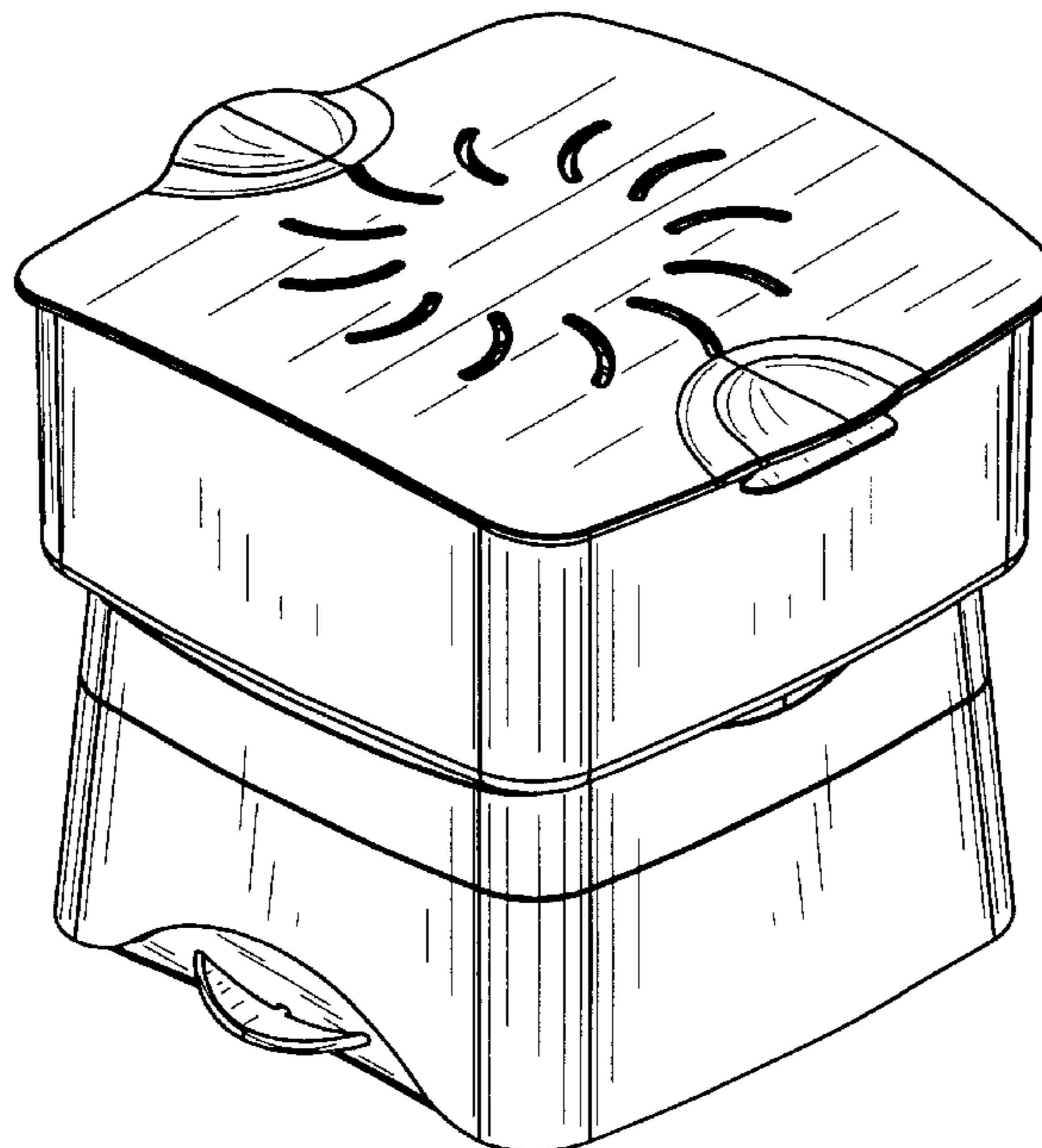
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