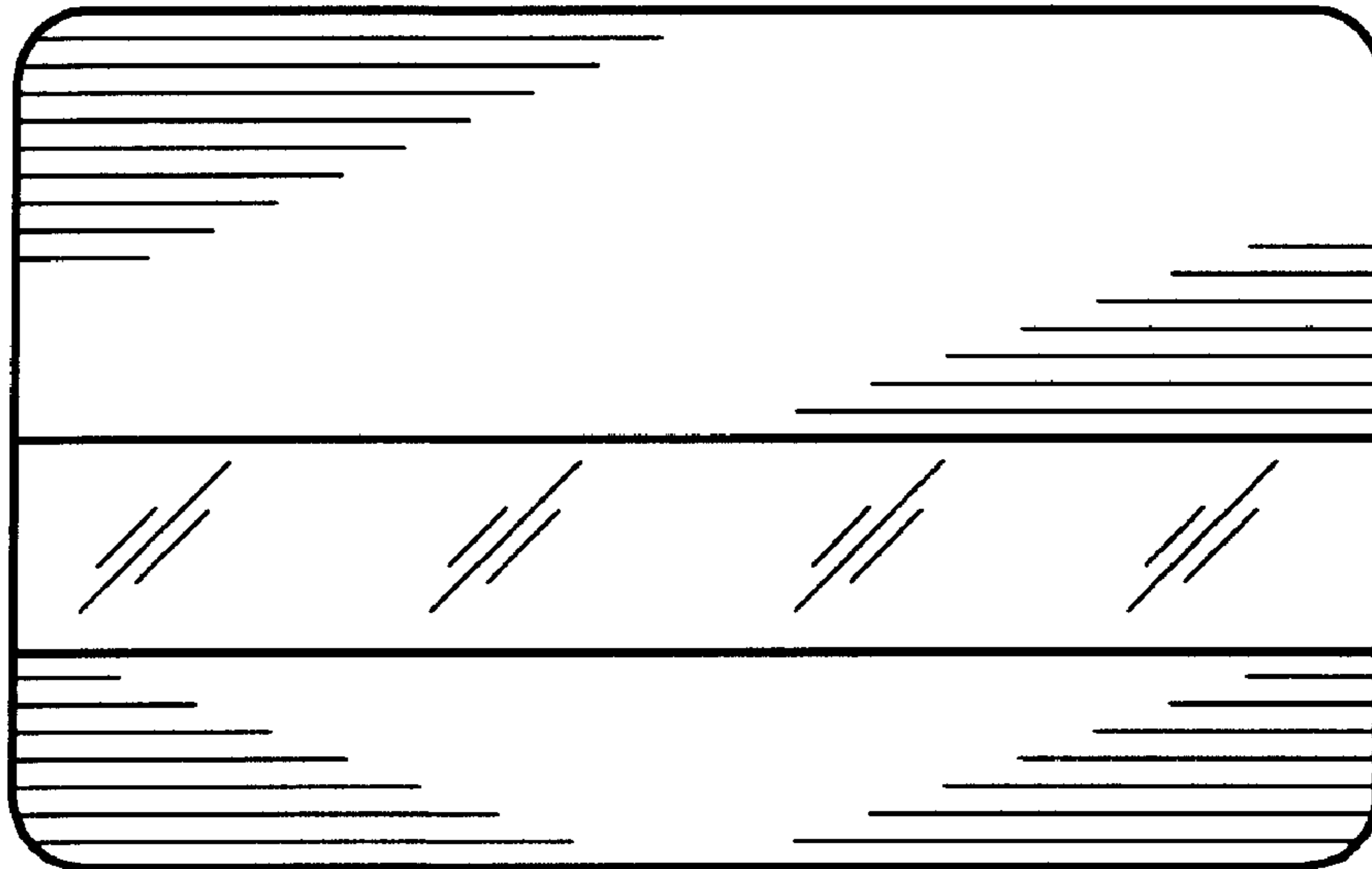