of the household product sanitizer of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a rear view of the household product sanitizer of the present invention;

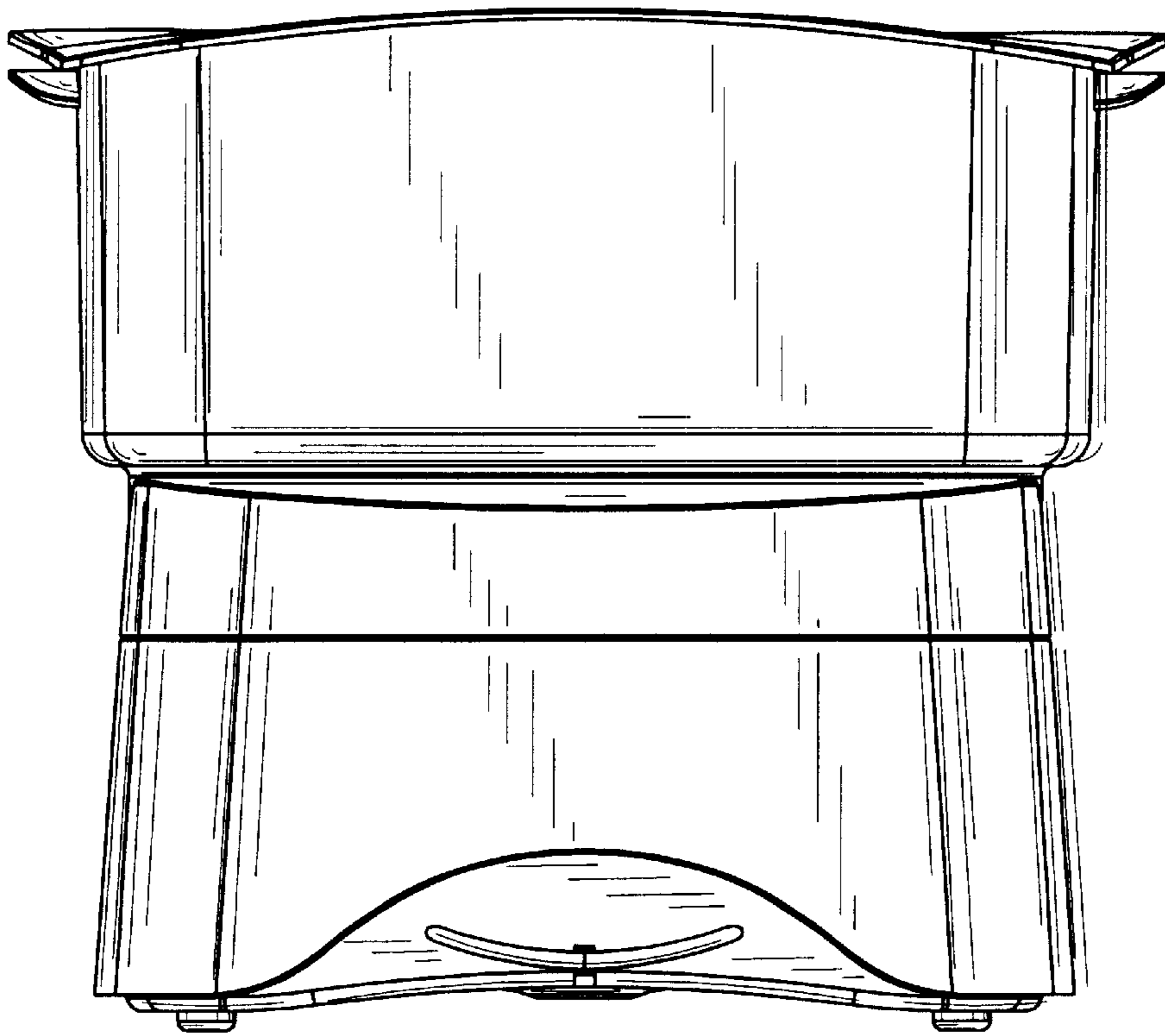