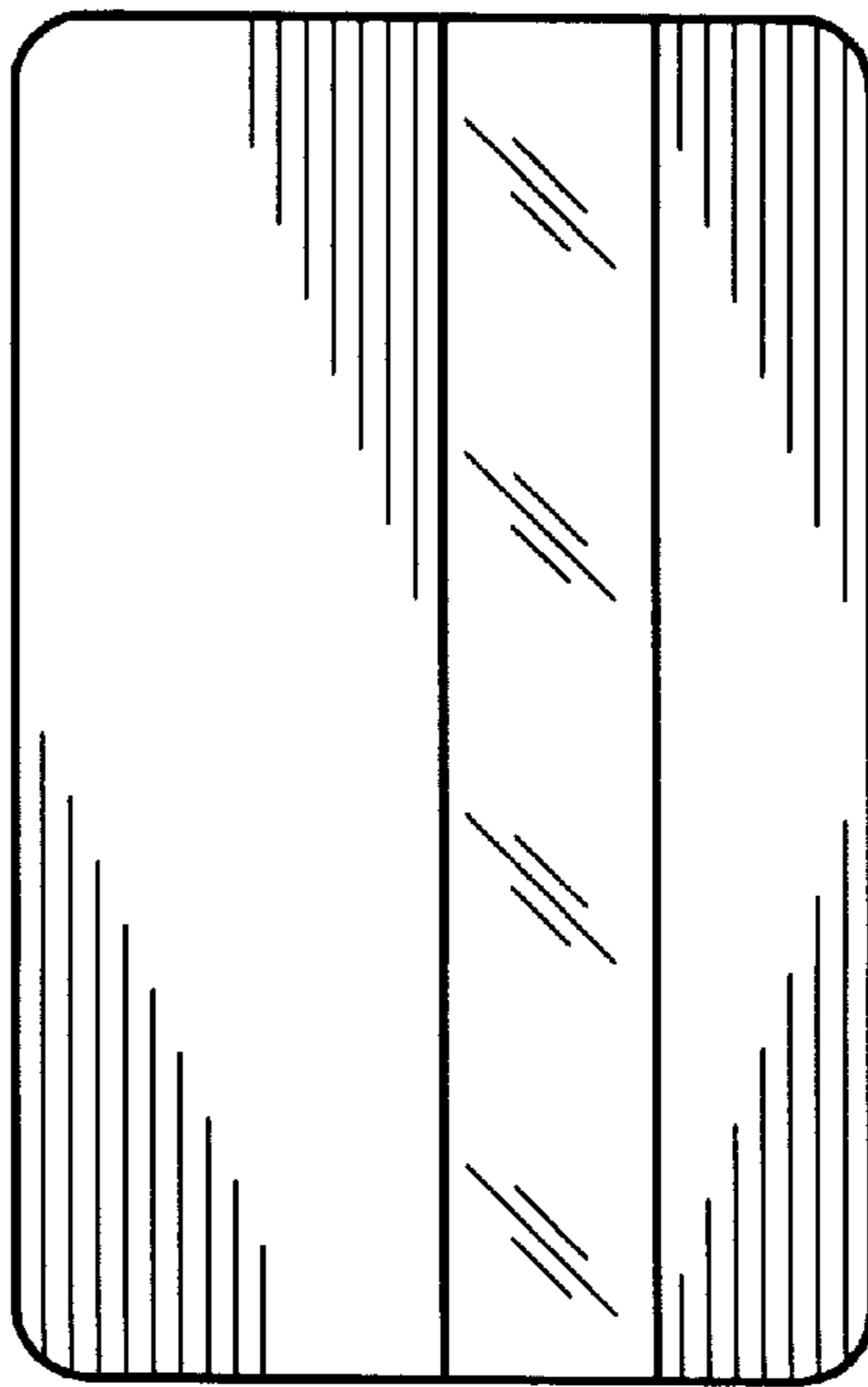

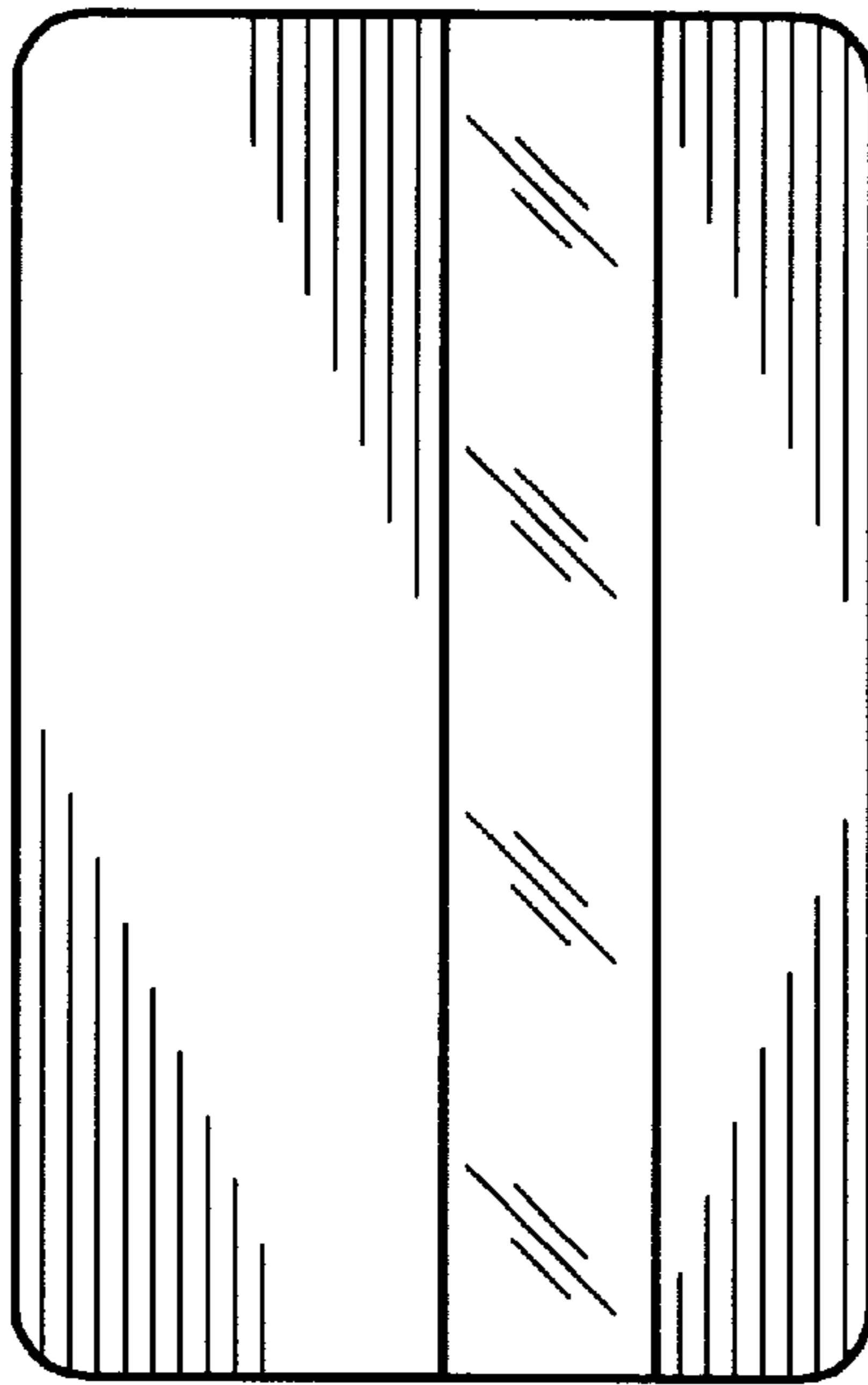