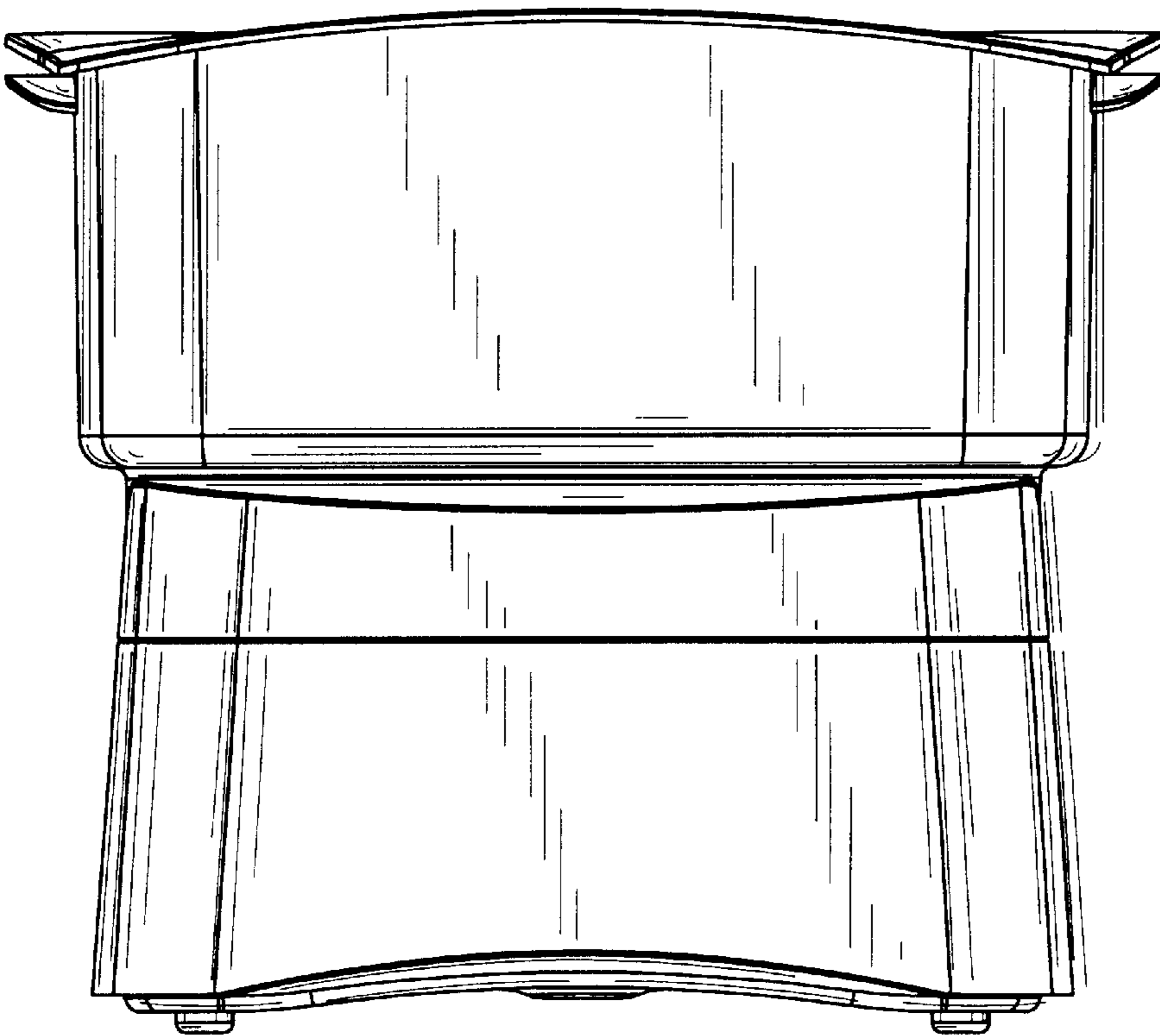

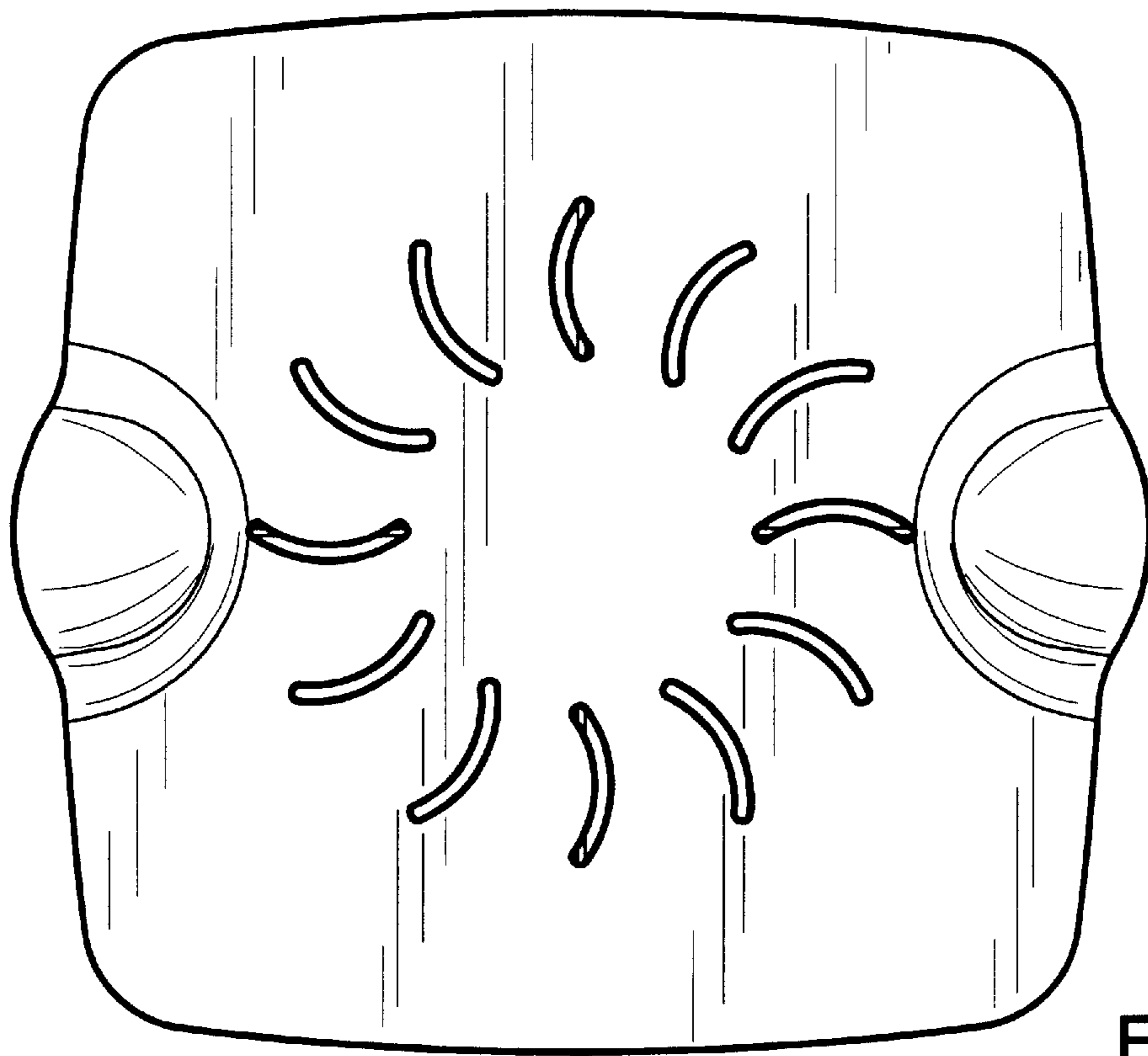

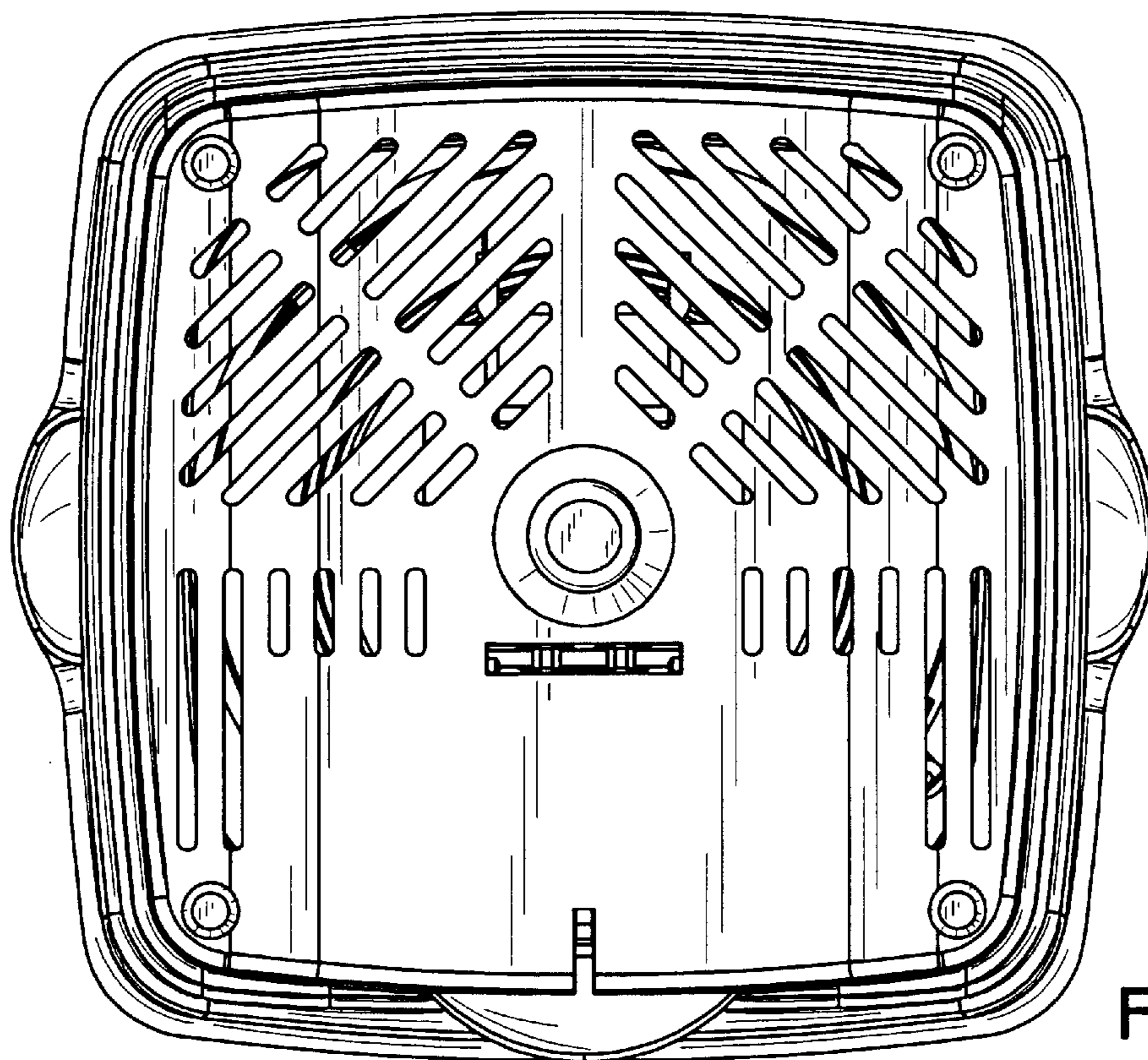

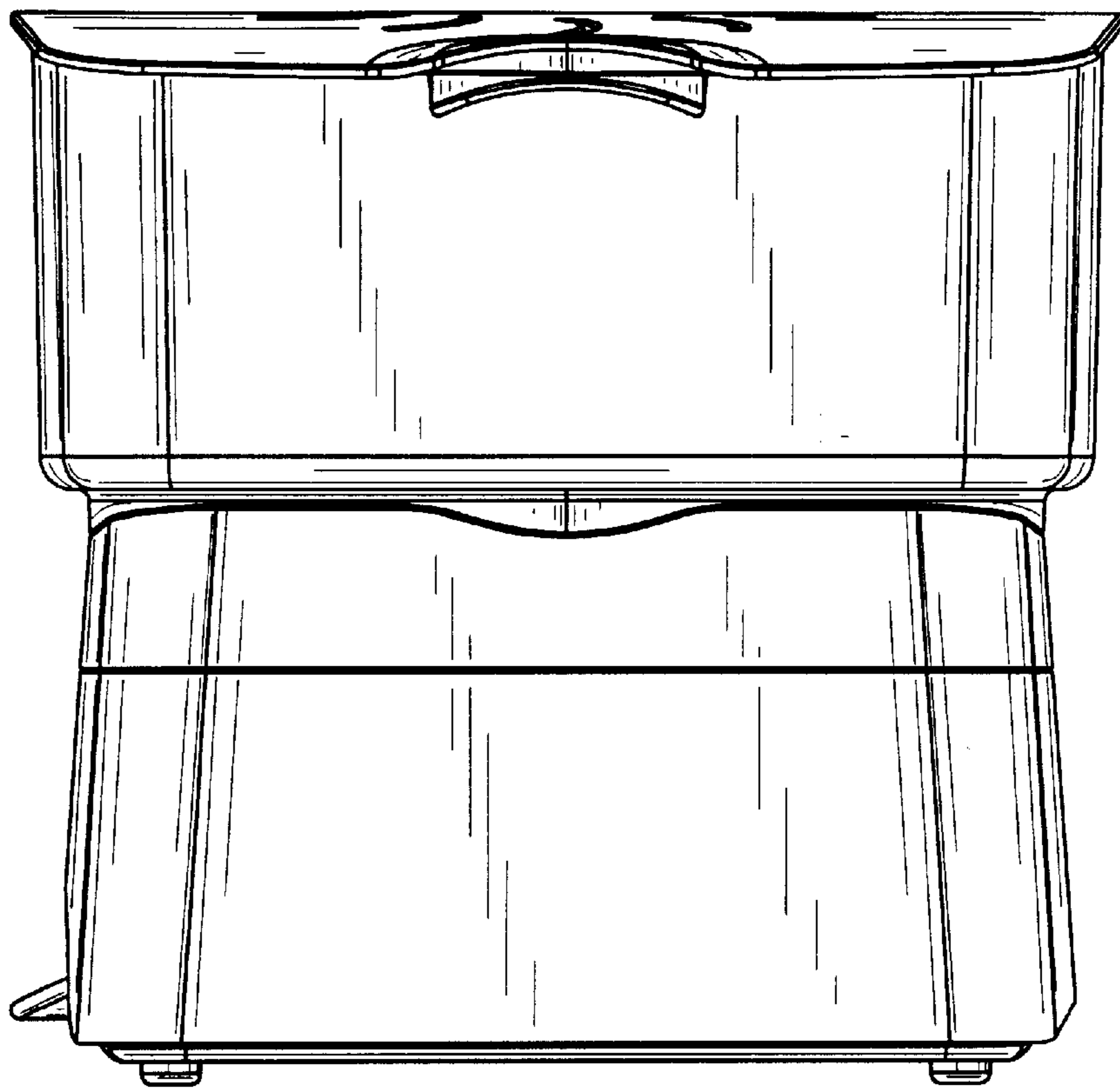

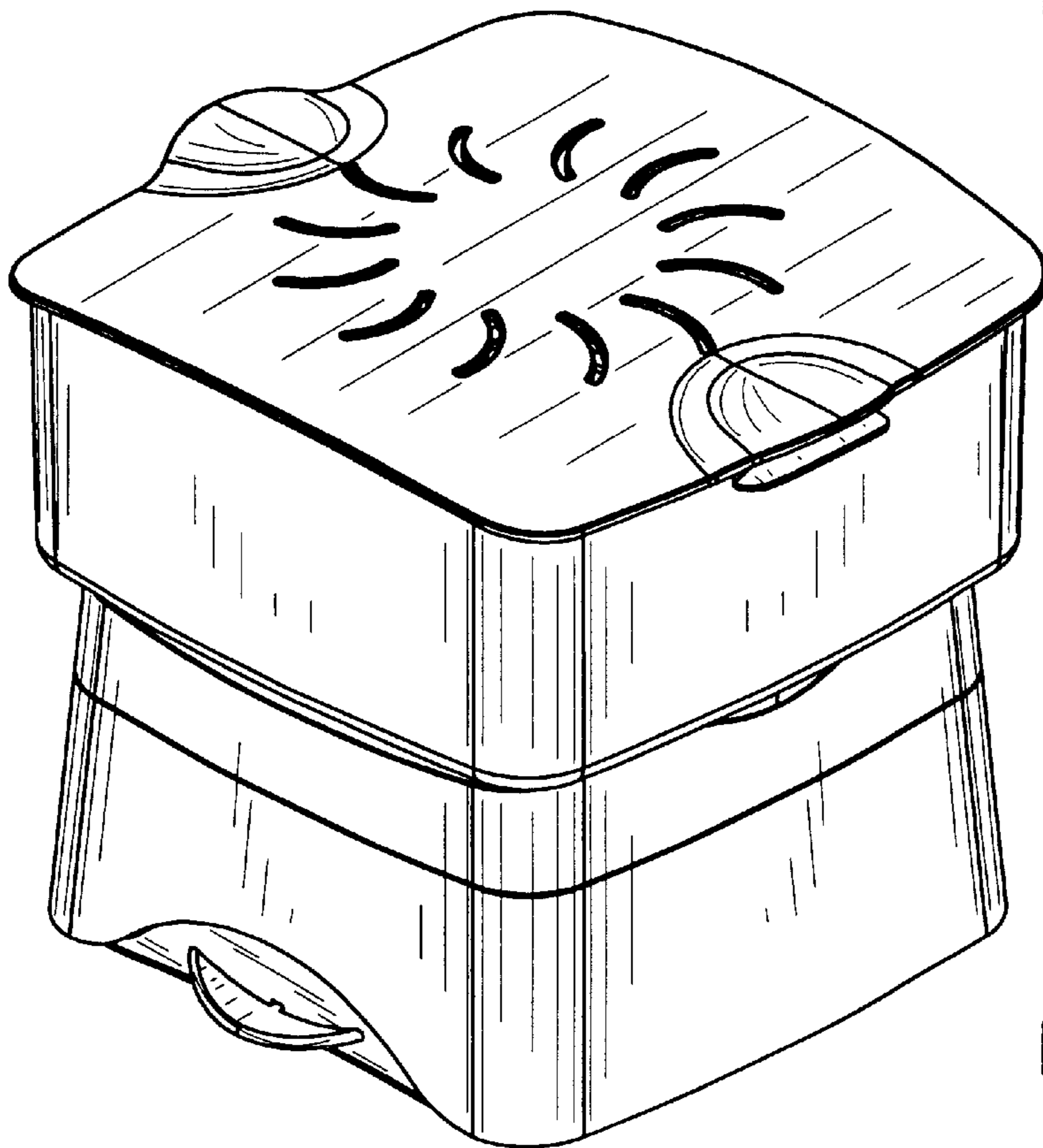
